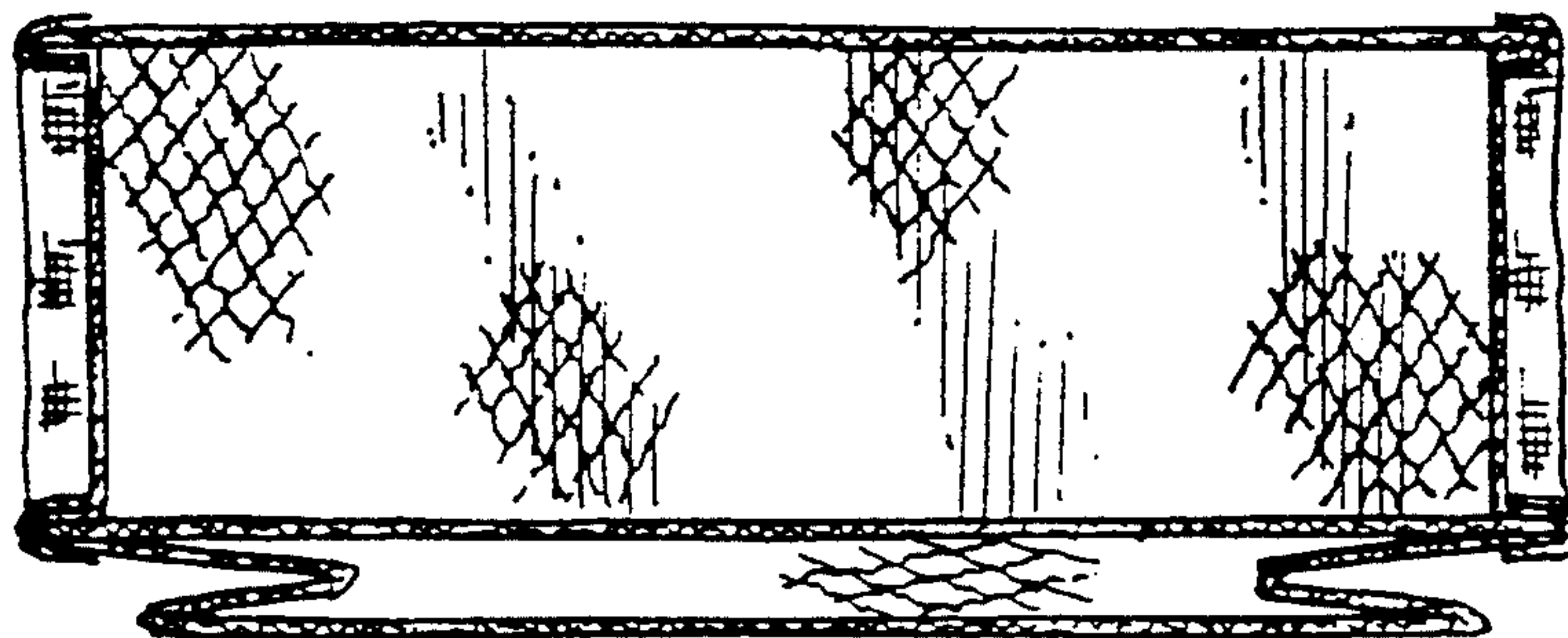
The ornamental design for a collapsible drip-dry accessory bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a collapsible drip-dry accessory bag showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof, the broken away portion of the cord is for purposes of illustration; FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1, the broken away portion of the cord is for purposes of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a section taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 5 is a perspective view of my ornamental design.



