[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottled water station, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the top, front, and left sides of a bottled water station, embodying my new design, the dotted line depiction of an inverted water bottle being for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; the right side being a mirror image of the left side as shown;

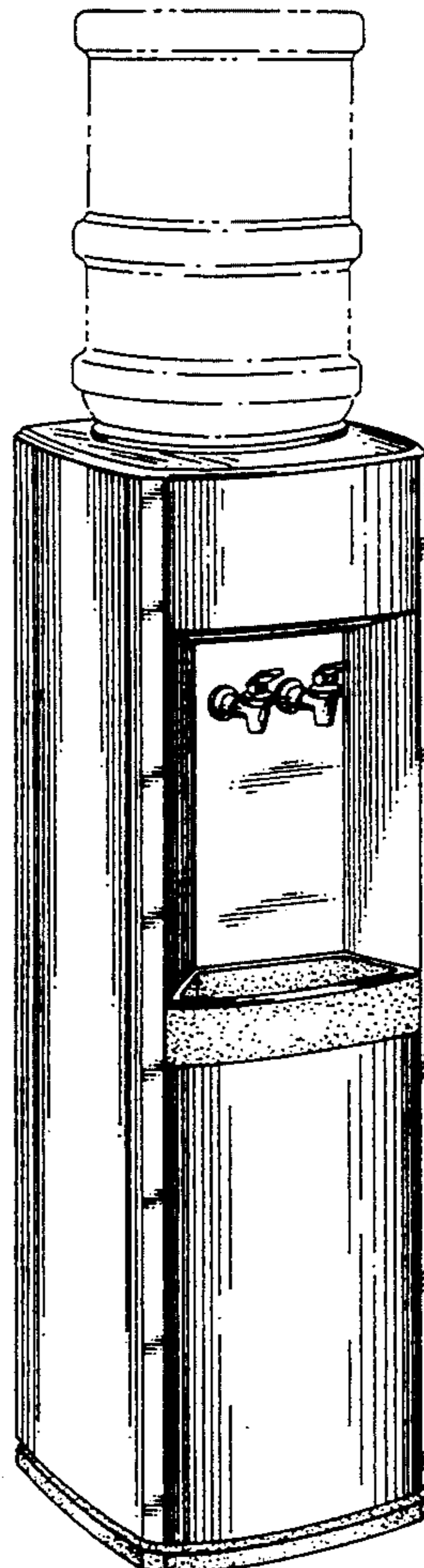
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmented horizontal sectional view taken generally on the line 6—6 of FIG. 2.

The bottom plan view is plain and unornamented.

The broken line showing of an inverted water bottle in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



