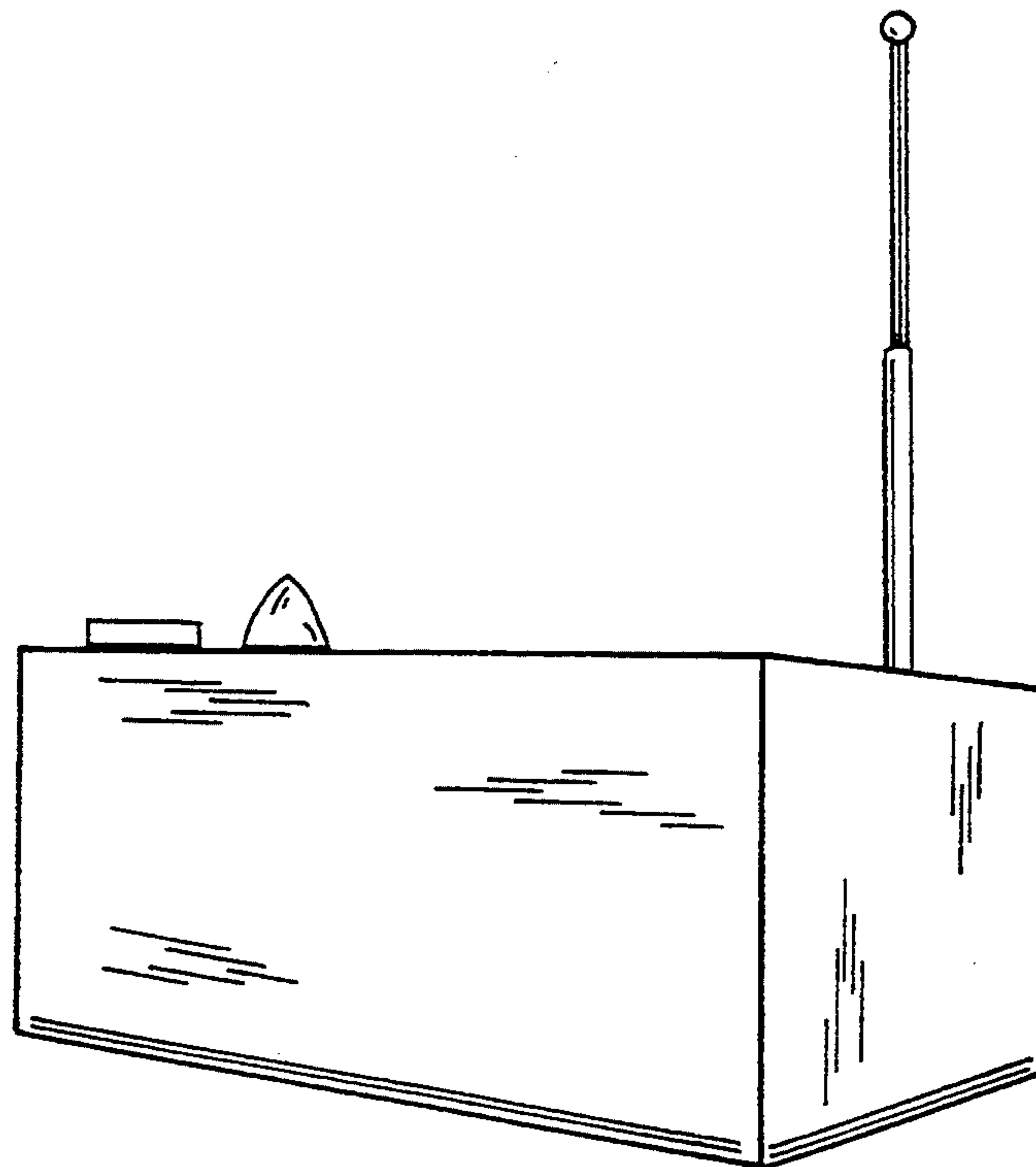
FIG. 1 is a perspective plan