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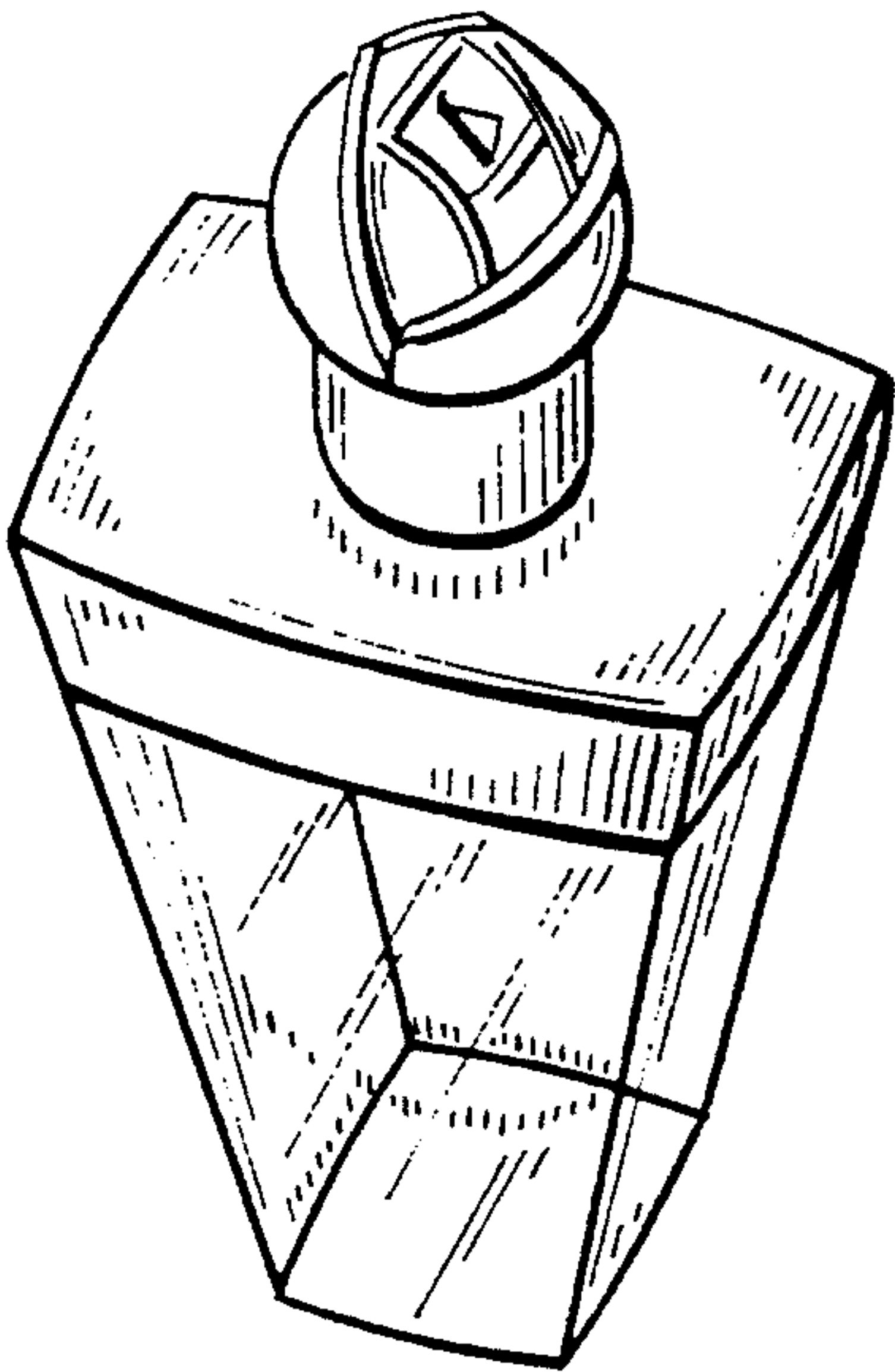

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined bottle and closure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined bottle and closure showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed opposite sides being identical;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of the bottle as disclosed in FIG. 1, the undisclosed opposite sides being identical;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of a third embodiment of the bottle as disclosed in FIG. 1, the undisclosed opposite sides being identical;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 5; and,
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 5, shown without the cap for clarity of illustration.



