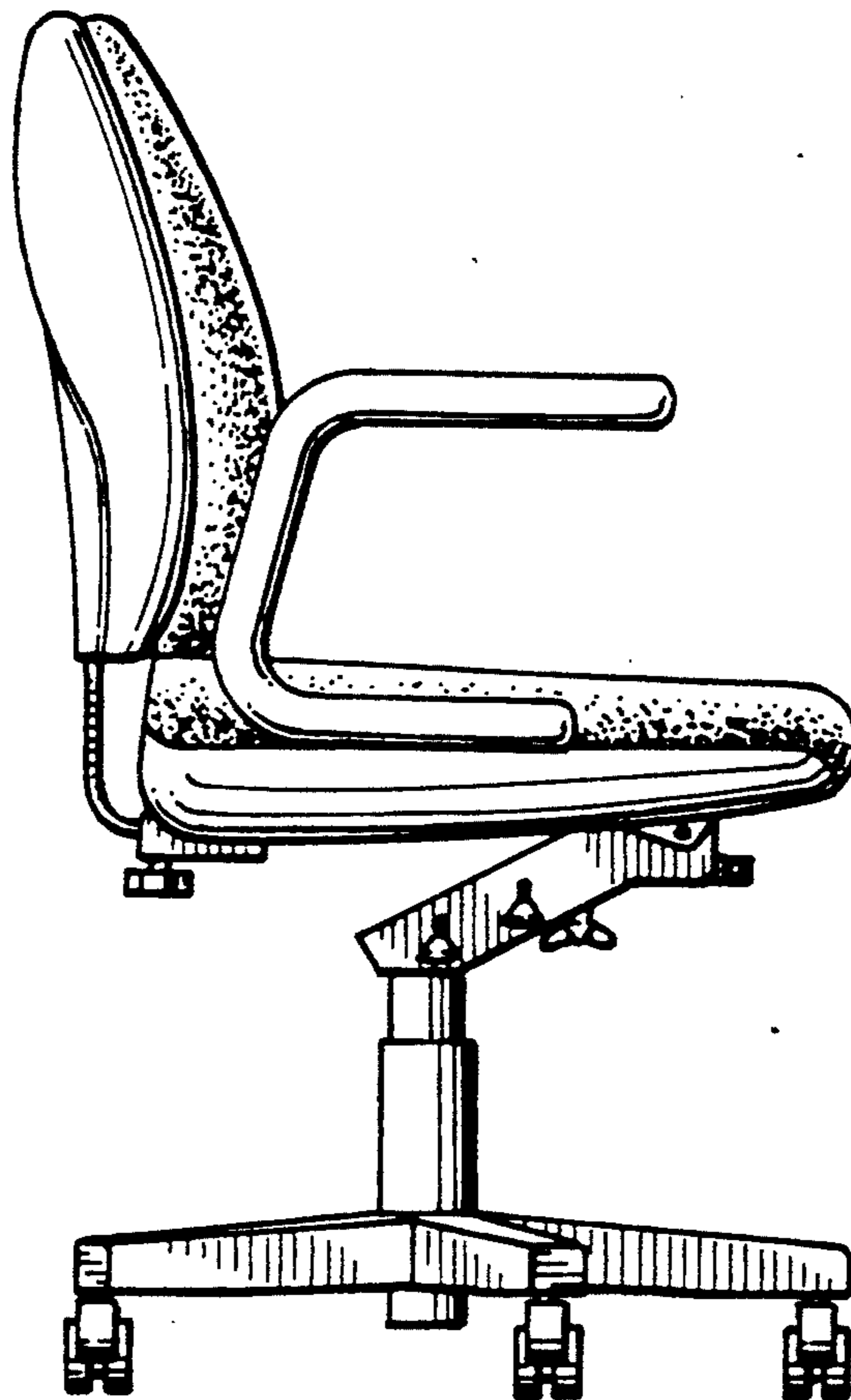

DESCRIPTION