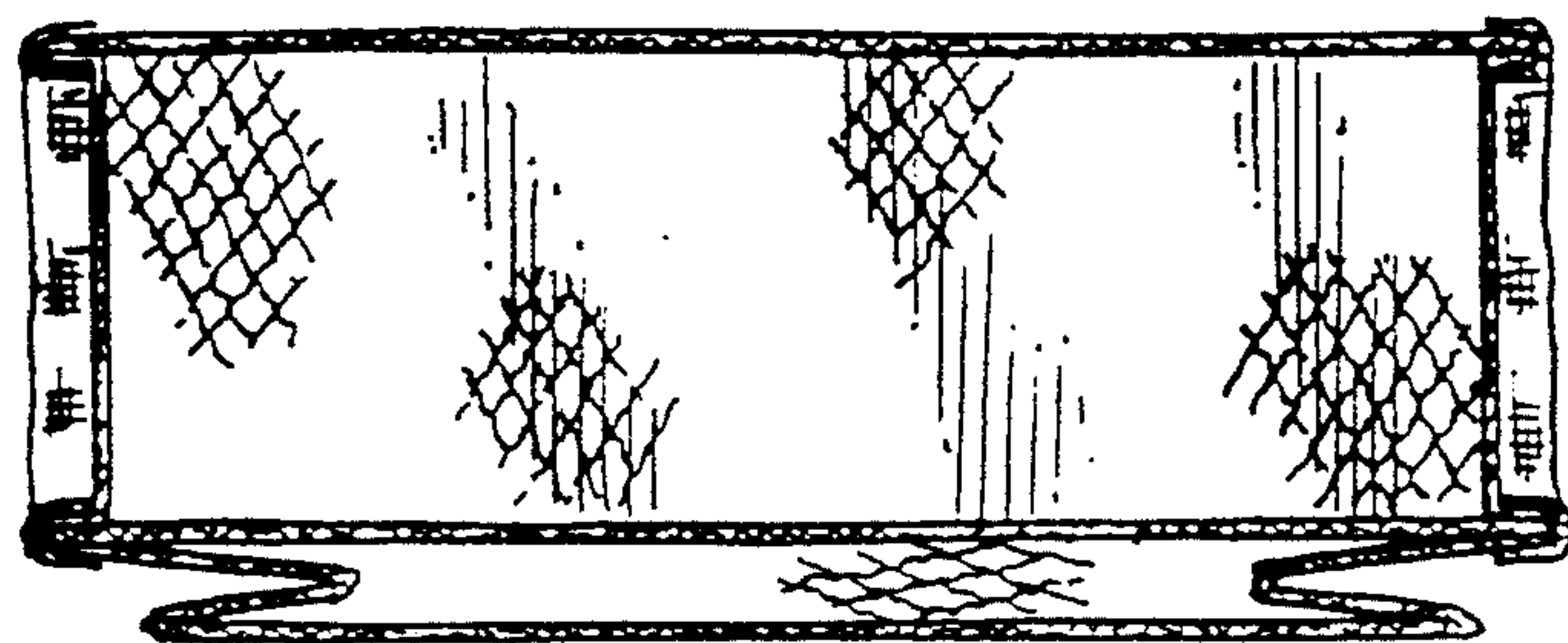
