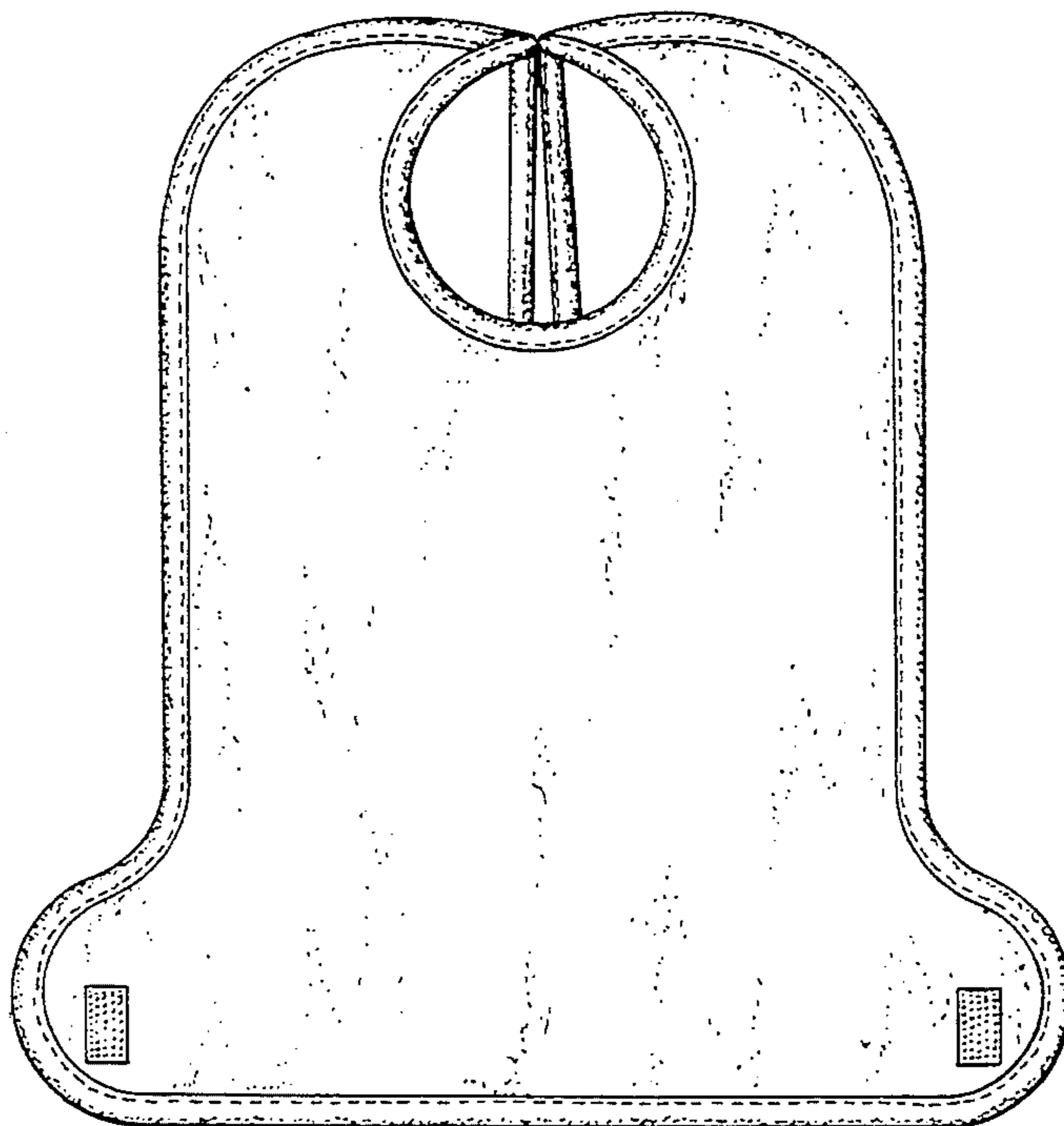
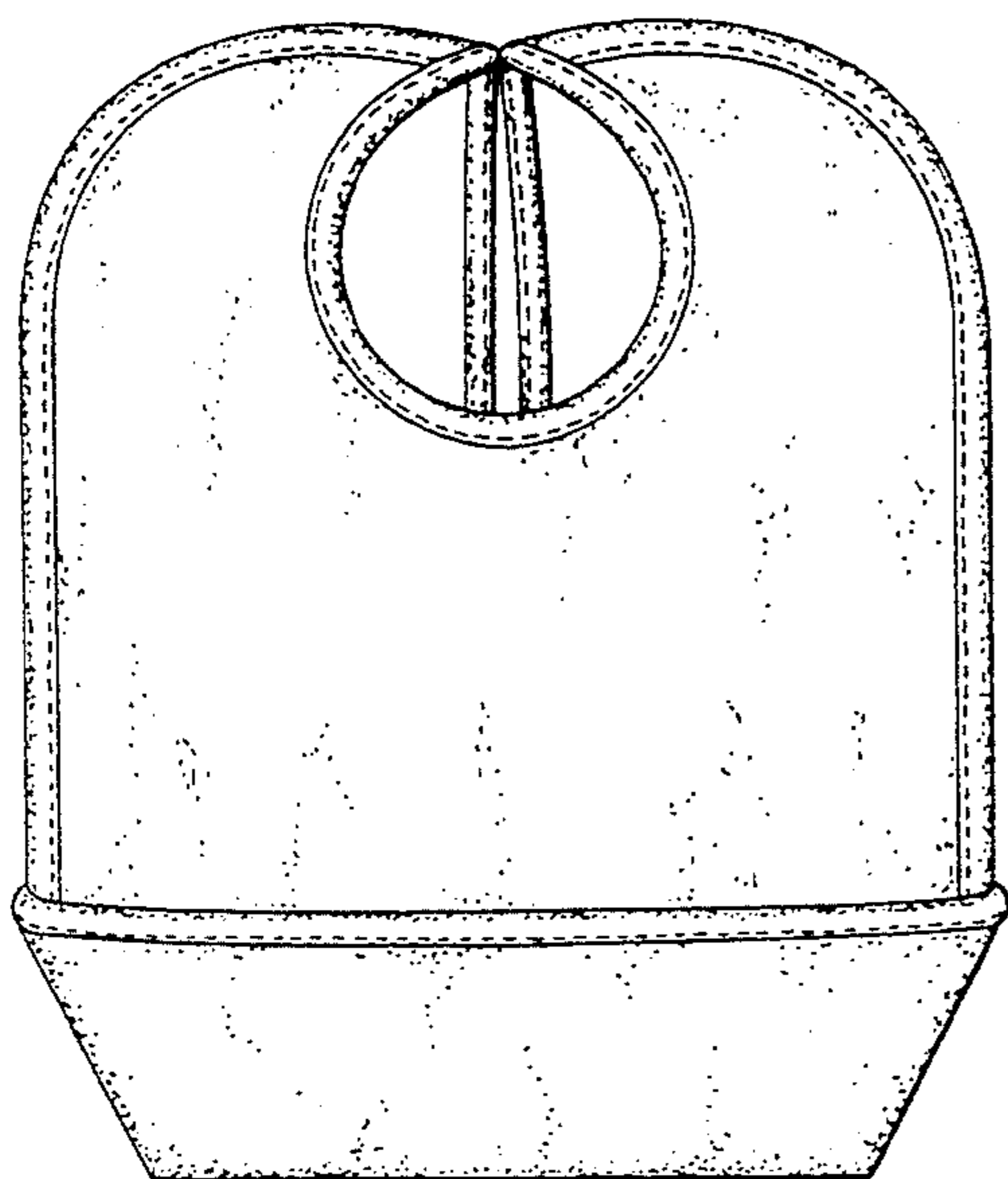
The ornamental design for a bib, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bib showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of my bib in an open position; and,
 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of my bib in an open position.
 The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1, 5, 6, and 7 are understood to represent conventional stitching.

