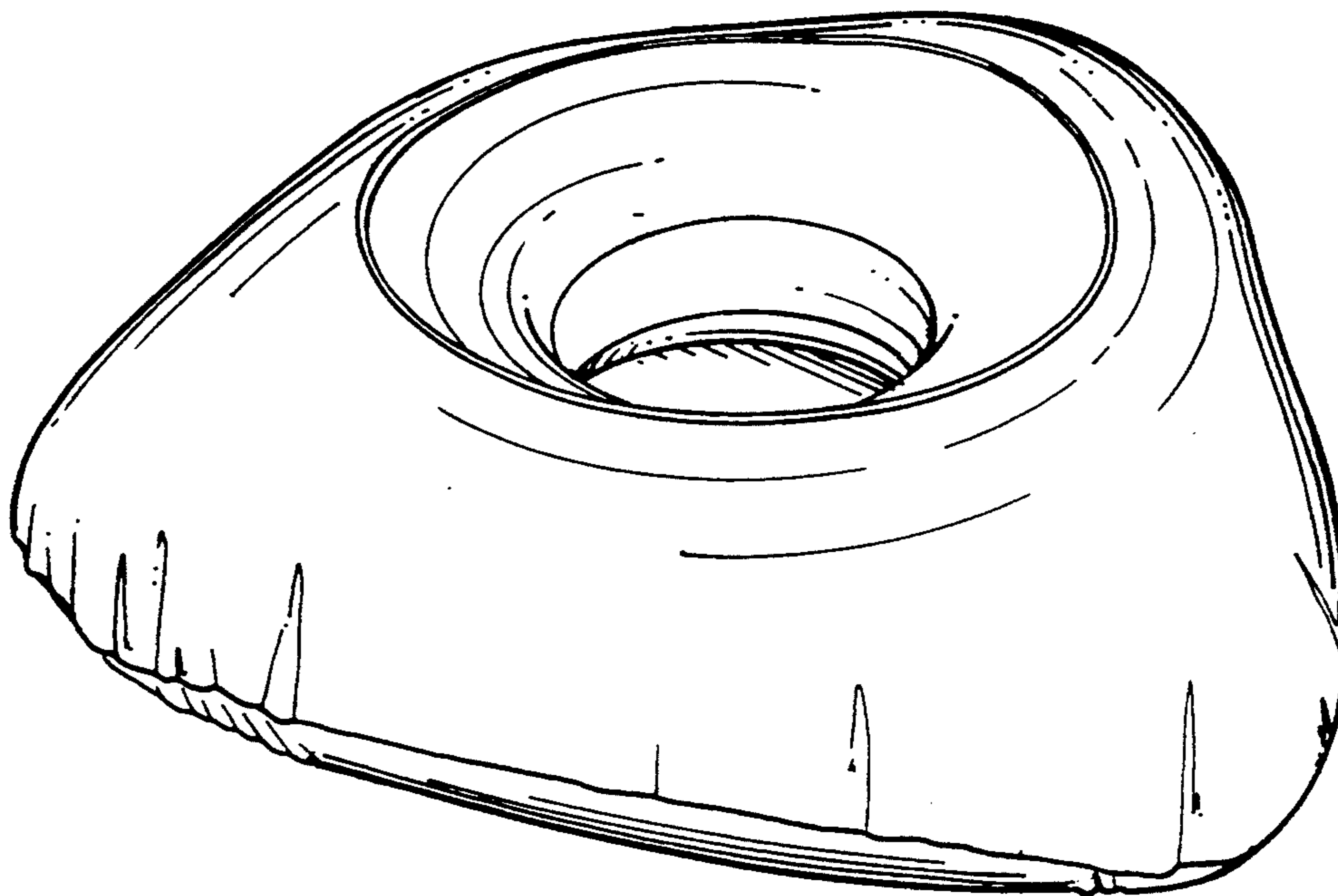

 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof.



