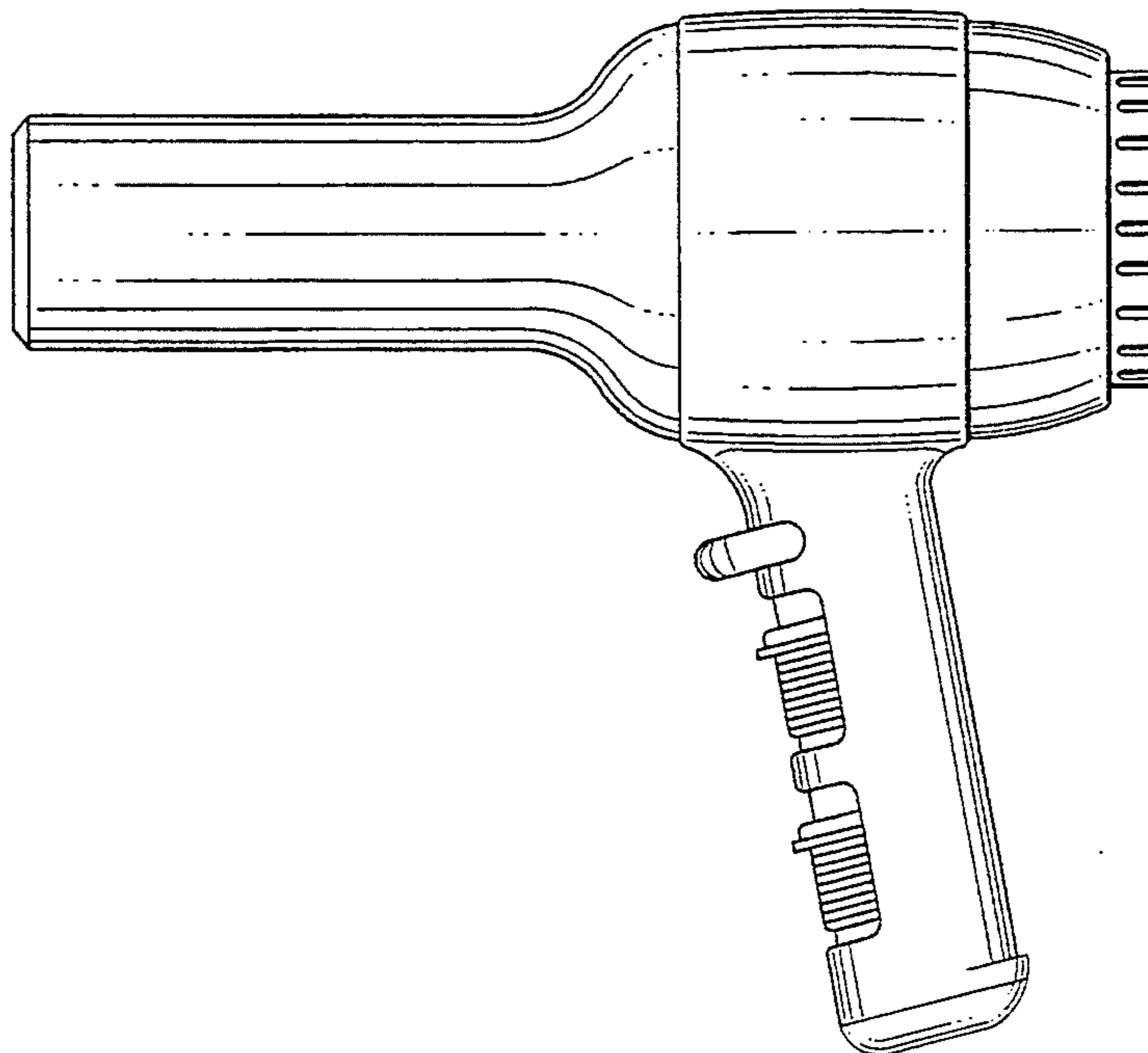

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevation of a hair dryer, showing my new design, the left side being a mirror image of the side shown;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevation thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 5 is a front elevation thereof.



