FIG. 5 is a bottom plan of the chess board.

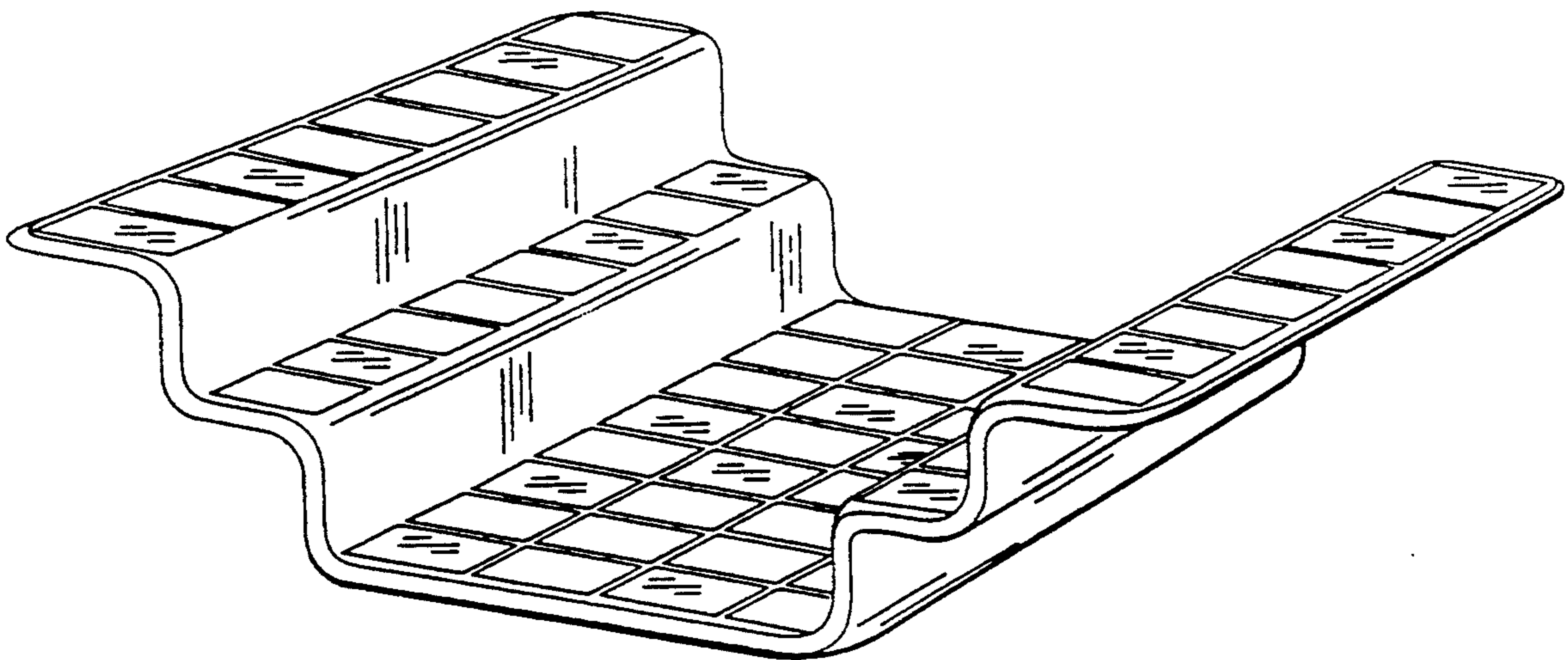

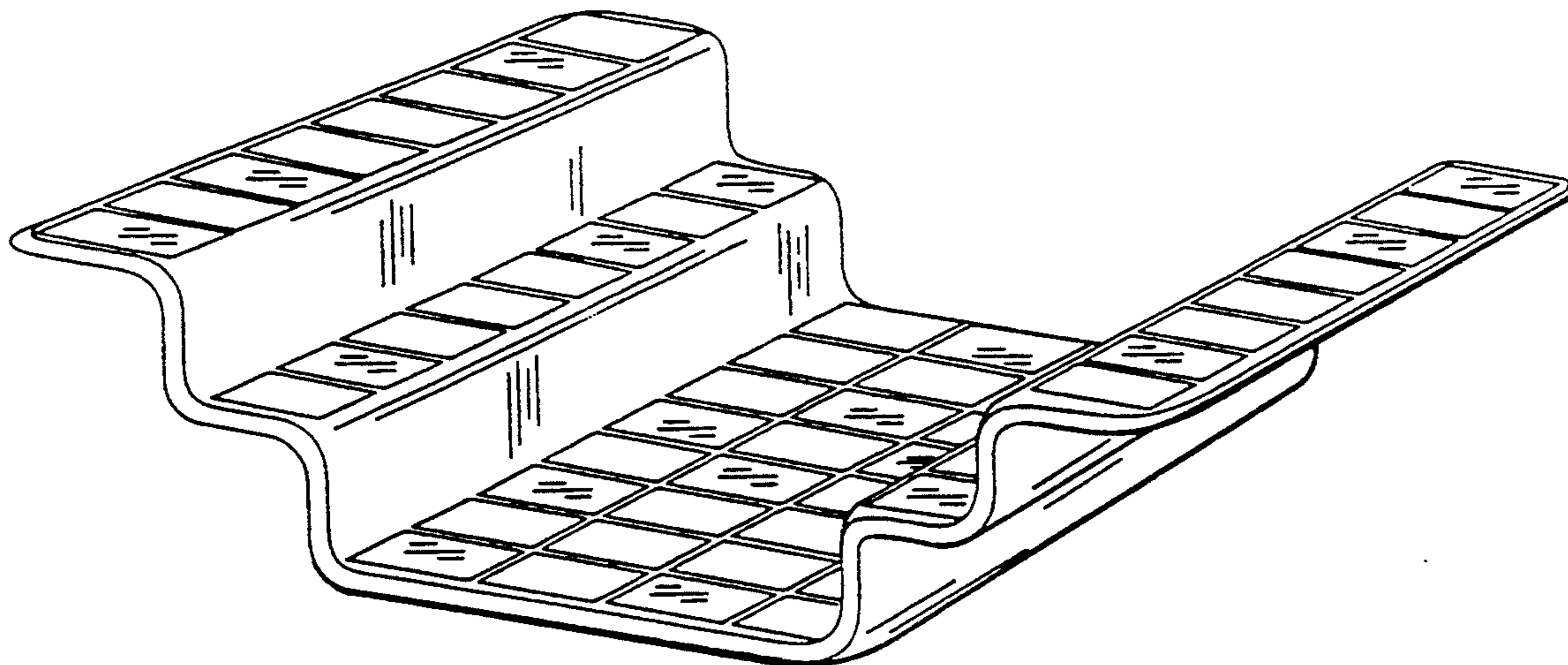

