[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a vehicle glove box door, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view in perspective of a vehicle glove box door showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

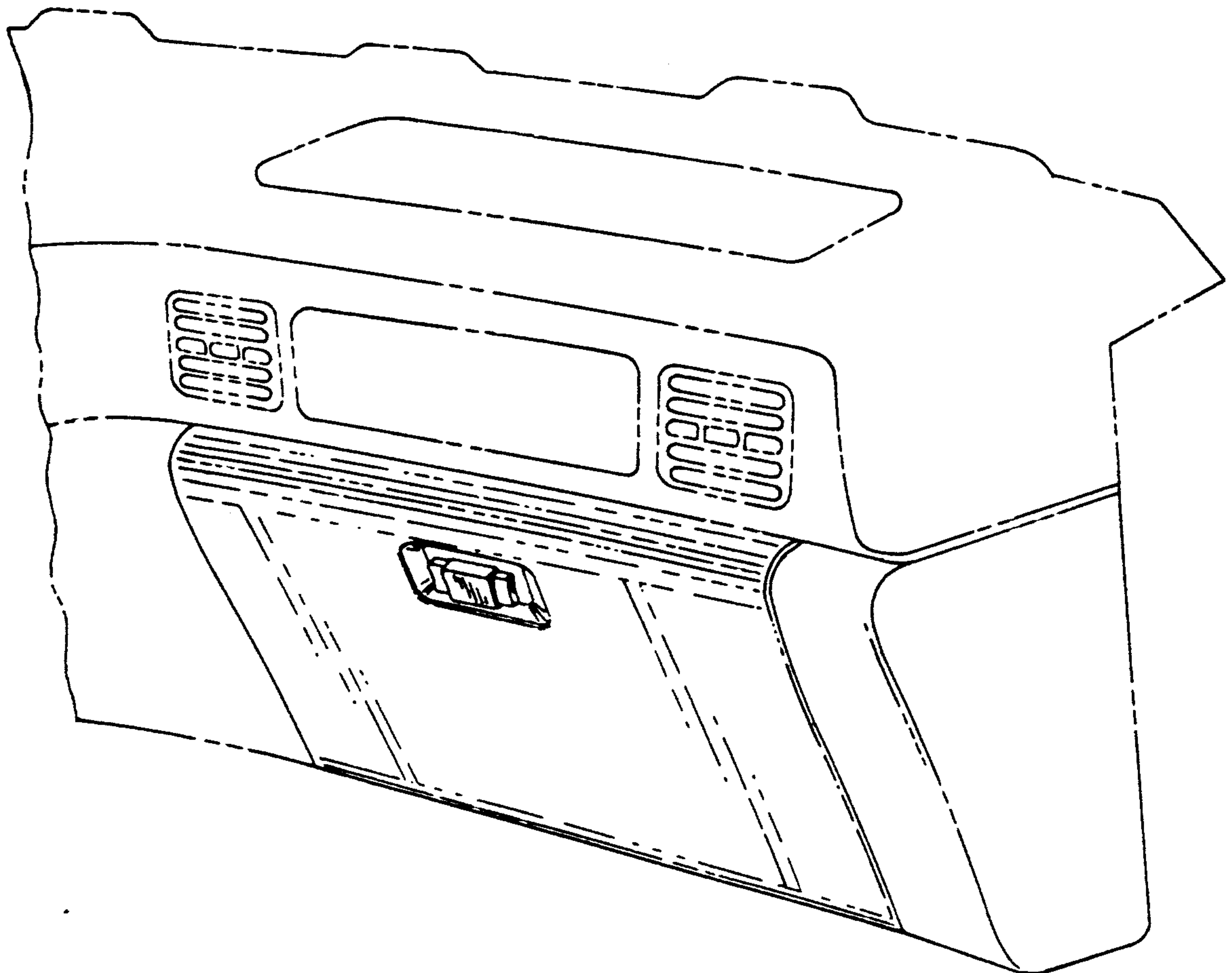
FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged left side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof.

The rear of the vehicle glove box door is substantially plain and unornamented.



