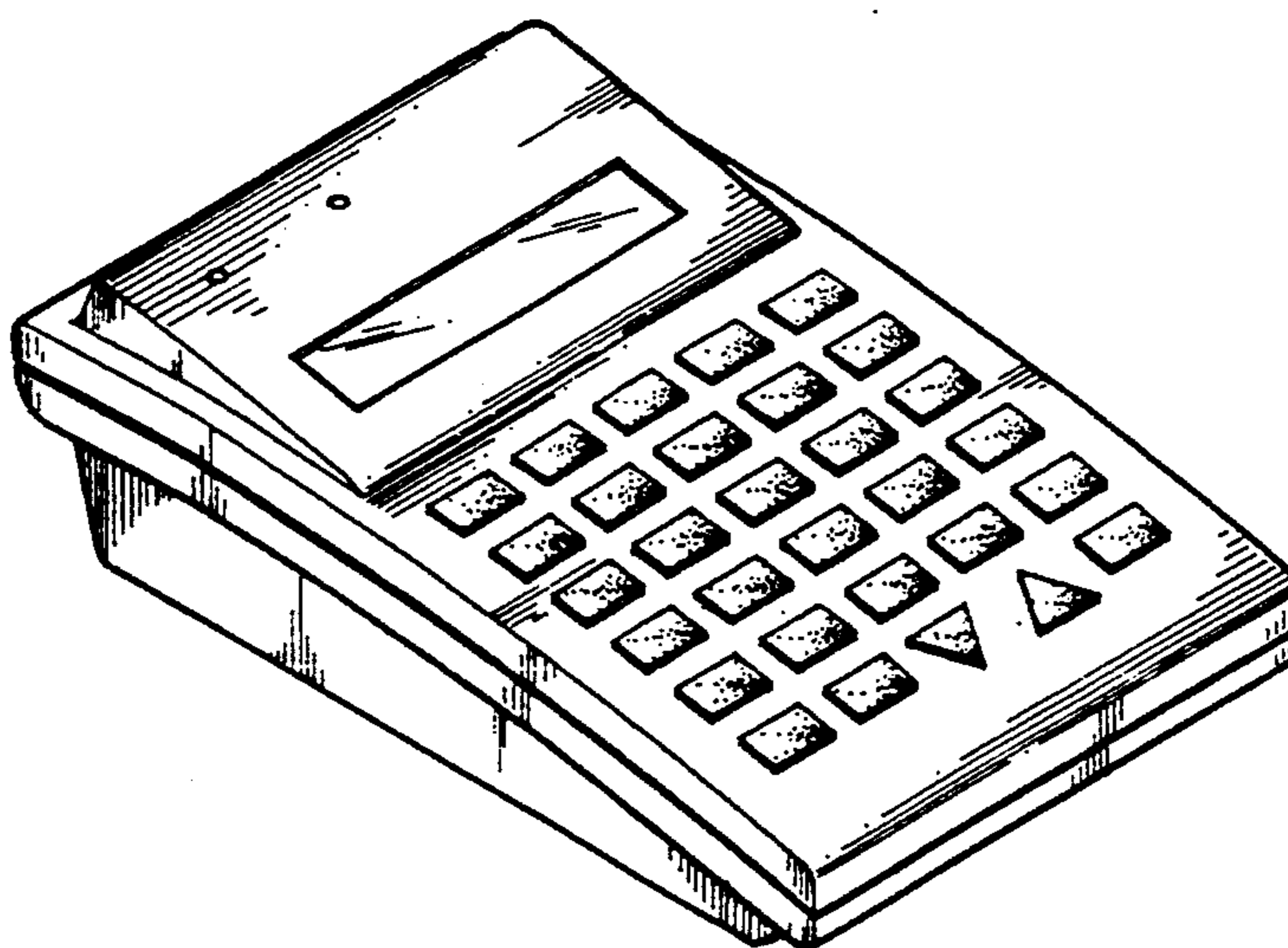

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a calling party identifying apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front-right-top side of a calling party identifying apparatus showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front-top-right perspective view of the calling party identifying apparatus, the triangular bracket being shown in broken lines for illustrative purpose only;
FIG. 8 is a rear-top-left perspective view of the calling party identifying apparatus, the triangular bracket being shown in broken lines for illustrative purpose only; and,
FIG. 9 is a front-top-right perspective view of the calling party identifying apparatus, the triangular bracket being shown in broken lines and separated therefrom for illustrative purpose only.



