FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

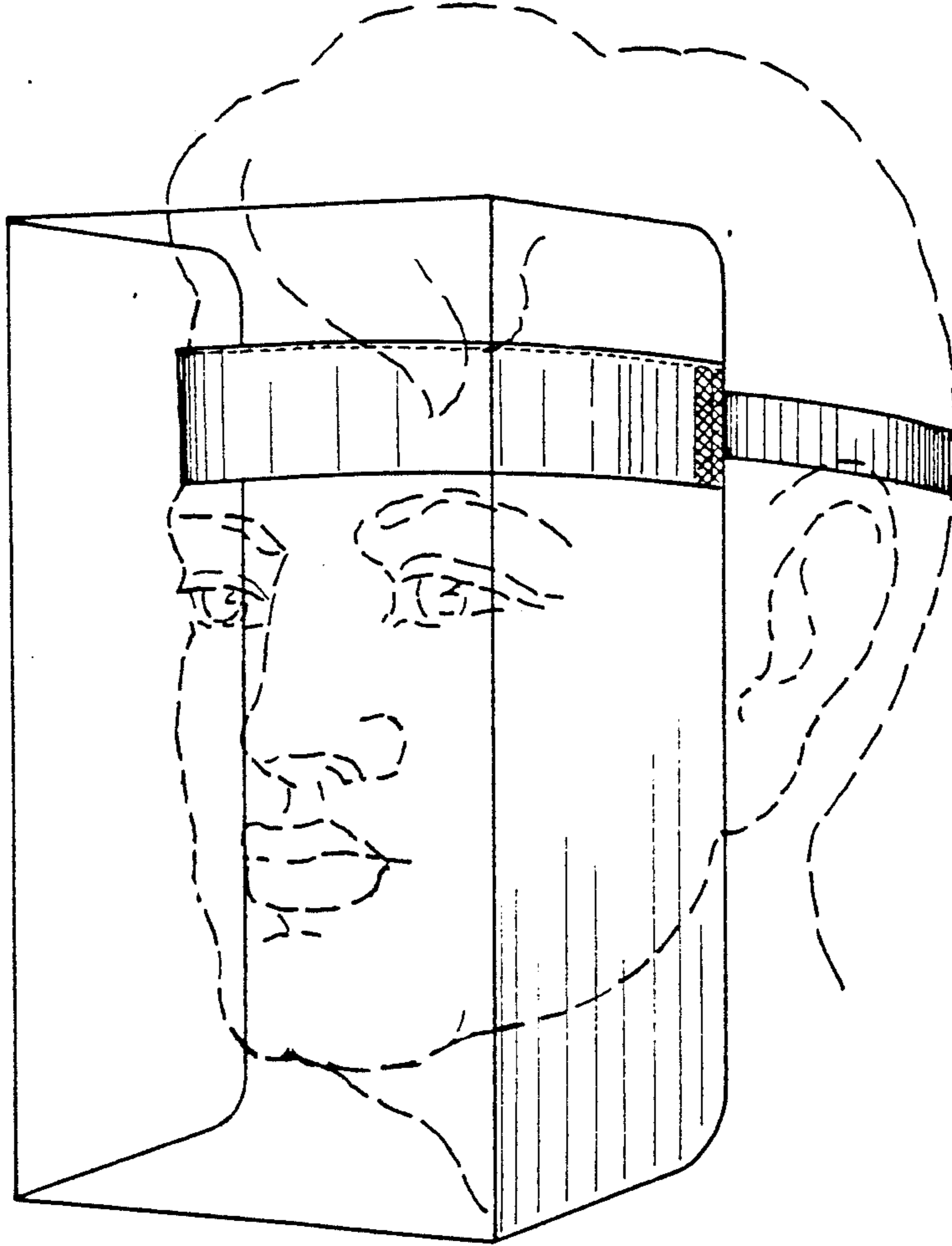
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

The broken lines on the band in FIGS. 1, 3, 4, 6 and 7 are understood to represent conventional stitching.



