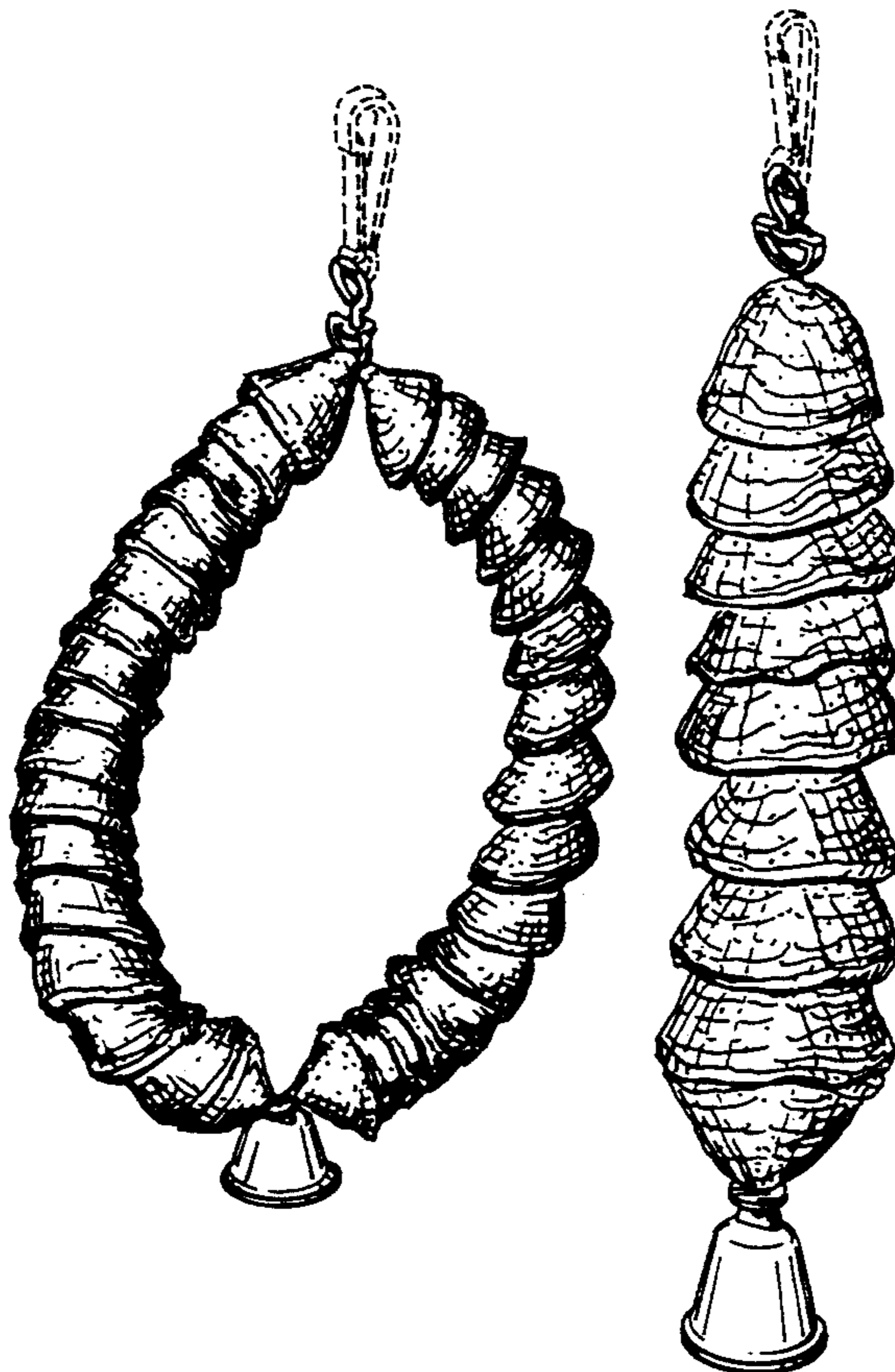

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined bird toy and beak sharpener, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined bird toy and beak sharpener showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the combined bird toy and beak sharpener of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image; FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image; and, FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



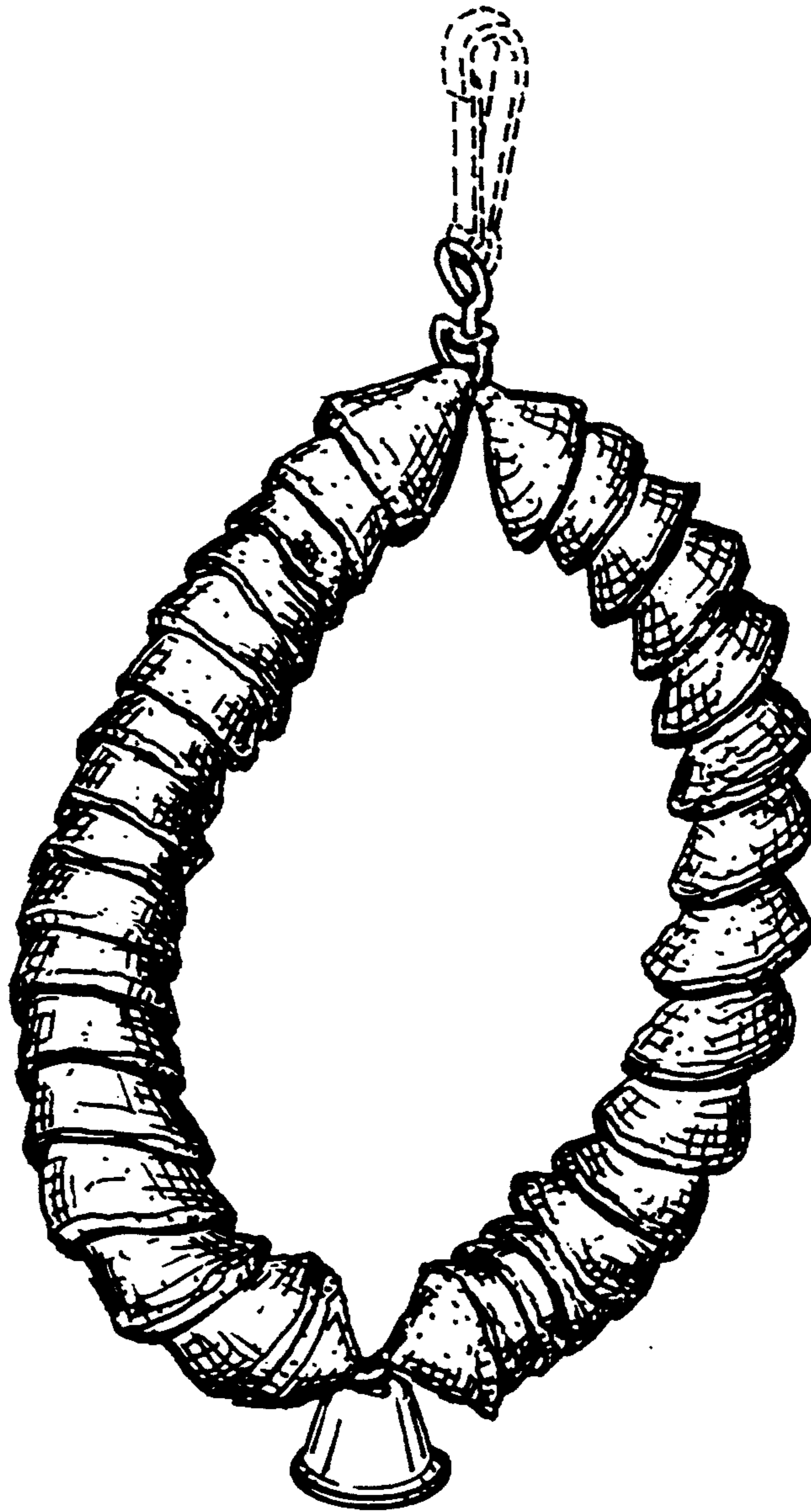

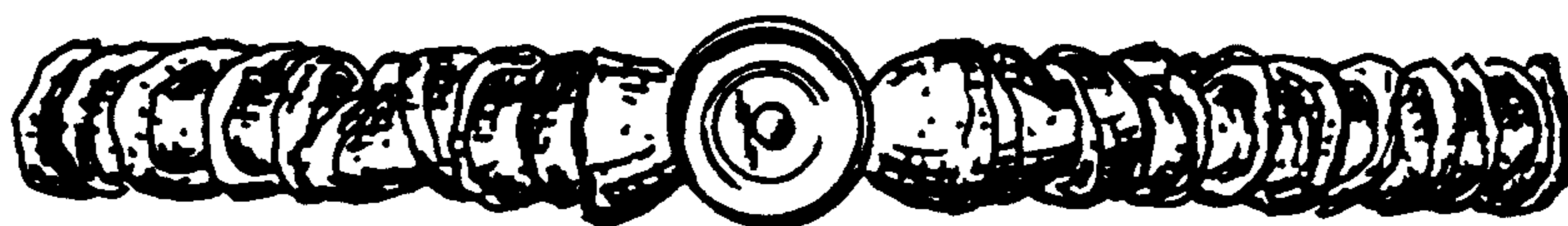