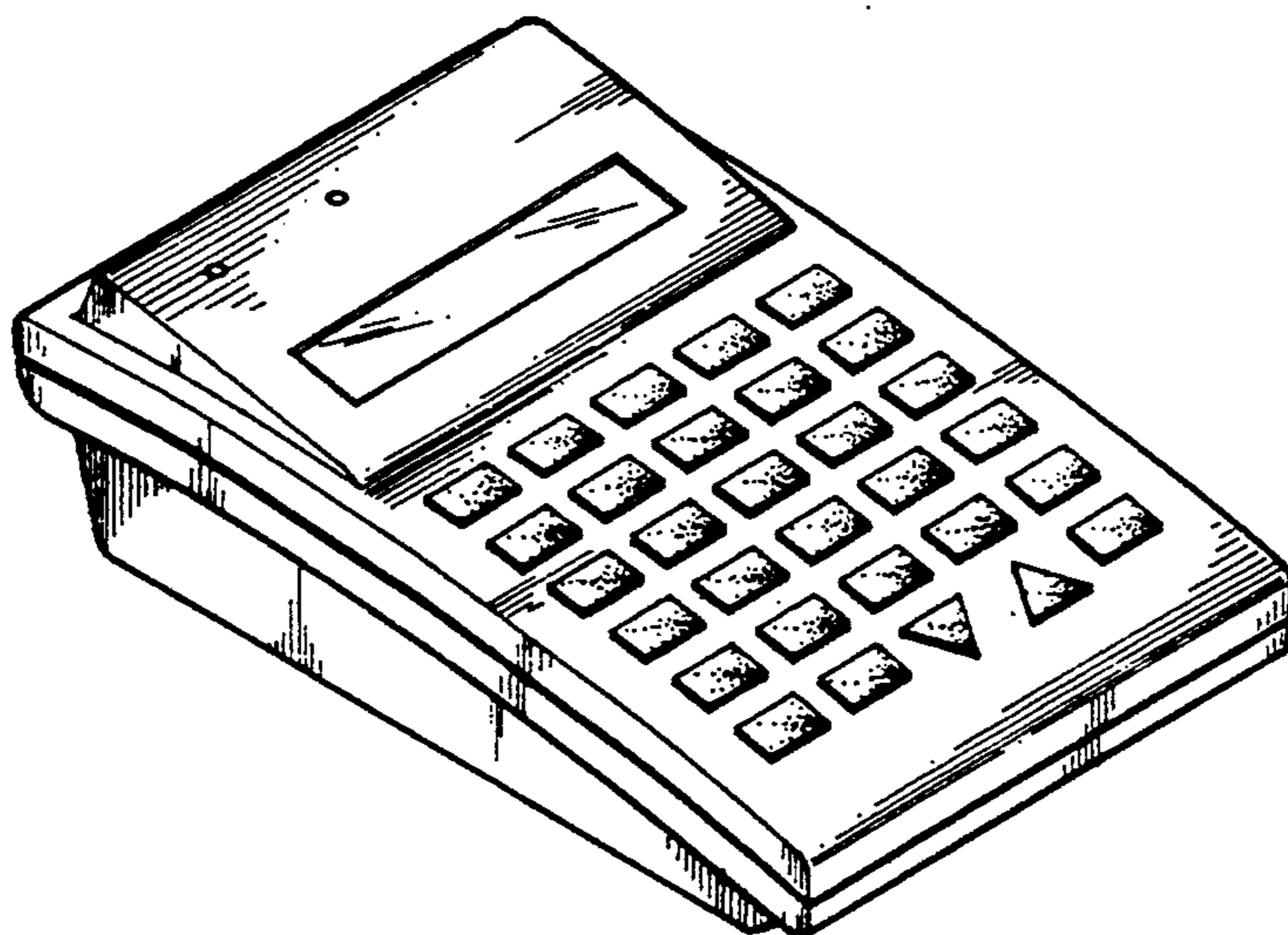

