DESCRIPTION

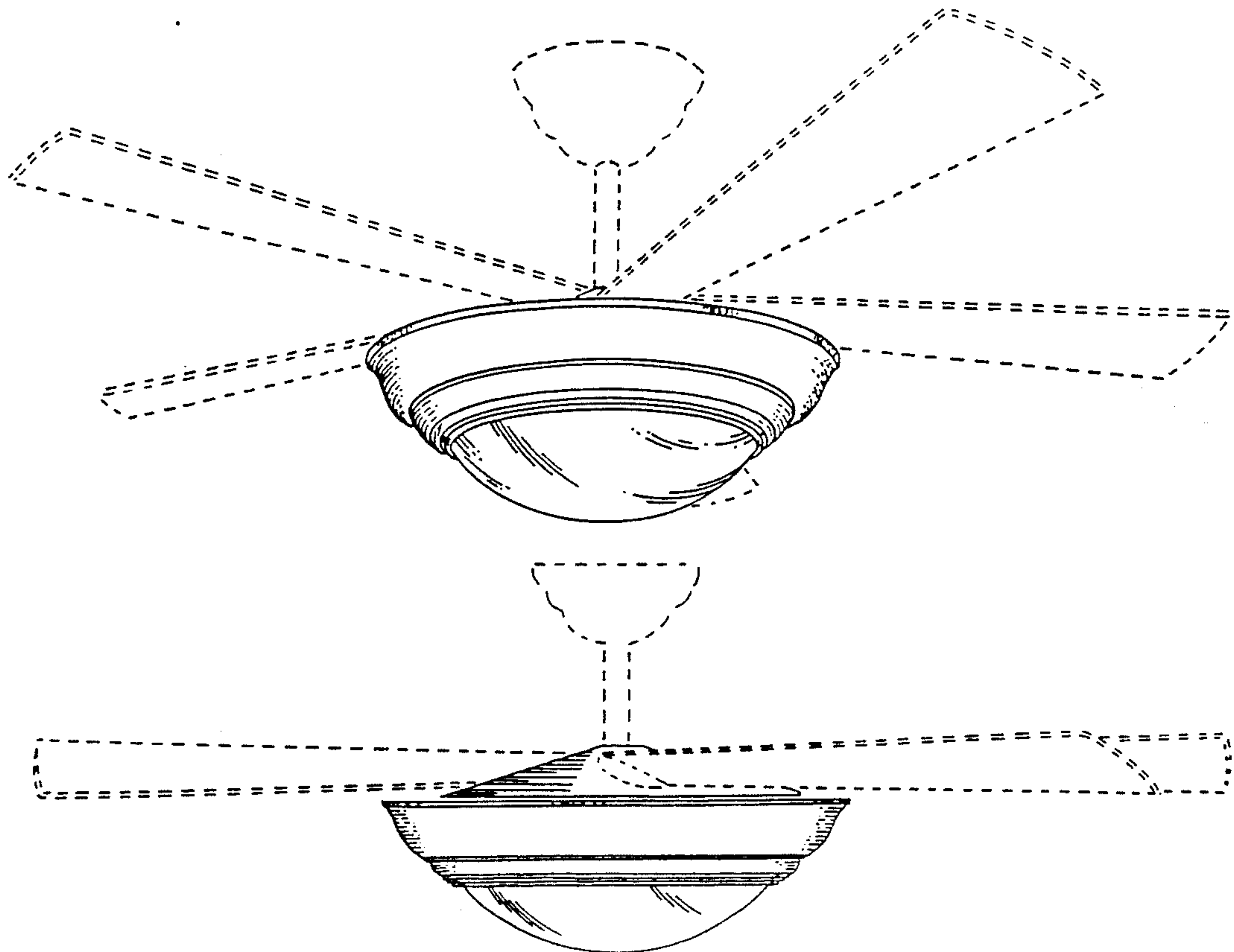
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined motor hous-

design;

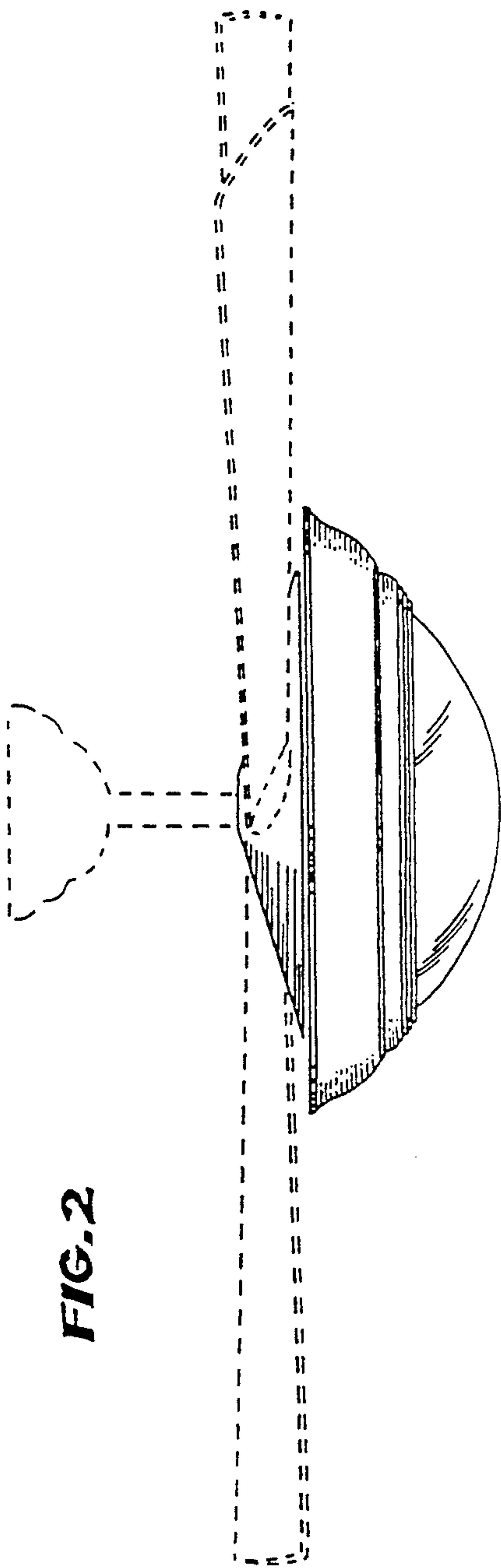
