DESCRIPTION

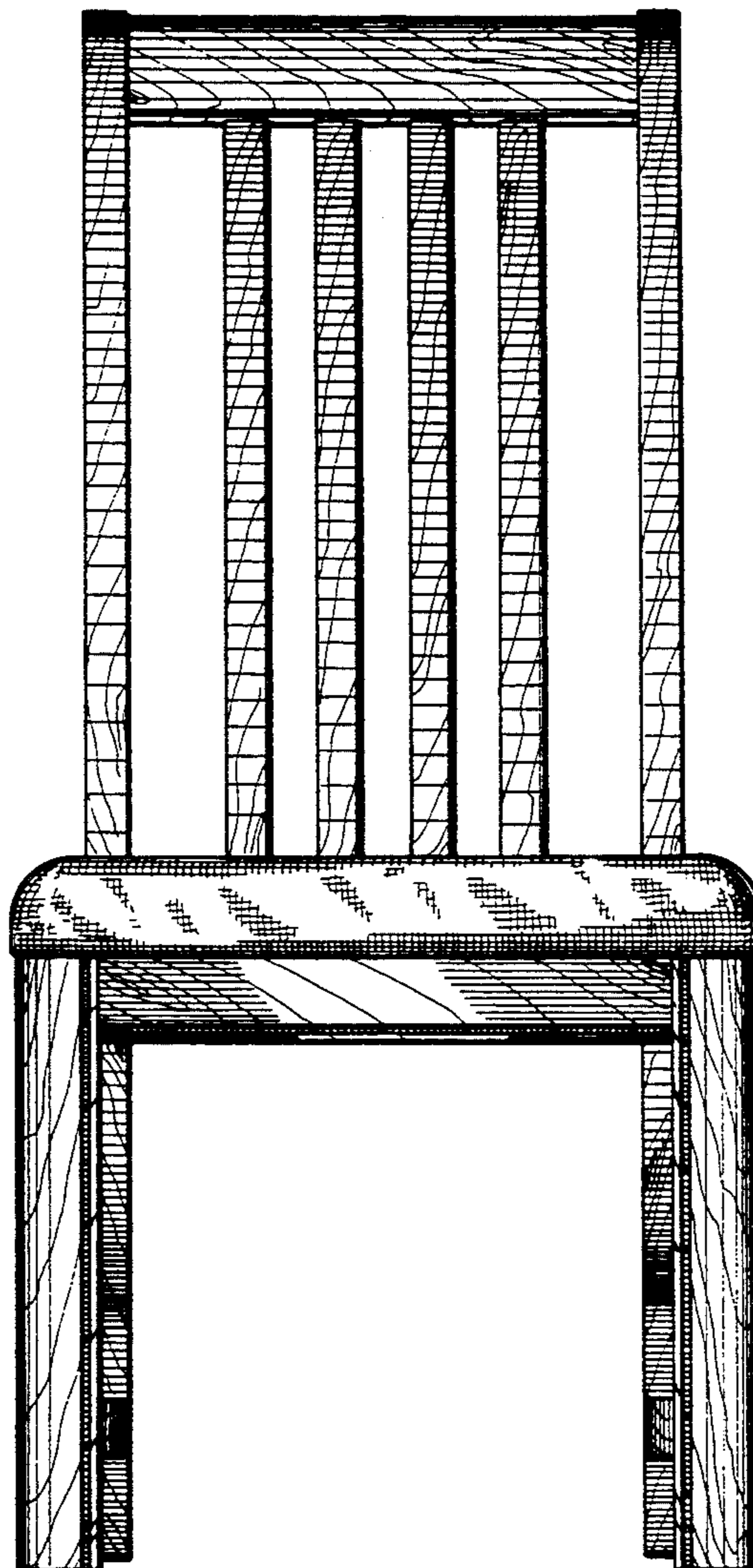
