FIG. 1 shows a front perspective view of a kiosk showing my design;

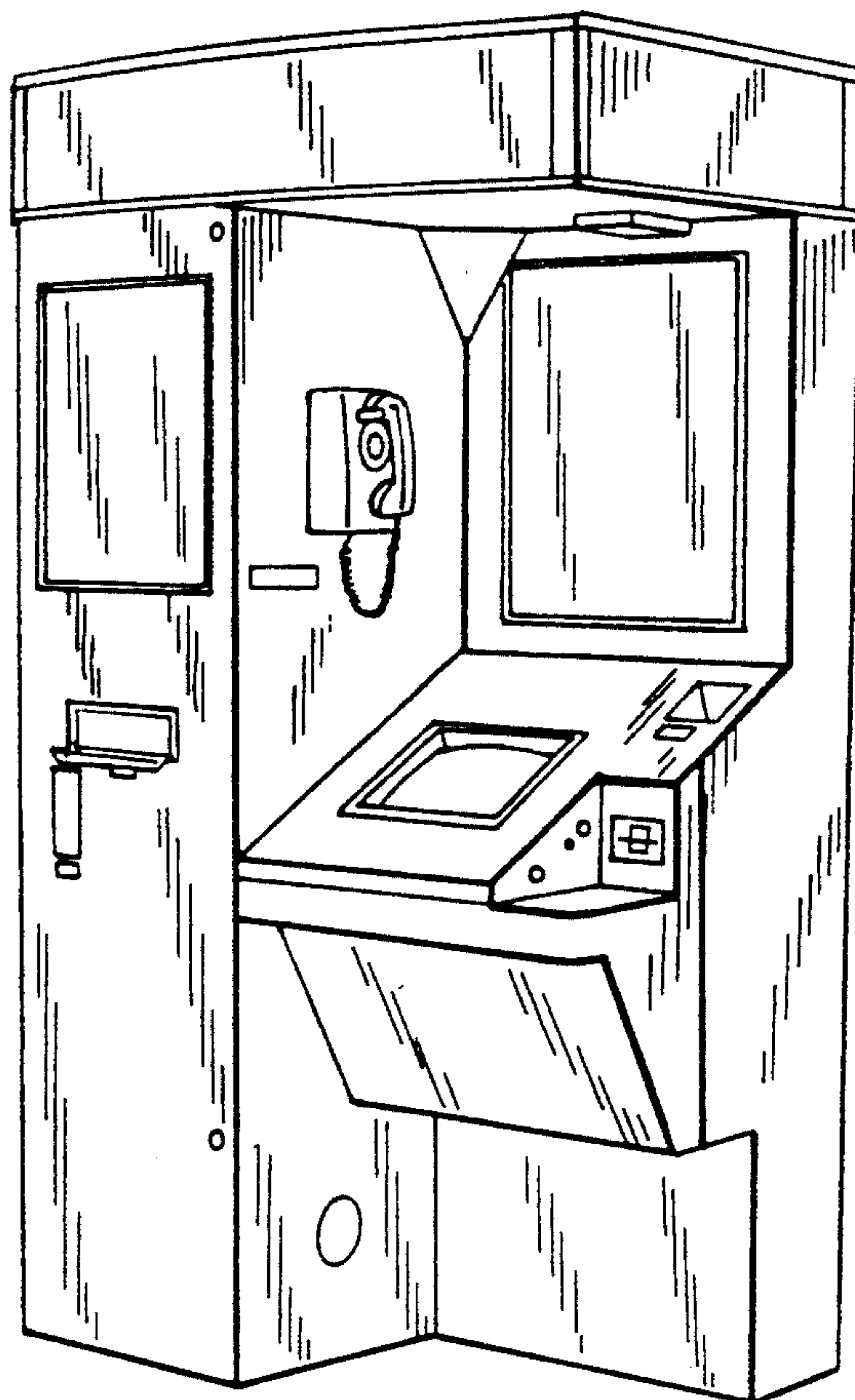
FIG. 2 shows a perspective view of my design;

FIG. 6 shows a perspective view of the alternate design shown in FIG. 5.