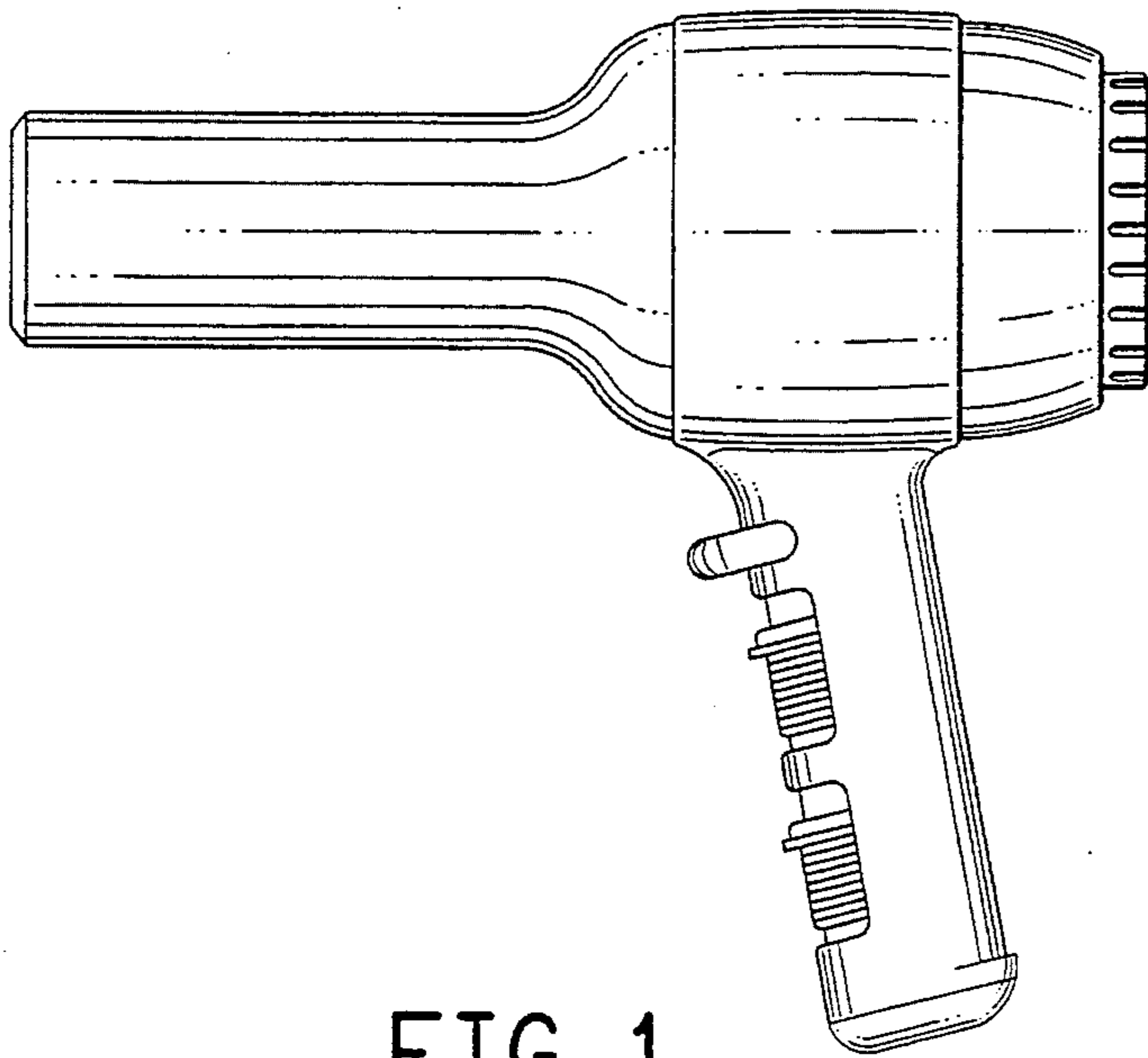

