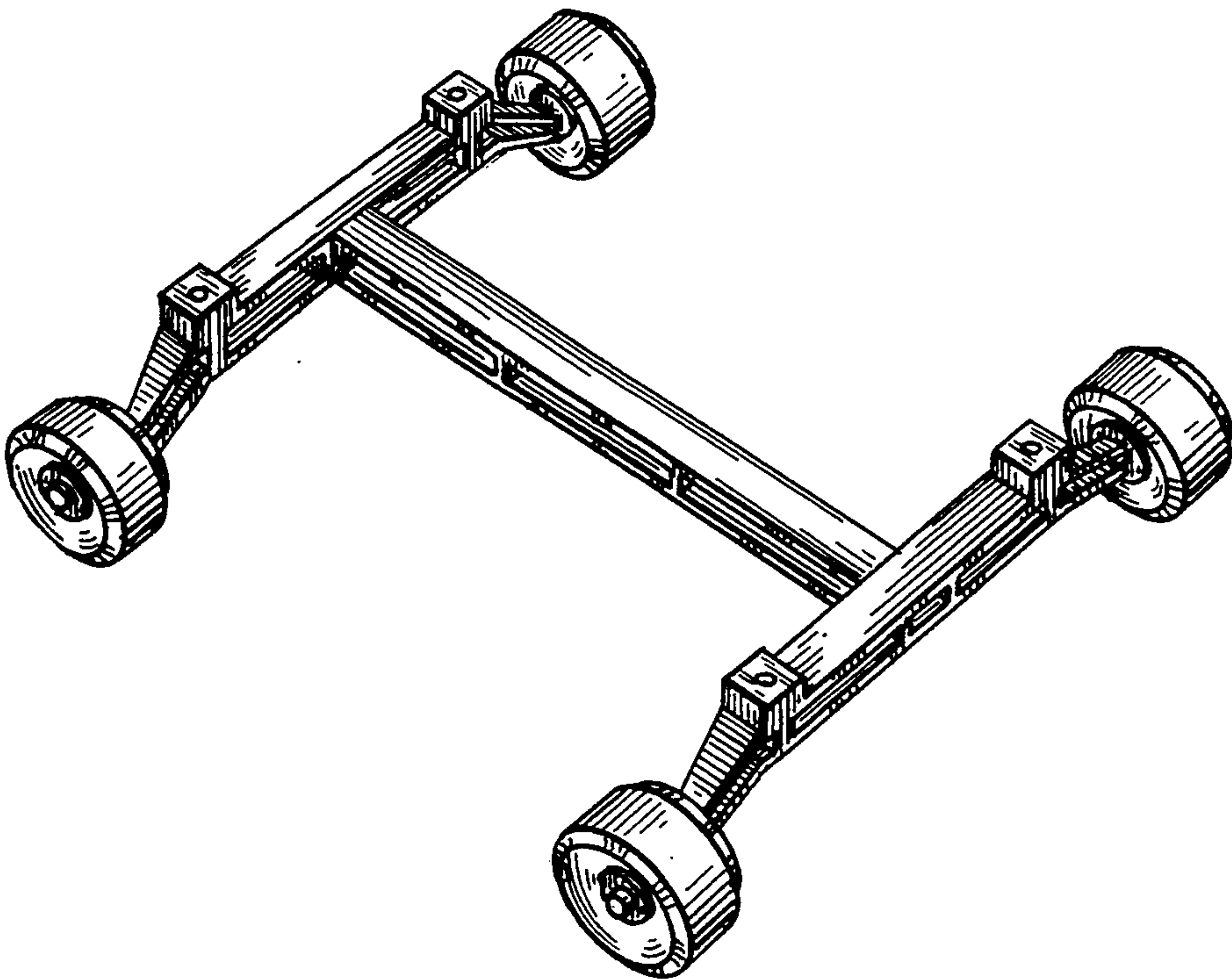
The ornamental design for a container dolly, as shown and described.

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, a left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.