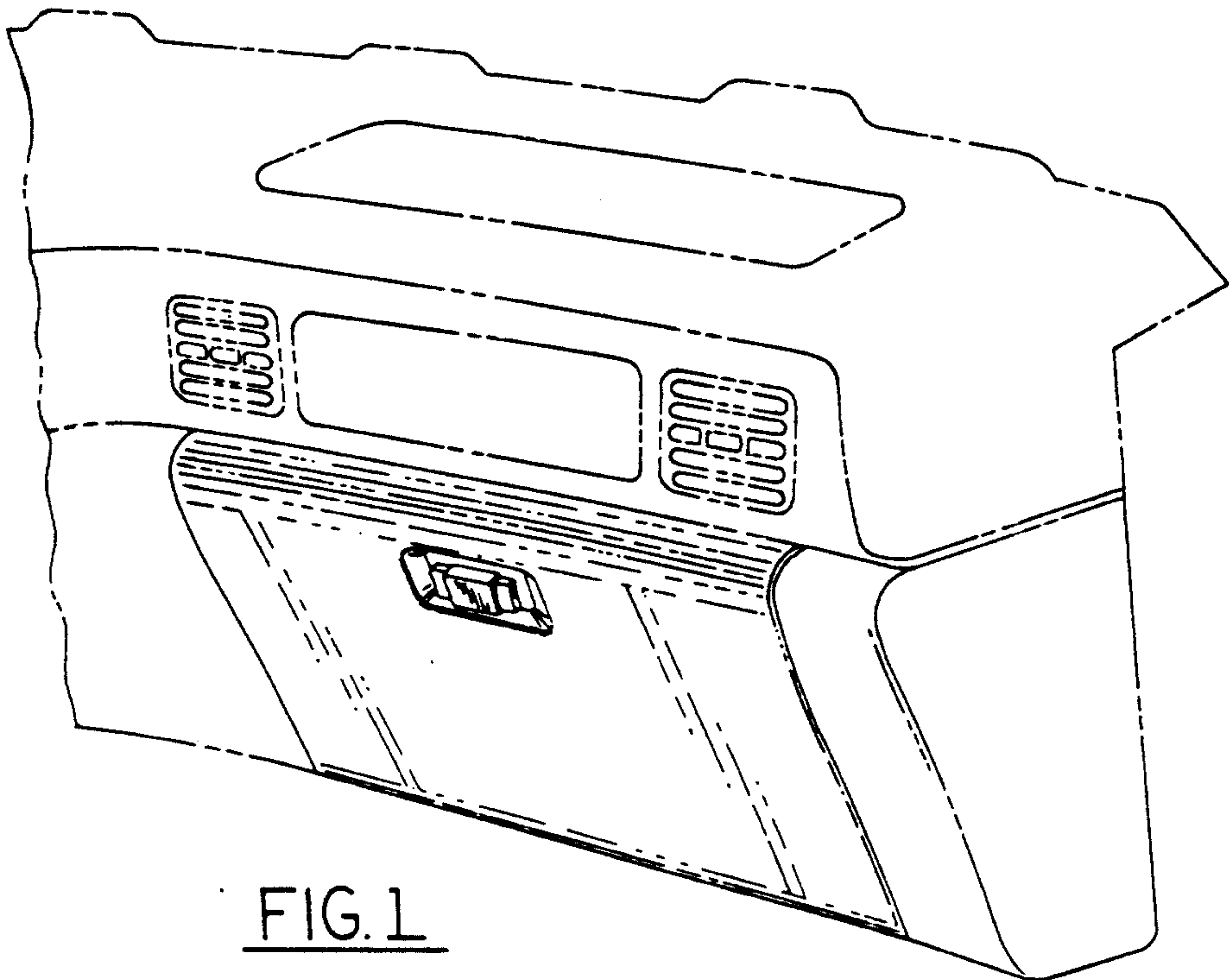