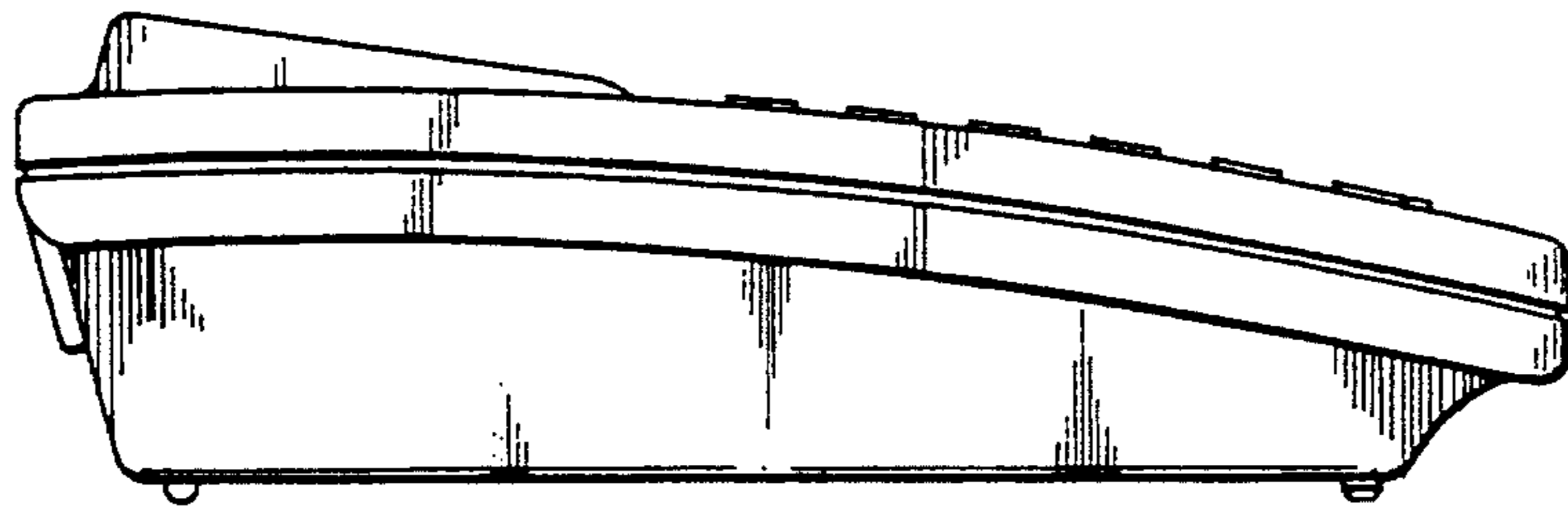

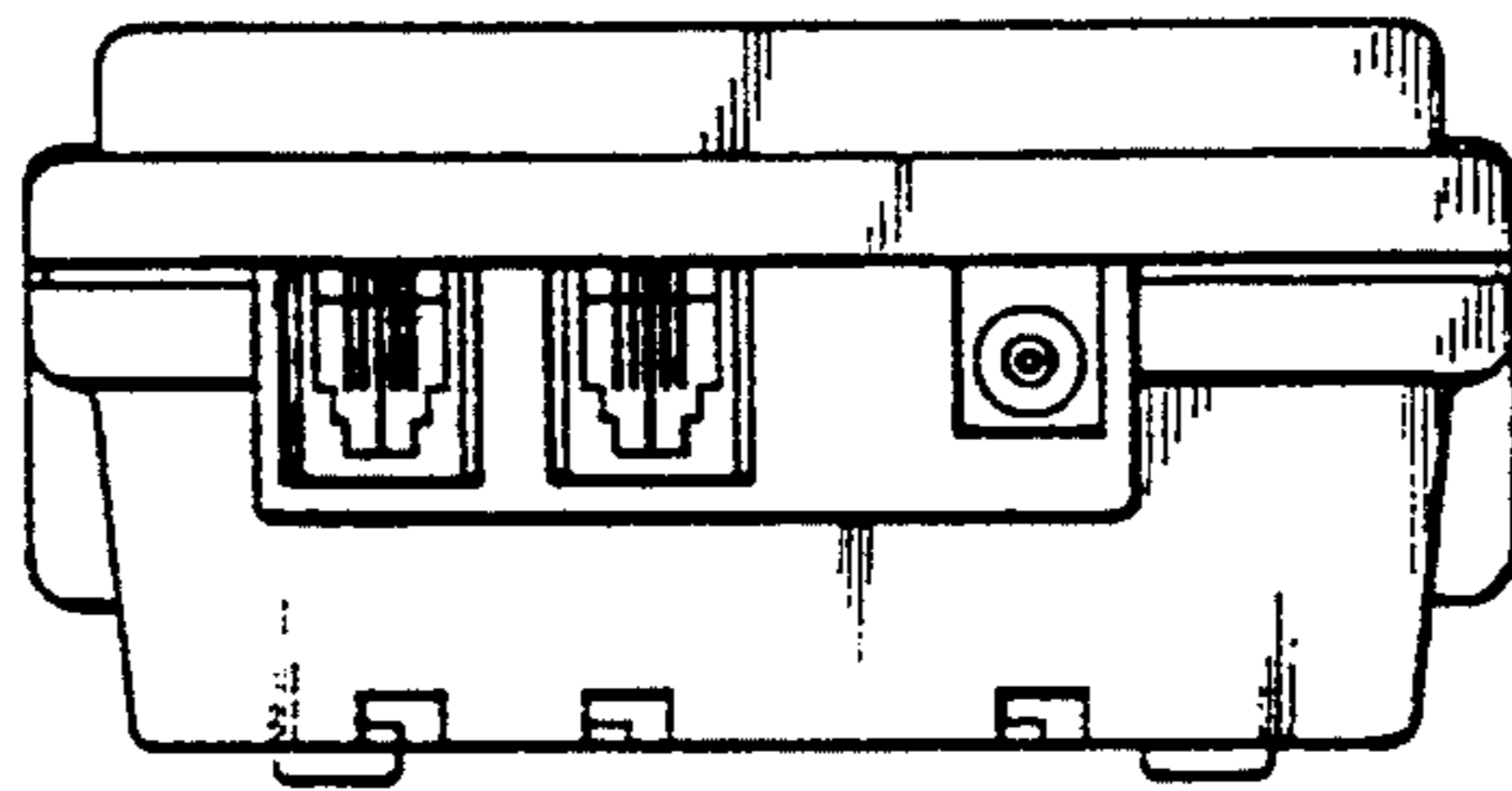