view showing my new

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



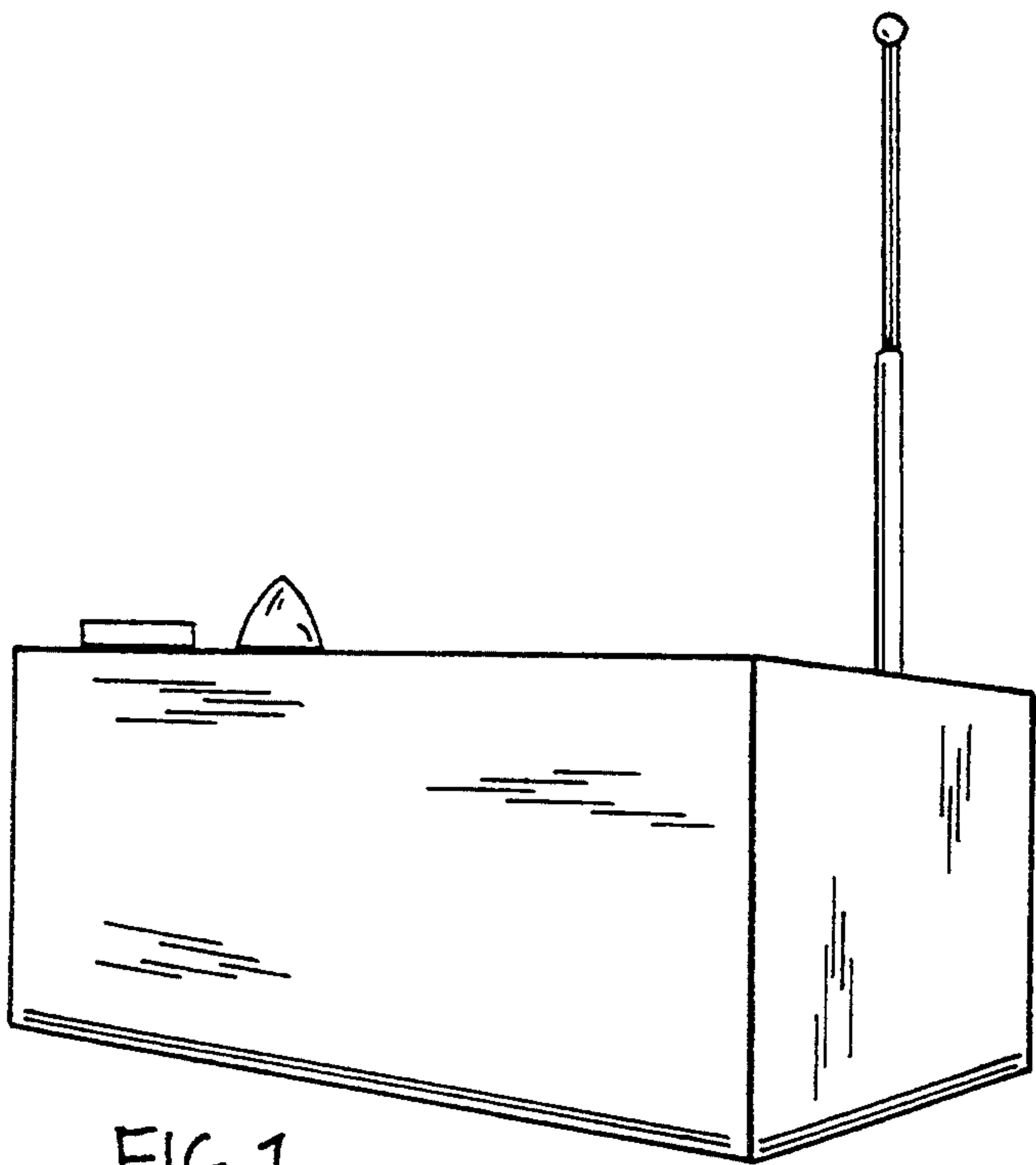

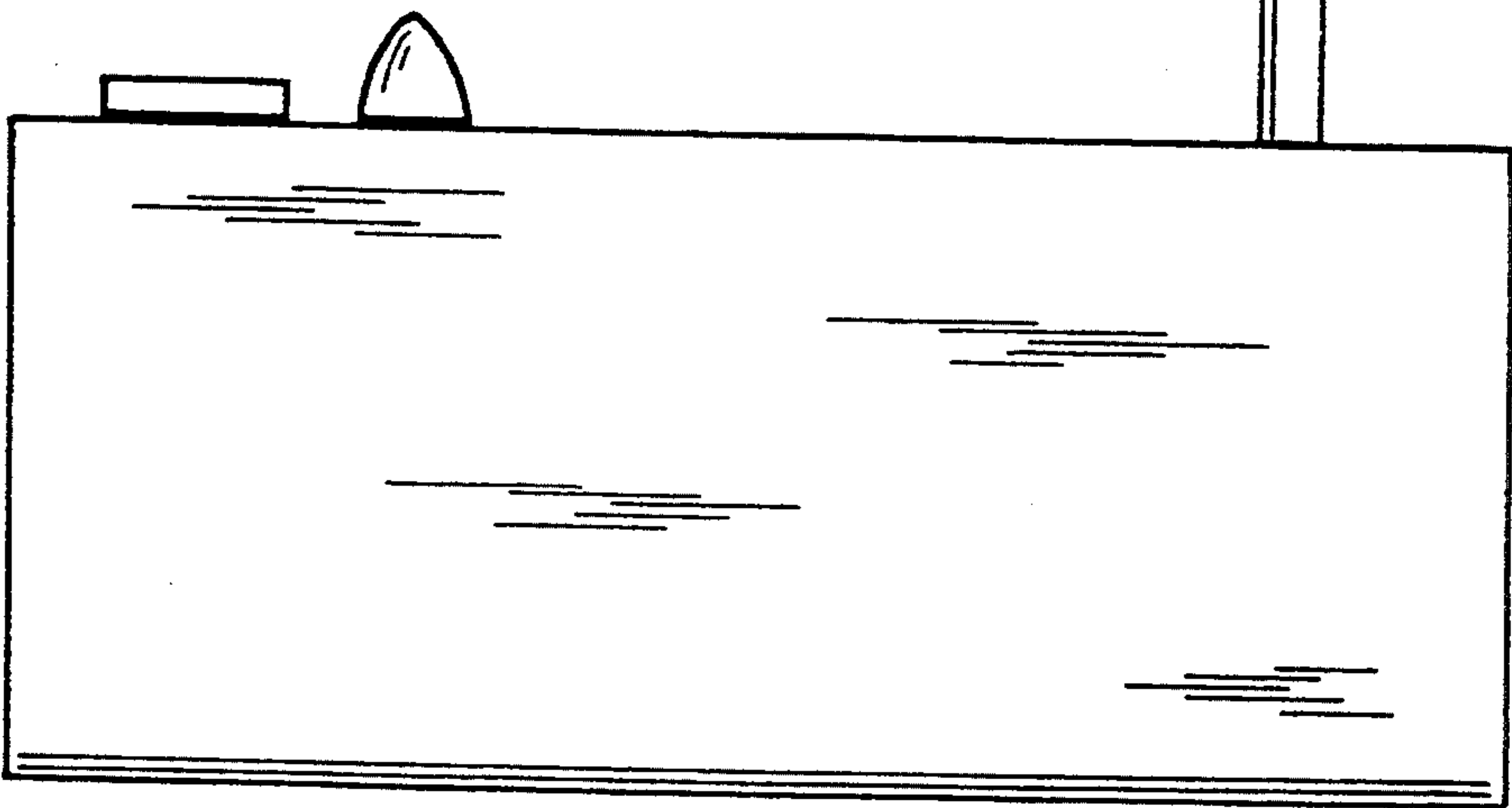

