[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined disposable emergency upper cervical and head immobilizer, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined disposable emergency upper cervical and head immobilizer in assembled position;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof, to a slightly enlarged scale;

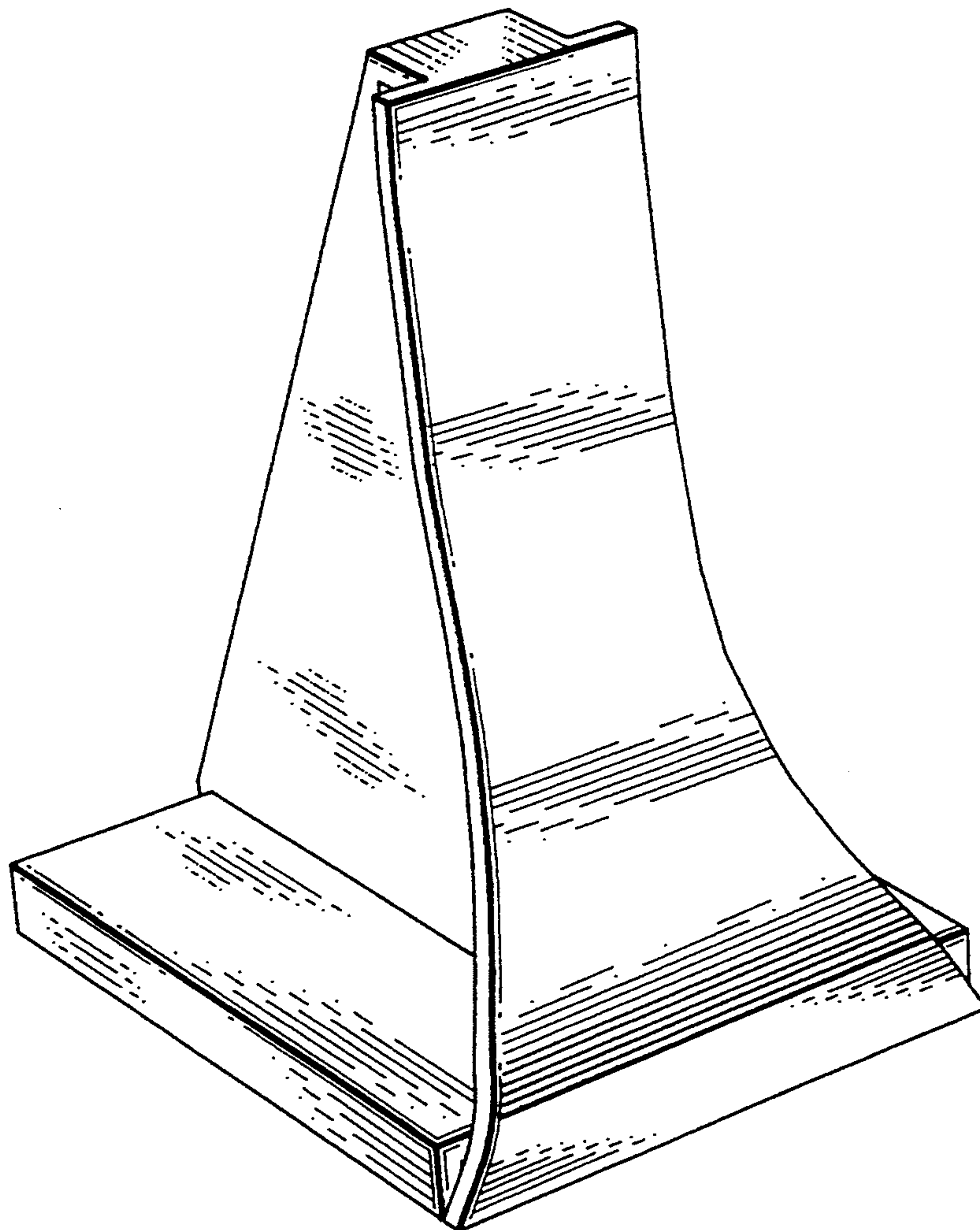
FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