FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

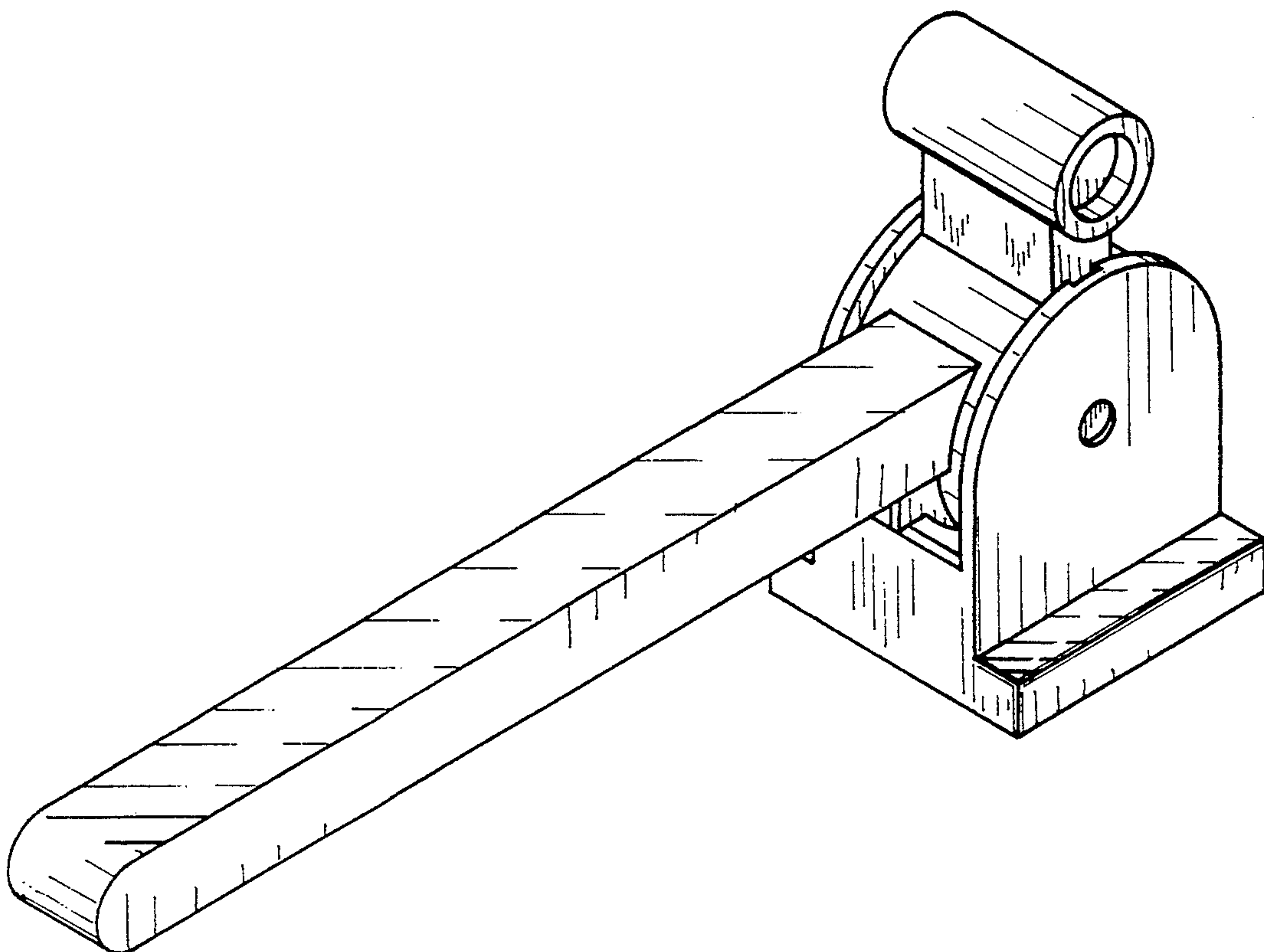
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the other side

tive position.



