The ornamental design for a glass lamp shade, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a glass lamp shade showing my new design;

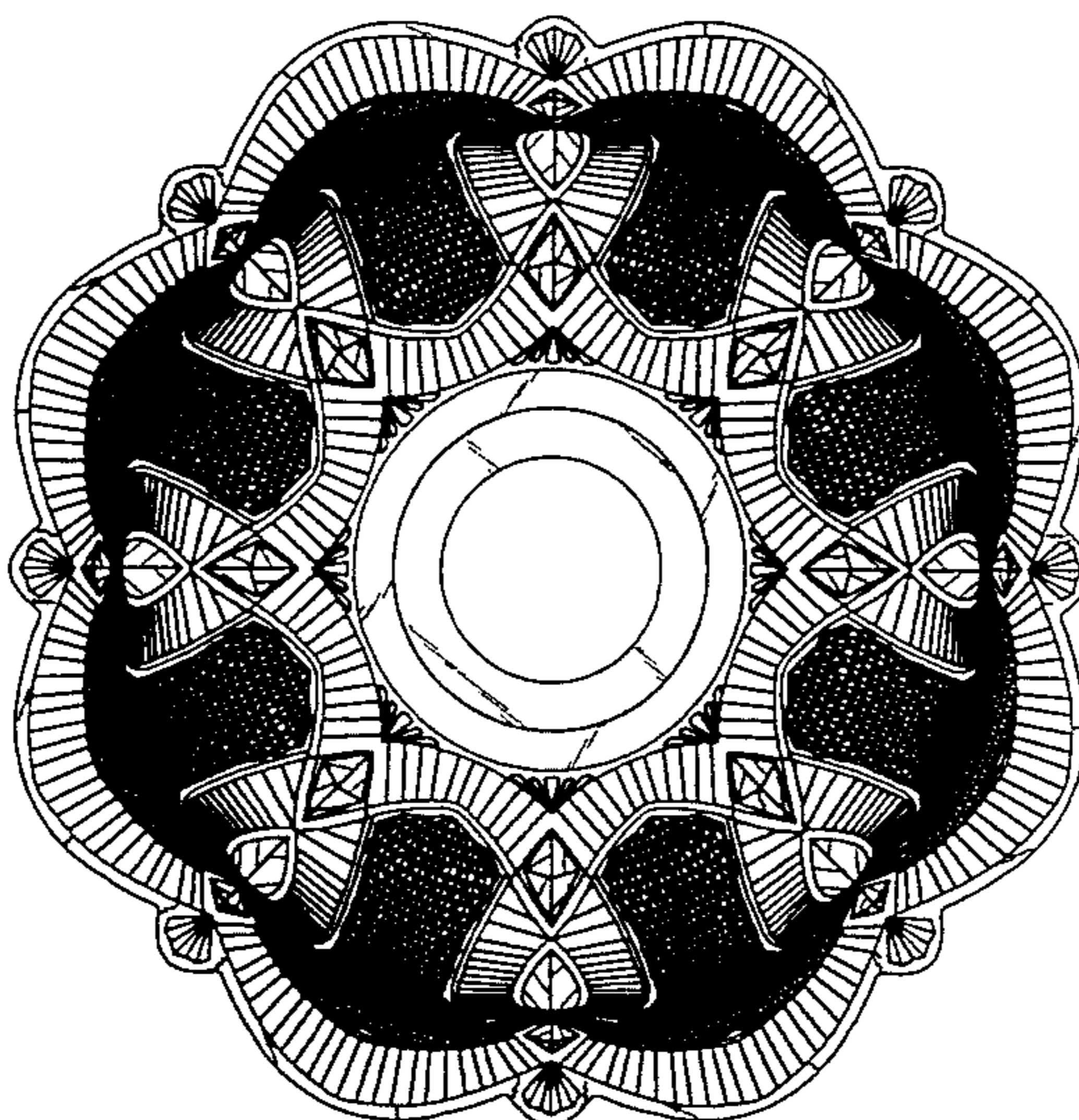
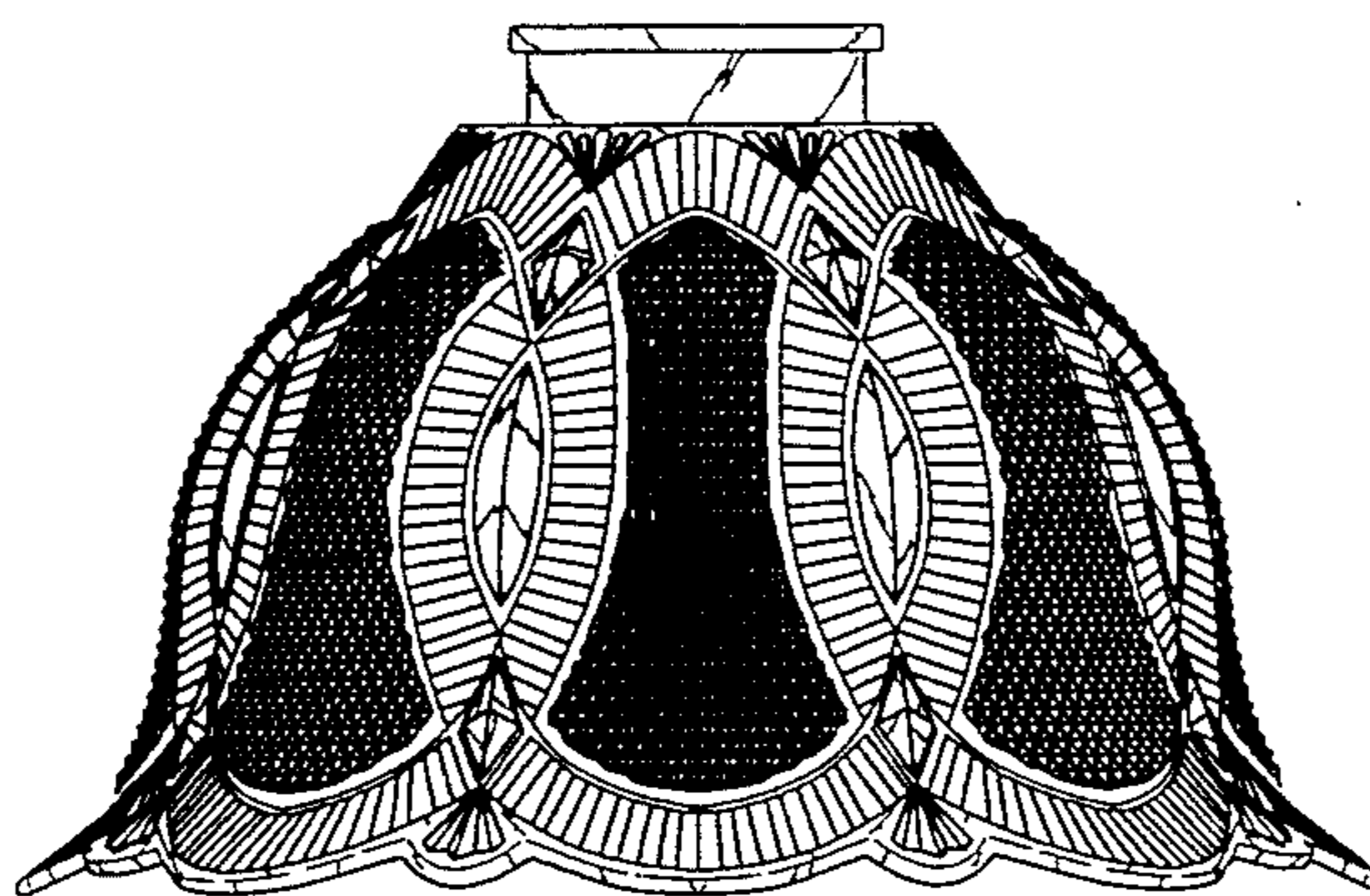
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear and side elevational views being identical;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the shade showing a portion of the surface pattern, the shade being fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration; and,

FIG. 6 is a second enlarged fragmentary view of the shade showing a portion of the surface pattern, the shade being fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration.



