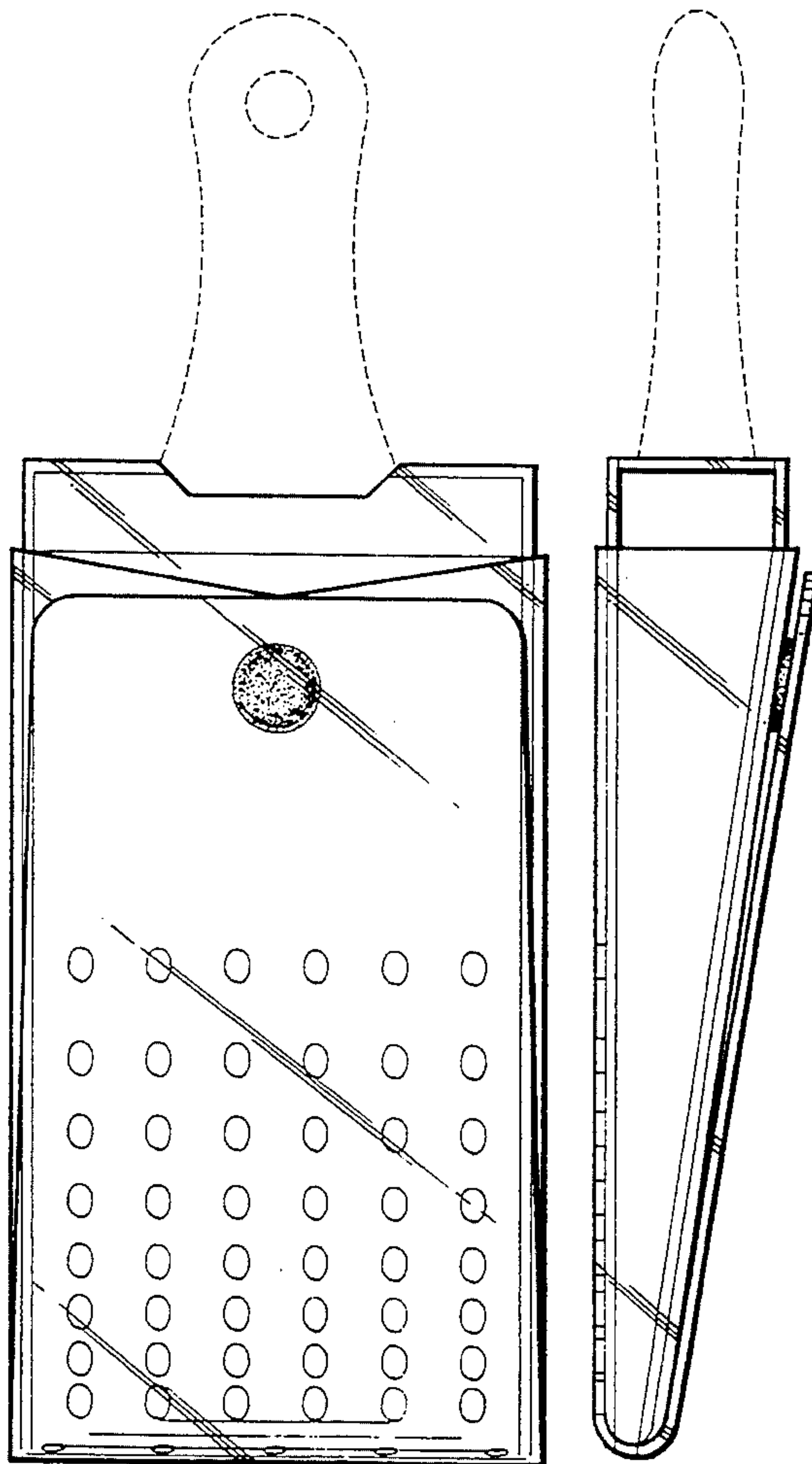

The broken line showing a paintbrush