[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a writing instrument, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a writing instrument showing our new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a writing instrument showing a second embodiment of our invention;  
 FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of a writing instrument showing a third embodiment of our invention;  
 FIG. 12 is a side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

 FIG. 15 is a top plan view thereof.

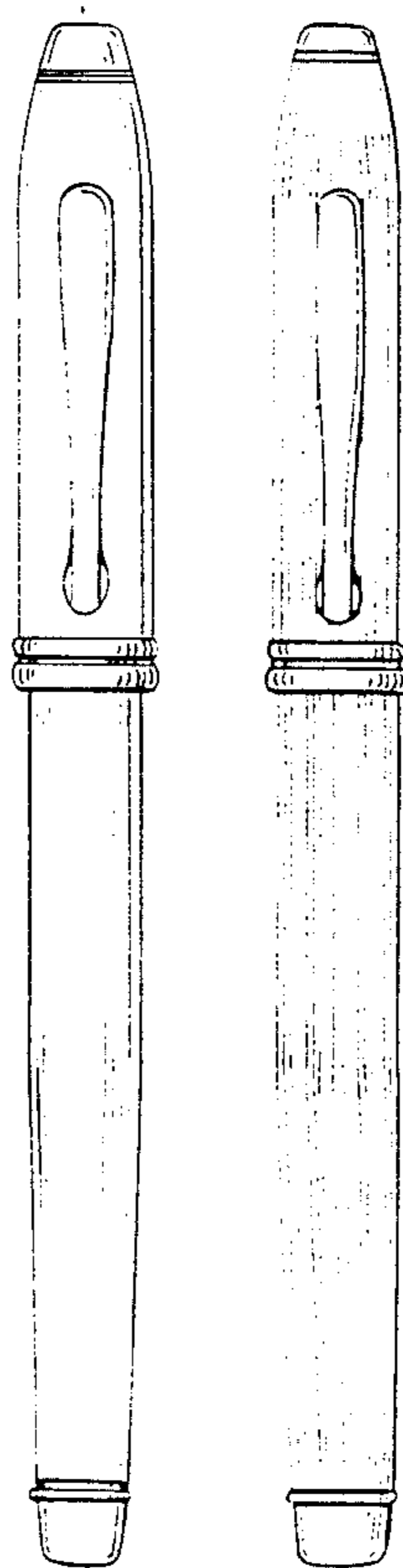

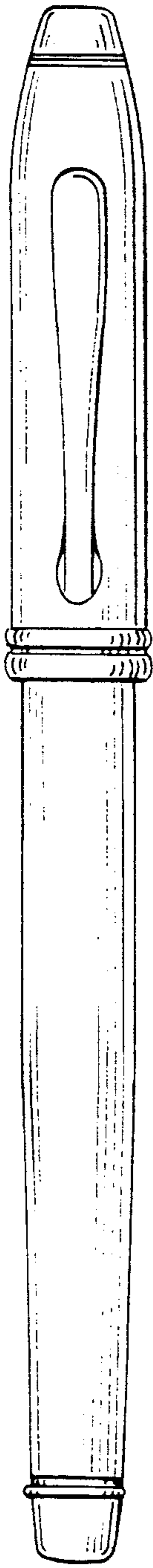

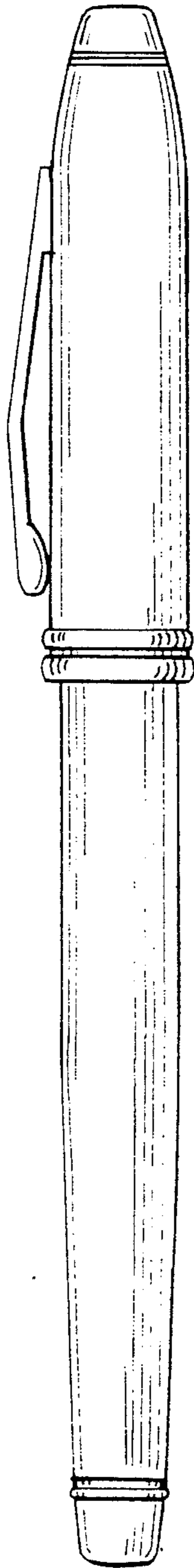

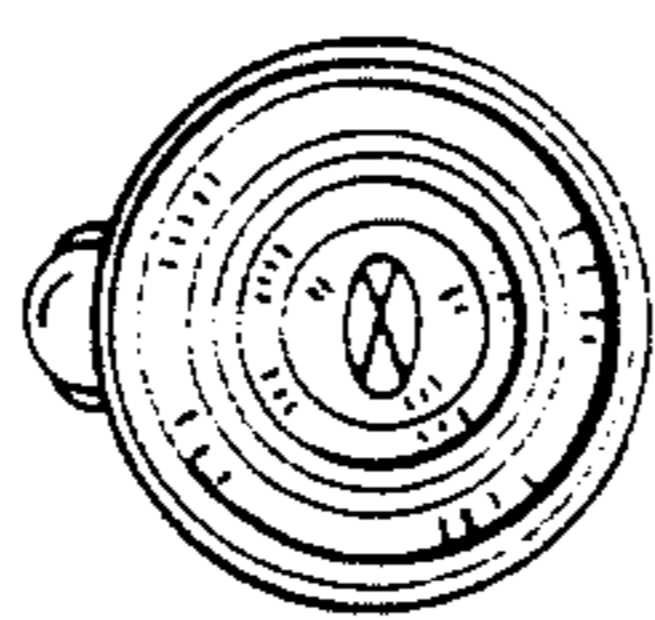
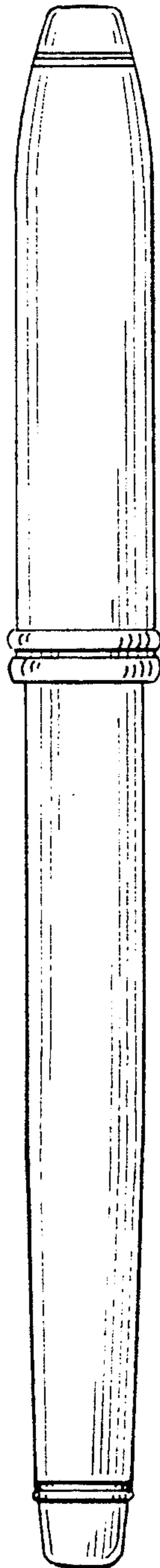

