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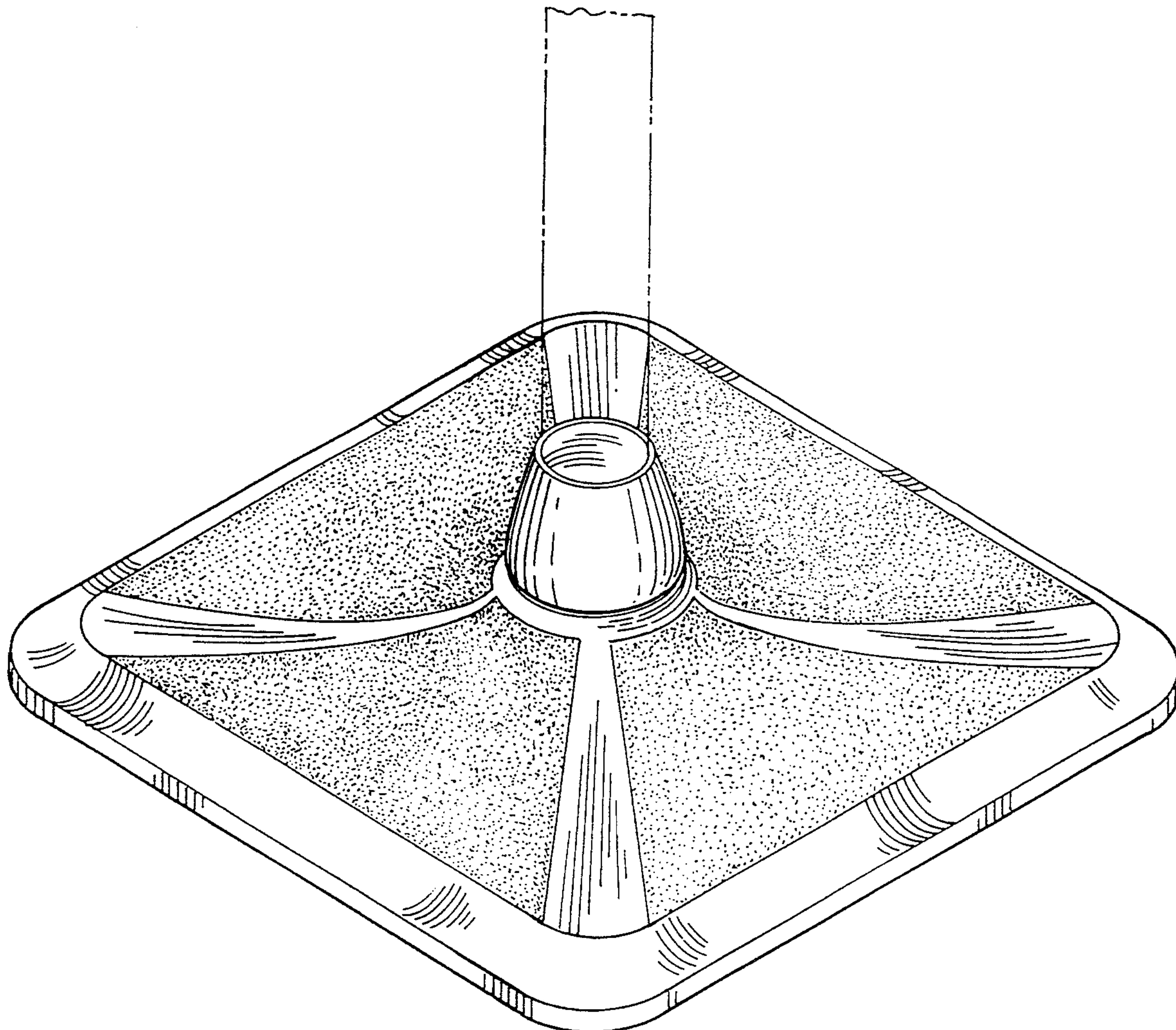
[57] **CLAIM**

and form no part of the claimed design.