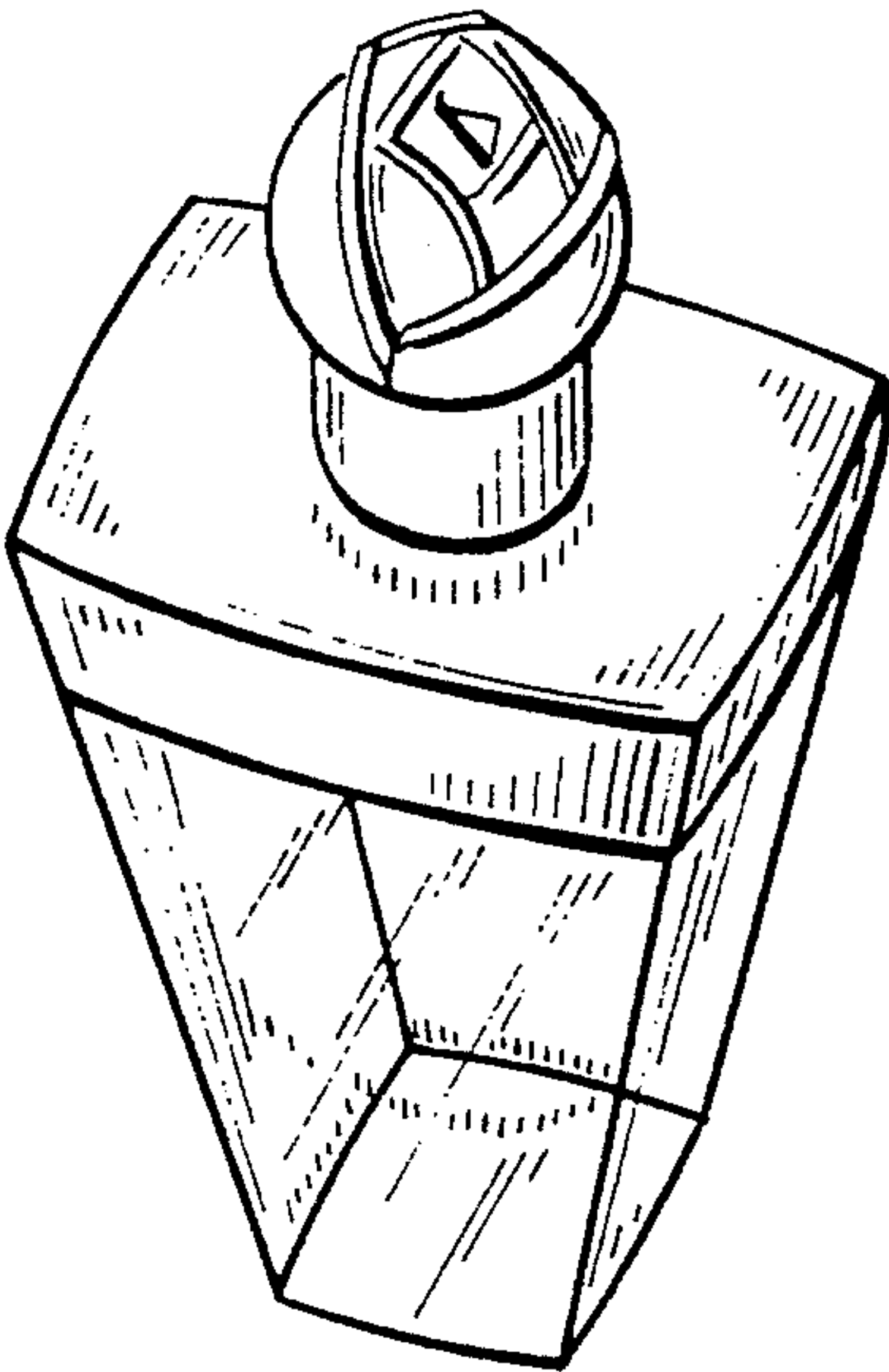

