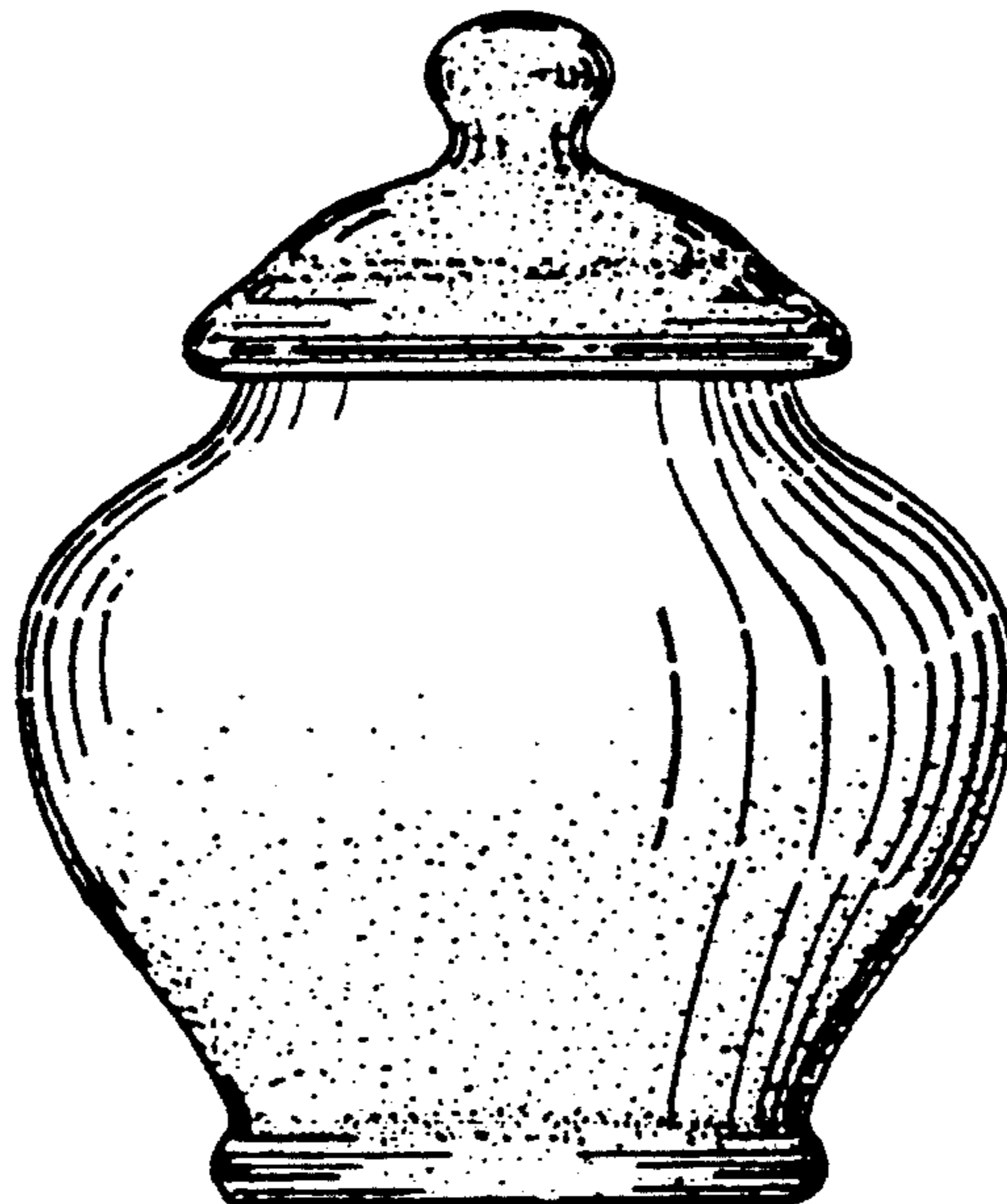

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a