FIG. 1 is a top, front and side perspective view of a portable toilet, showing my new design;

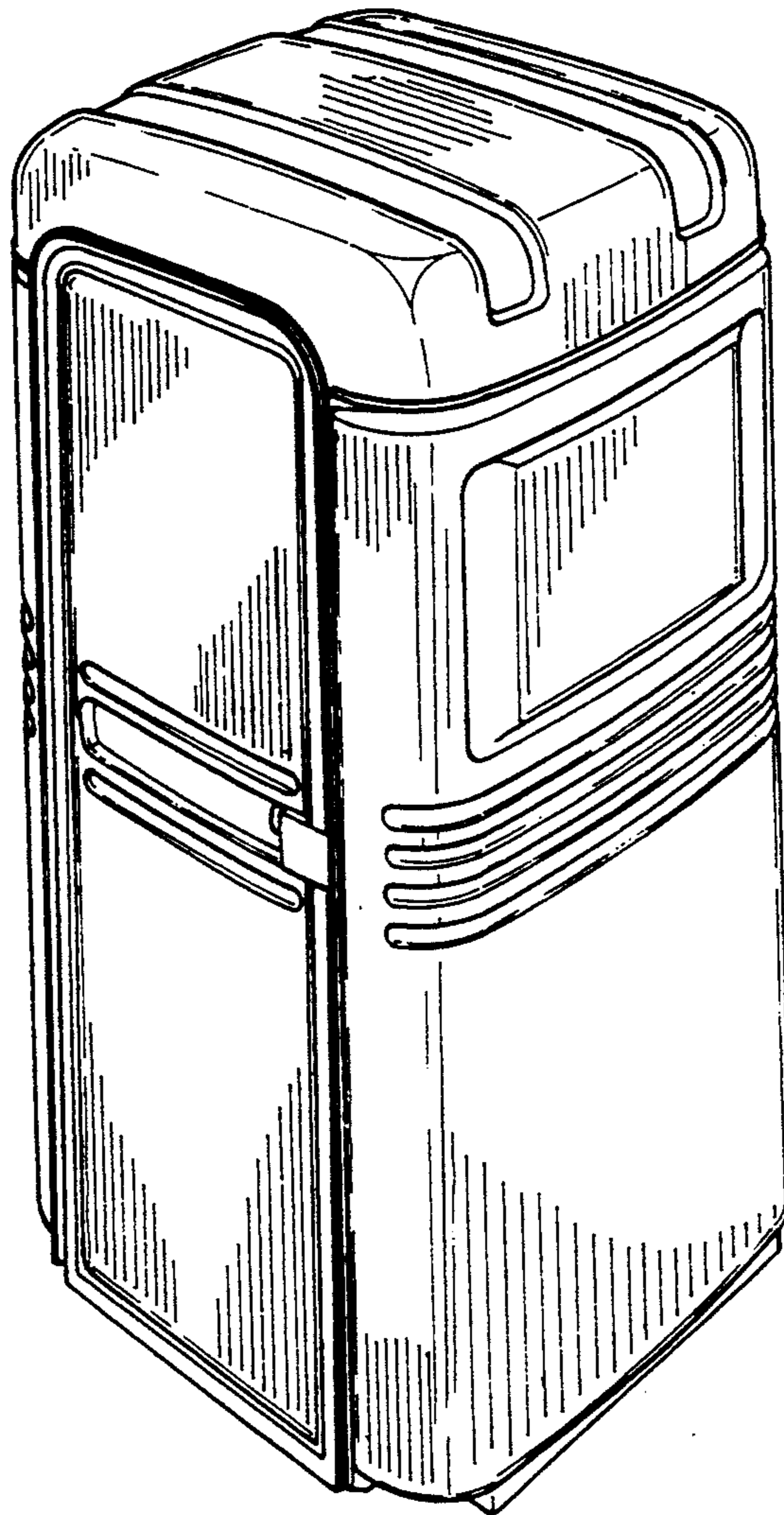
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

The bottom is plain and unadorned.



