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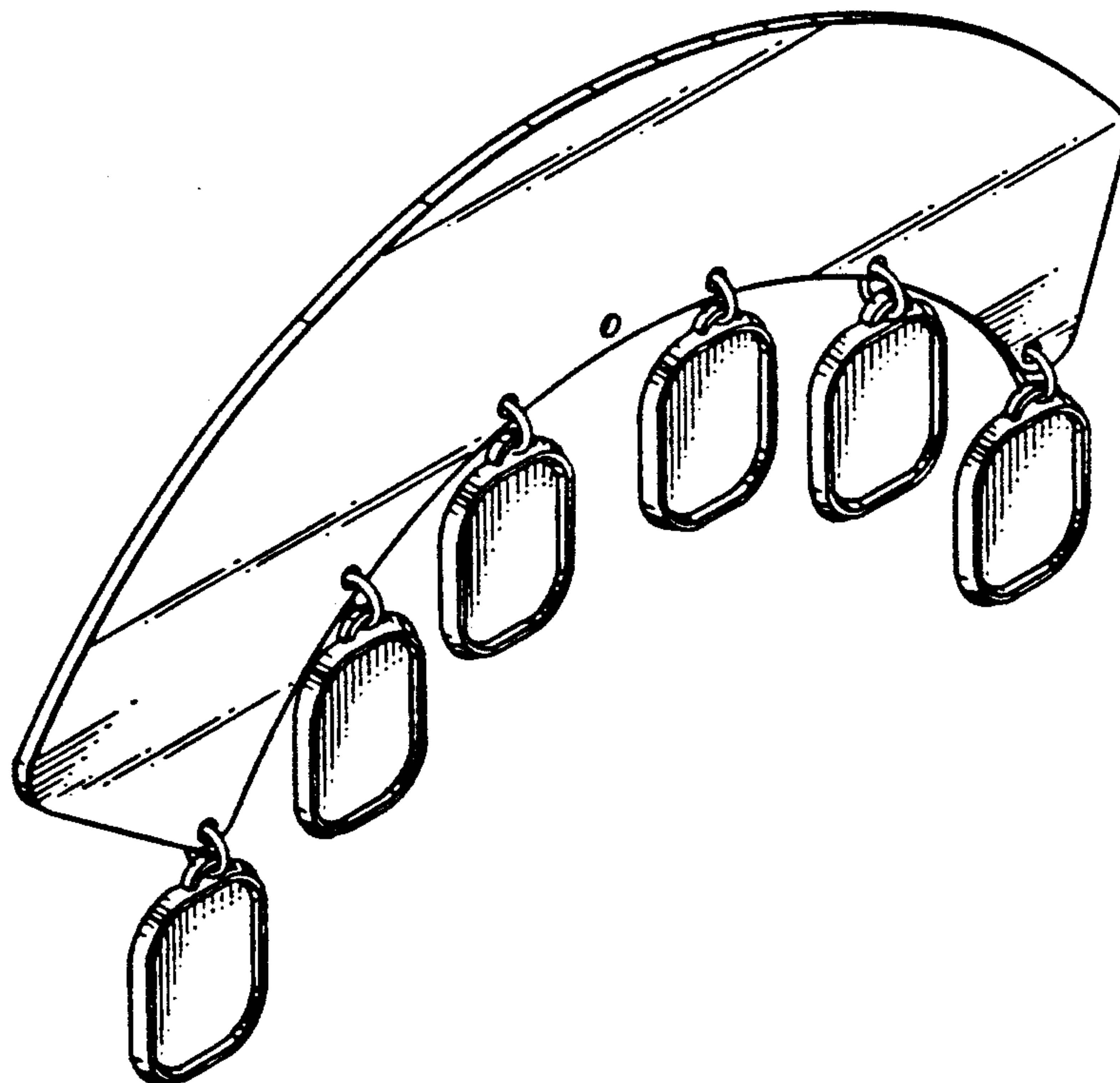

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an ornamental charm, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an ornamental charm showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 8 is a front view of a tie retainer showing a second embodiment of my new design, such embodiment showing a single string of disks descending from a main portion, each of which is identical to the disks shown in FIGS. 1-7; and,
FIG. 9 is a front view of a third embodiment of an ornamental charm showing my new design, such embodiment having two rows of disks descending from a main portion, each of such disks being identical to those illustrated in FIG. 1-7.



