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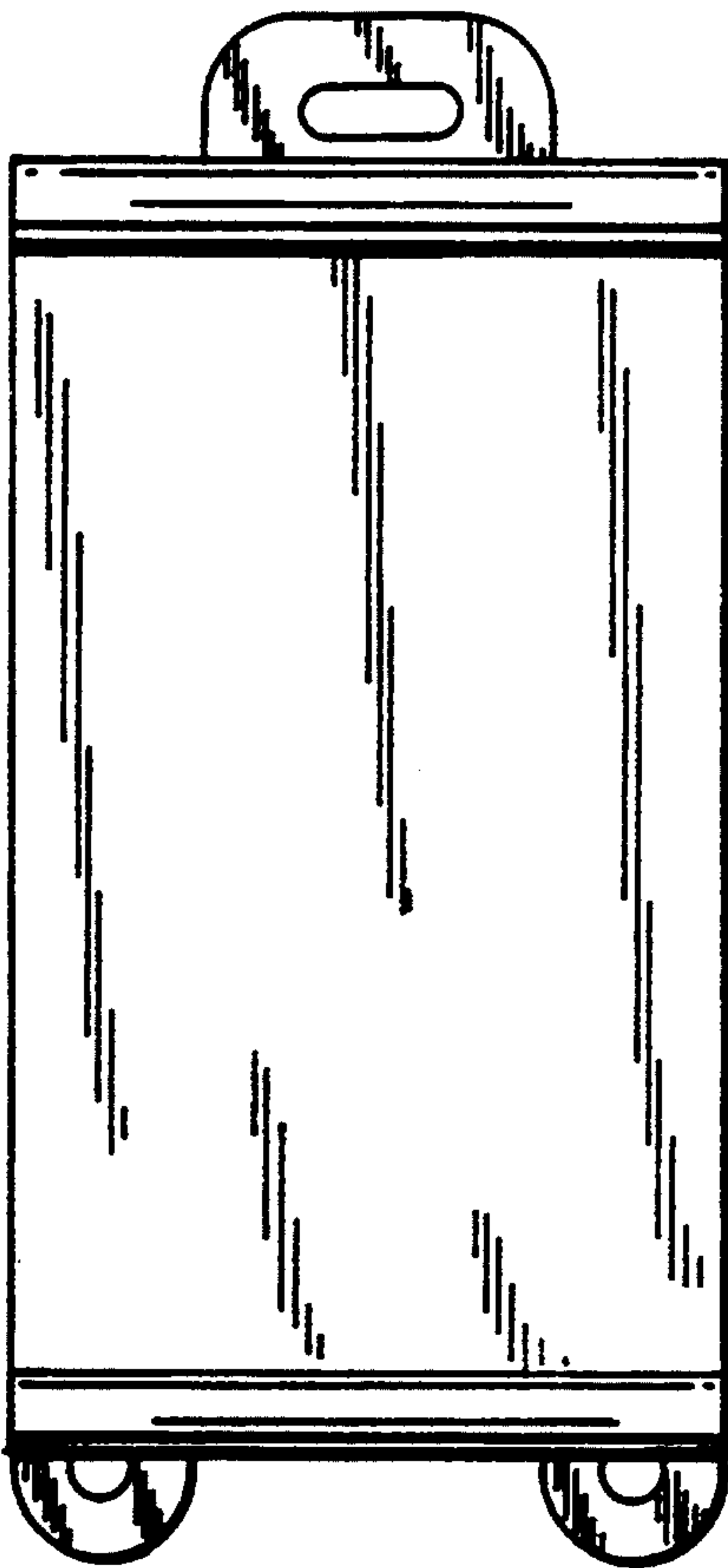
