DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined leg abductor and cushion showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror of that shown;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror of that shown;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,


FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.