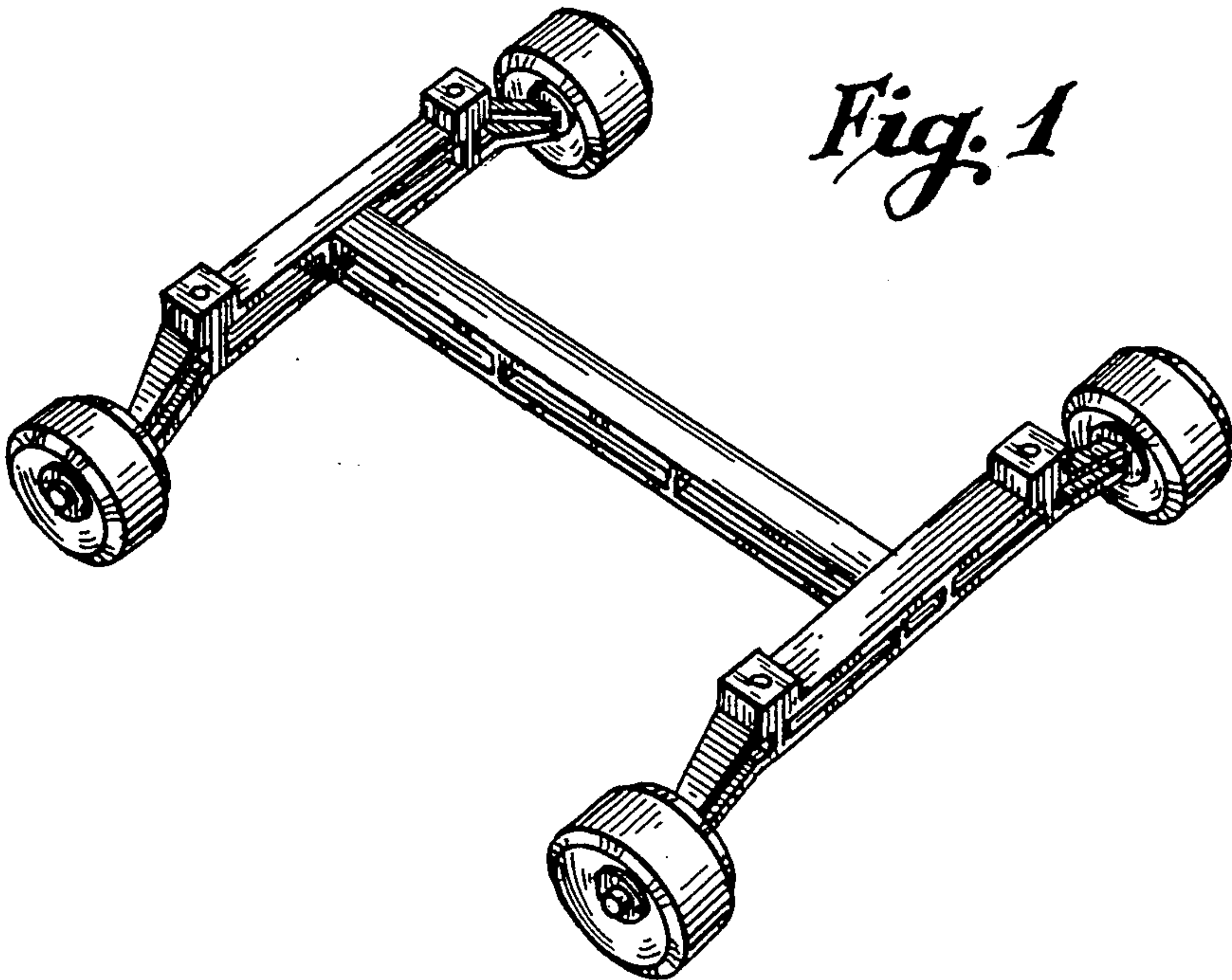