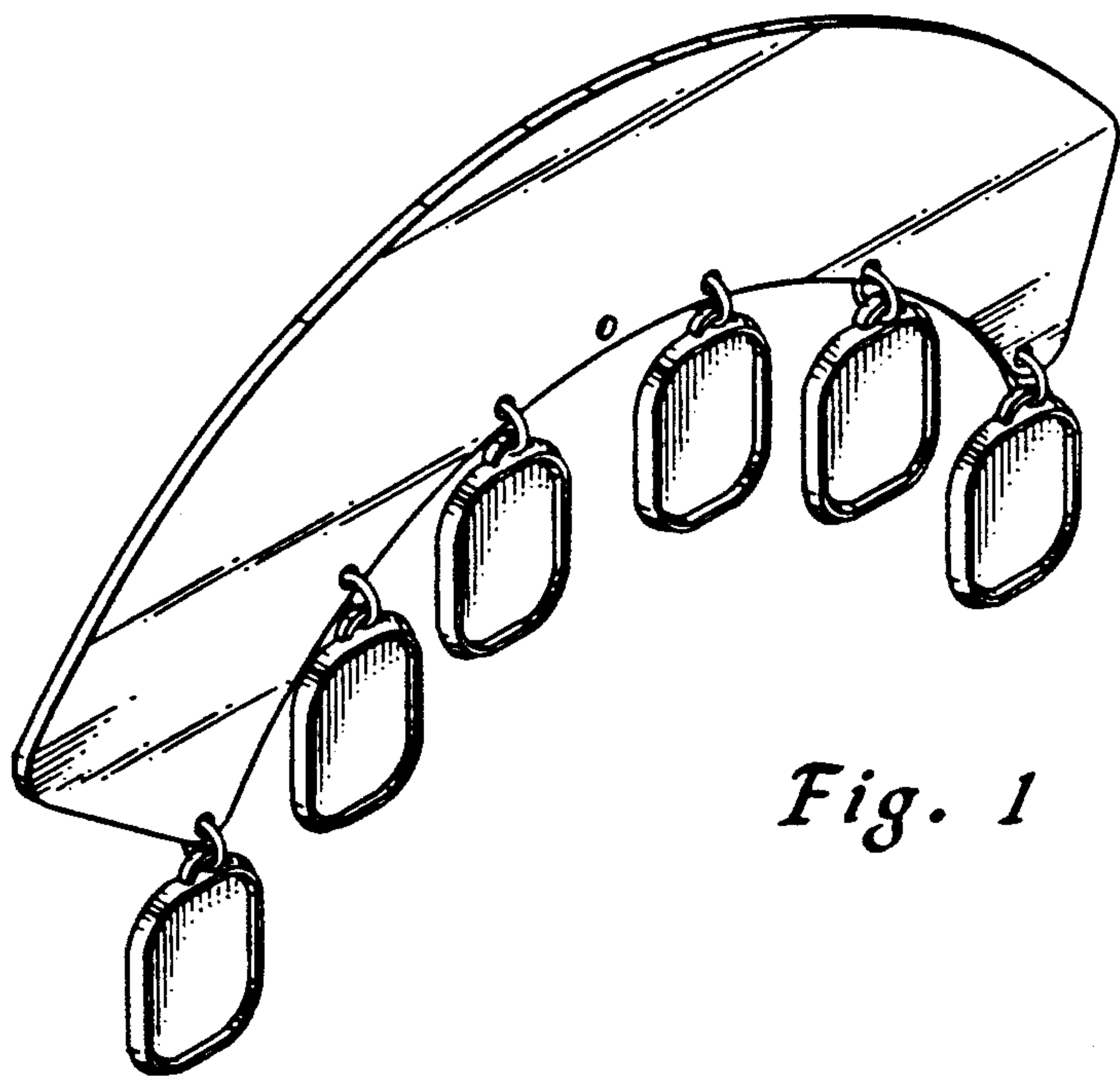

