FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

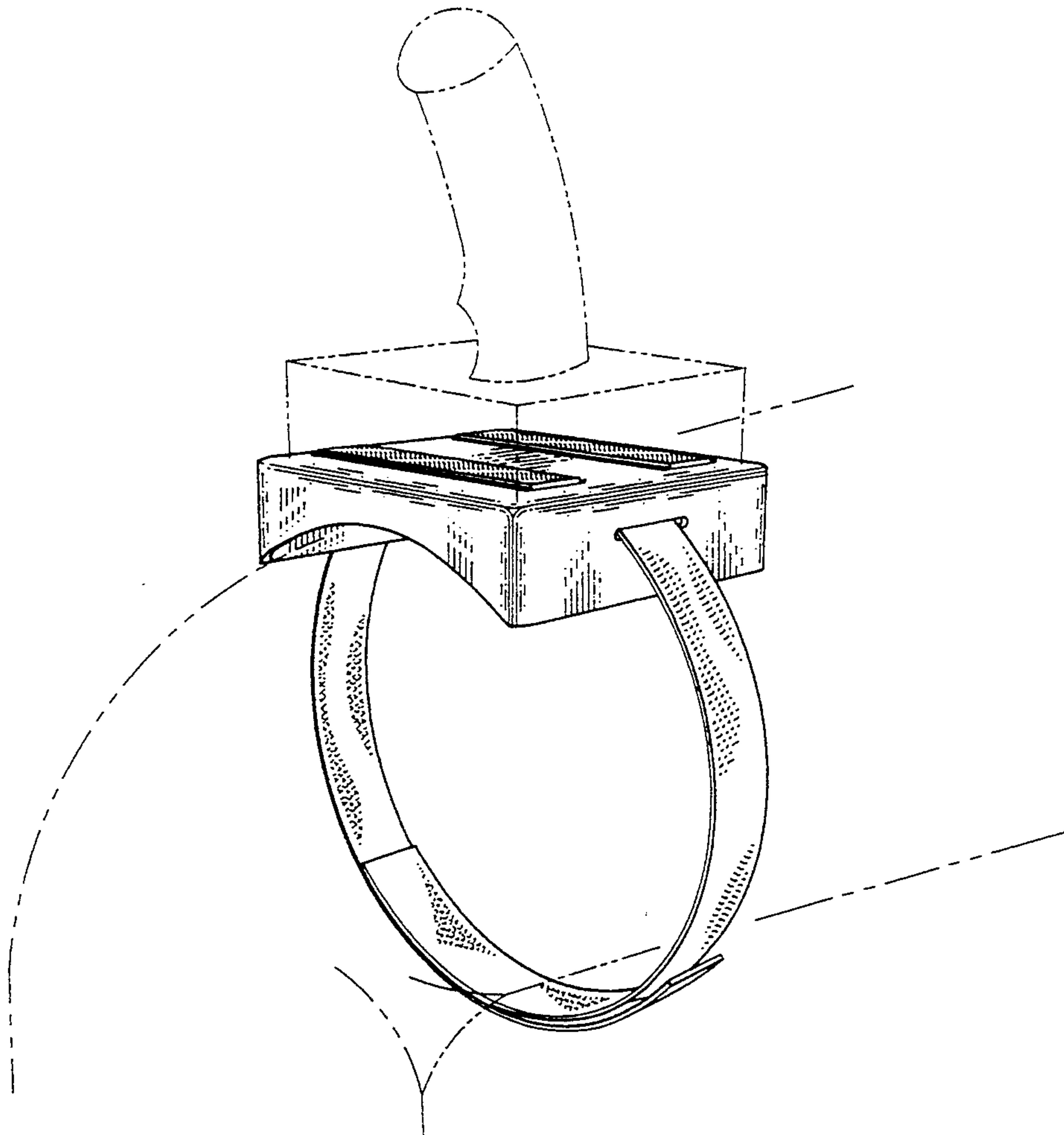
