The ornamental design for a night light insert for a
fragrance dispenser unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left side perspective view of a night
light insert for a fragrance diffuser unit showing my
new design, the dispenser being shown in broken lines
for illustrative purposes only;
FIG. 2 is a front, left side and top perspective view of
the night light insert of my new design;
FIG. 3 is a front elevtional view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right
side being a mirror image of the left side;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

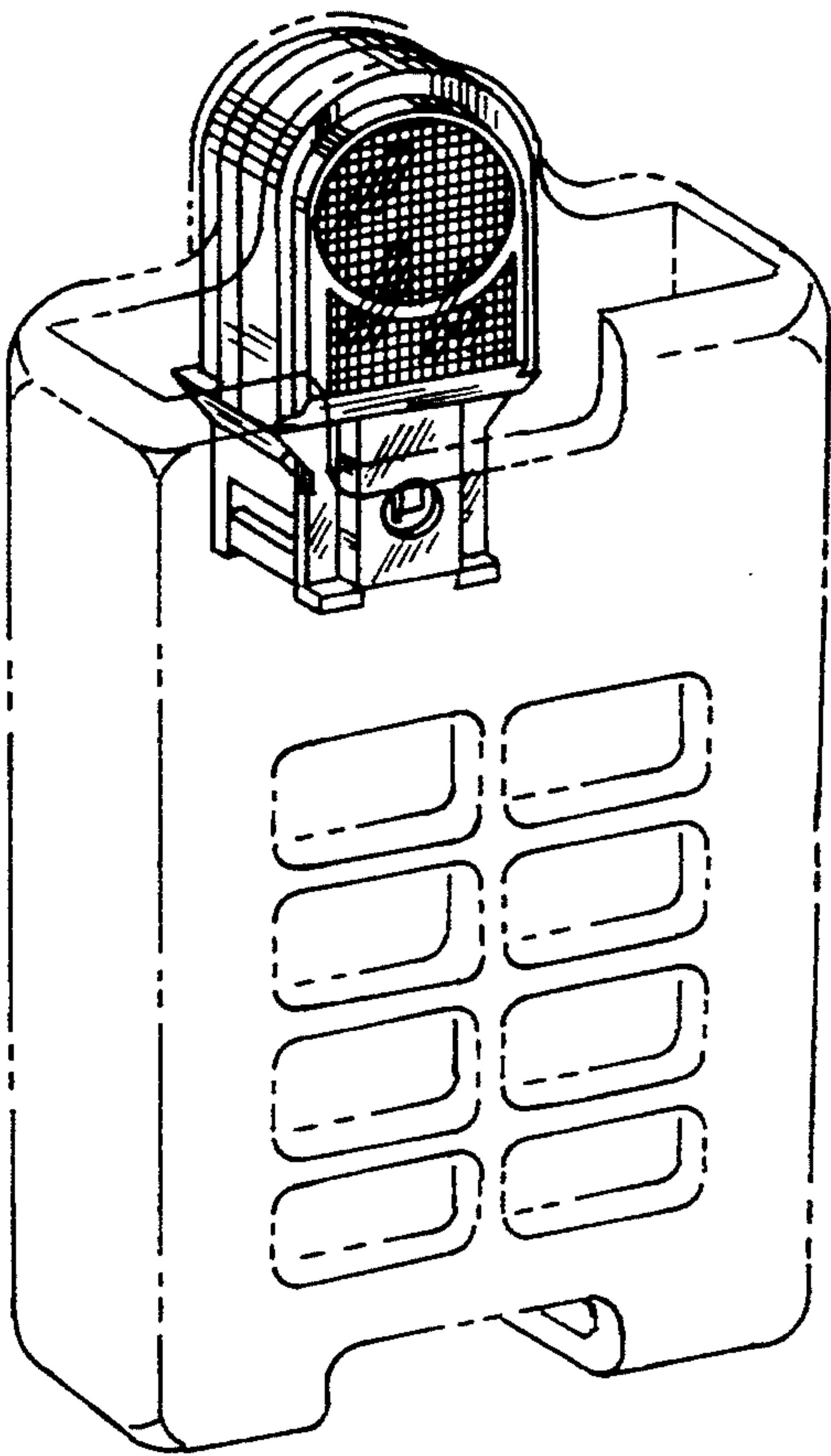

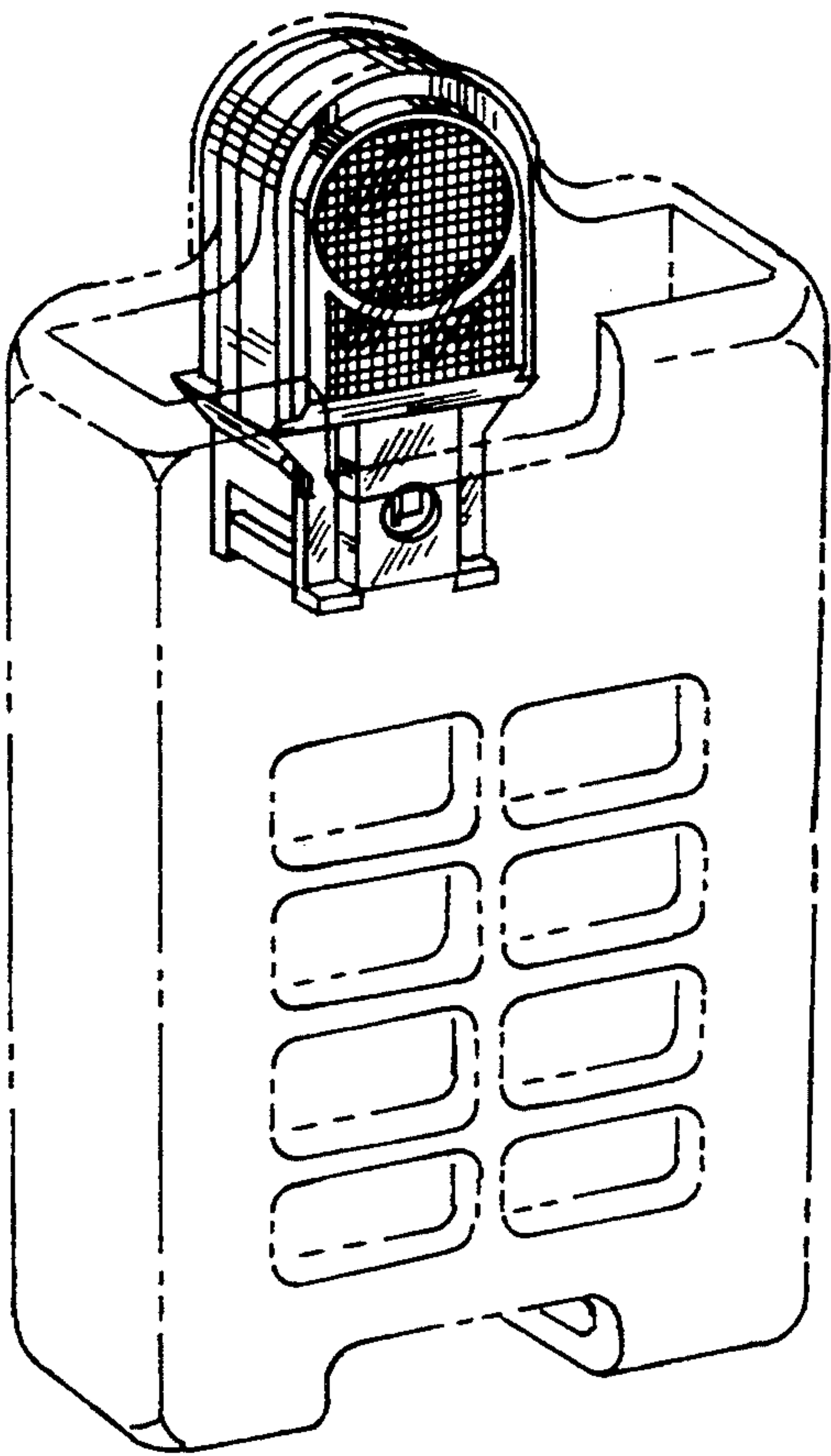

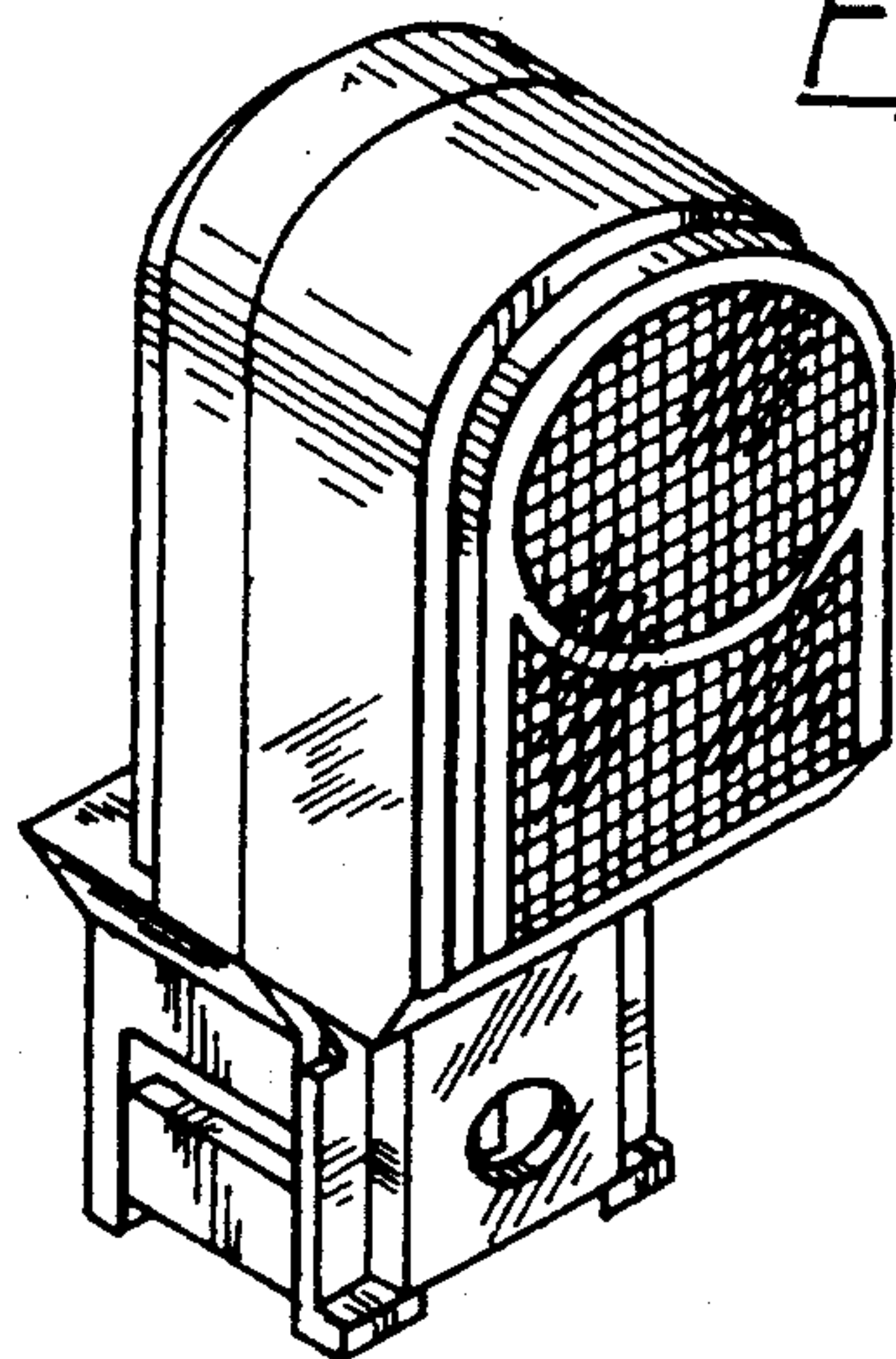