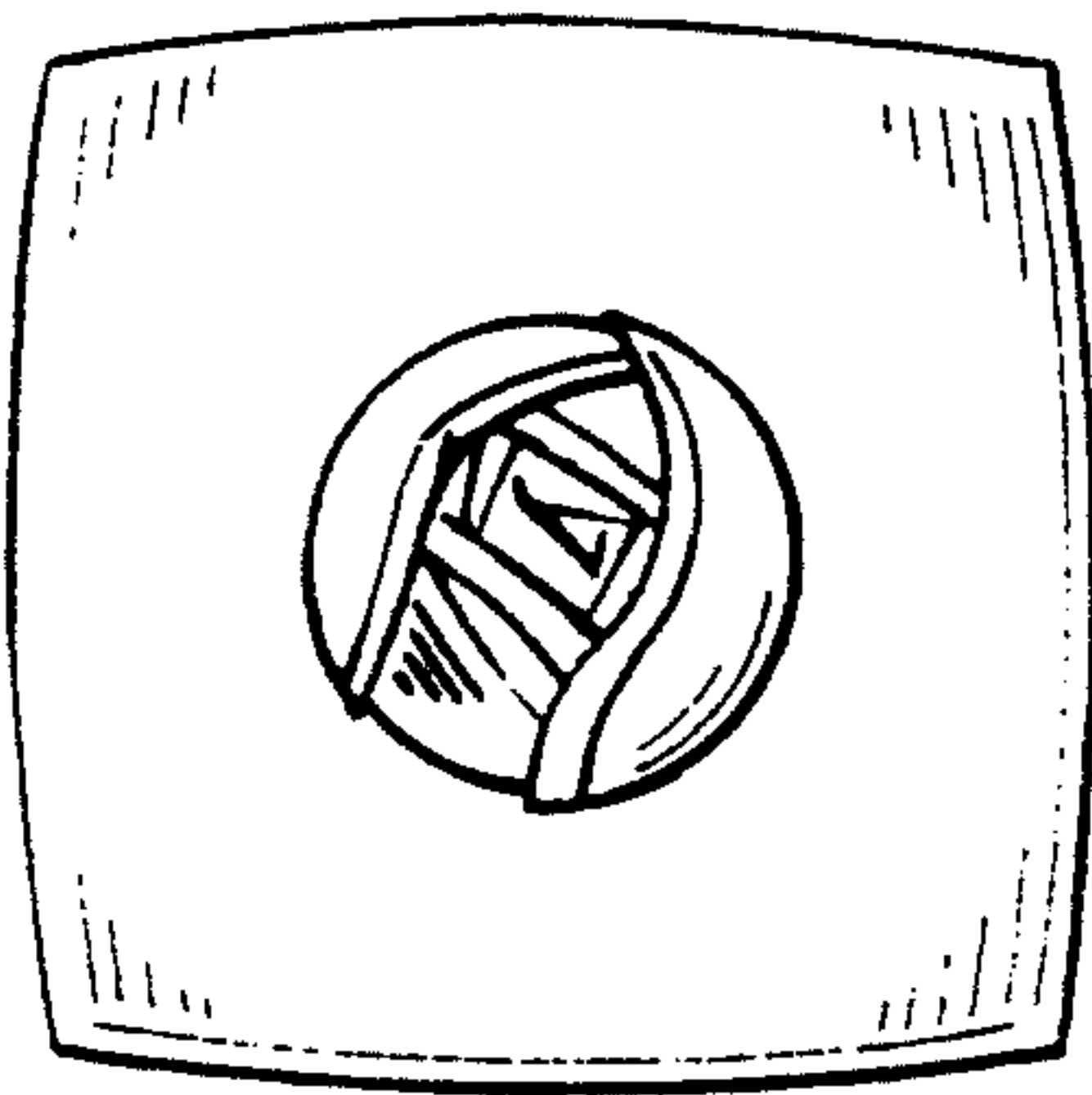