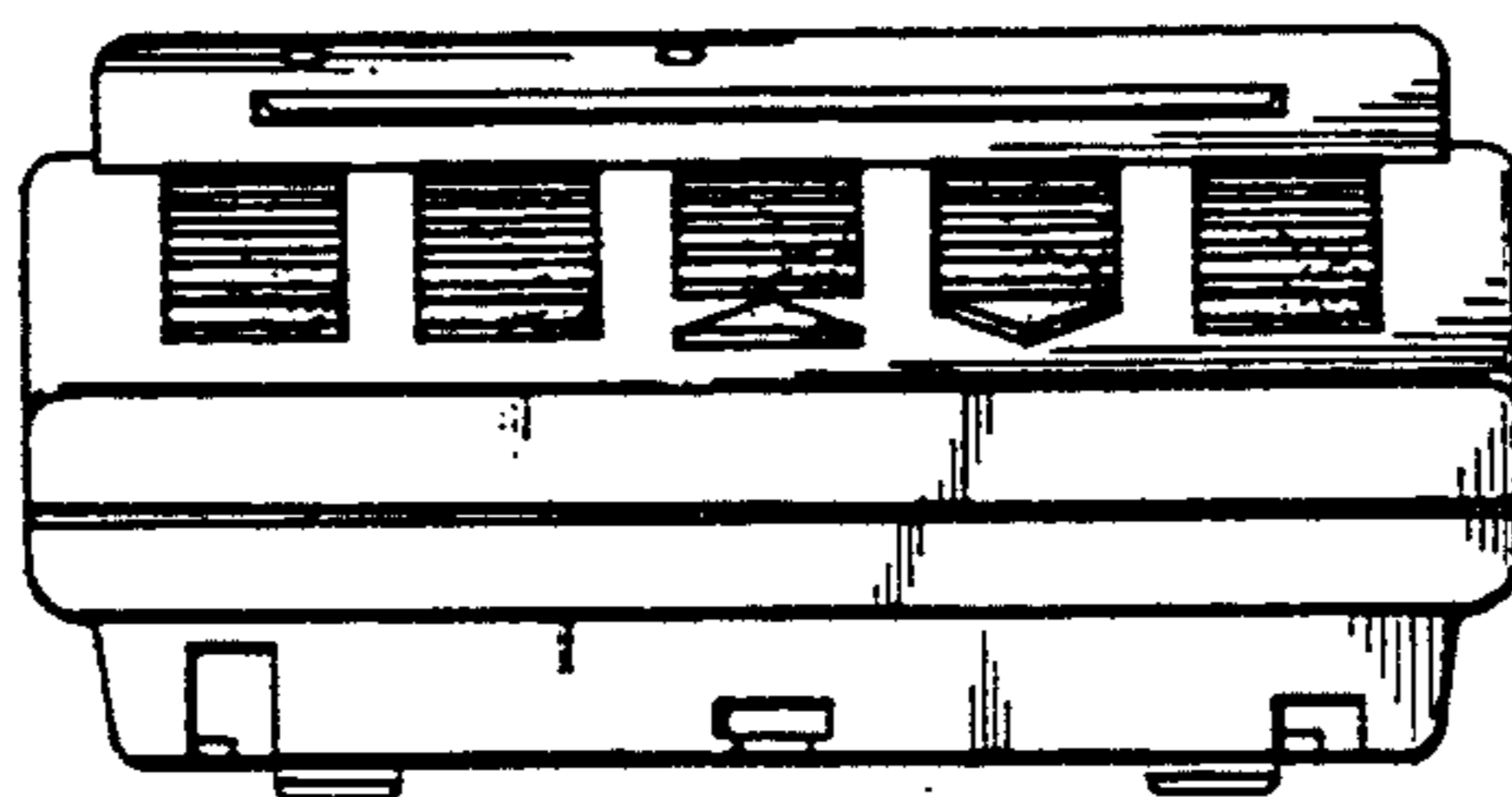