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof with the strap shown in a closed position;

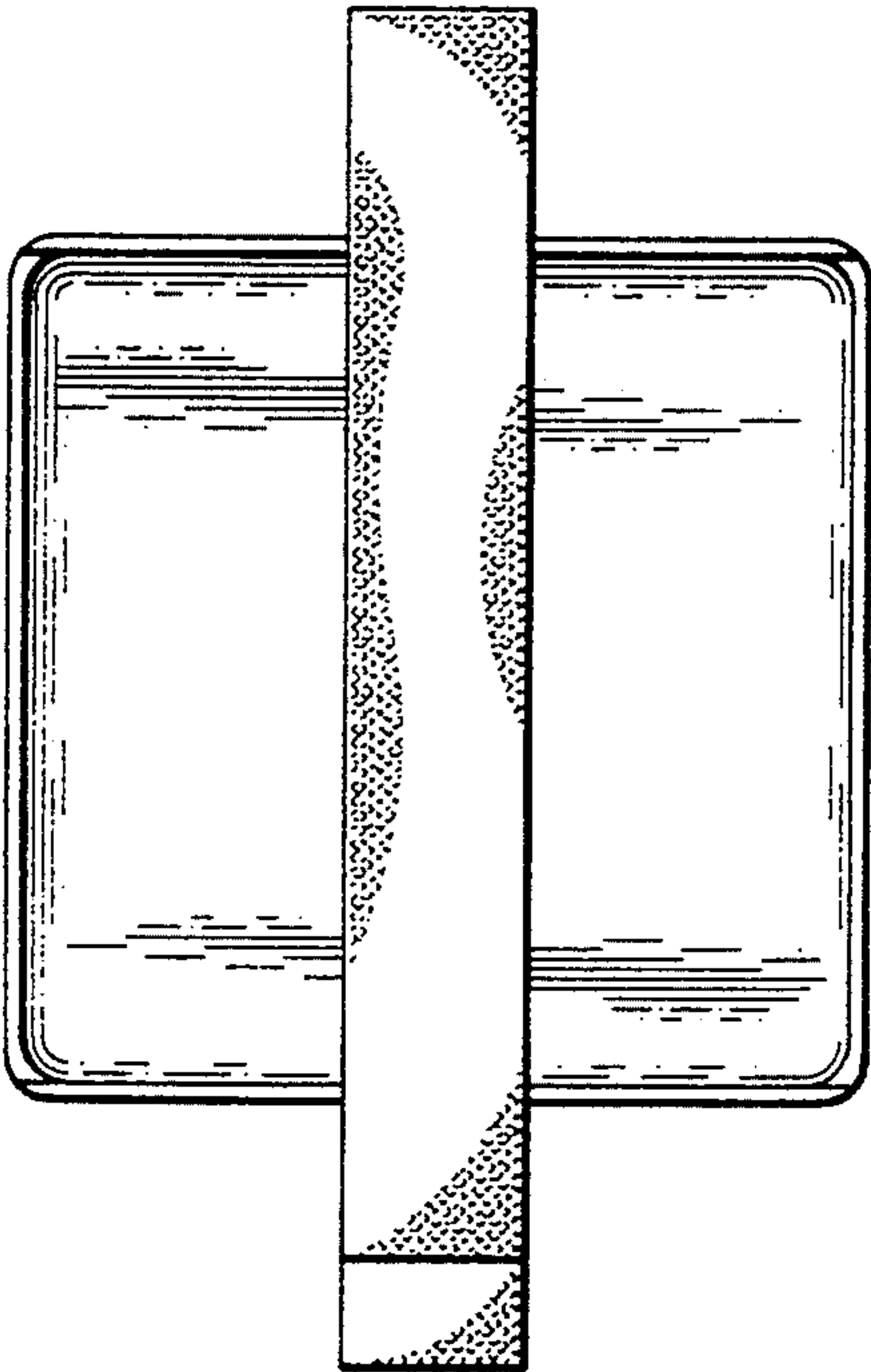
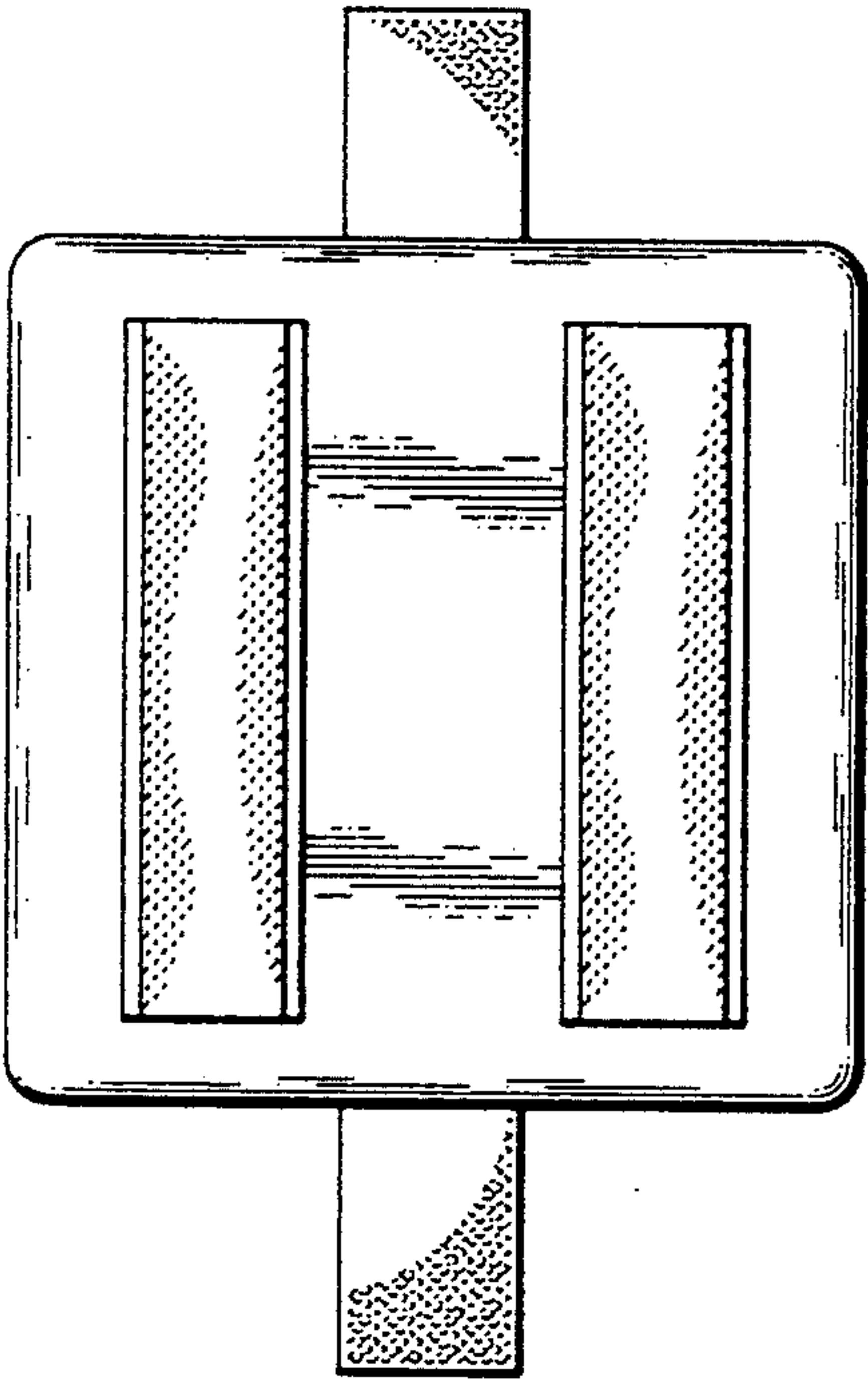
