DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tape player showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top, front and left-side perspective view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a top, front and left-side perspective view thereof, shown in the open position.

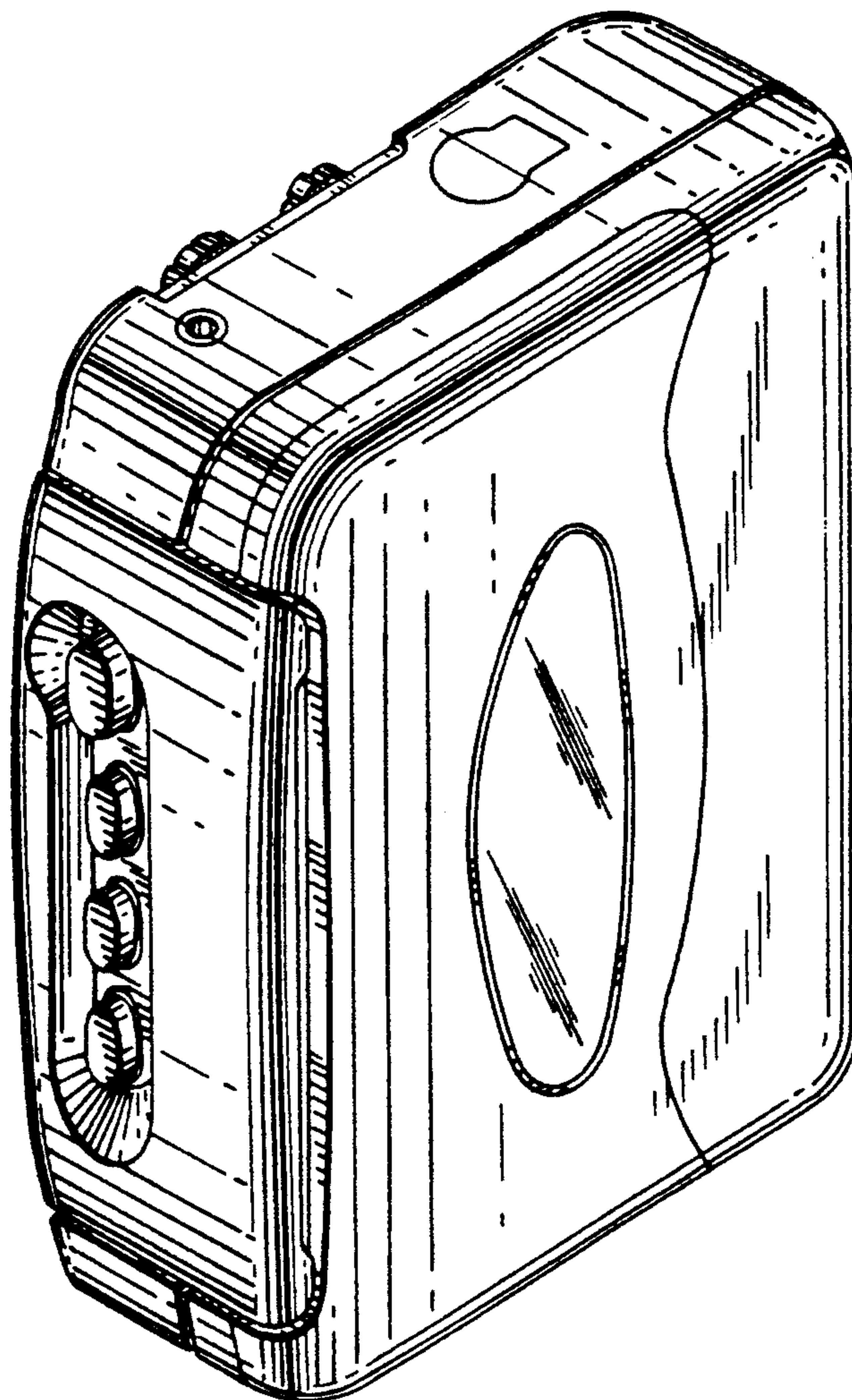

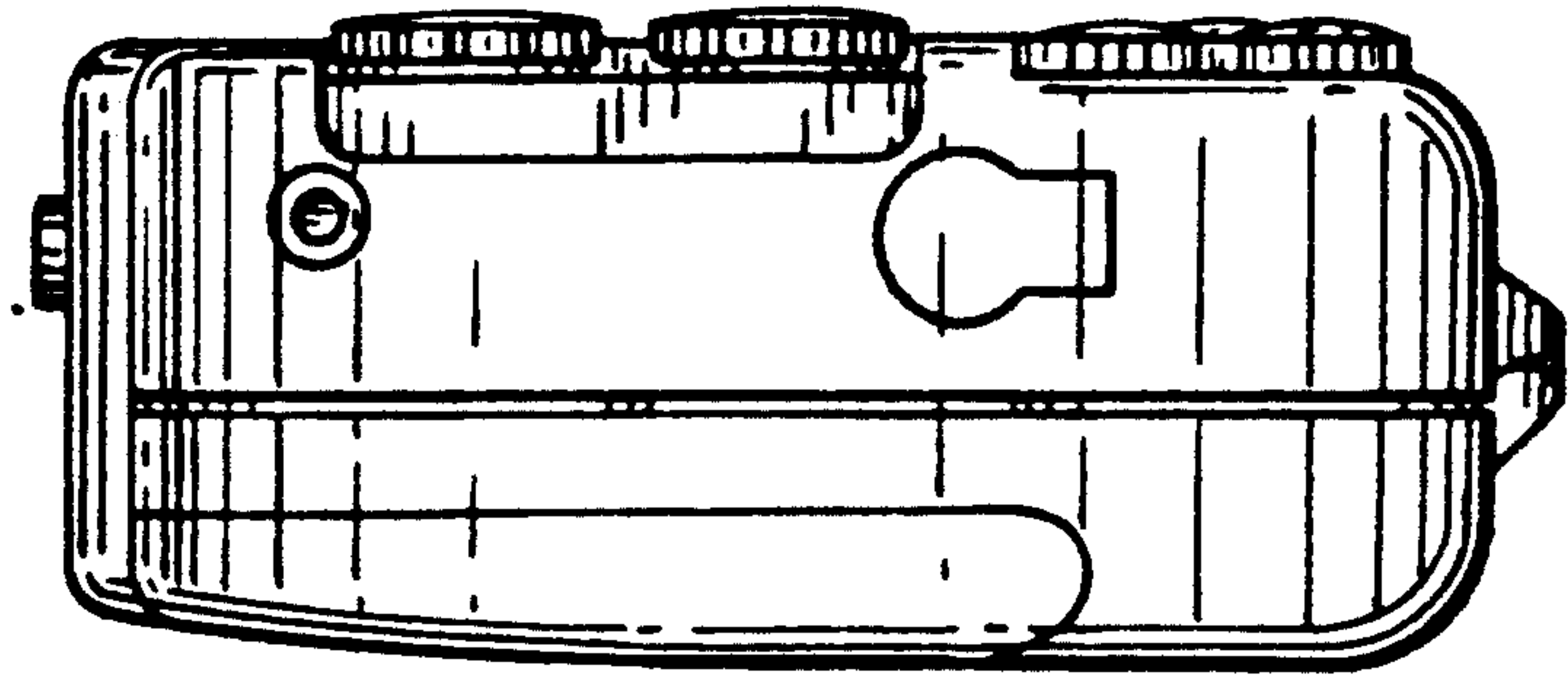