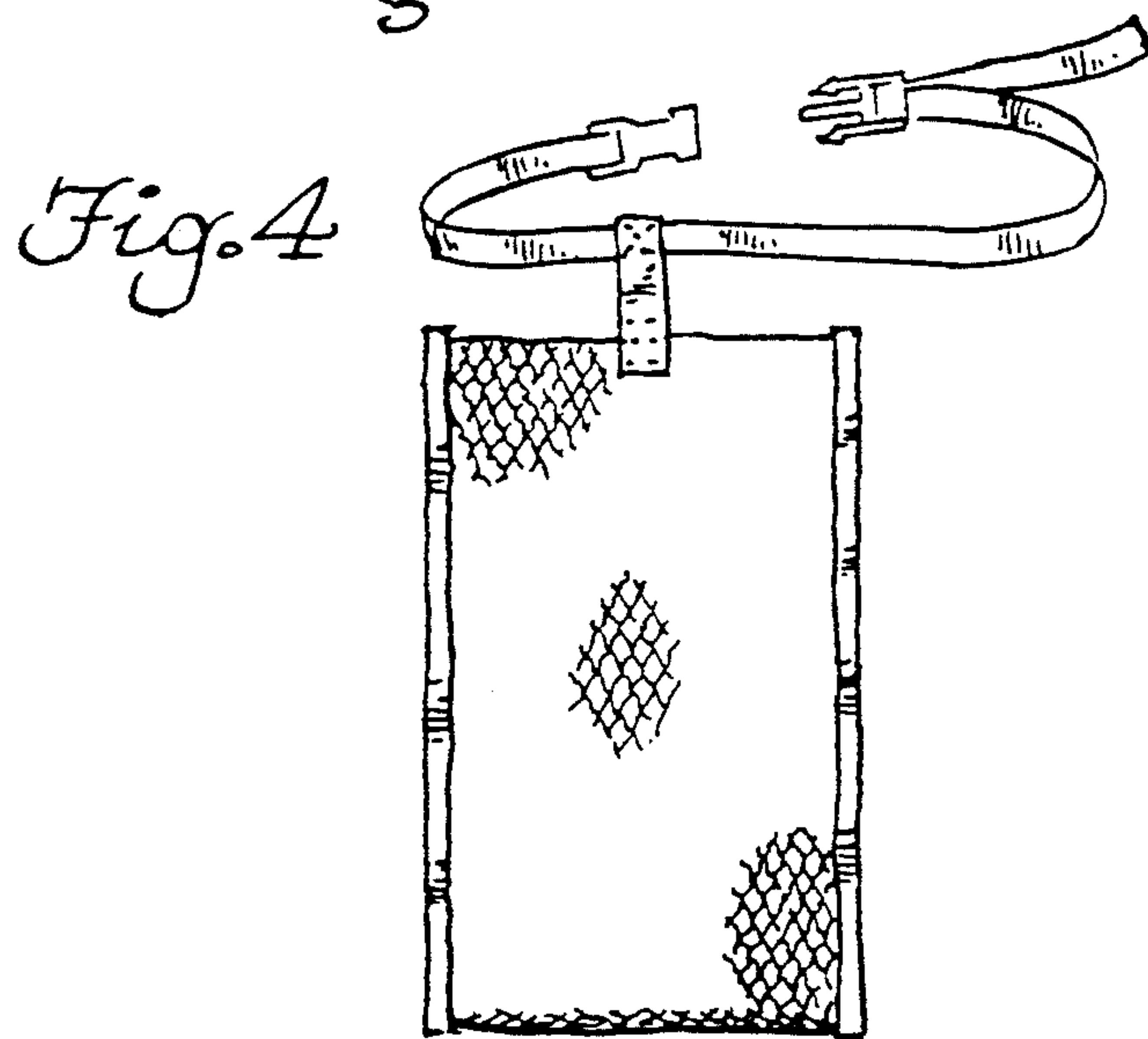