side thereof, to a reduced scale, the opposite side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



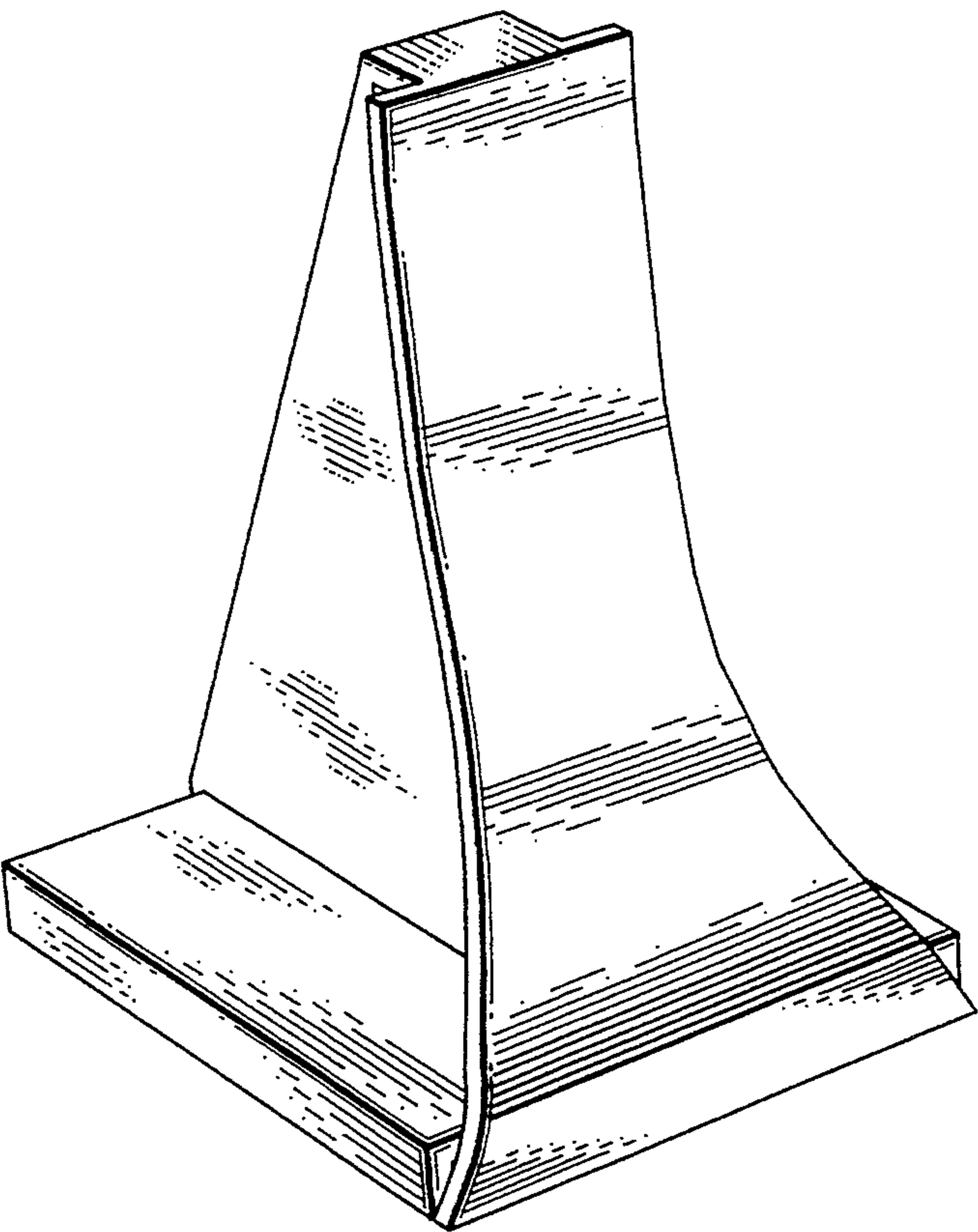

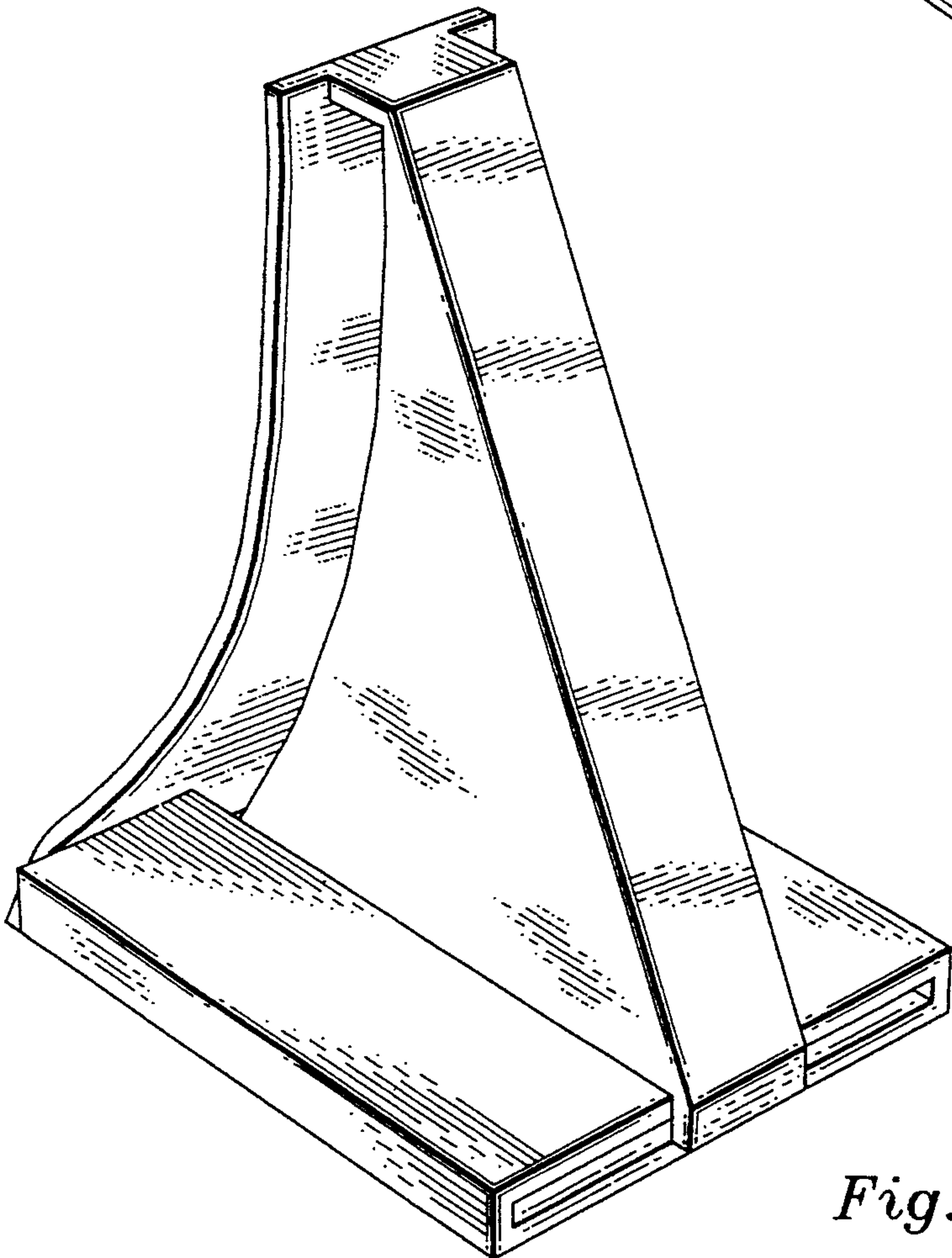