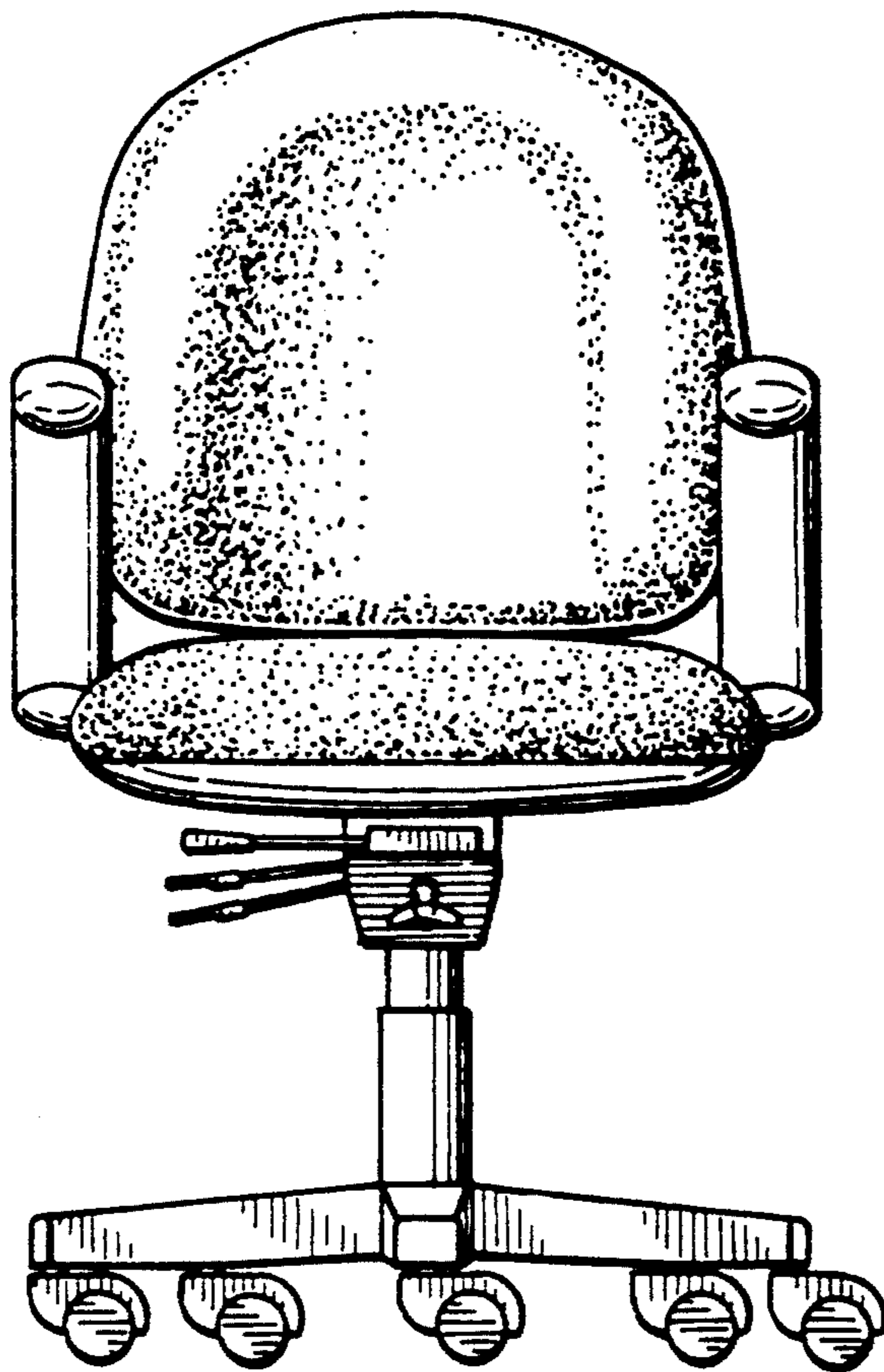

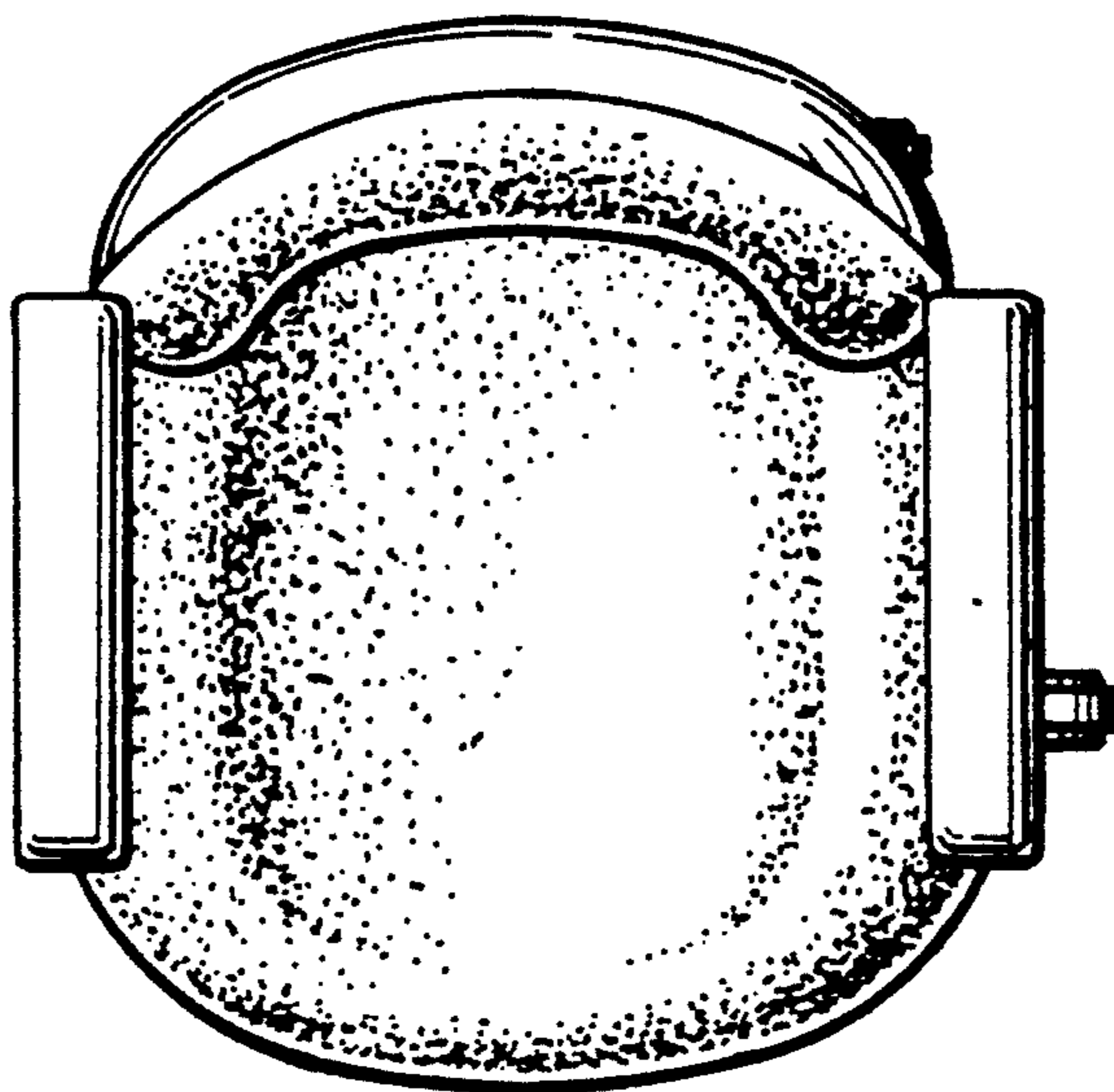