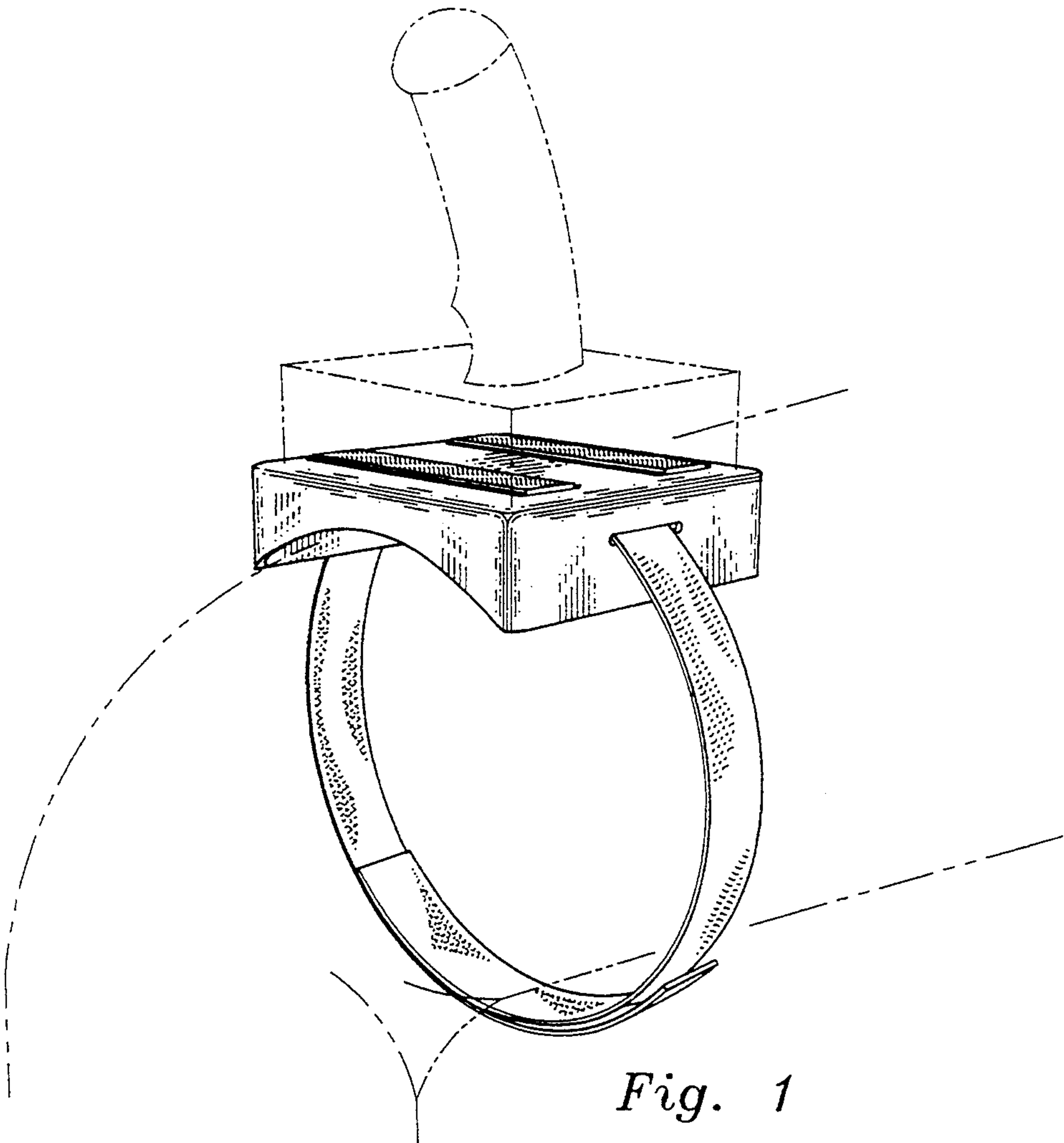
FIG. 5 is a back view thereof with the strap shown in an open position;