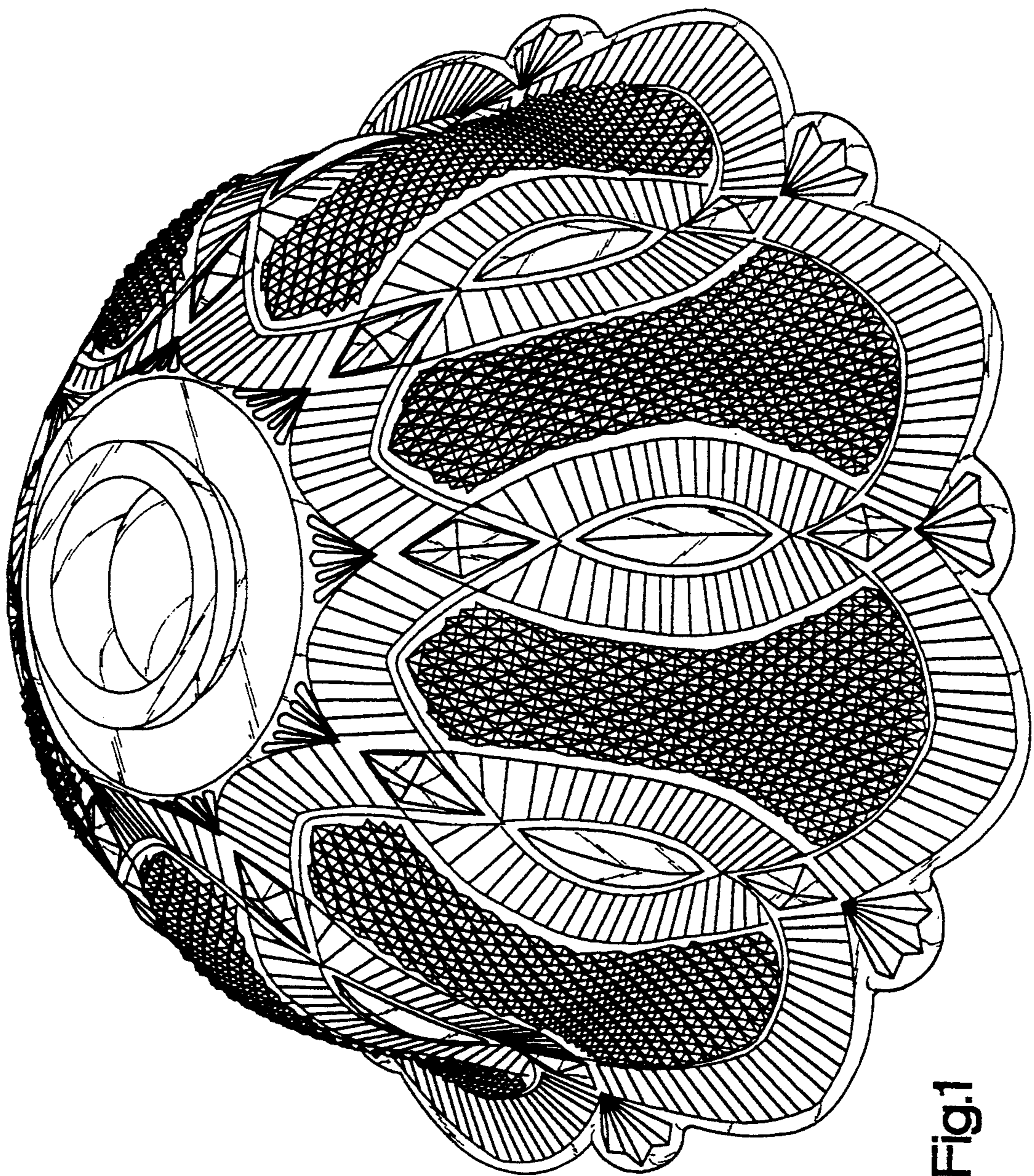

