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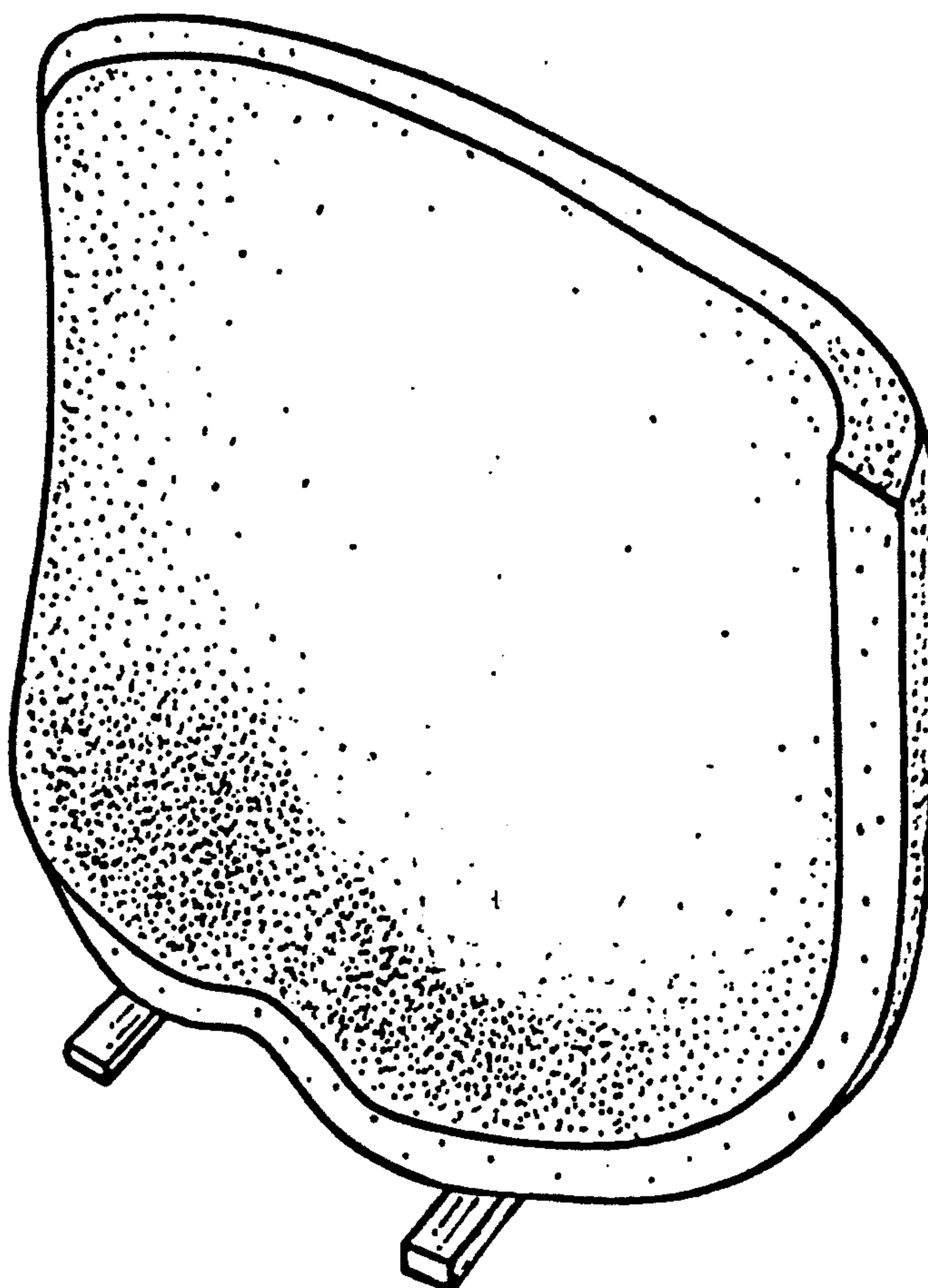

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a rump protection device showing my new design;

The stippled surface shading is understood to repeat throughout the indicated area.



