left side view being a mirror image thereof.

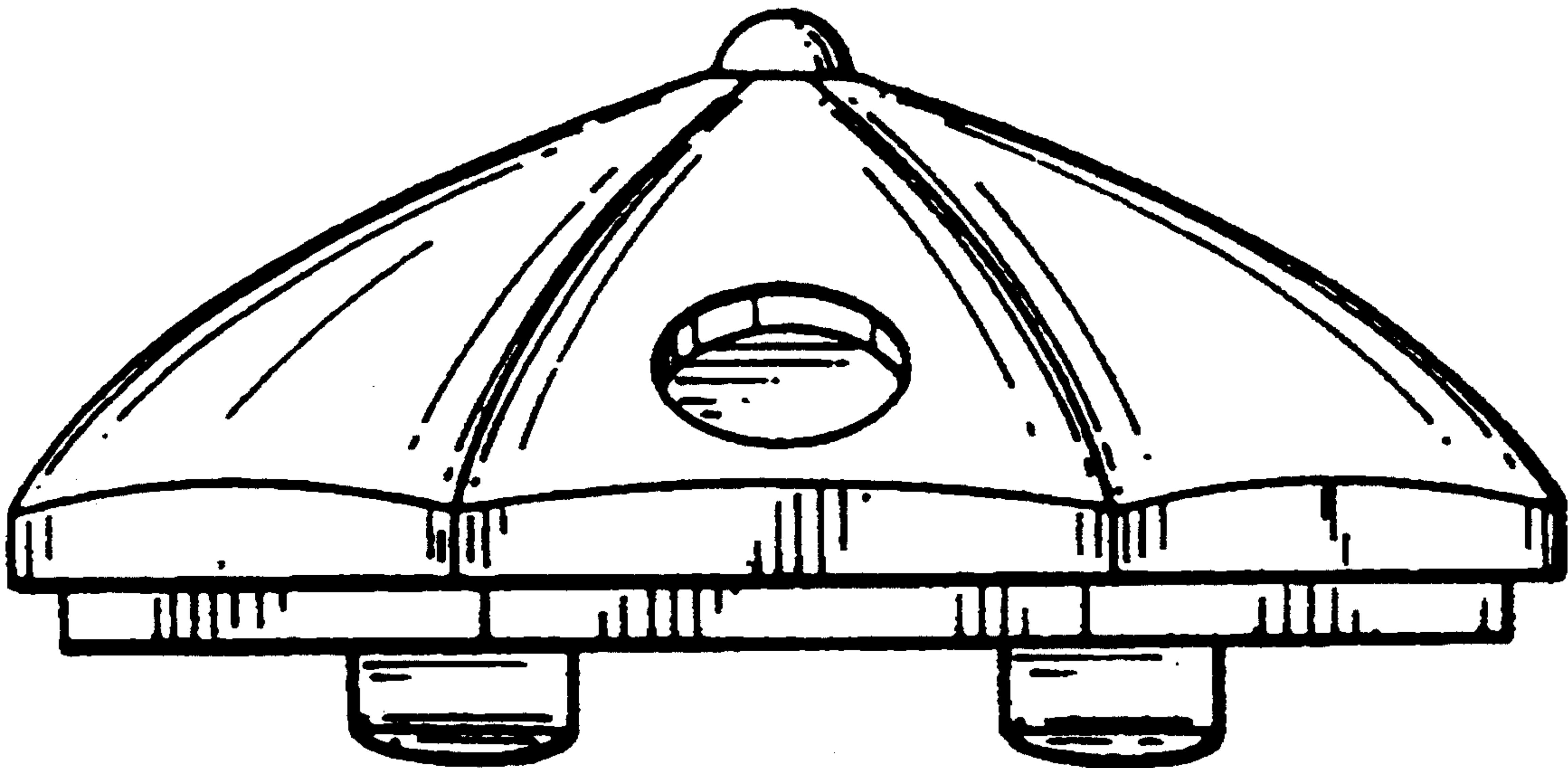