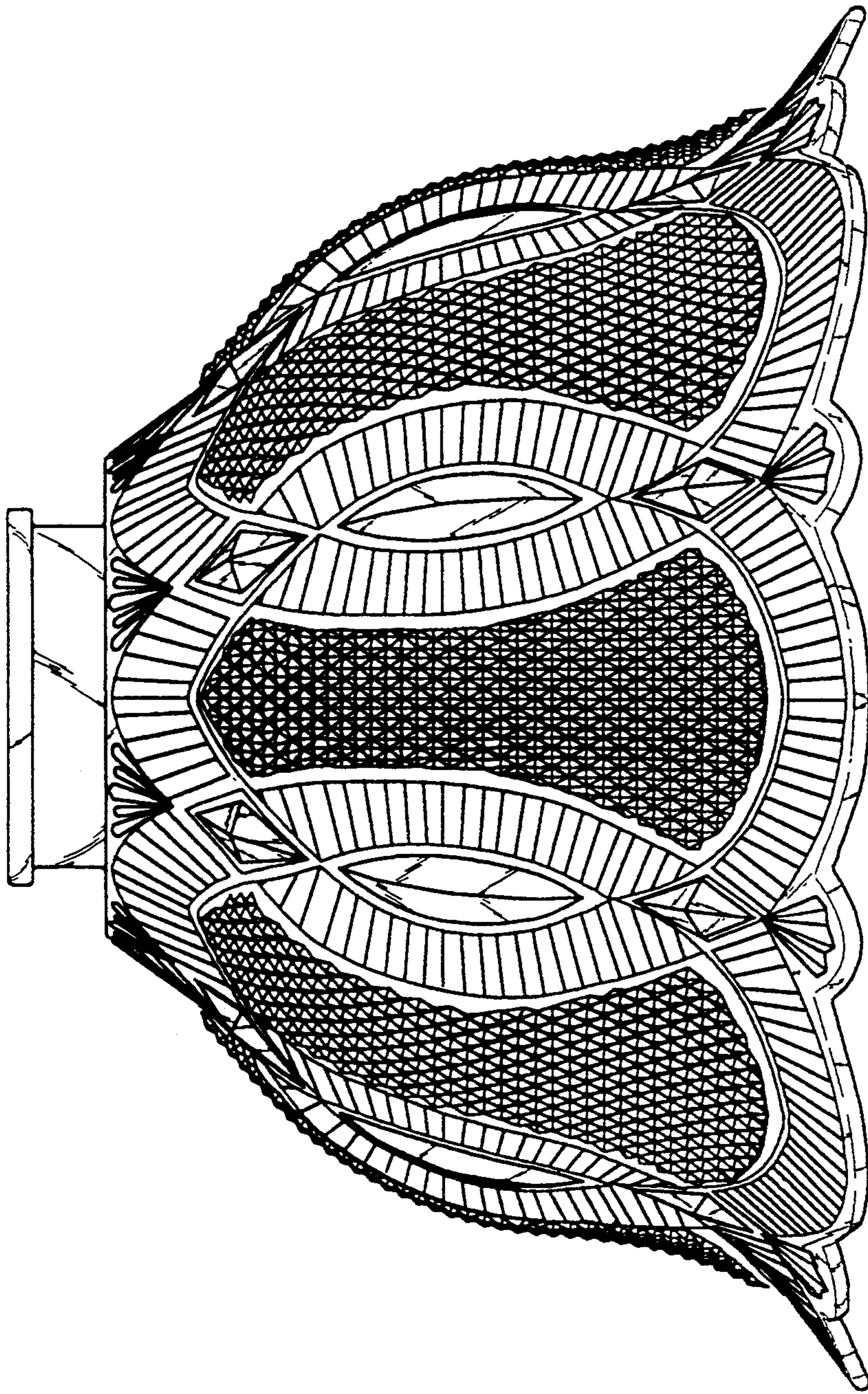