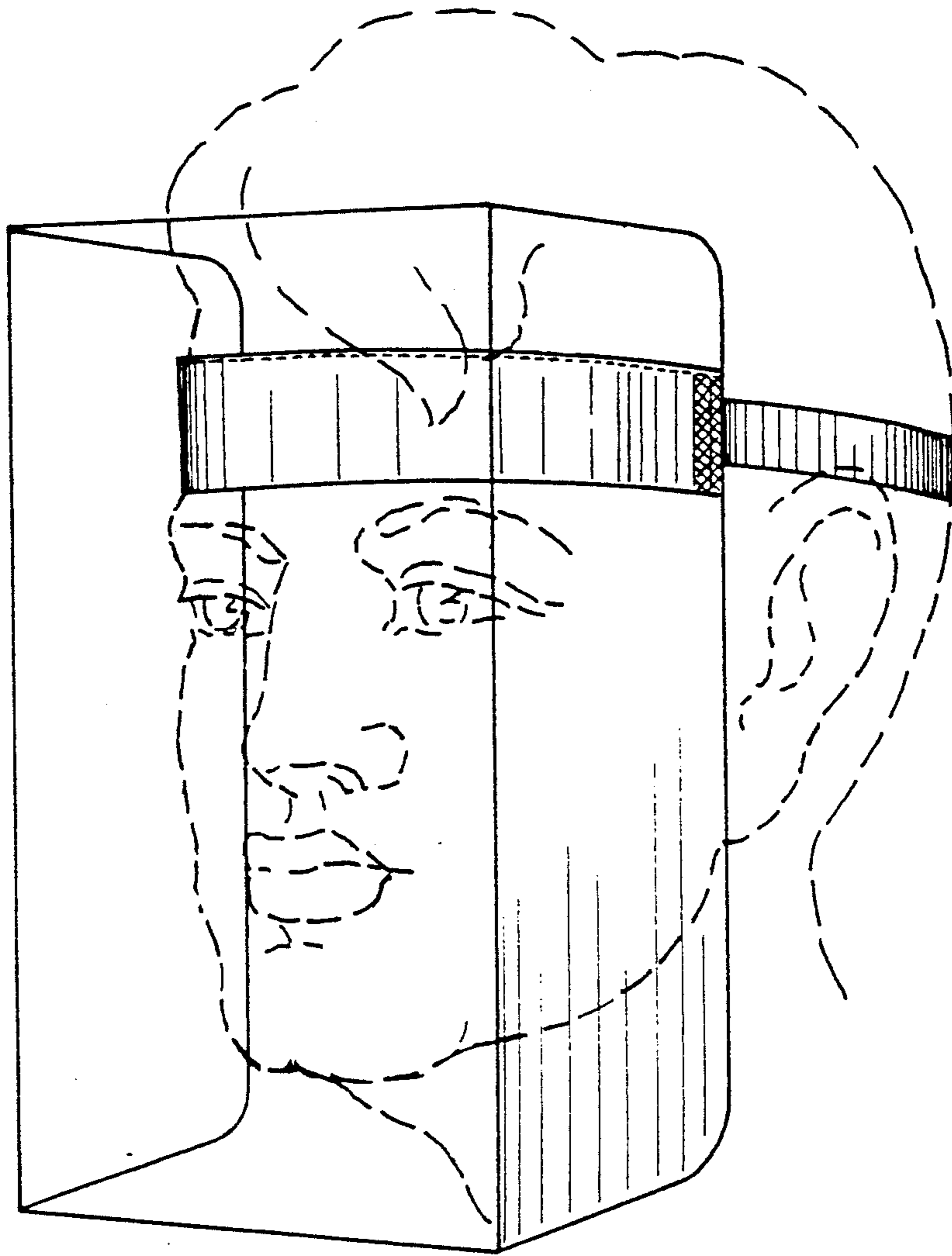