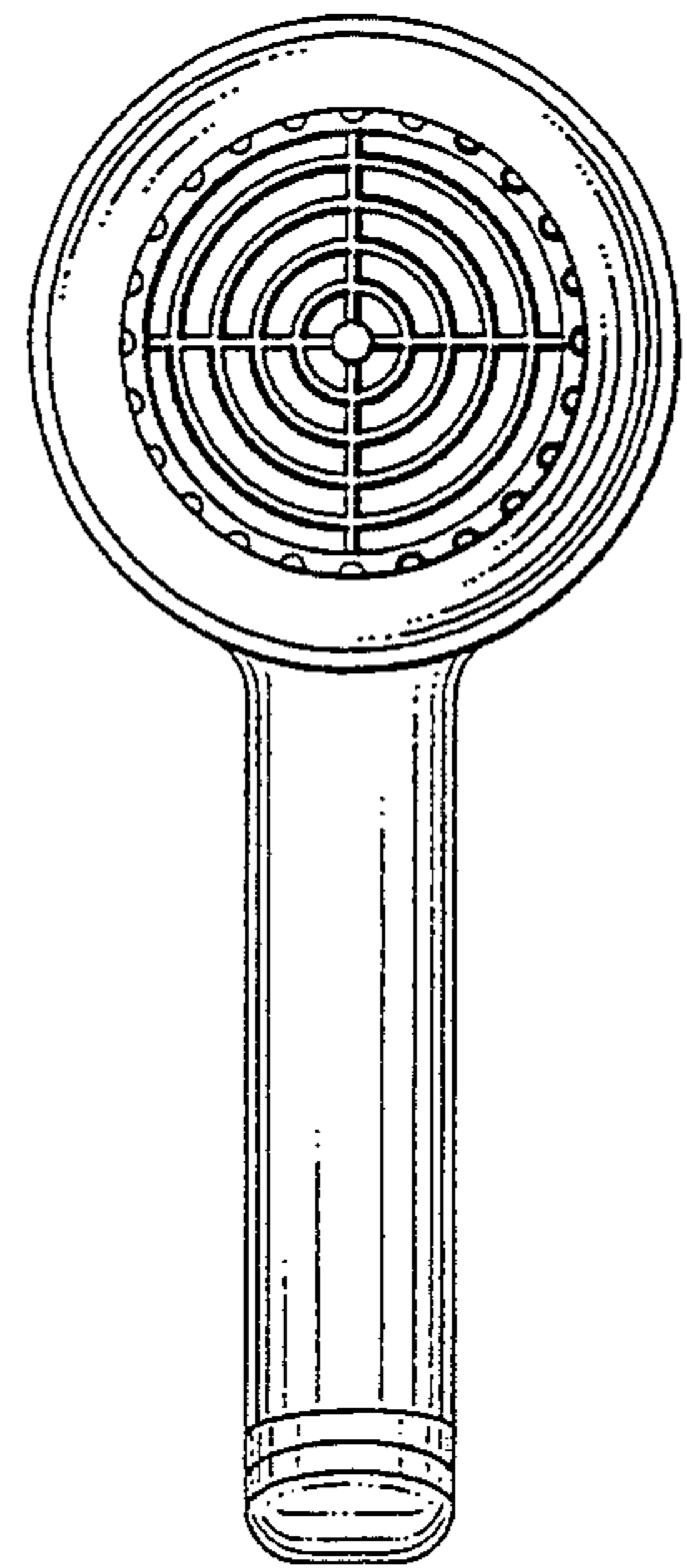