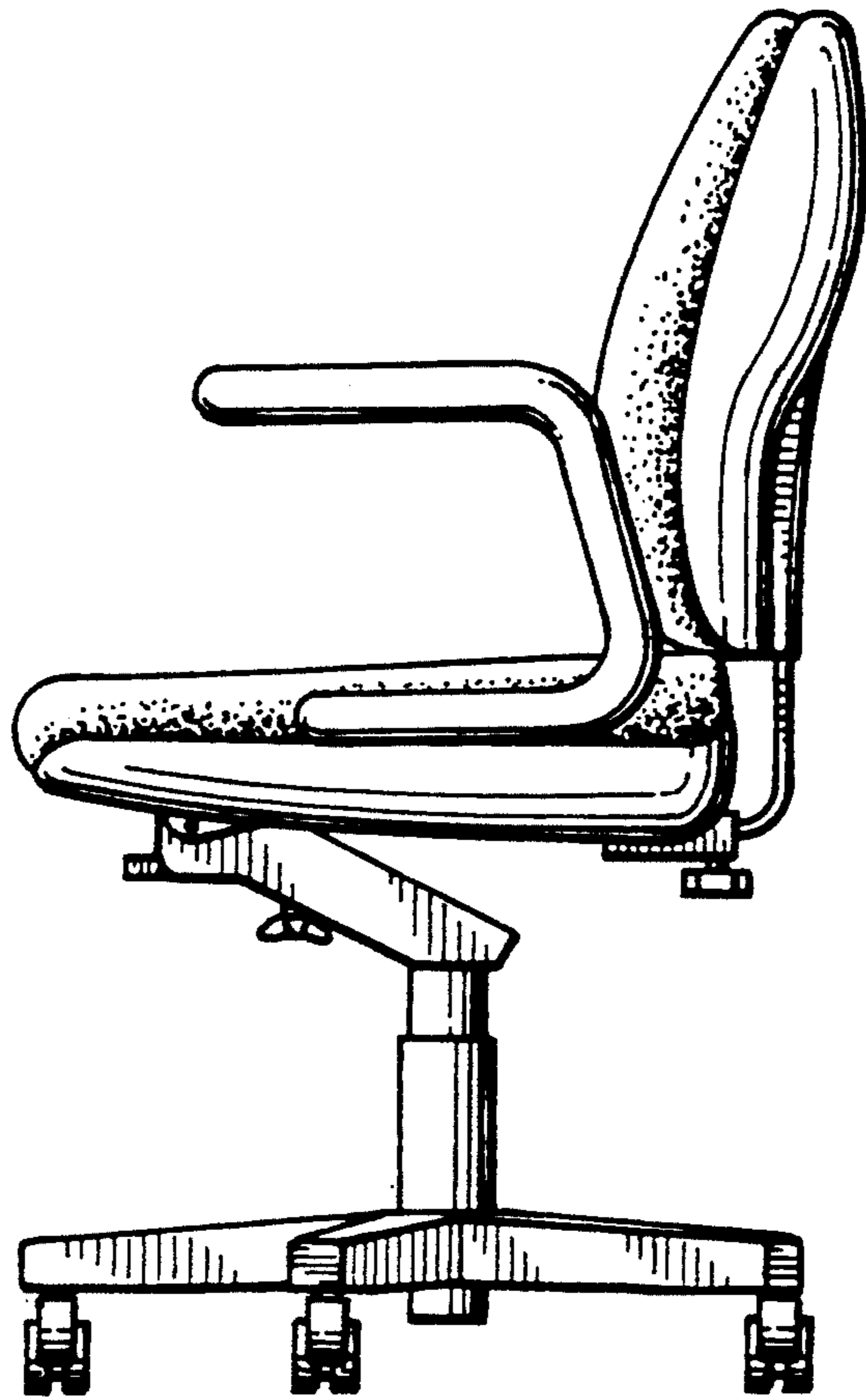

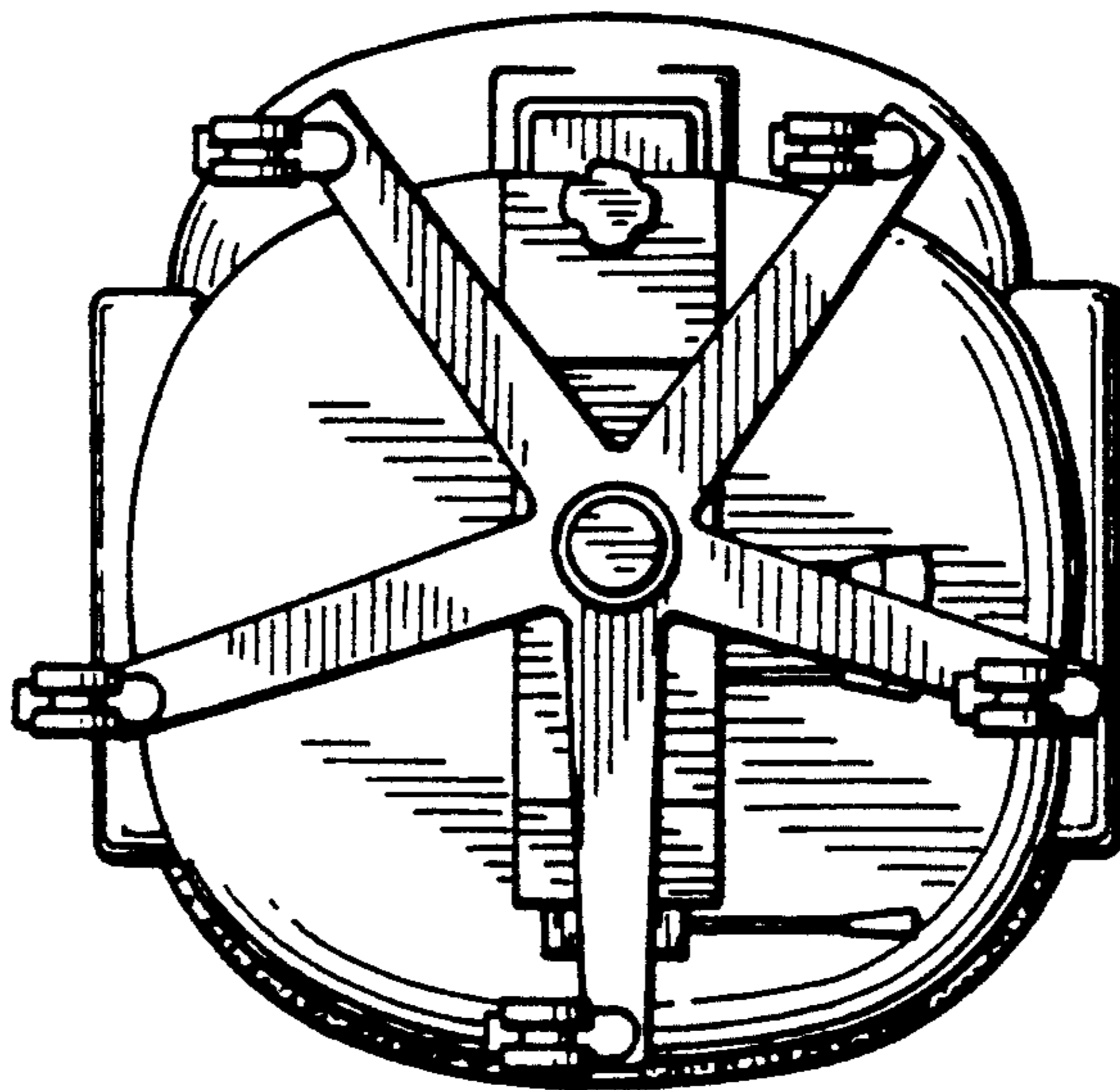