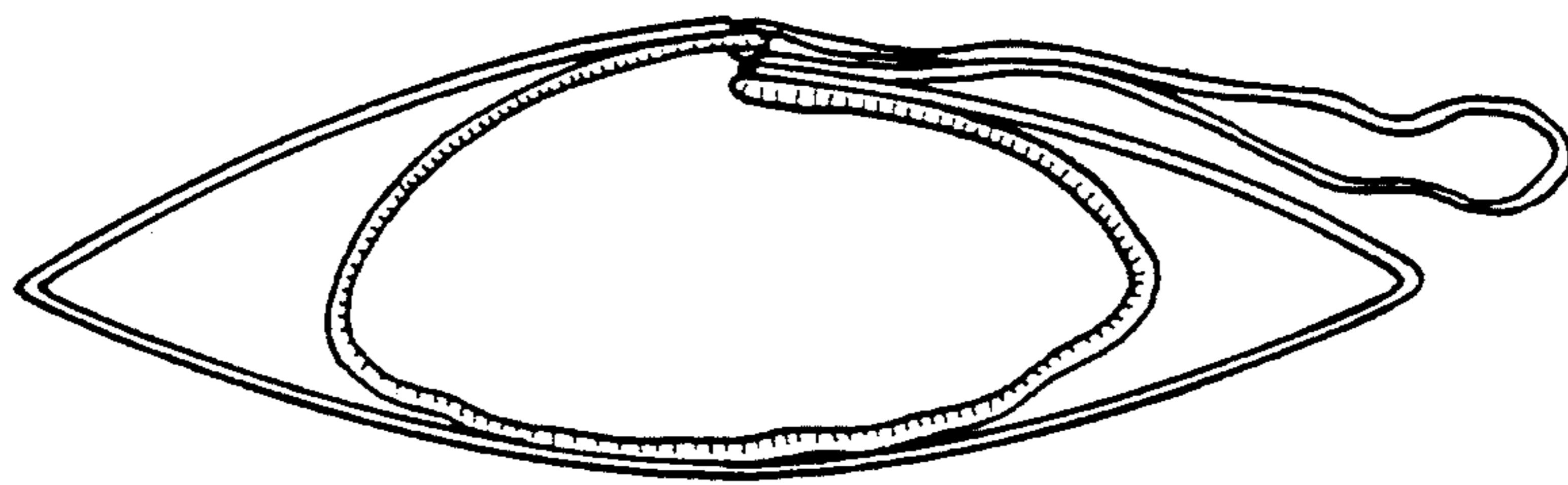