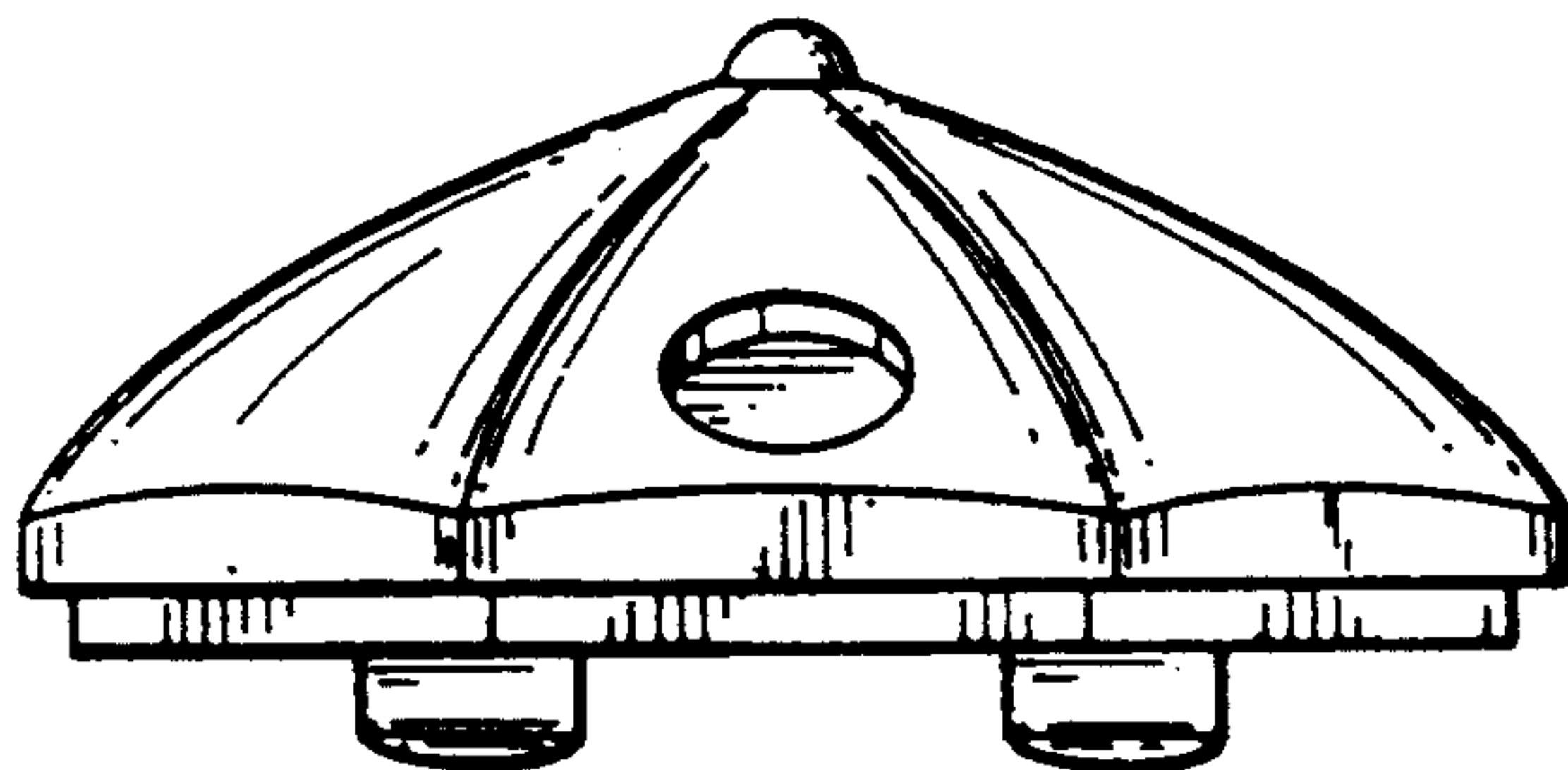

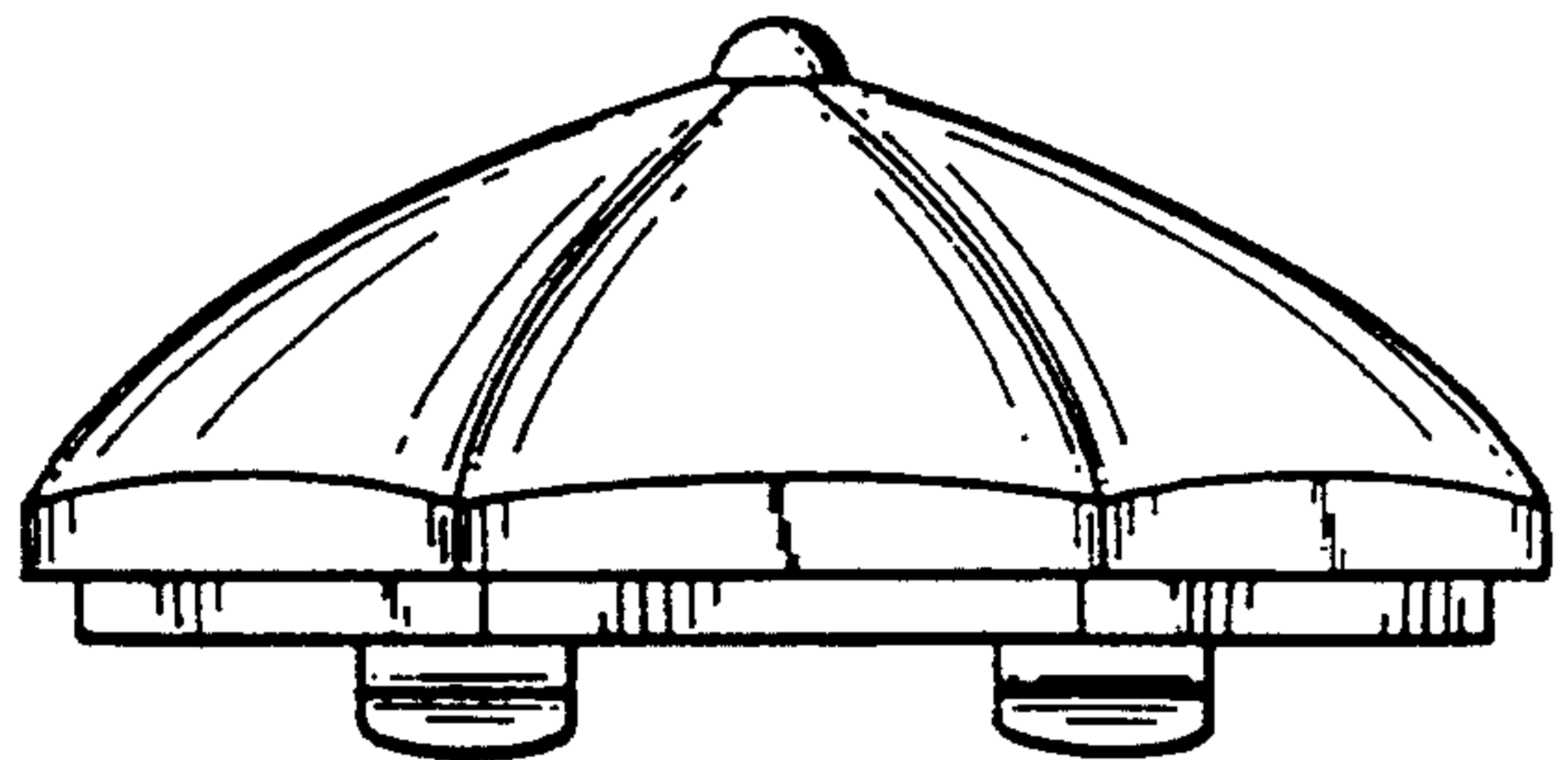