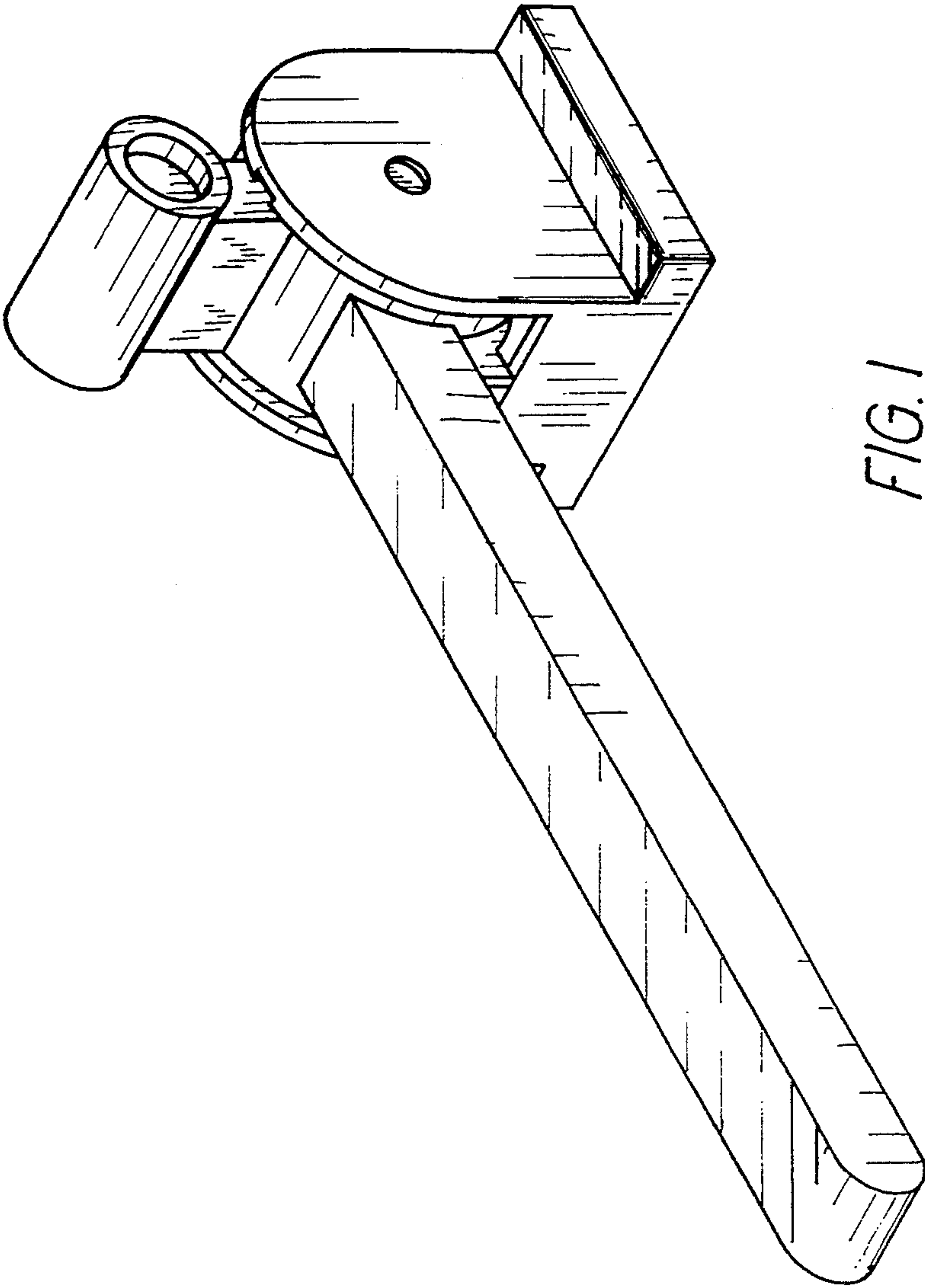