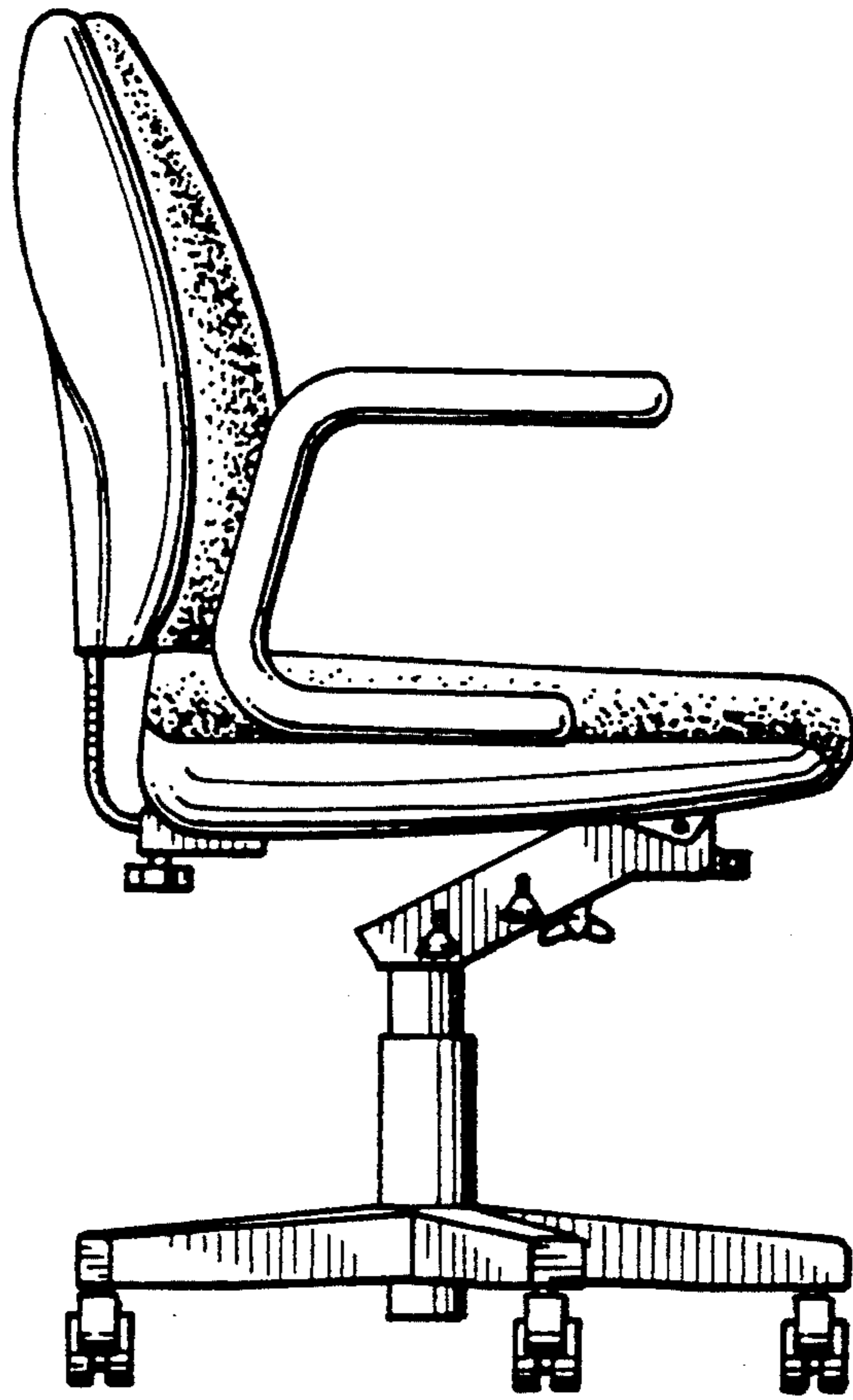