The broken line showing of joy stick and human leg is for illustrative purpose only and forms no part of the claim.





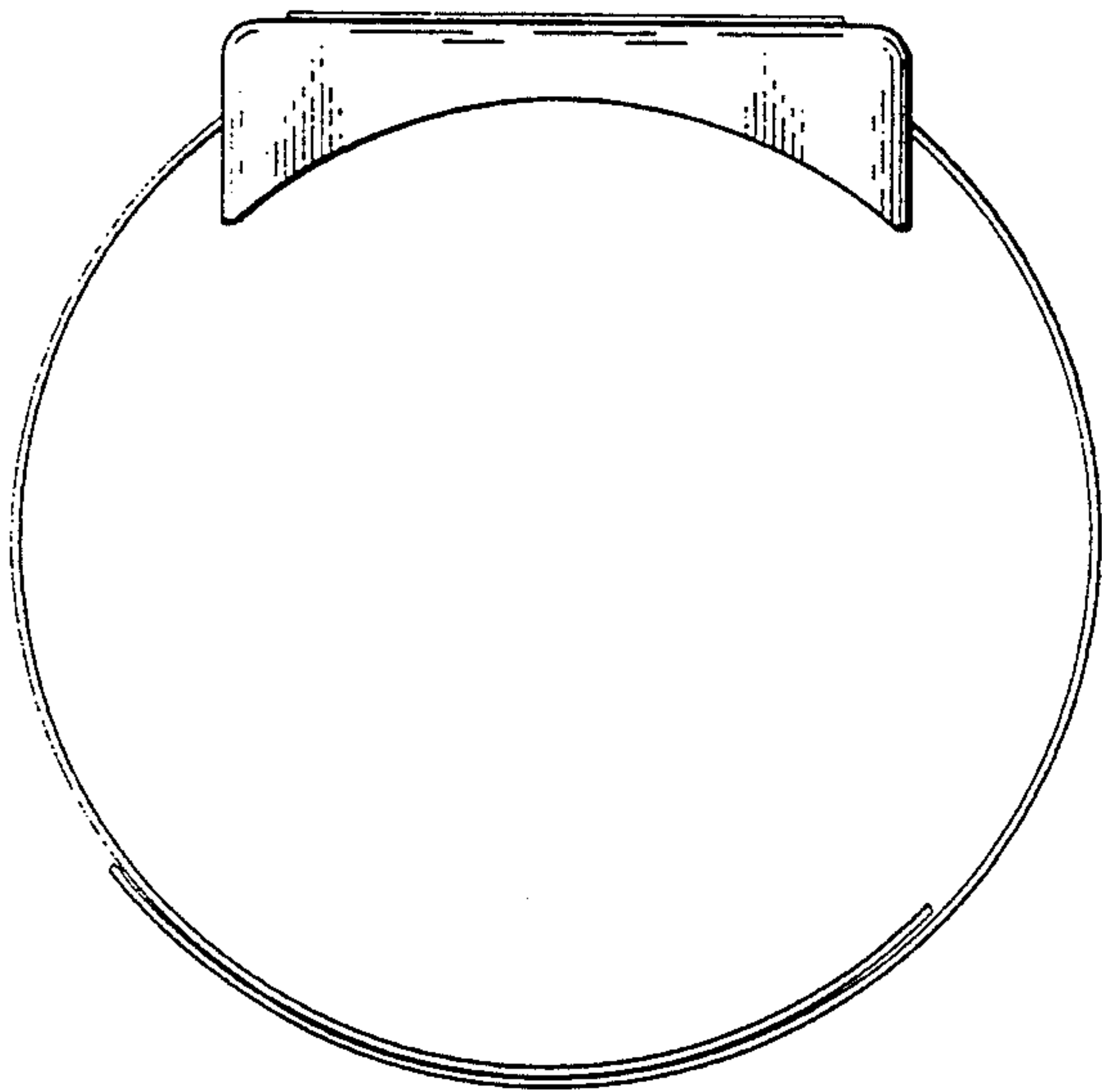

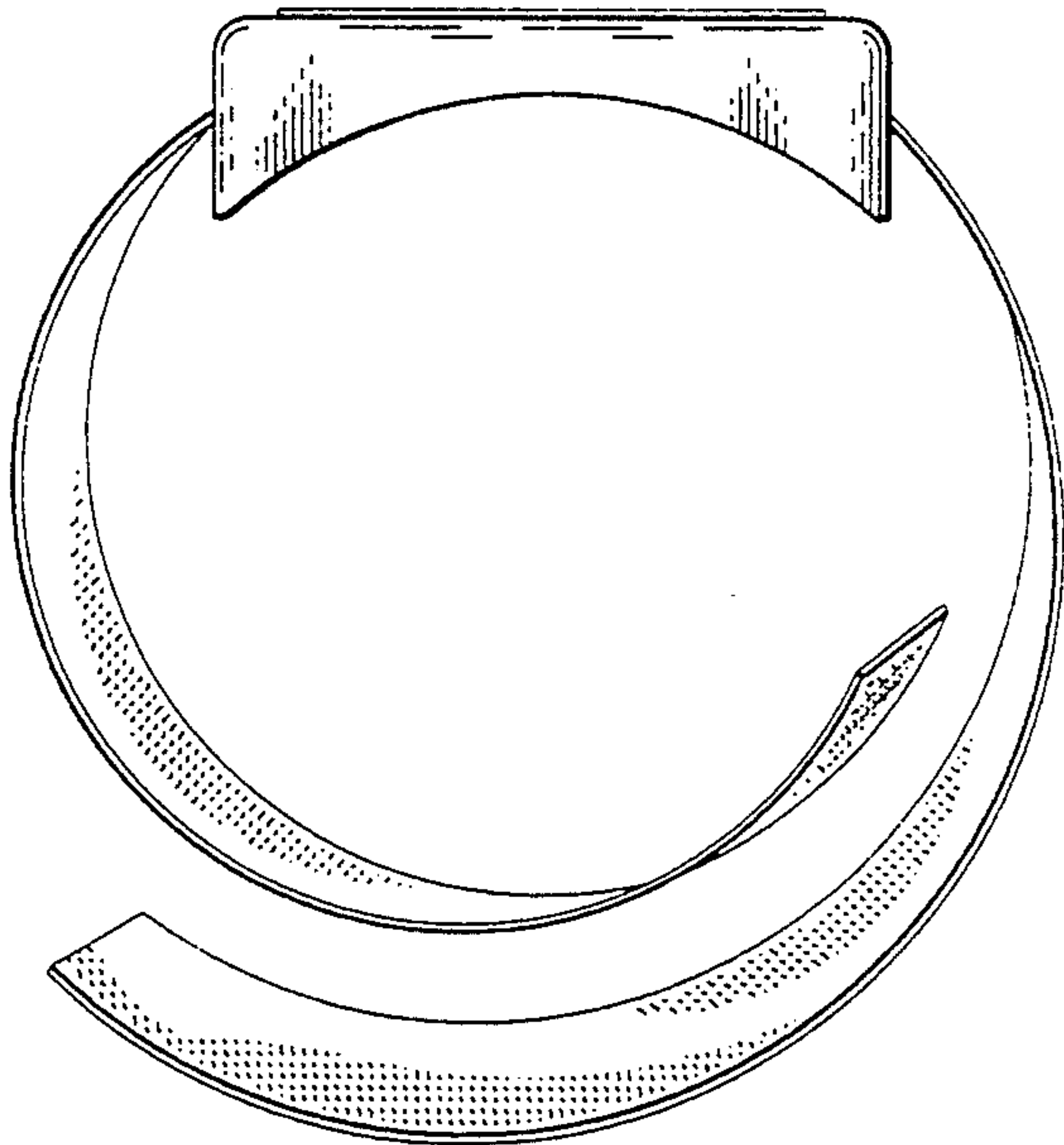