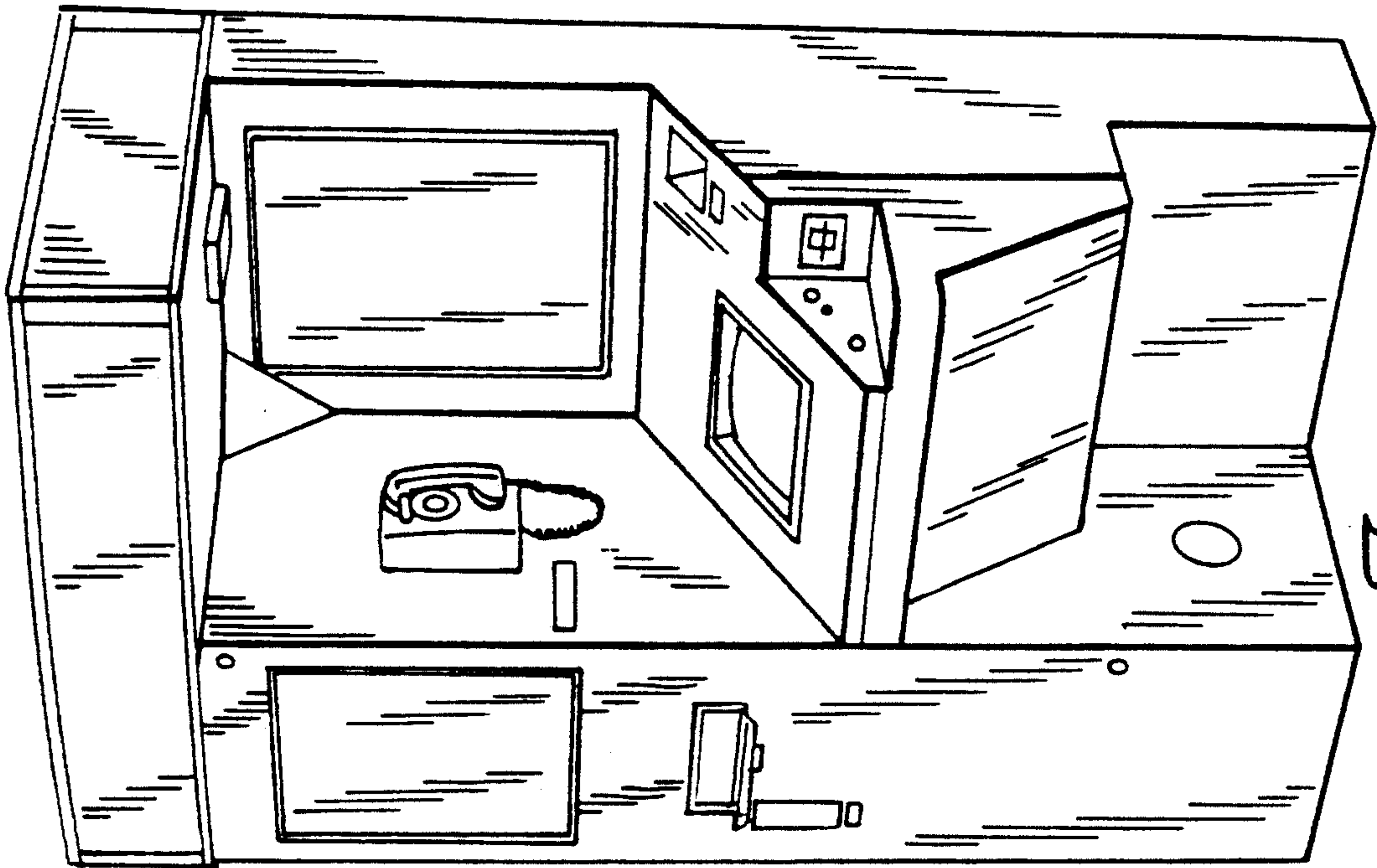