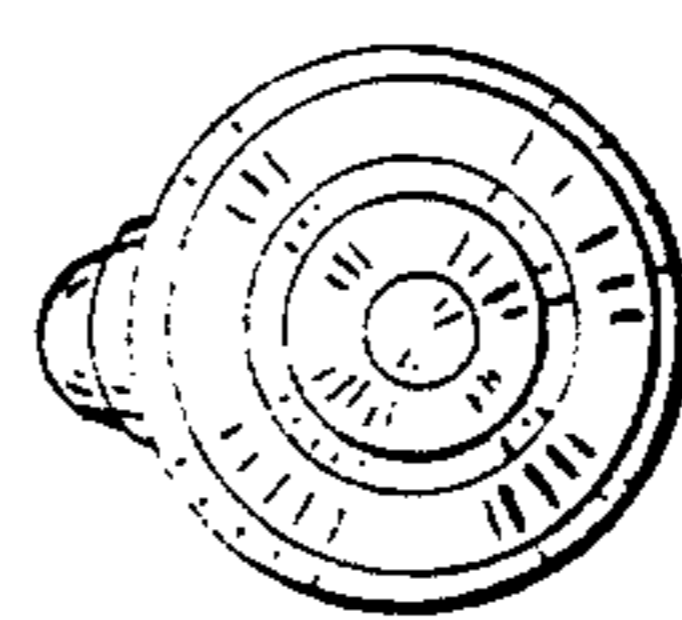

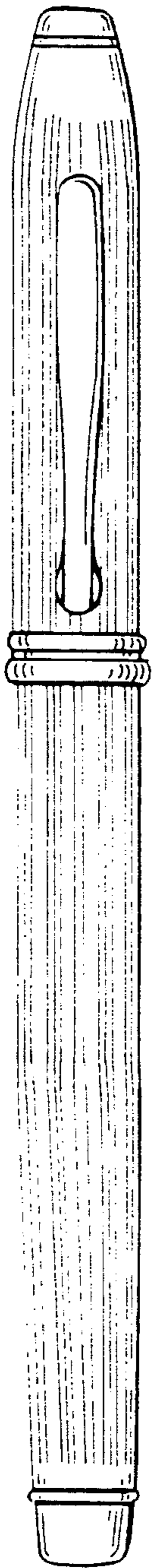

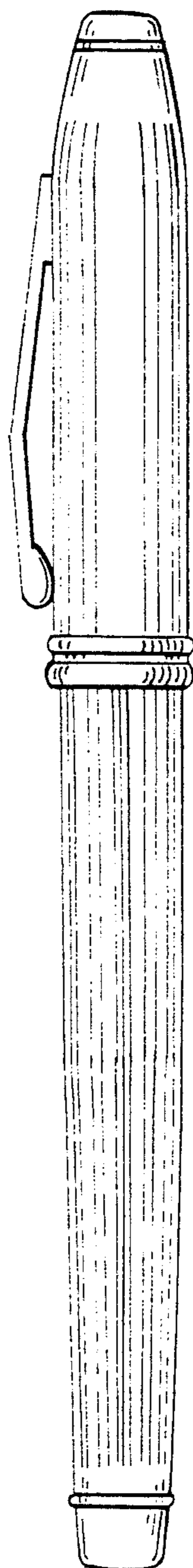

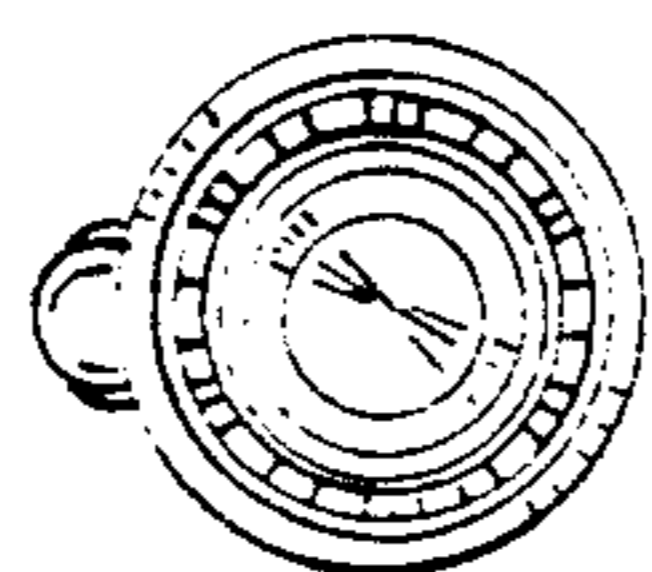
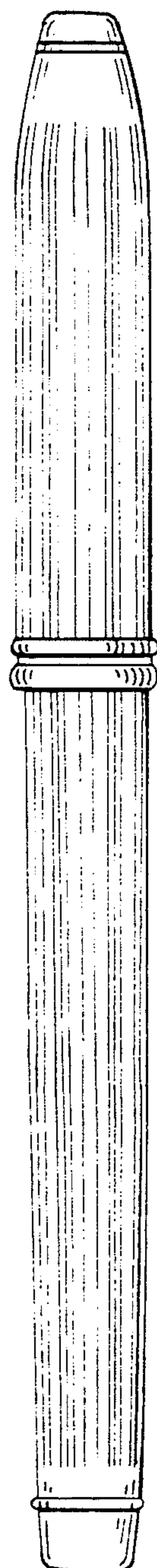