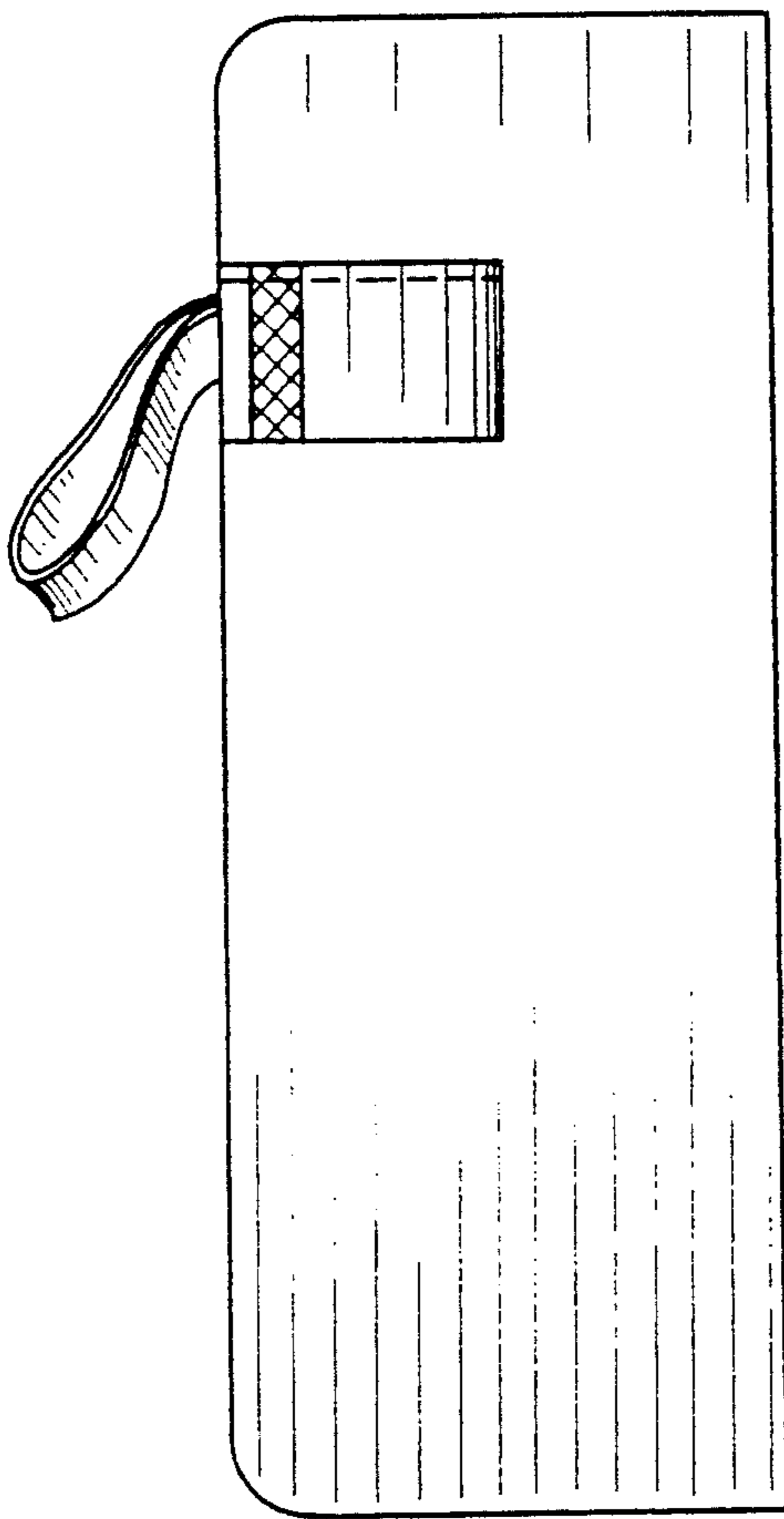

