The ornamental design for a outer surface of a set of doors for an electronic equipment cabinet, as shown and described.

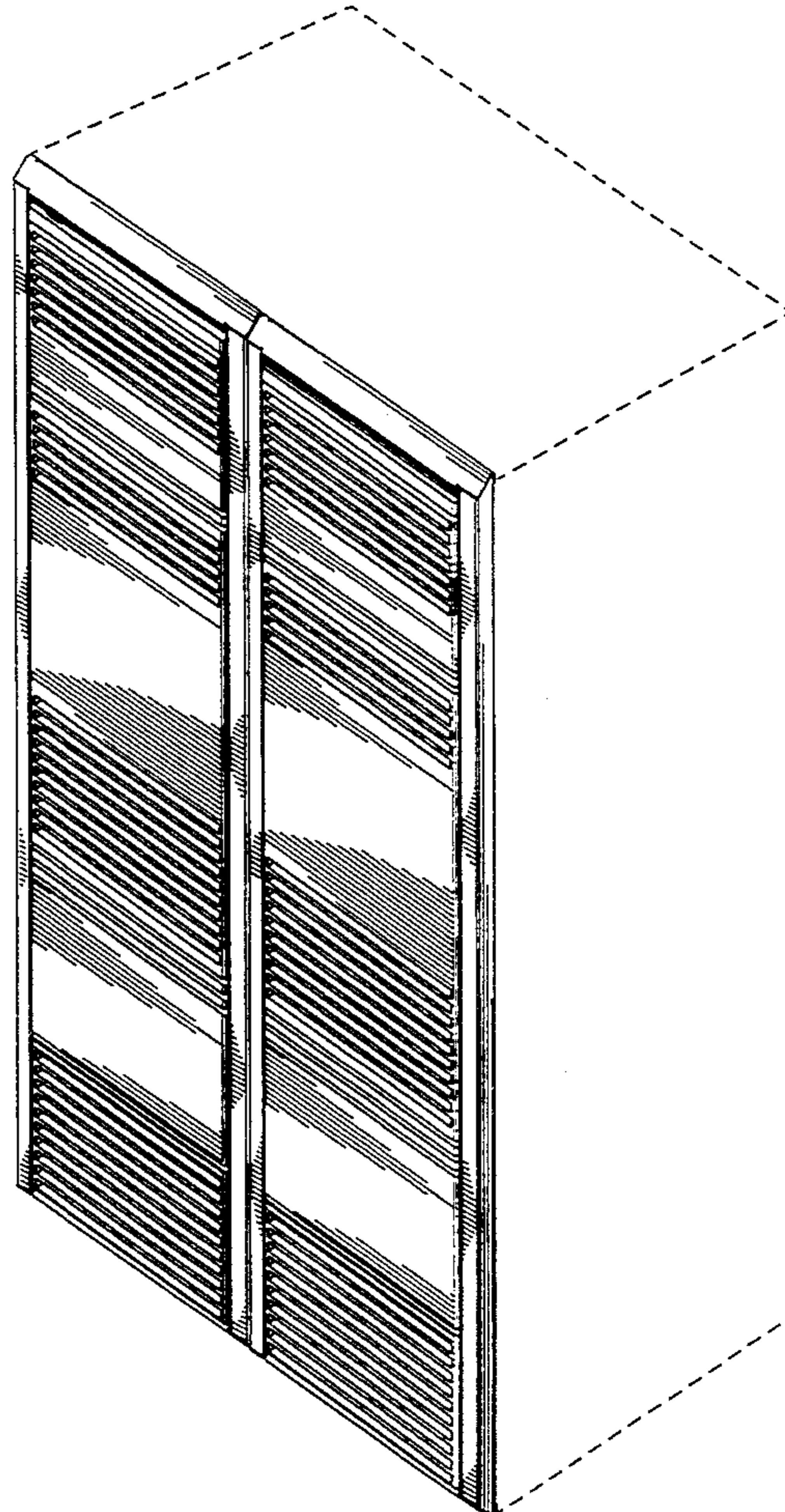
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view showing our new design for the outer surface of a set of doors for an electronic equipment cabinet