ceramic fragrance jar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a ceramic fragrance jar showing our new design, in which the stippling represents a shiny glazed finish;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of an unglazed alternative embodiment of the ceramic fragrance jar shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



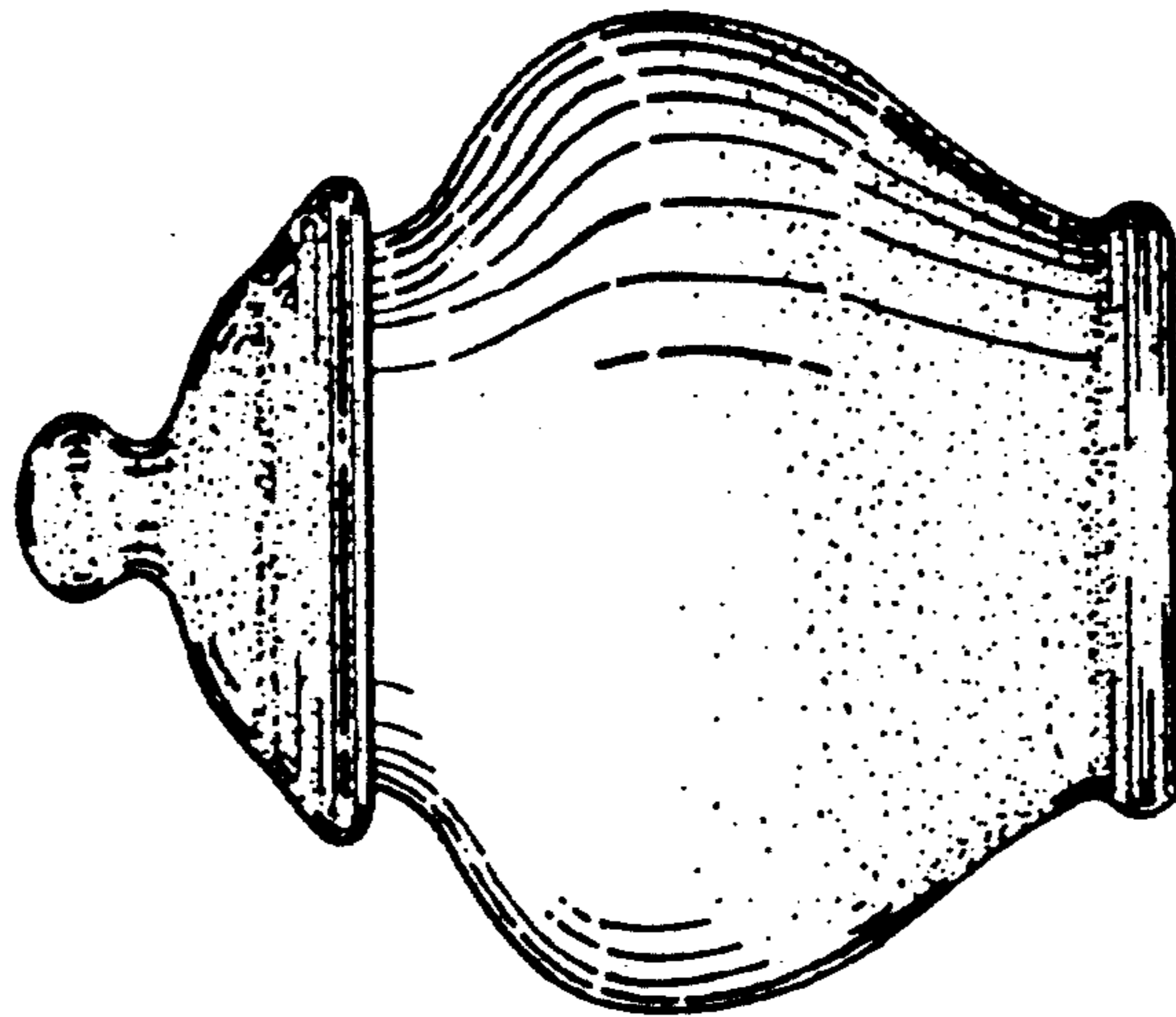