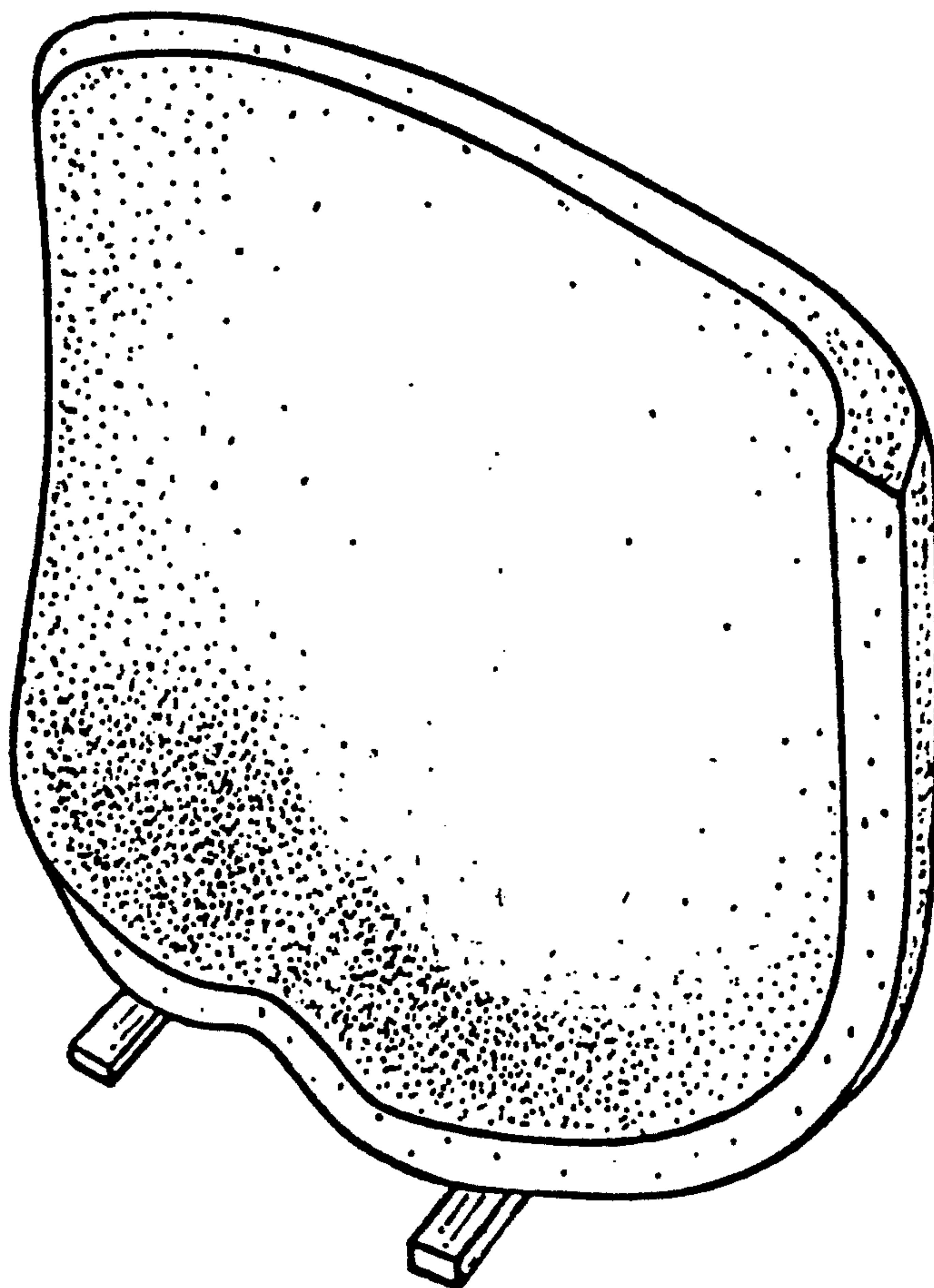

