DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an physical exerciser showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, showing the exerciser in an alternate position;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view from the left side thereof, the elevational view from the right side being identical; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

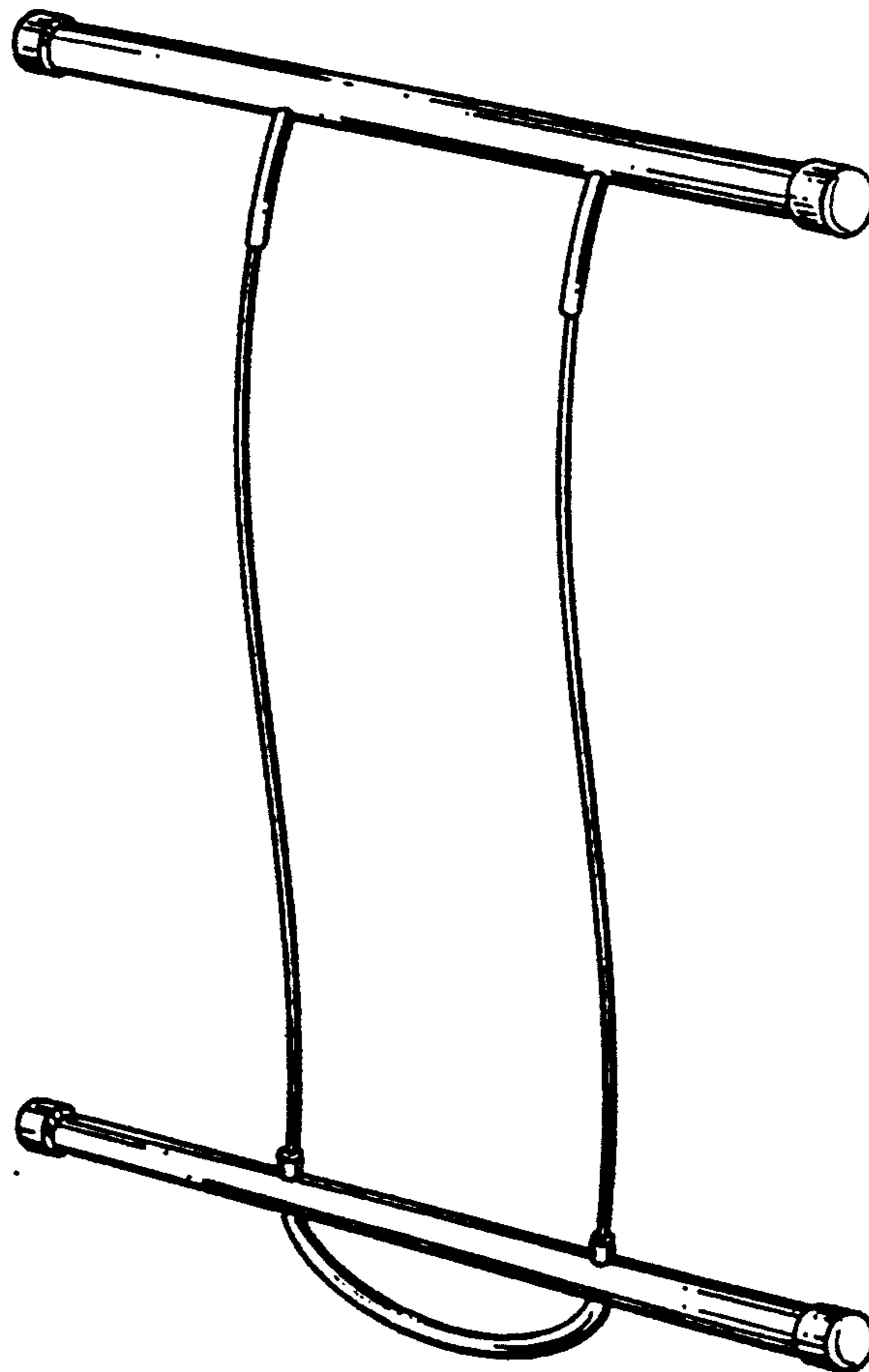

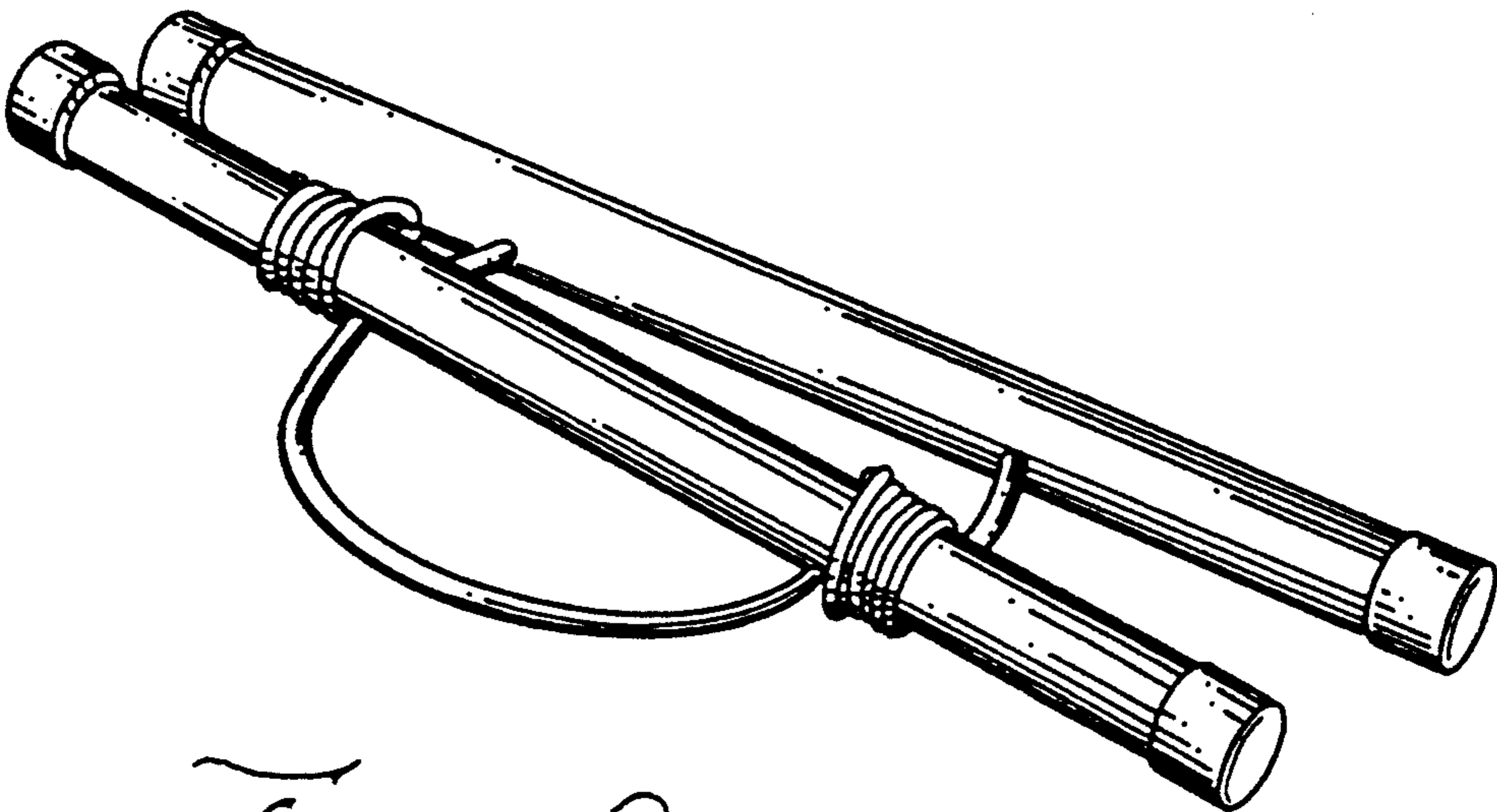
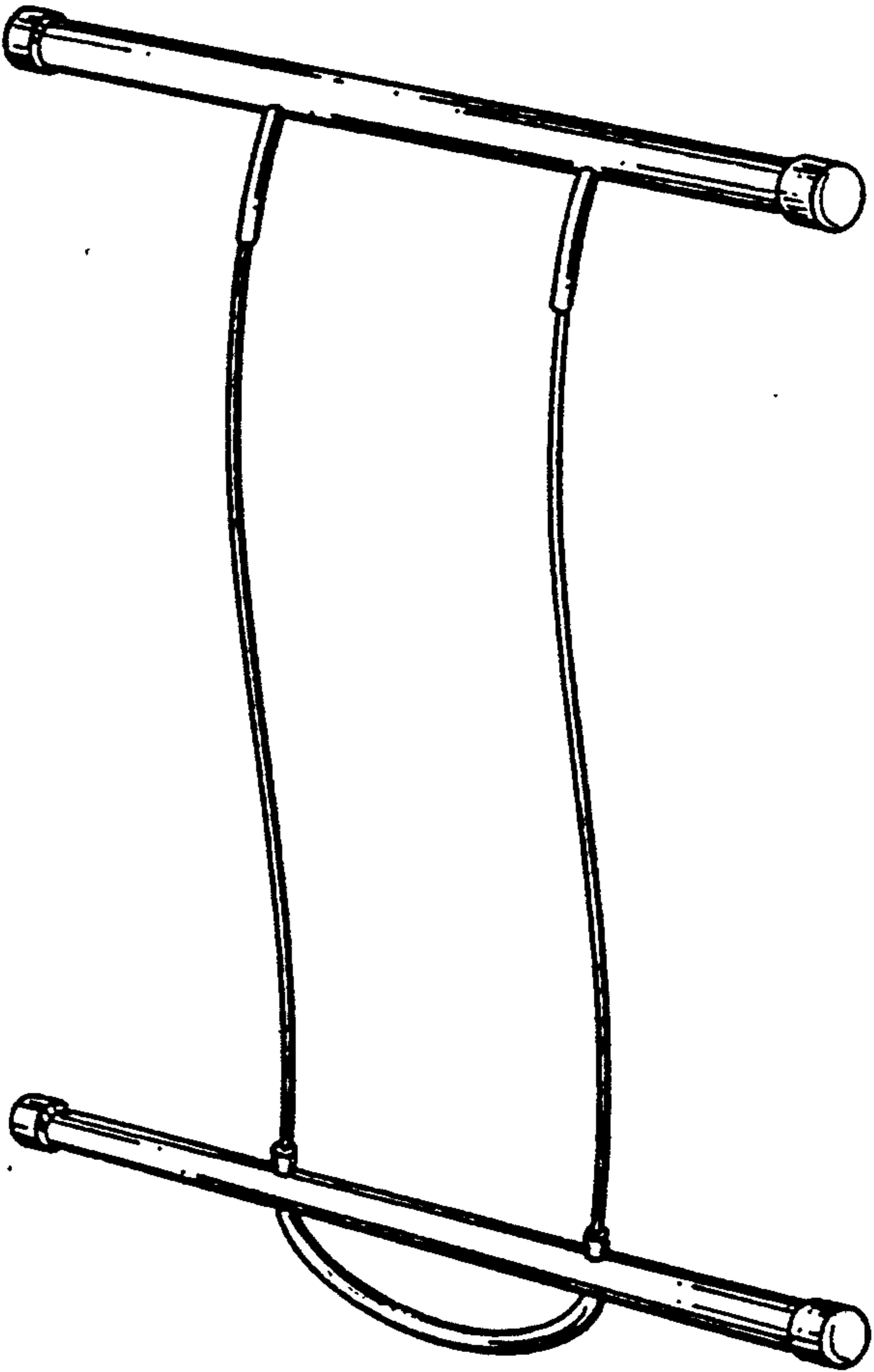