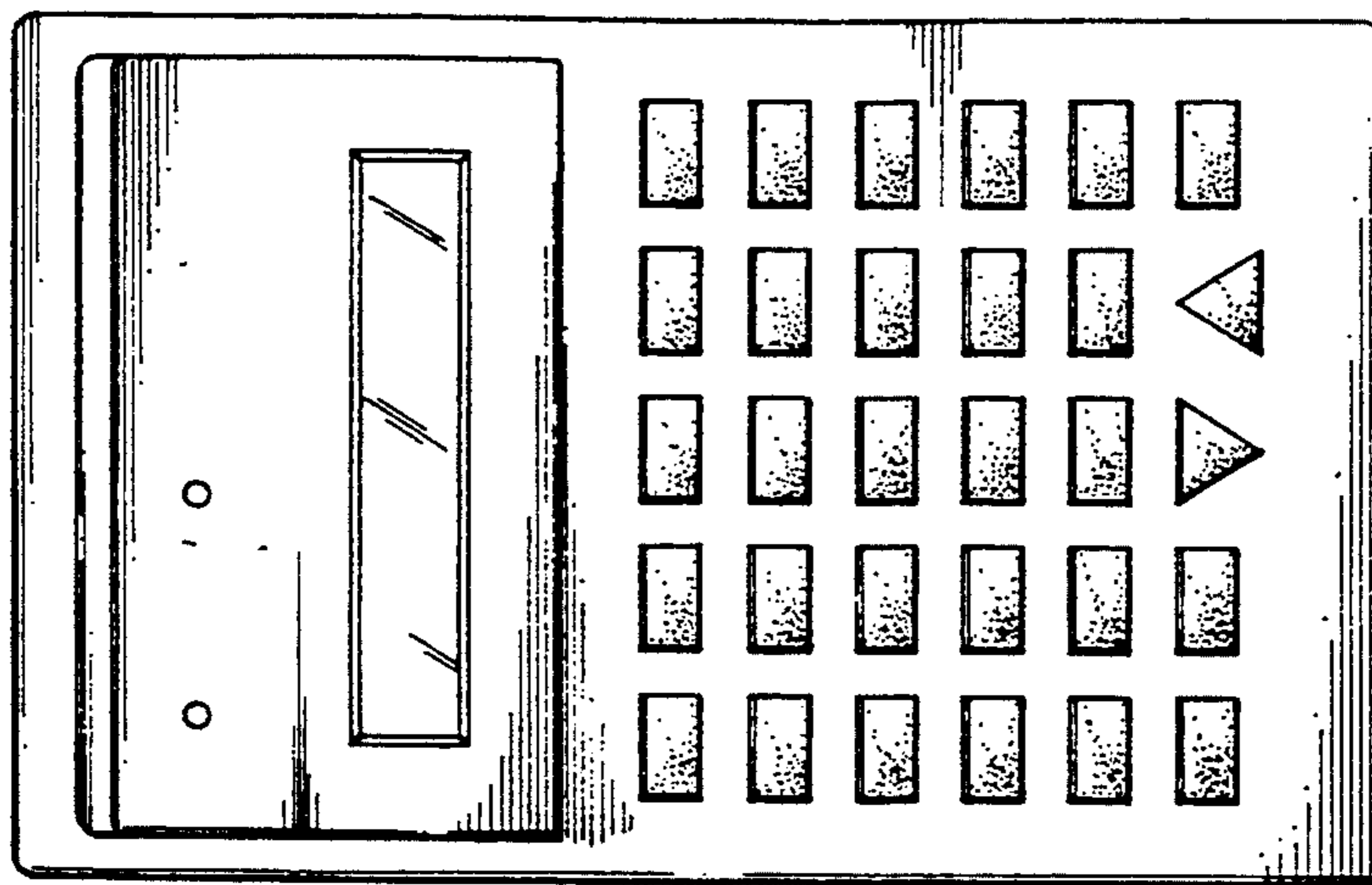