handle is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



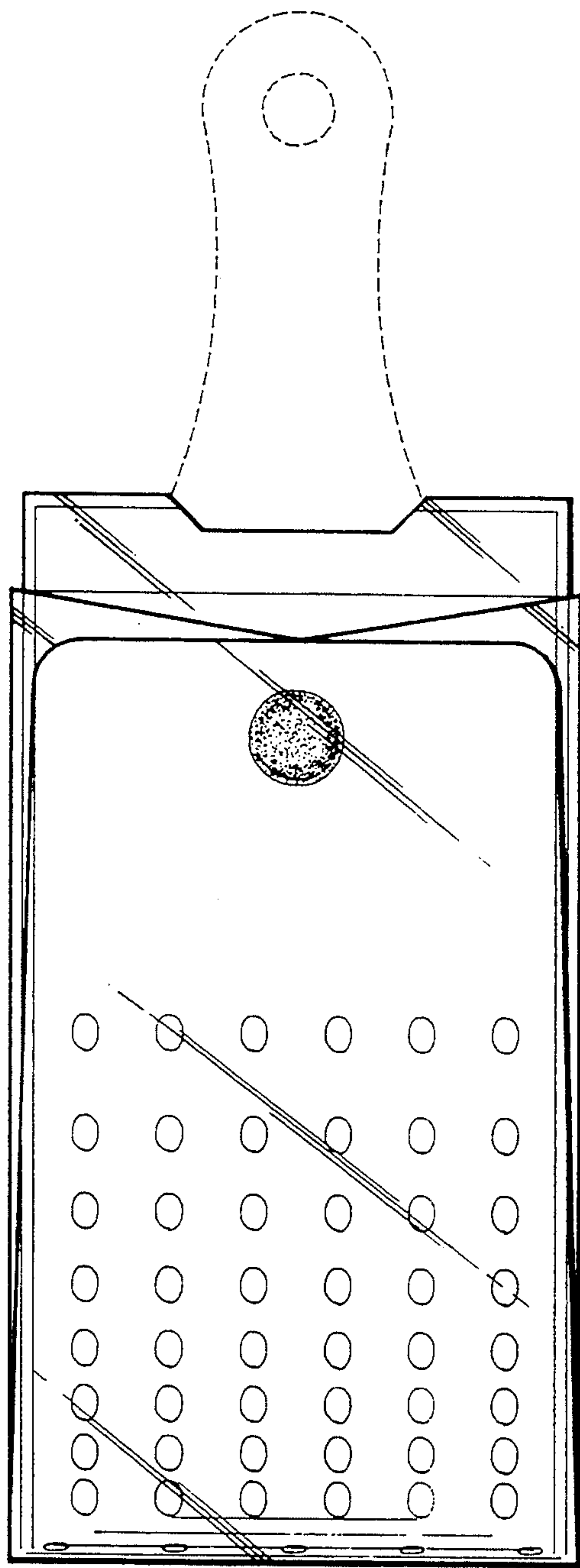

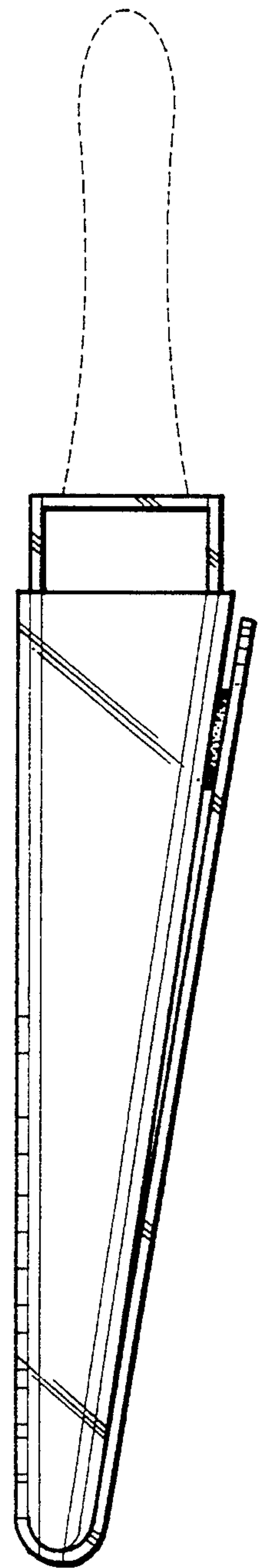