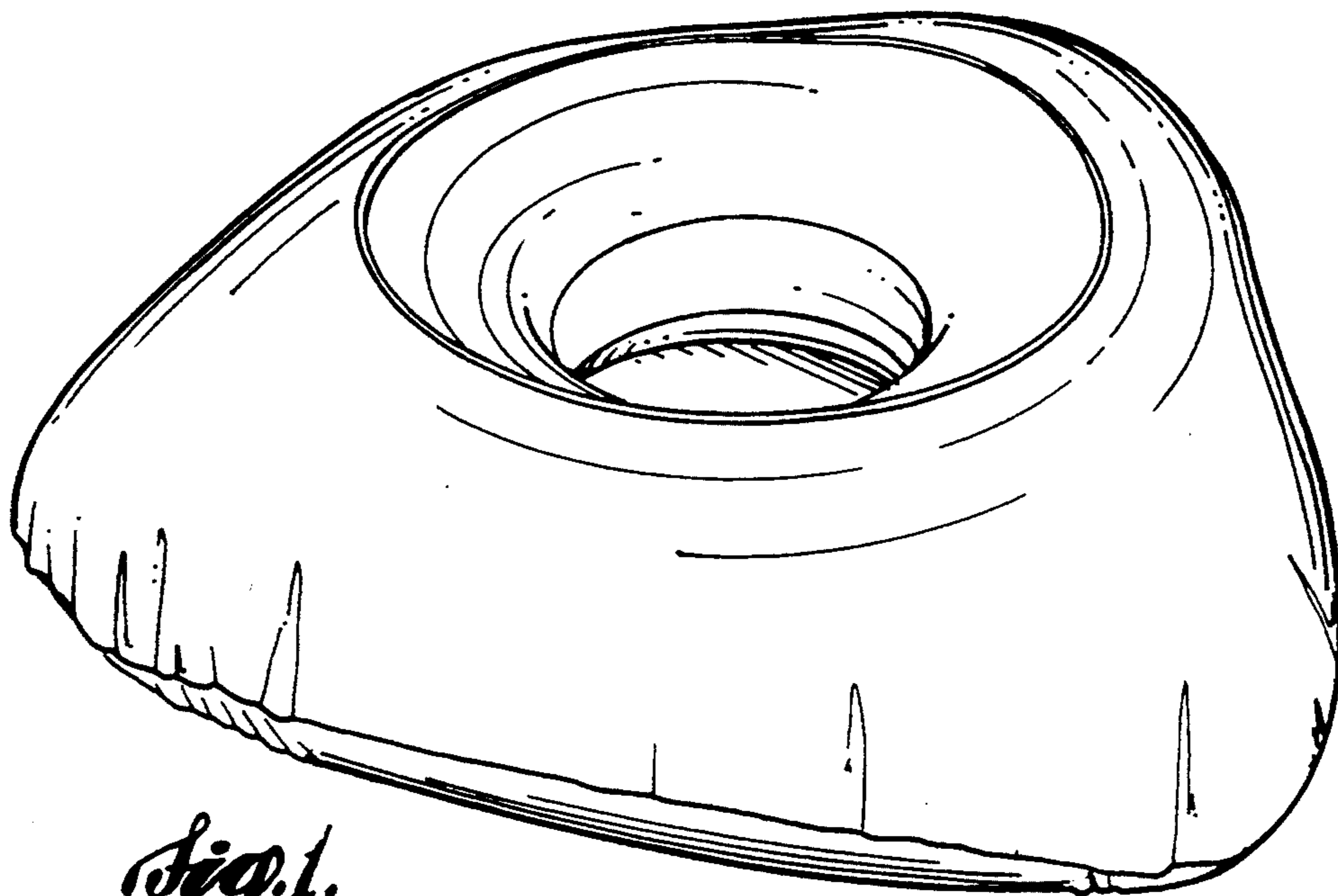