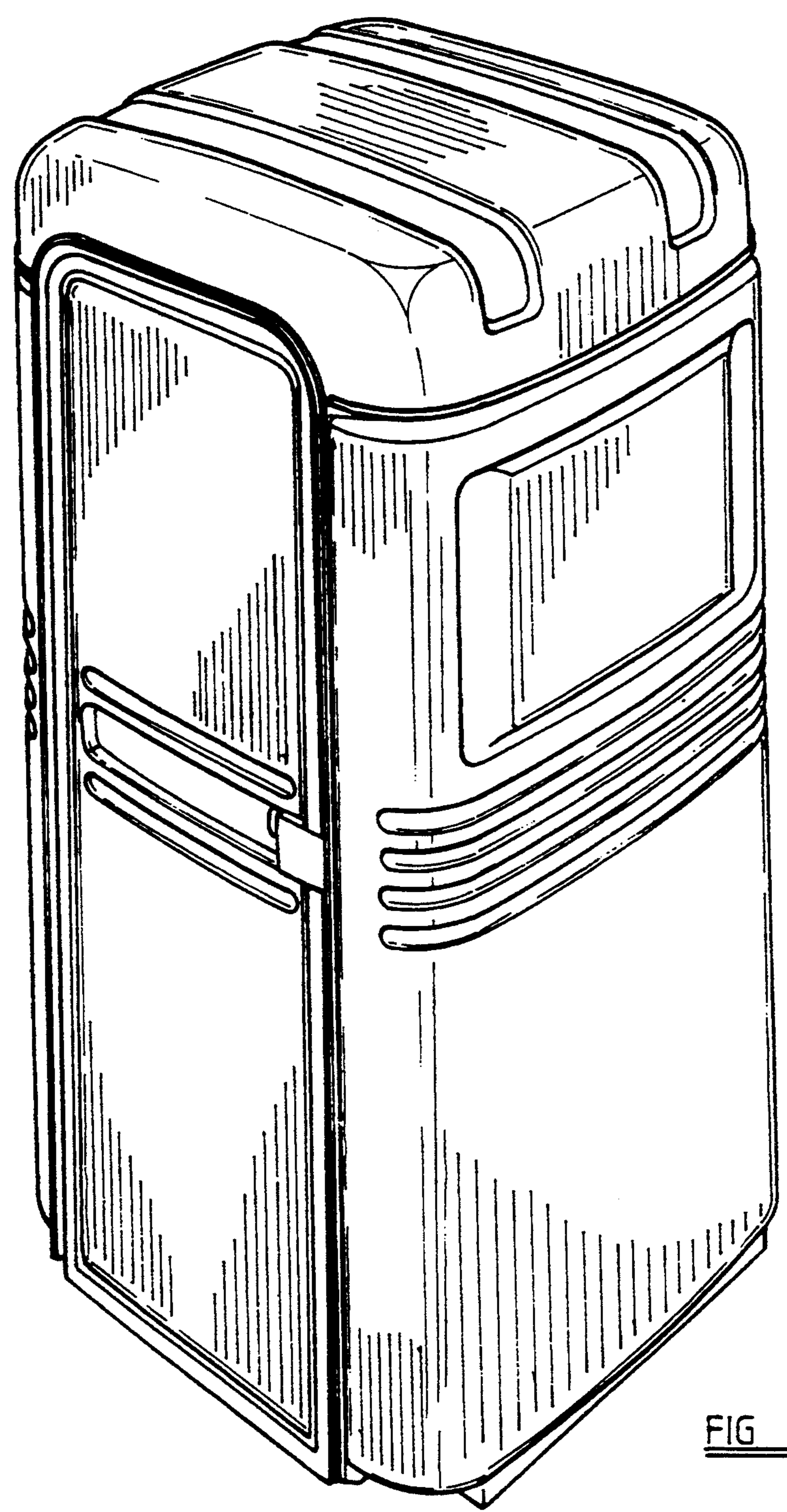