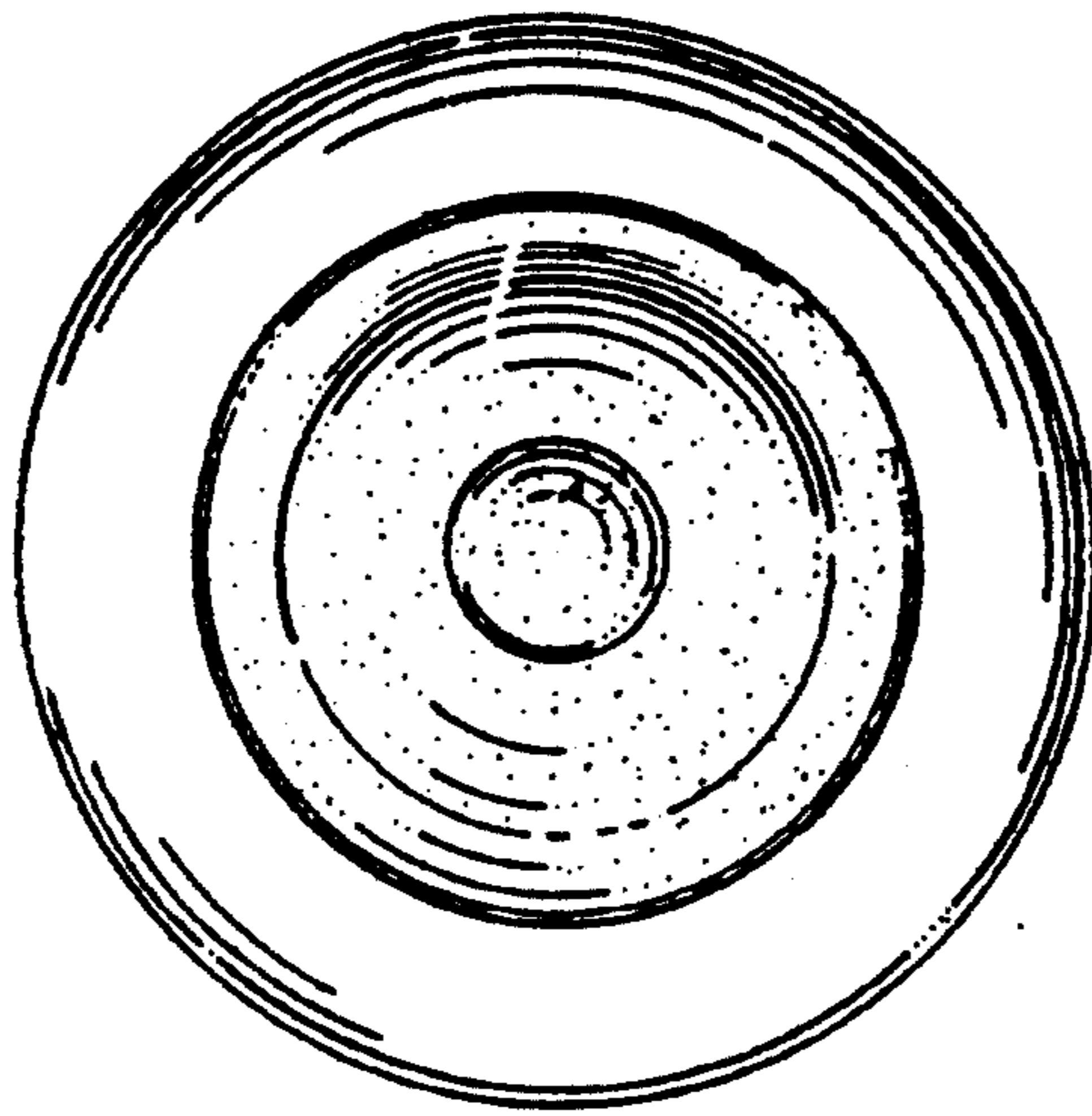

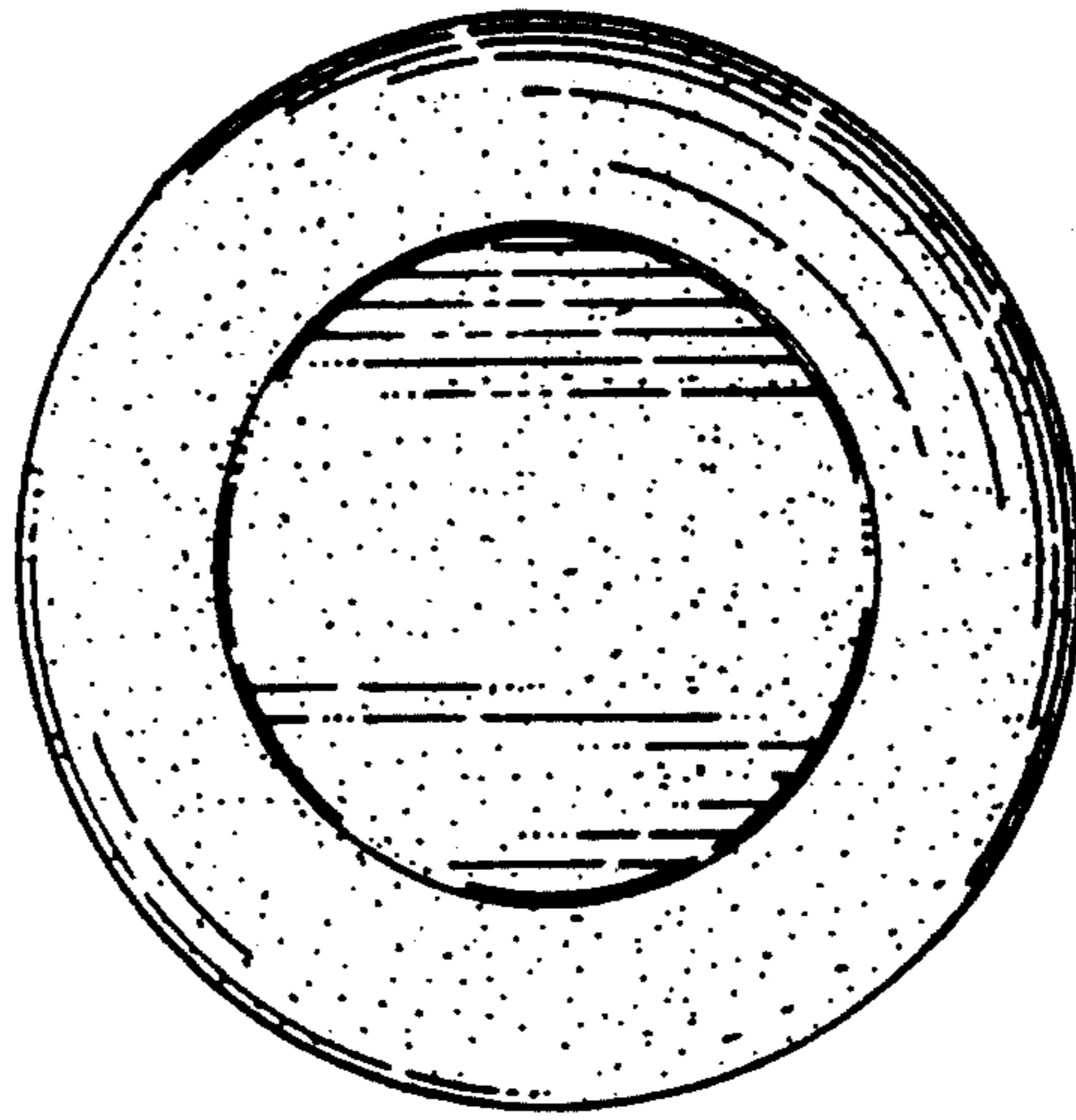

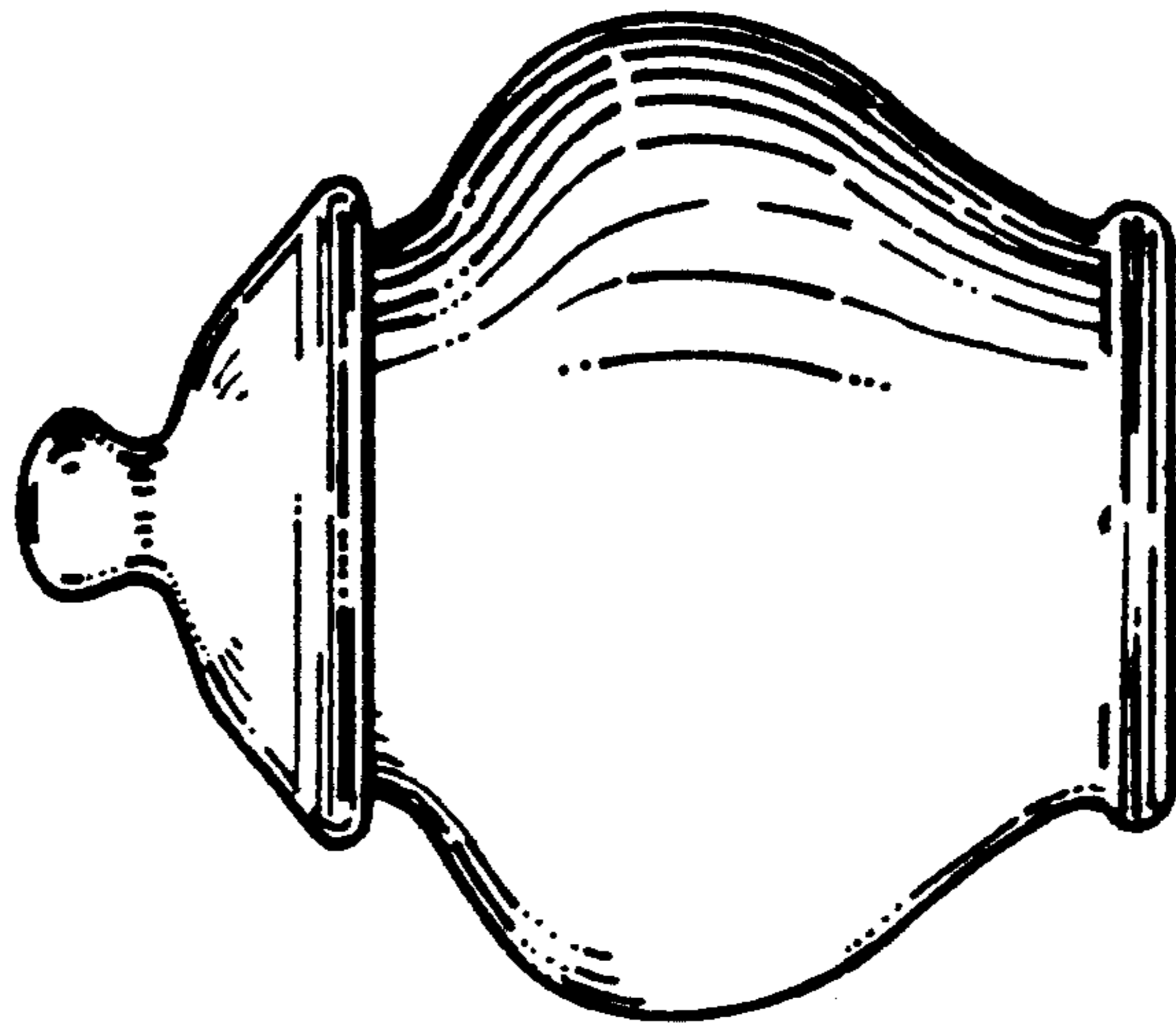