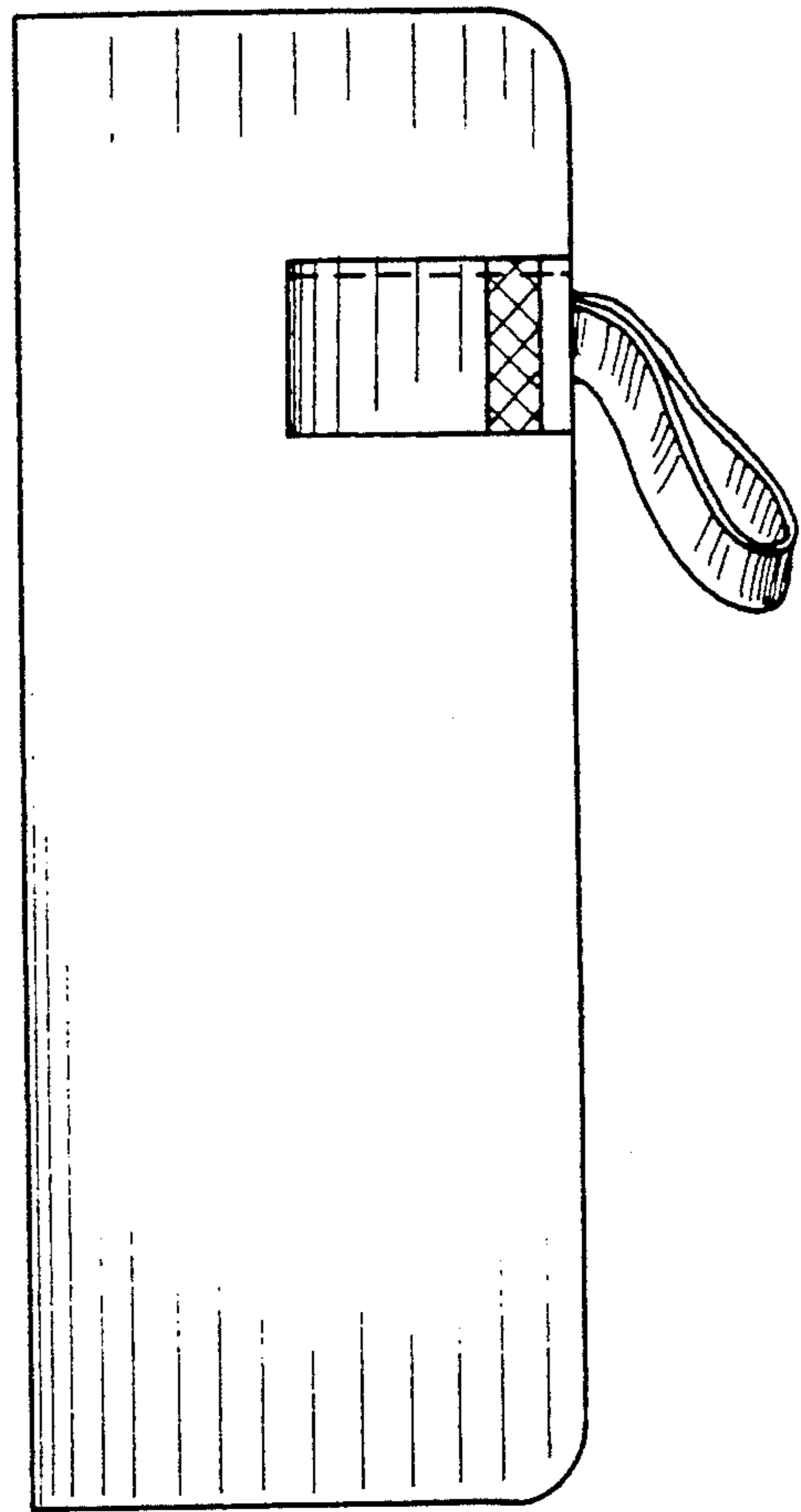

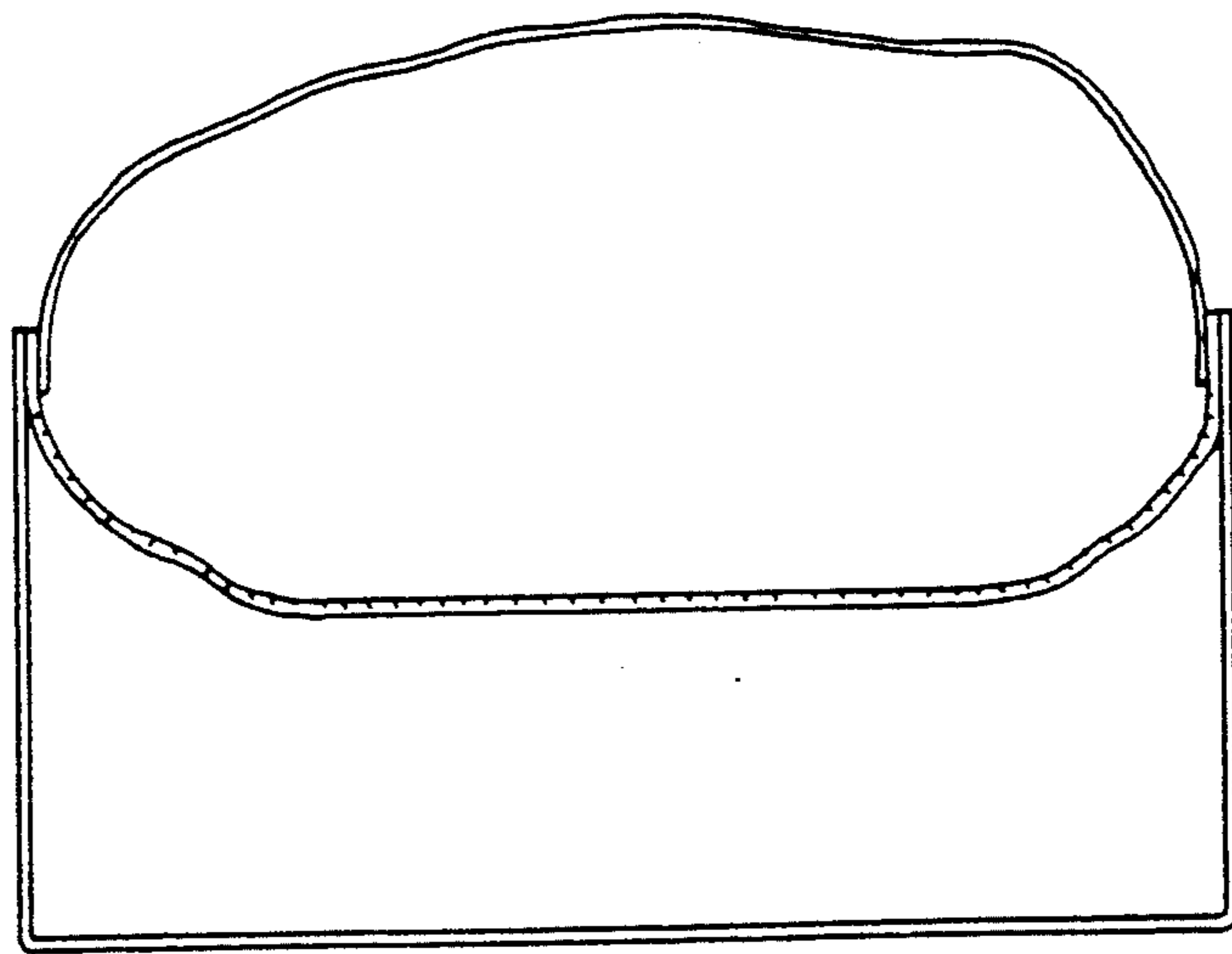