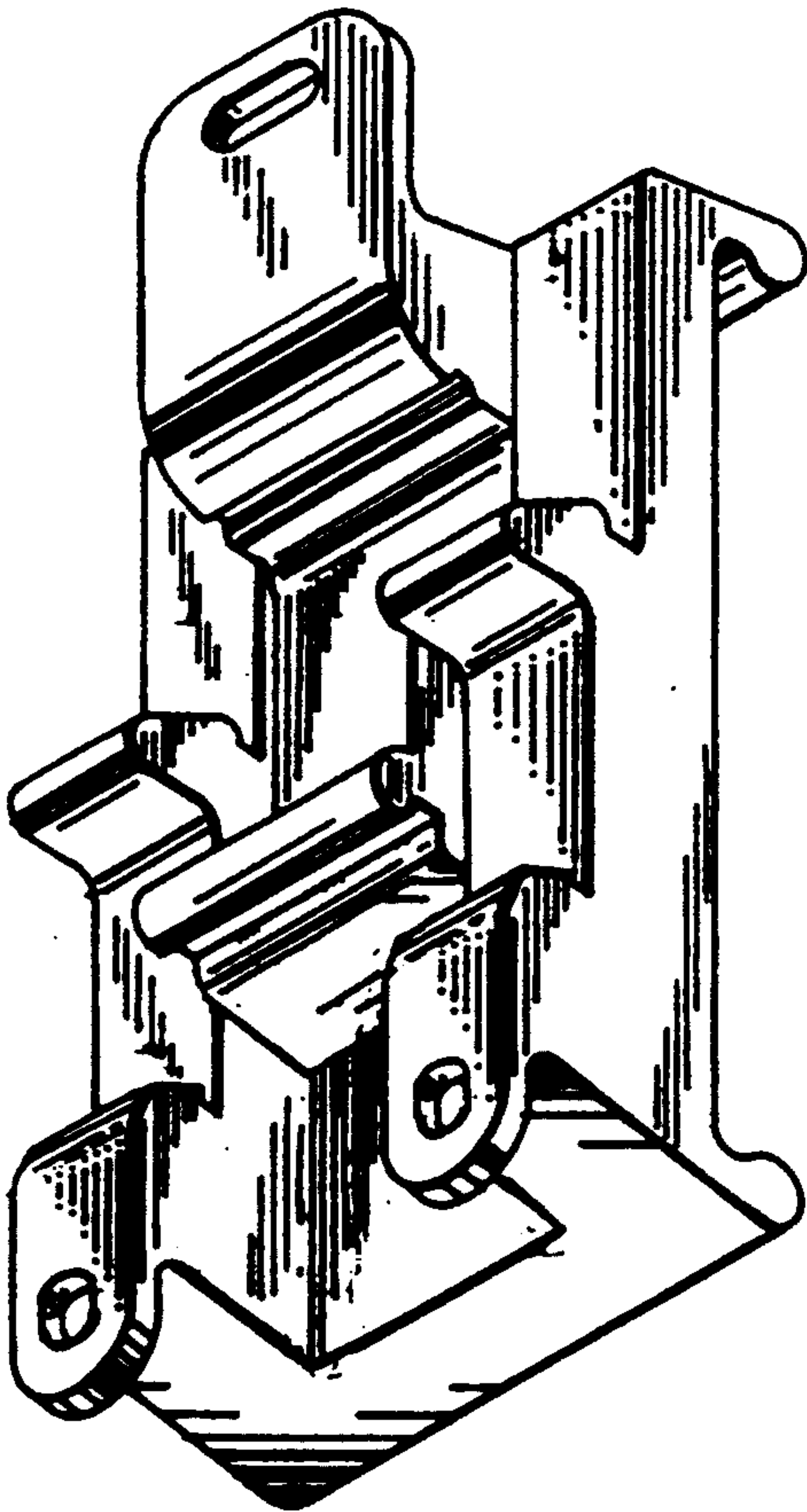

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