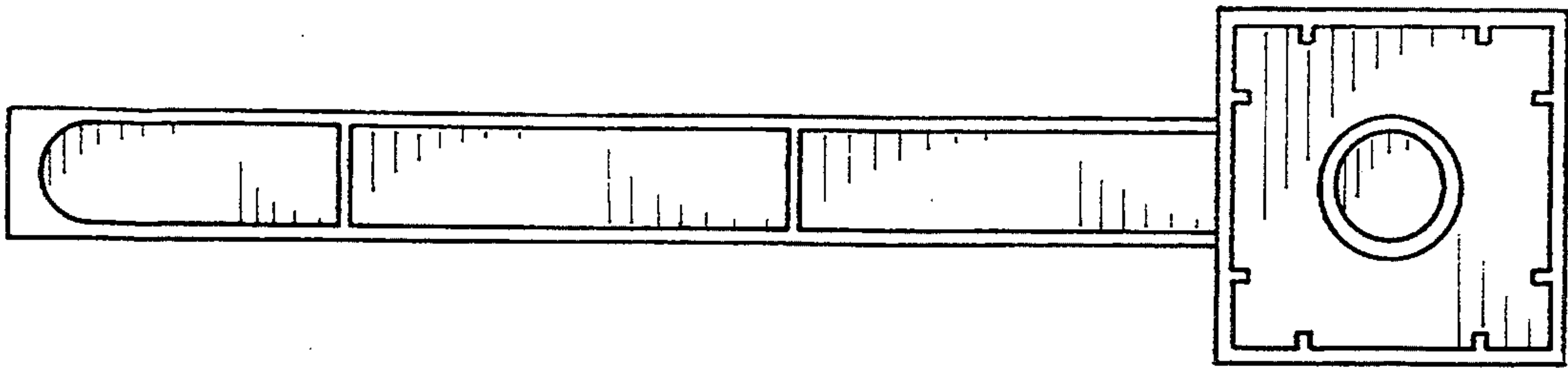

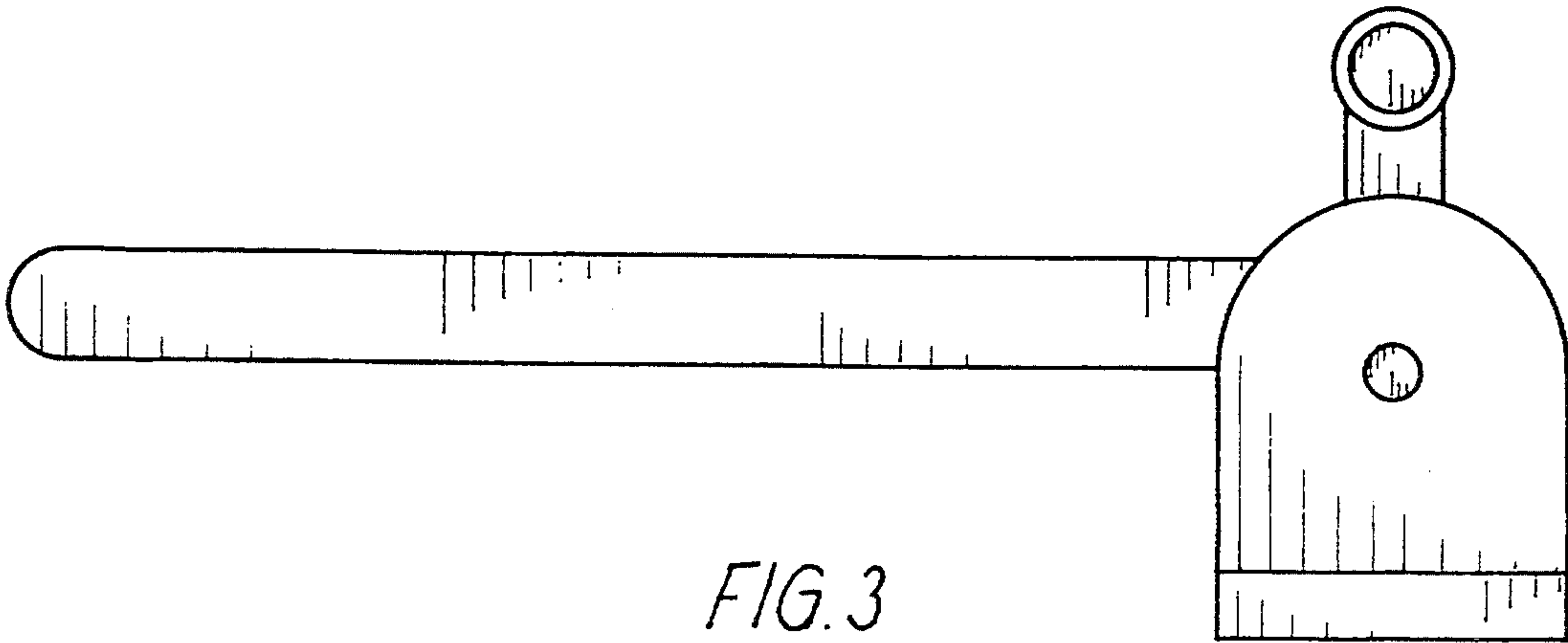