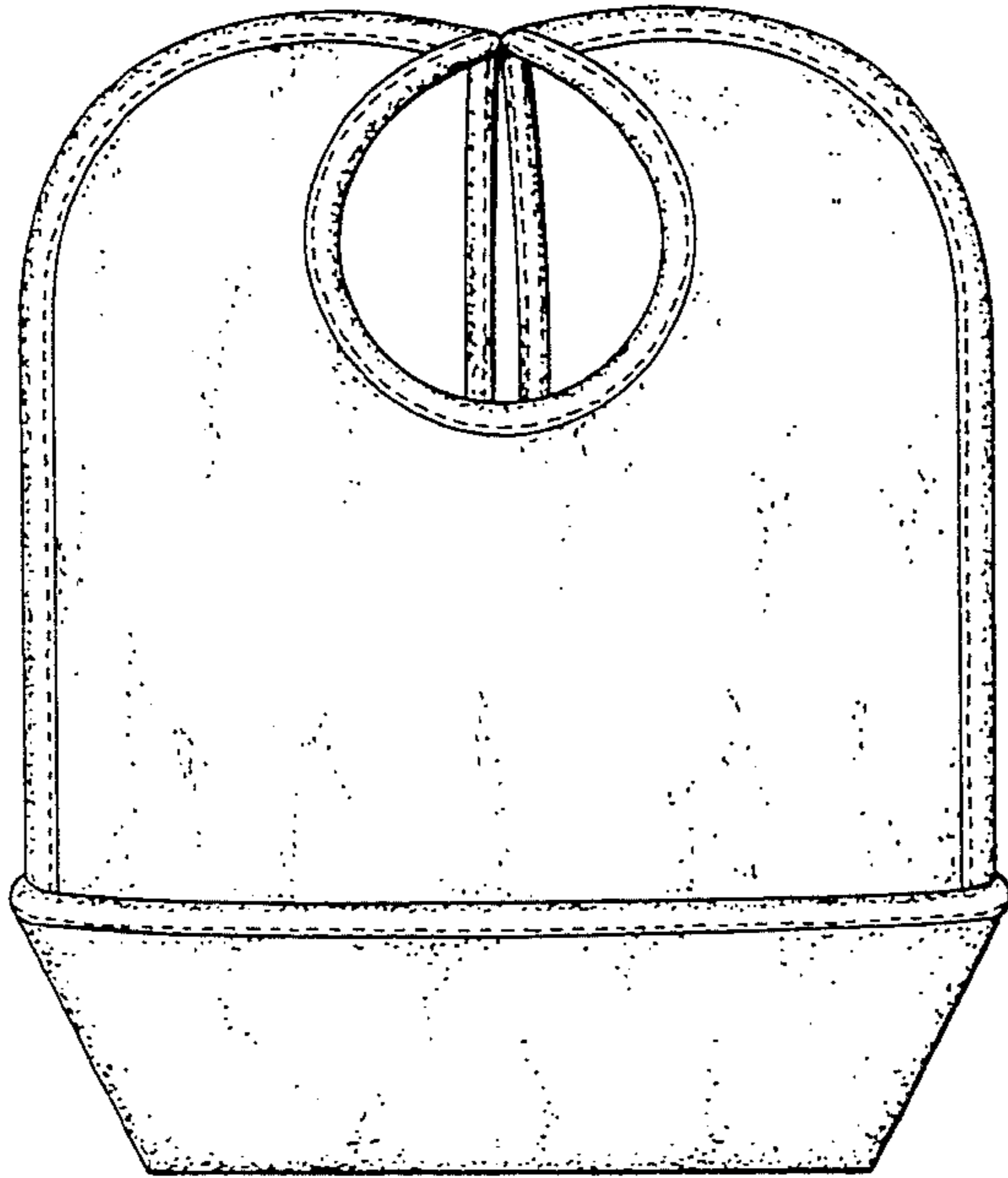