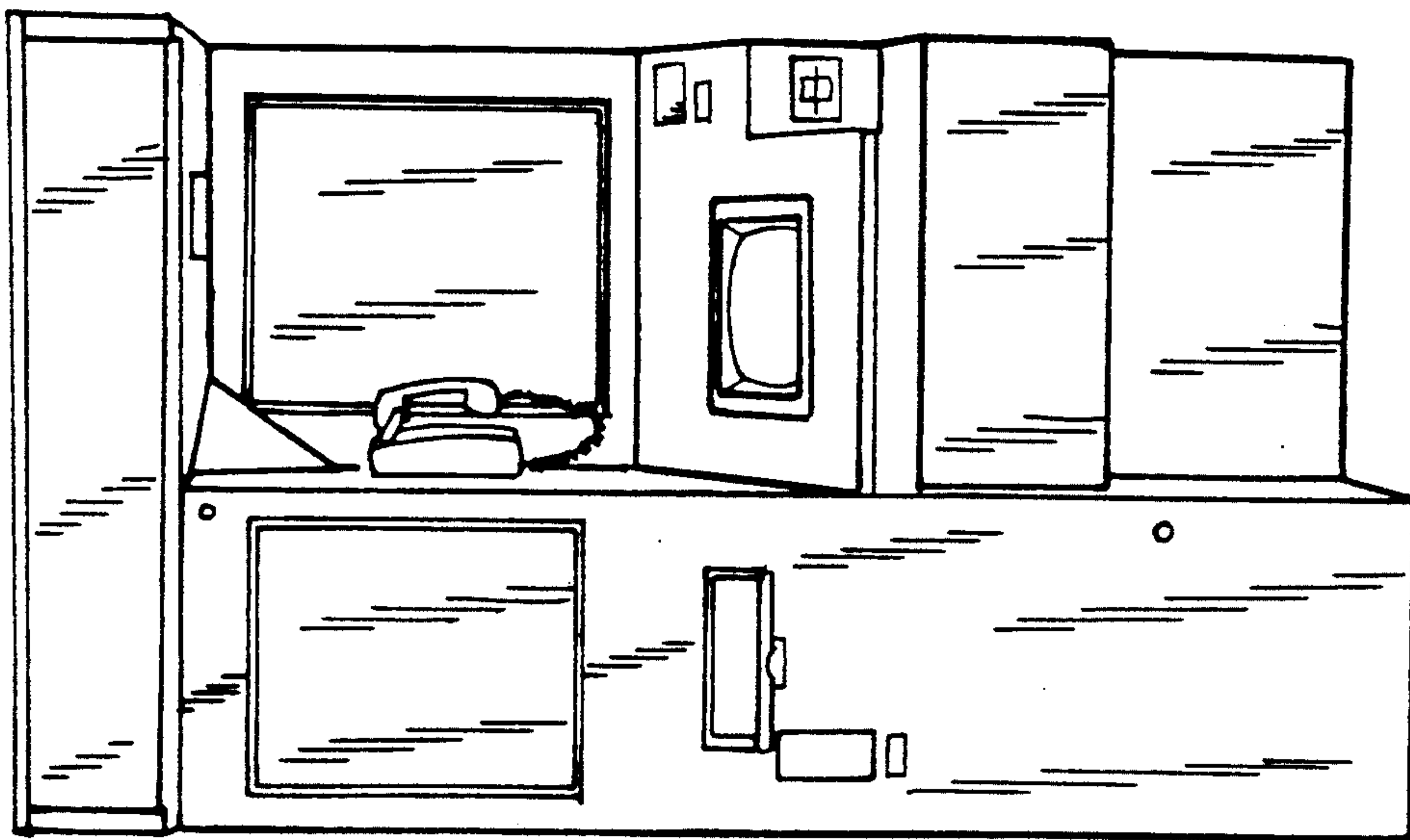