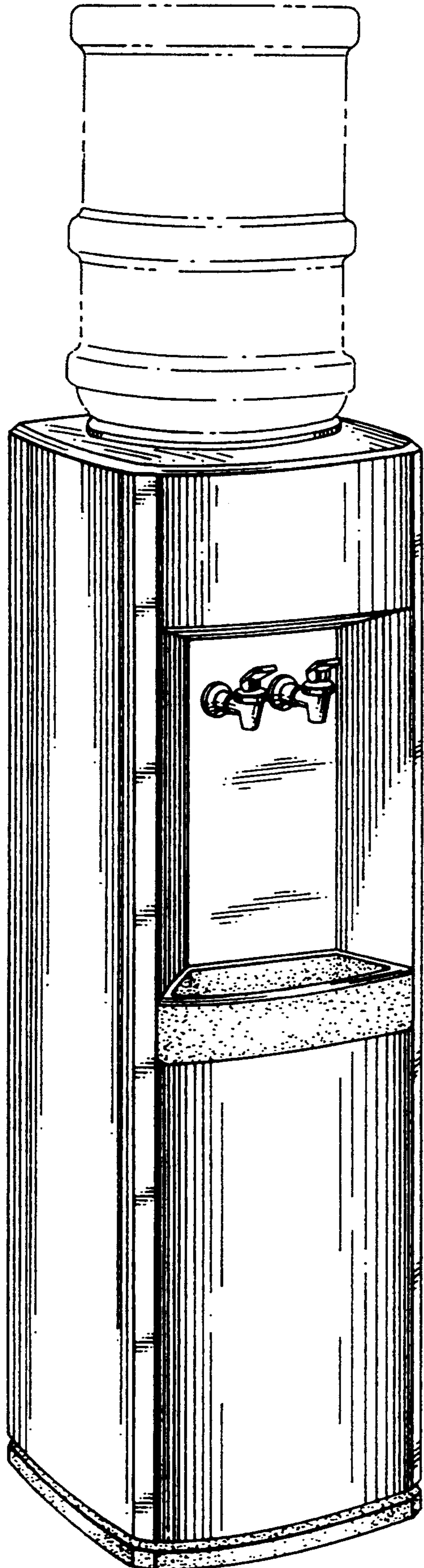

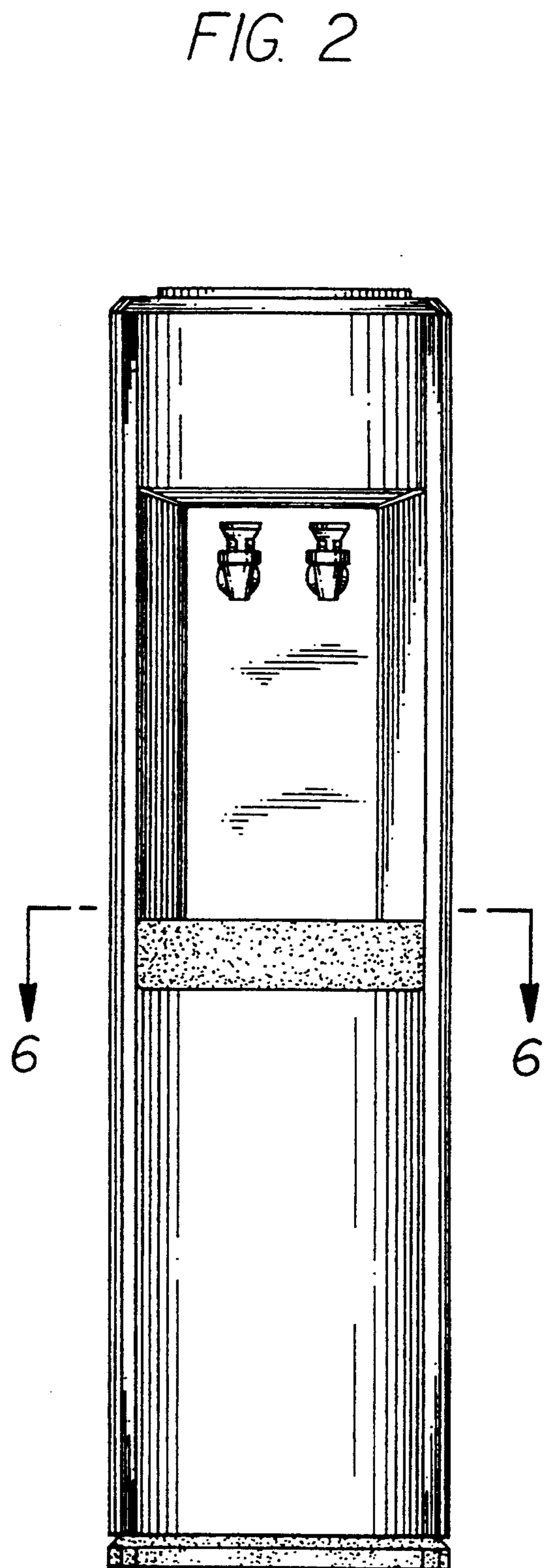

