FIG. 7 is a right-side view thereof.

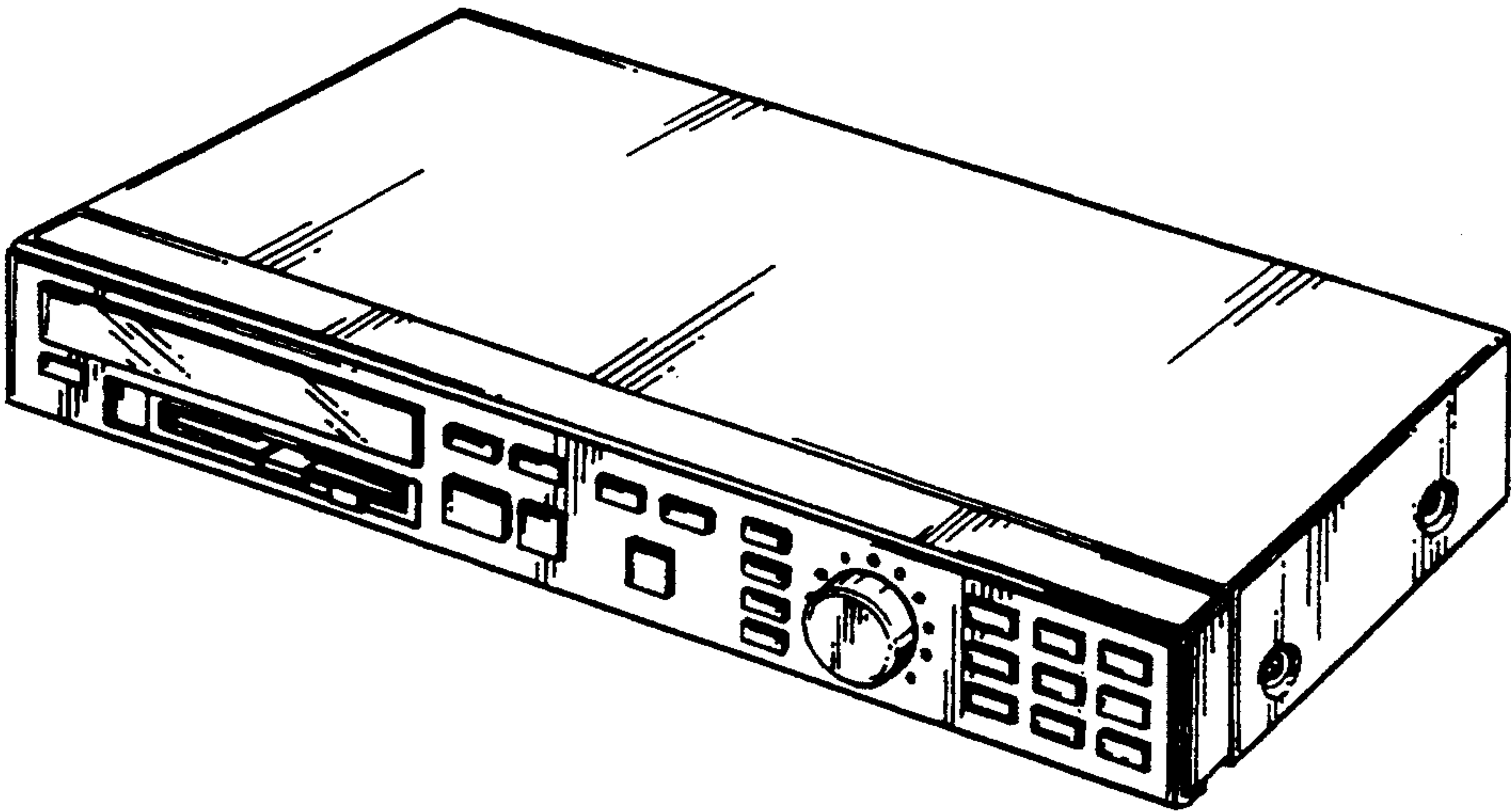