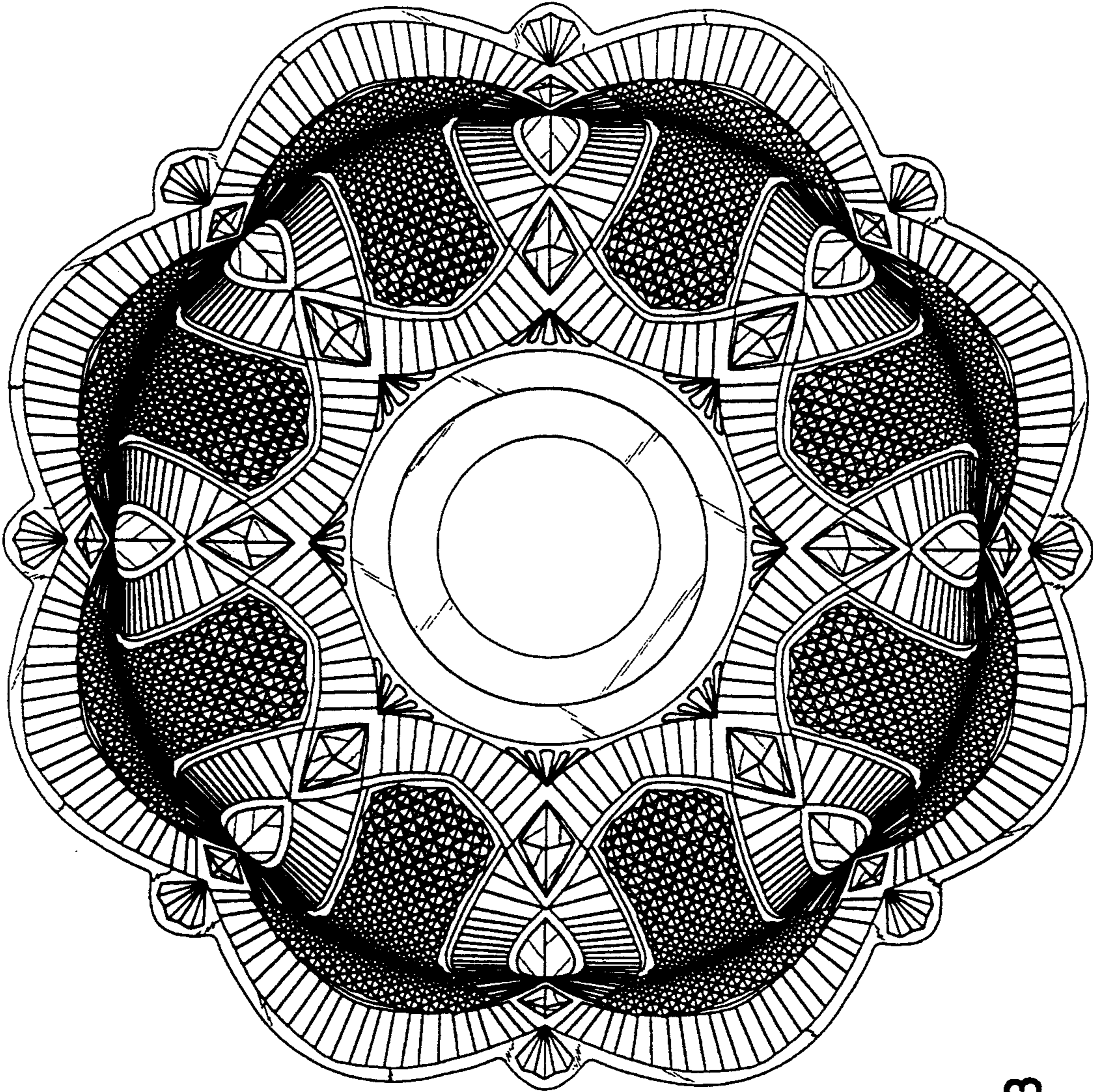