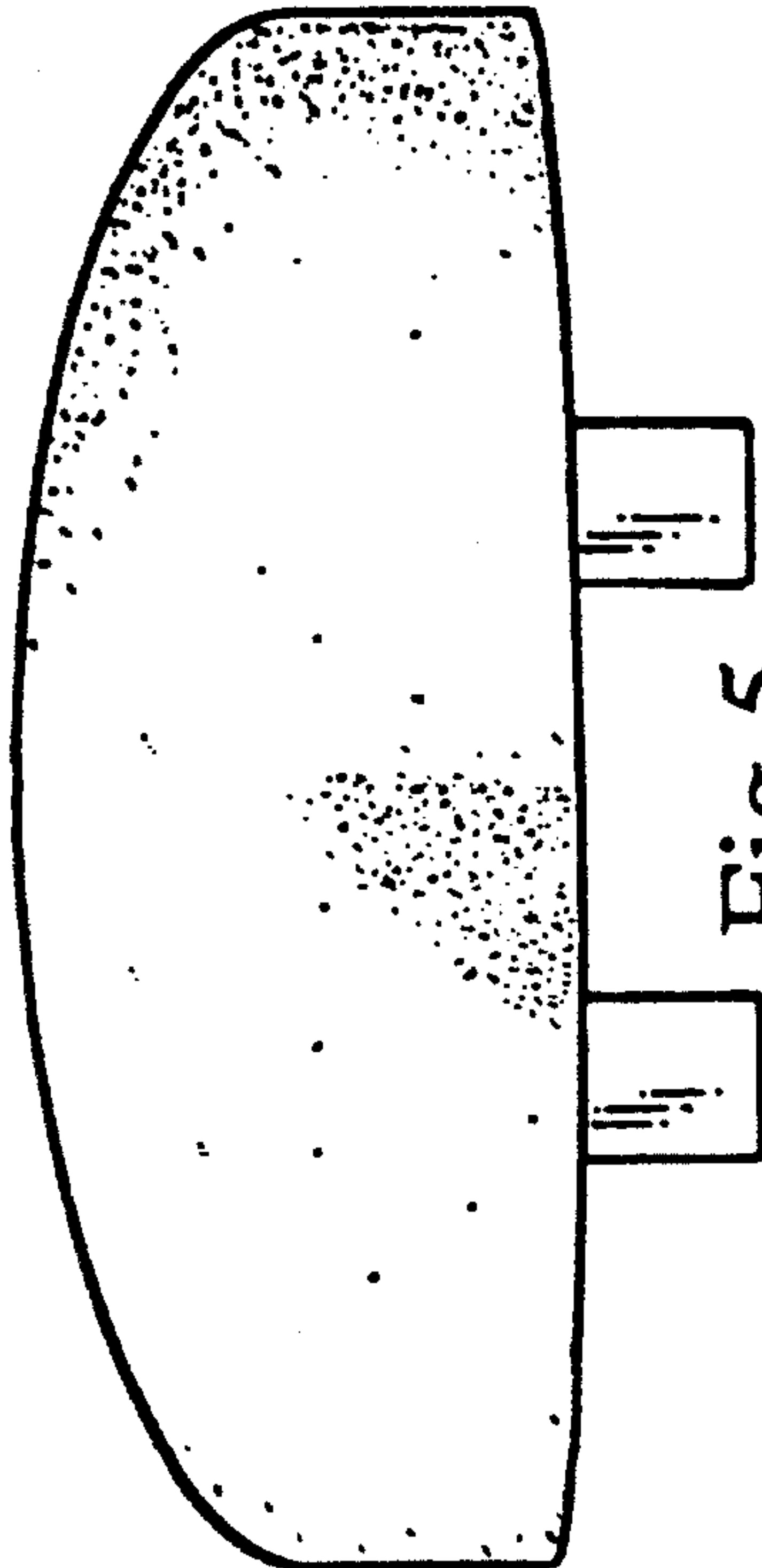