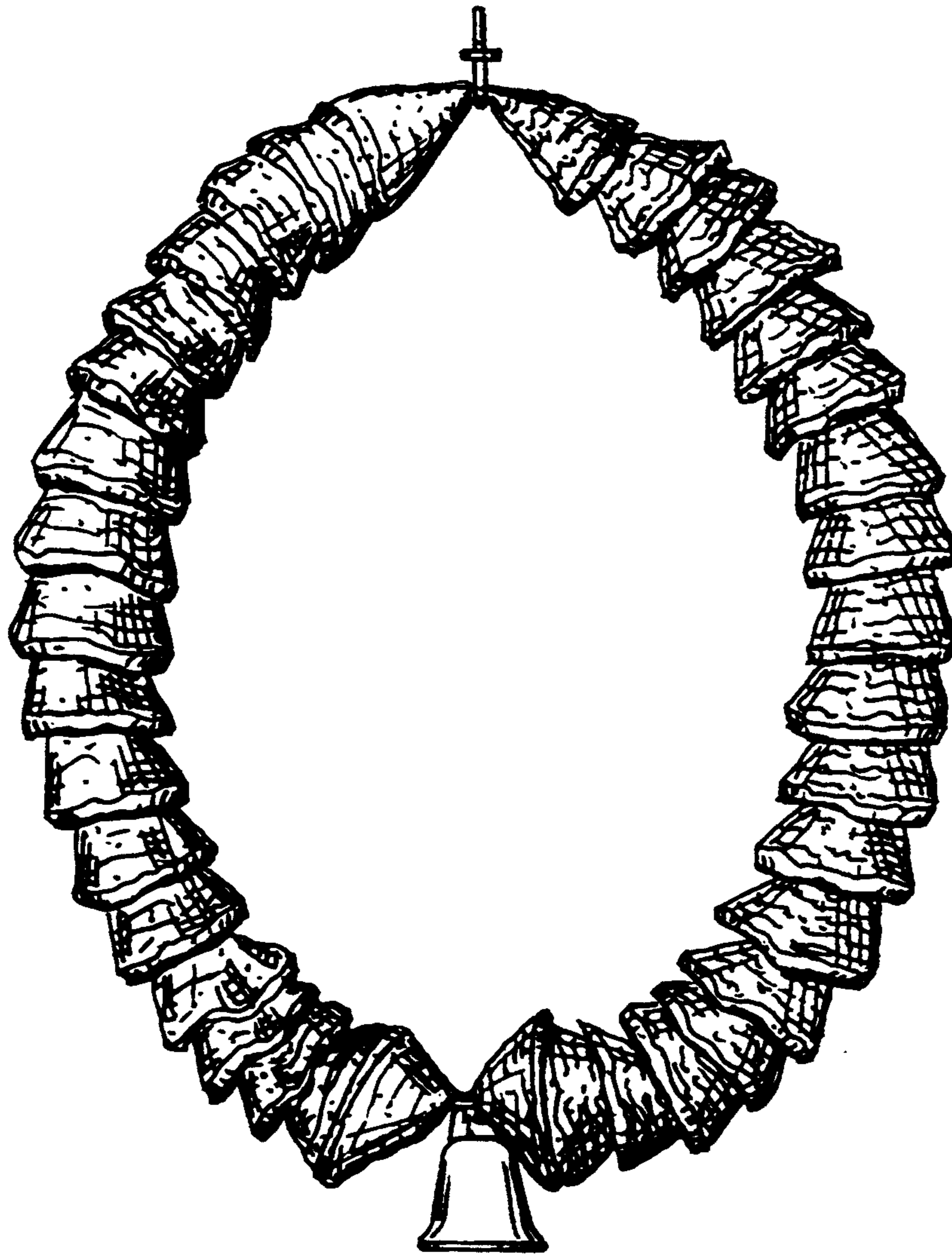

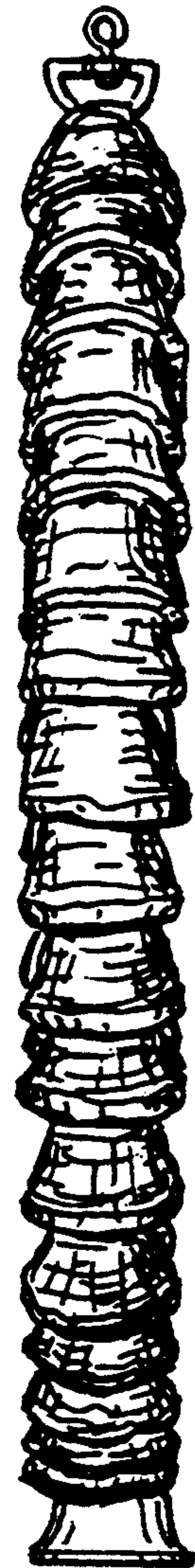

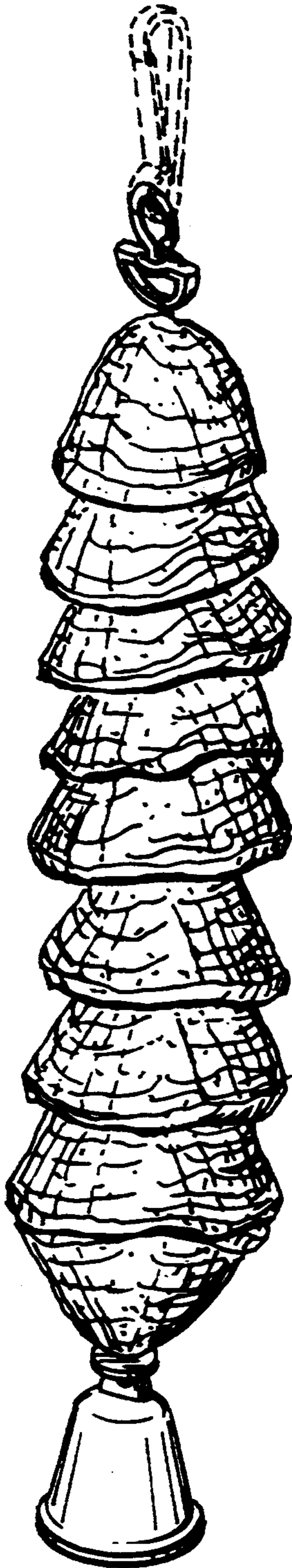

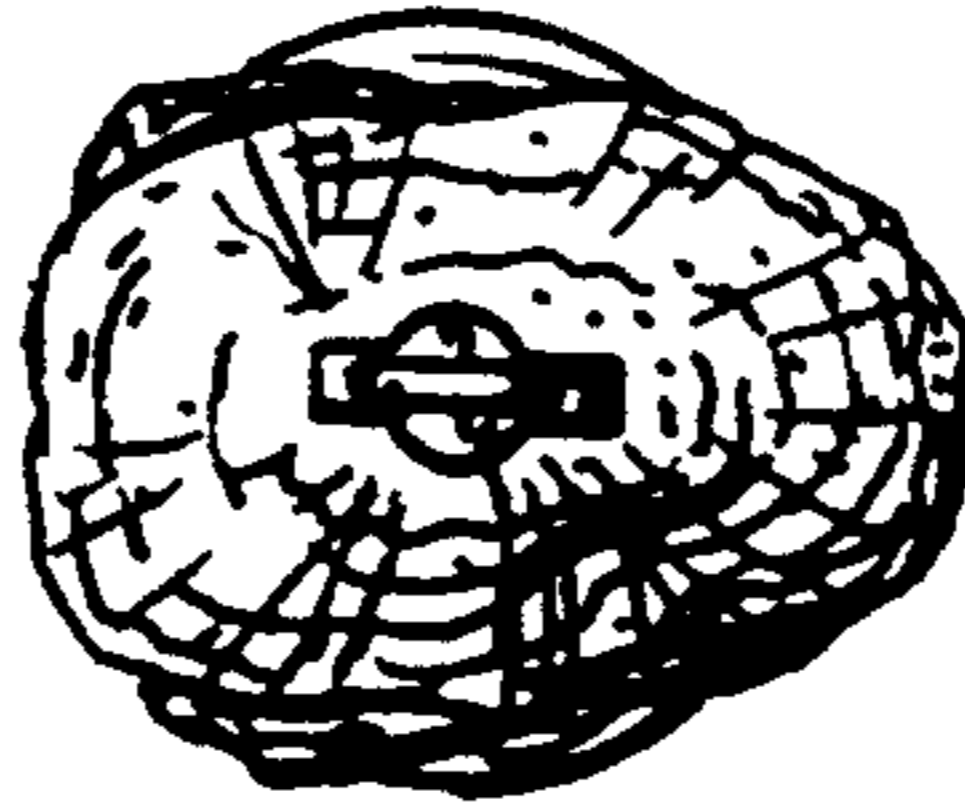

