CLAIM

The ornamental design for a guitar body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a guitar body showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right-side view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left-side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a back view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an upper end view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a lower end view thereof.

Broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 4 show environmental structure only, namely a portion of a guitar neck, and are not a part of the claimed design.