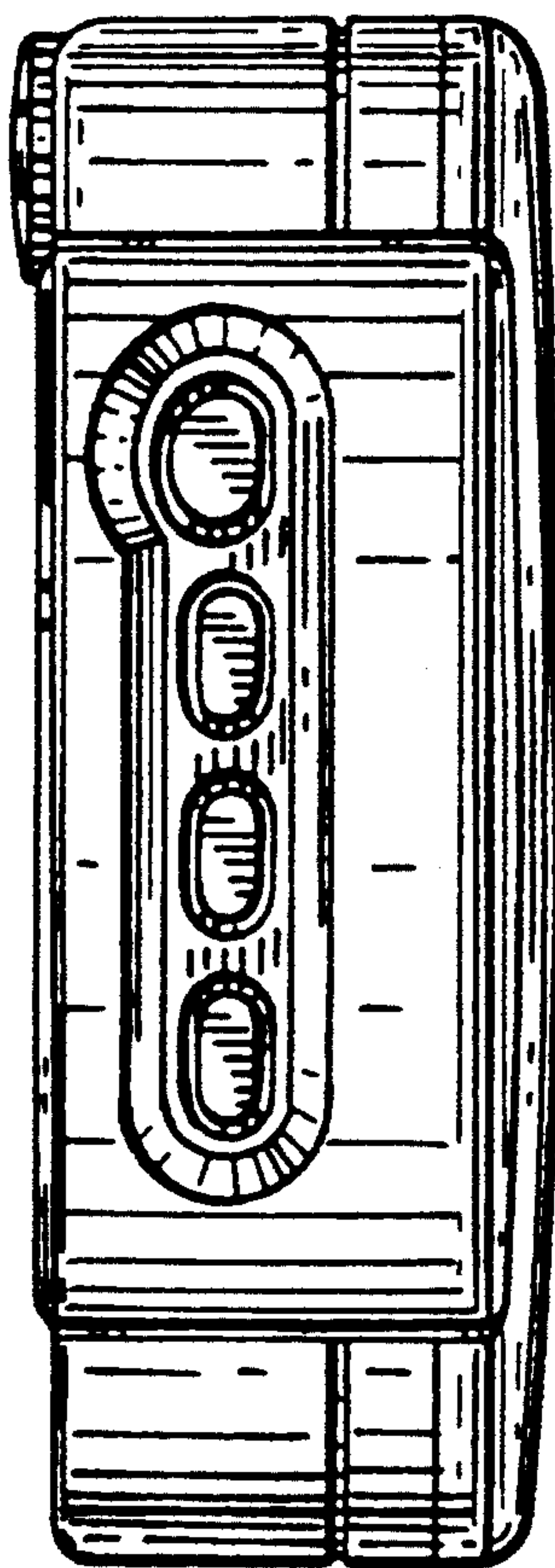

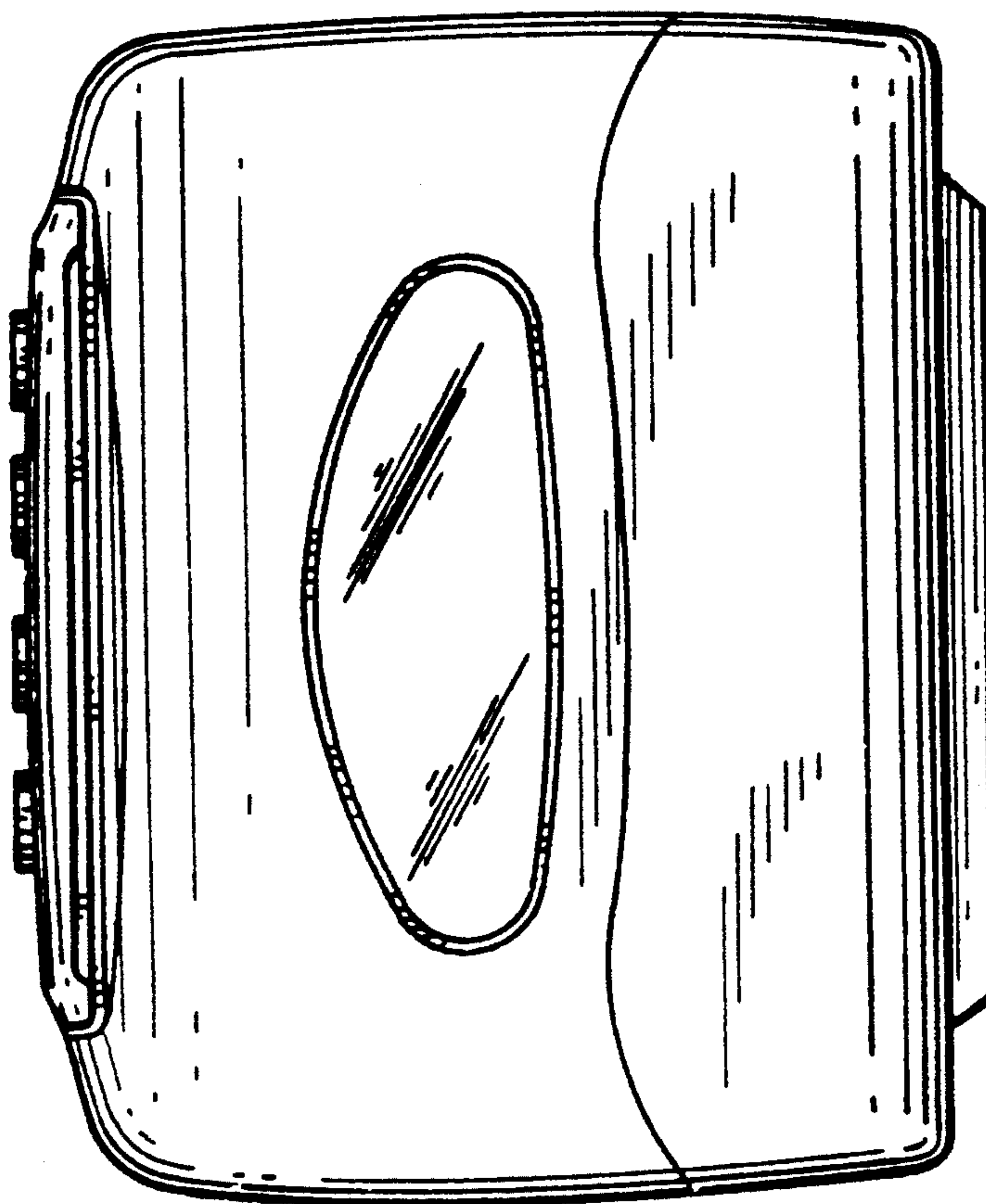

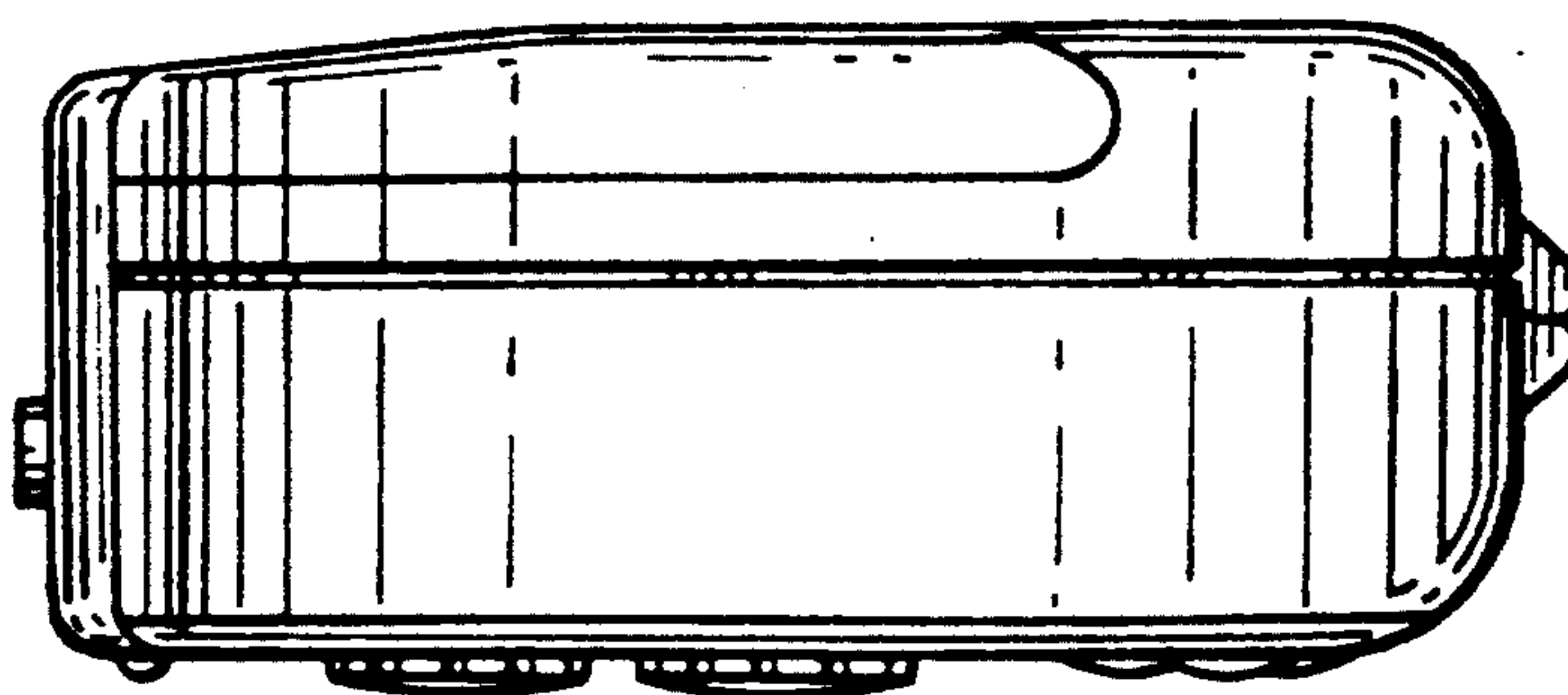