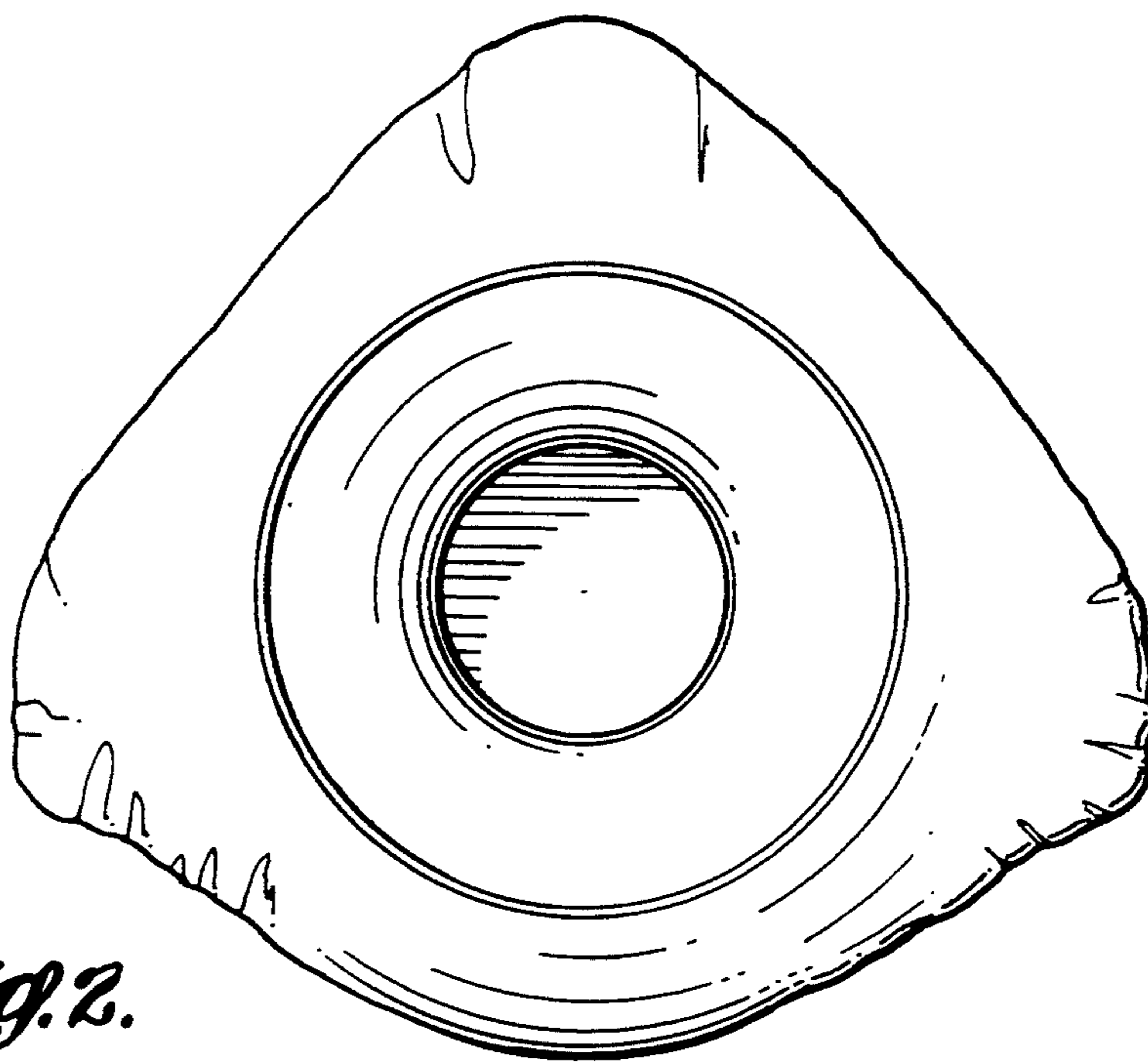