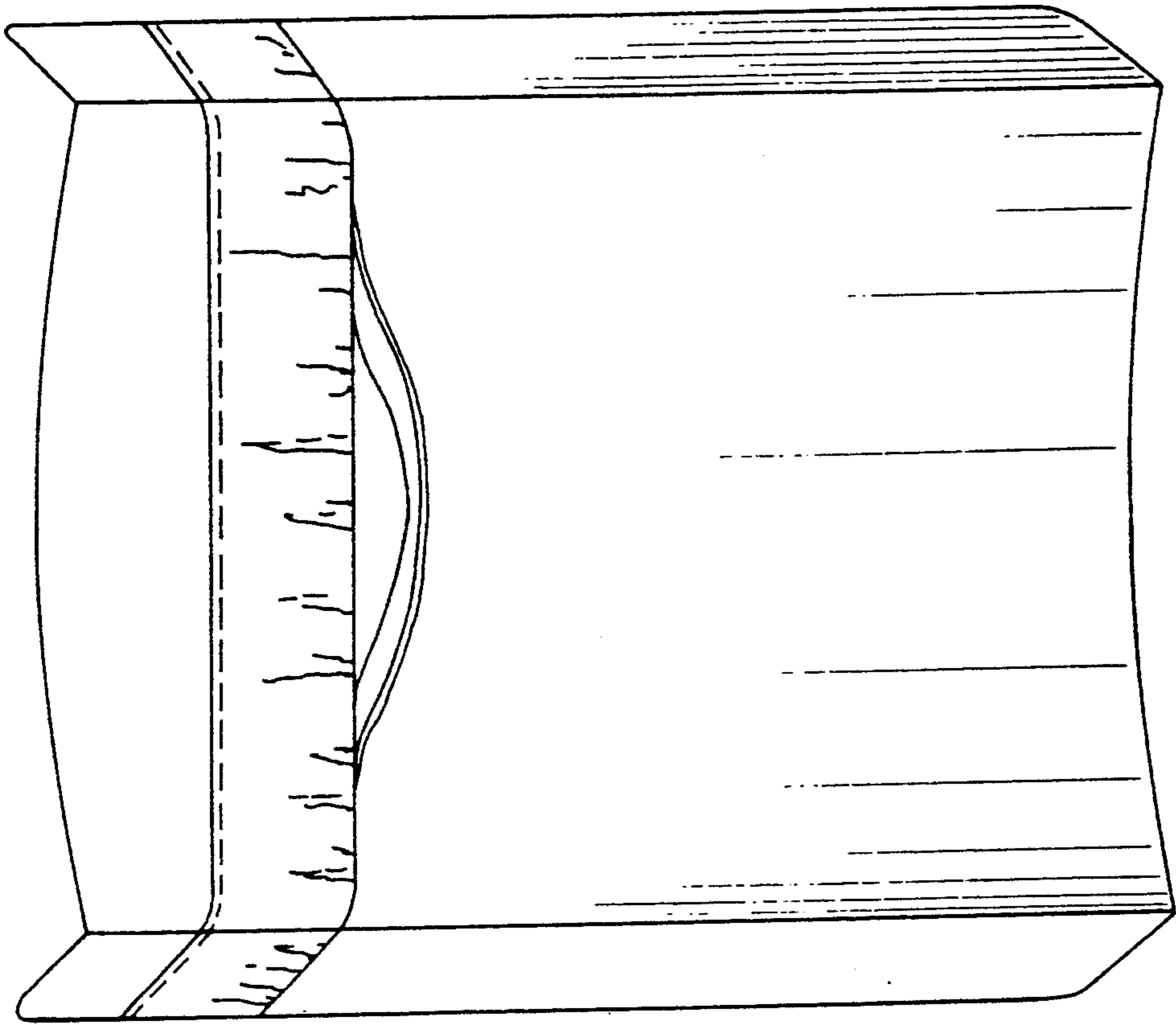