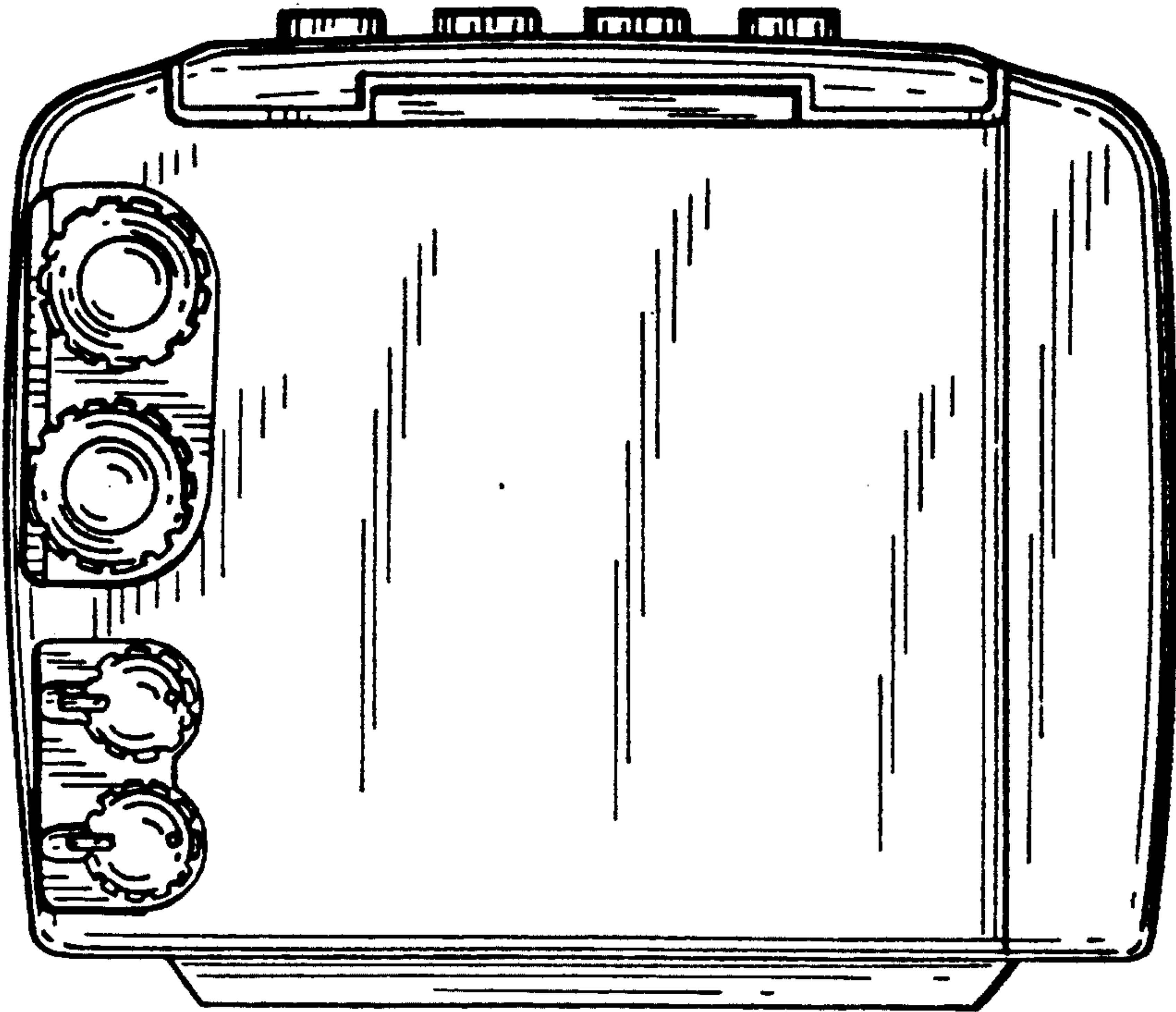

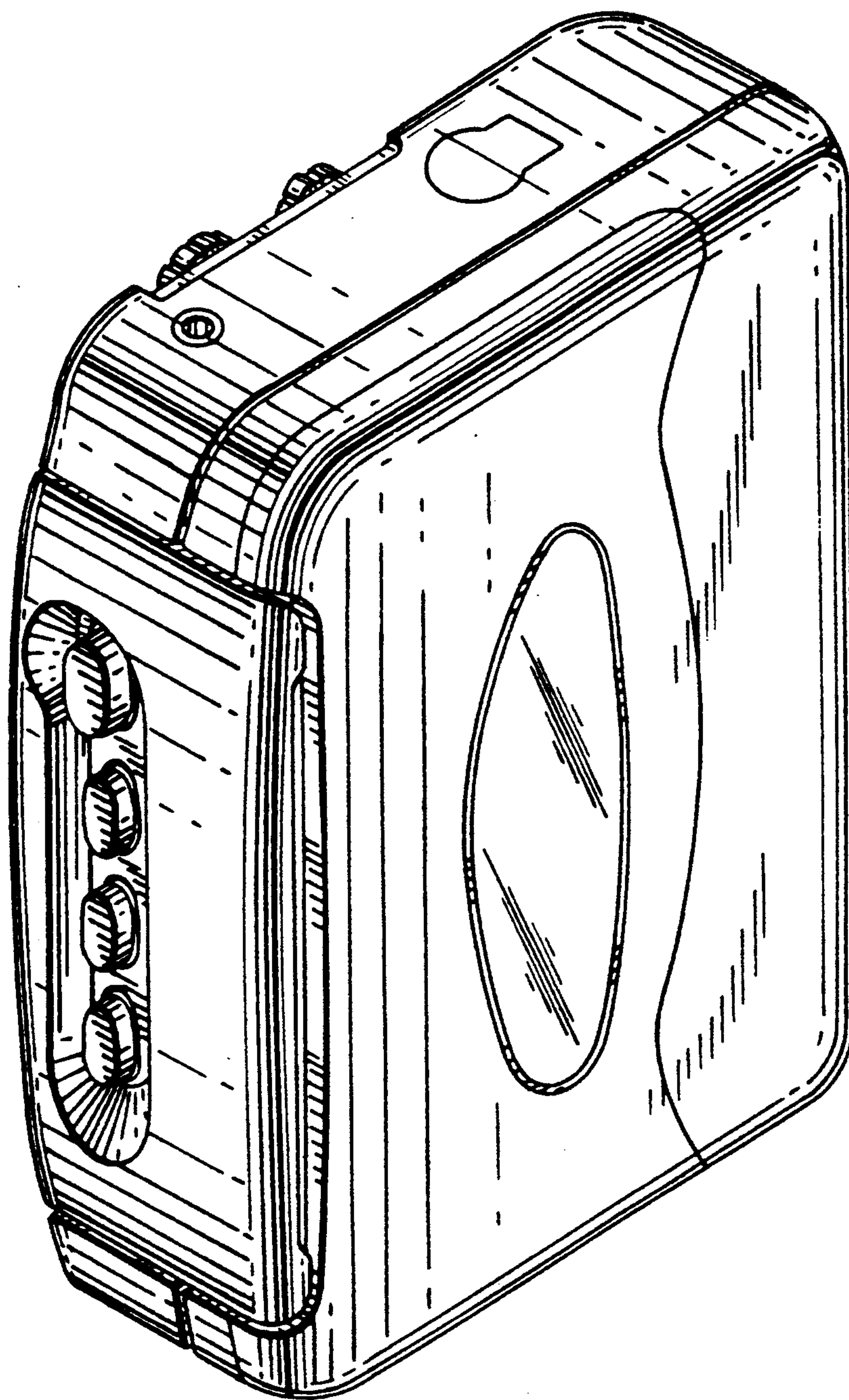