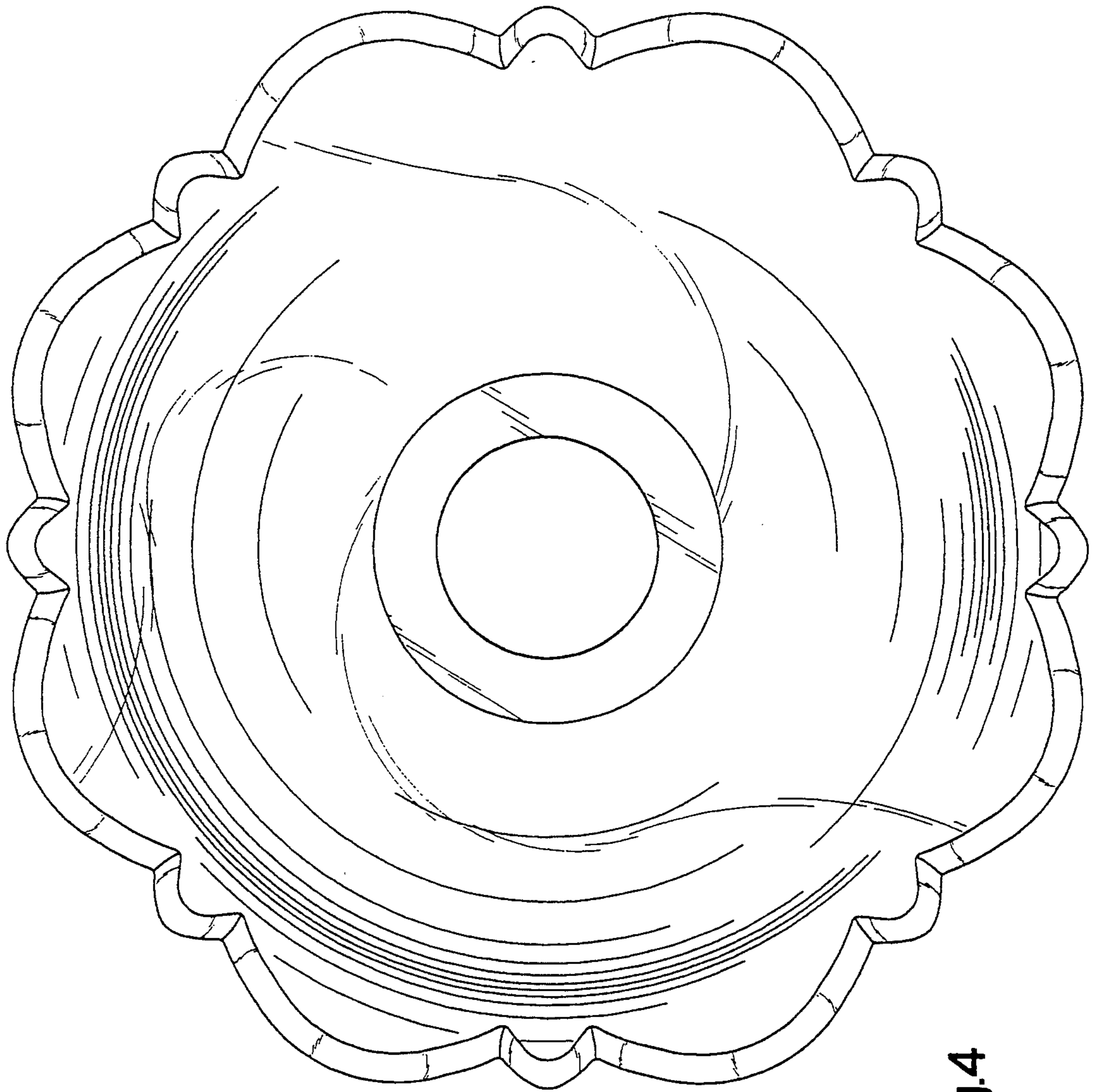