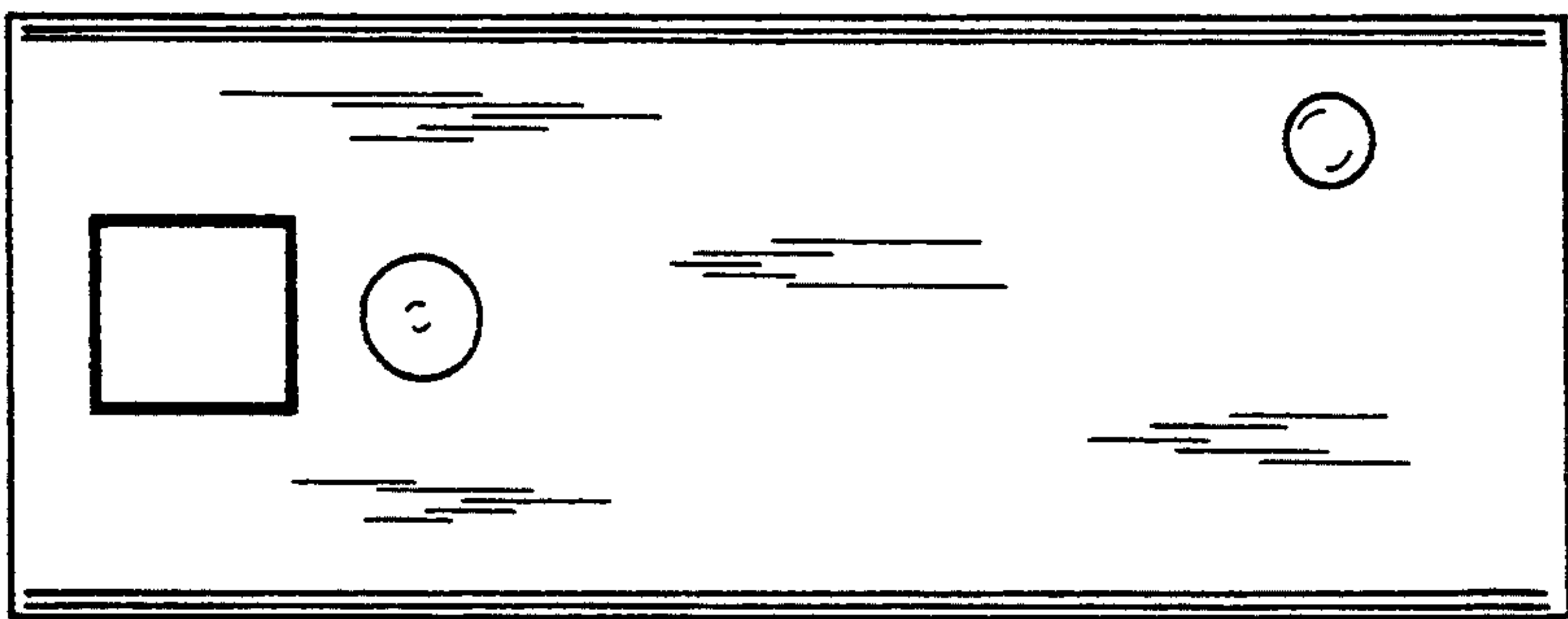