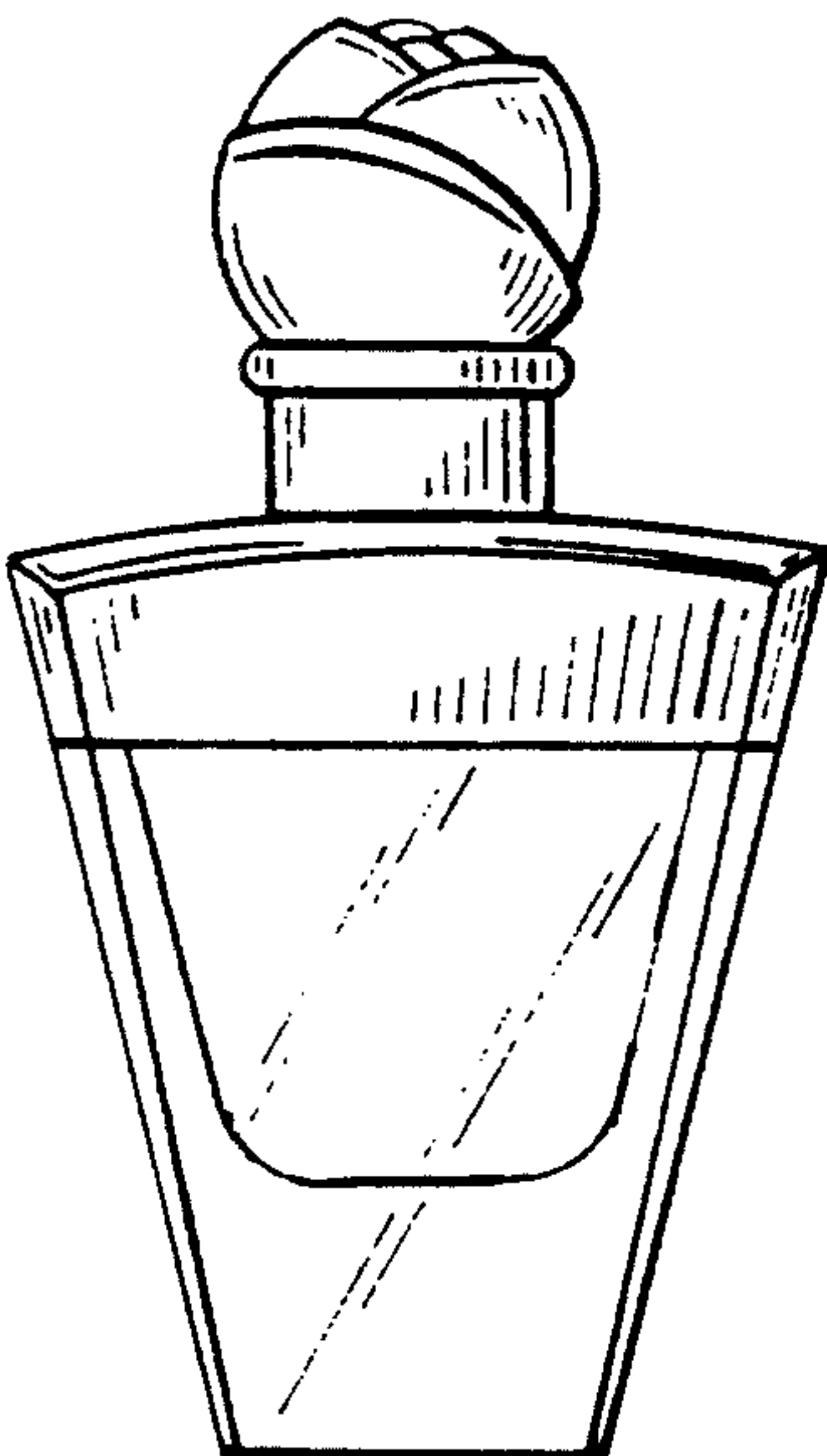