the bottom, rear and left side of a clip for mounting electrical equipment on a rail according to our new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



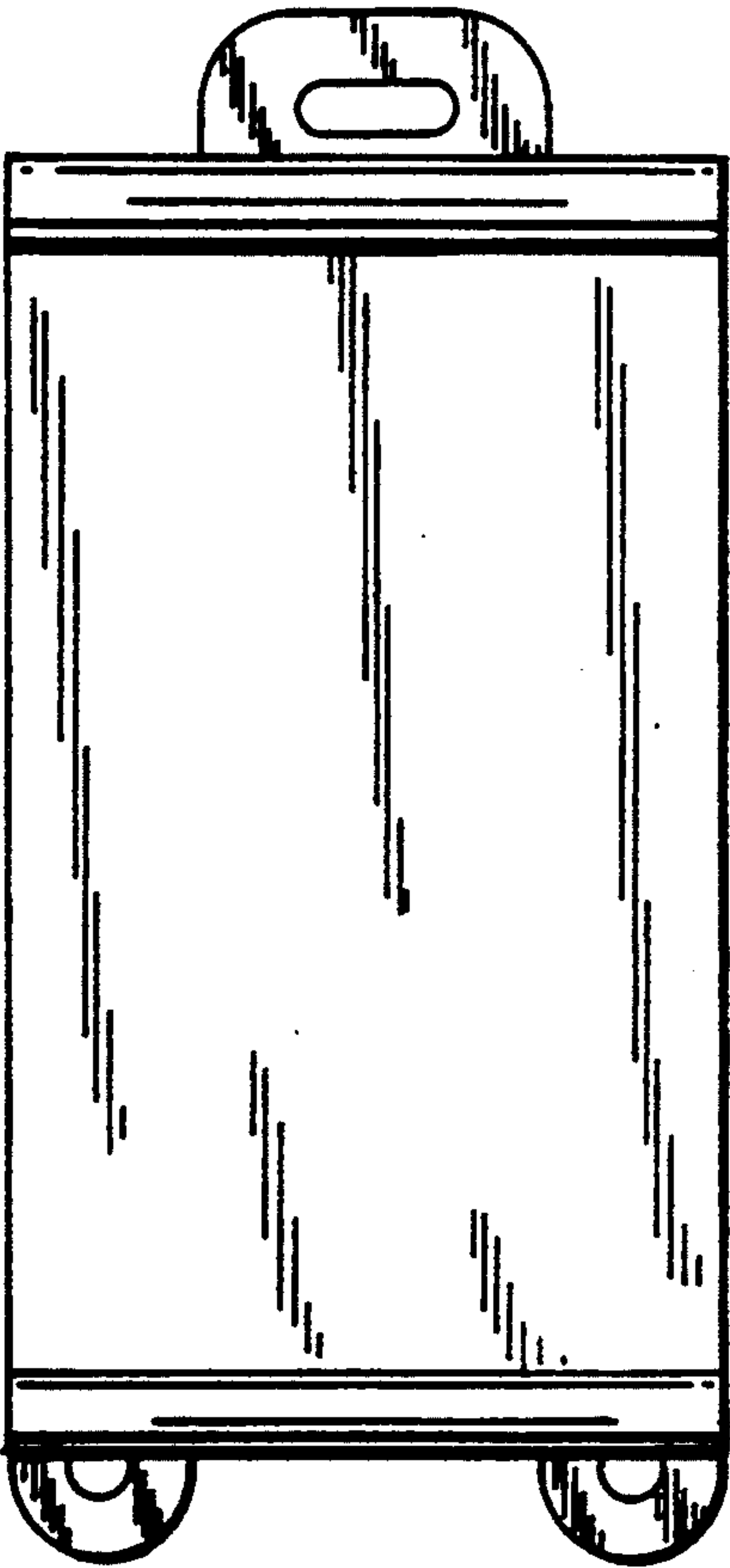
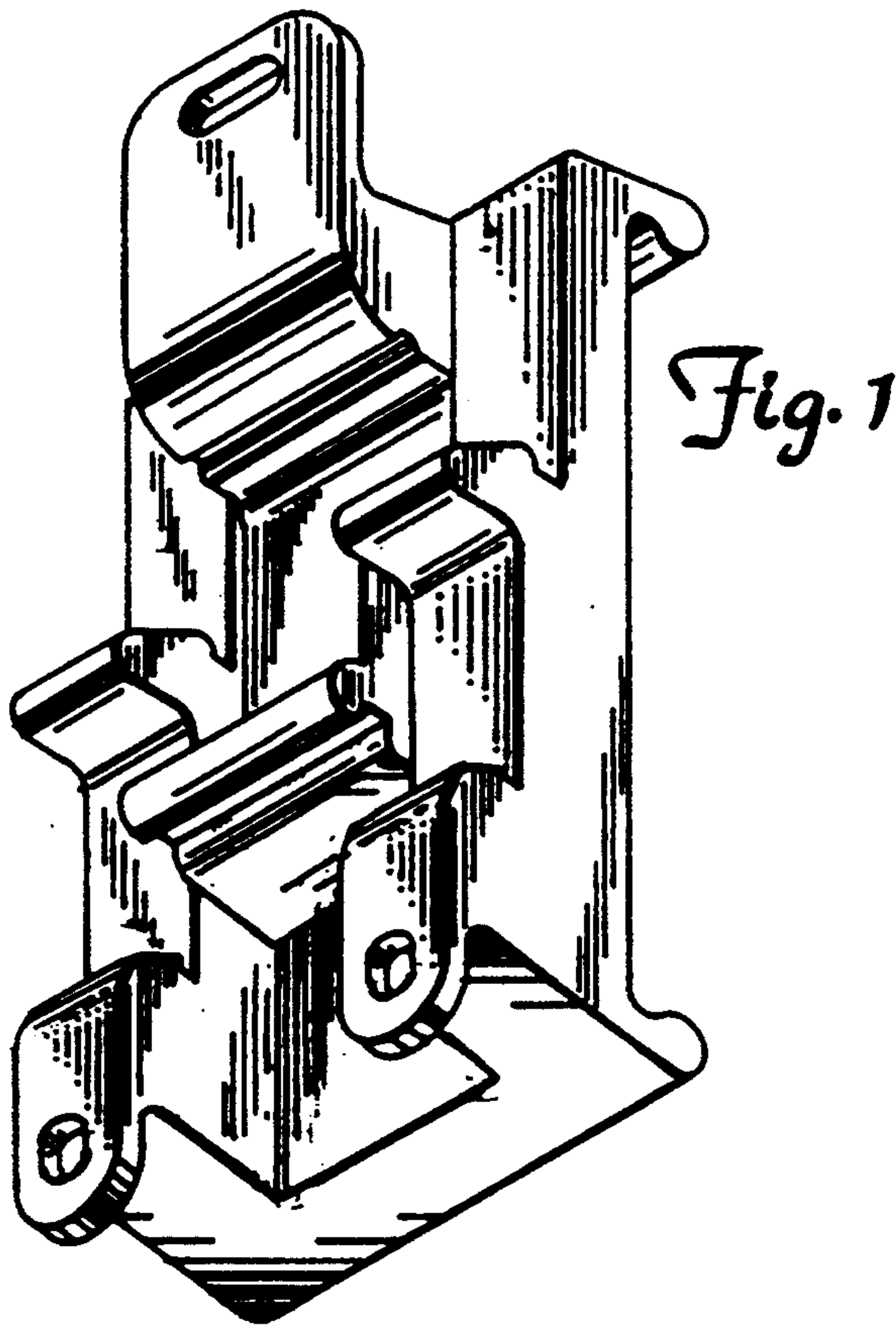