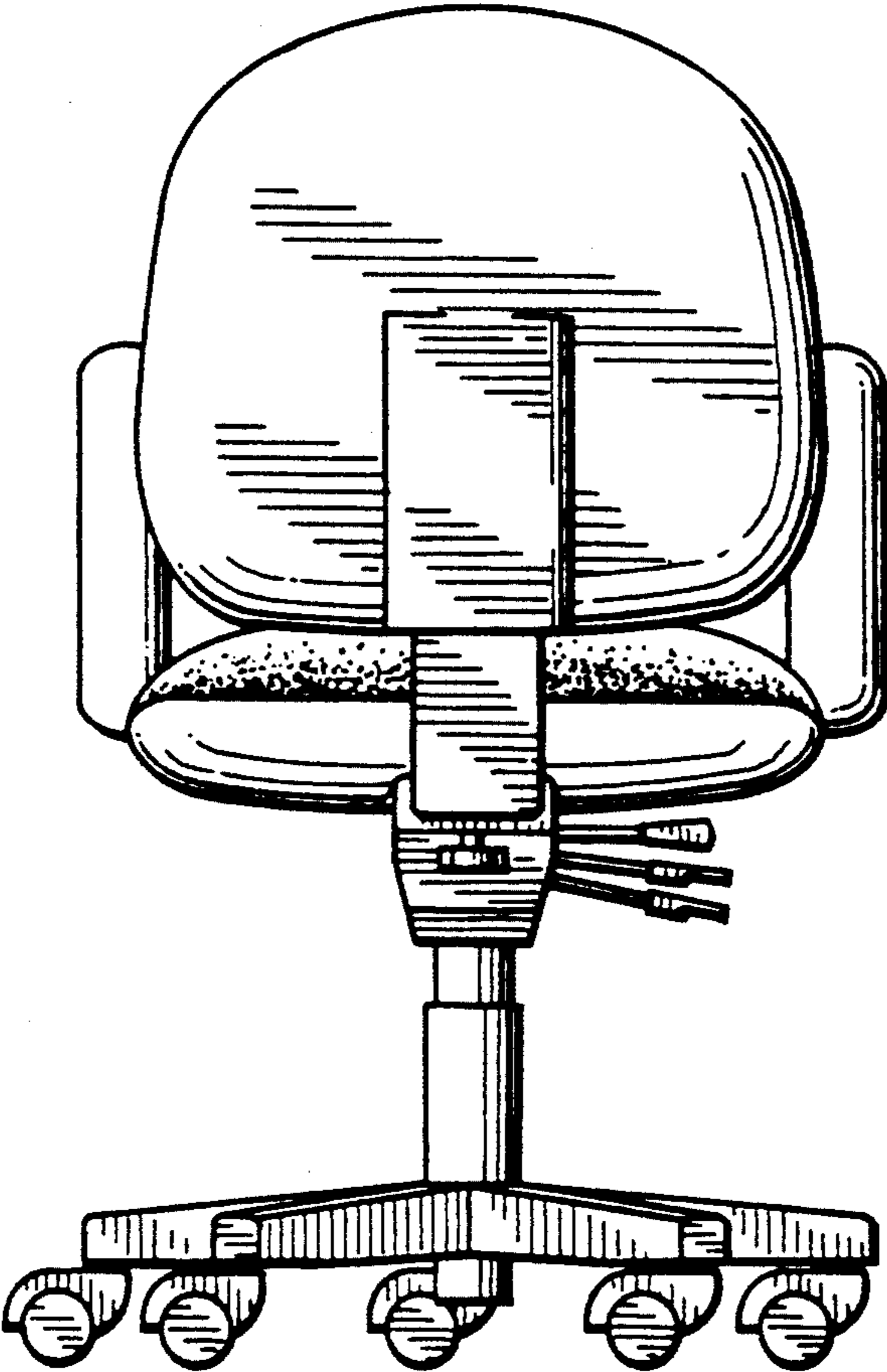

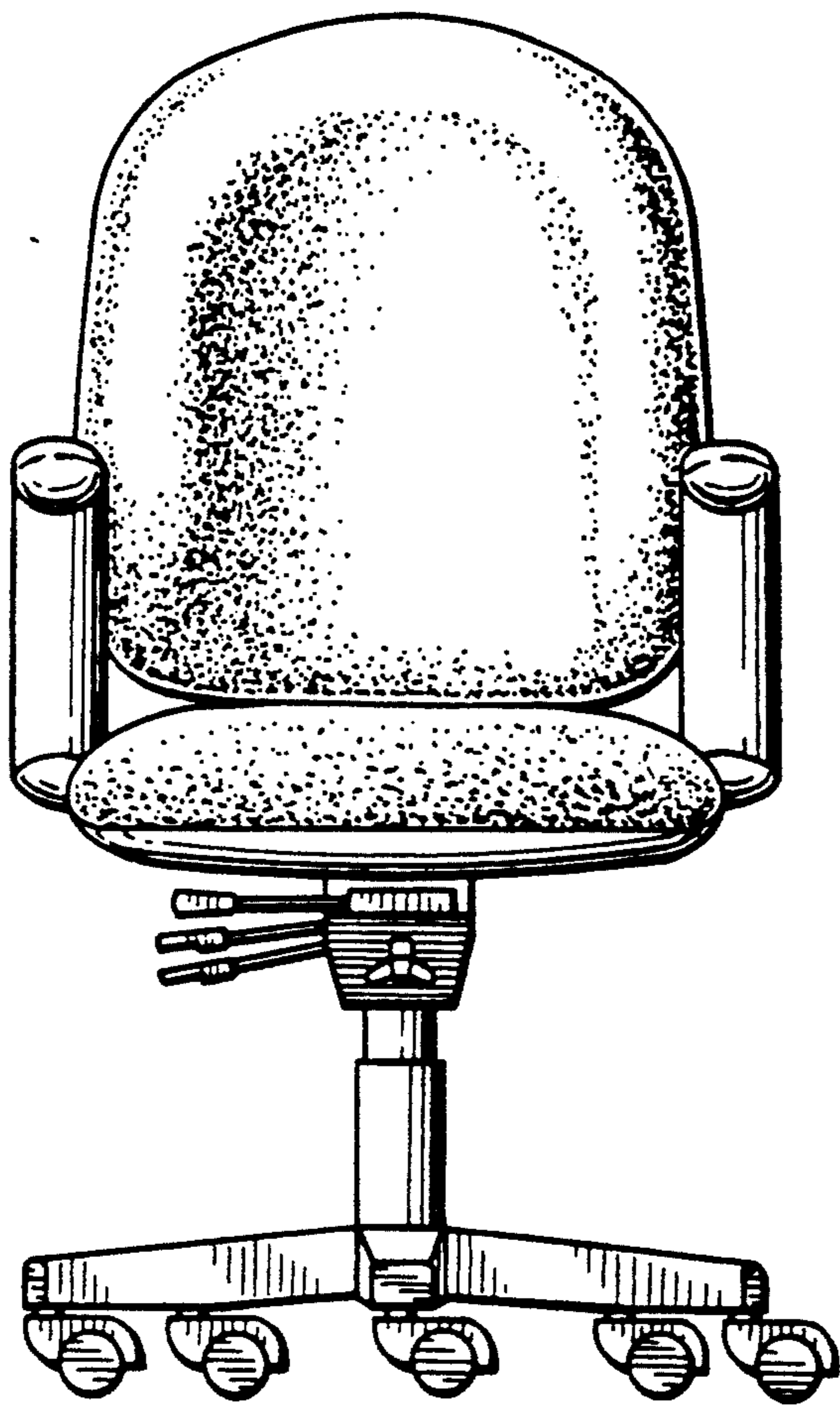