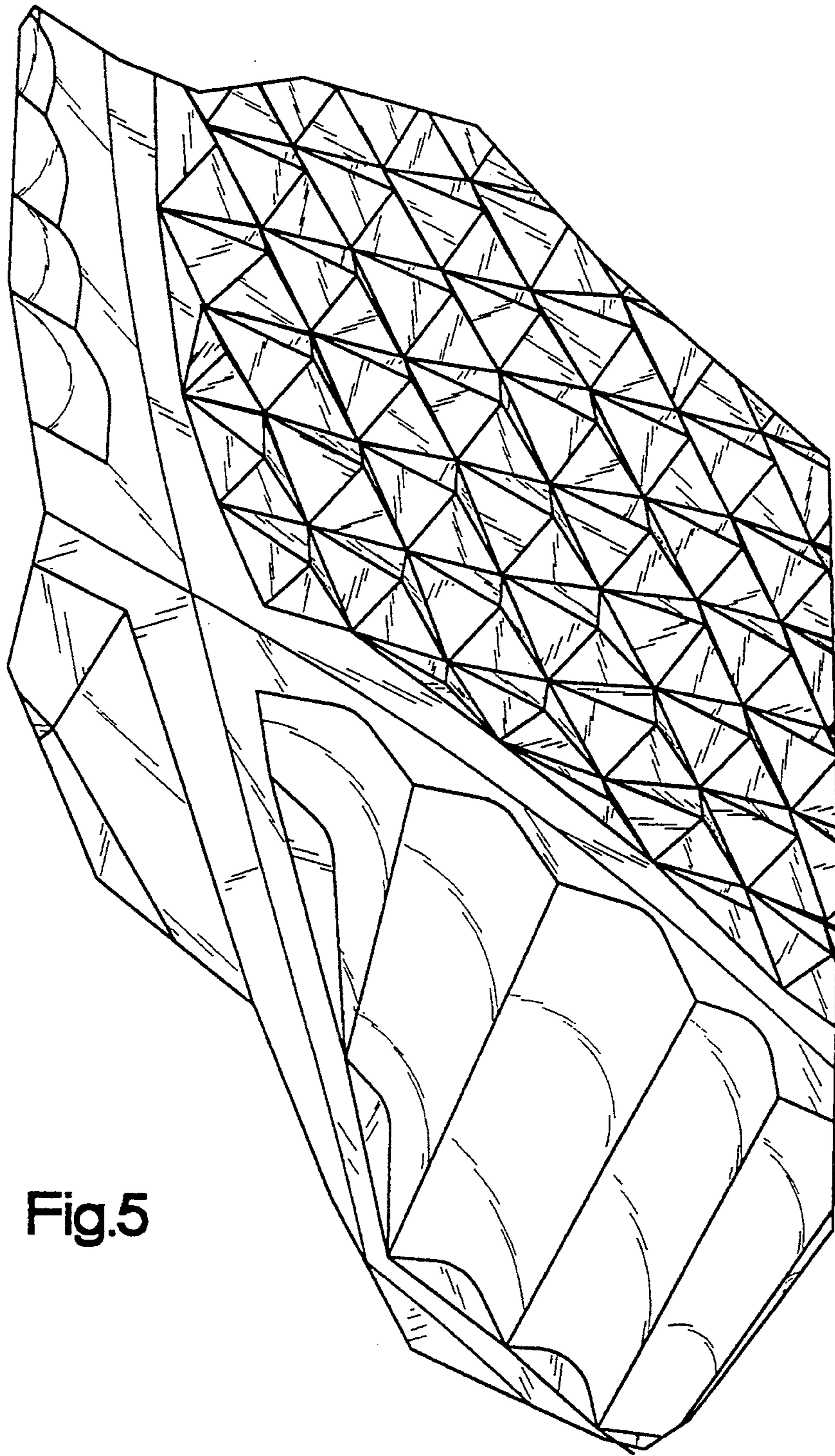