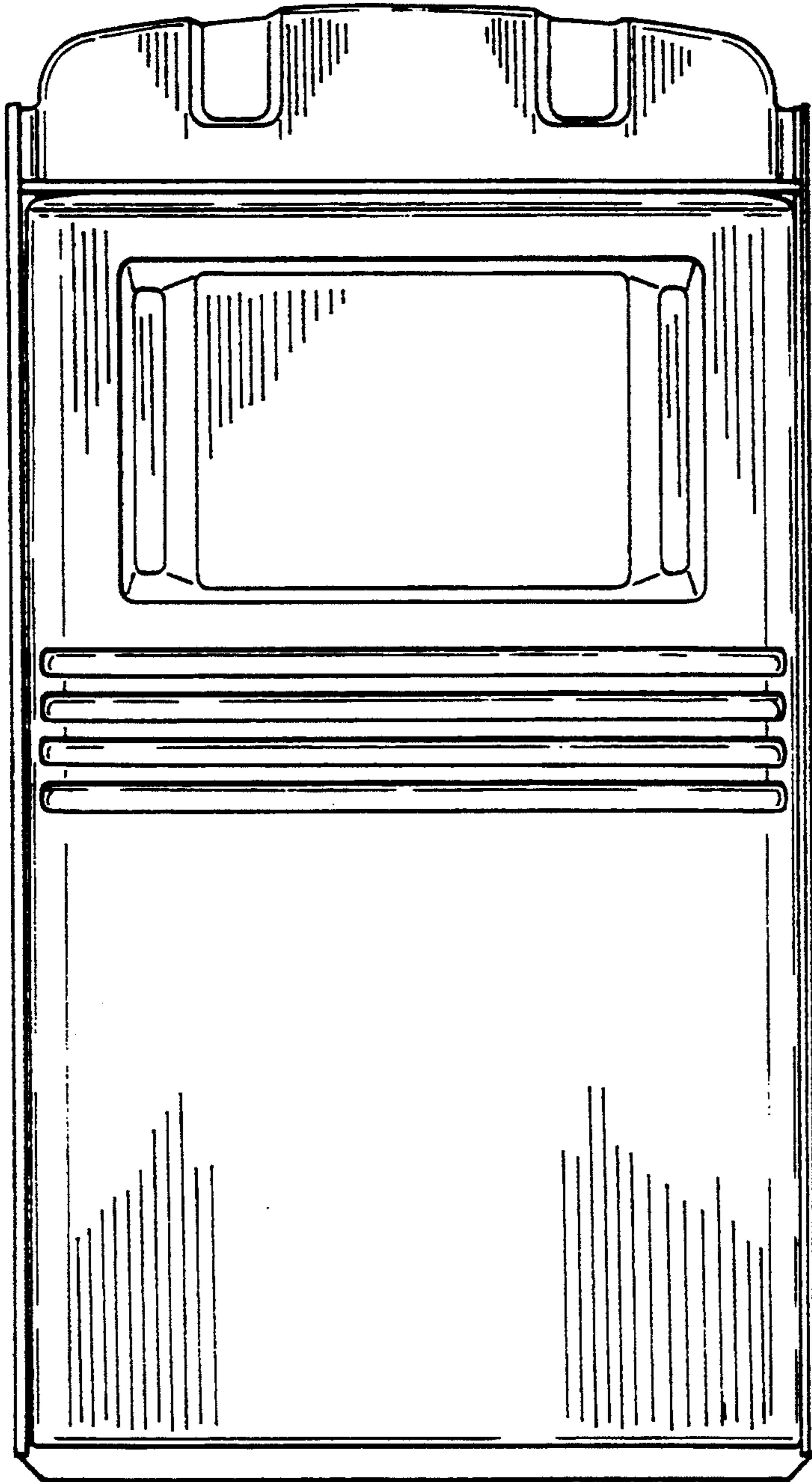