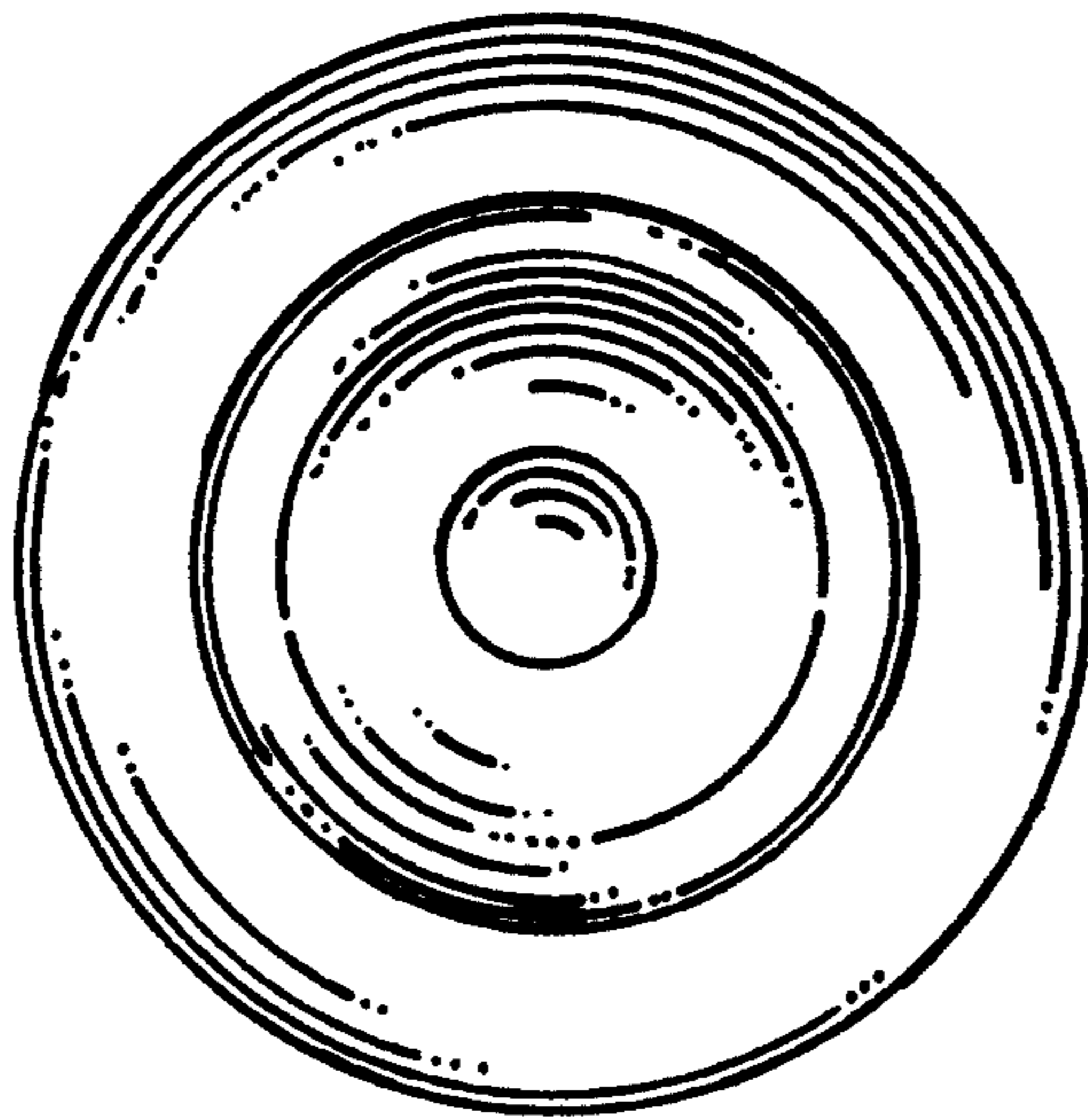

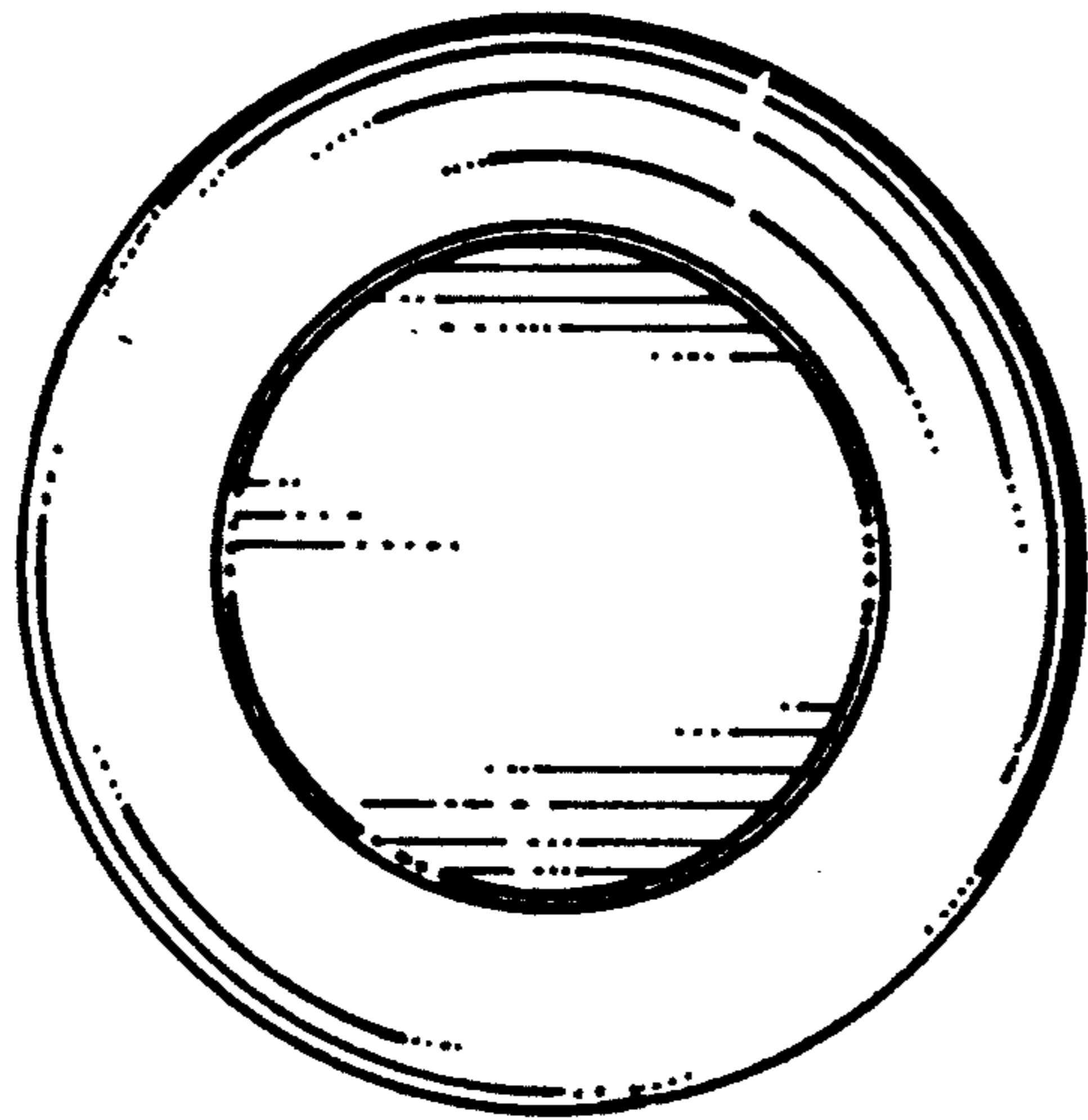