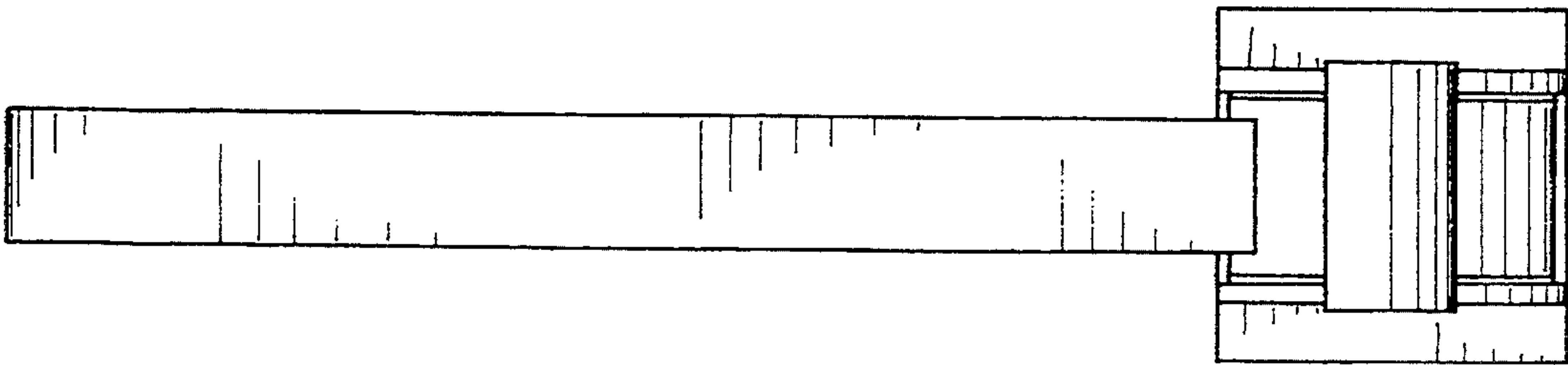