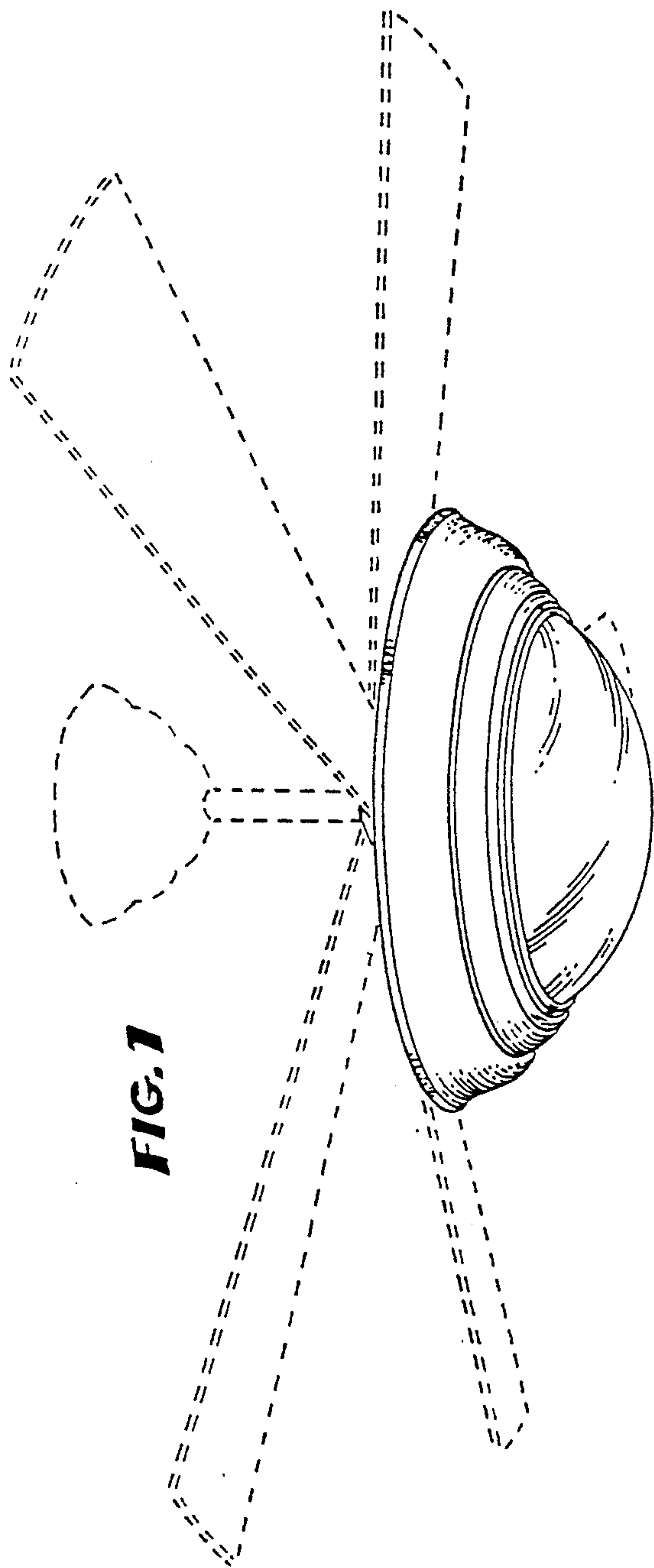
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other three
sides being identical to that shown;

