FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof.

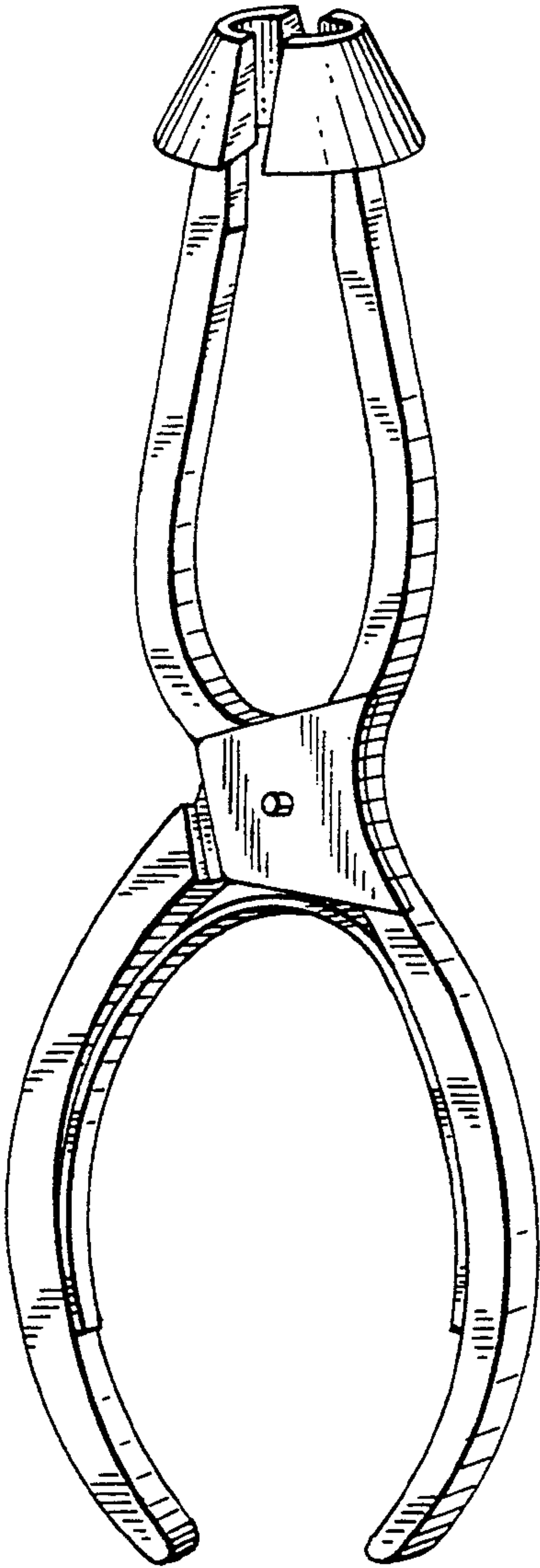

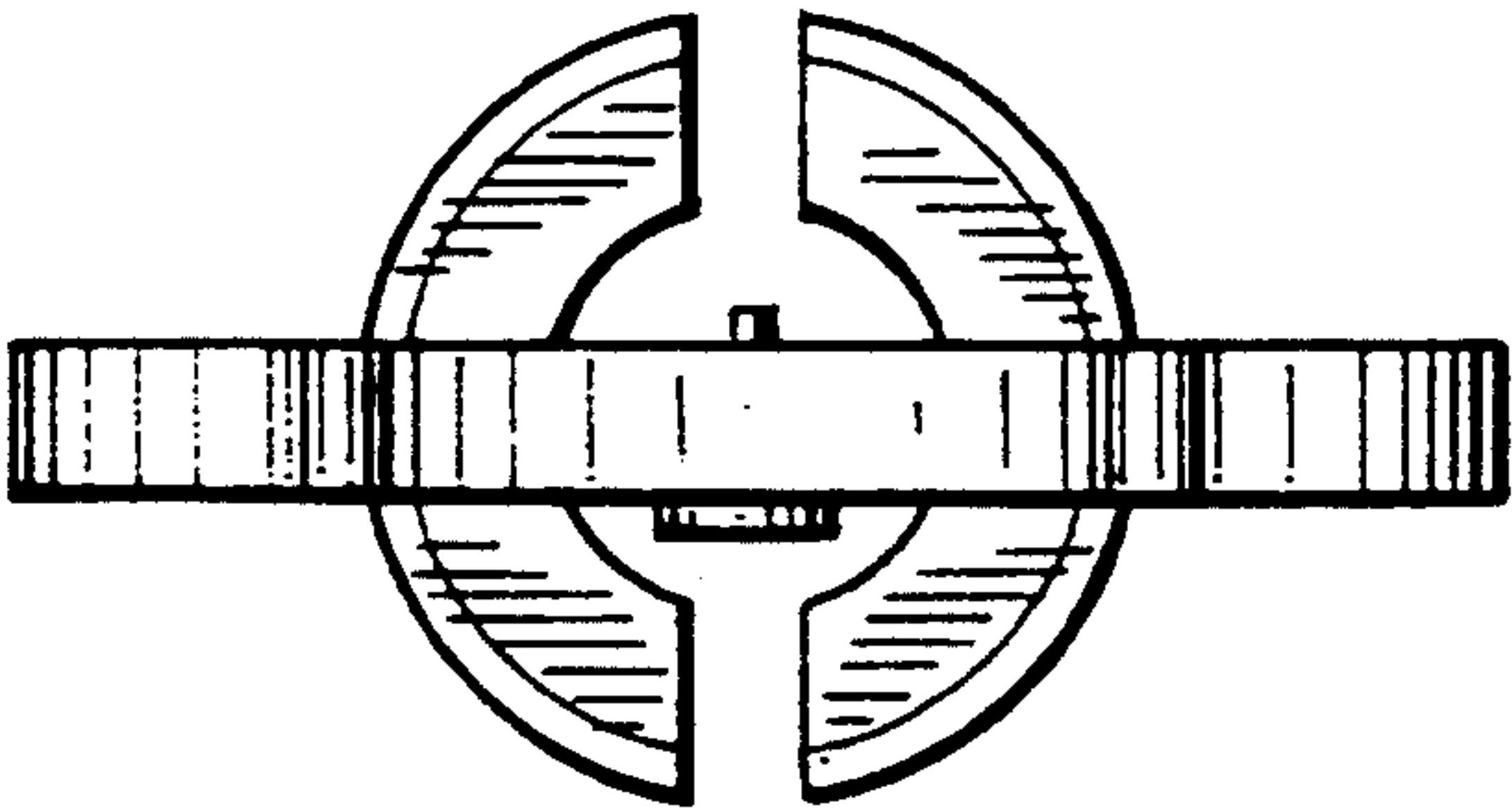