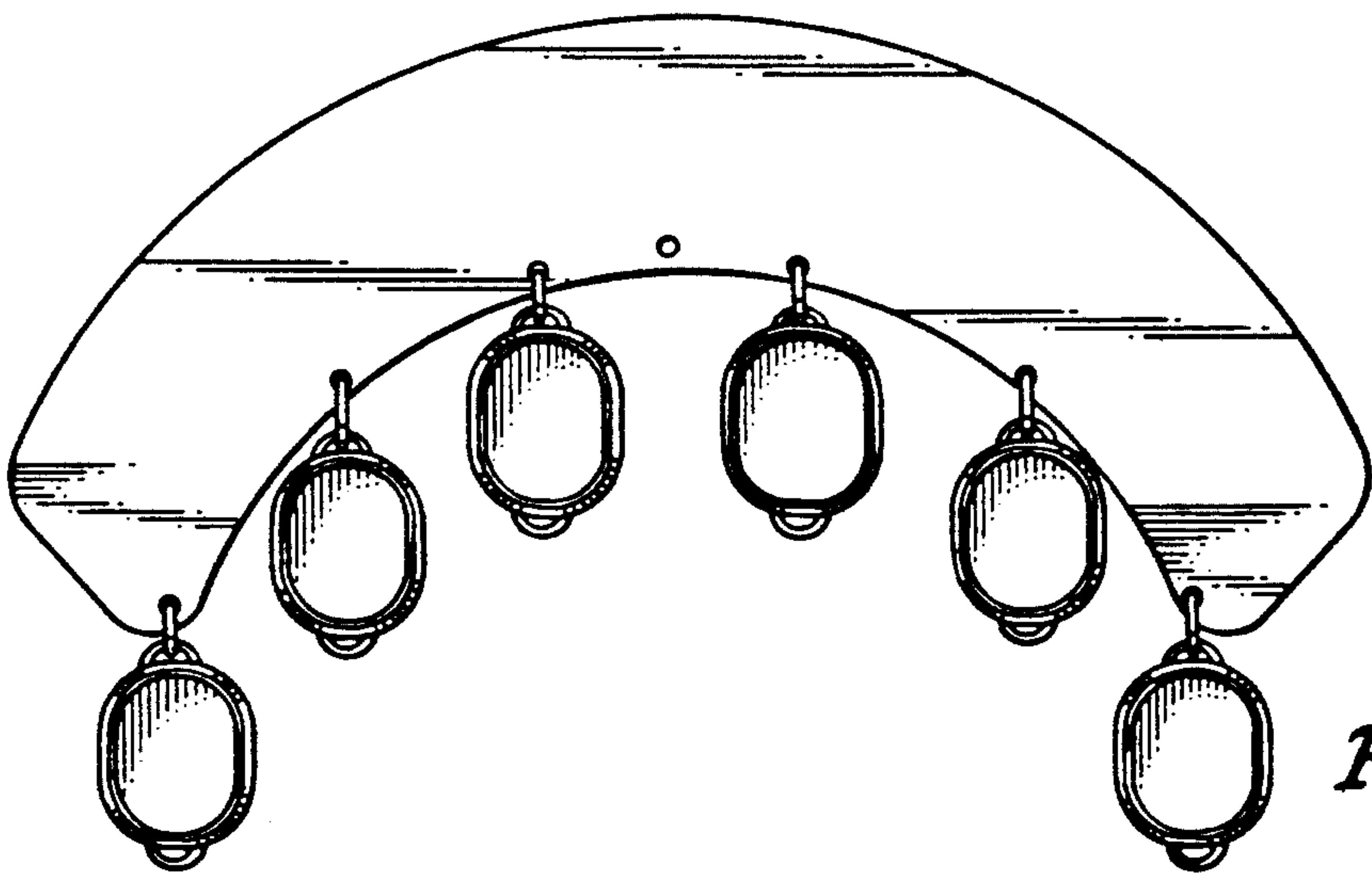

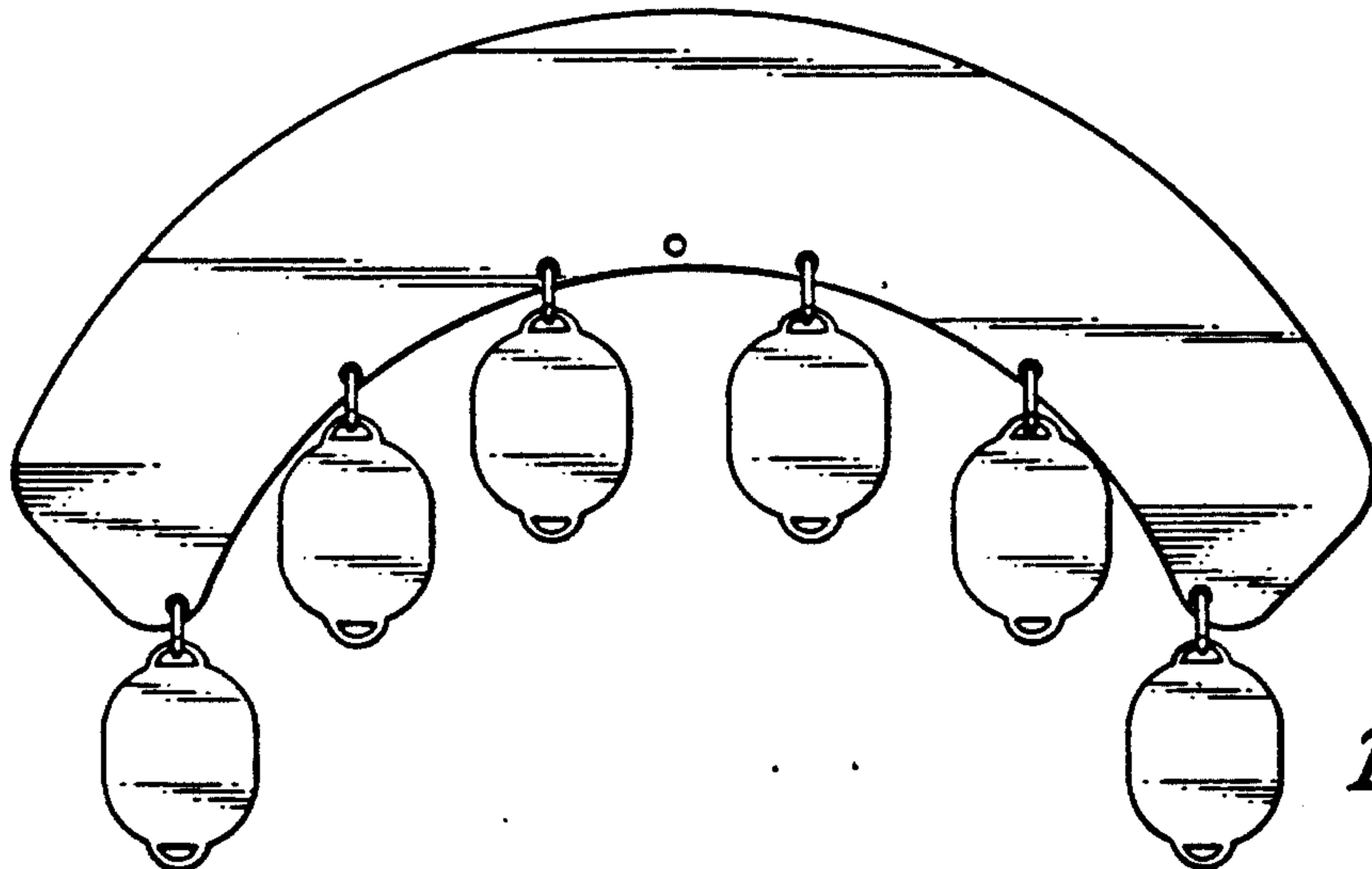