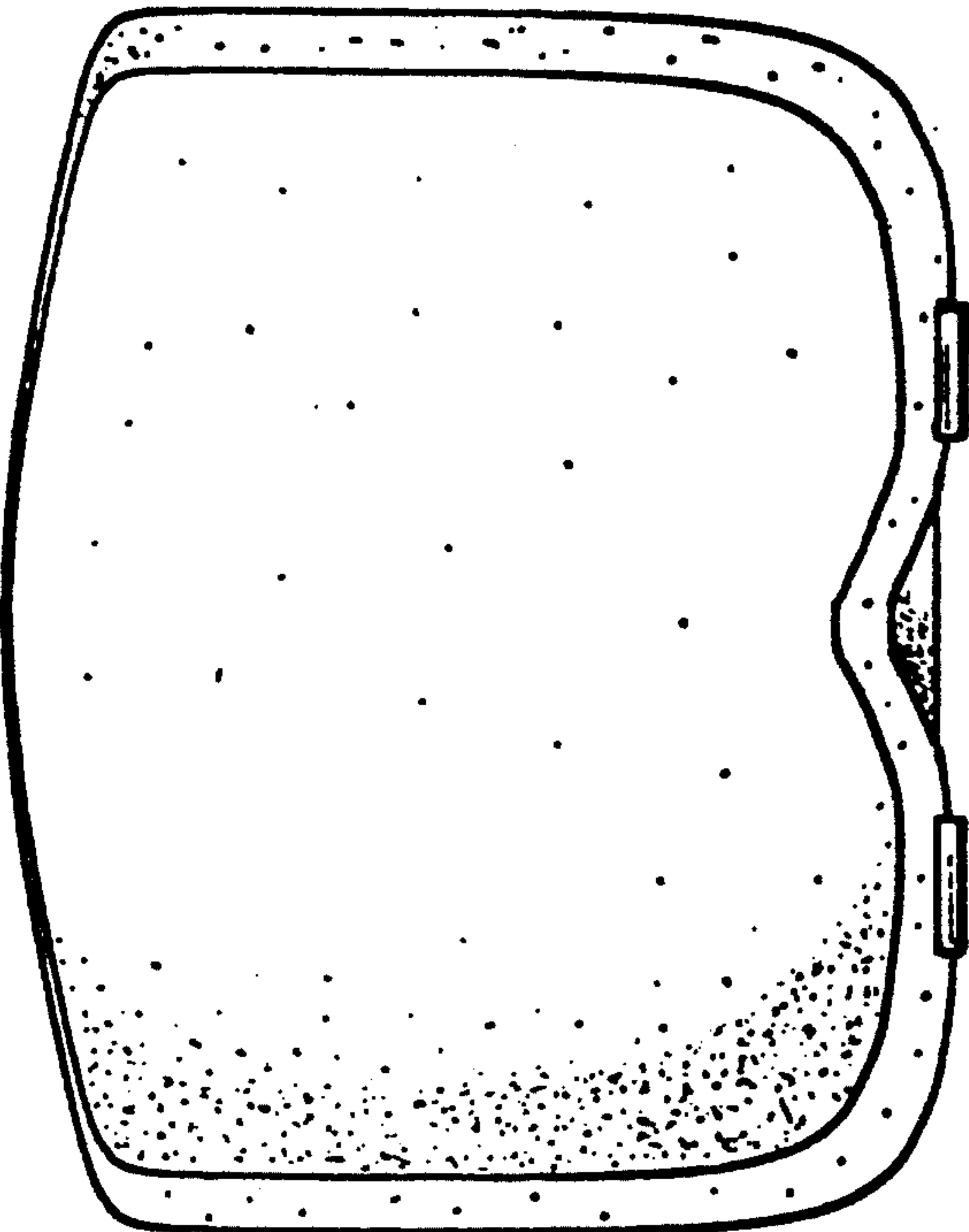

