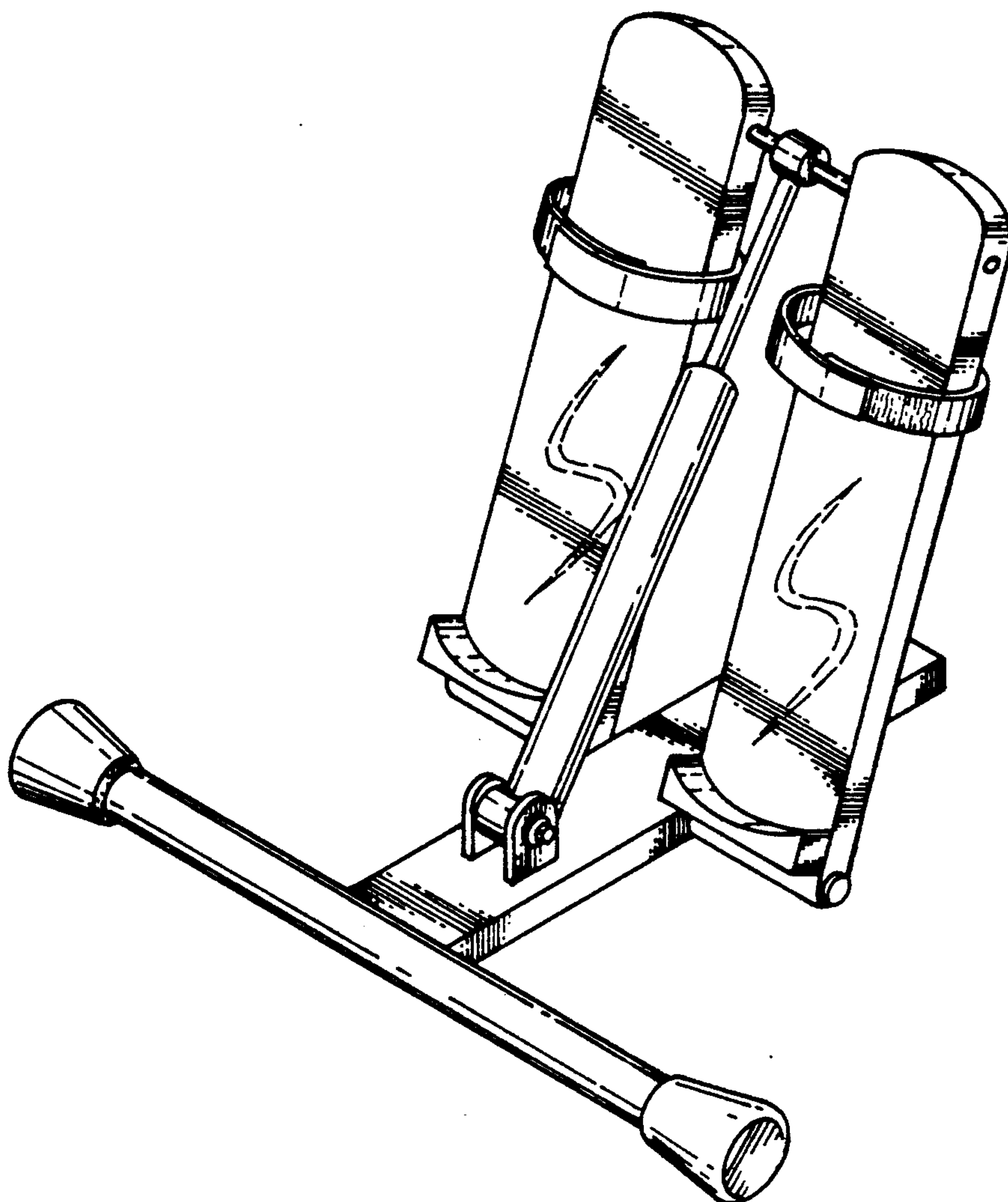
The ornamental