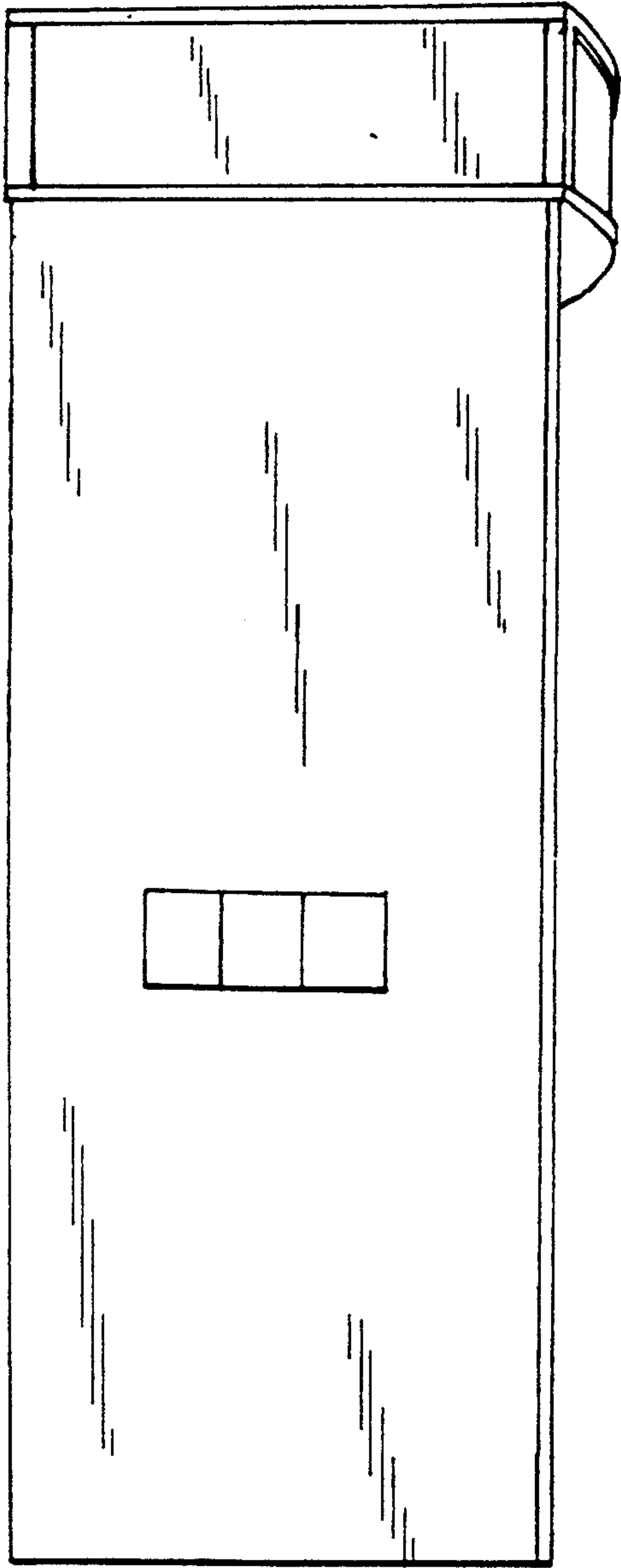

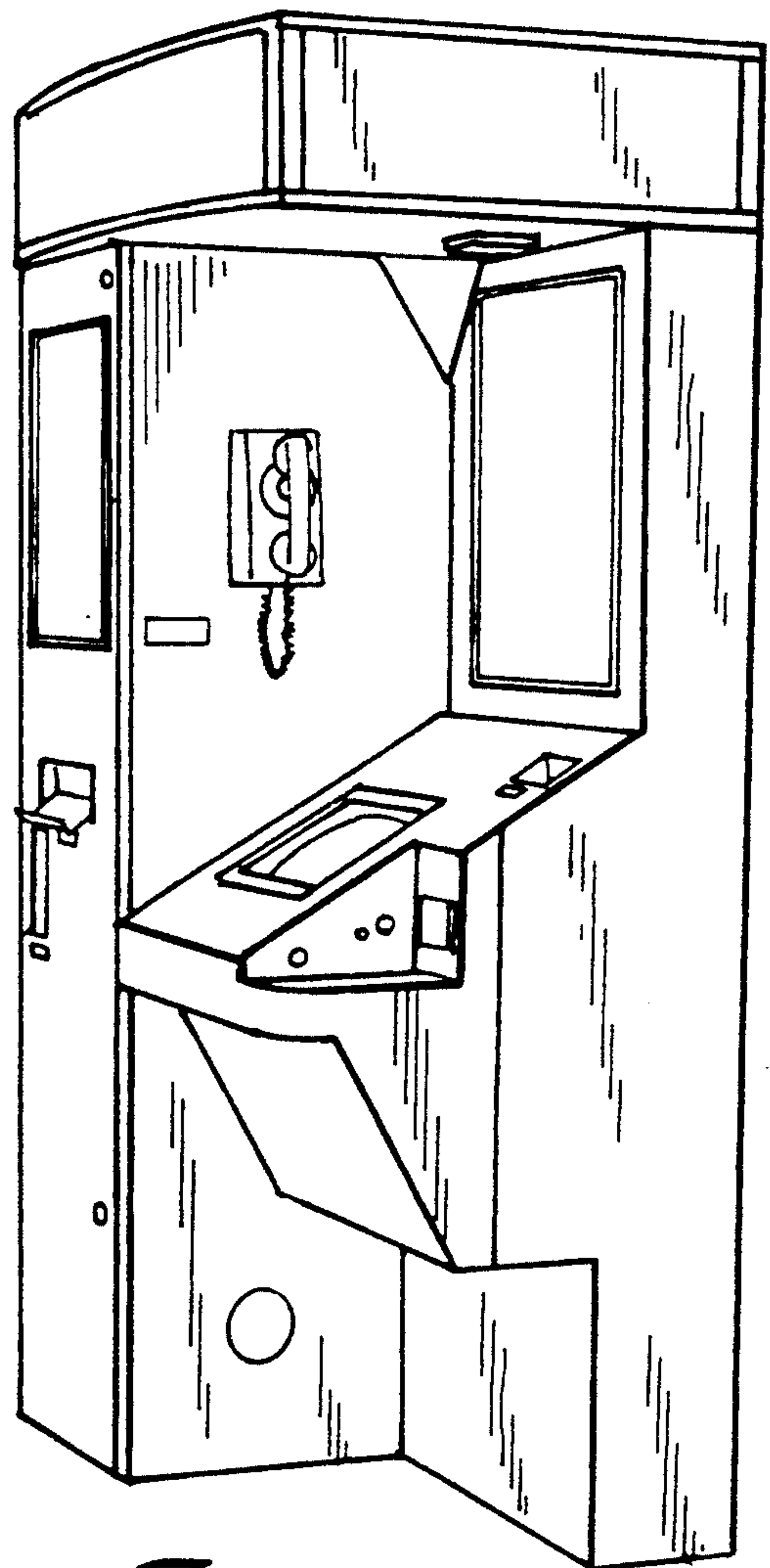