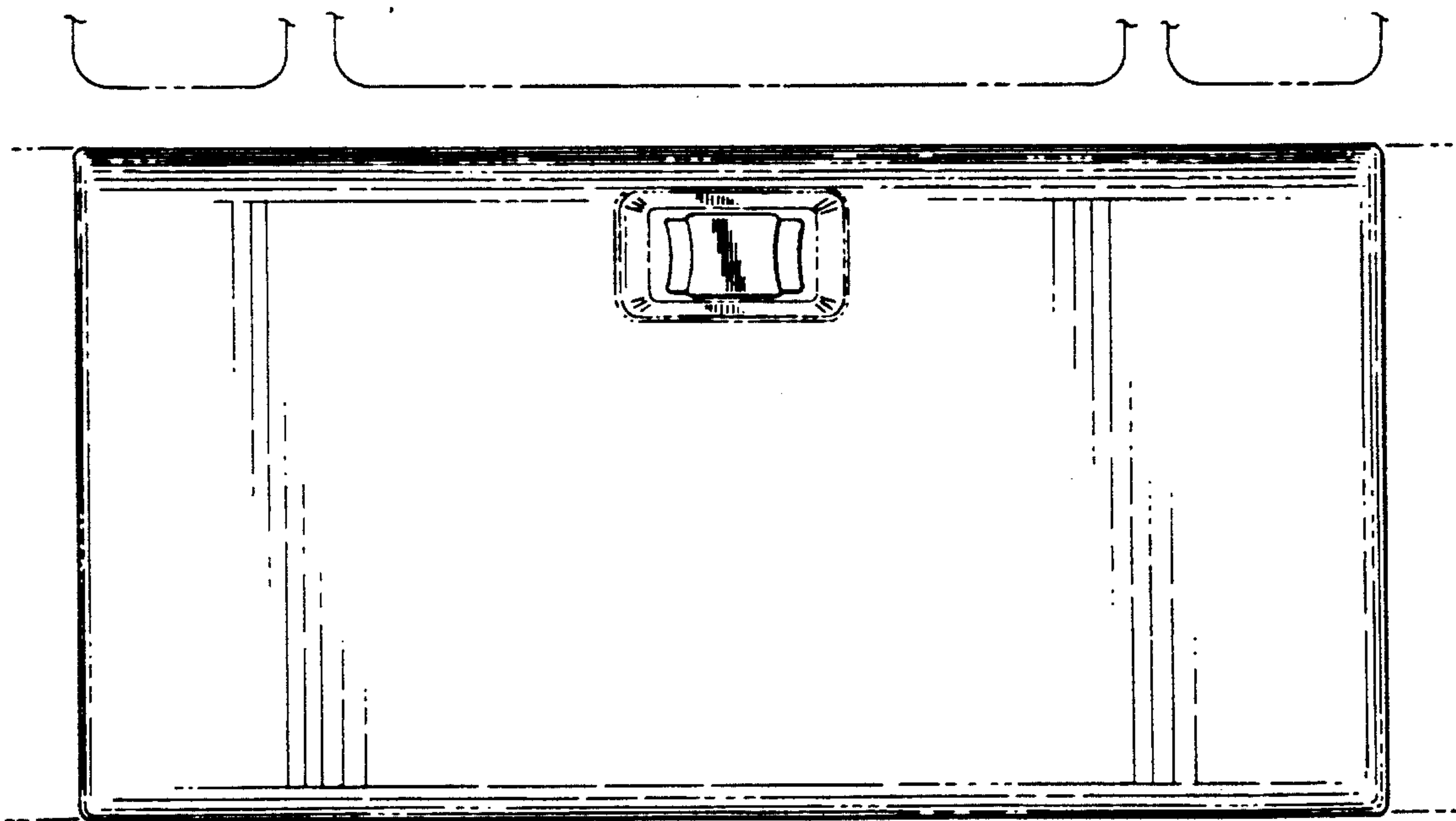

