FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical.

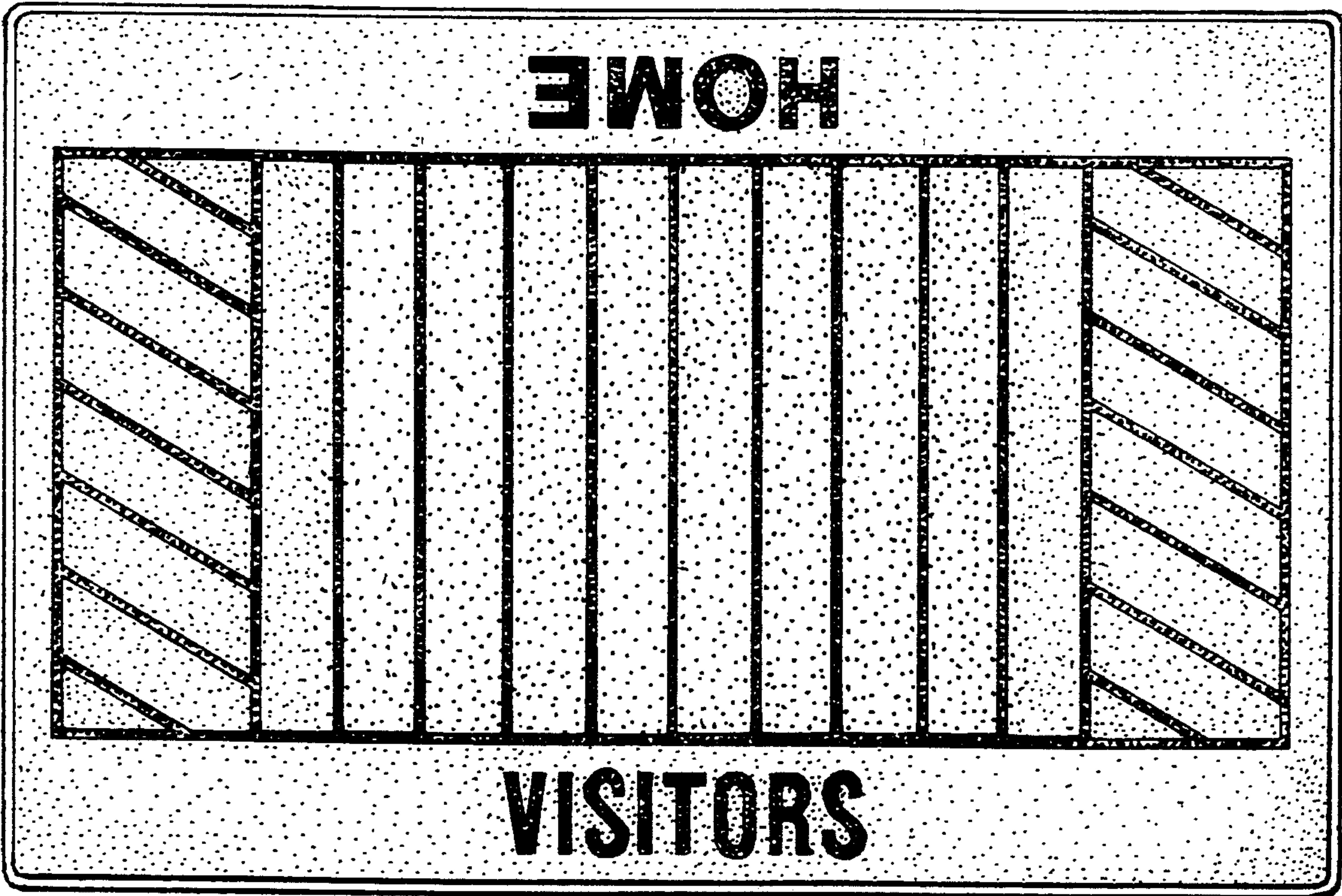

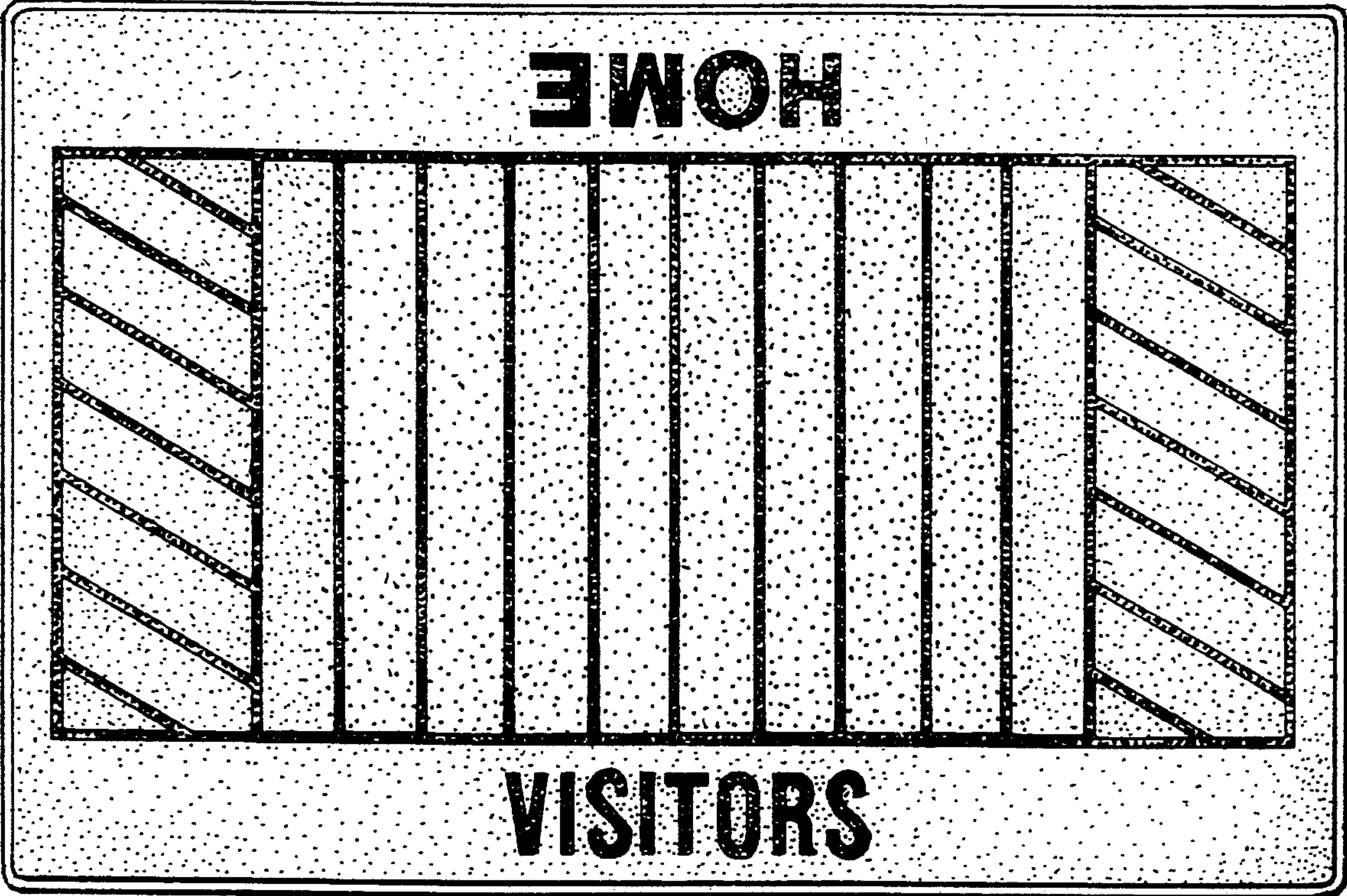