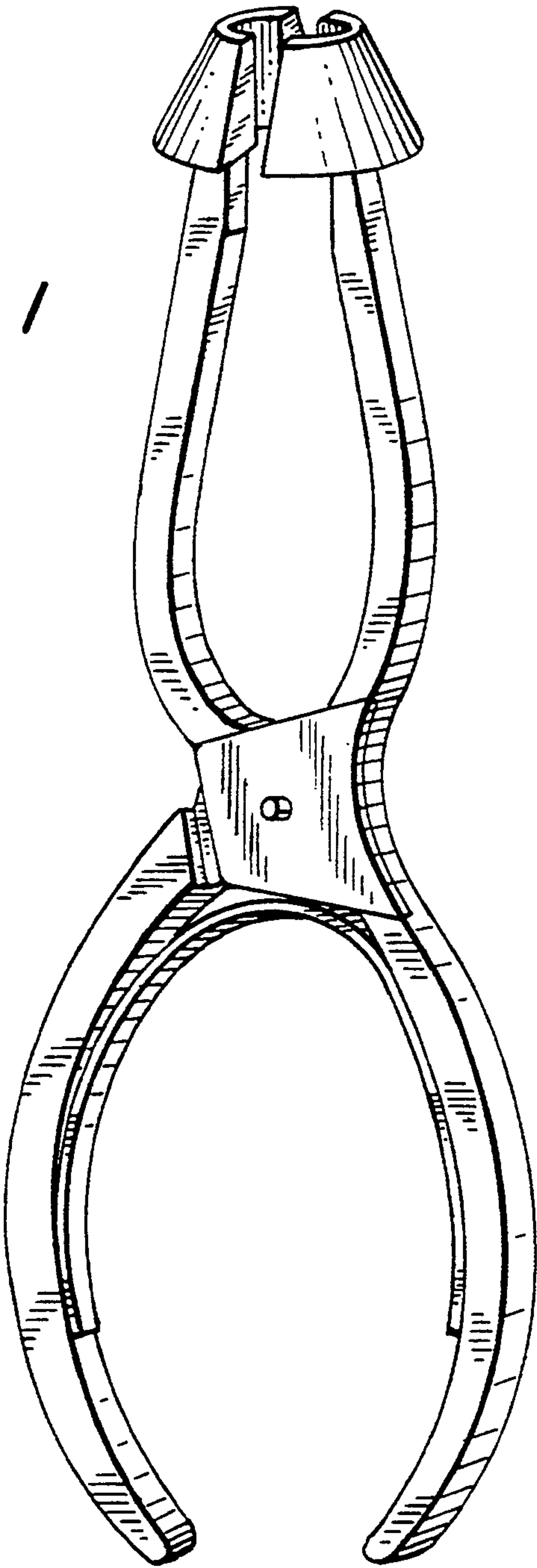