design for a leg exerciser, as shown and described.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



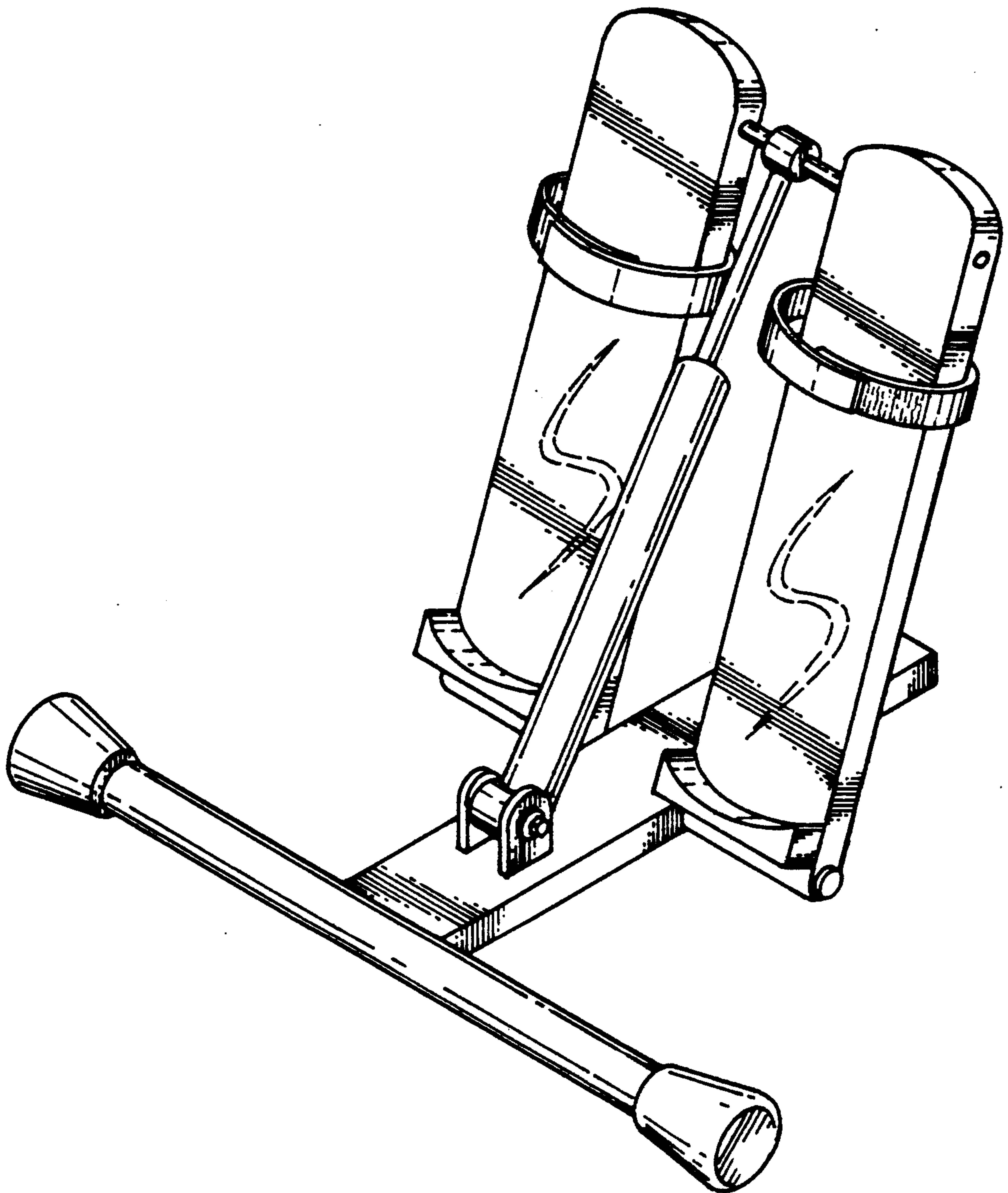

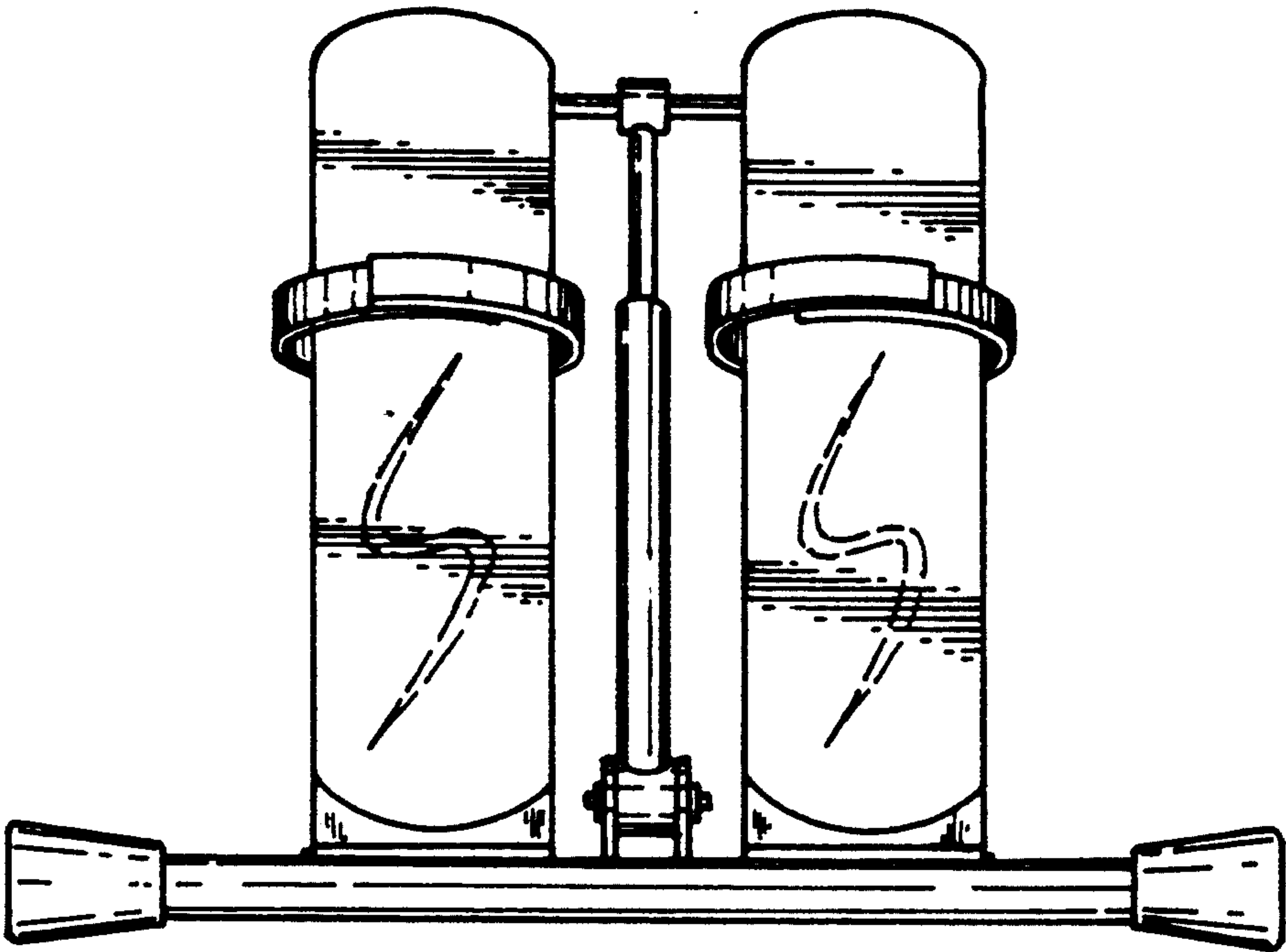