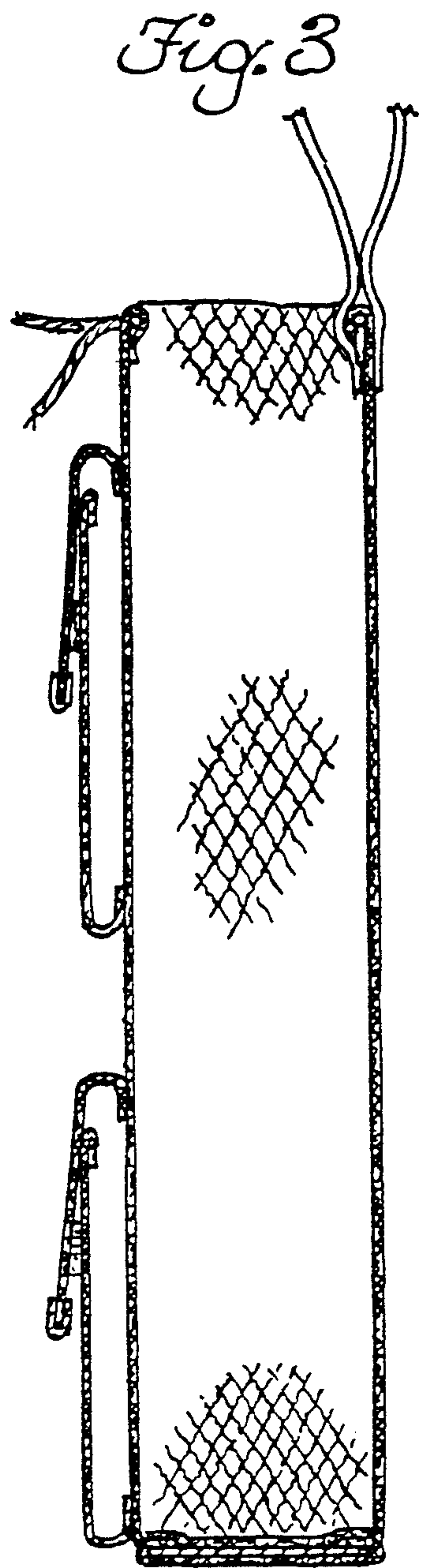
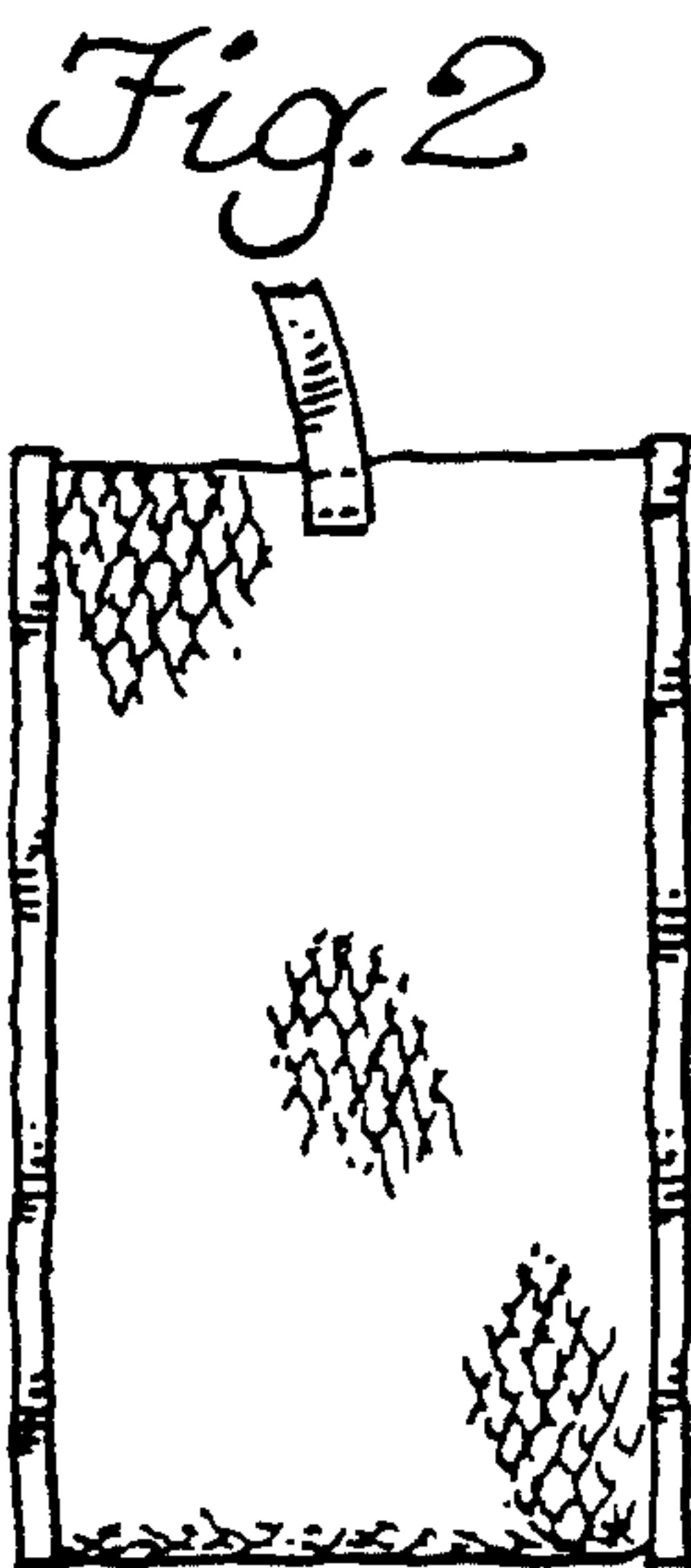
