The ornamental design for a combined digital audio disc player, radio tuner and tape recorder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a combined digital audio player, radio tuner and tape recorder according to my present design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

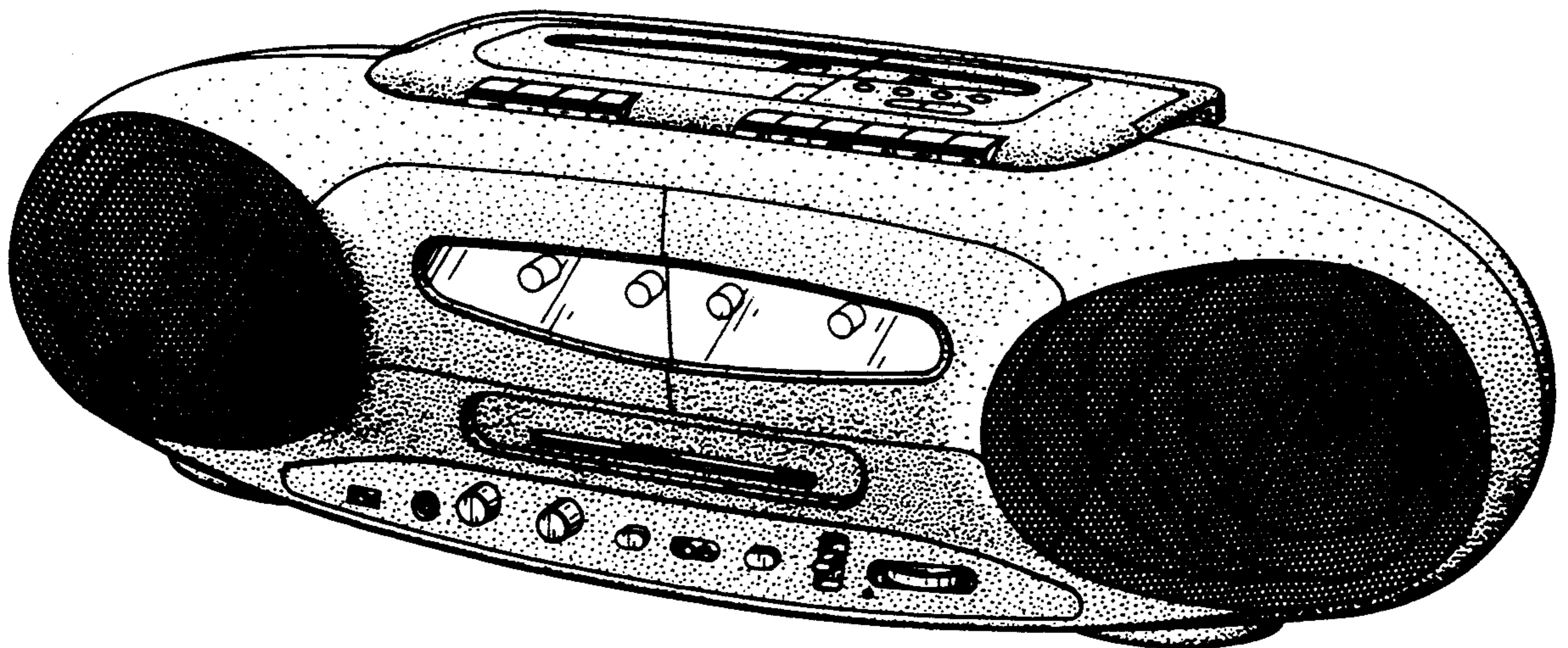
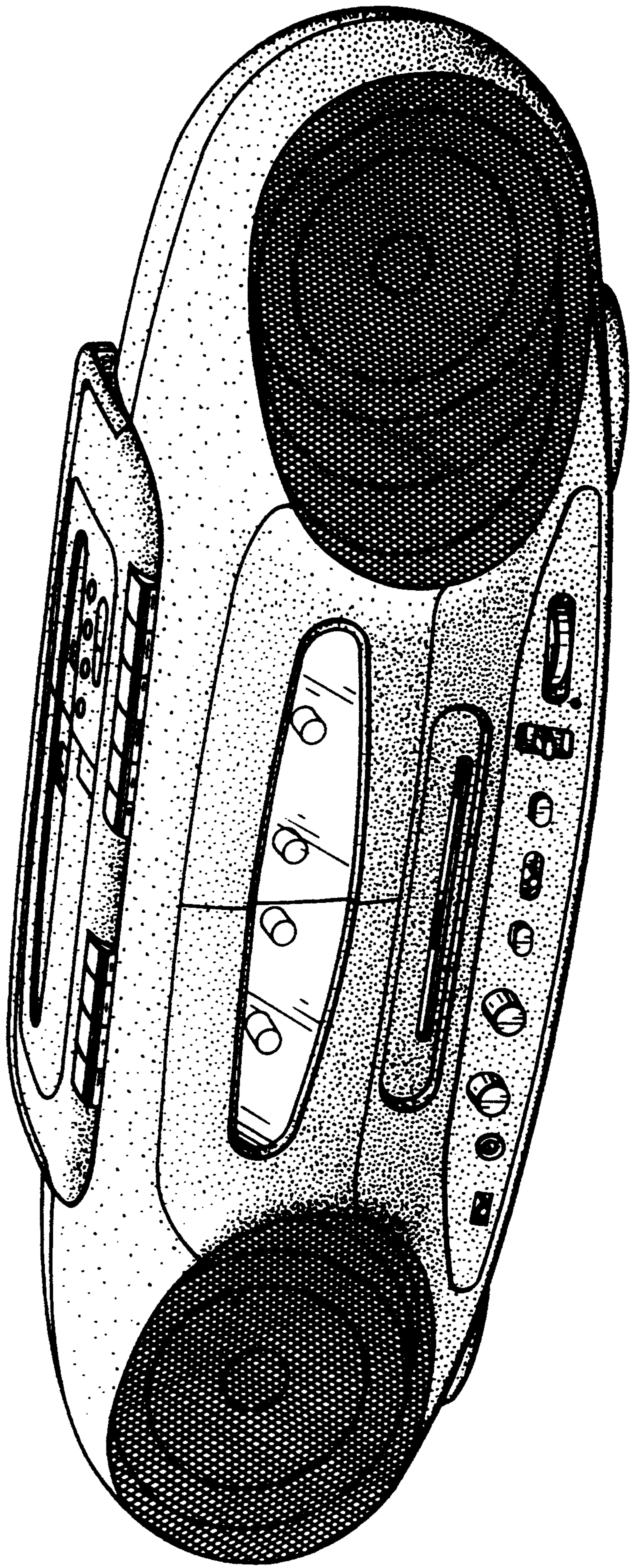

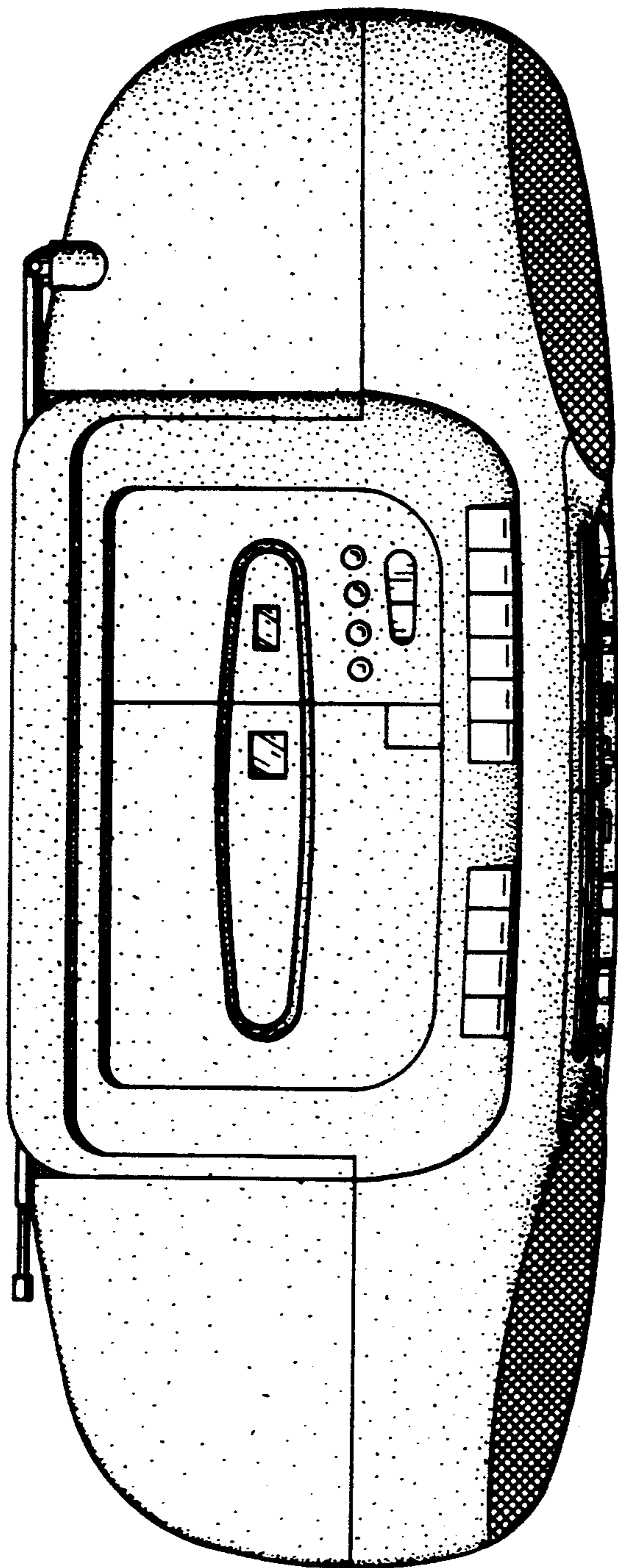