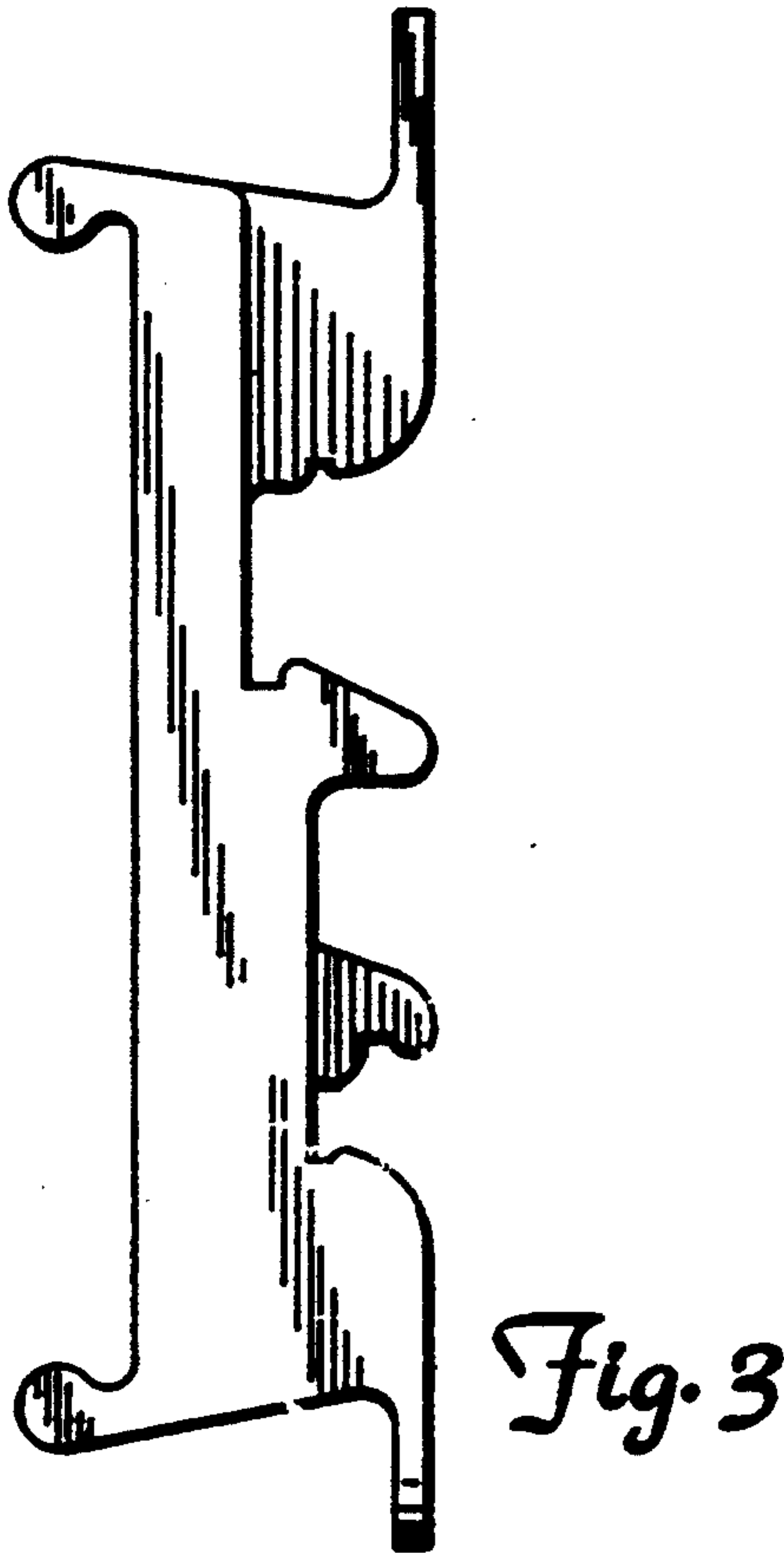

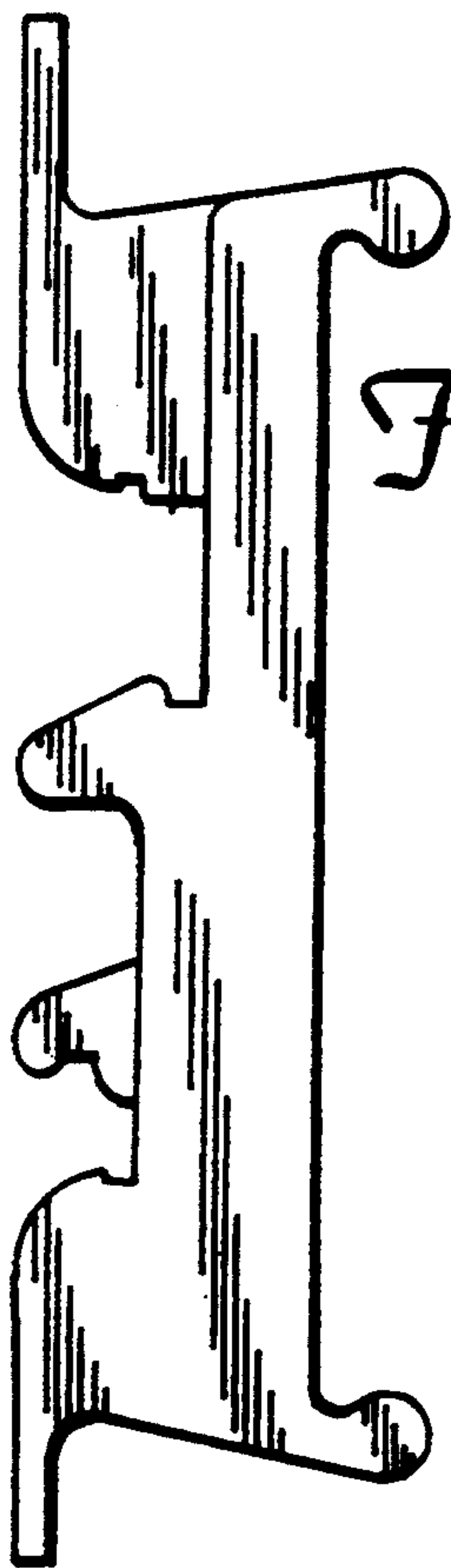