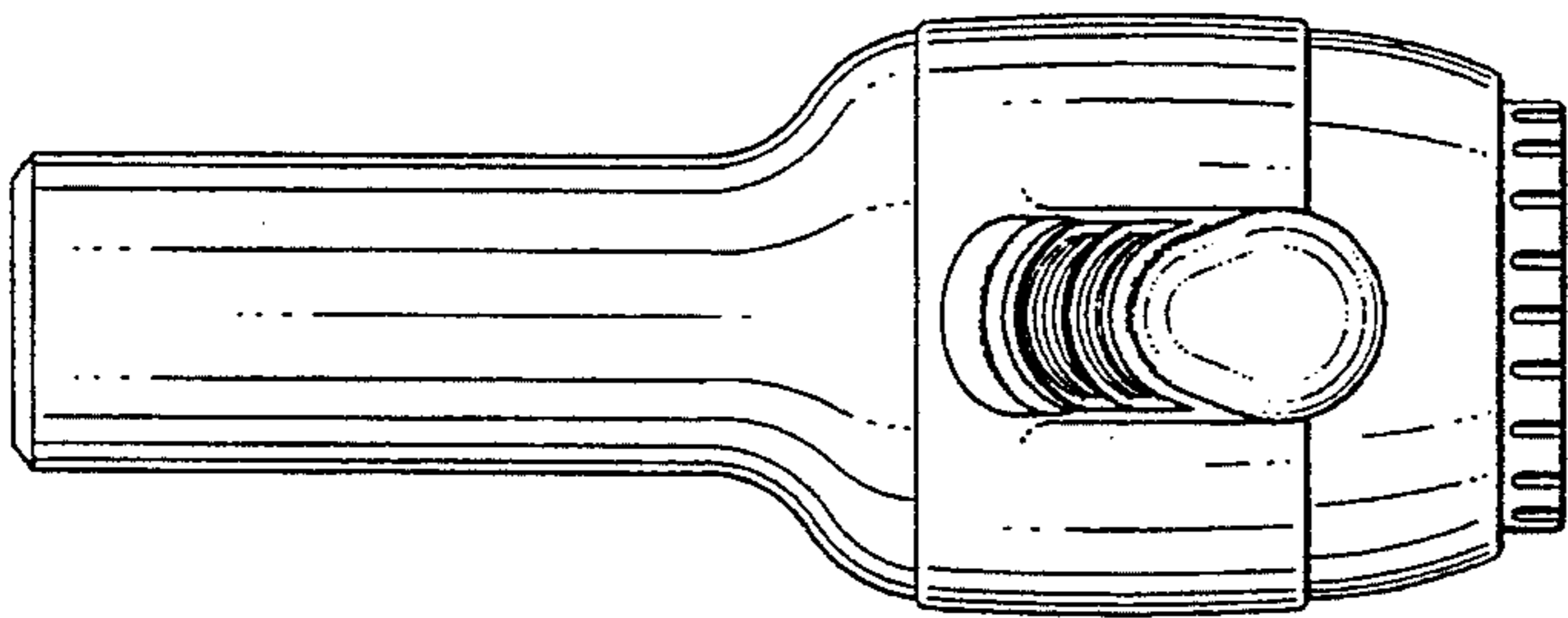

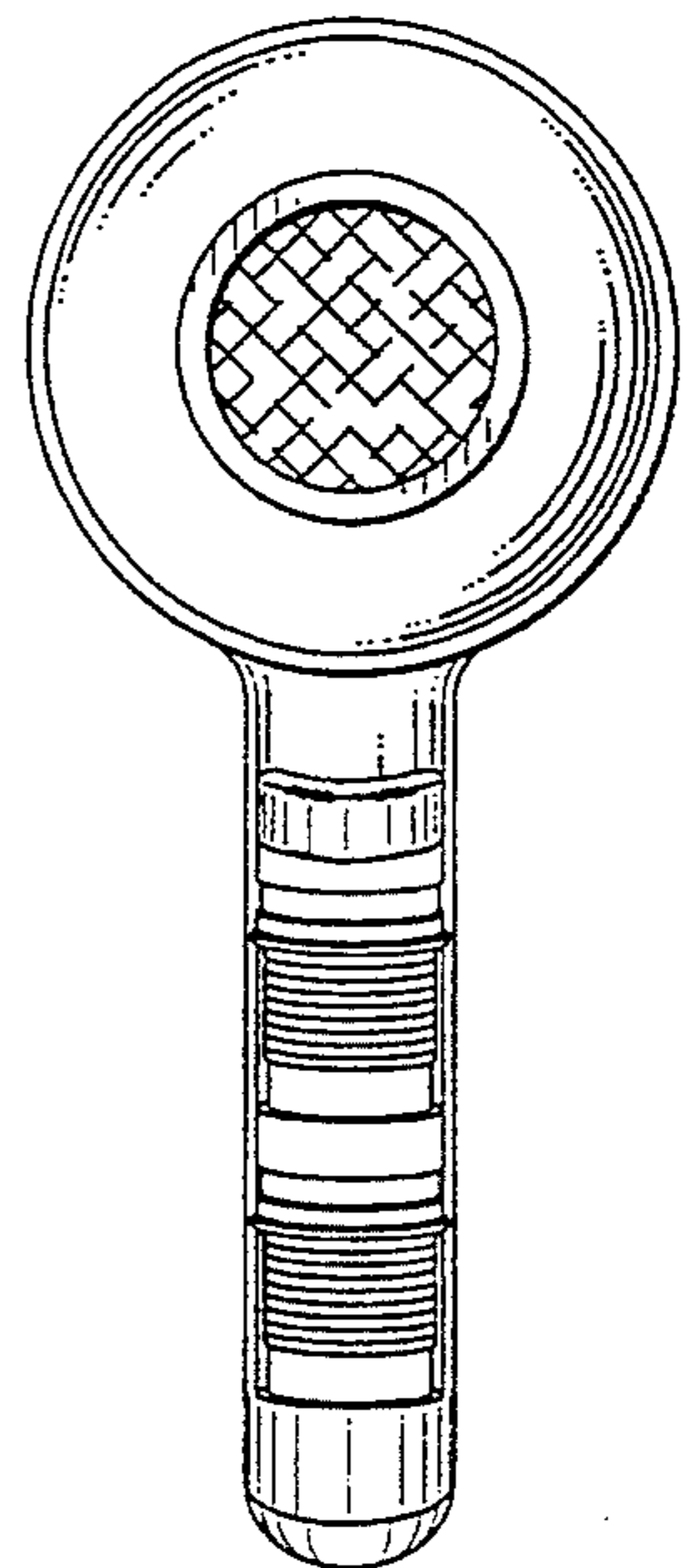