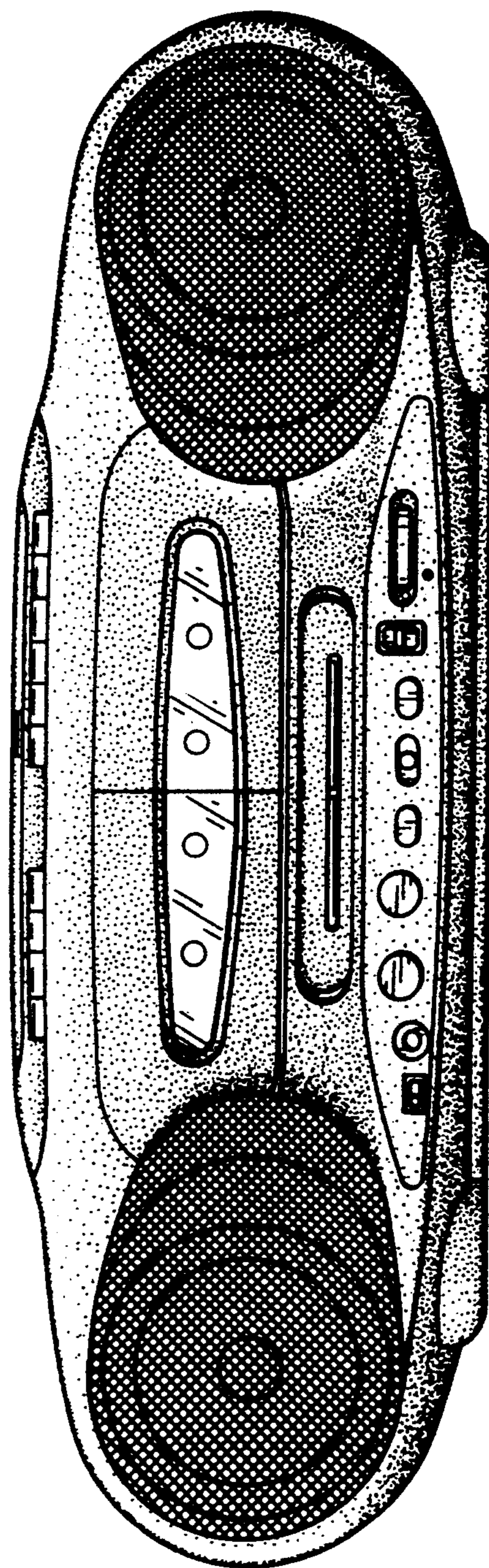

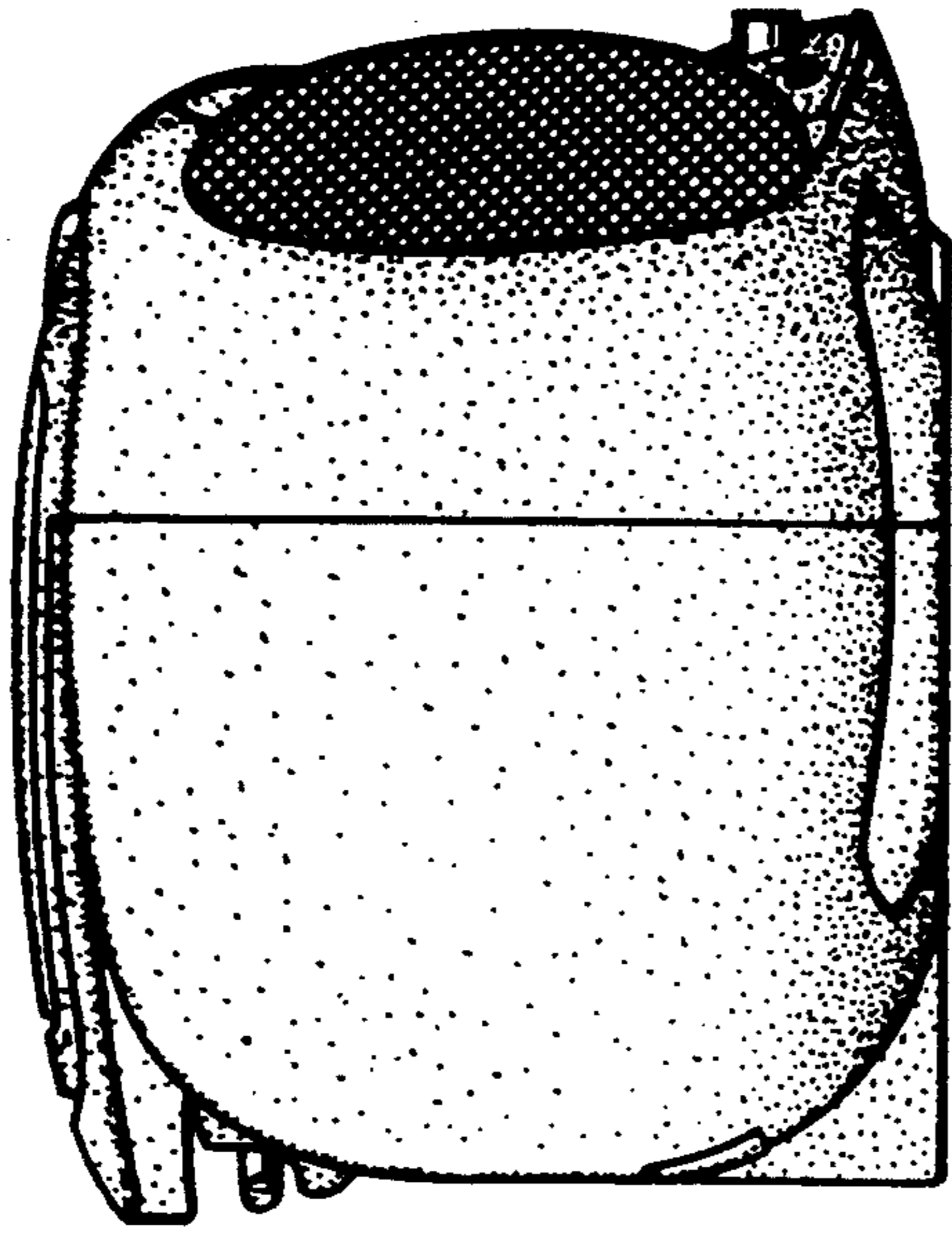