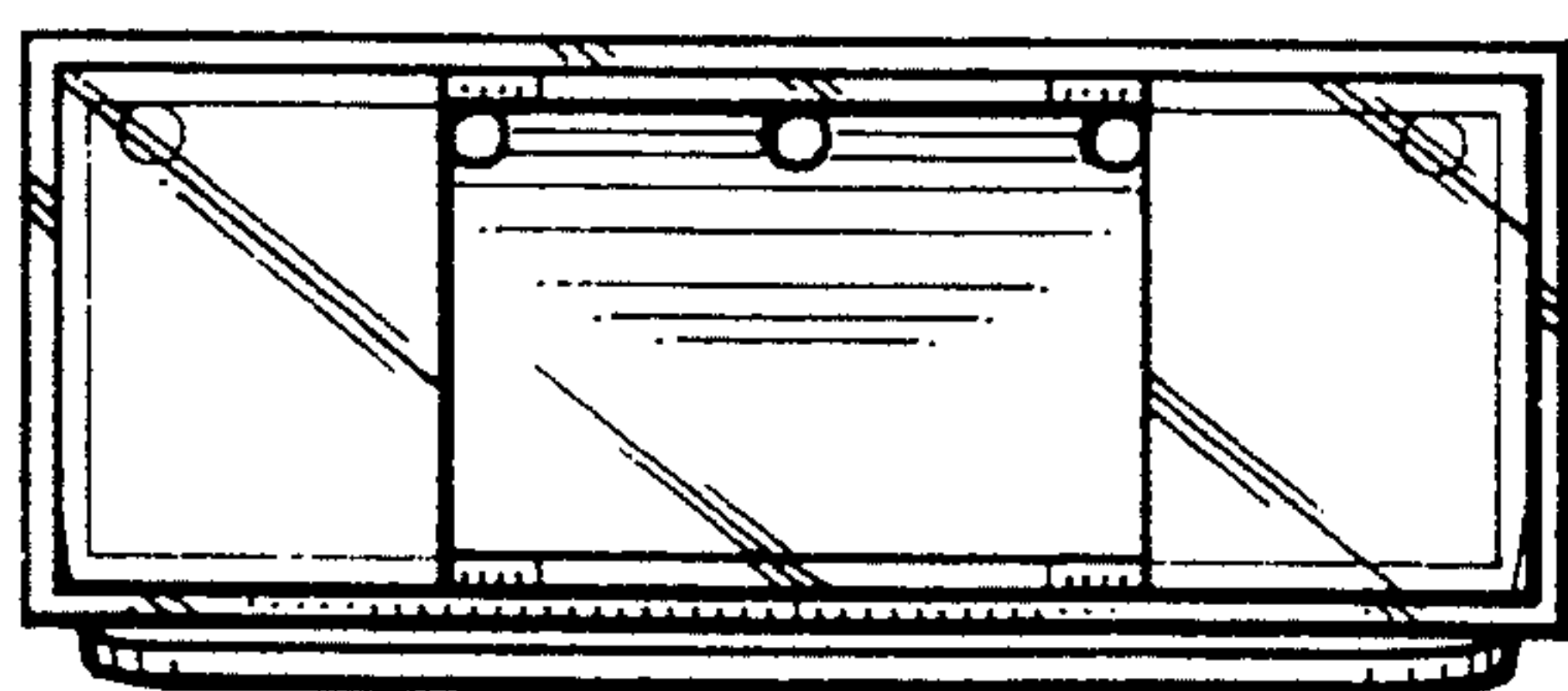

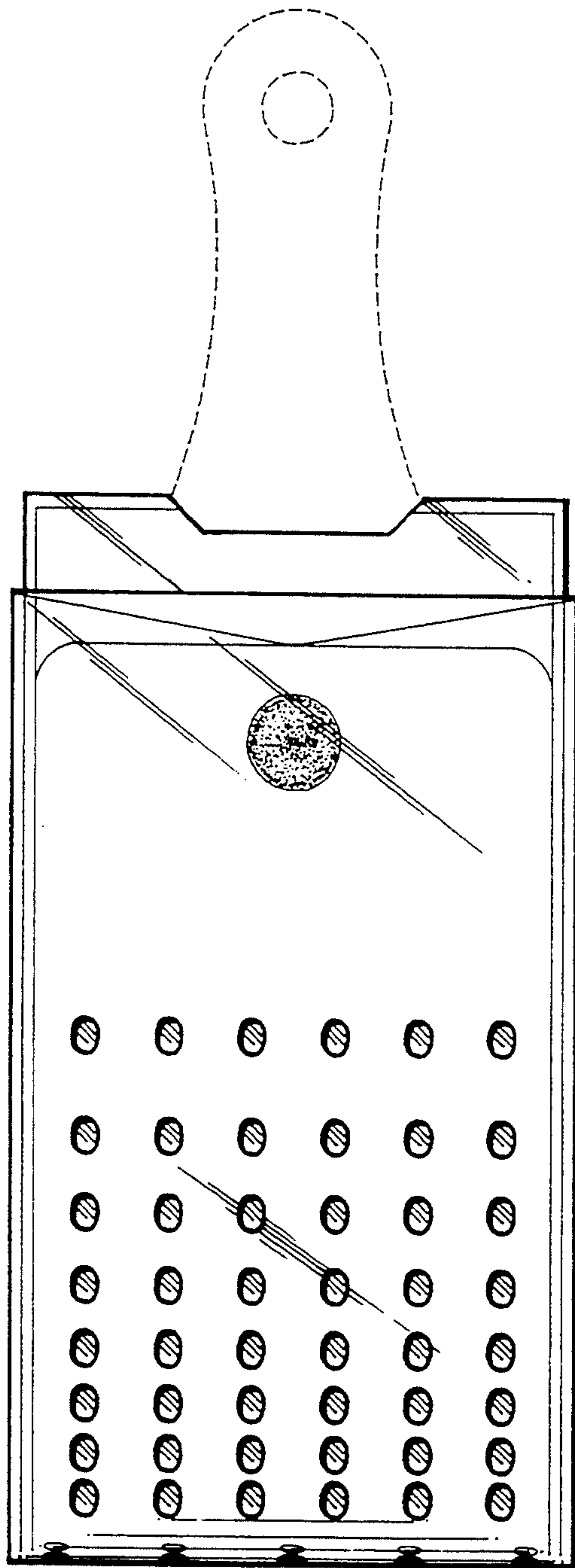