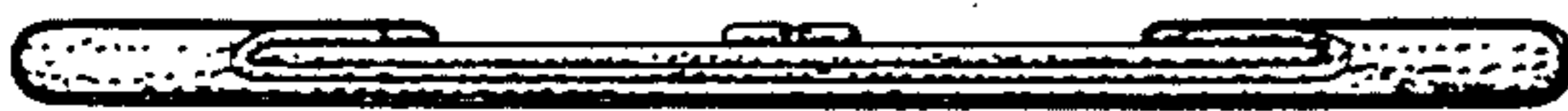

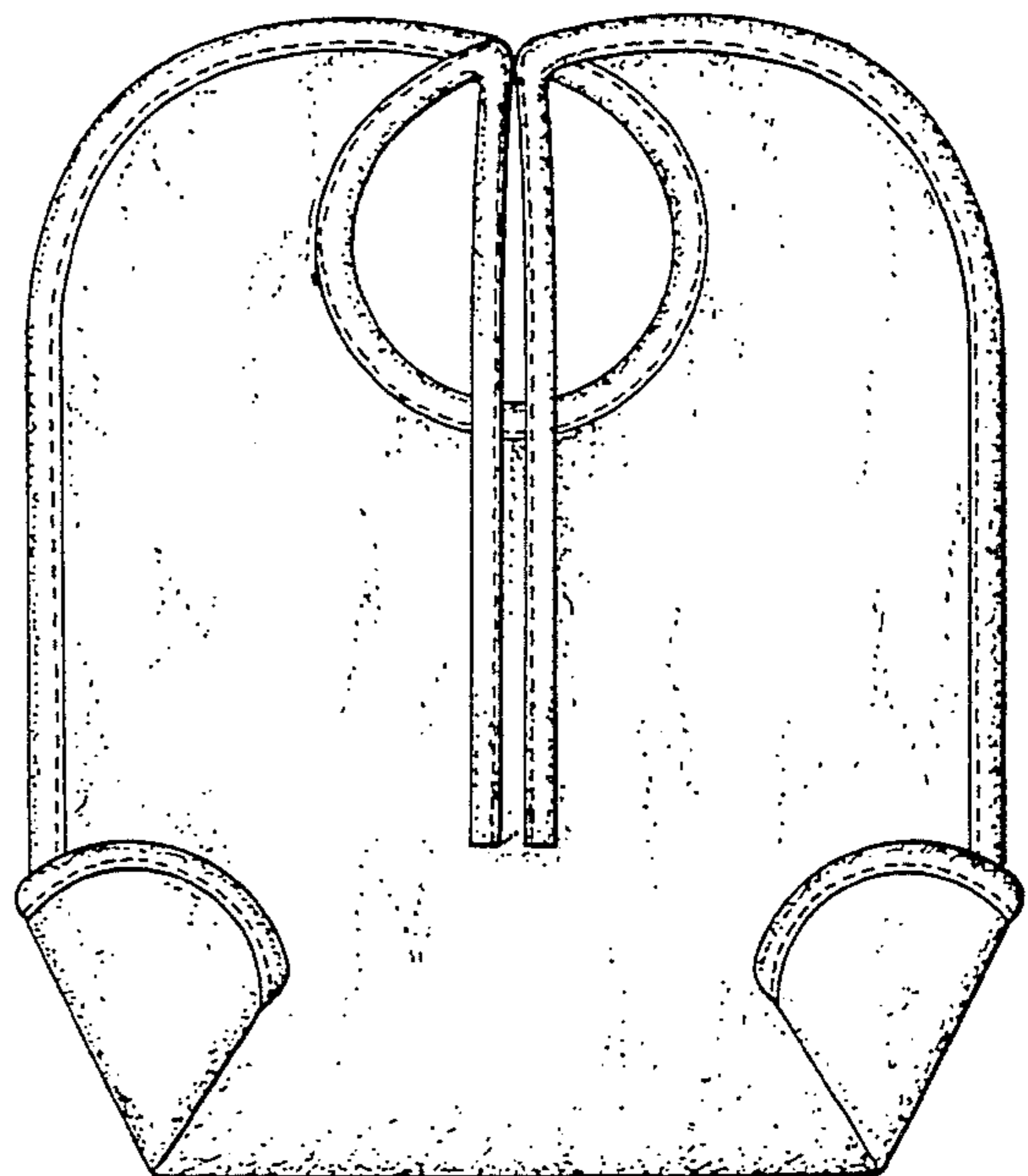

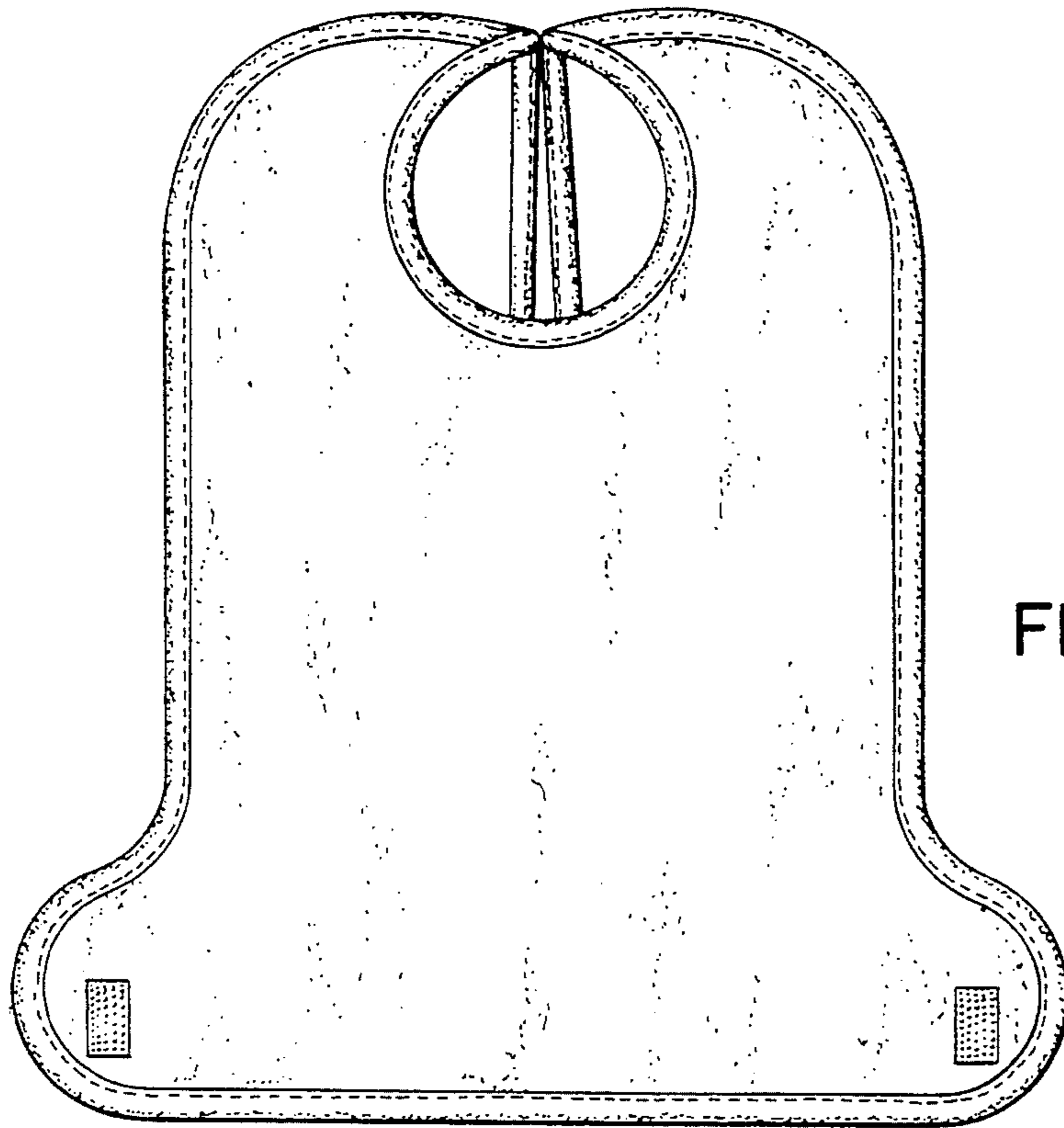