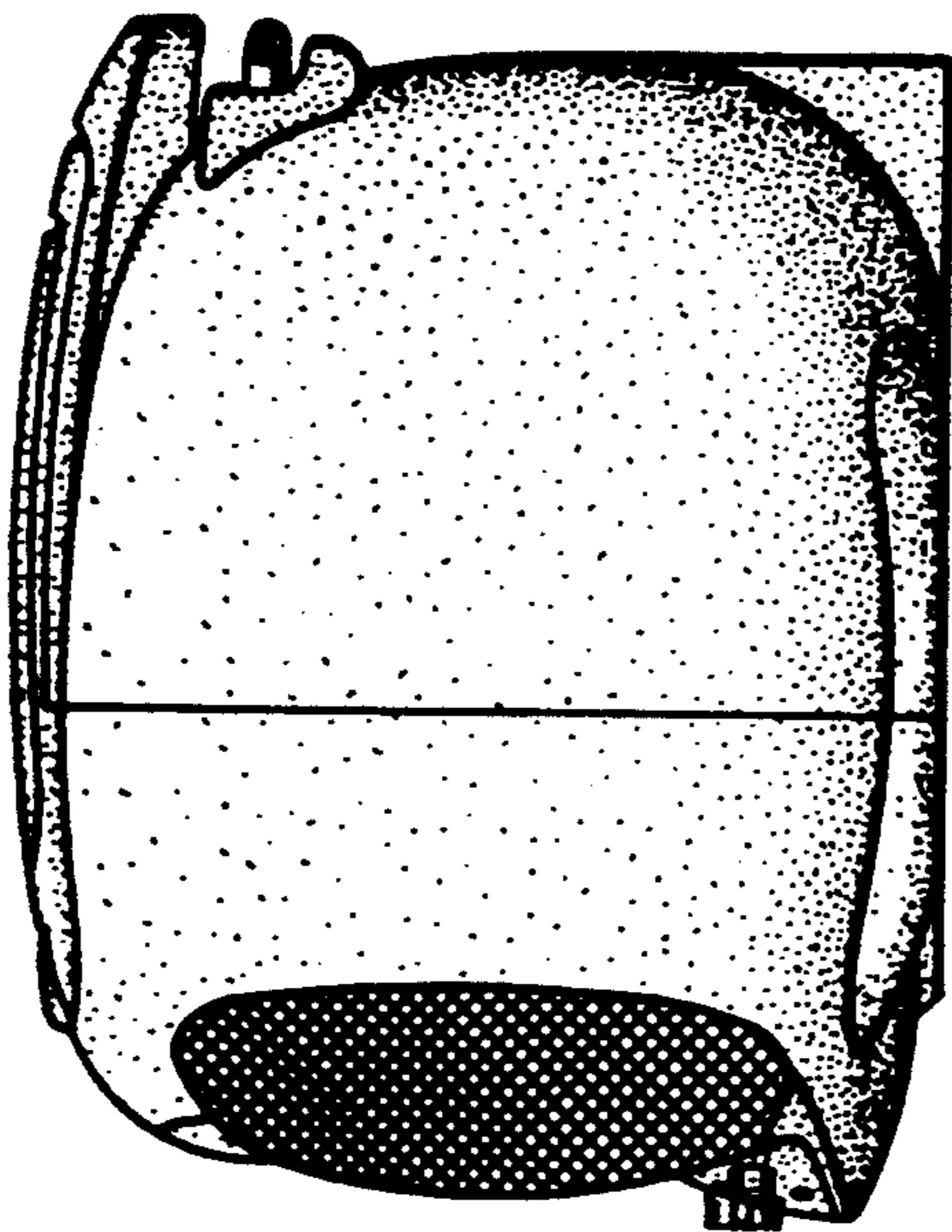

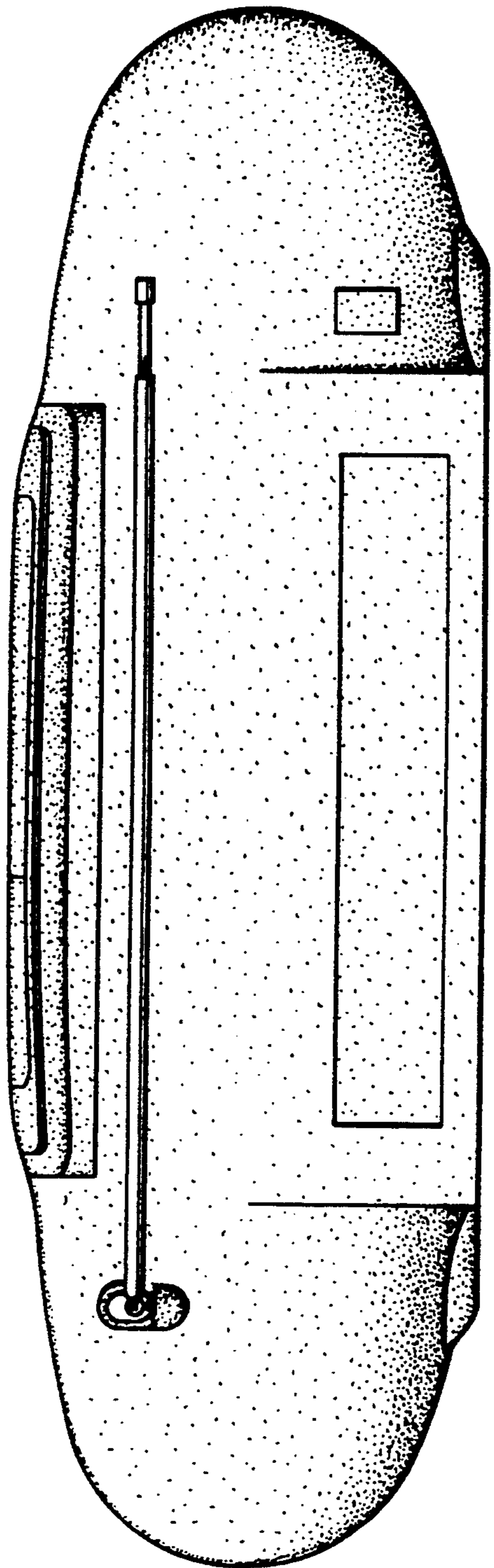

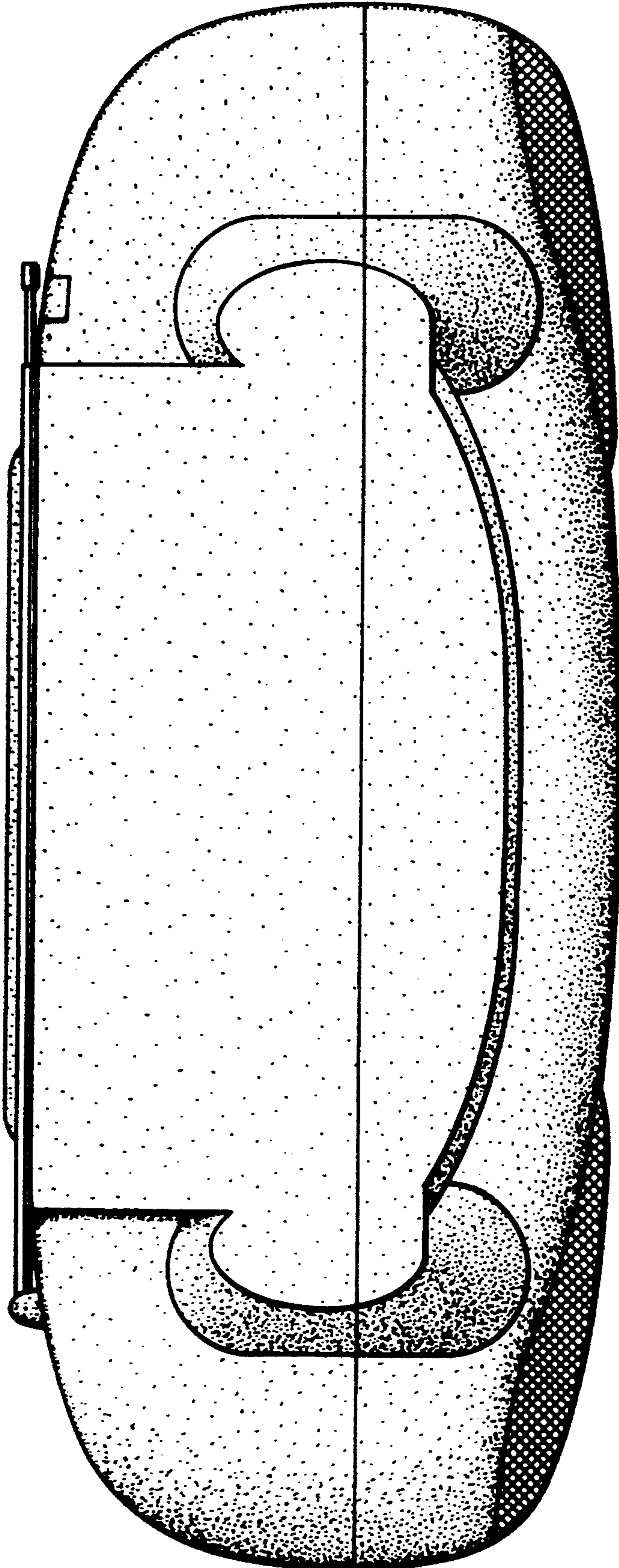