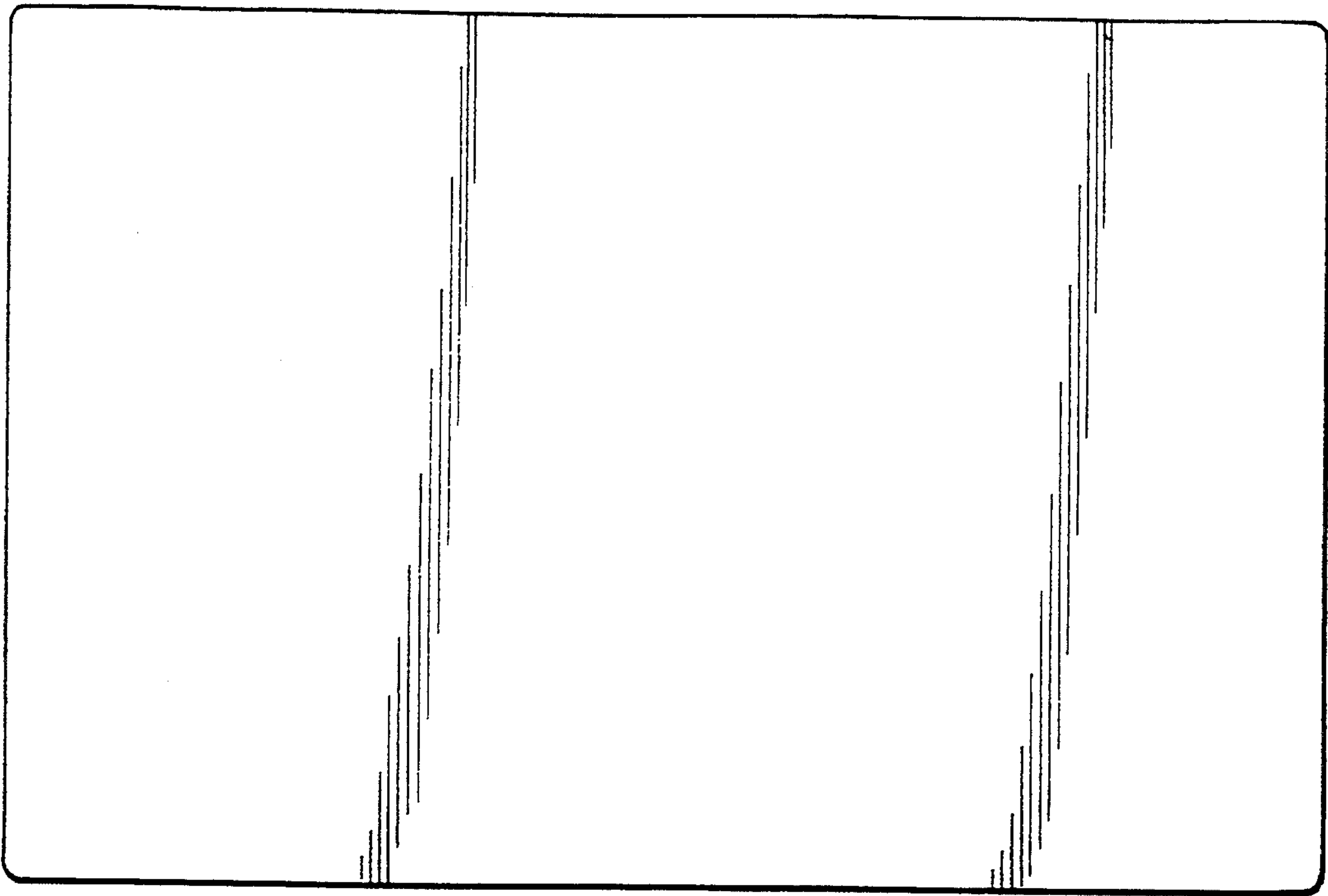