with the broken line matter being for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forming no part of the claimed design;

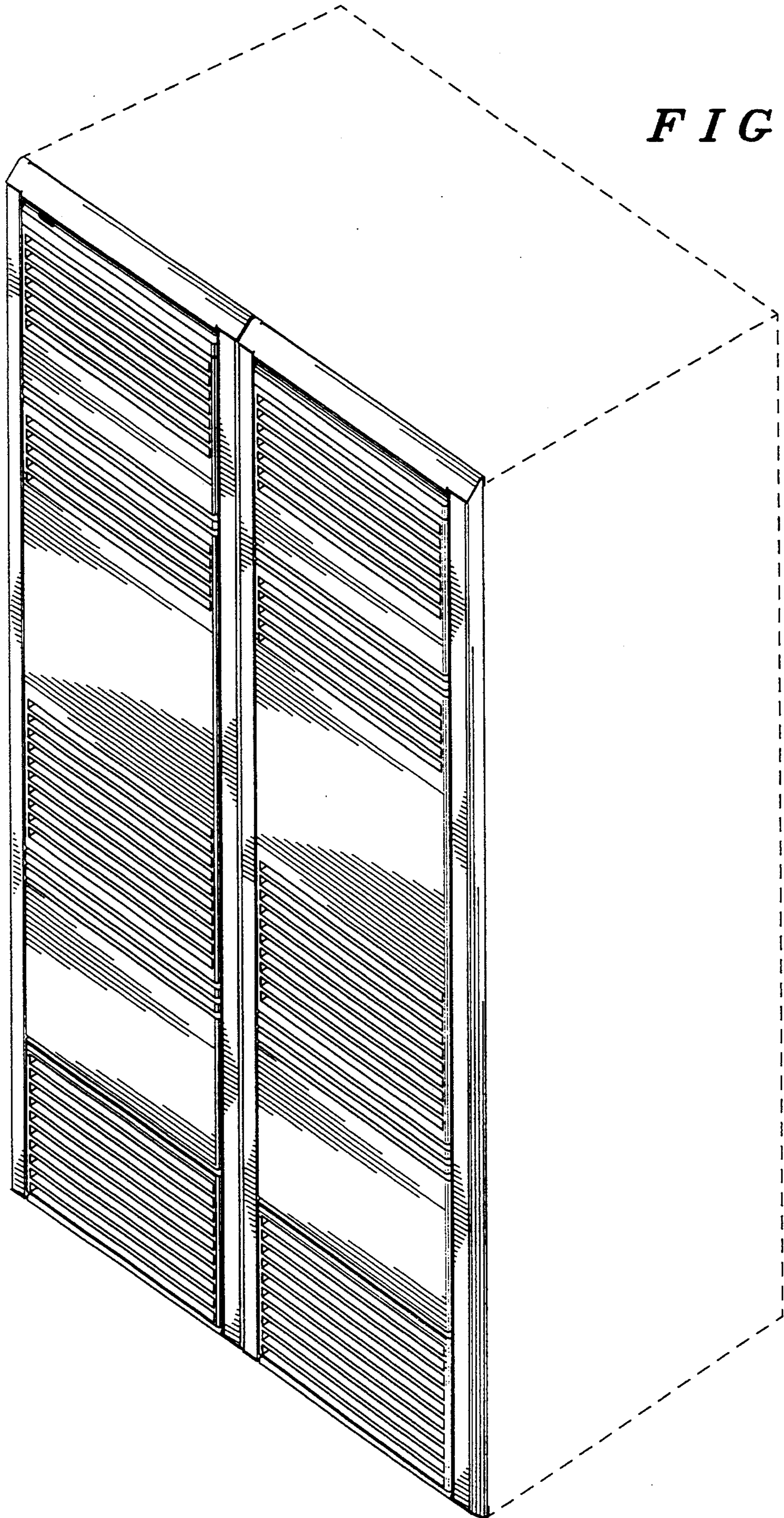
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being the same; and,

The plan and side elevational views are the same as the first embodiment.