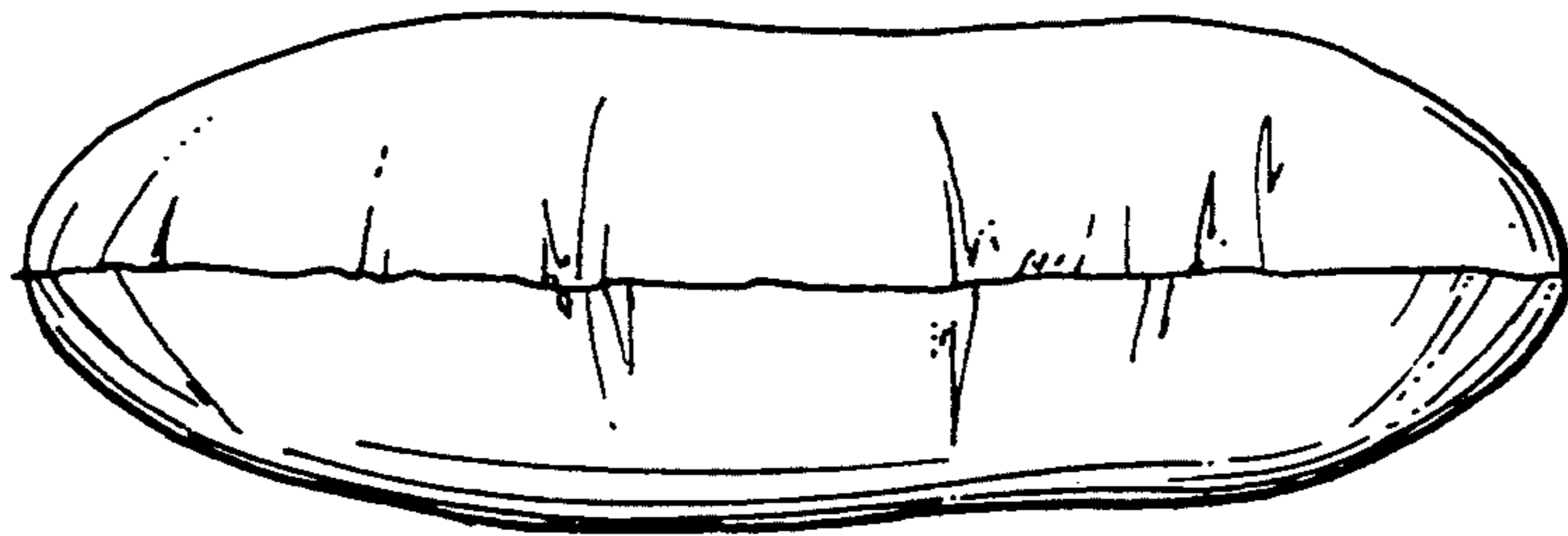
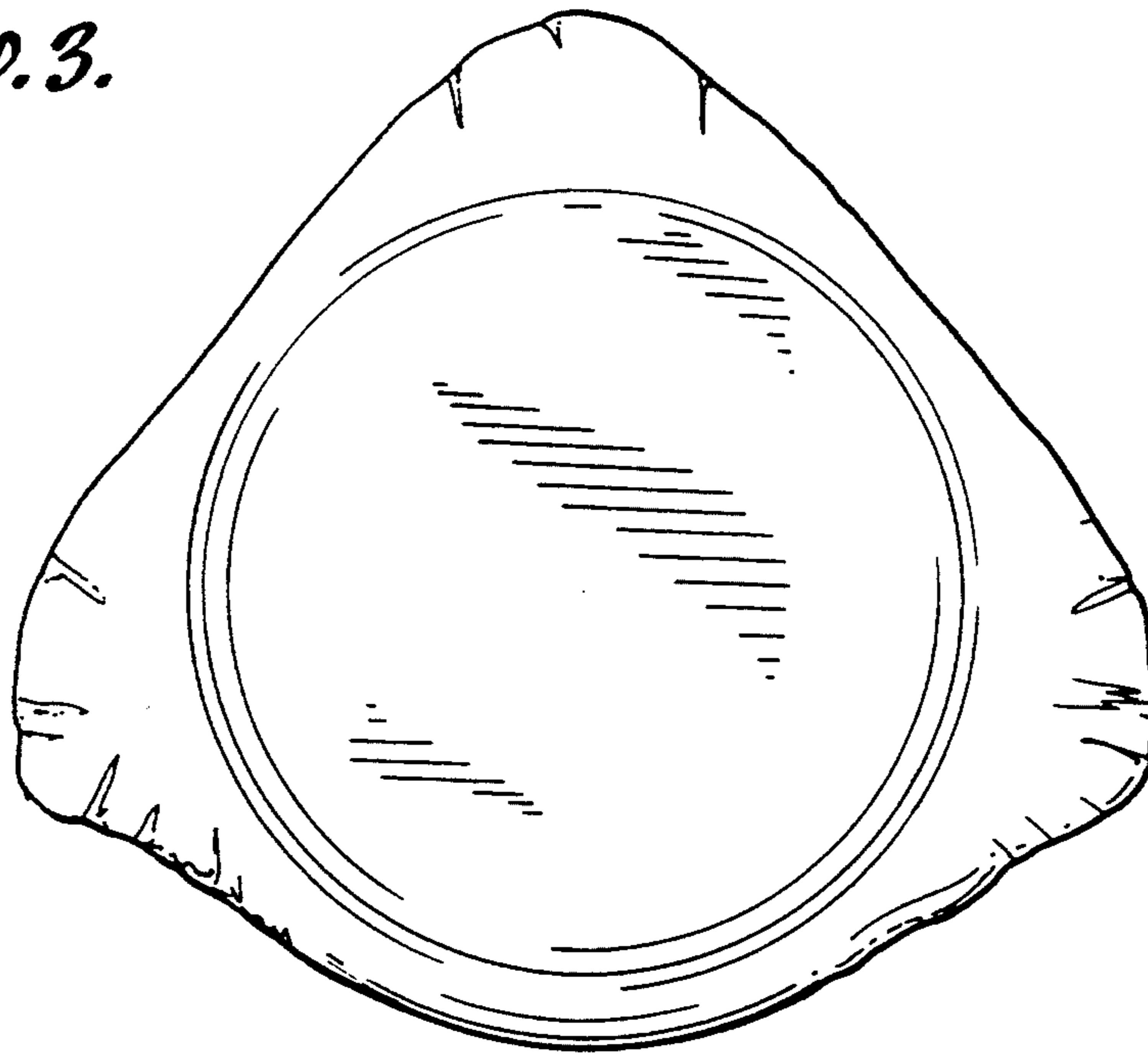