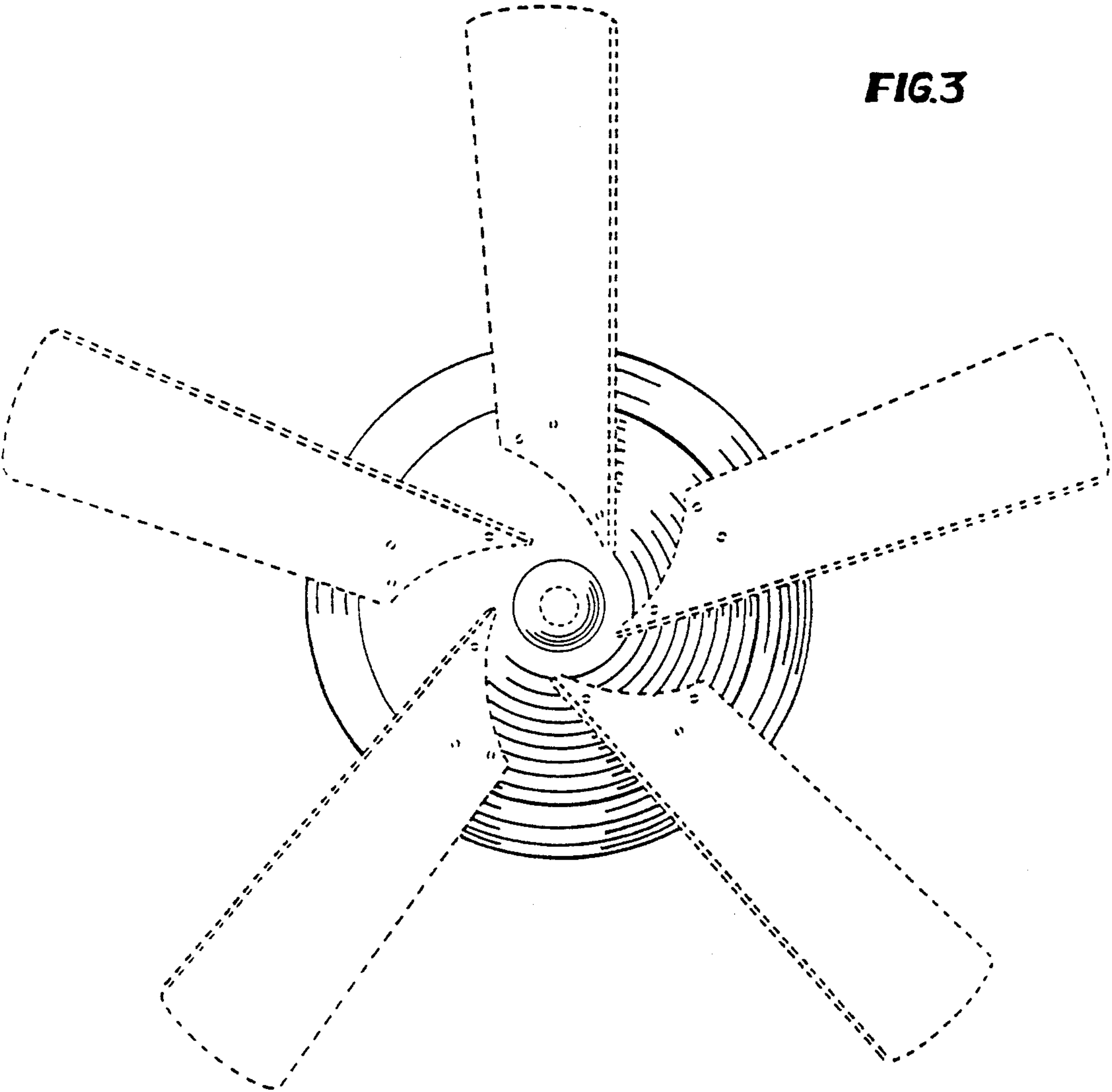
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, on a reduced scale;

purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.