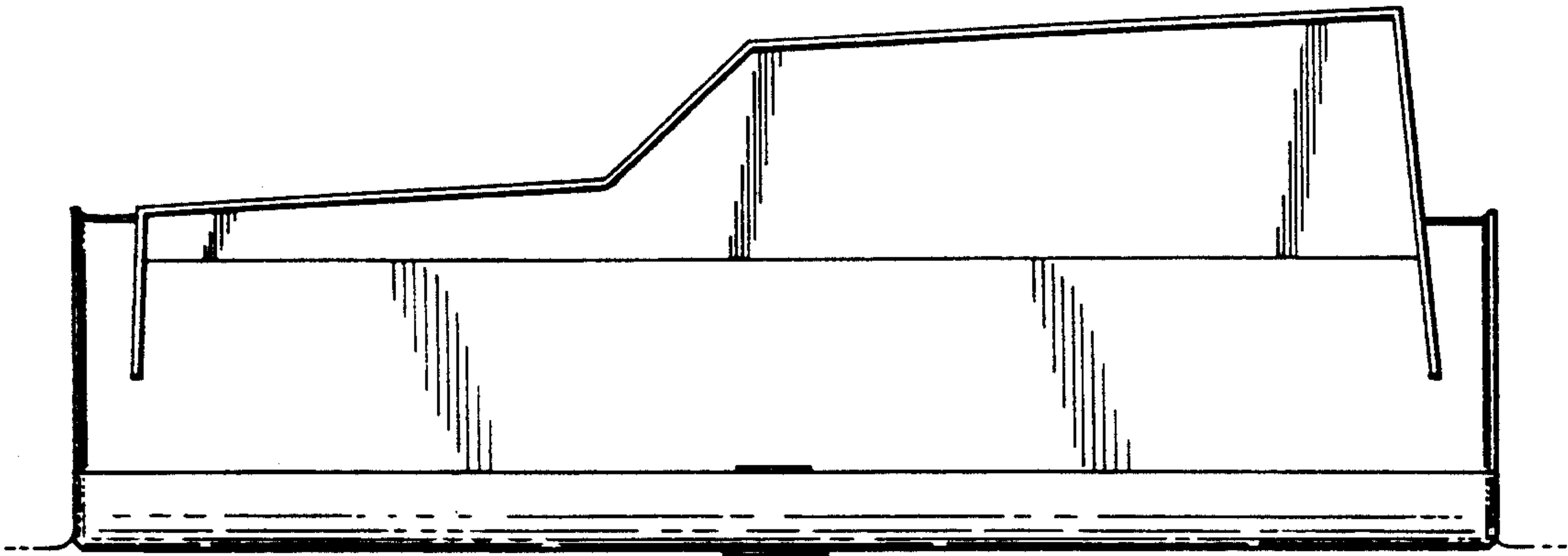

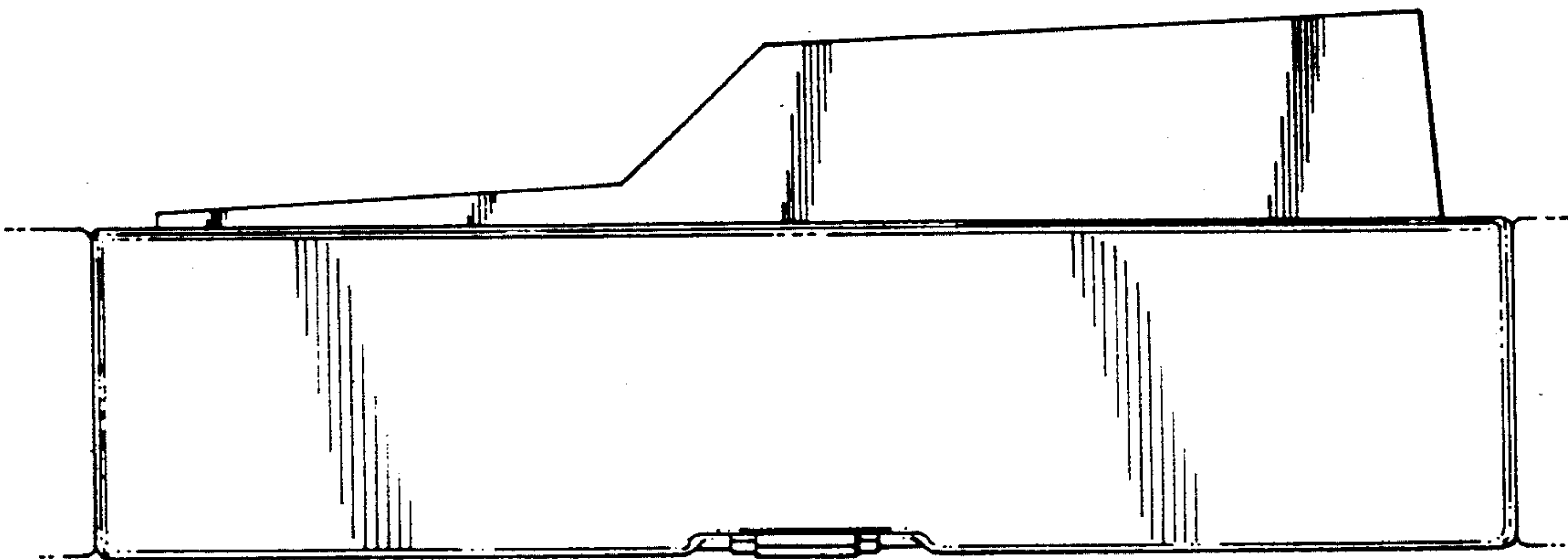