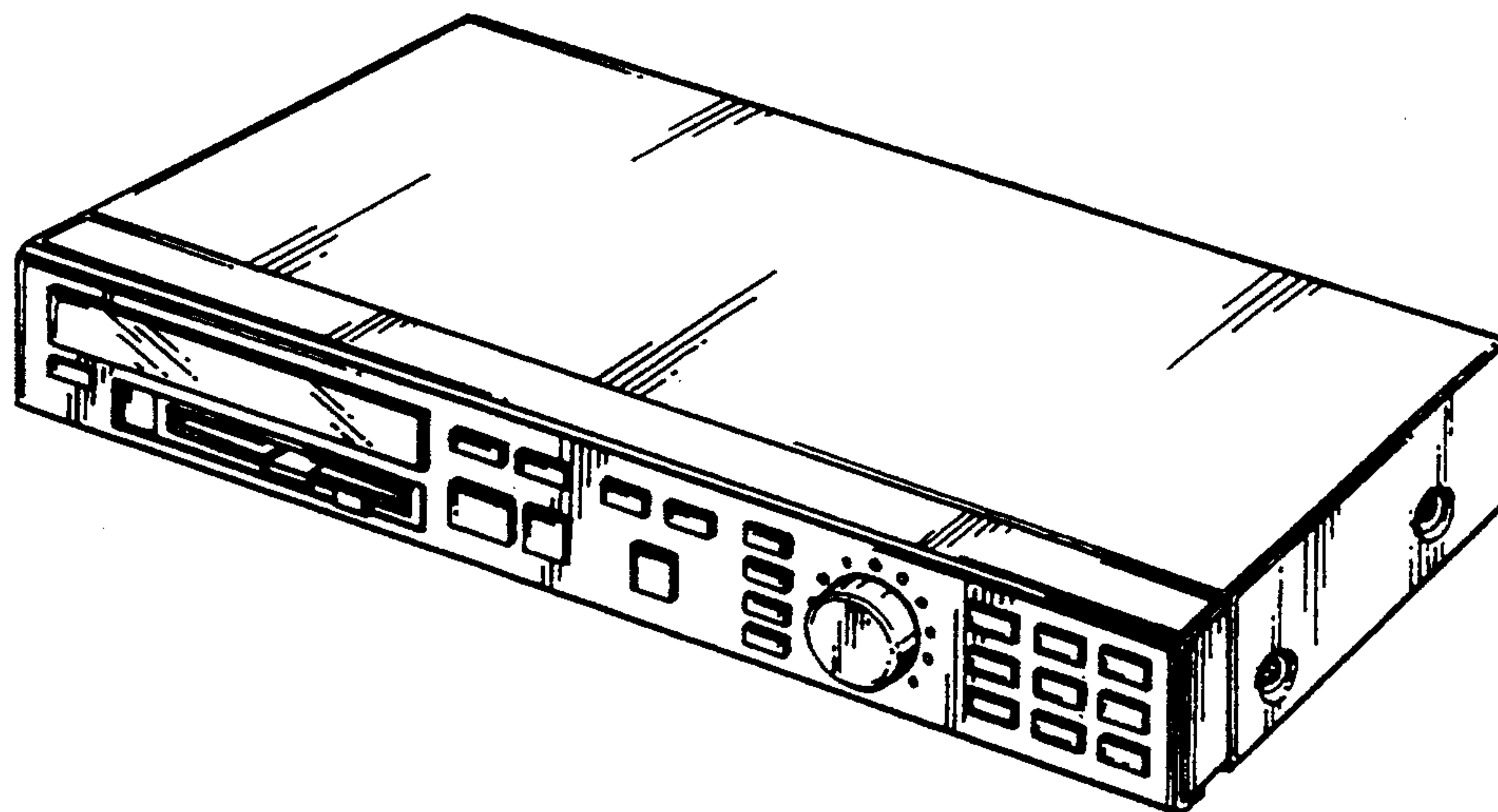