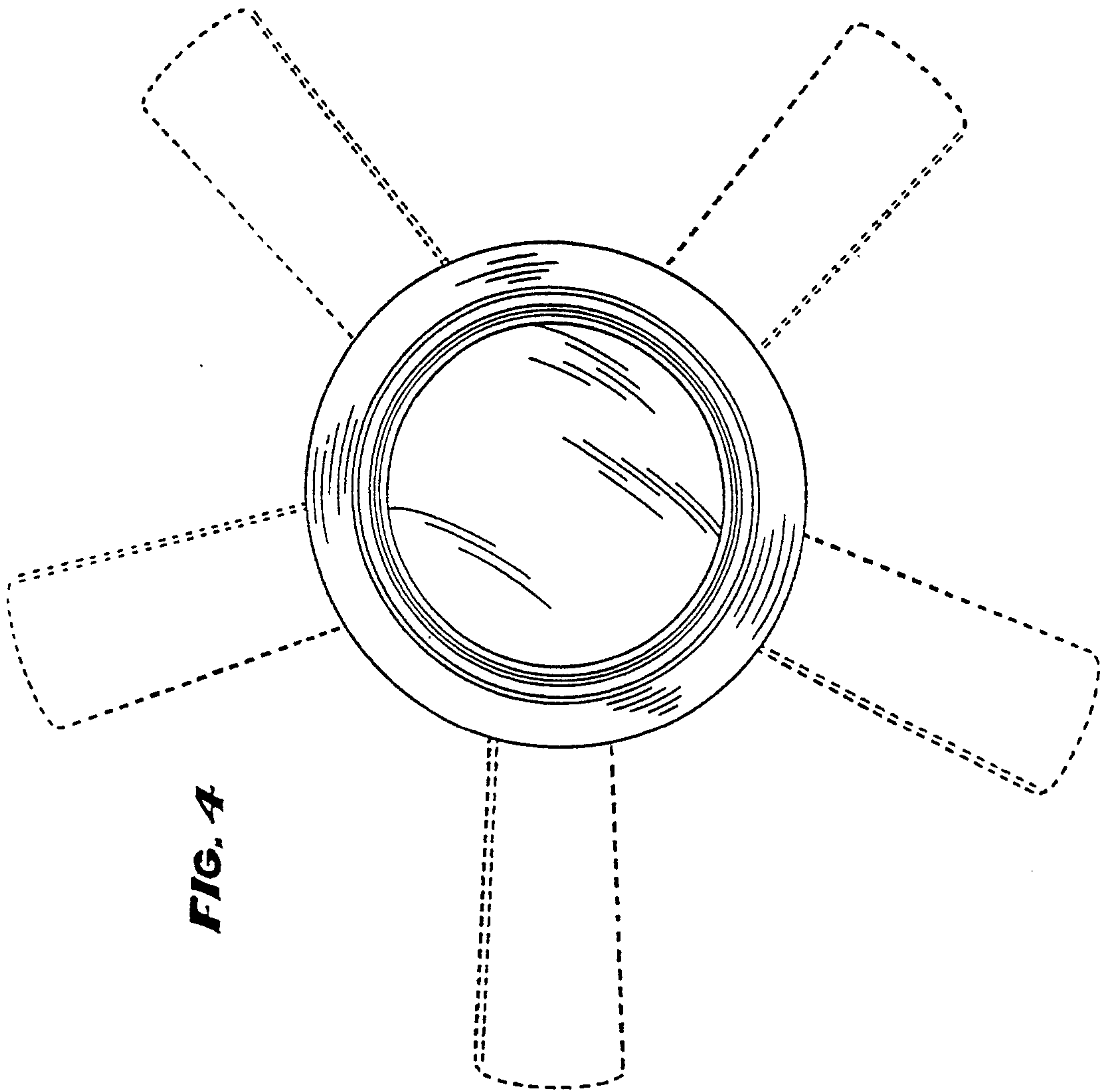