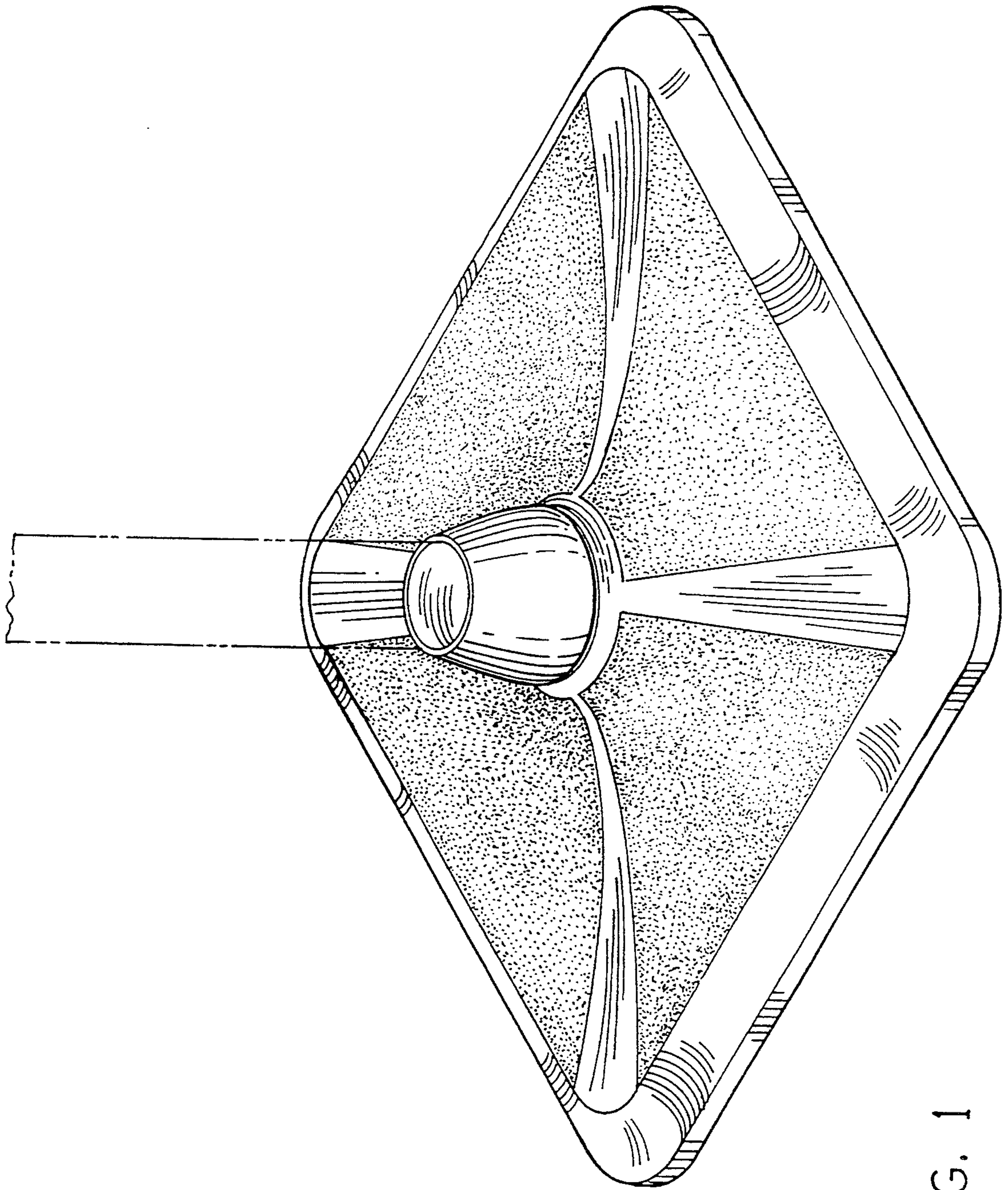