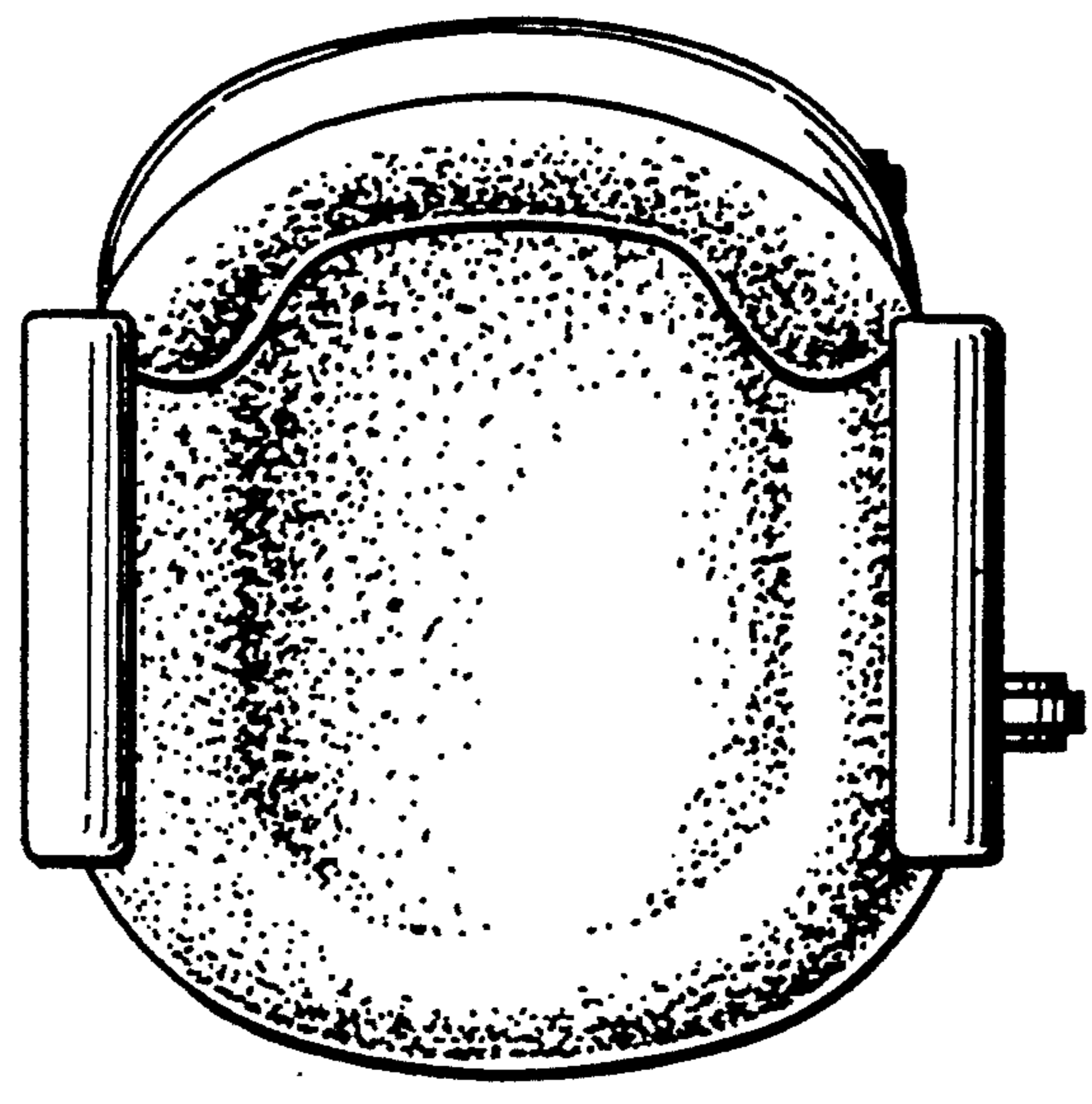

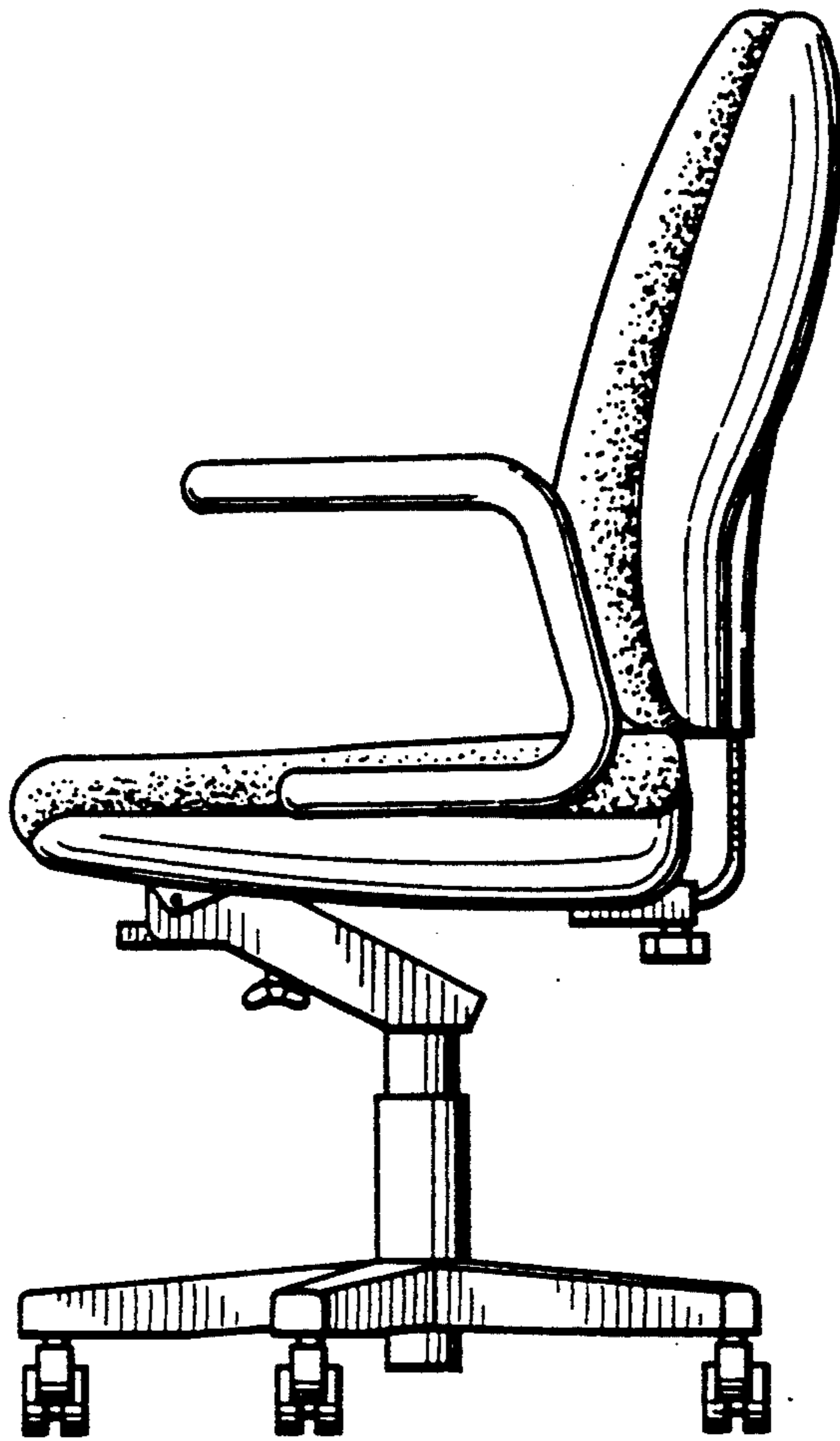