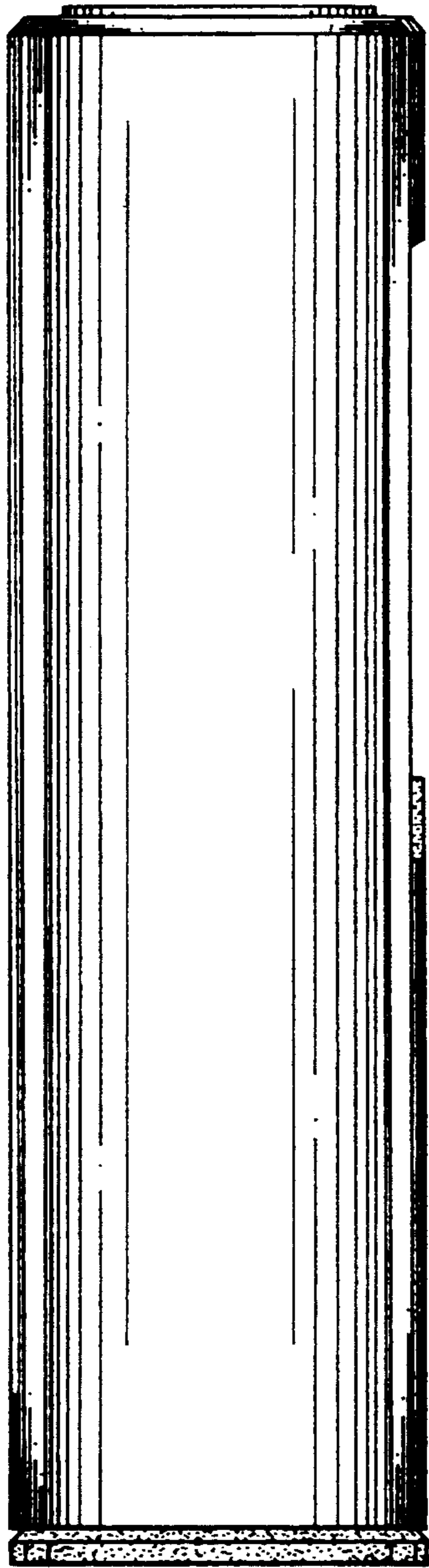

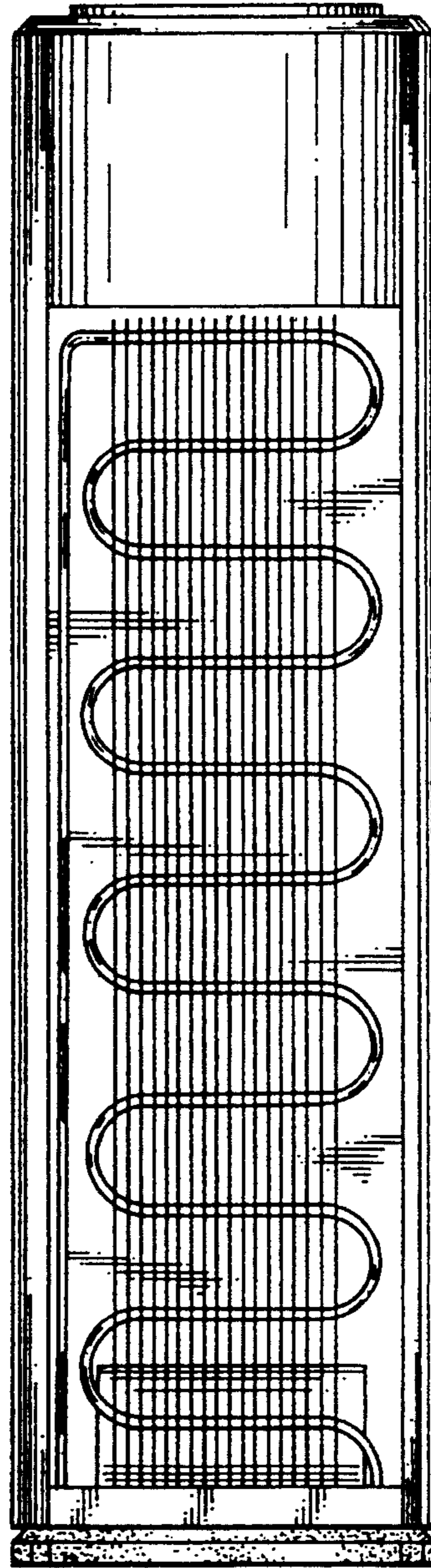

