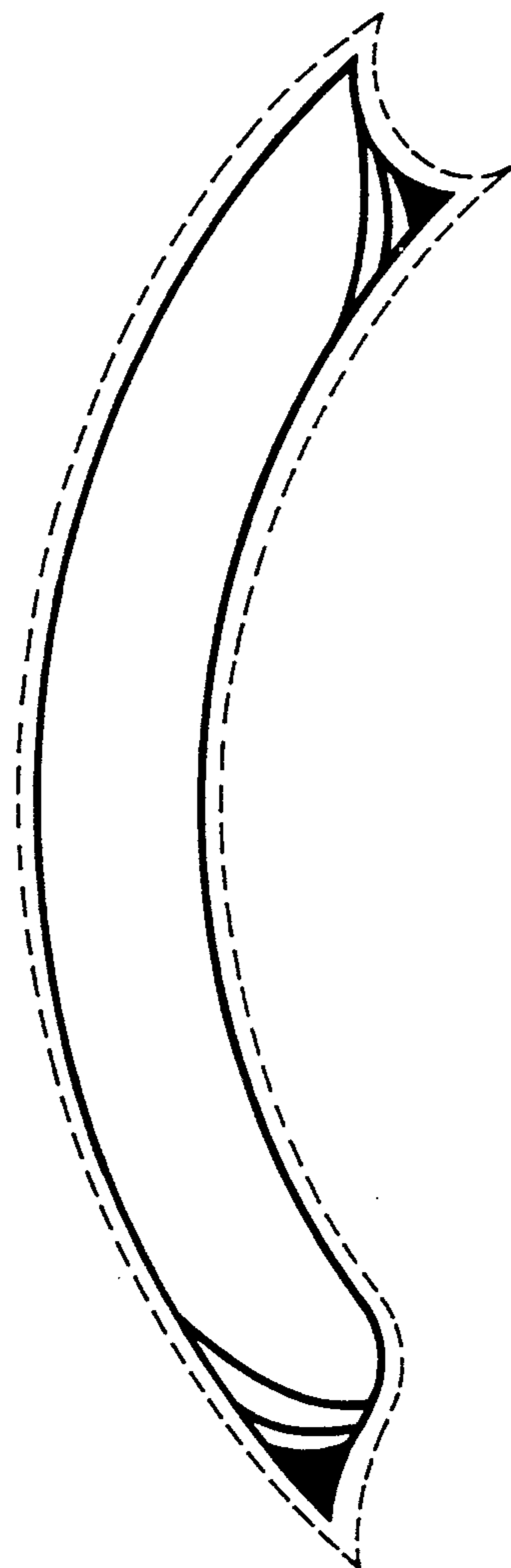

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for decalcomania for china dinnerware, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of my new design for decalcomania for china dinnerware, the fragmentary broken line is illustrative of environmental structure only and forms no part of the design. The decalcomania is of no substantial thickness.



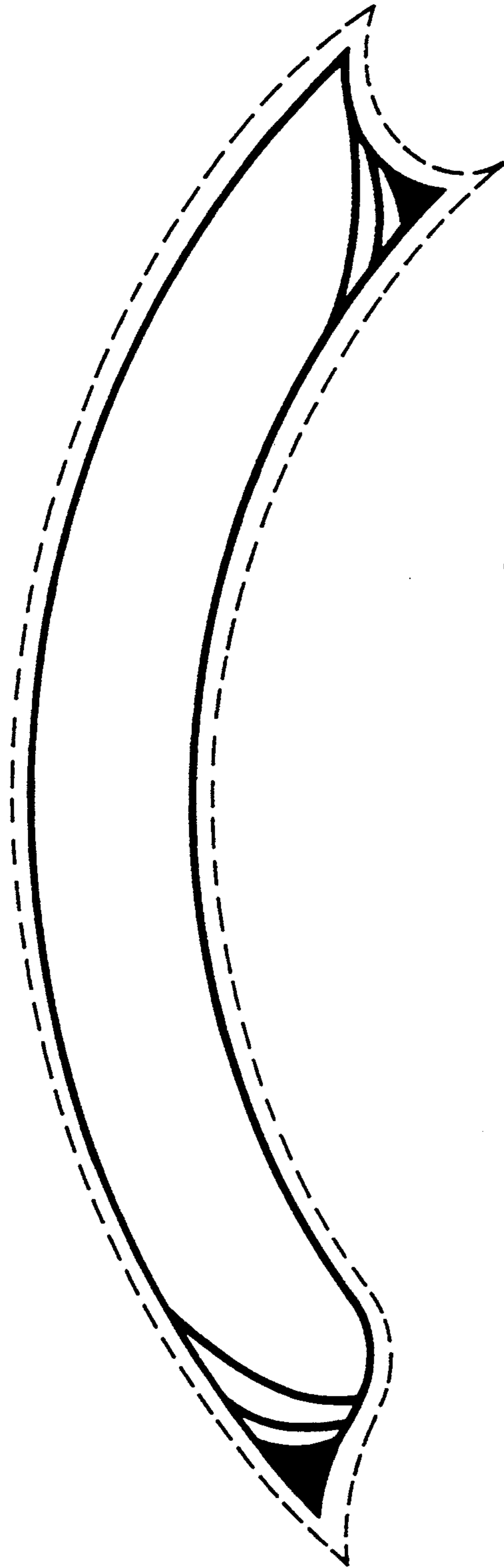


FIG. 1