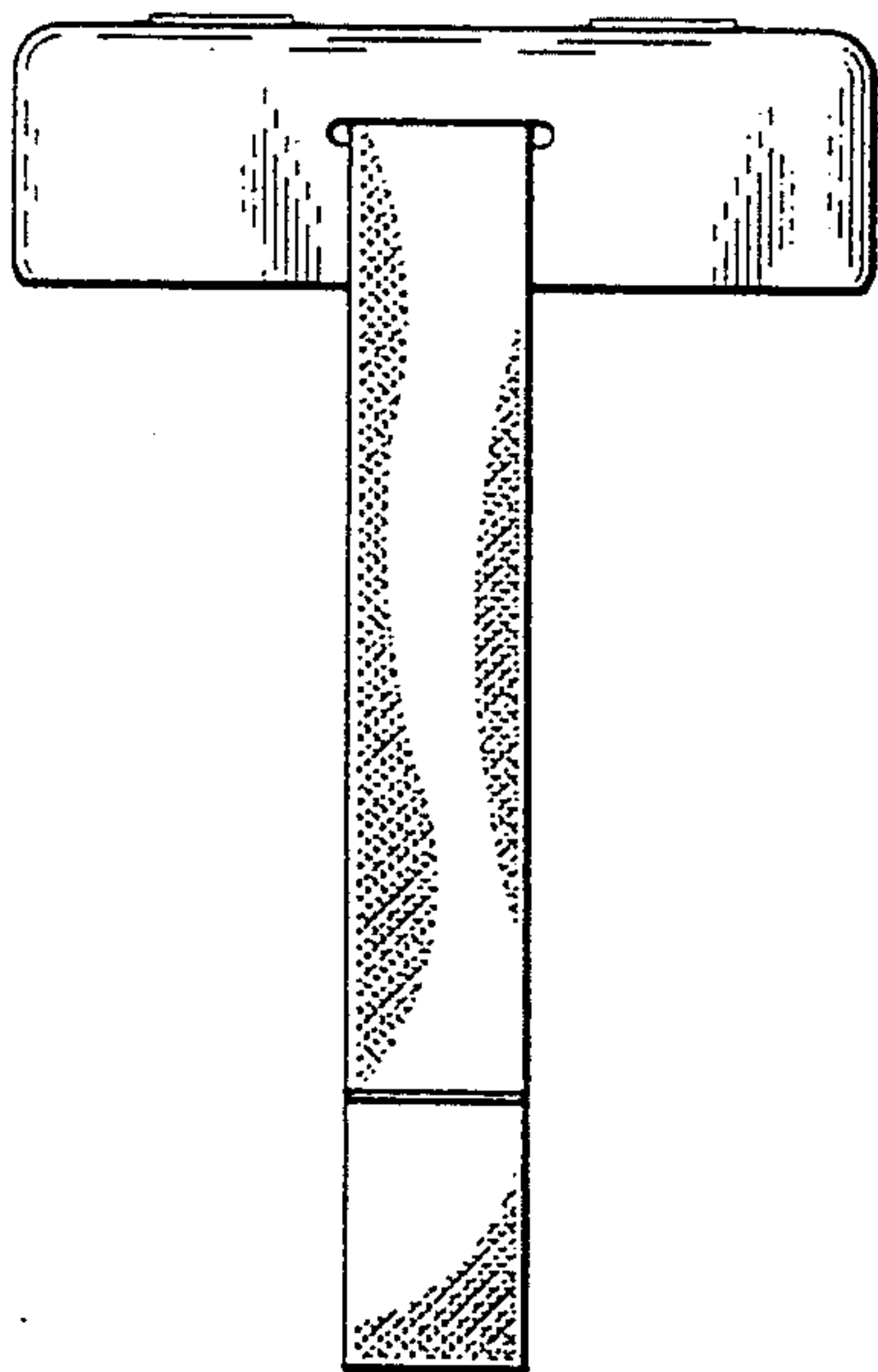

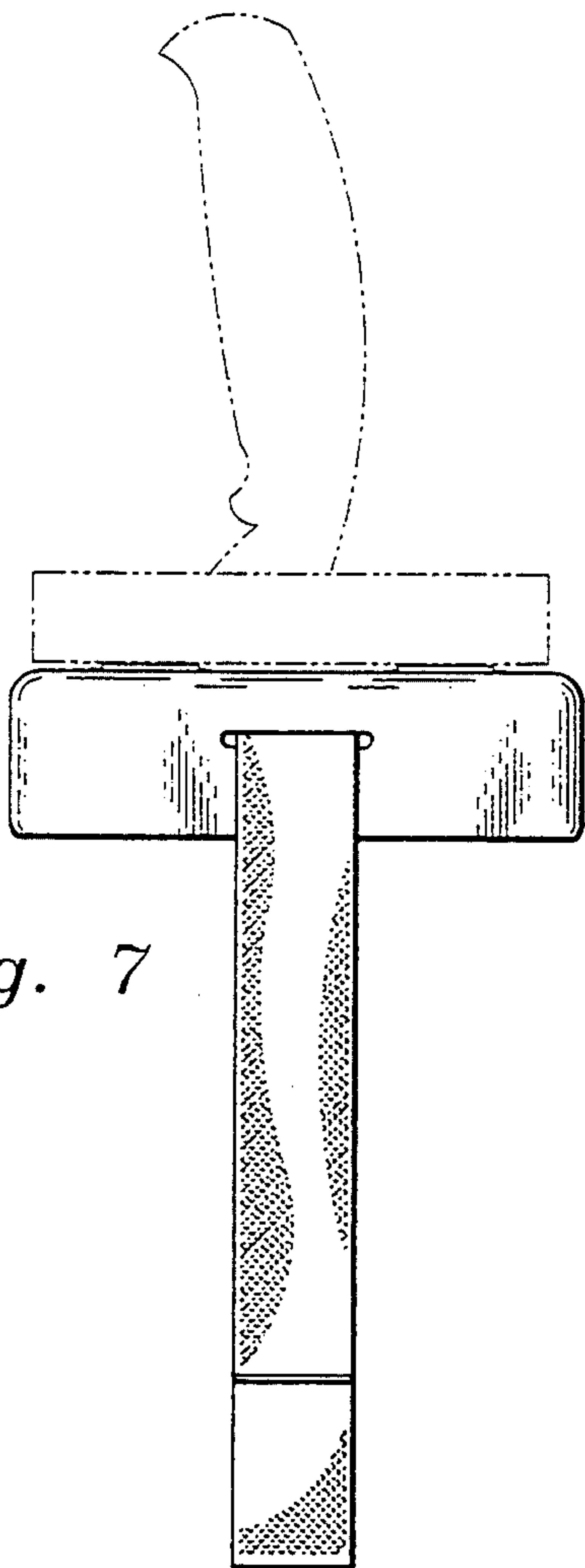