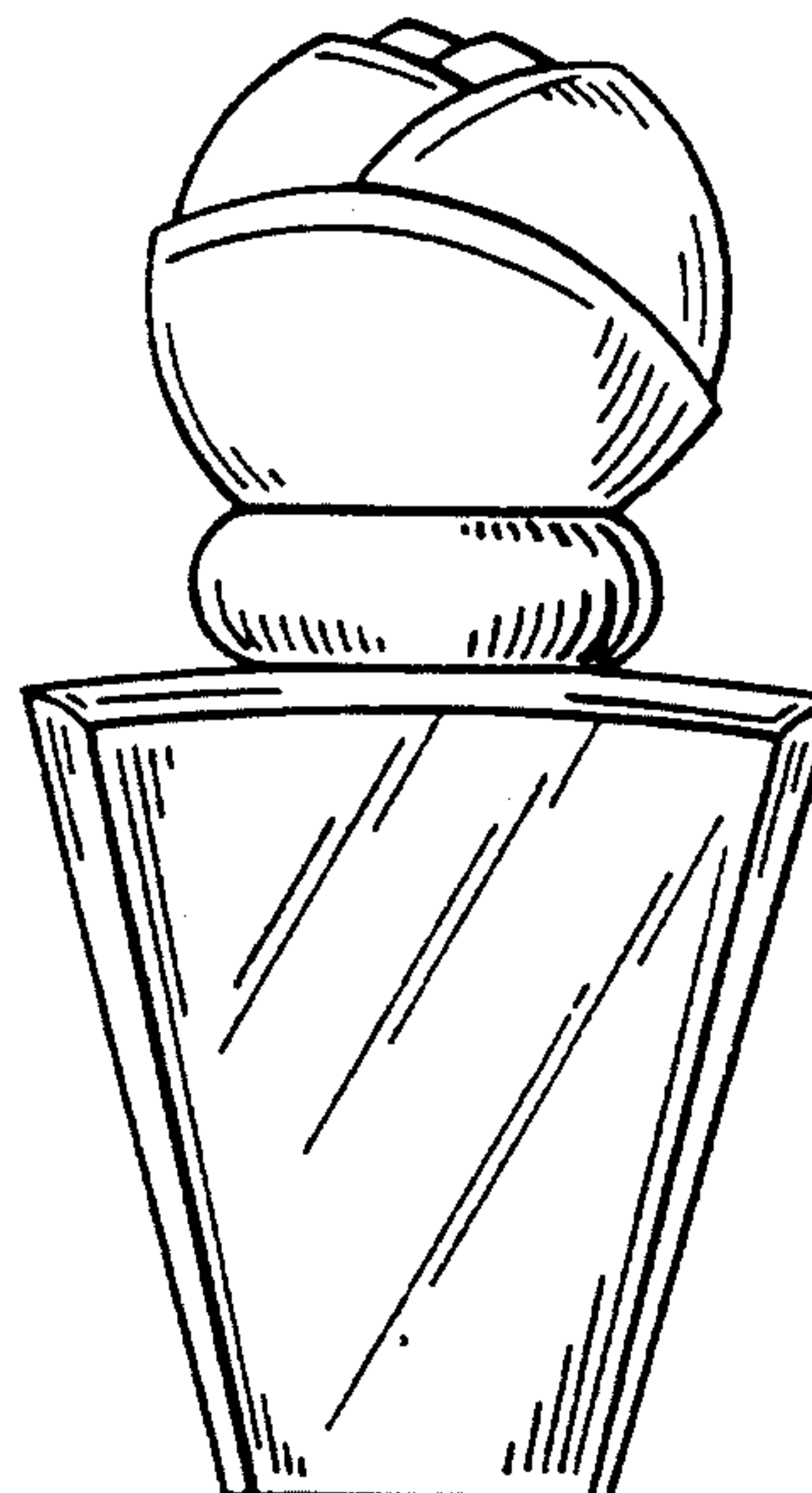
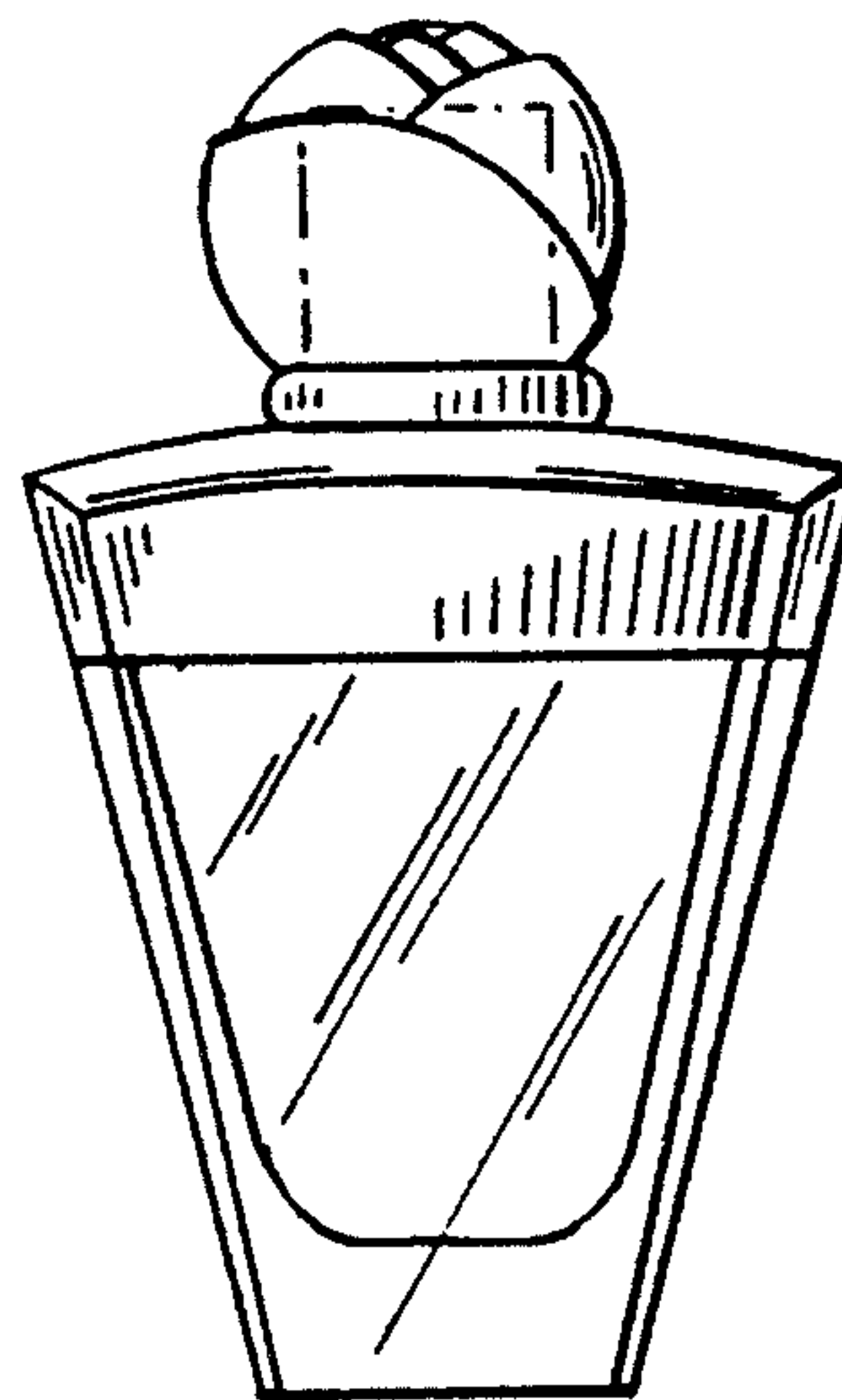