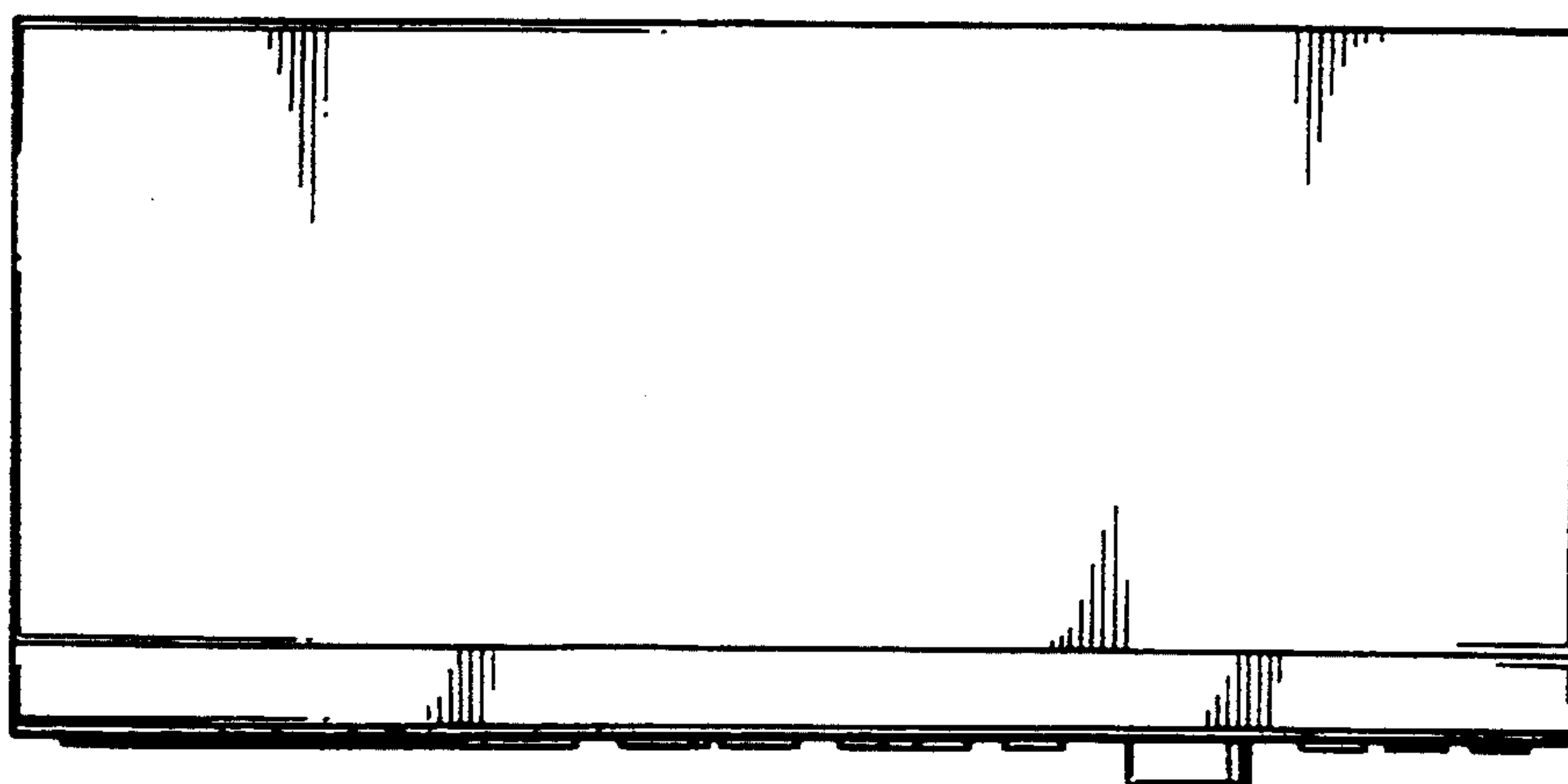

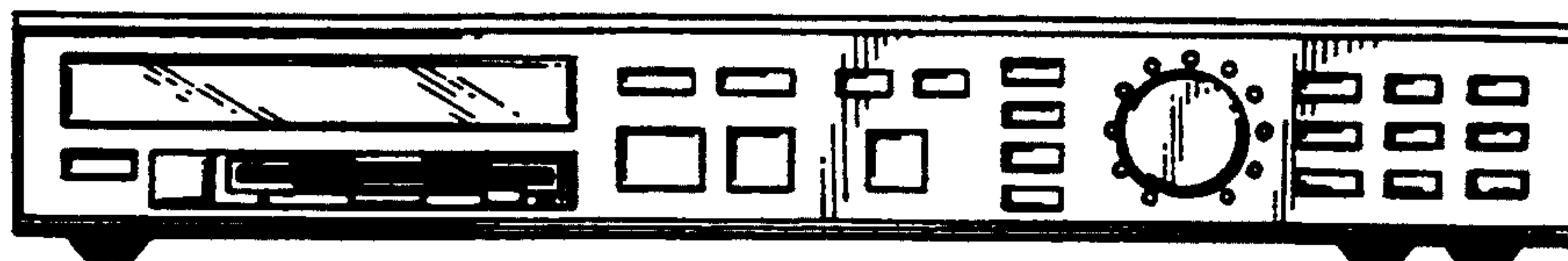