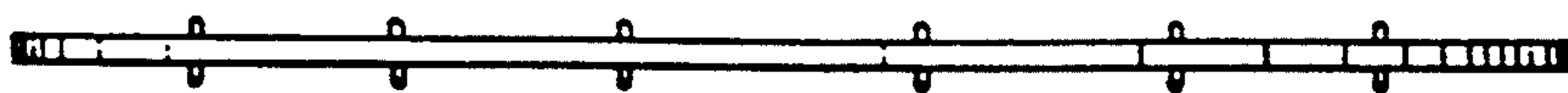

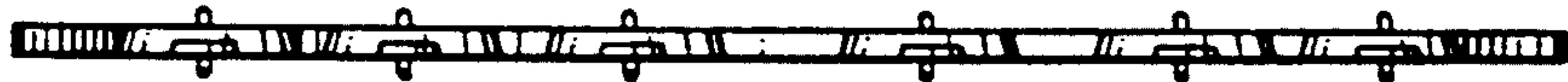

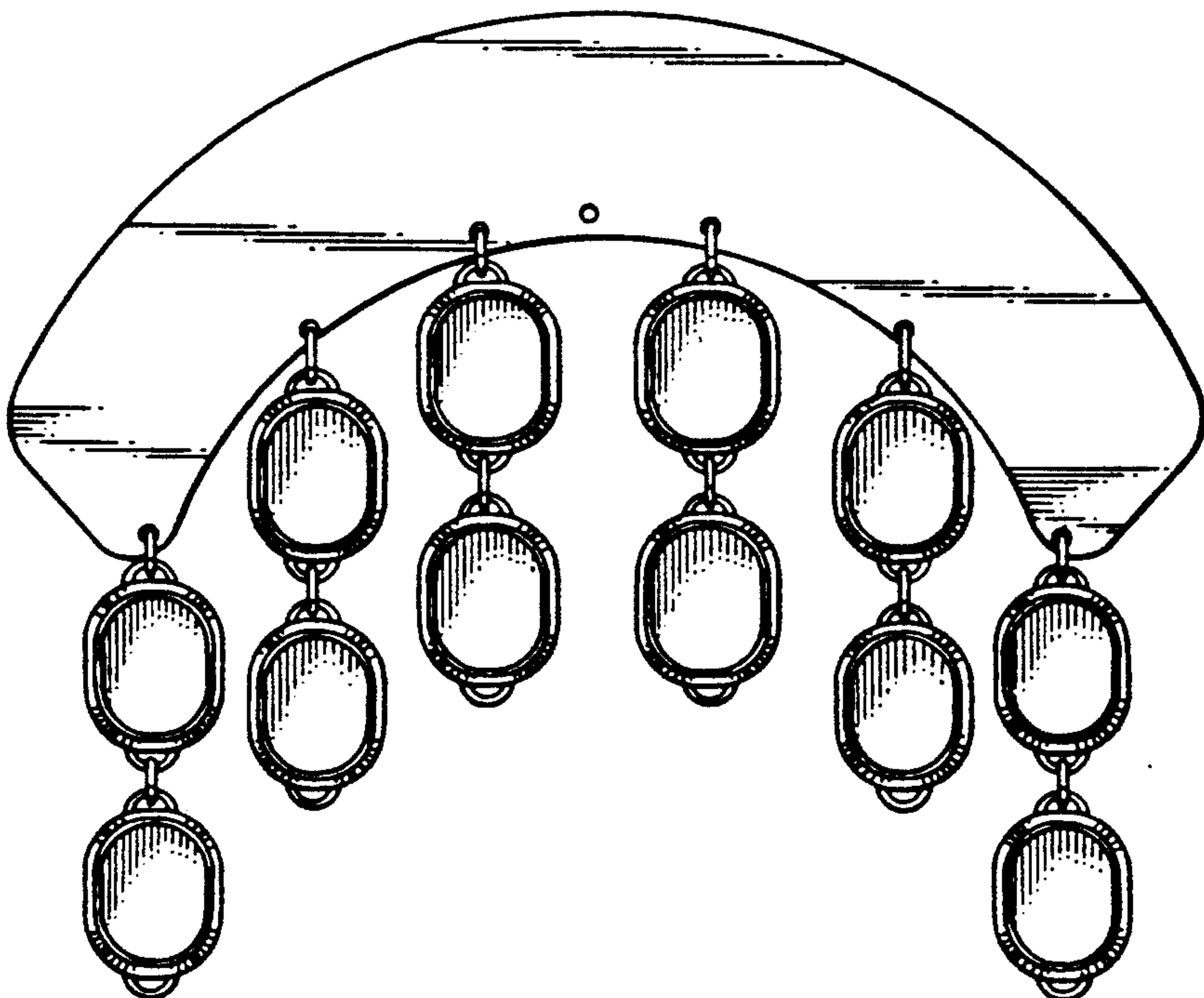