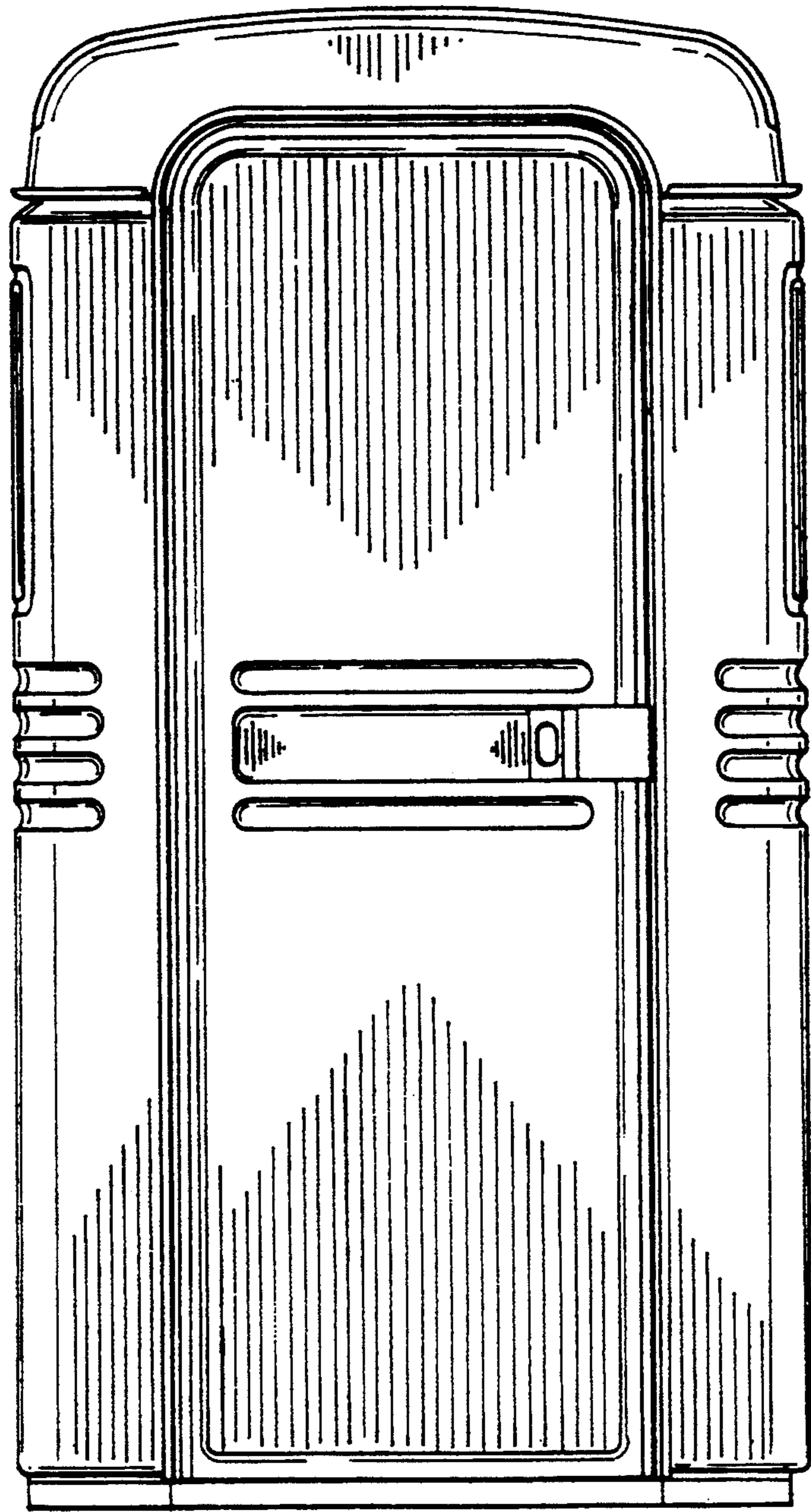

