## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design is a cell culture scraper, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of the disclosed cell culture scraper, shown in a section broken away for ease of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the disclosed cell culture scraper;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view of the disclosed cell culture scraper taken along the line 3—3 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view of the disclosed cell culture scraper taken along the line 4—4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view of the disclosed cell culture scraper taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmented side view of the tip portion of the disclosed cell culture scraper, with the scraper portion removed;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the disclosed cell culture scraper, shown with a section broken away for ease of illustration;

FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the disclosed cell culture scraper, shown with a section broken away for ease of illustration; and,

FIG. 9 is a rear view of the disclosed cell culture scraper.

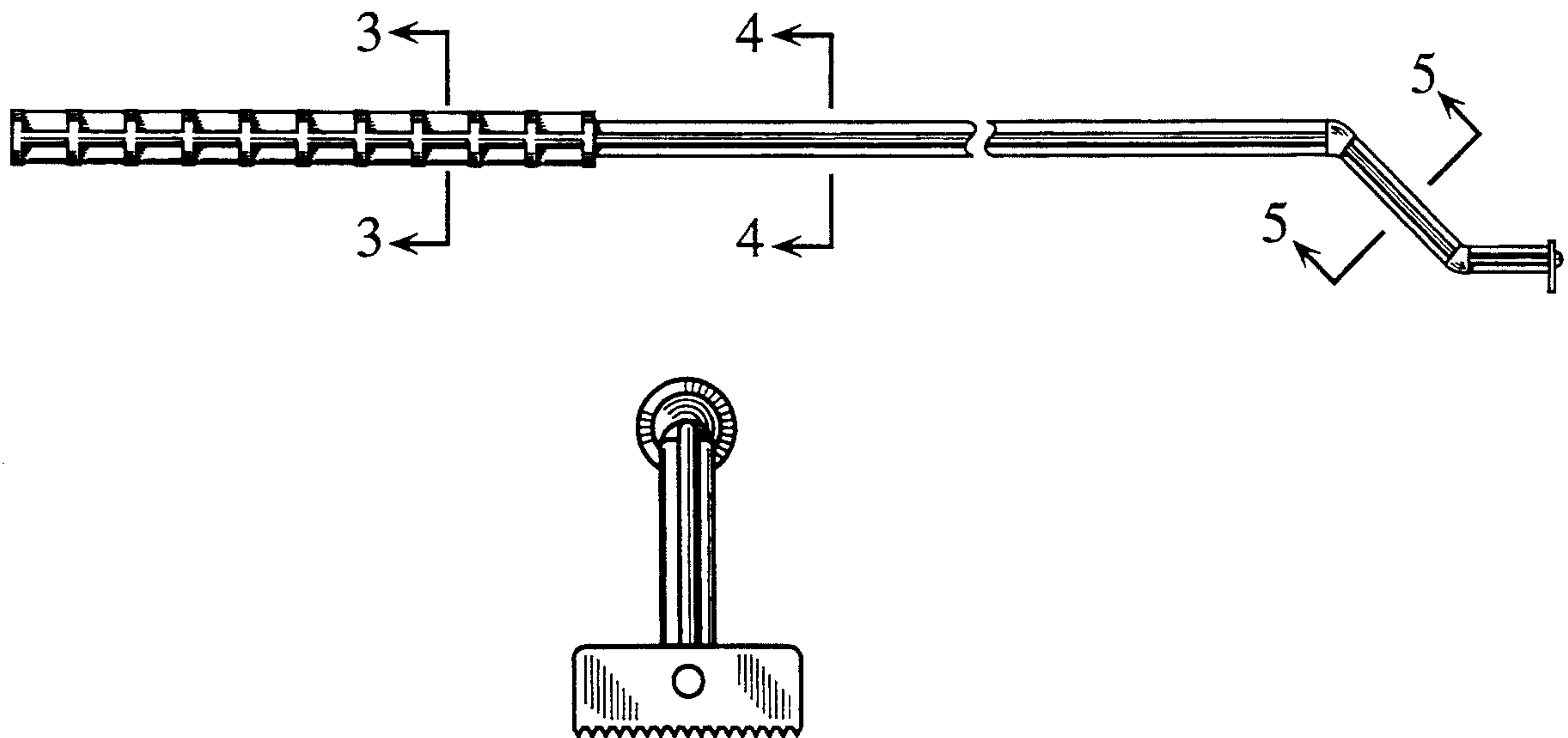