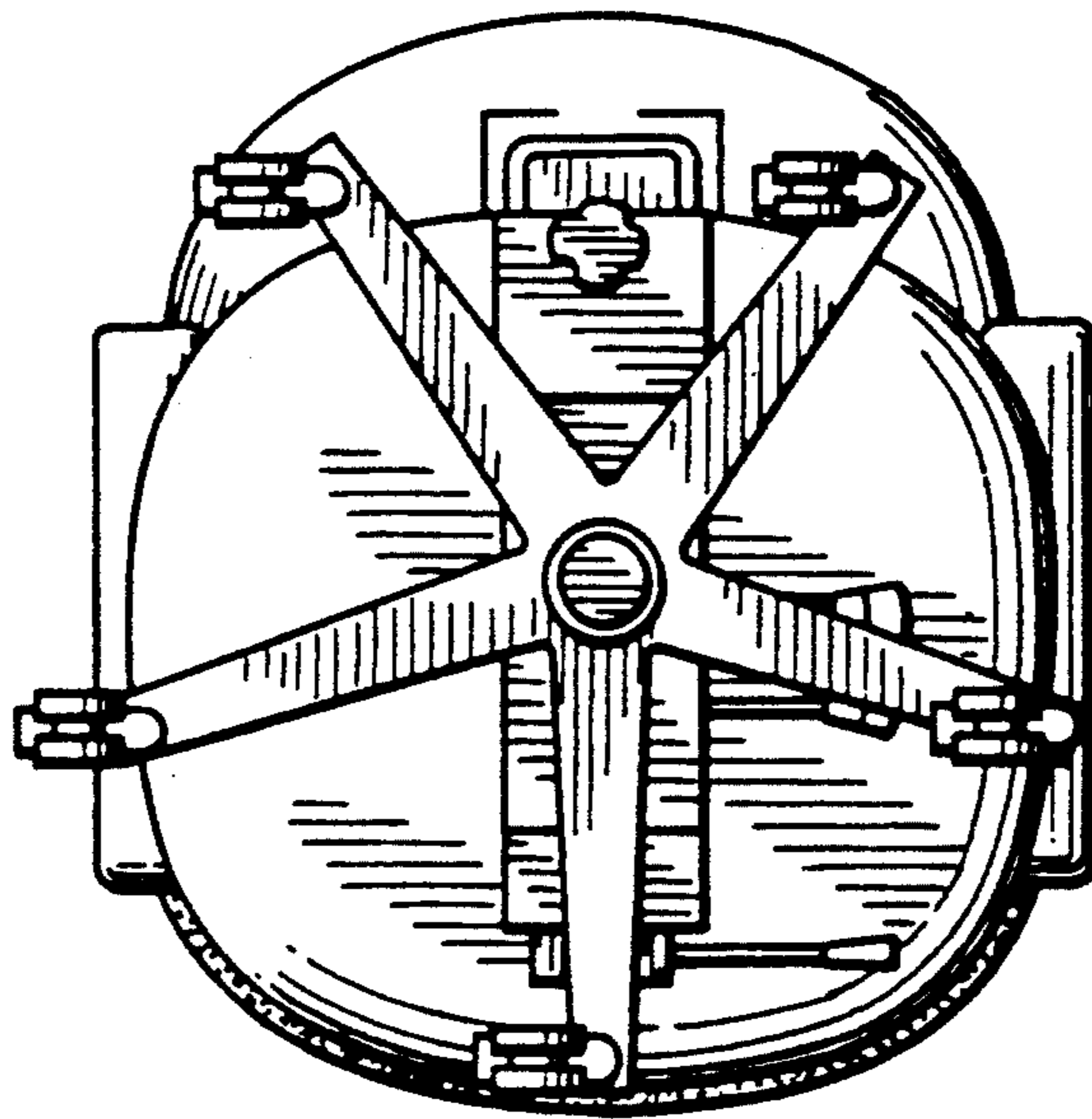