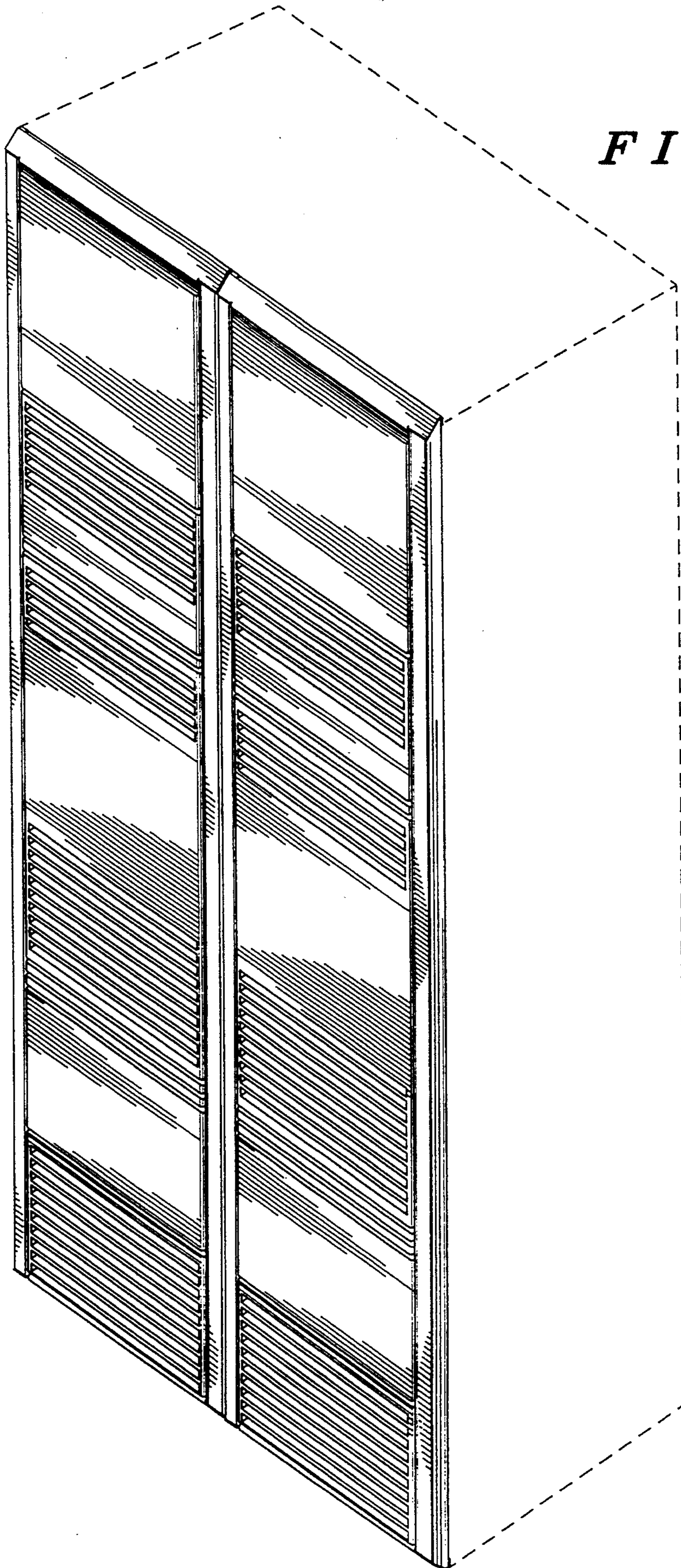