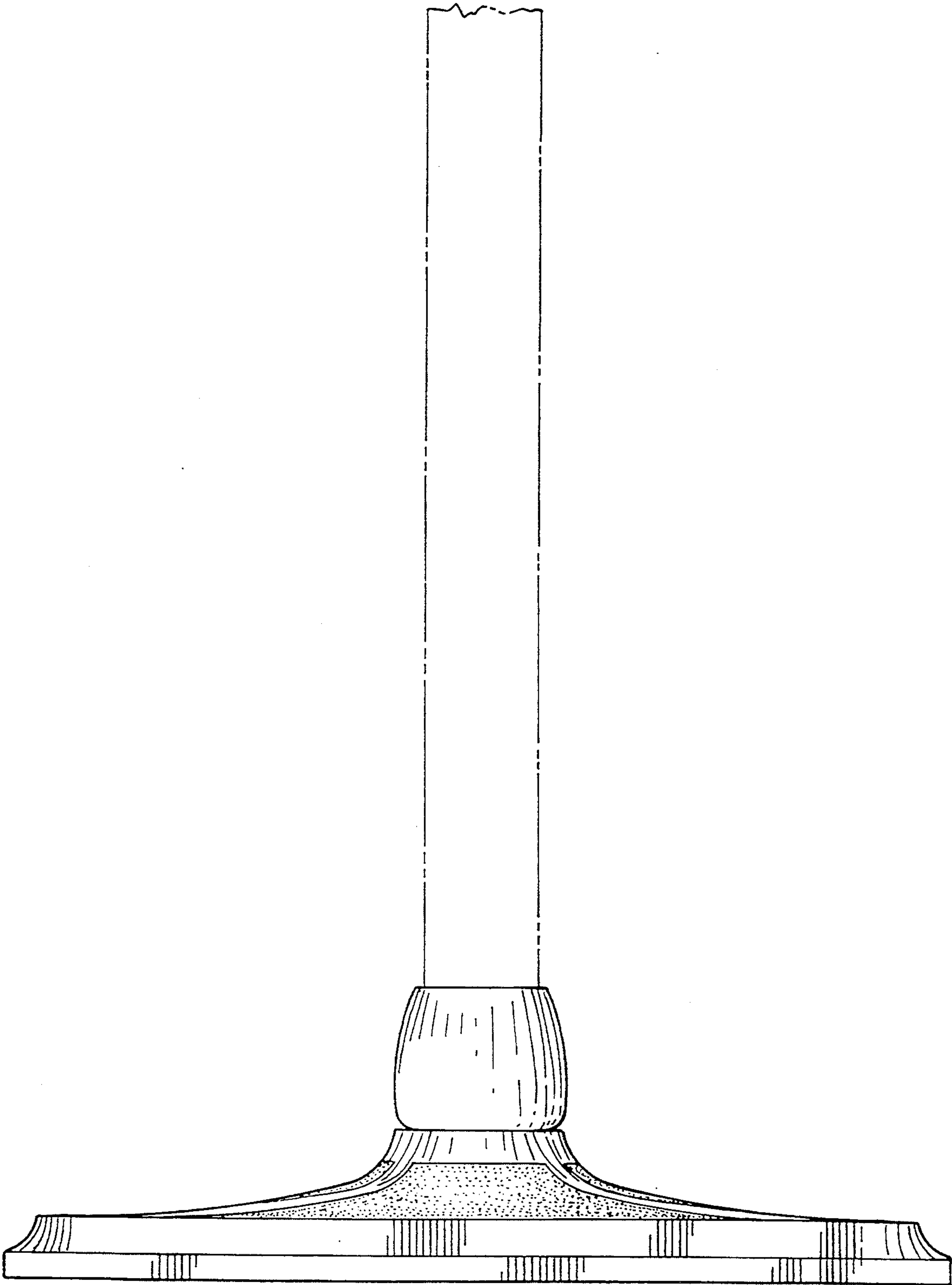