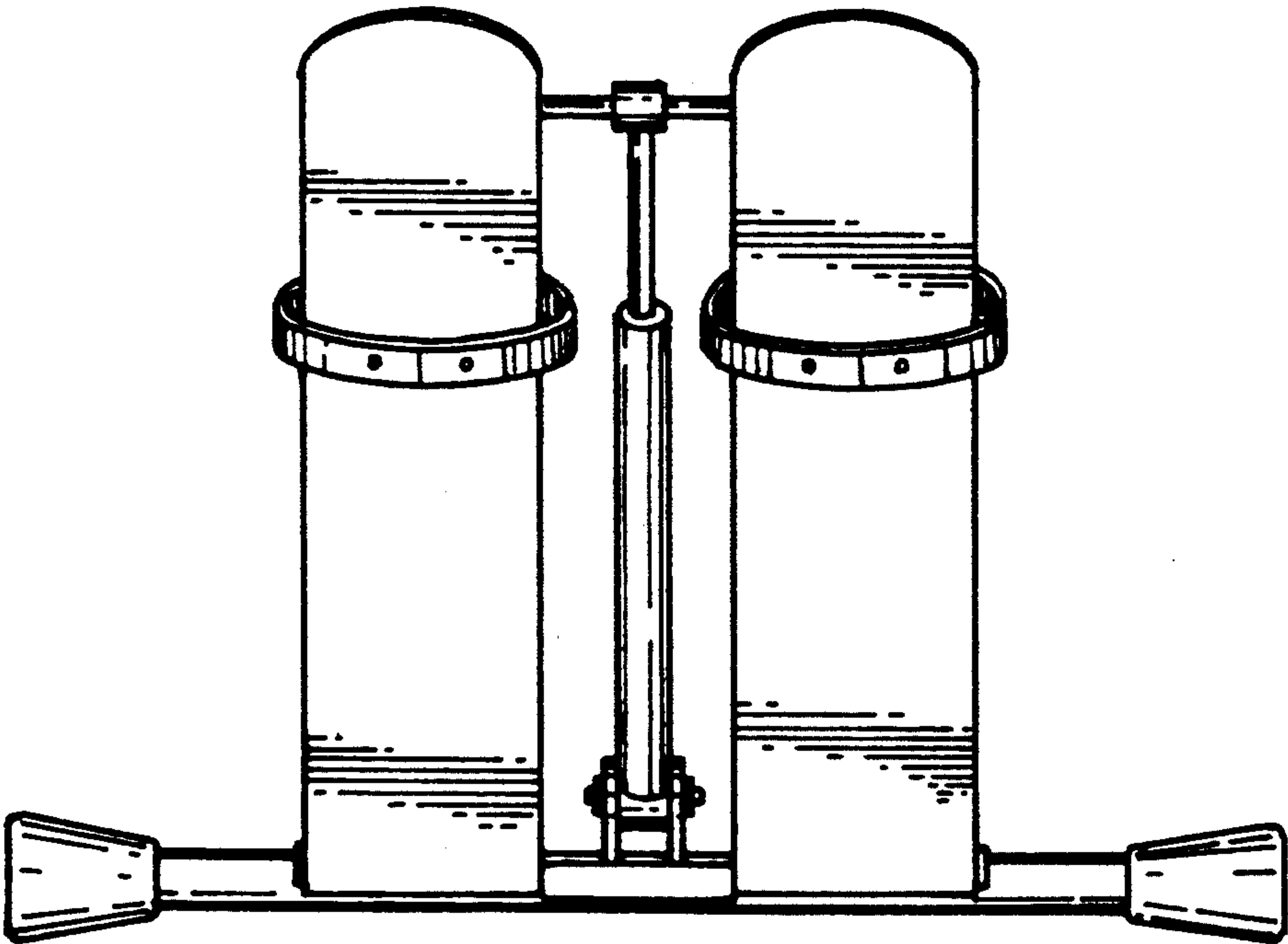