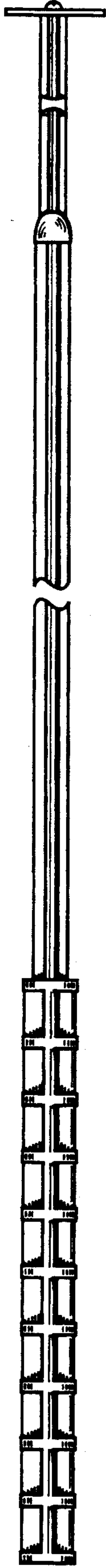

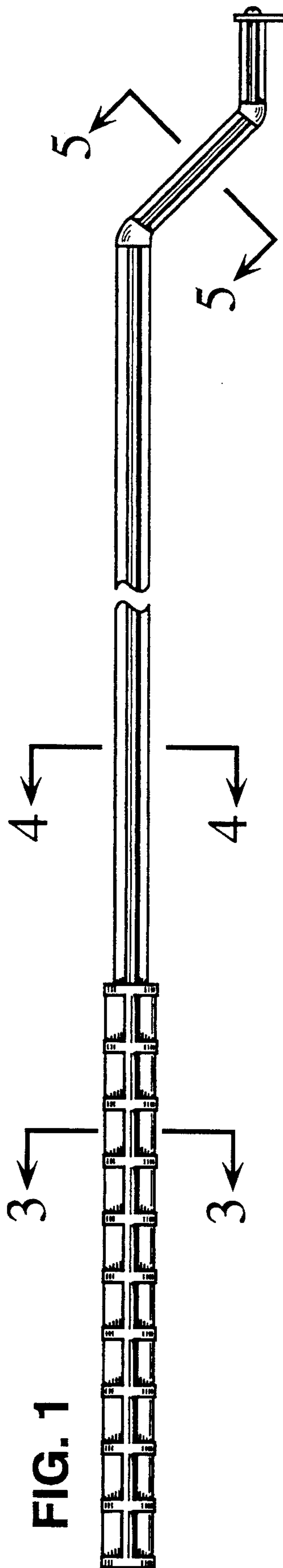

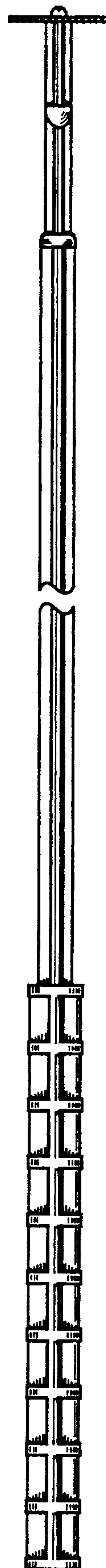

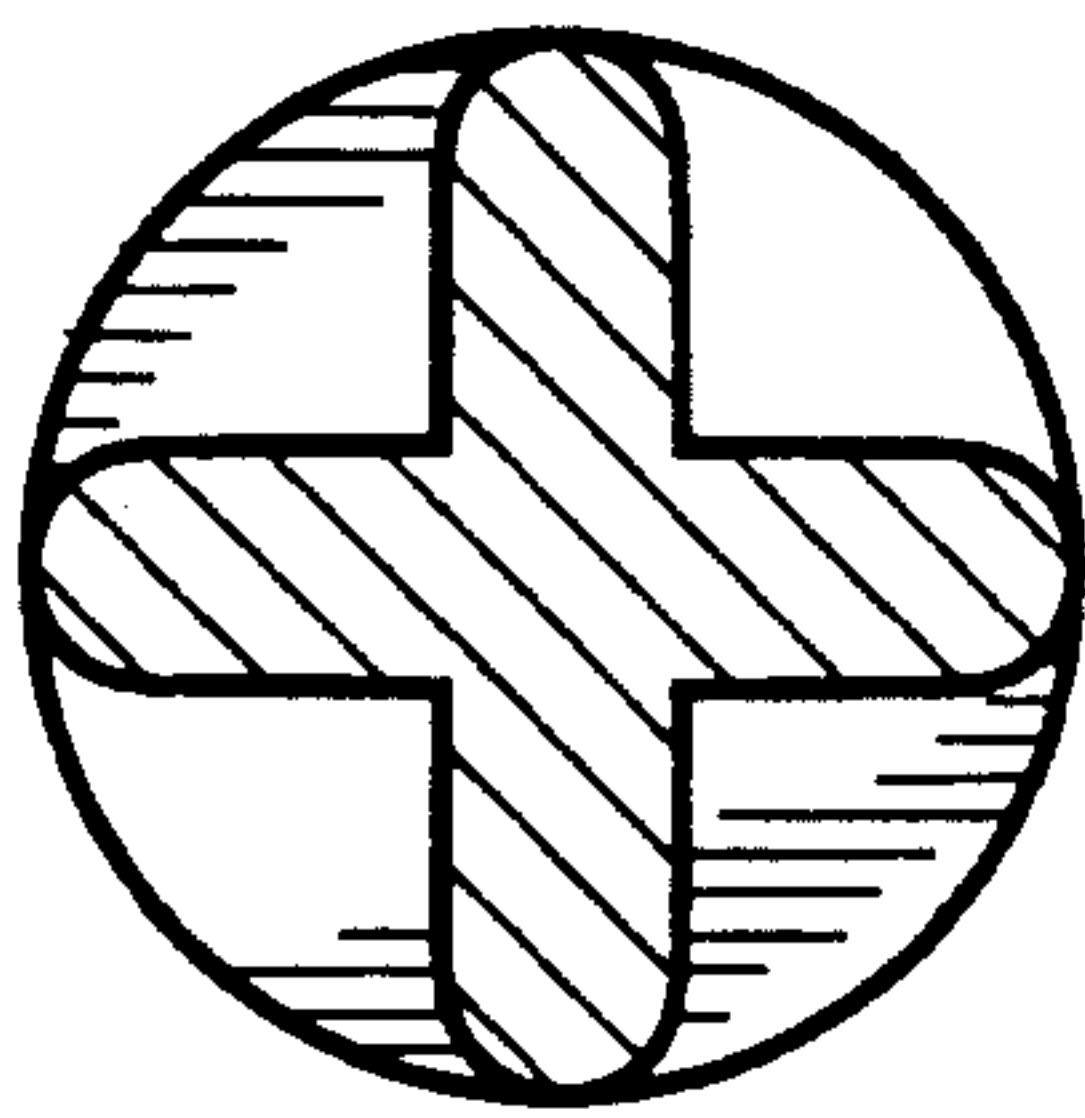

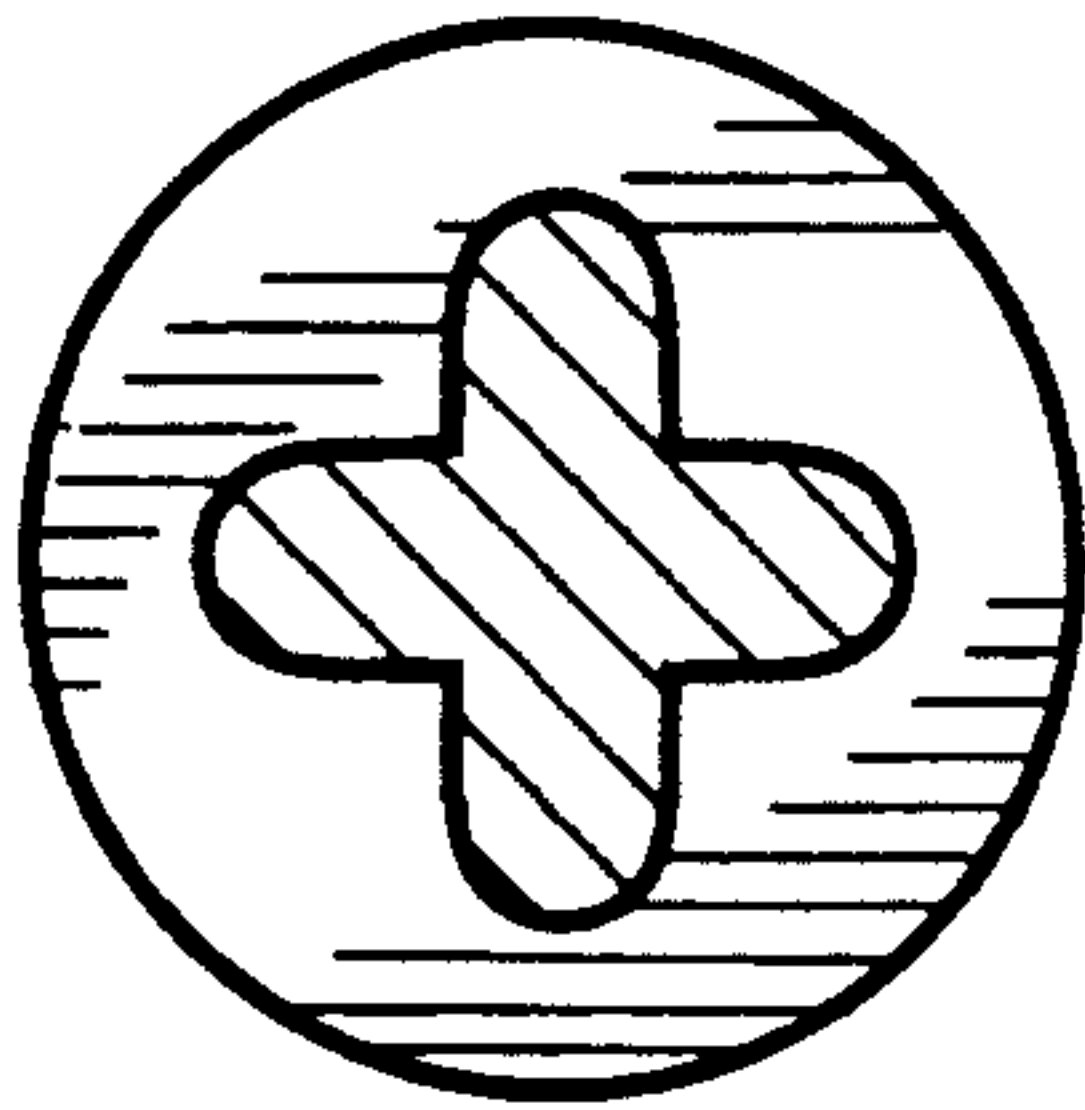

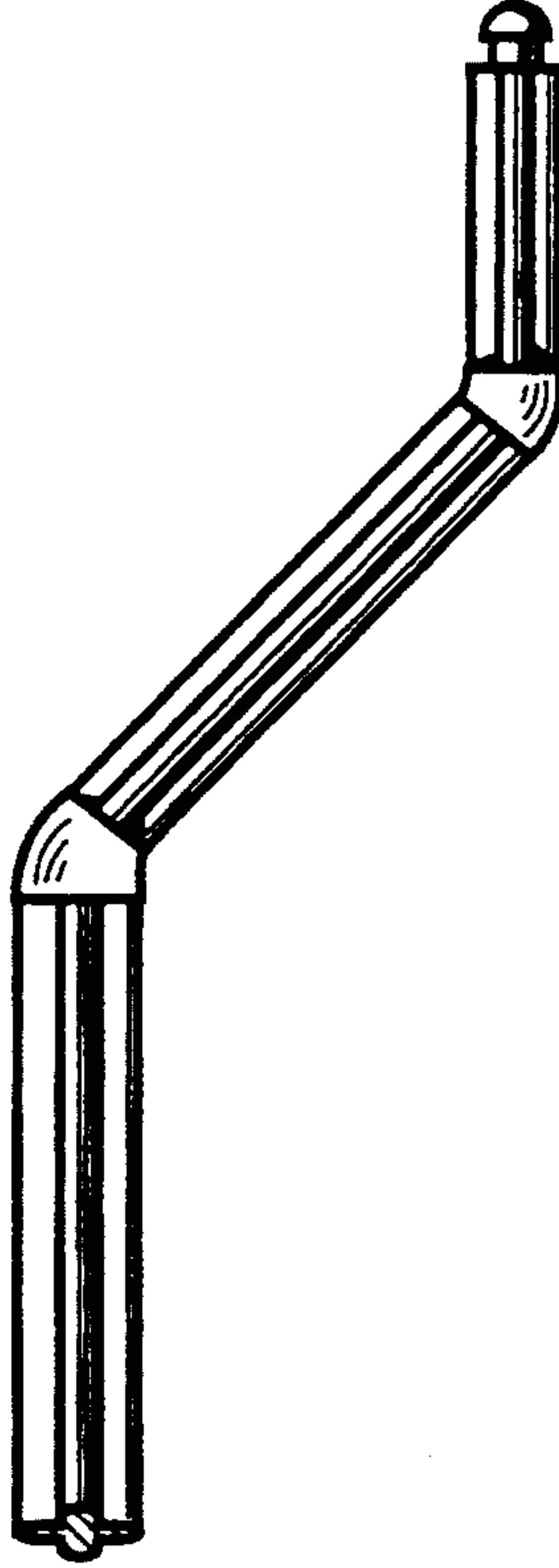

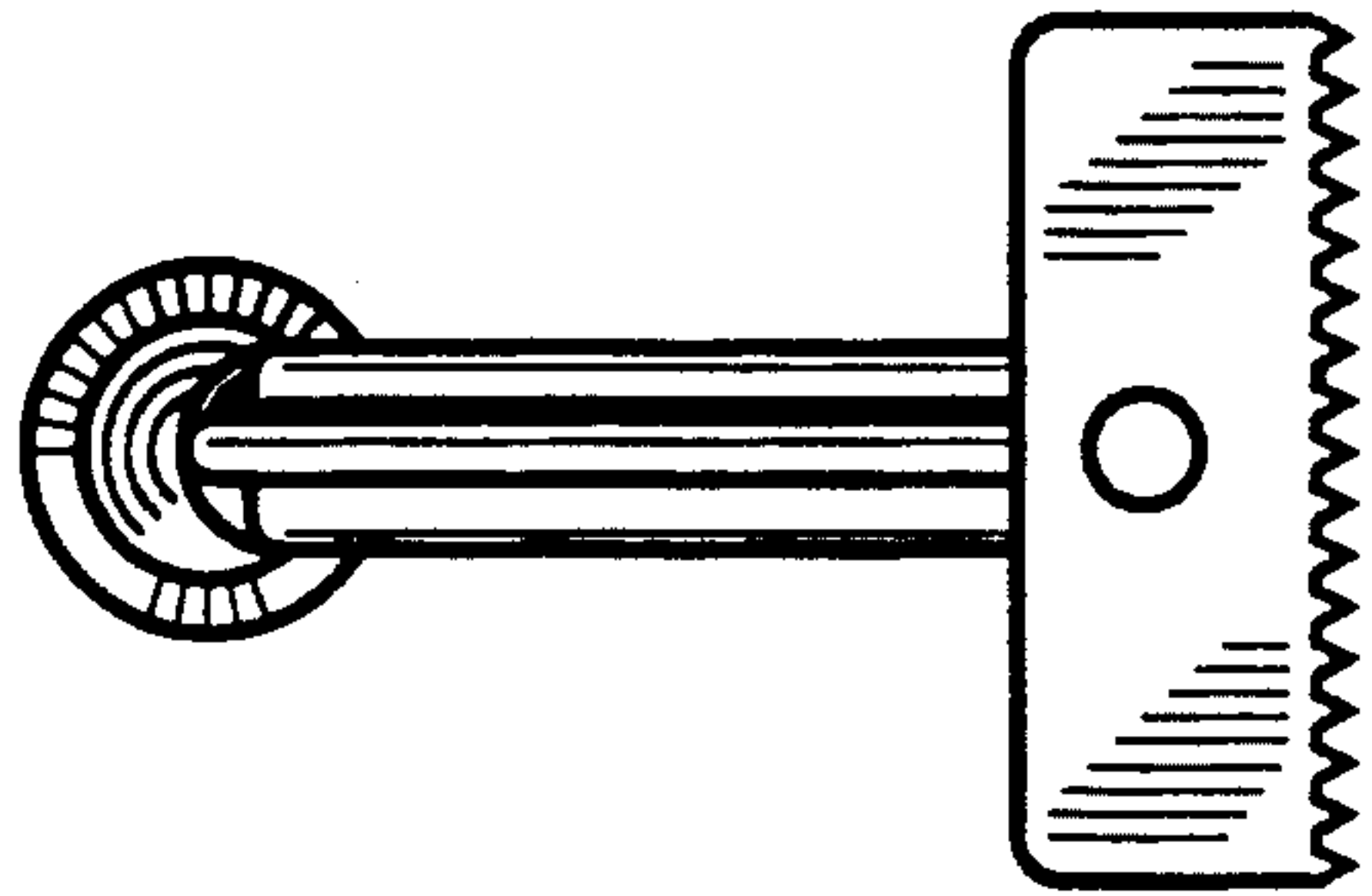