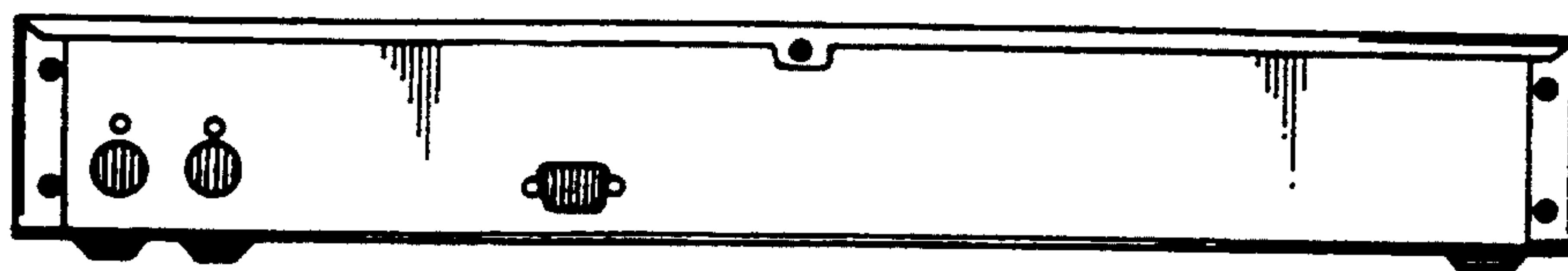