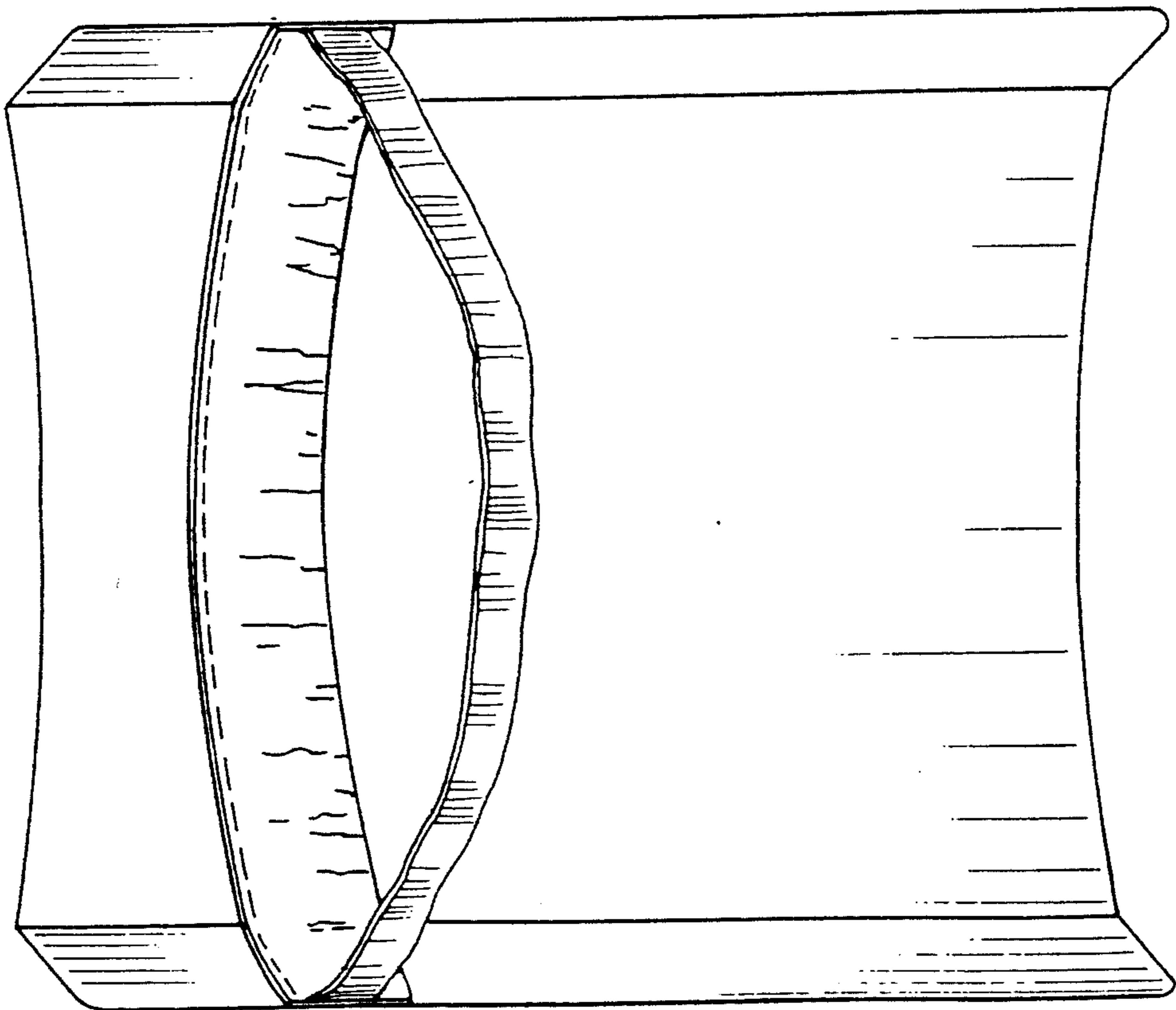