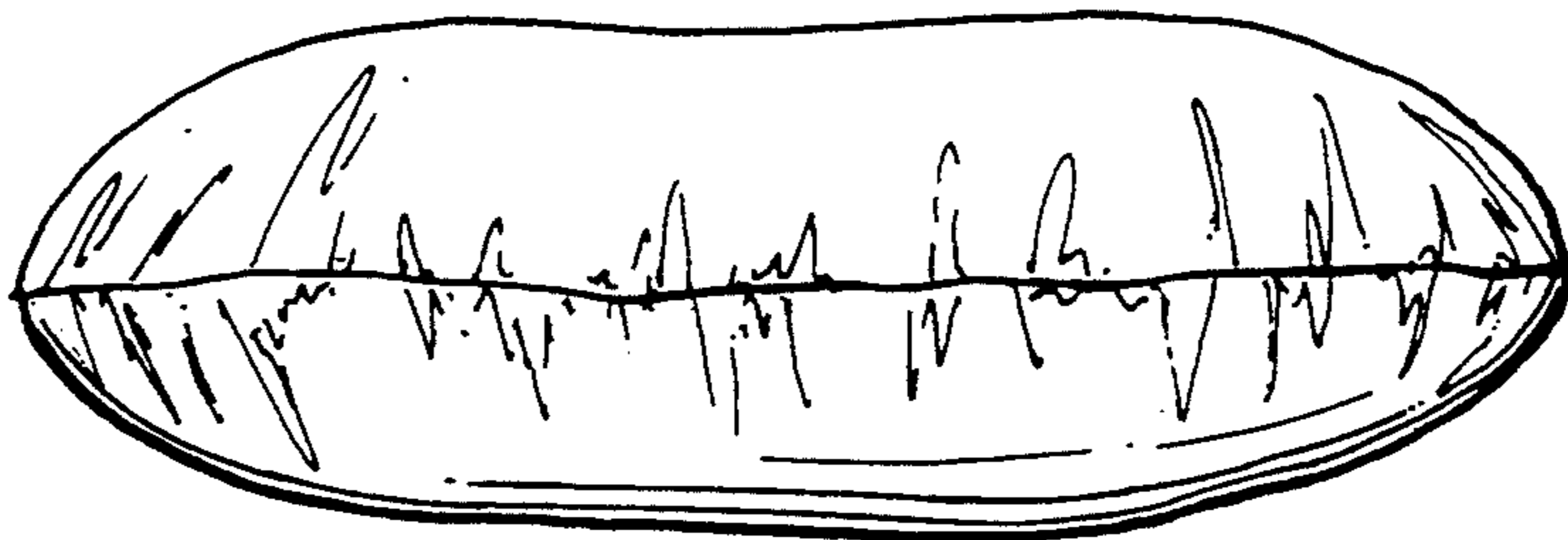