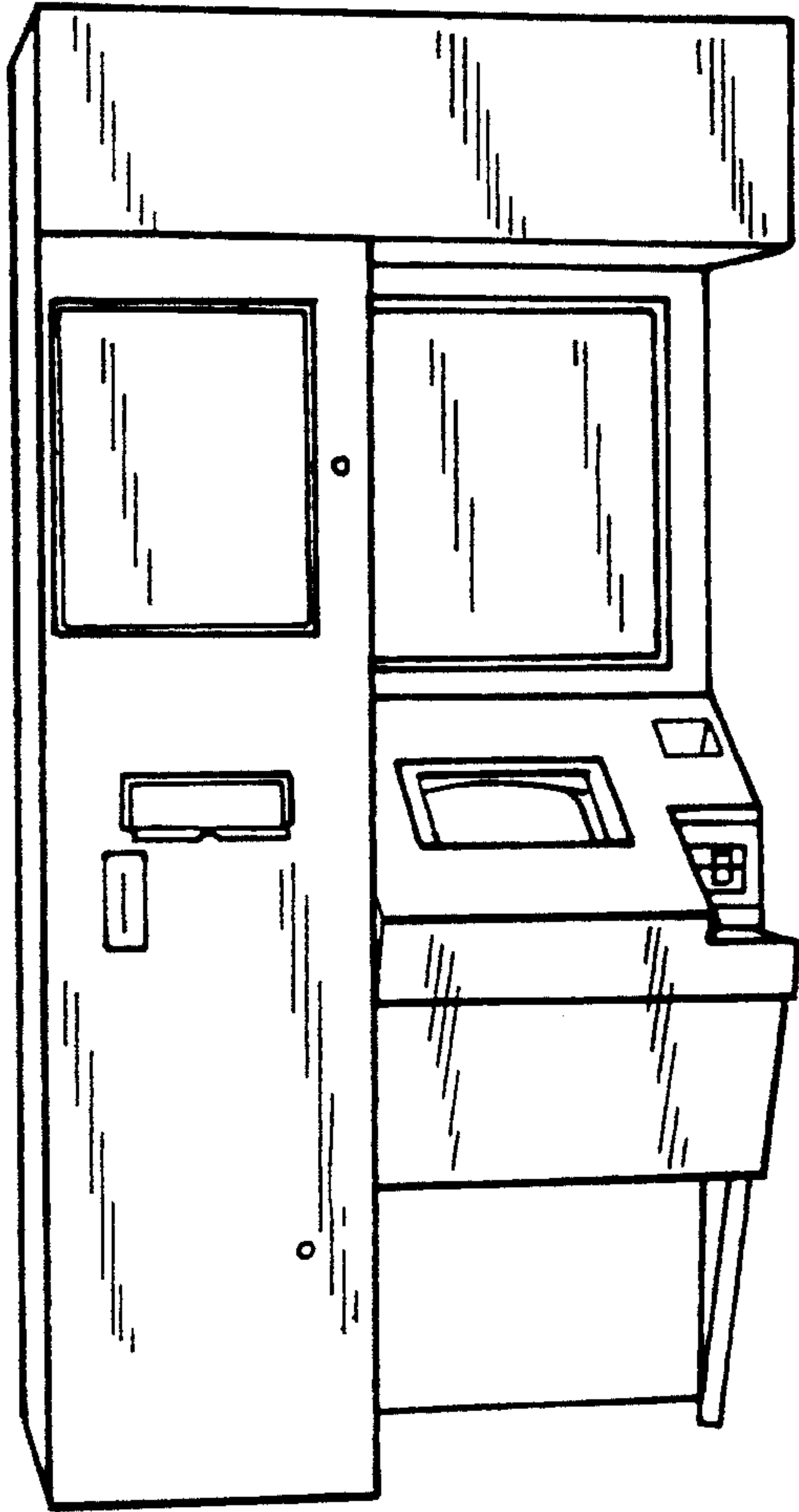