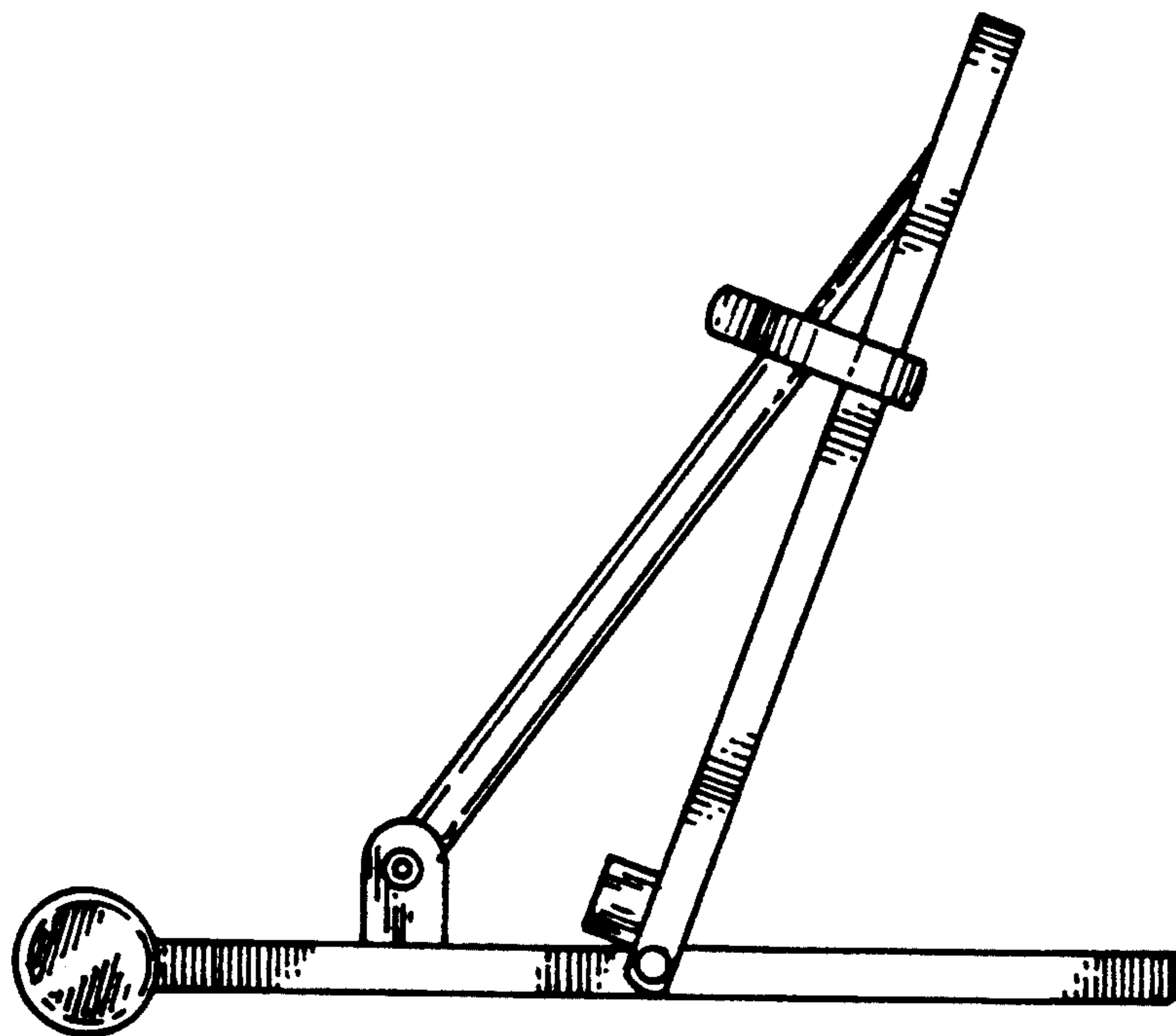

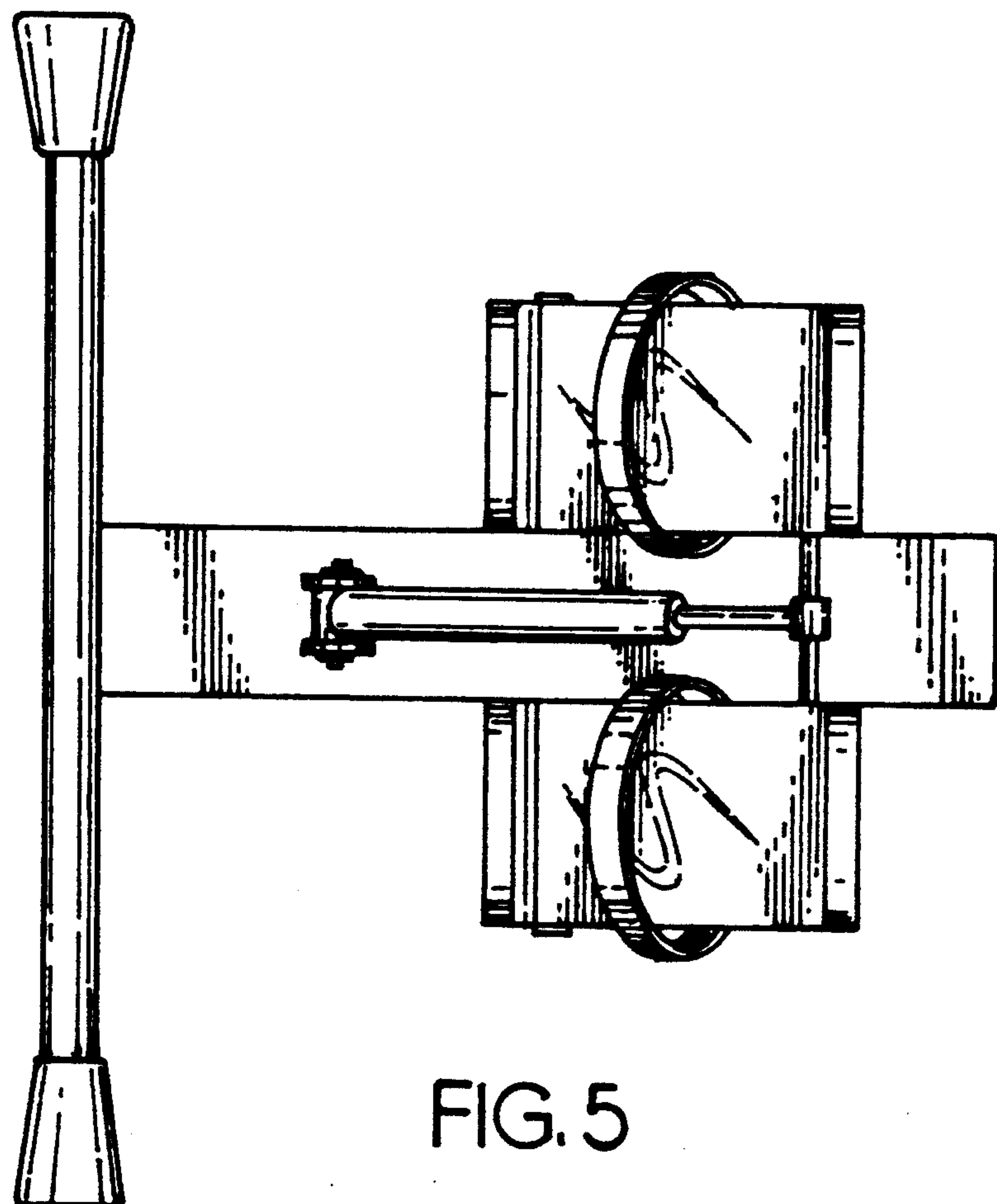

