[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a paving stone unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the paving stone unit of our new design, the bottom view being identical thereto;

FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof, the left side being identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of an alternate embodiment of a paving stone unit of our new design, the bottom view being identical thereto;

FIG. 6 is a right side view of the paving stone unit of

FIG. 5, the left side being identical thereto;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the paving stone unit of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the paving stone unit of FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of an alternate embodiment of a paving stone unit of our new design, the bottom view being identical thereto;

FIG. 10 is a right side view of the paving stone unit of

unit of FIG. 9; FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of the paving stone


unit of FIG. 9; FIG. 13 is a top plan view of an alternate embodiment of a paving stone unit of our new design, the bottom view being identical thereto;


FIG. 14 is a right side view of the paving stone unit of