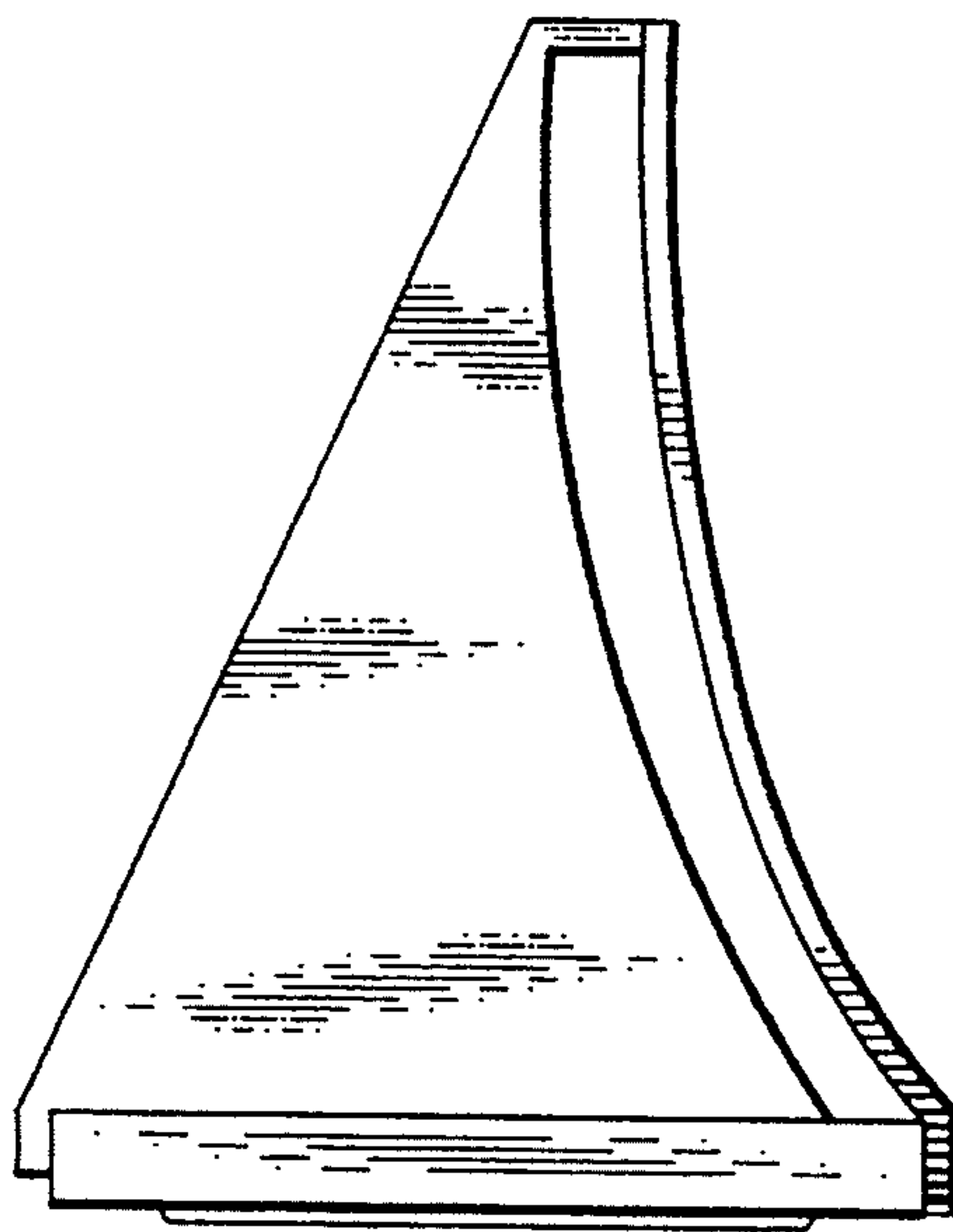

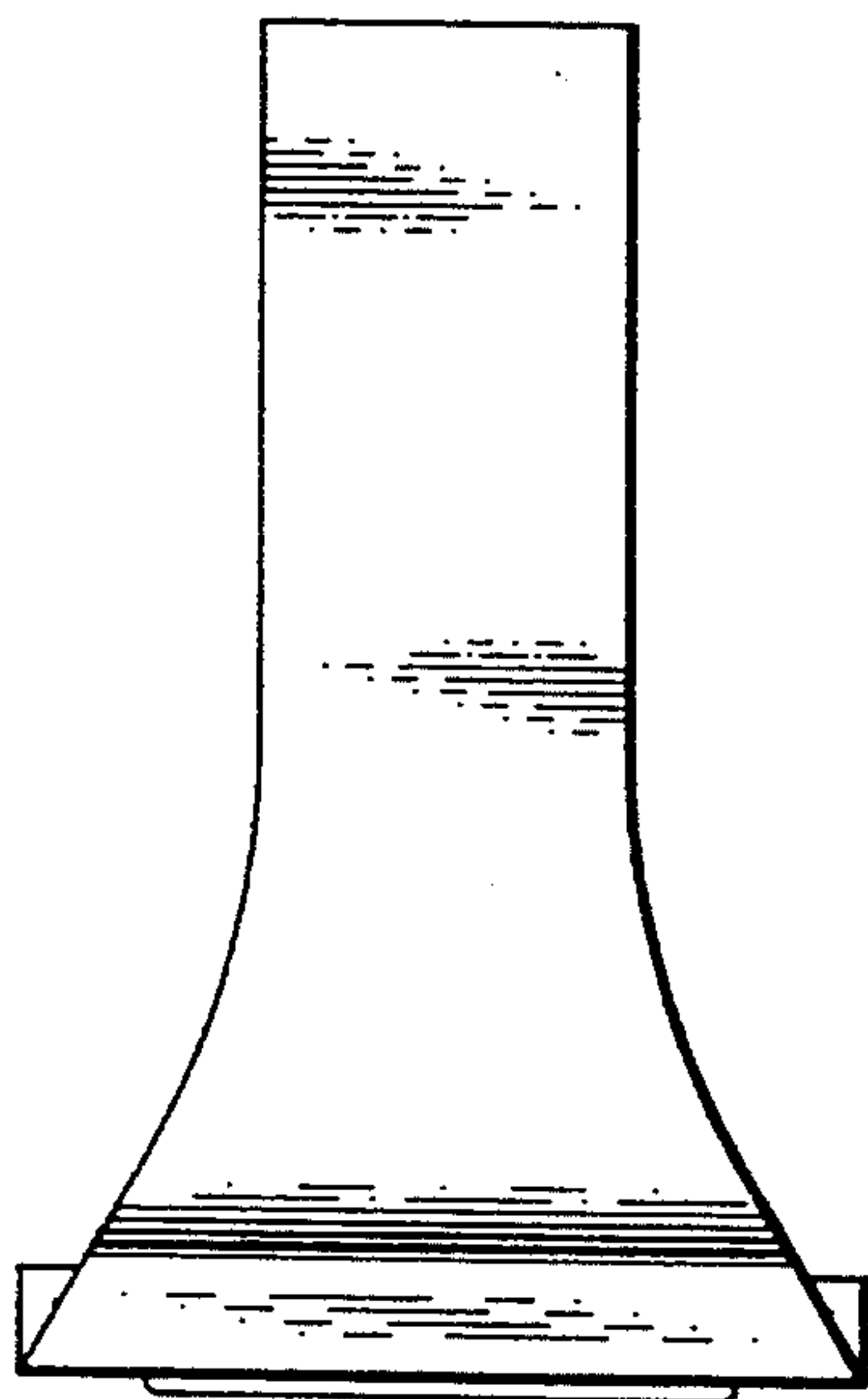