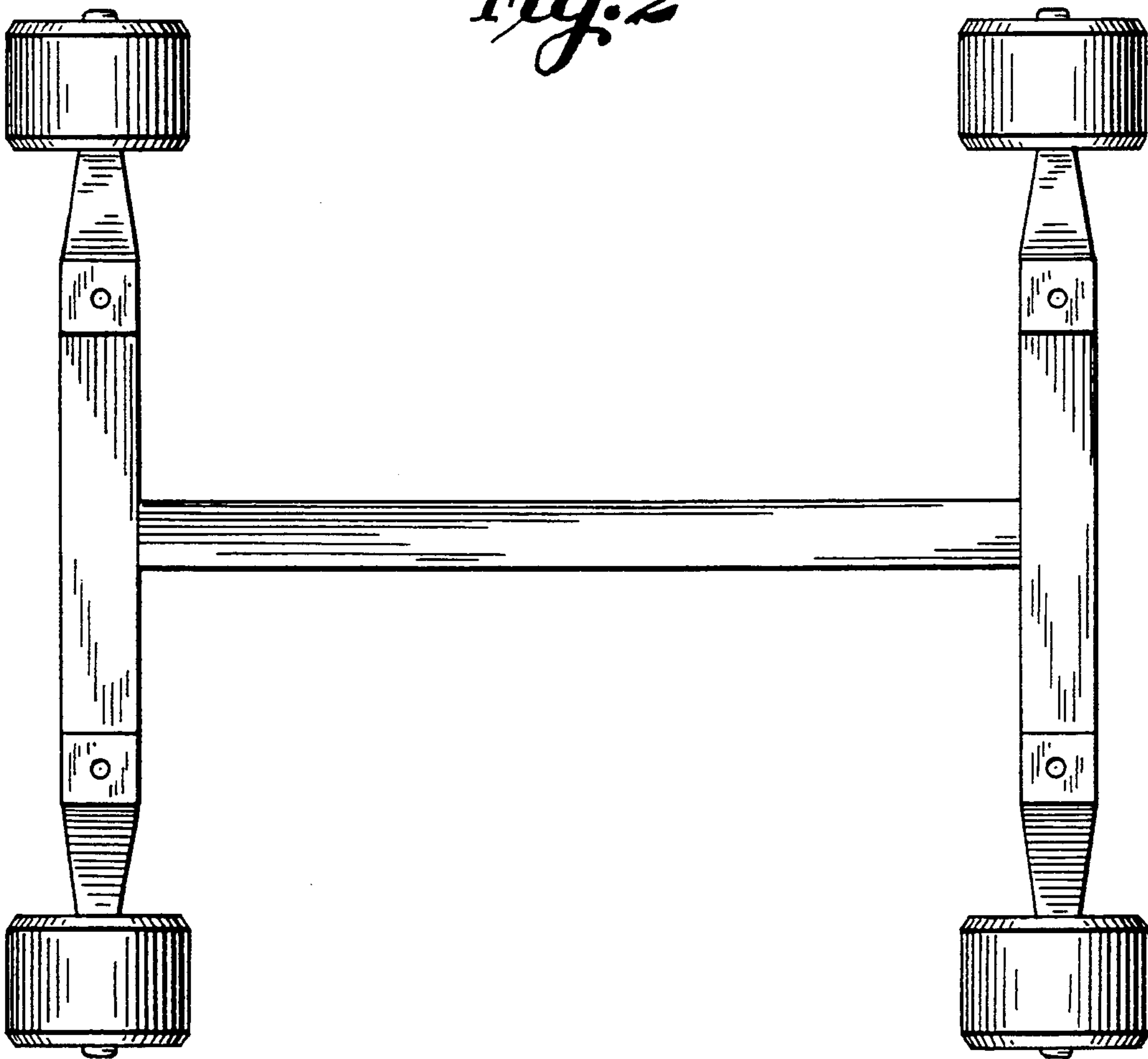

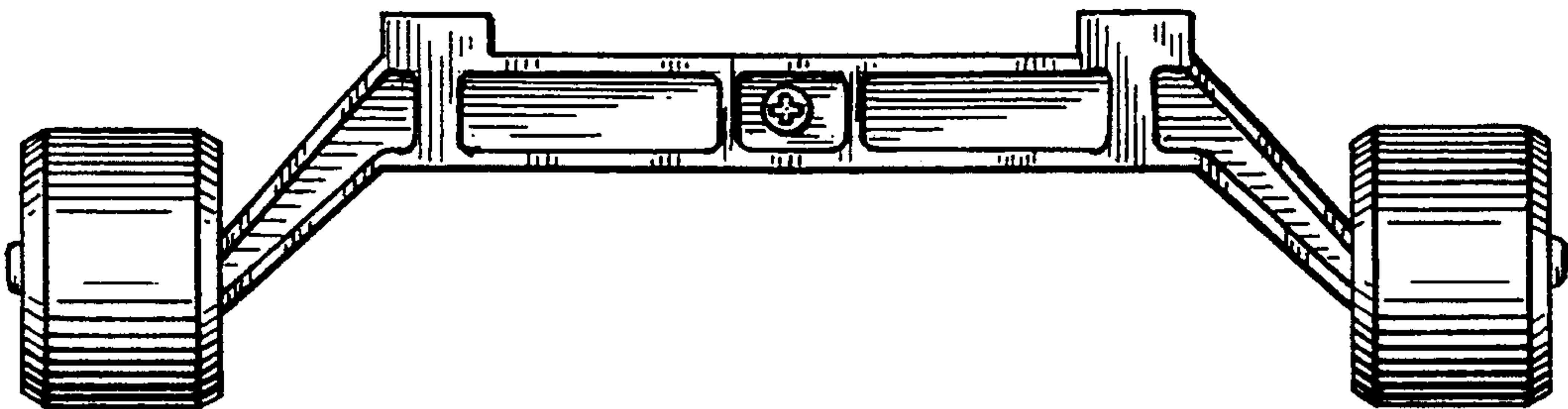