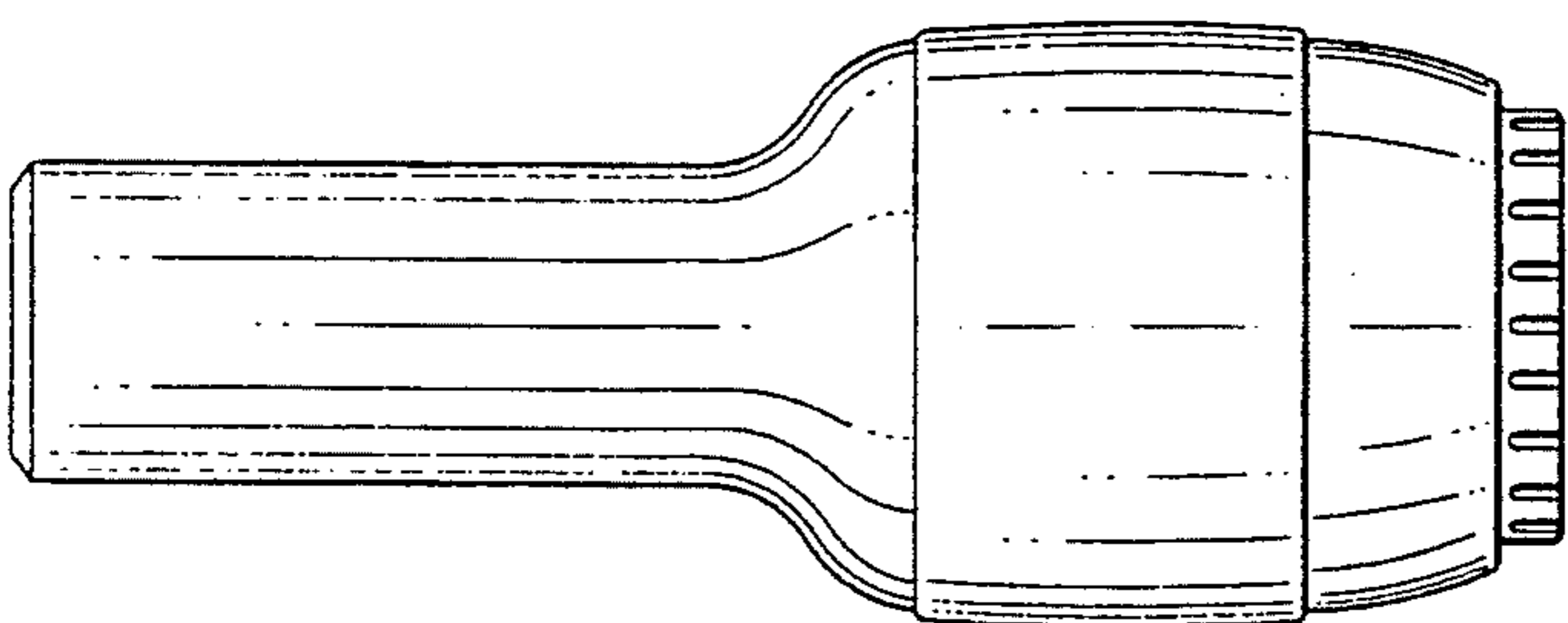