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a dining chair incorporating the design of this invention;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



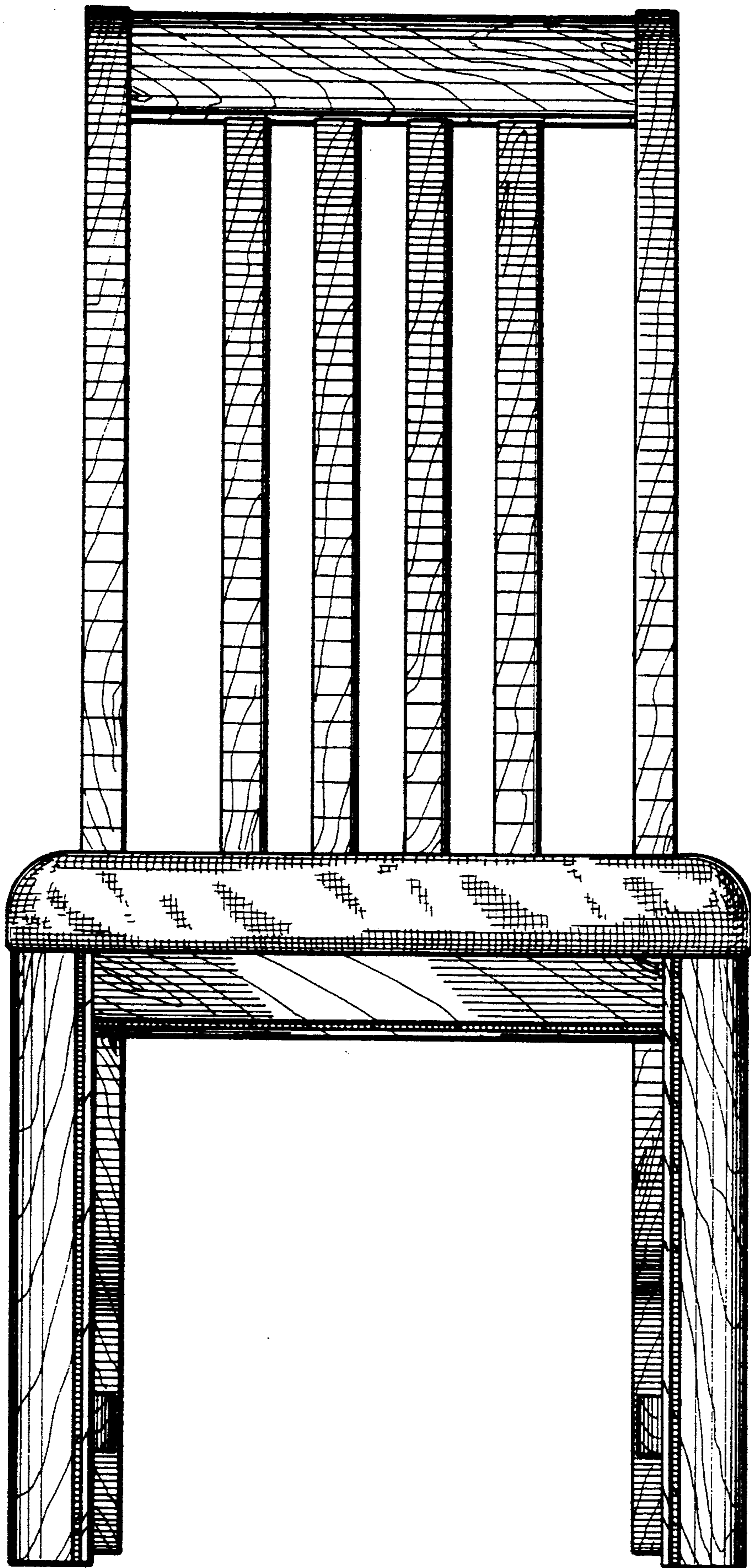

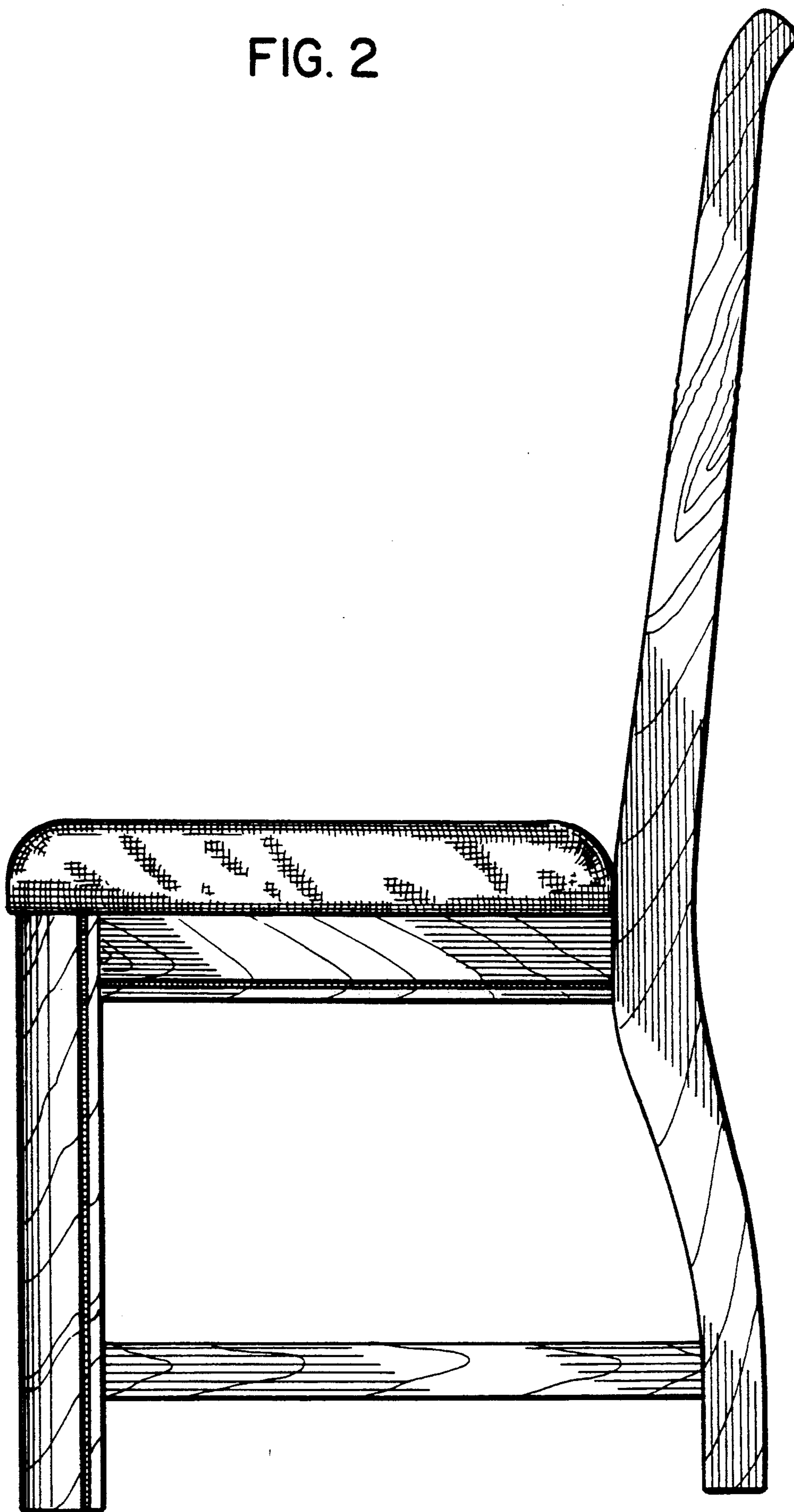