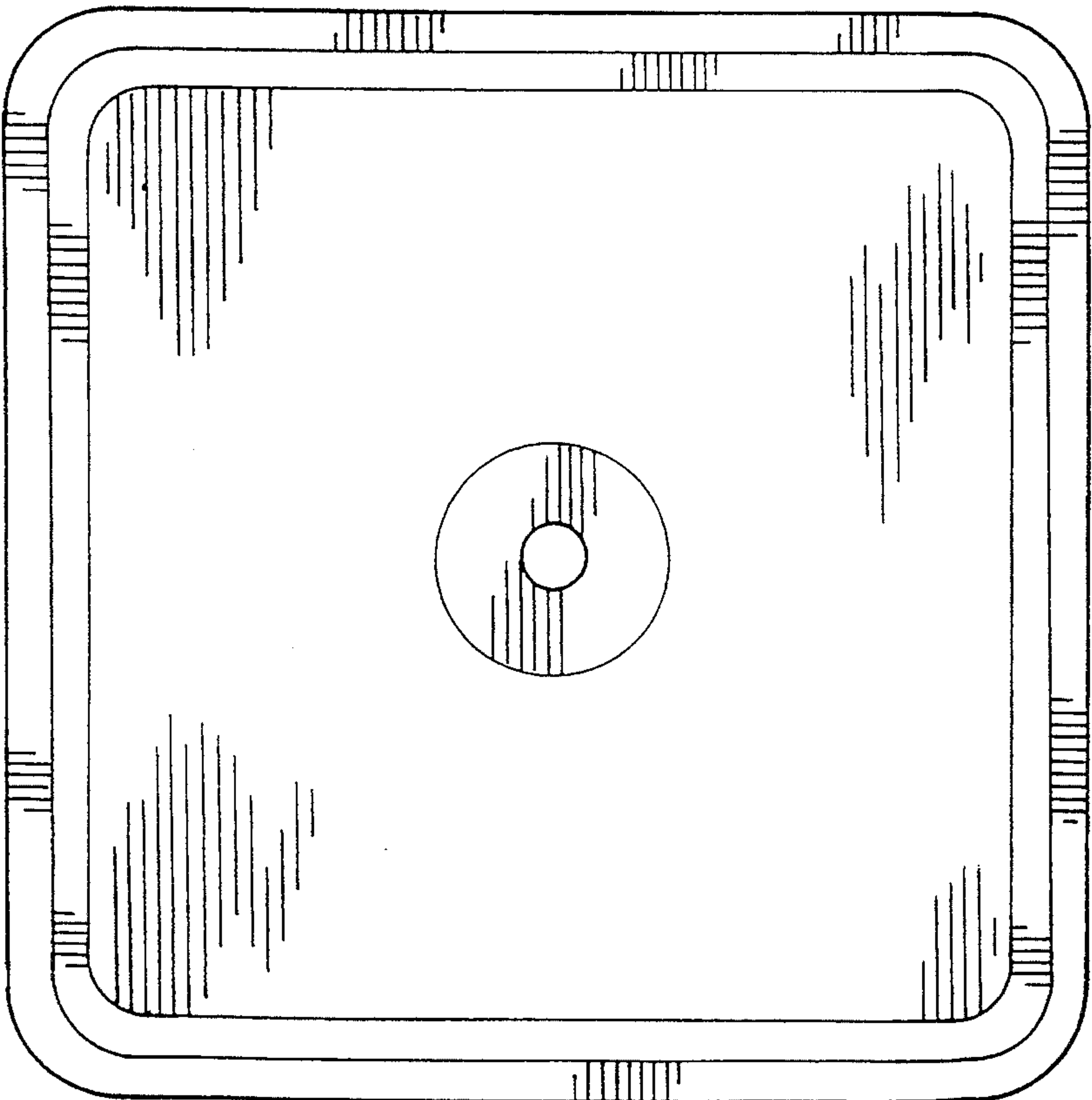