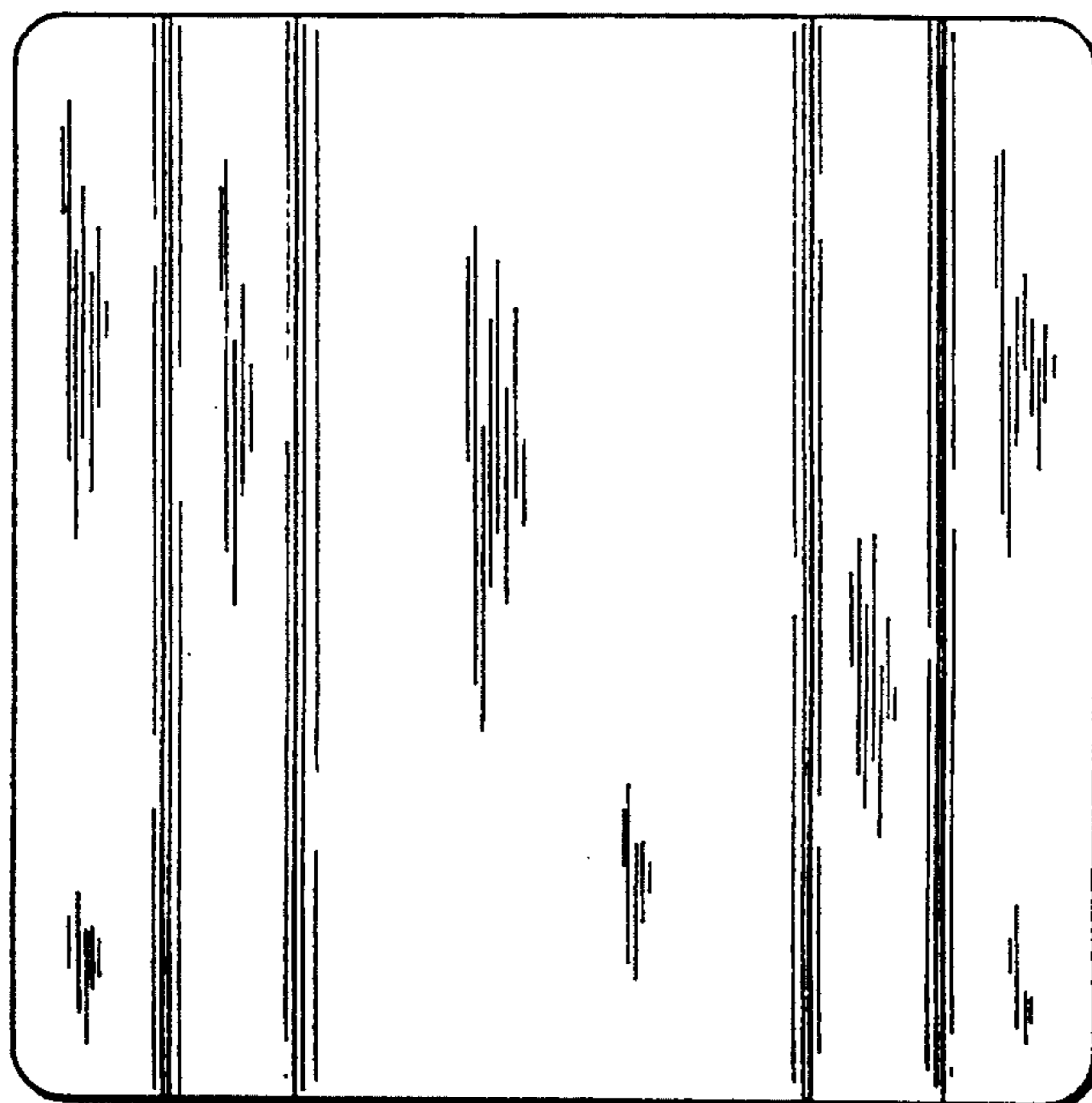