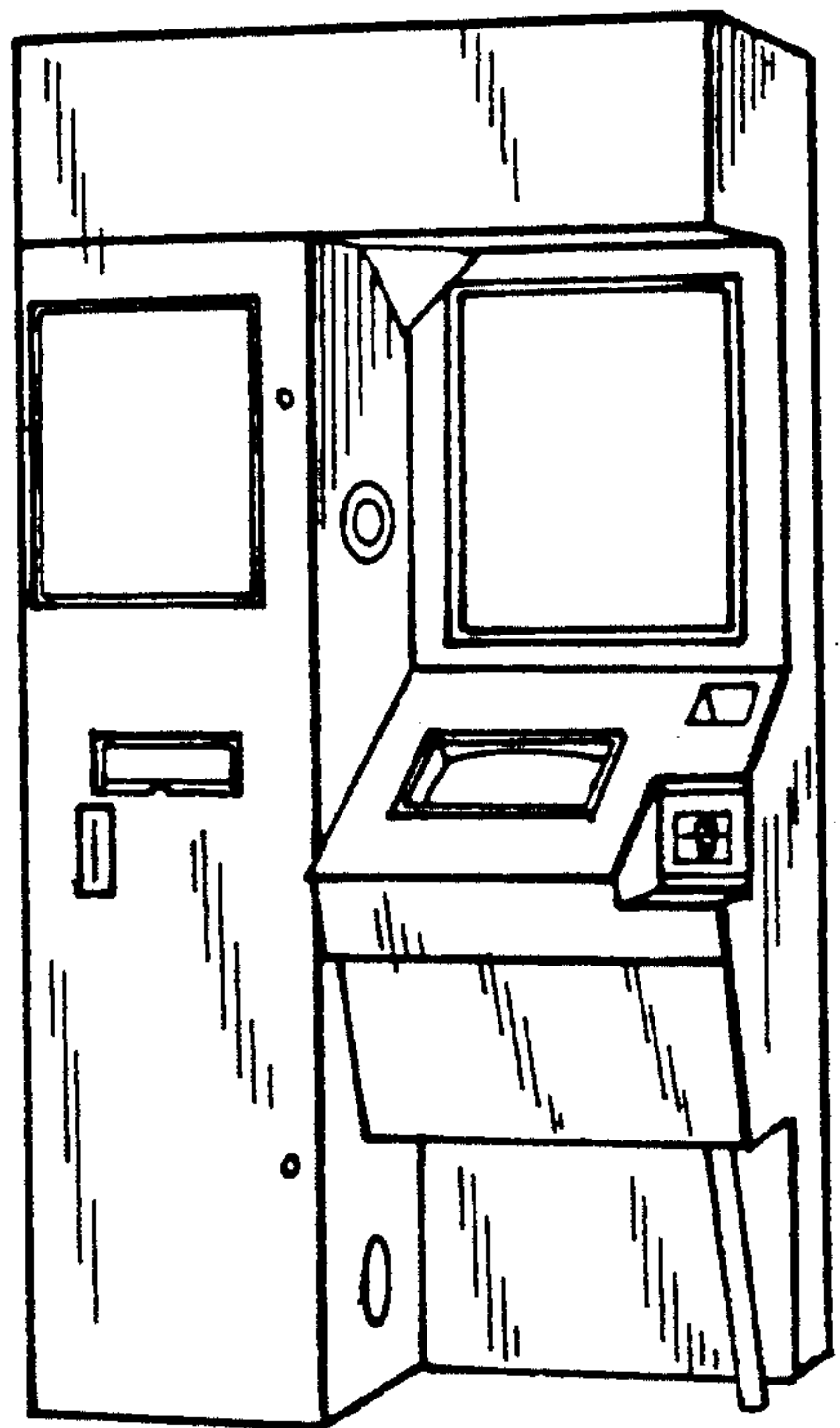