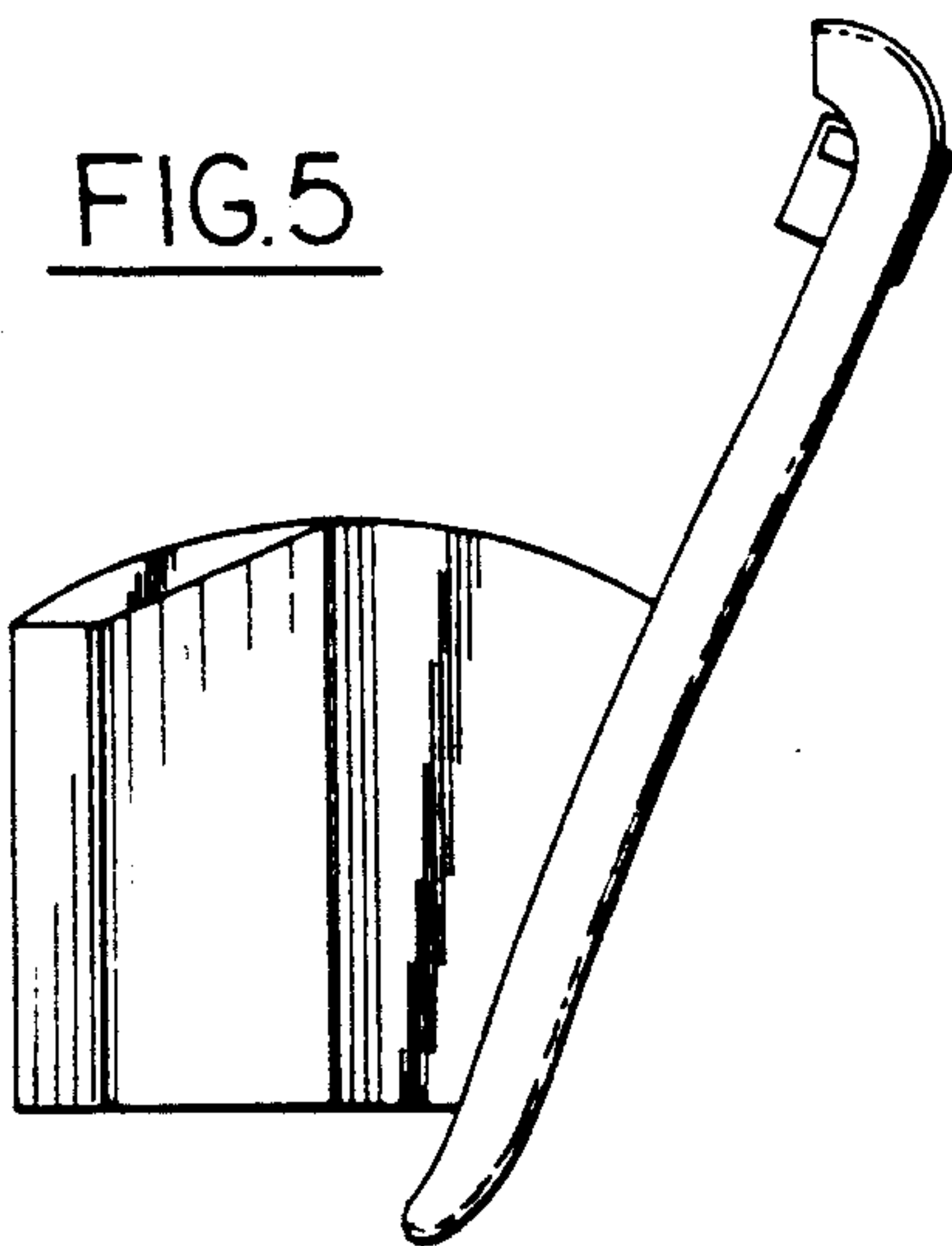