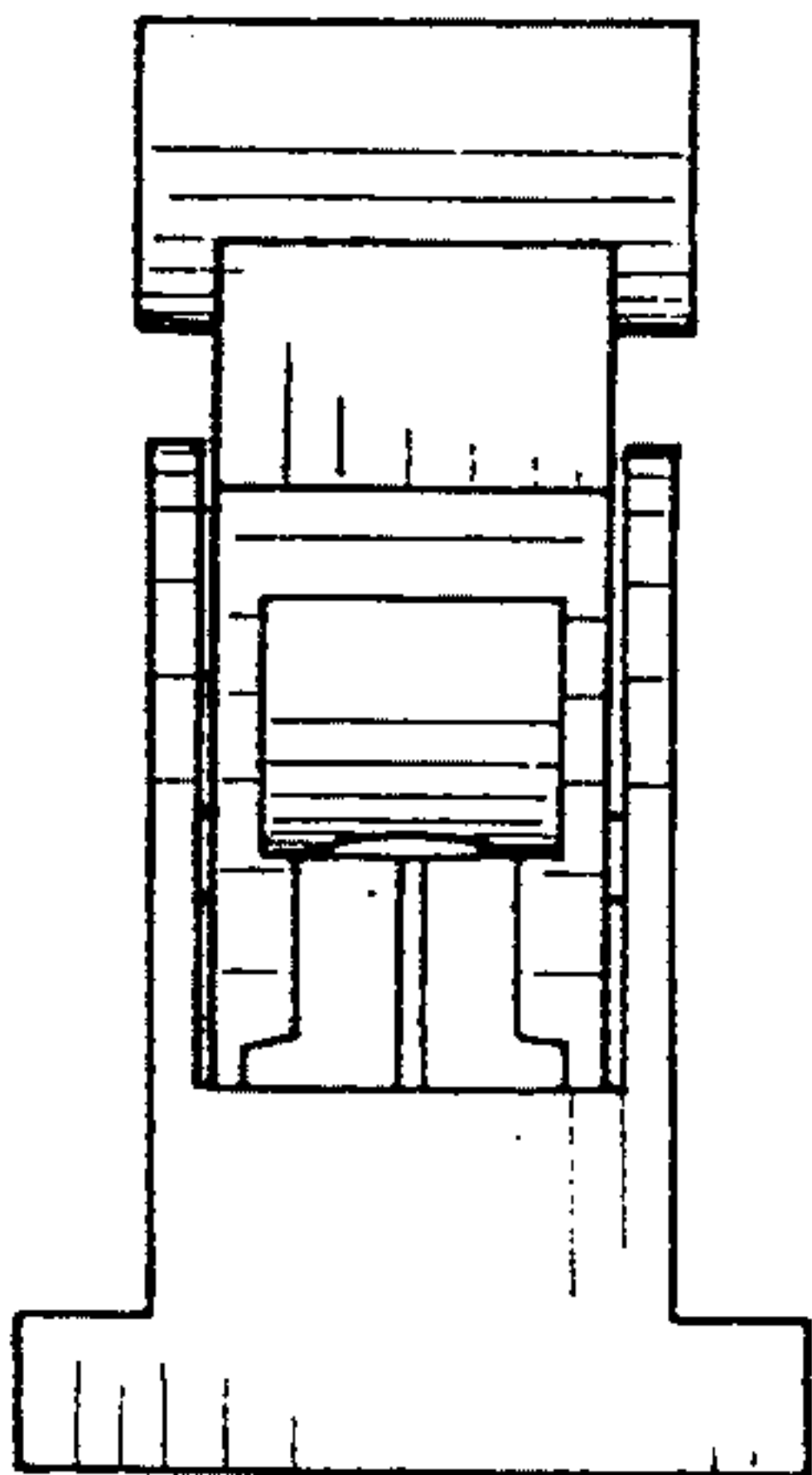

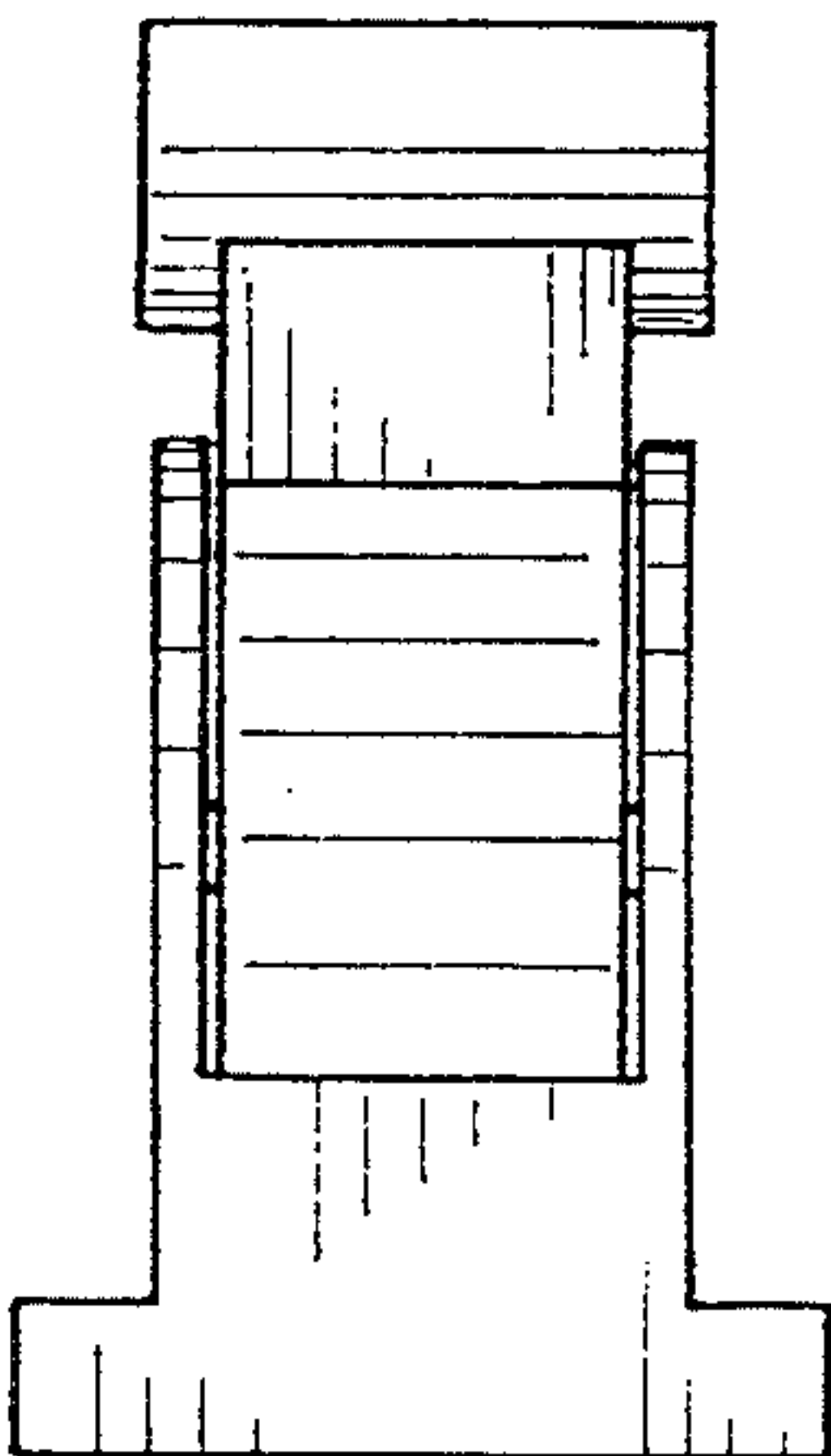