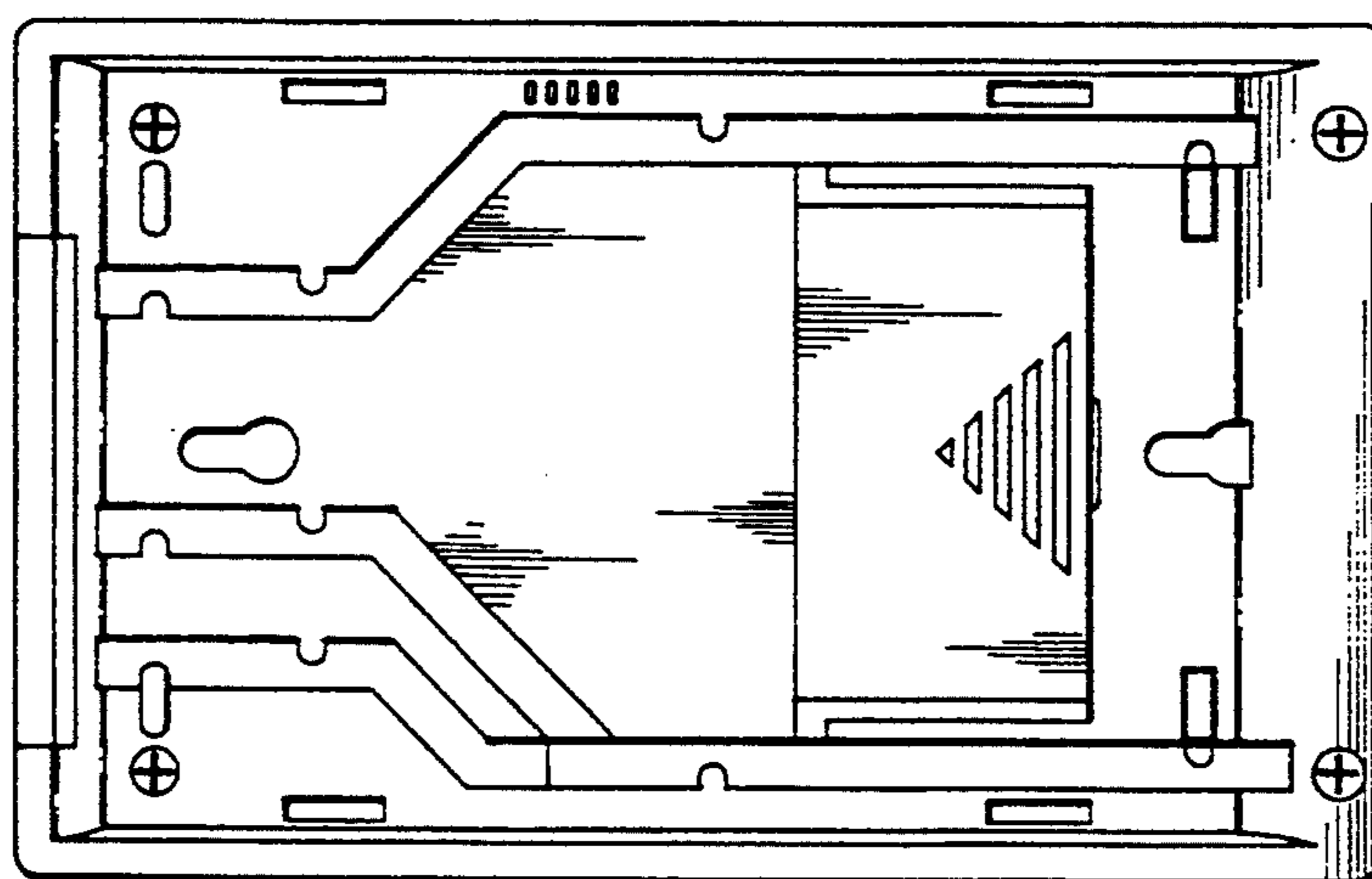