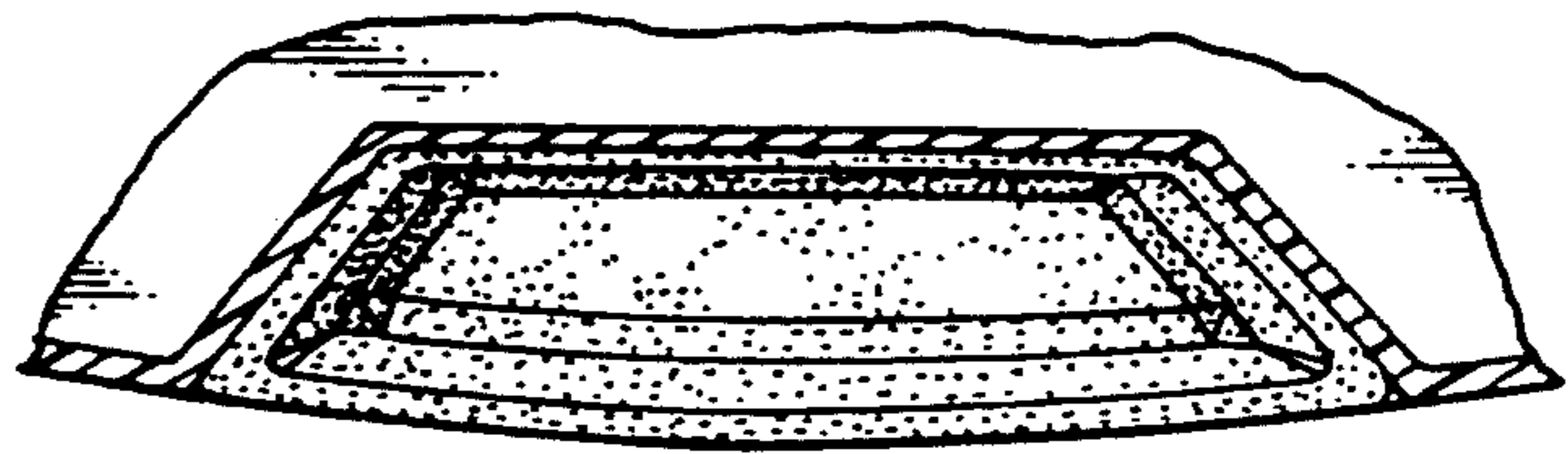
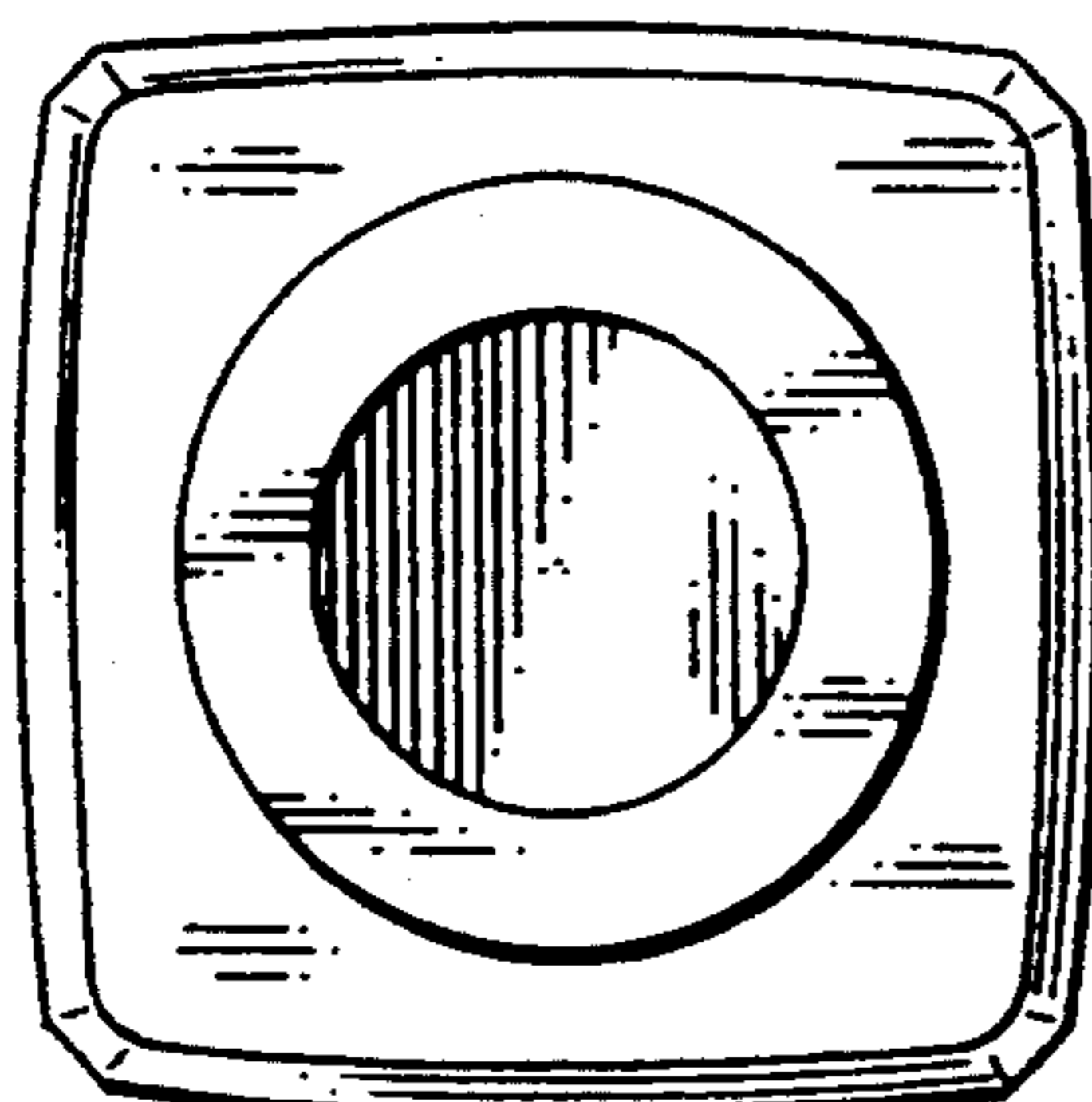