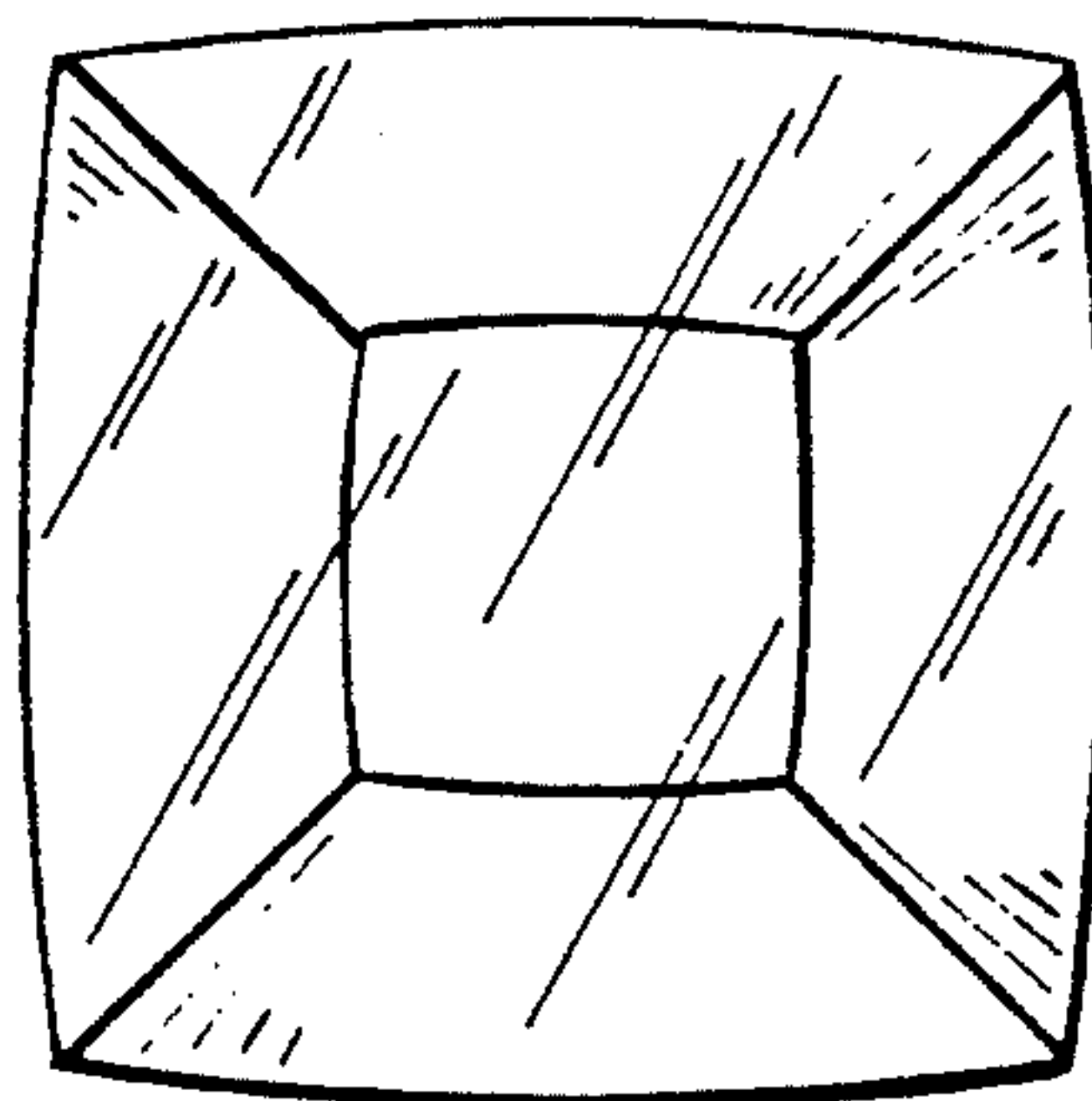