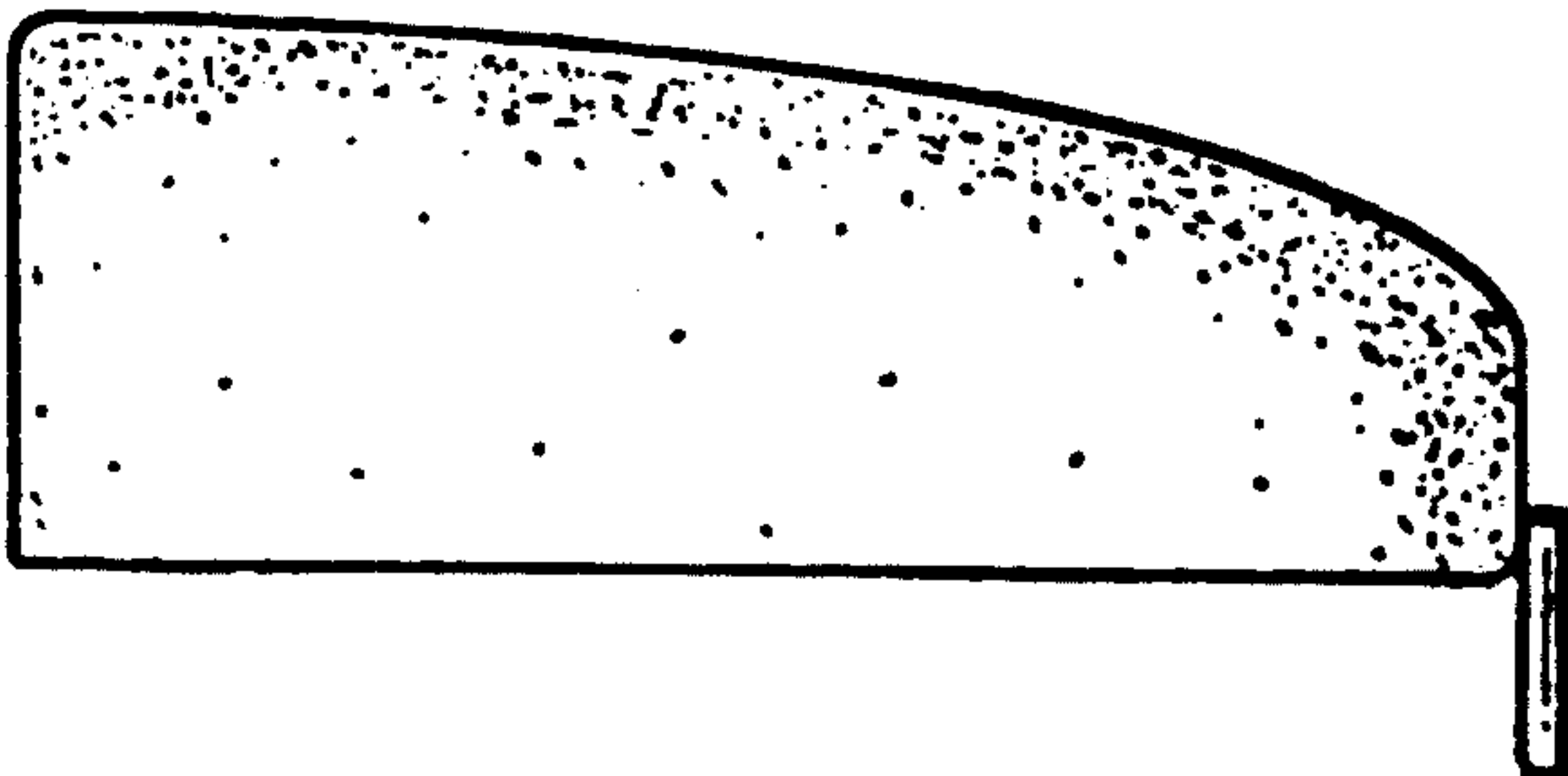