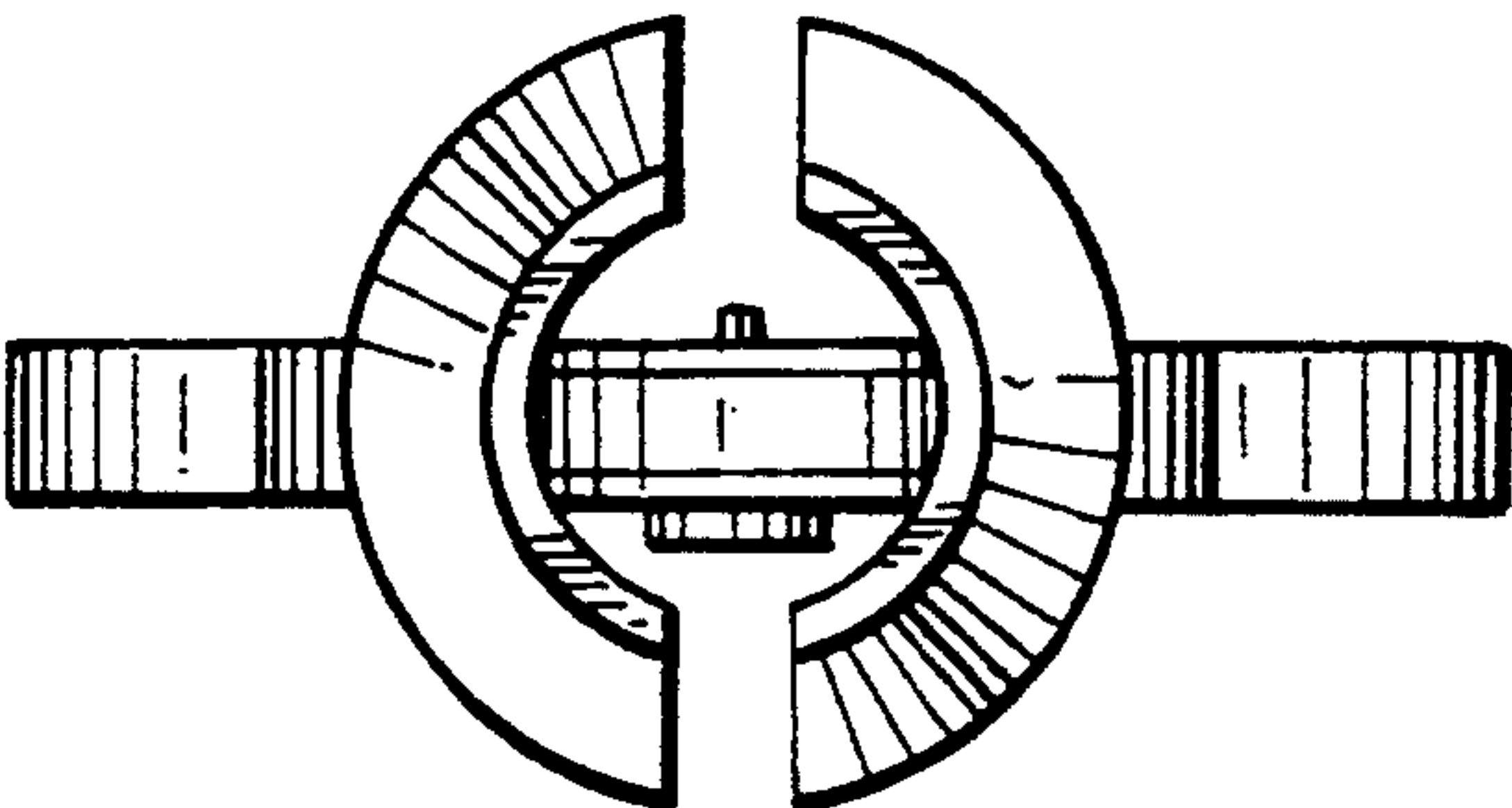

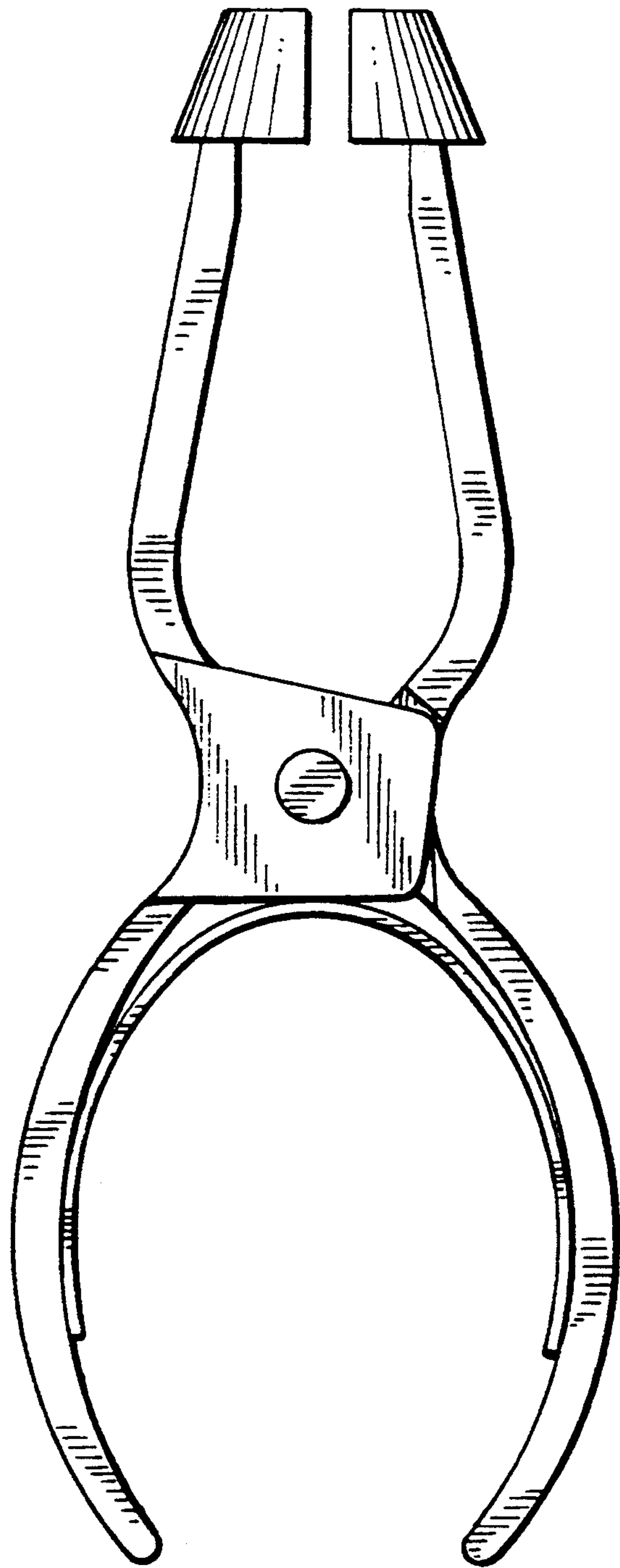