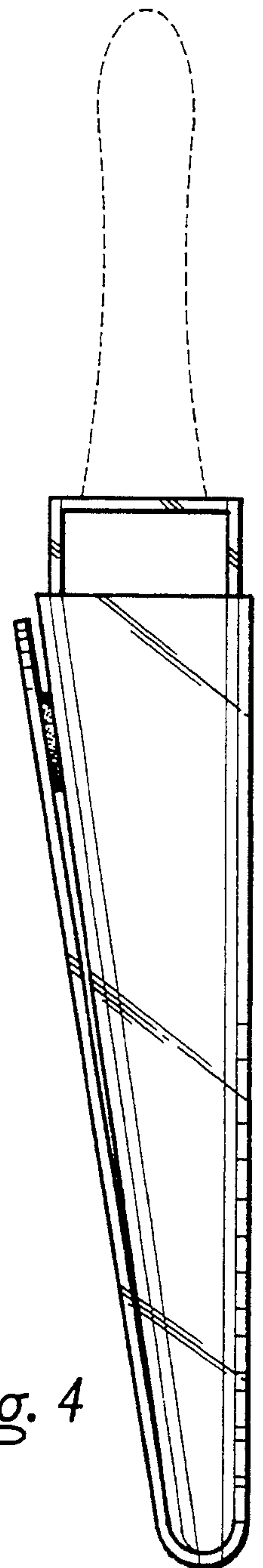

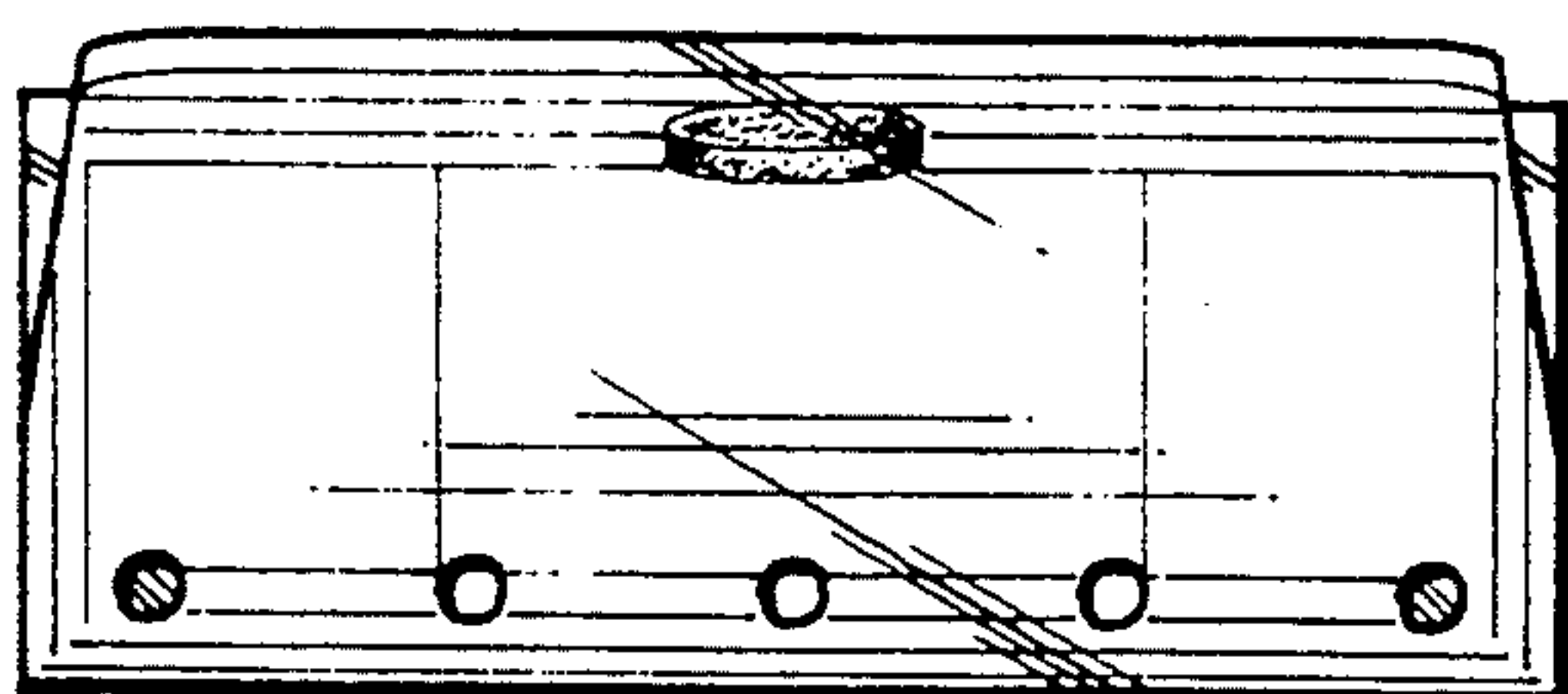
