[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an oven heatable food package, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the top, front and righthand end of one embodiment of an oven heatable food package showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a righthand side elevational view thereof, the lefthand side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing the top, front and righthand end of another embodiment of an oven heatable food package showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 10 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 12 is a righthand side elevational view thereof, the lefthand side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.


The dotted lines shown in the front lid flap of the package in FIGS. 1, 4, 7 and 10 are cuts defining a lifting tab and zip strip along the front upper edge of the package. The dotted line in the lid panel in FIGS. 1, 2, 7 and 8 is an inverted double score line. The lift tab and zip strip cuts and the fold line are shown in dotted lines since they do not enter into the present design.