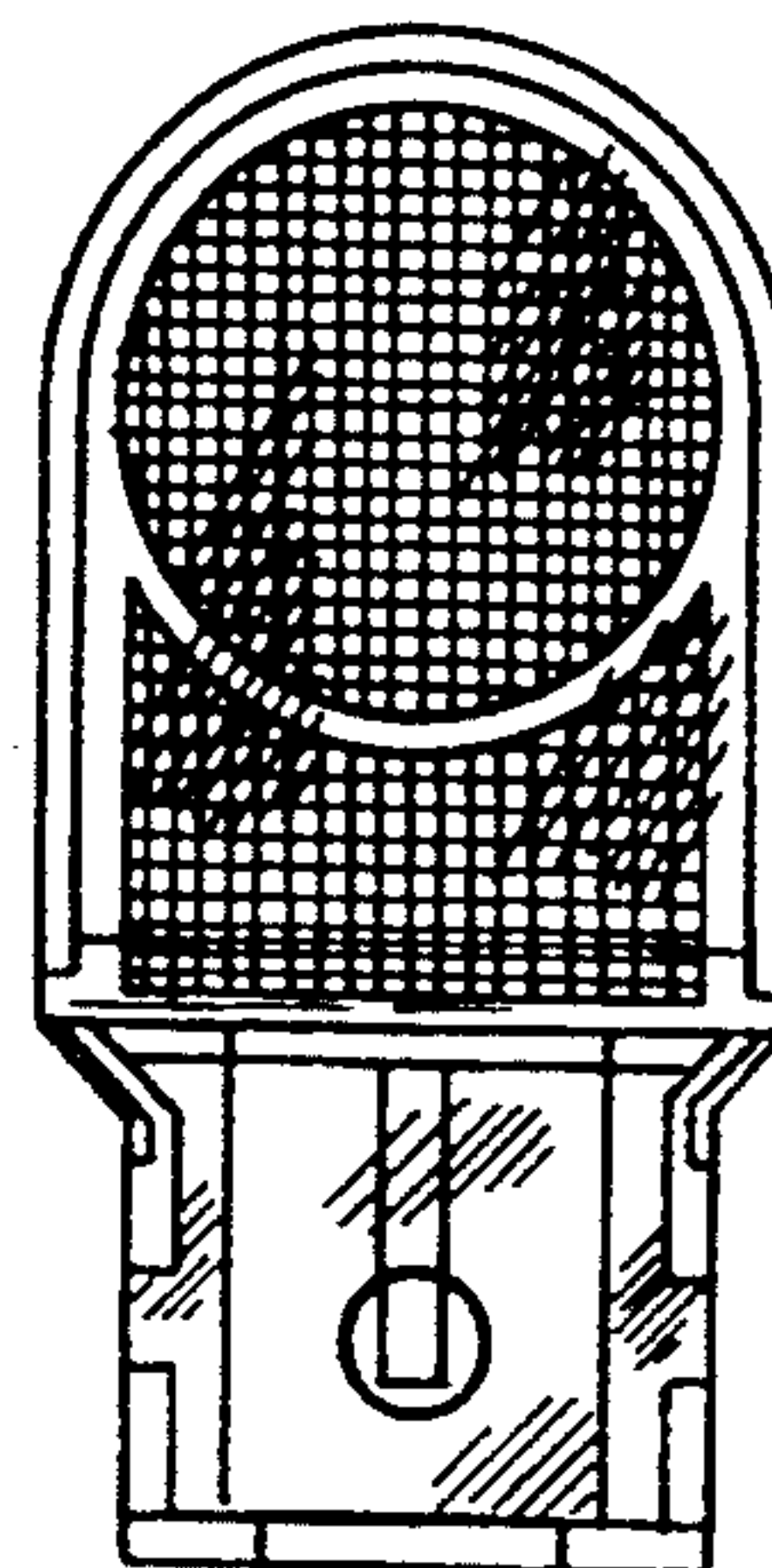

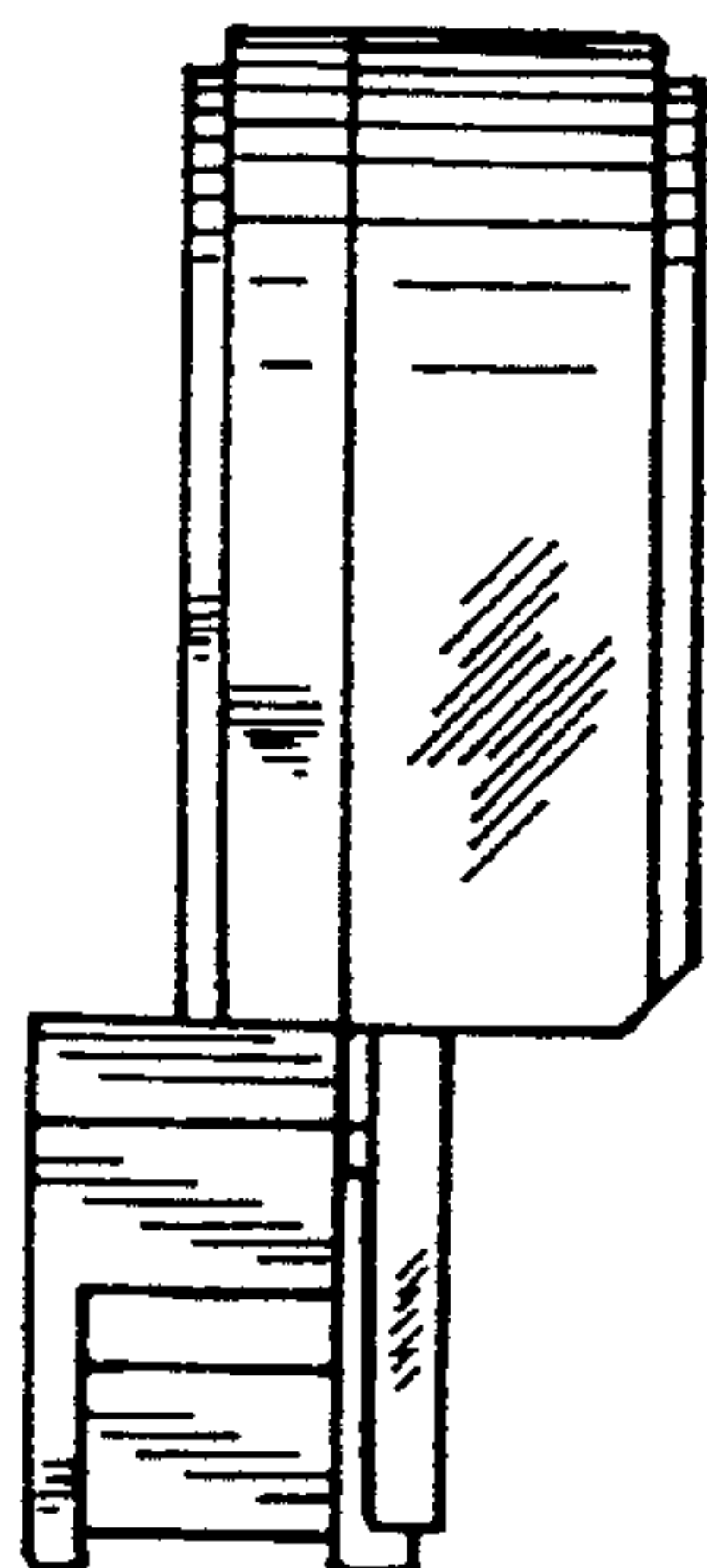

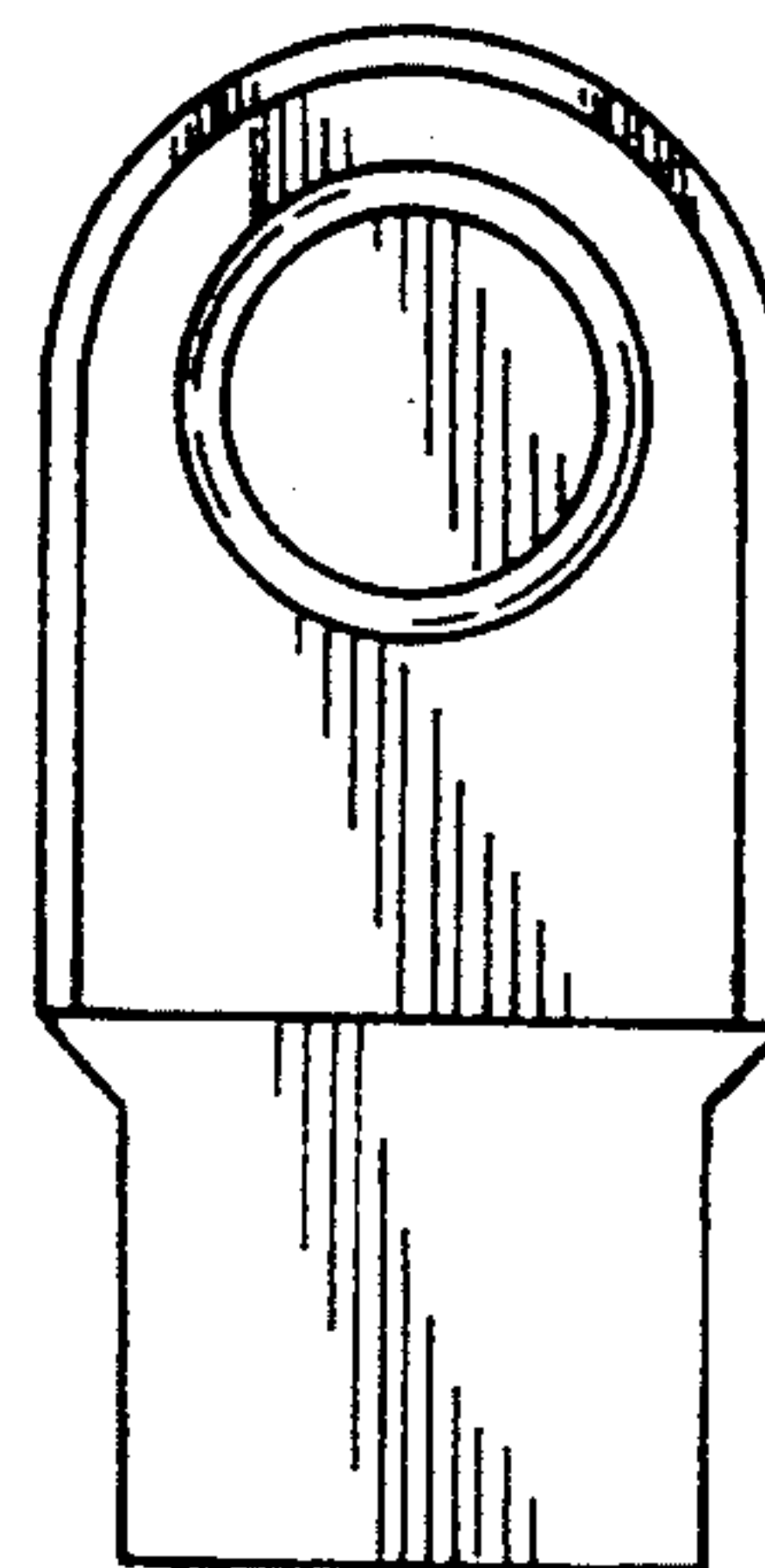

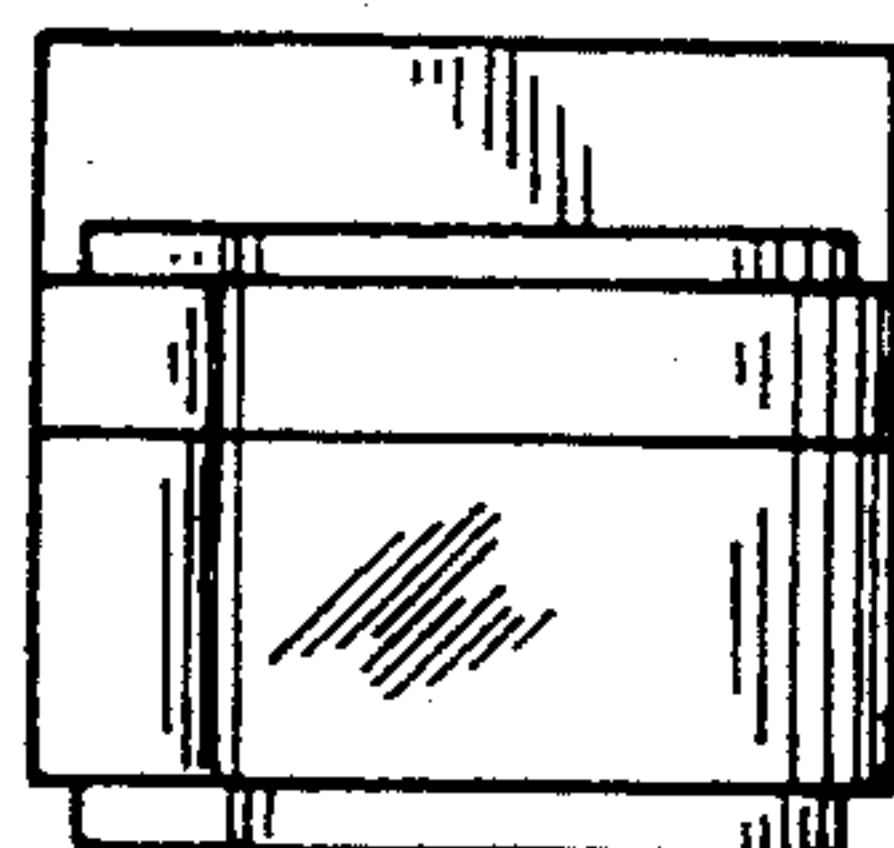