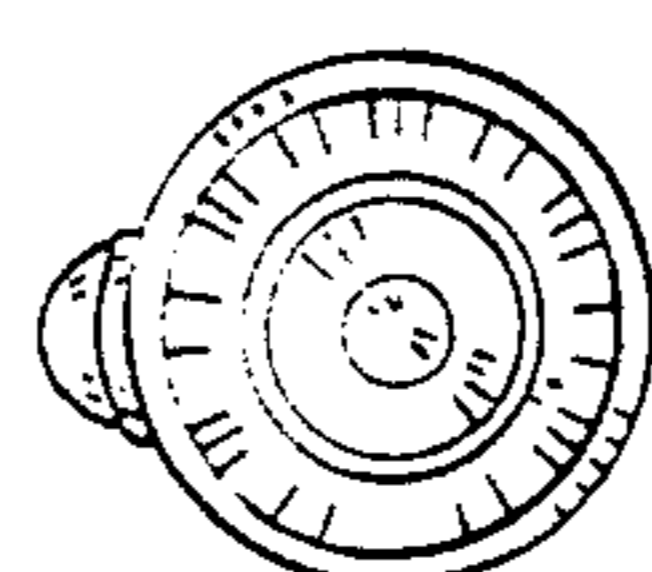

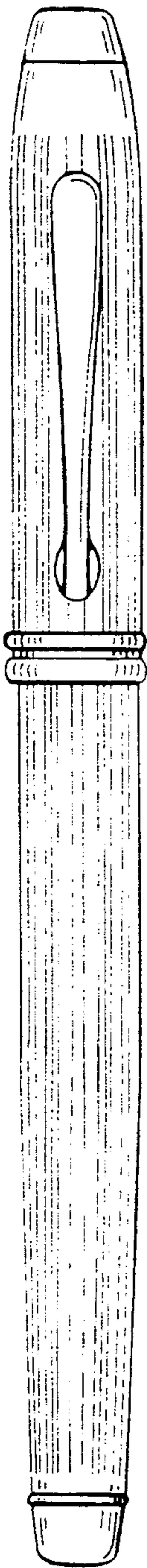

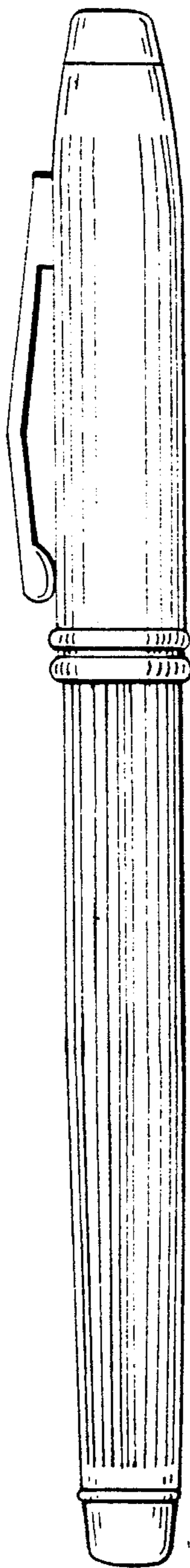

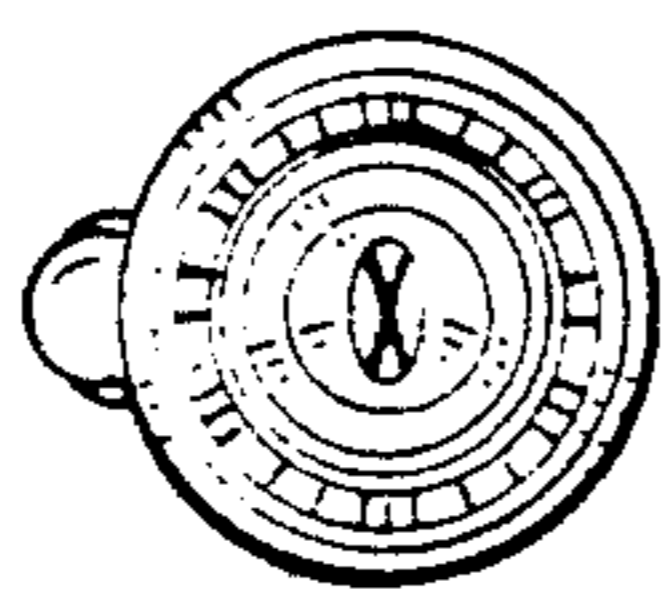

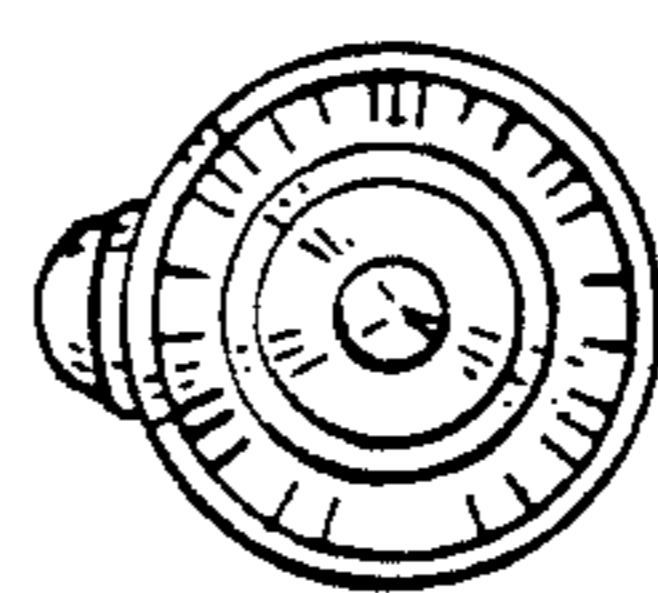
