DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a water fountain showing my new design on an enlarged scale;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is an opposite side elevational view thereof.
 The bottom portion of the tee is shown broken away to indicate an indeterminate length.