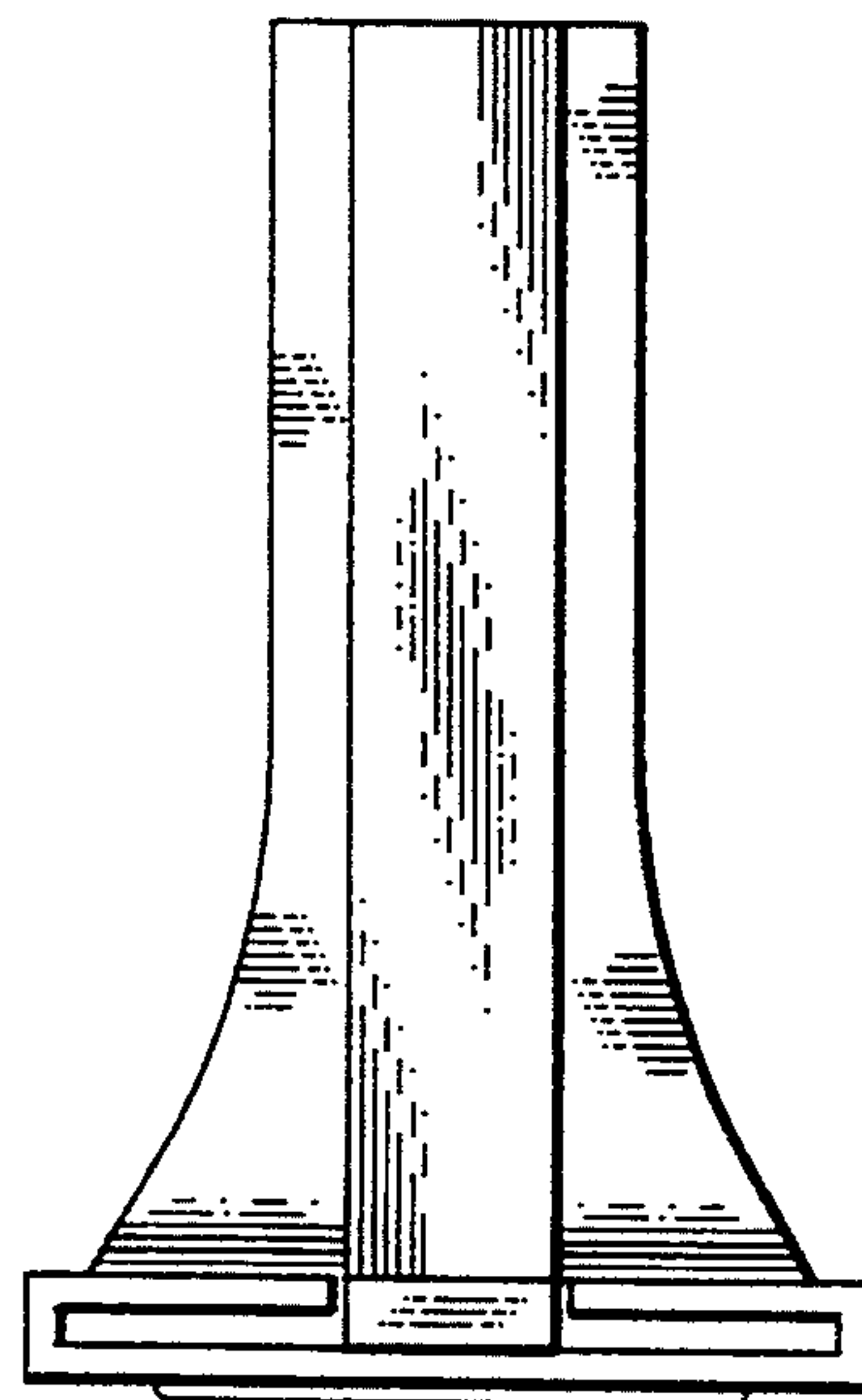

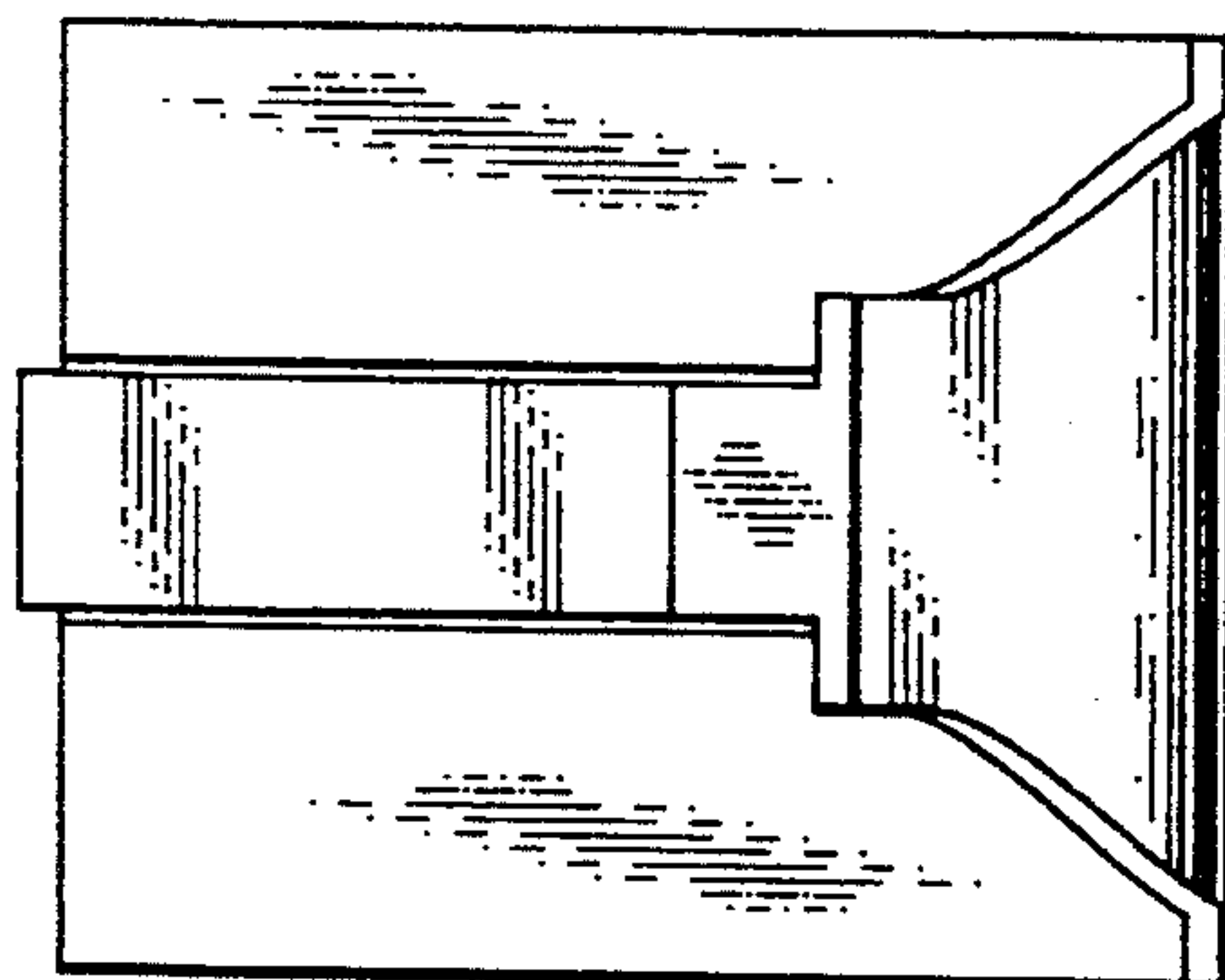

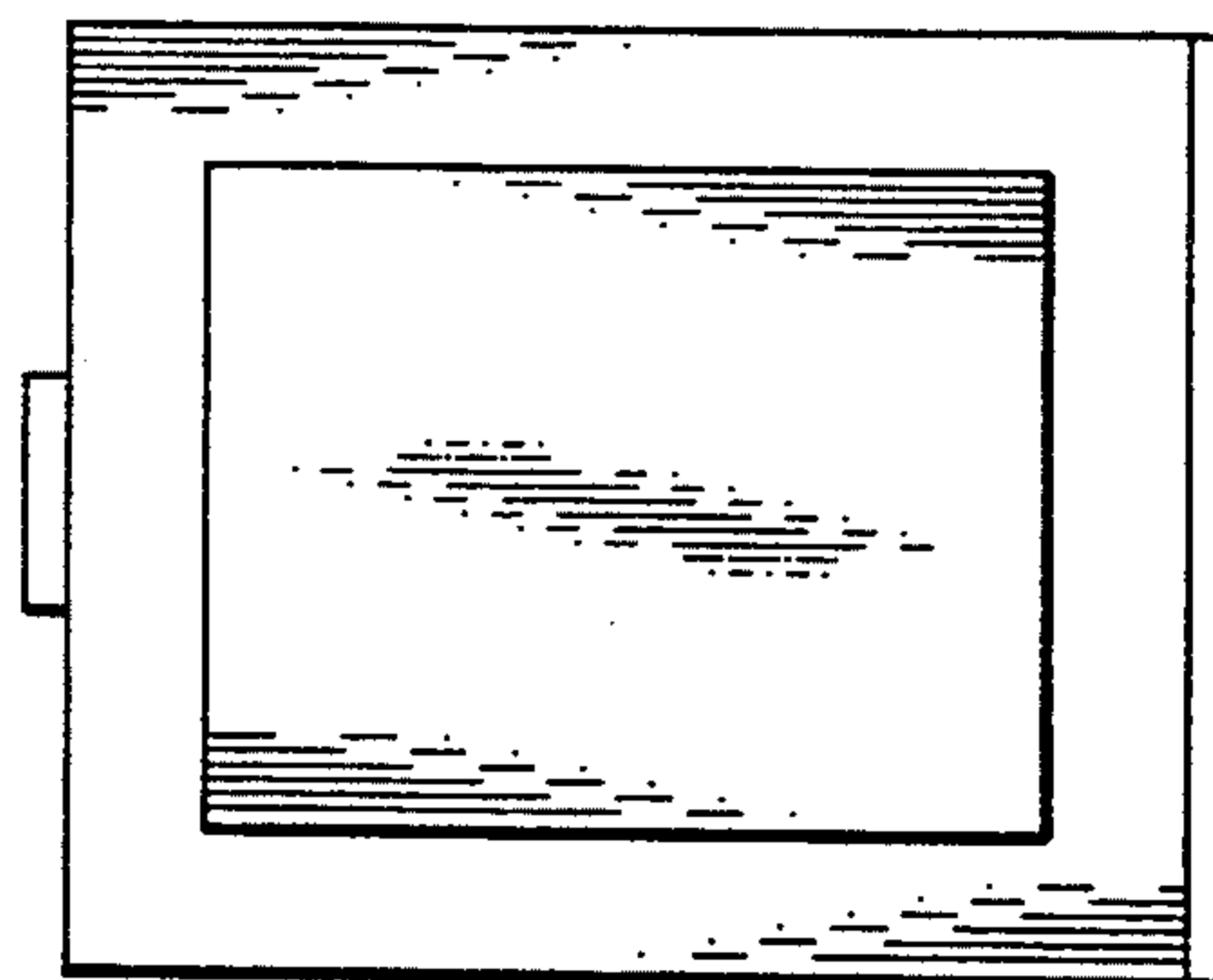