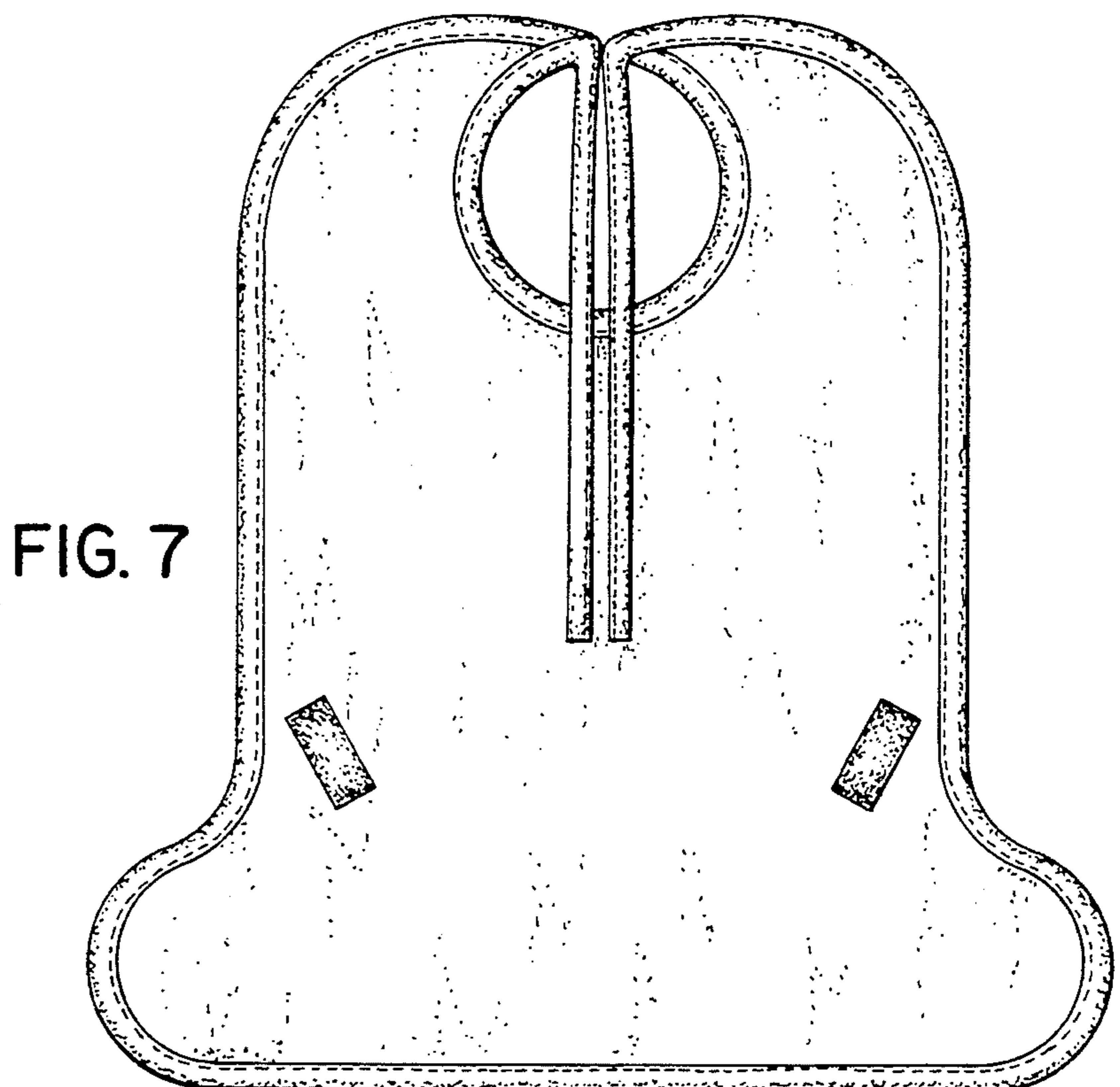