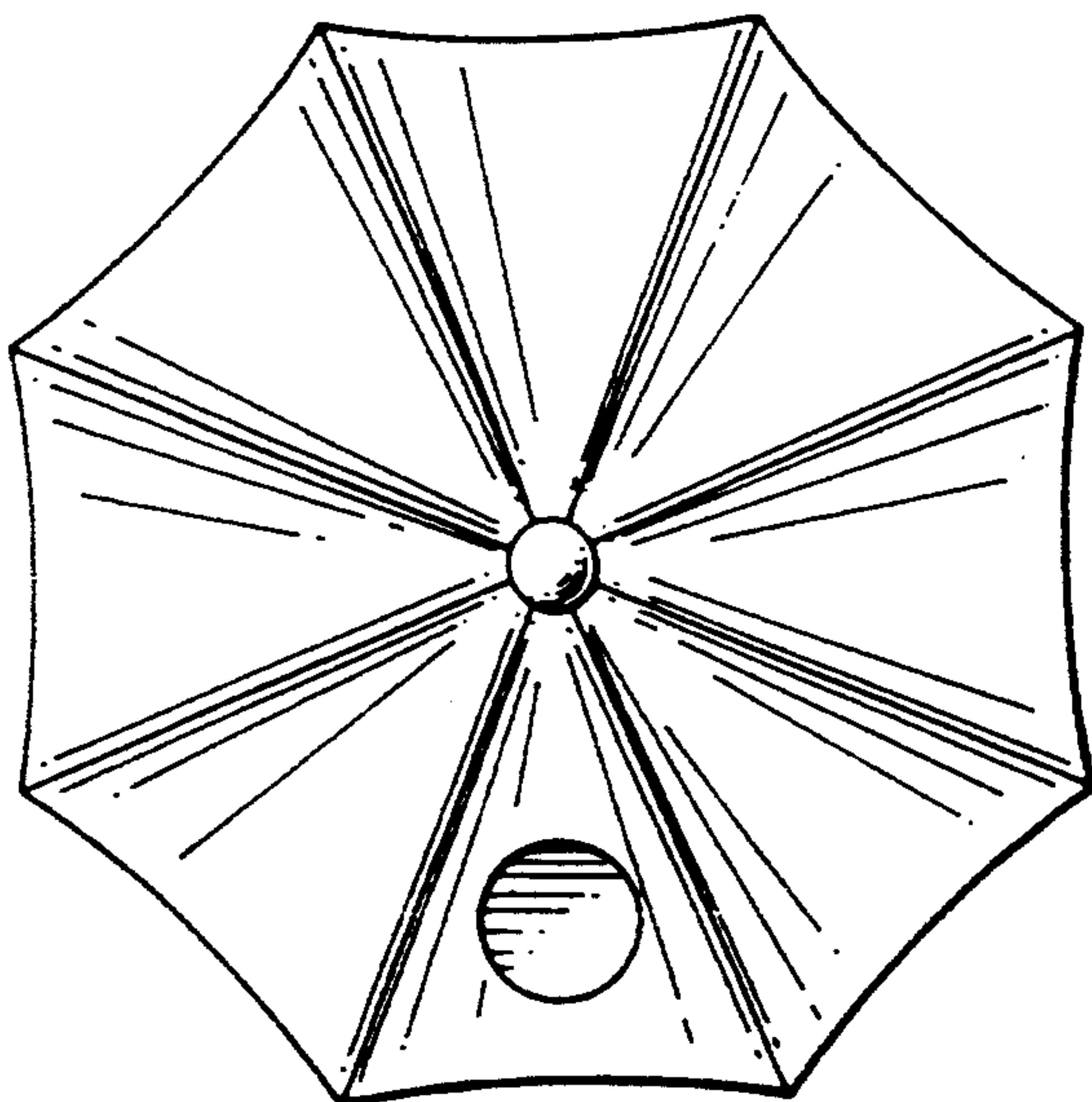

