[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a water closet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a water closet showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a second embodiment thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 5, the right side being a mirror image of the left side;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 5.