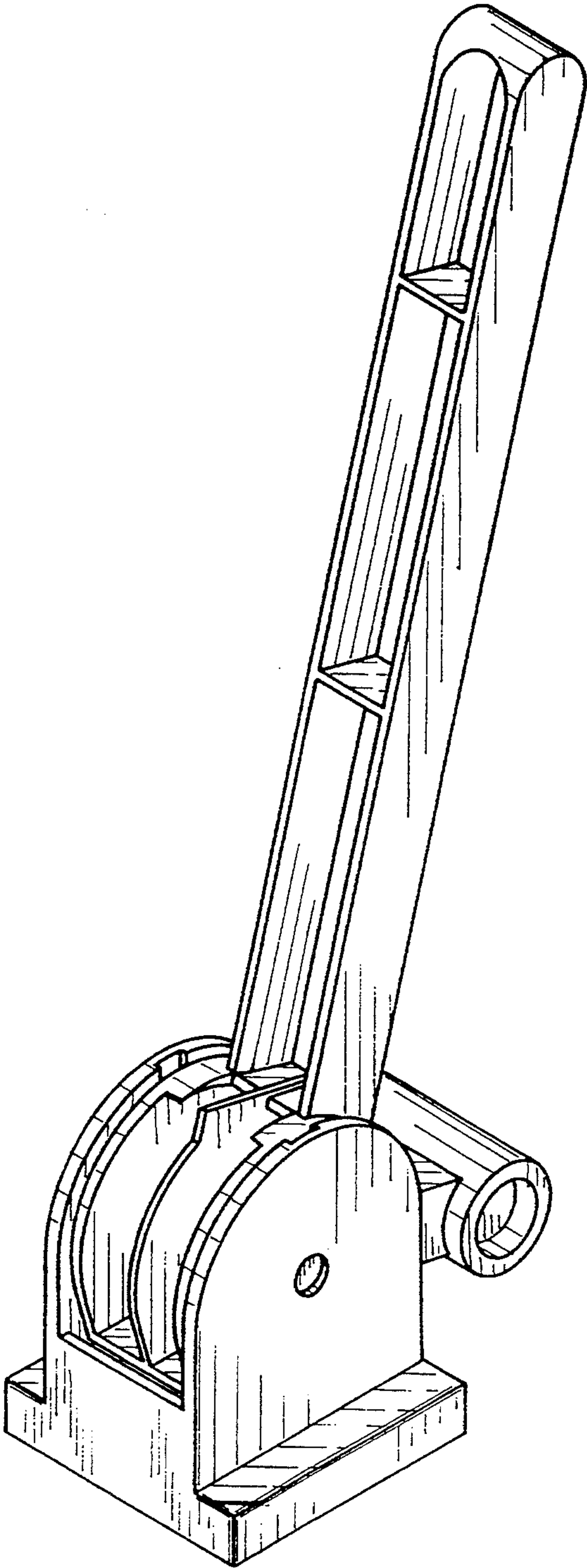