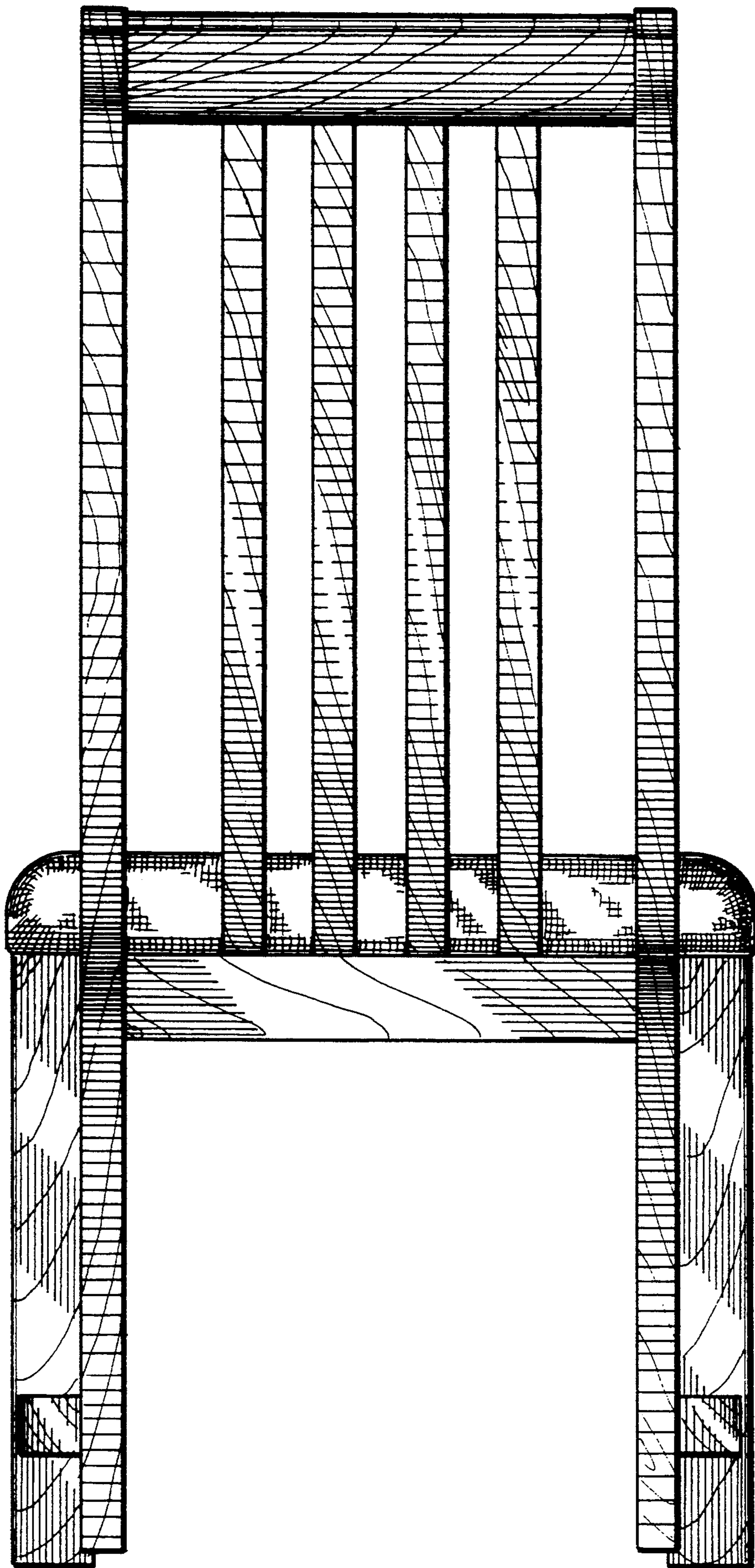

