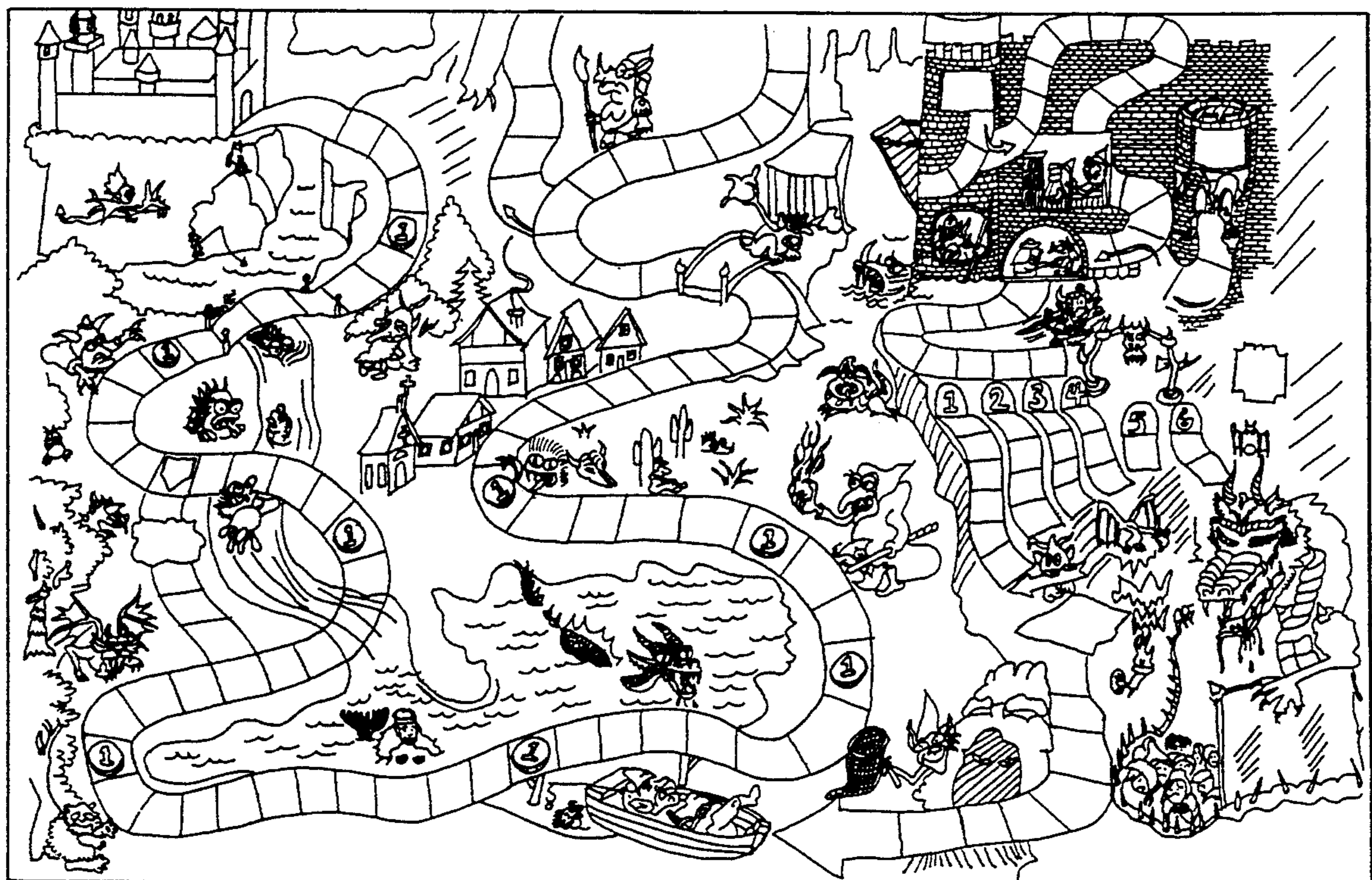

FIG. 4 is a side view, the opposite side being identical thereto.