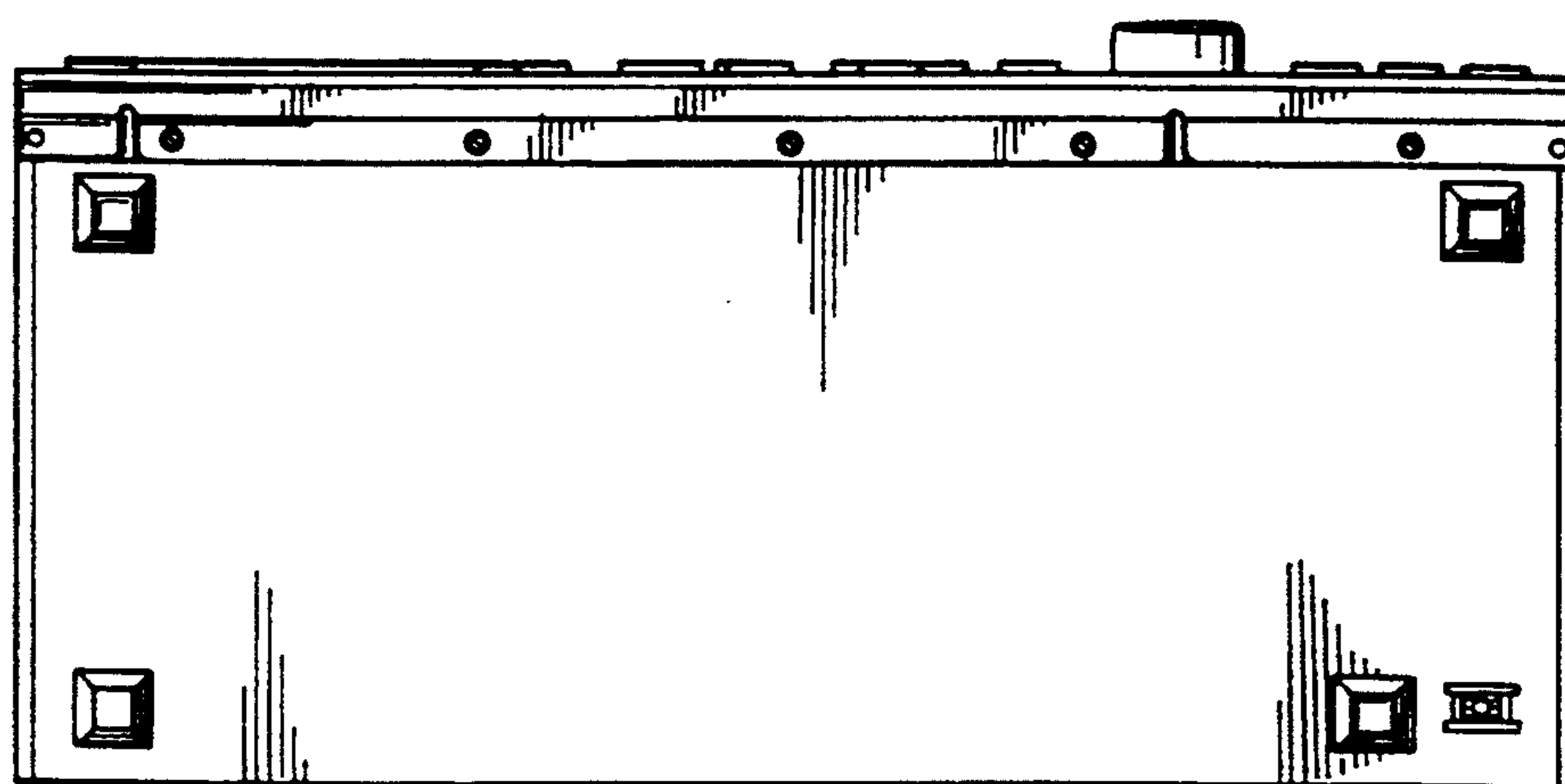

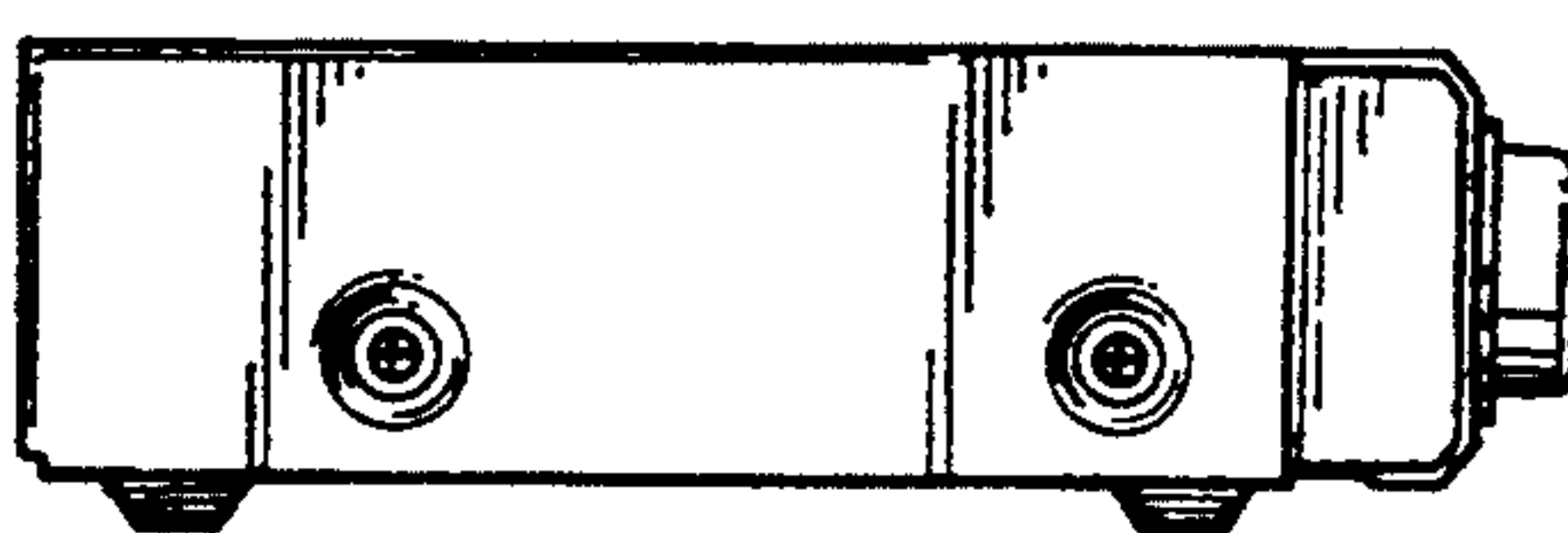