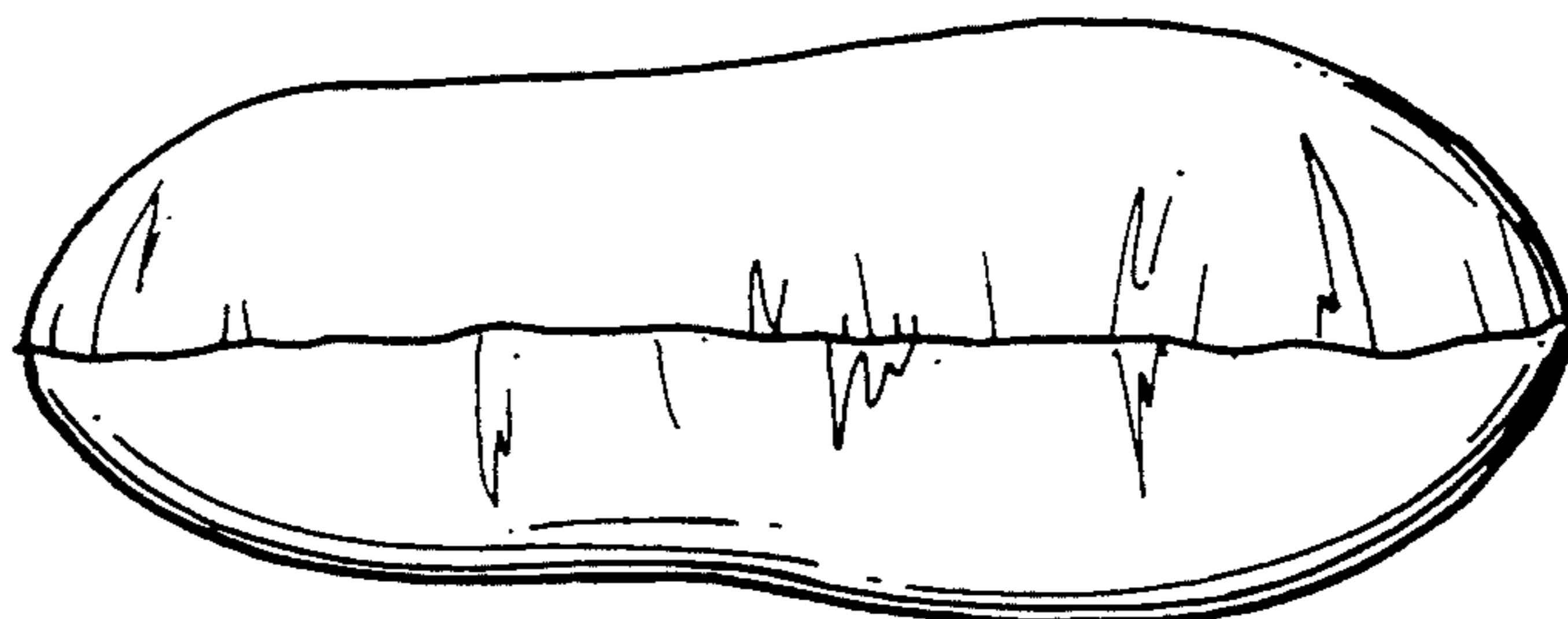