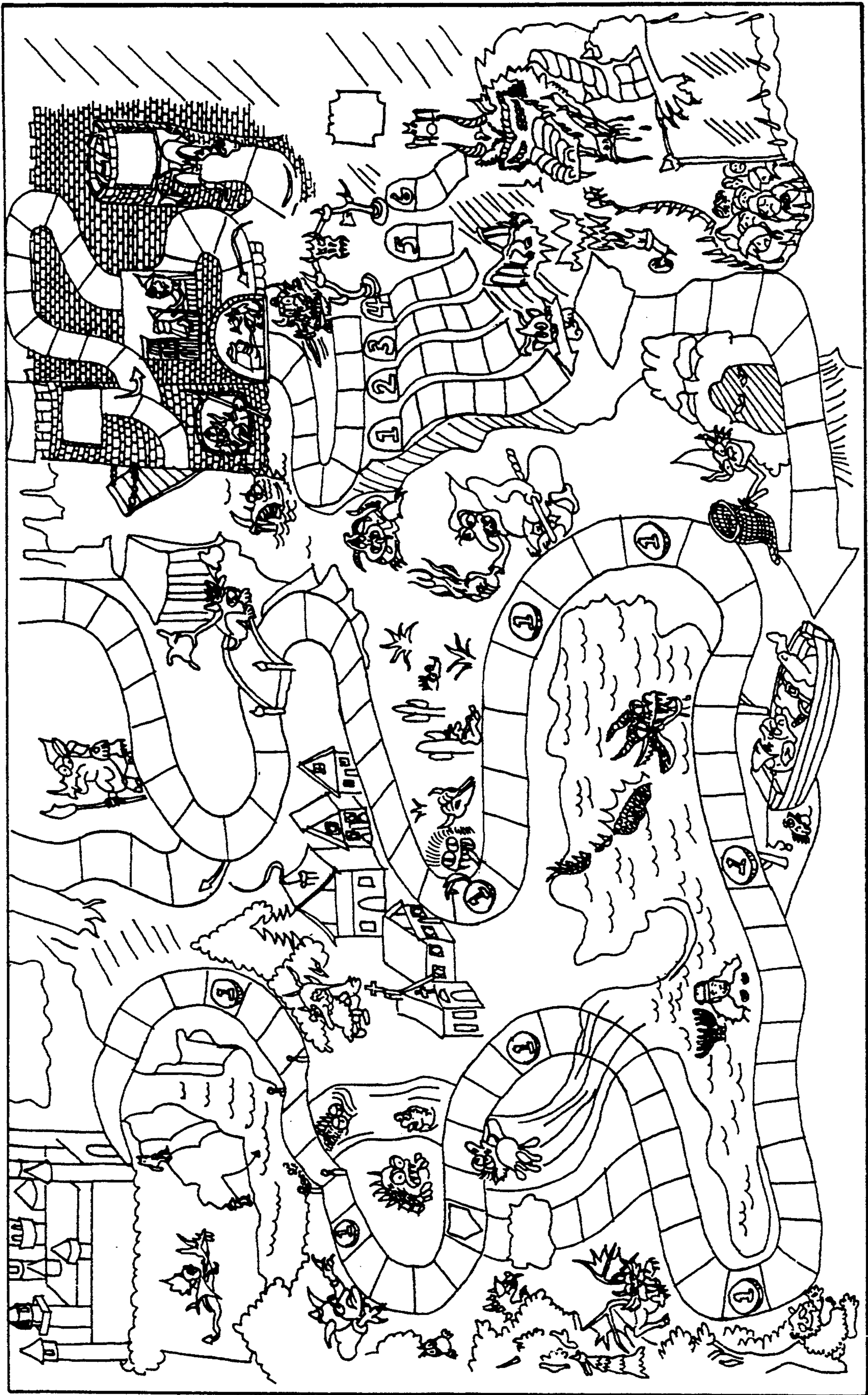