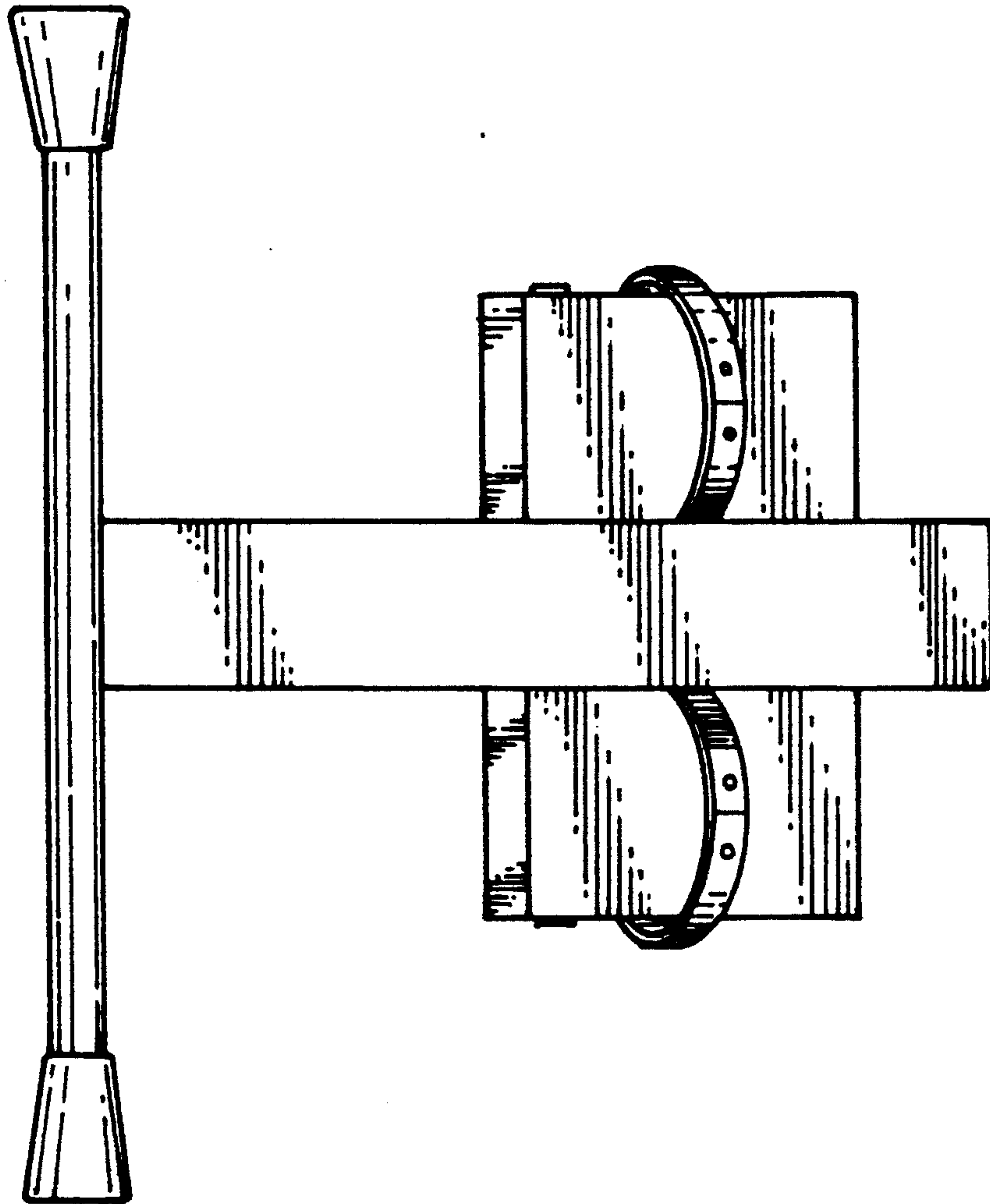