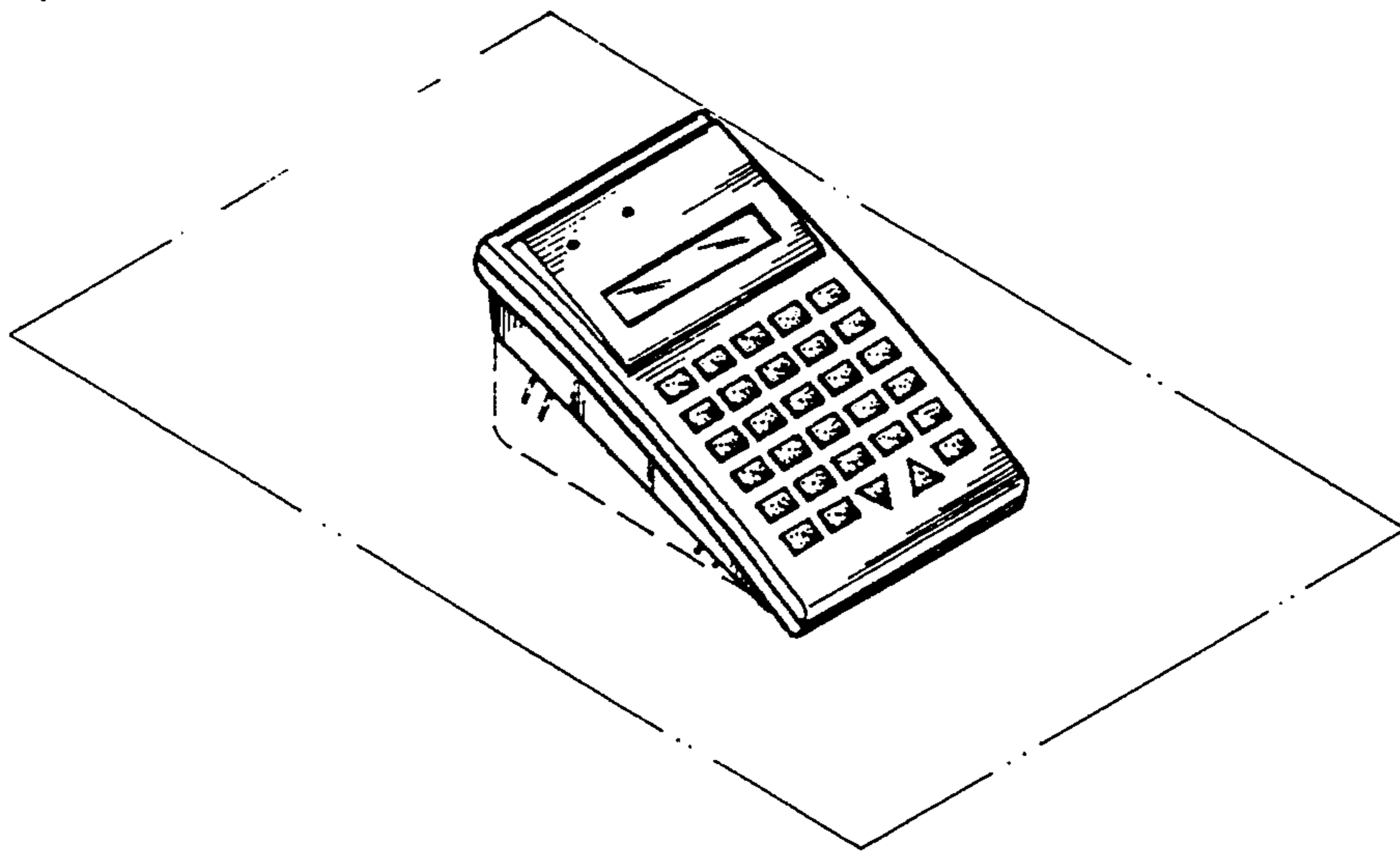

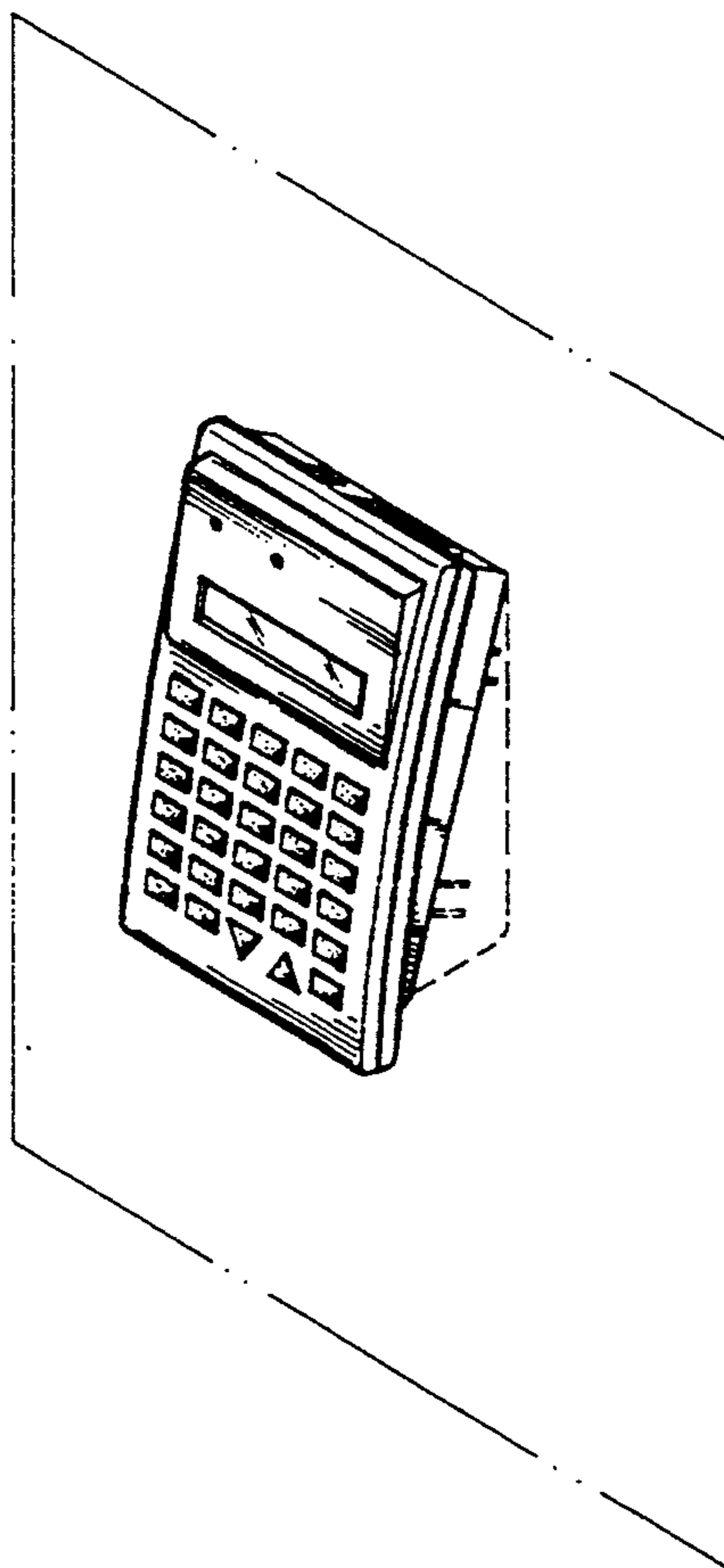