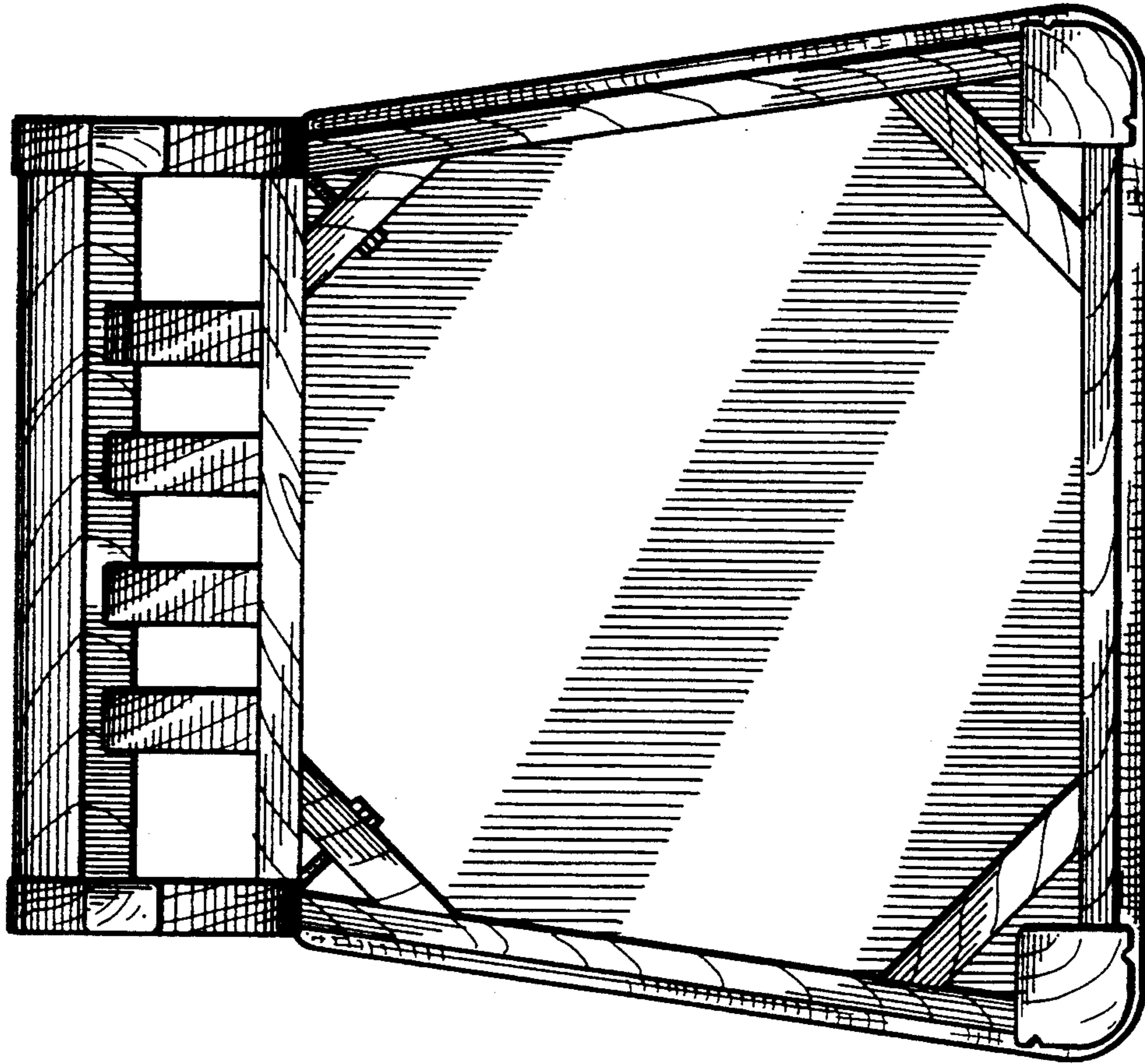

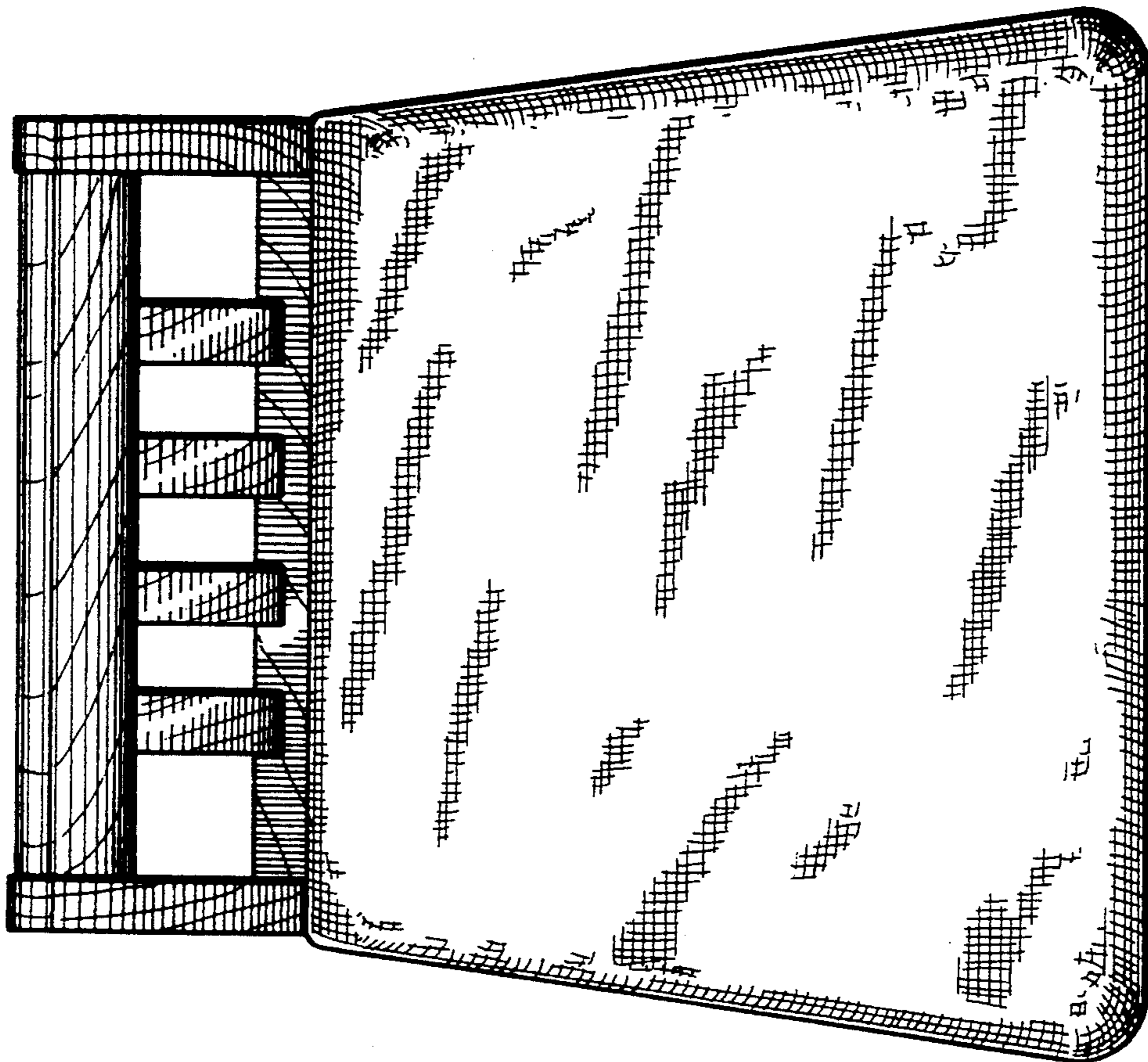