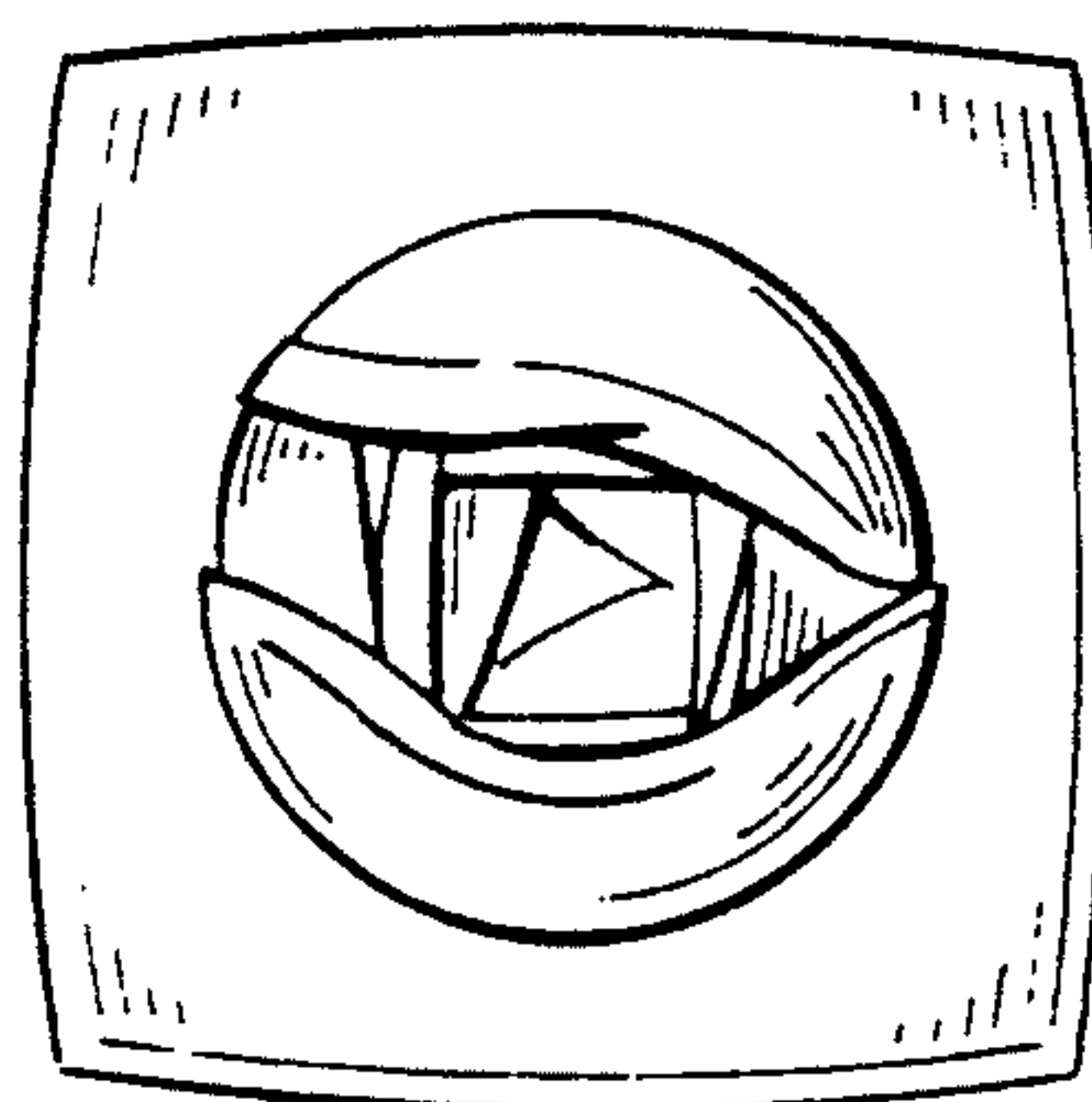