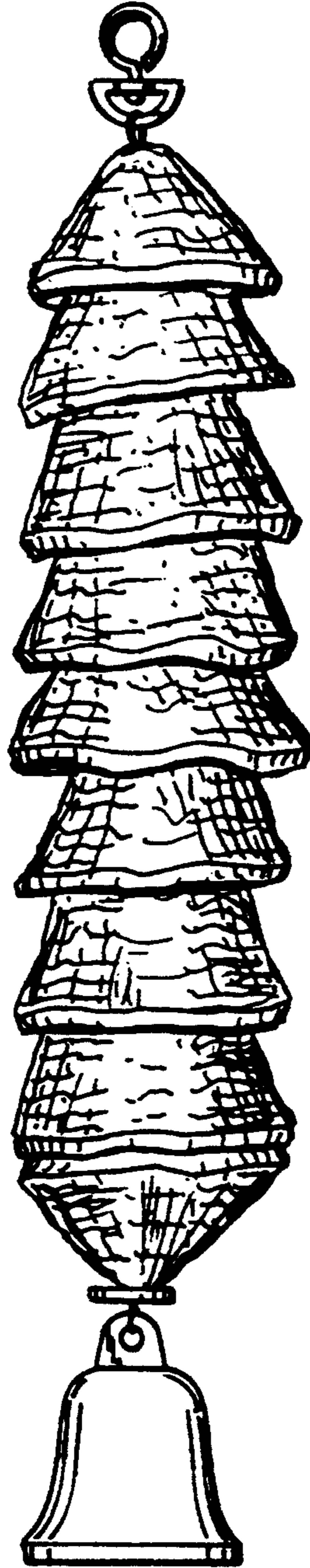

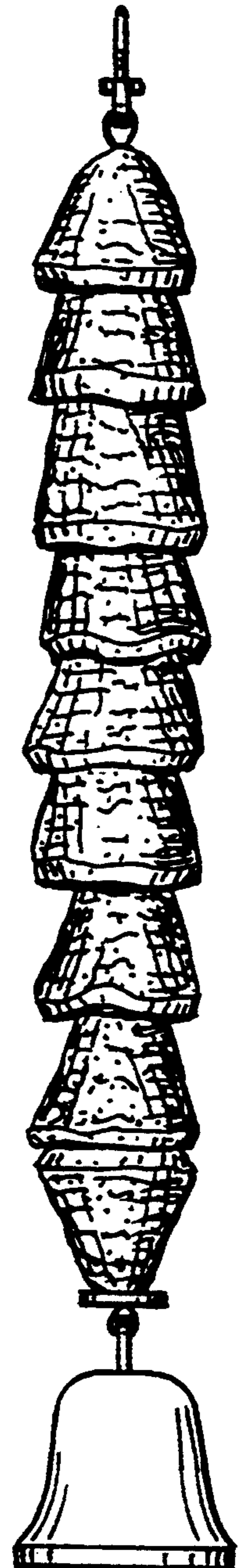

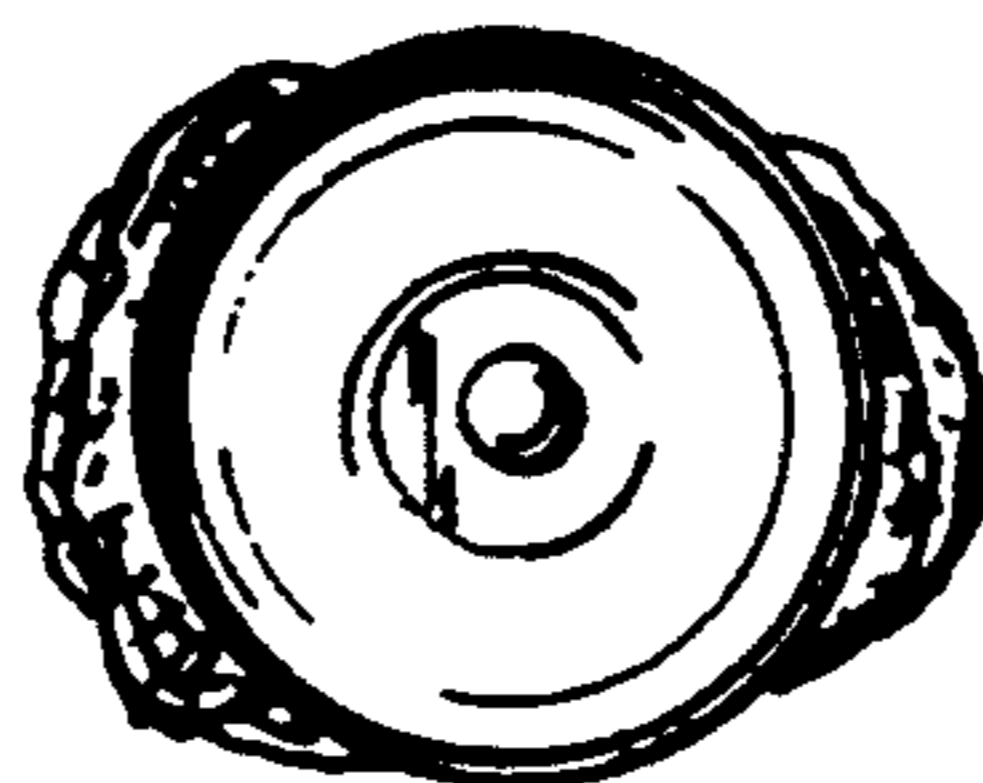