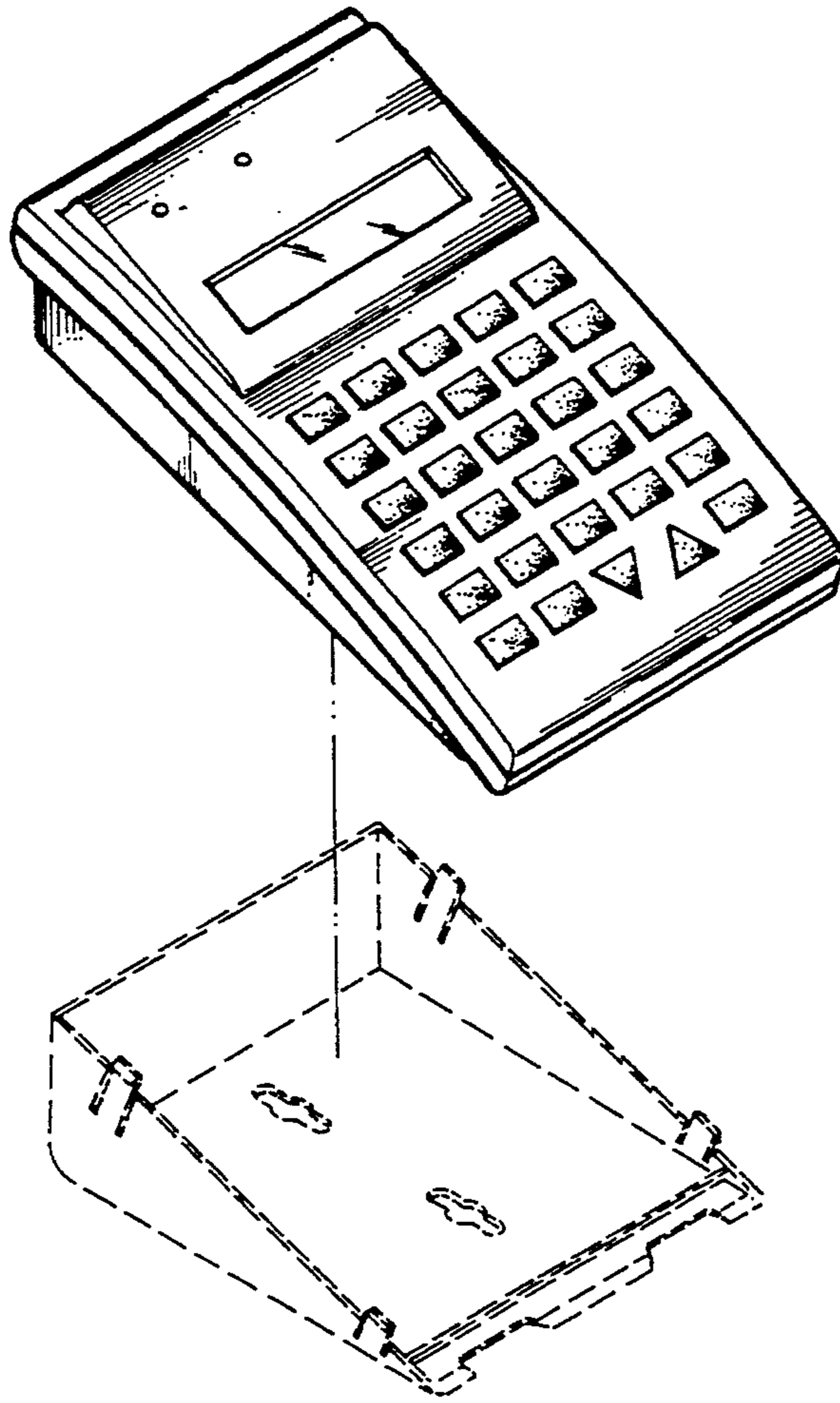