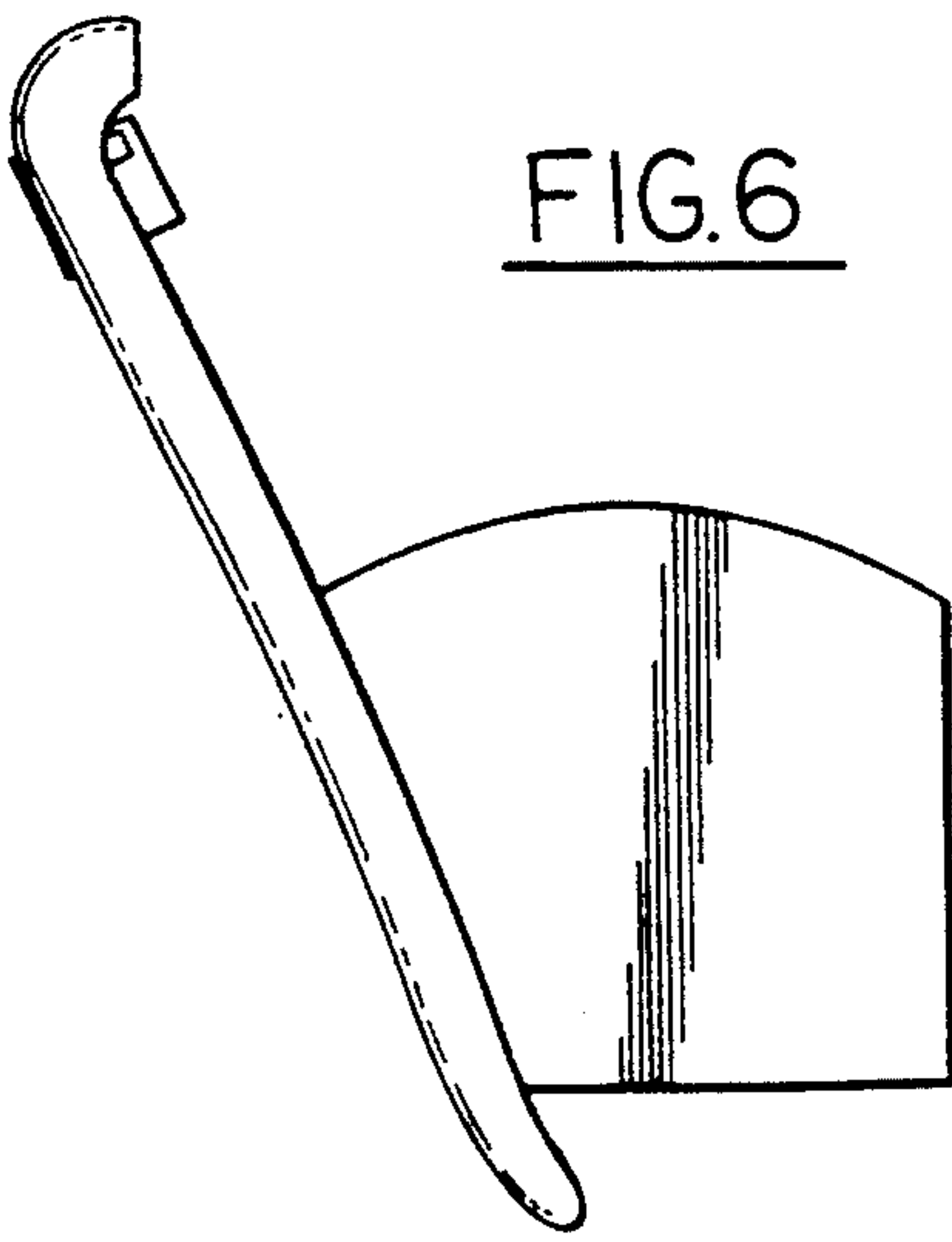