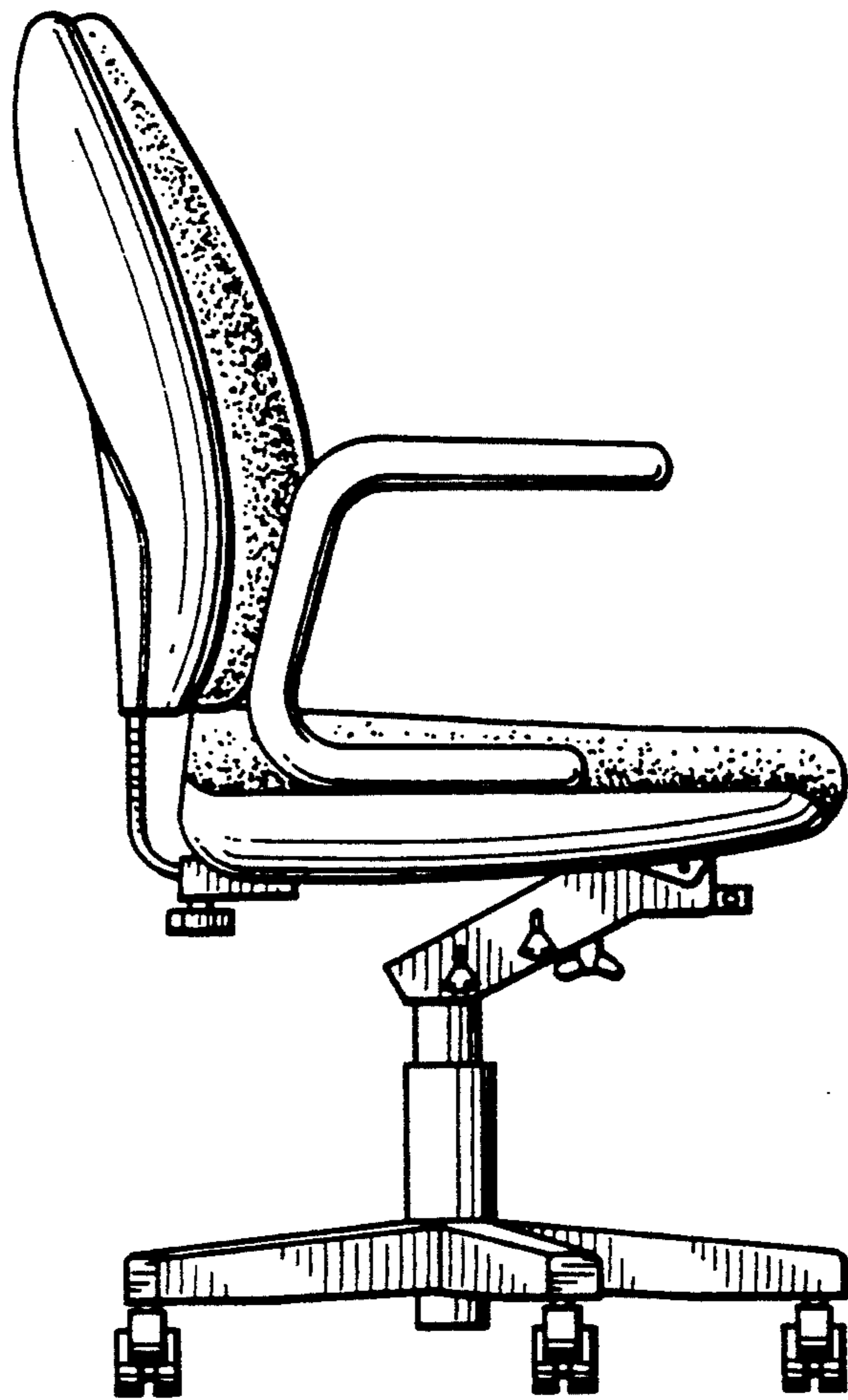

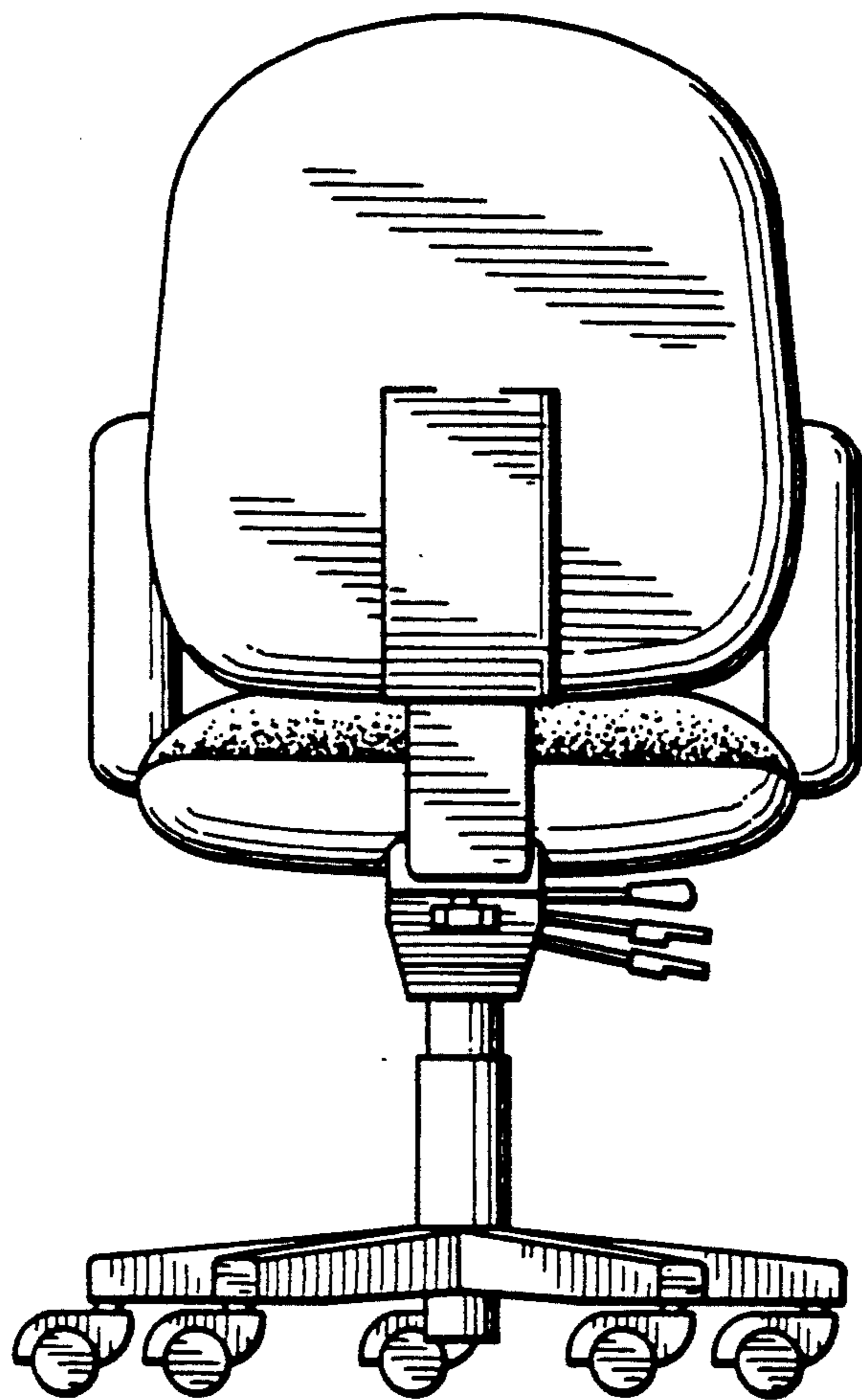