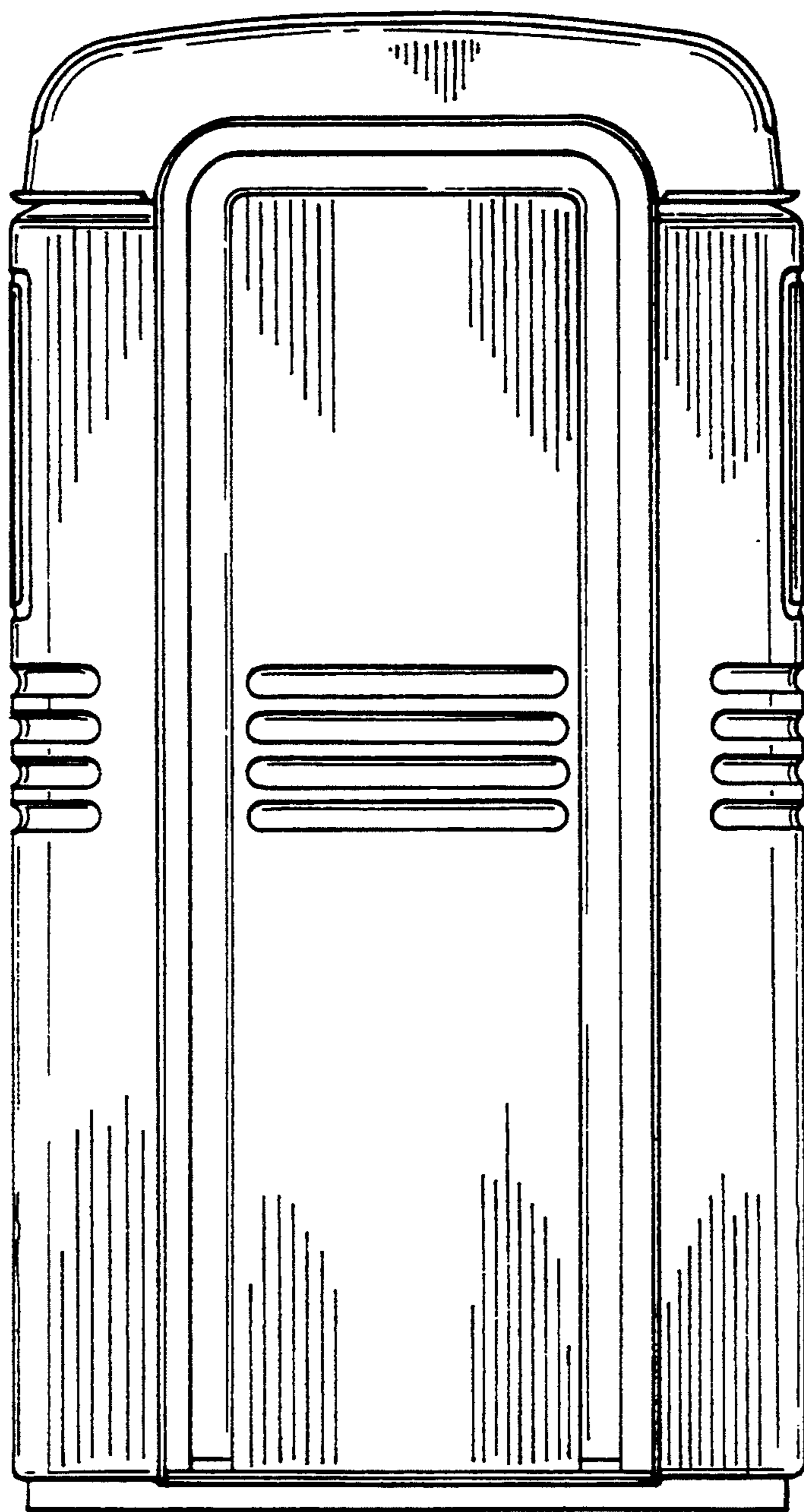