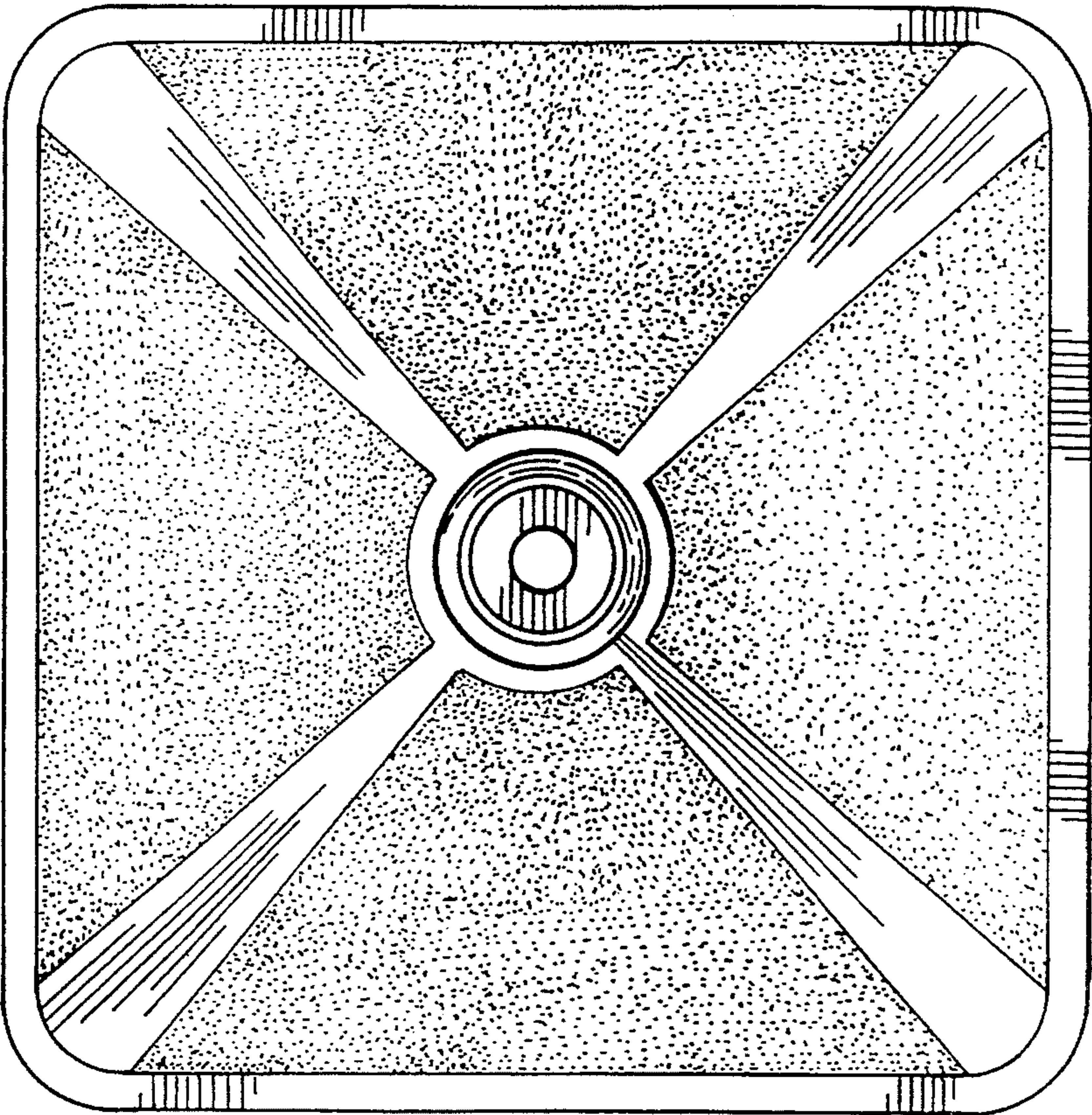