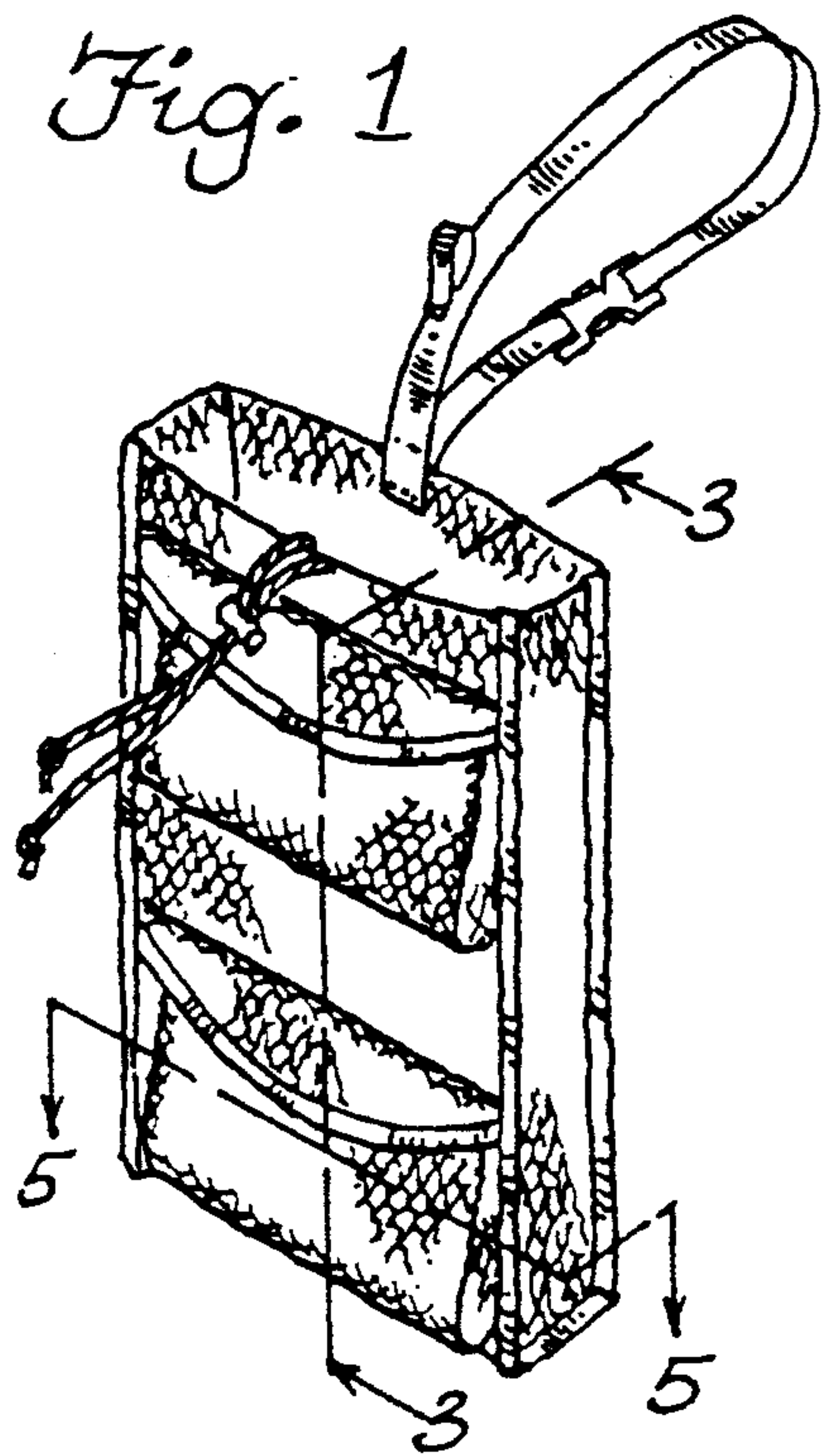