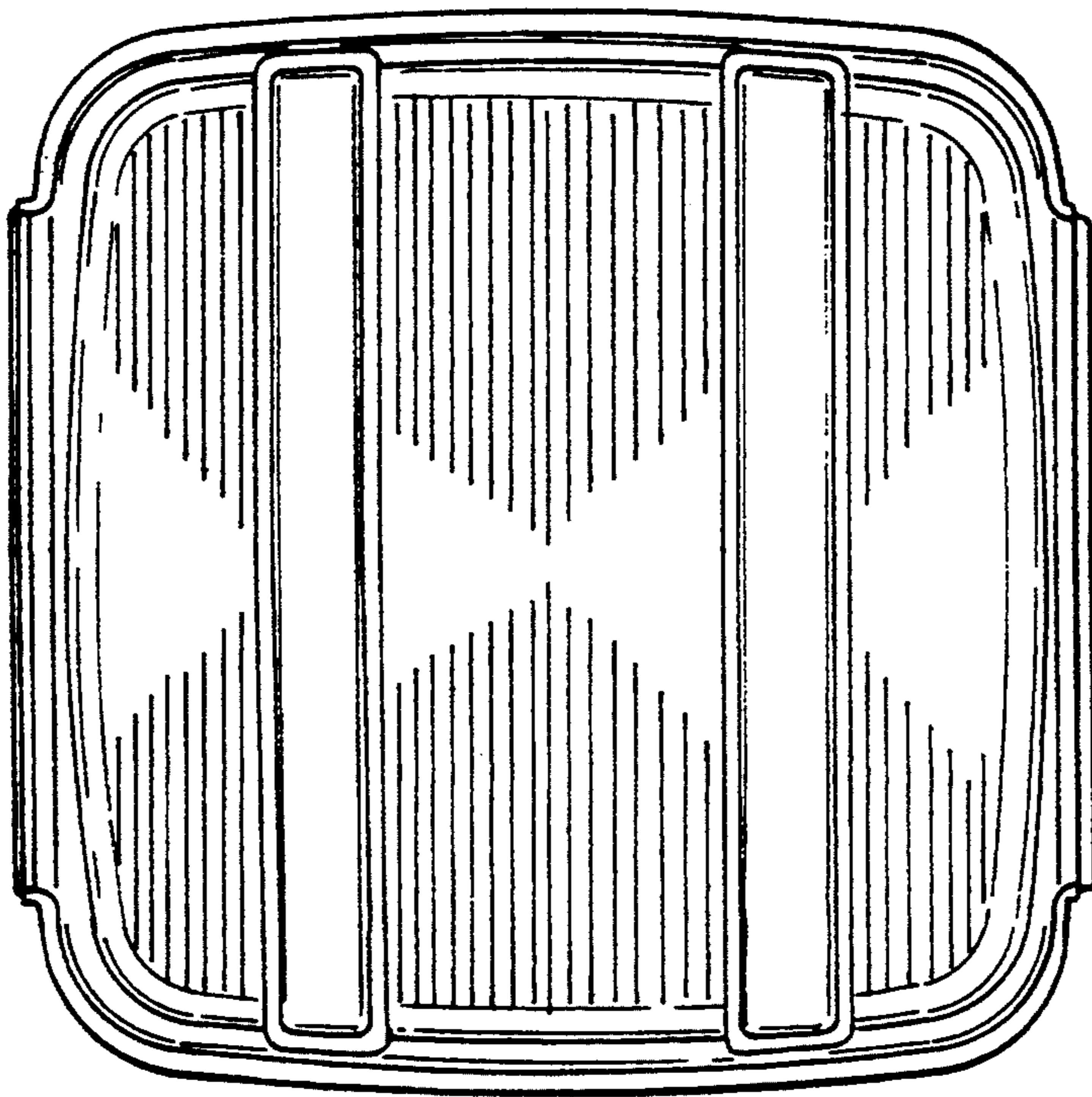