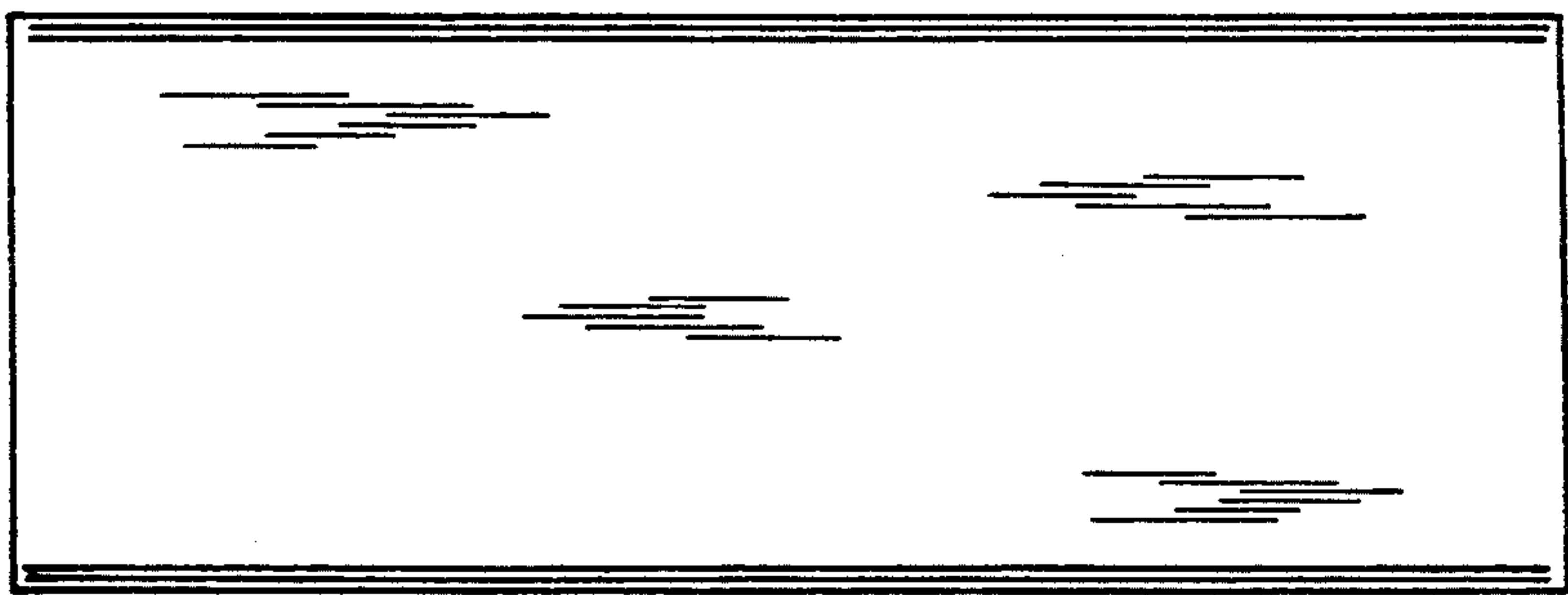

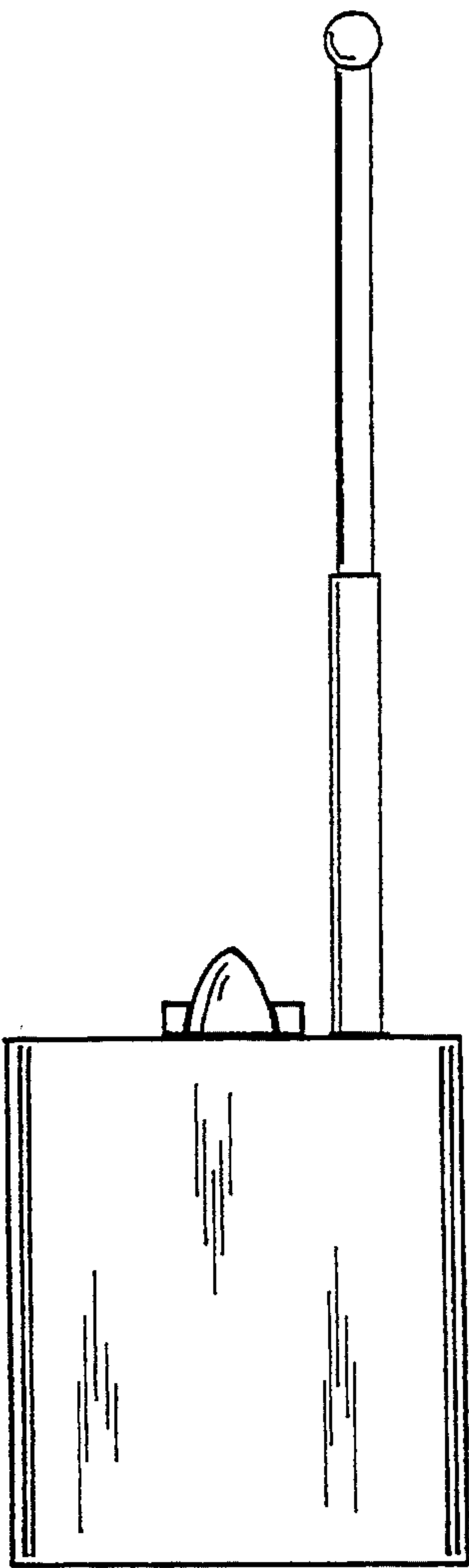