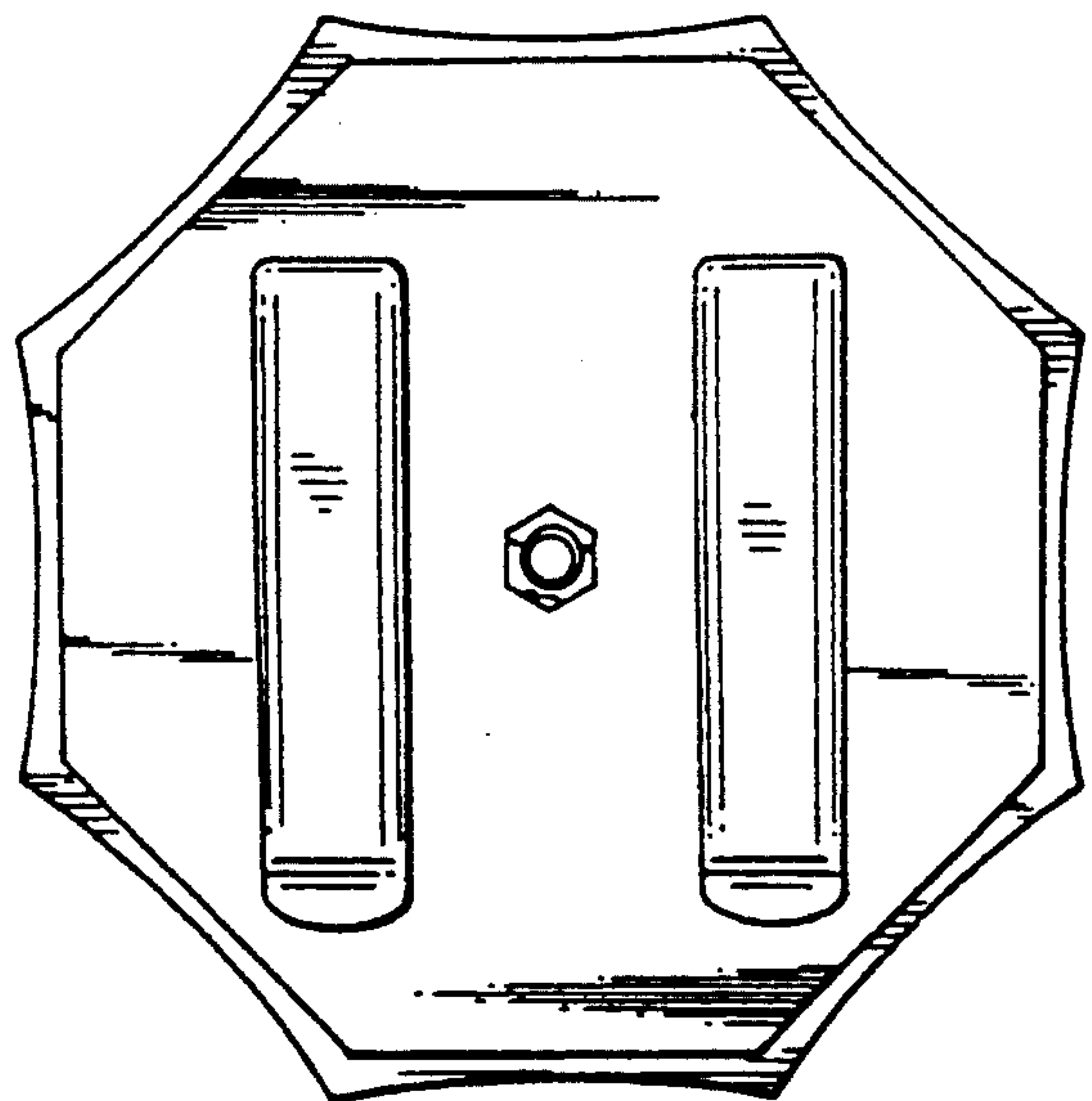