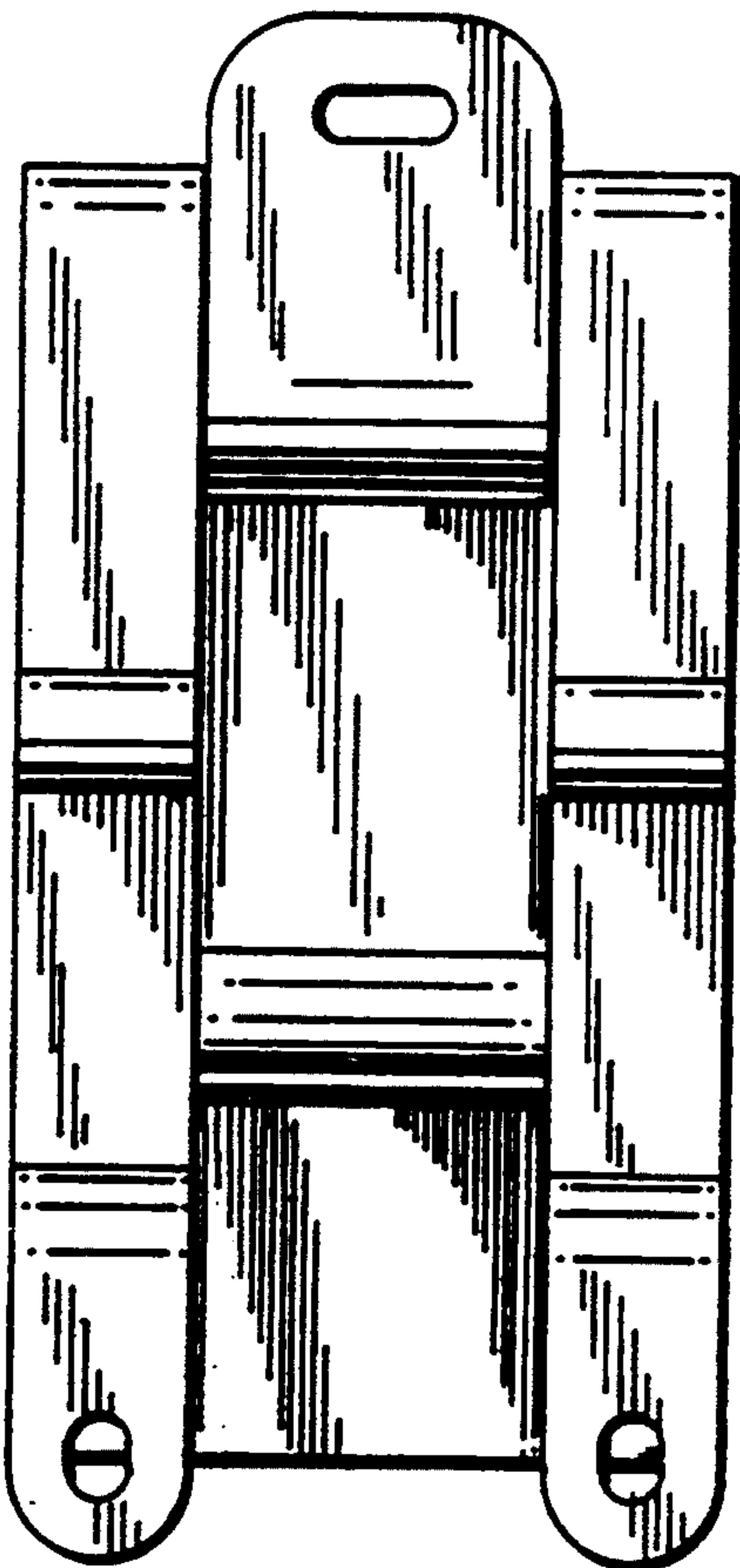

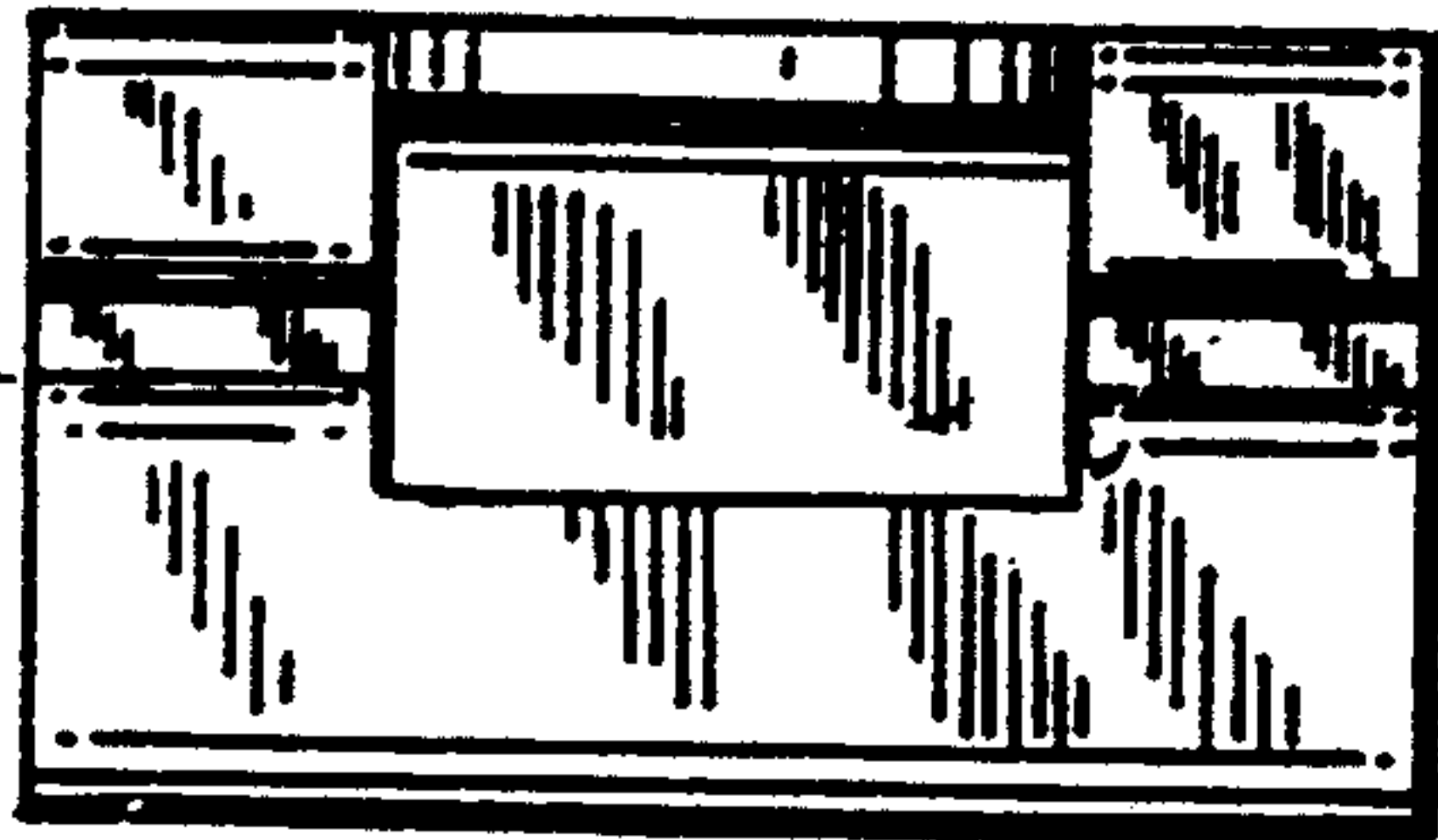