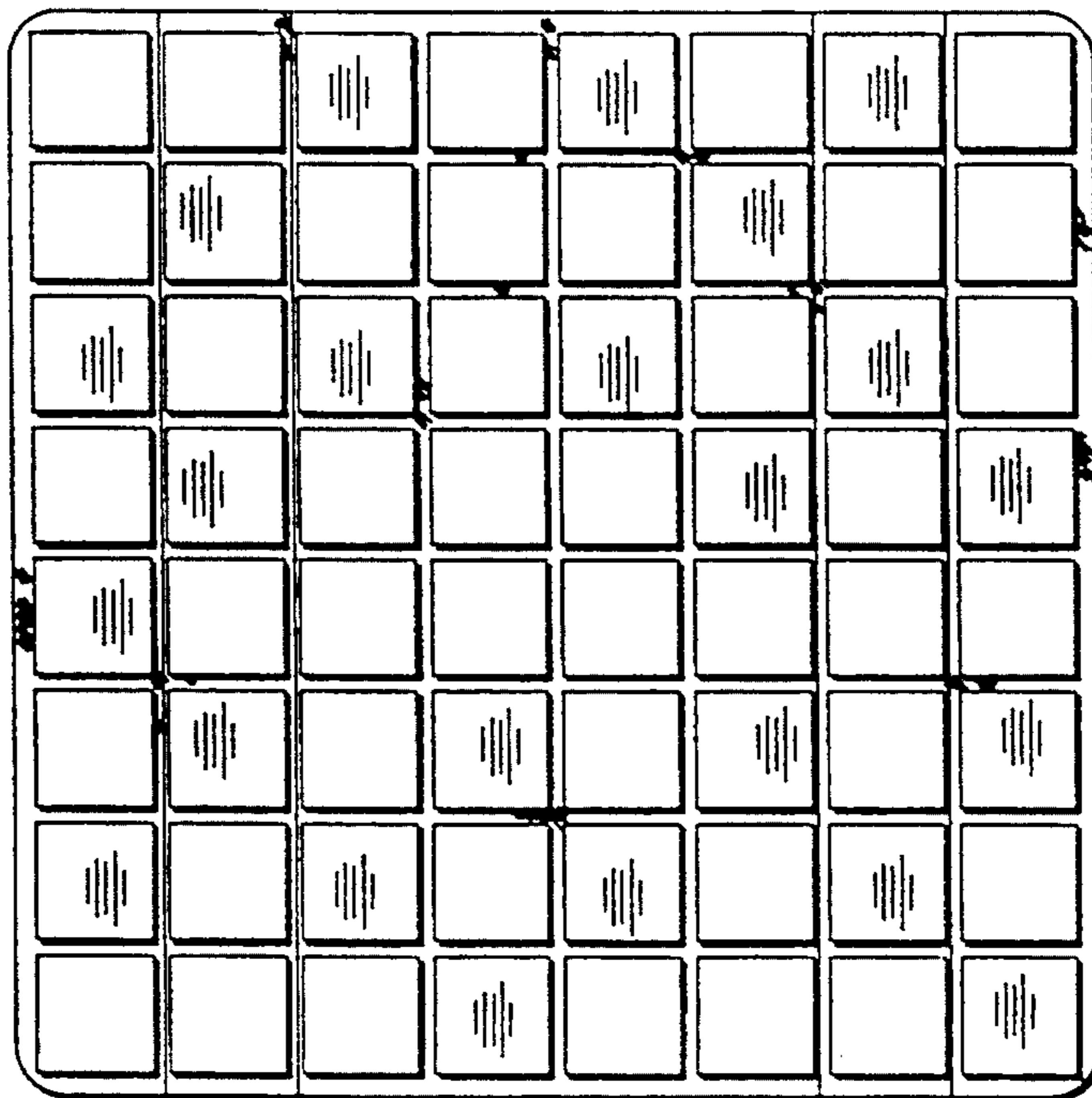

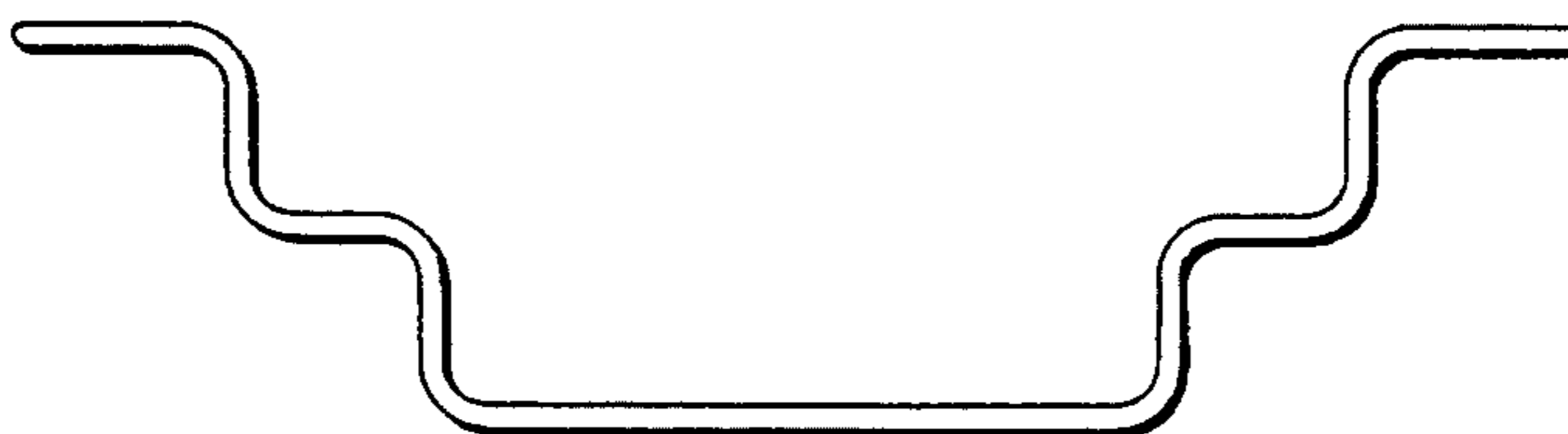