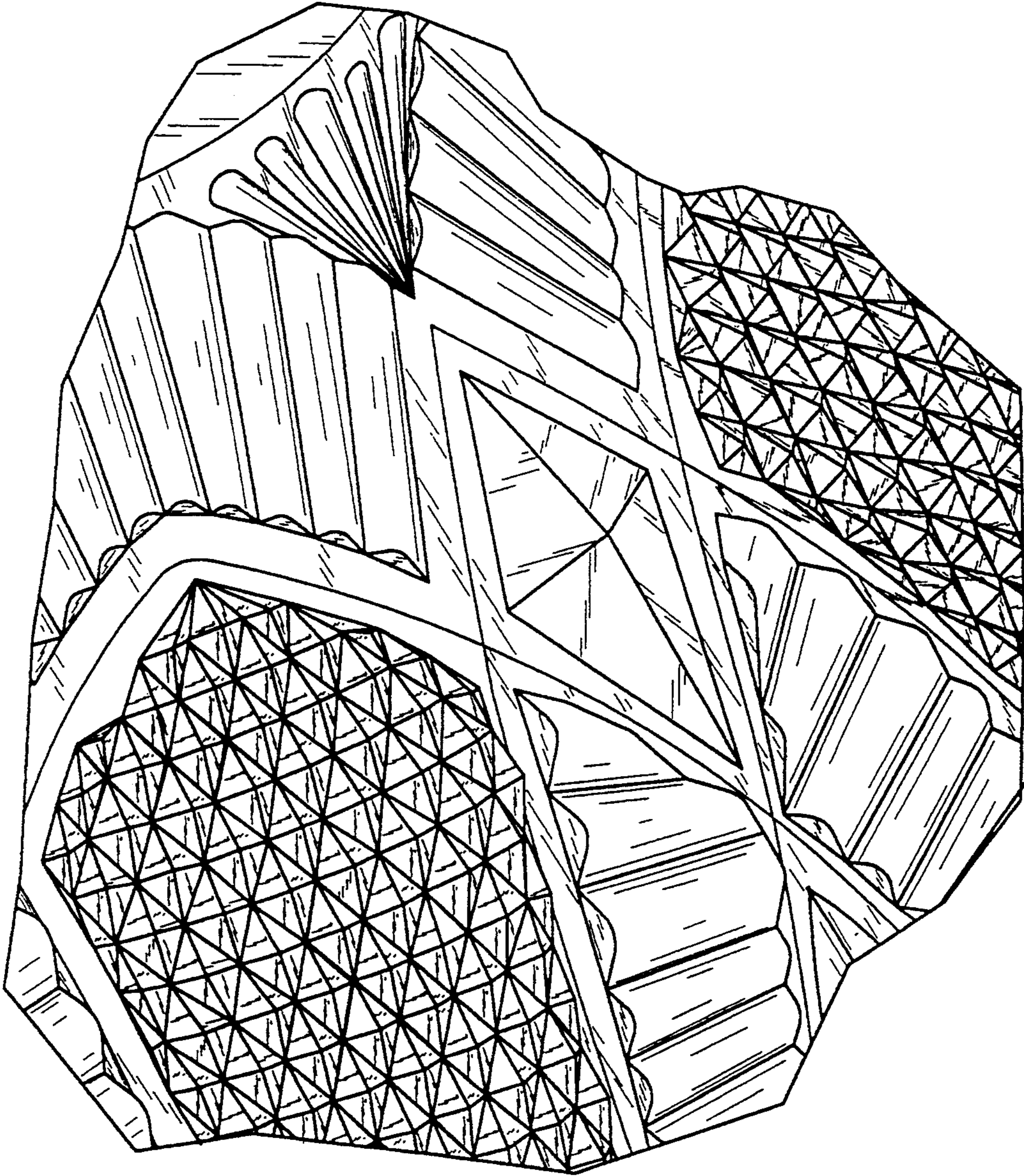