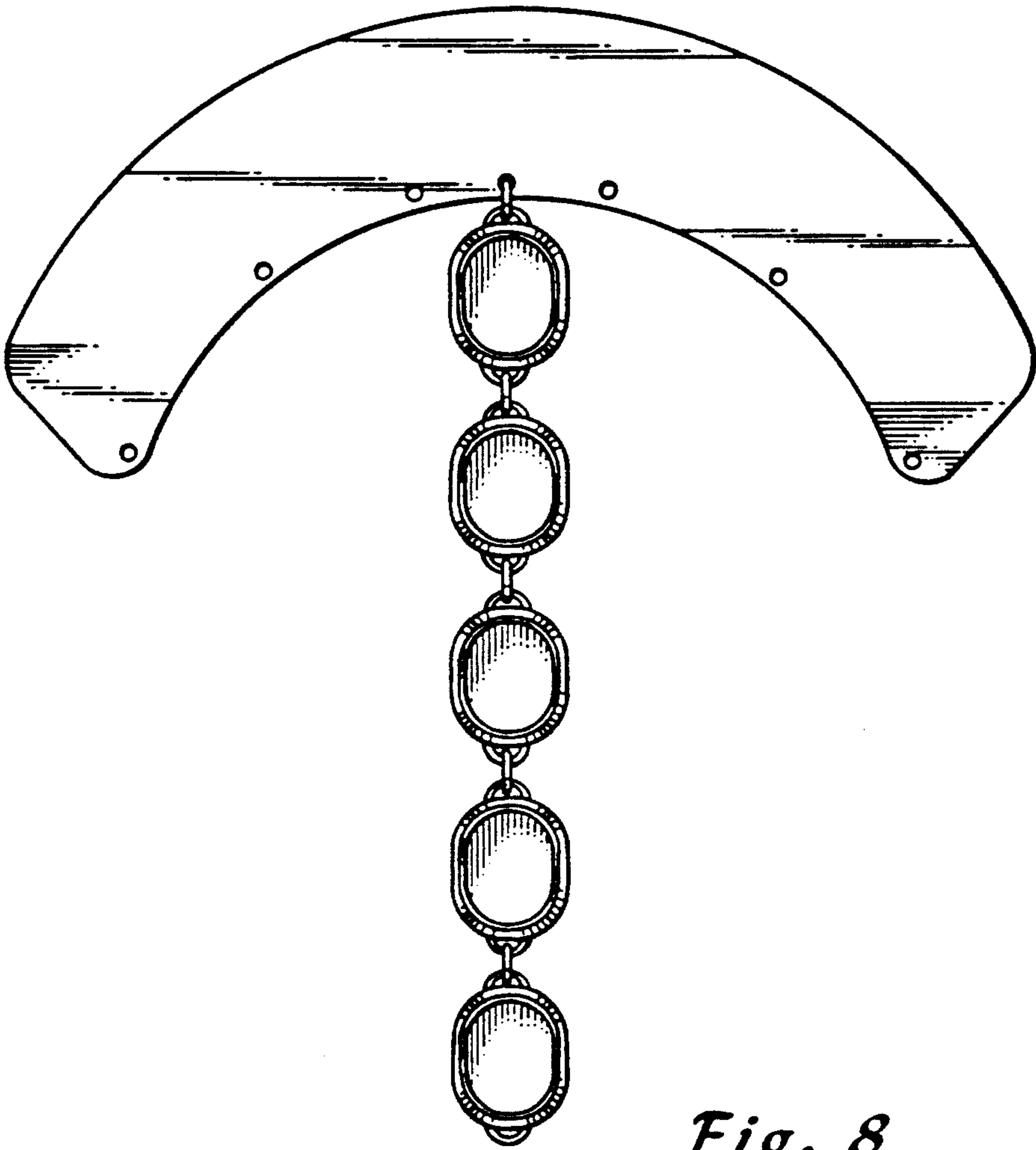