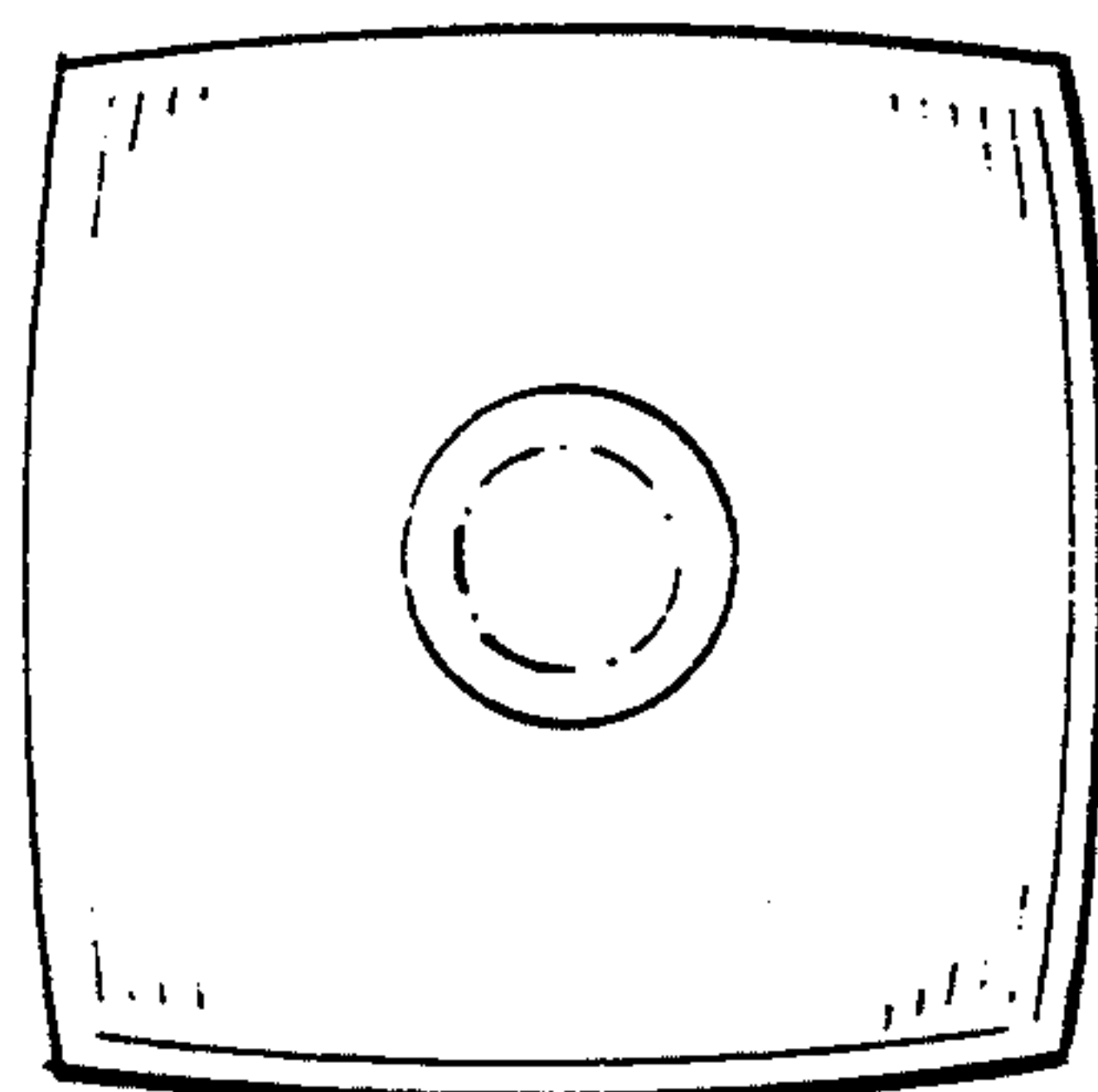
