substantially a mirror image thereof;

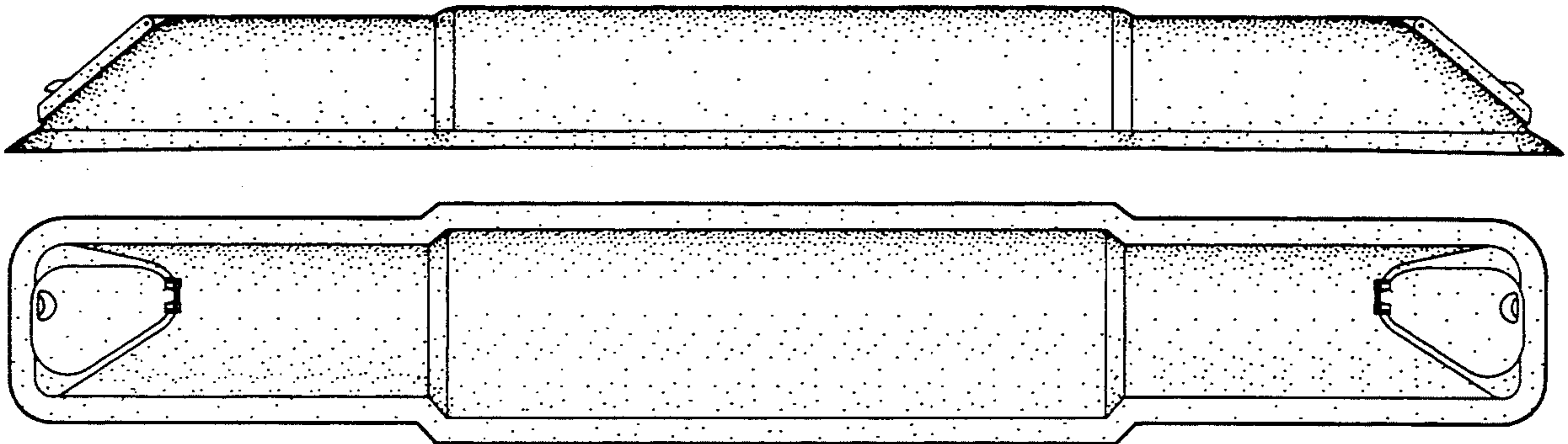

shown.



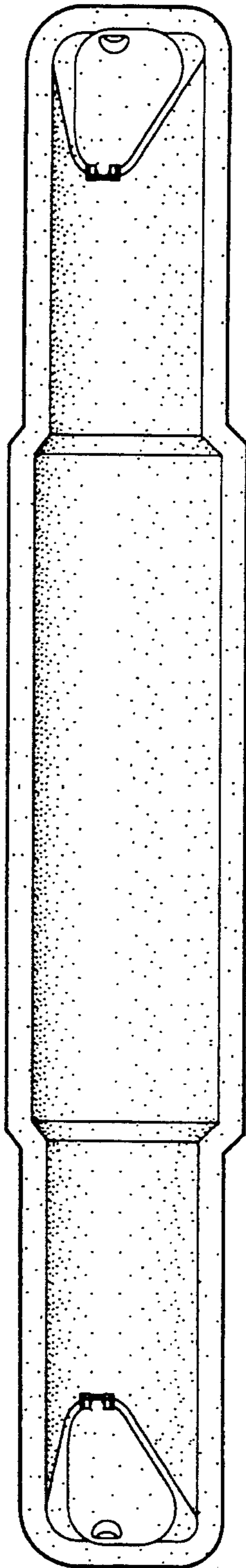

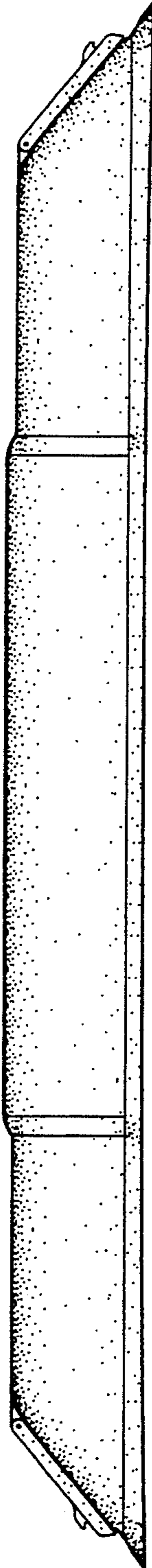

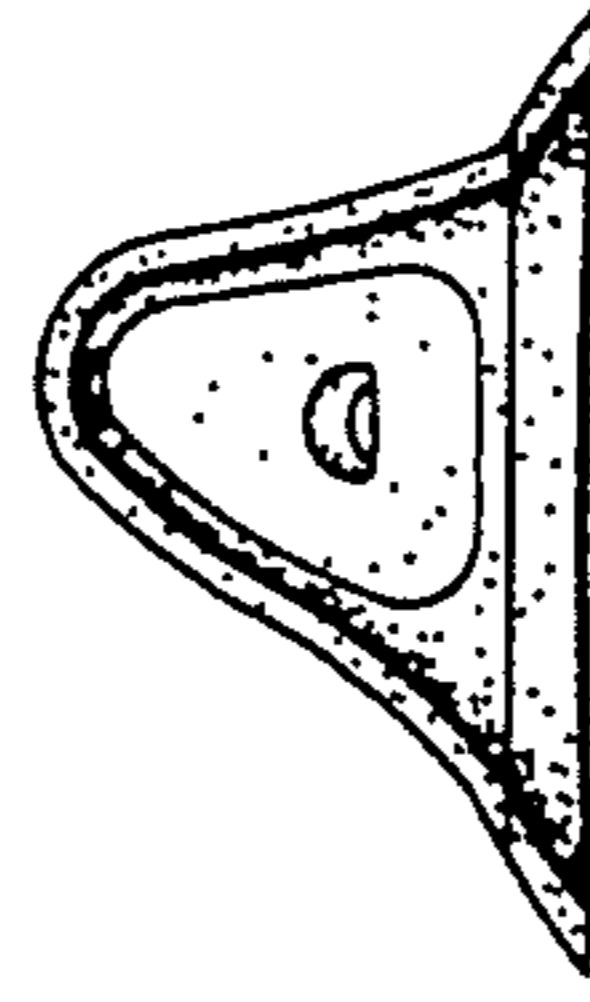
