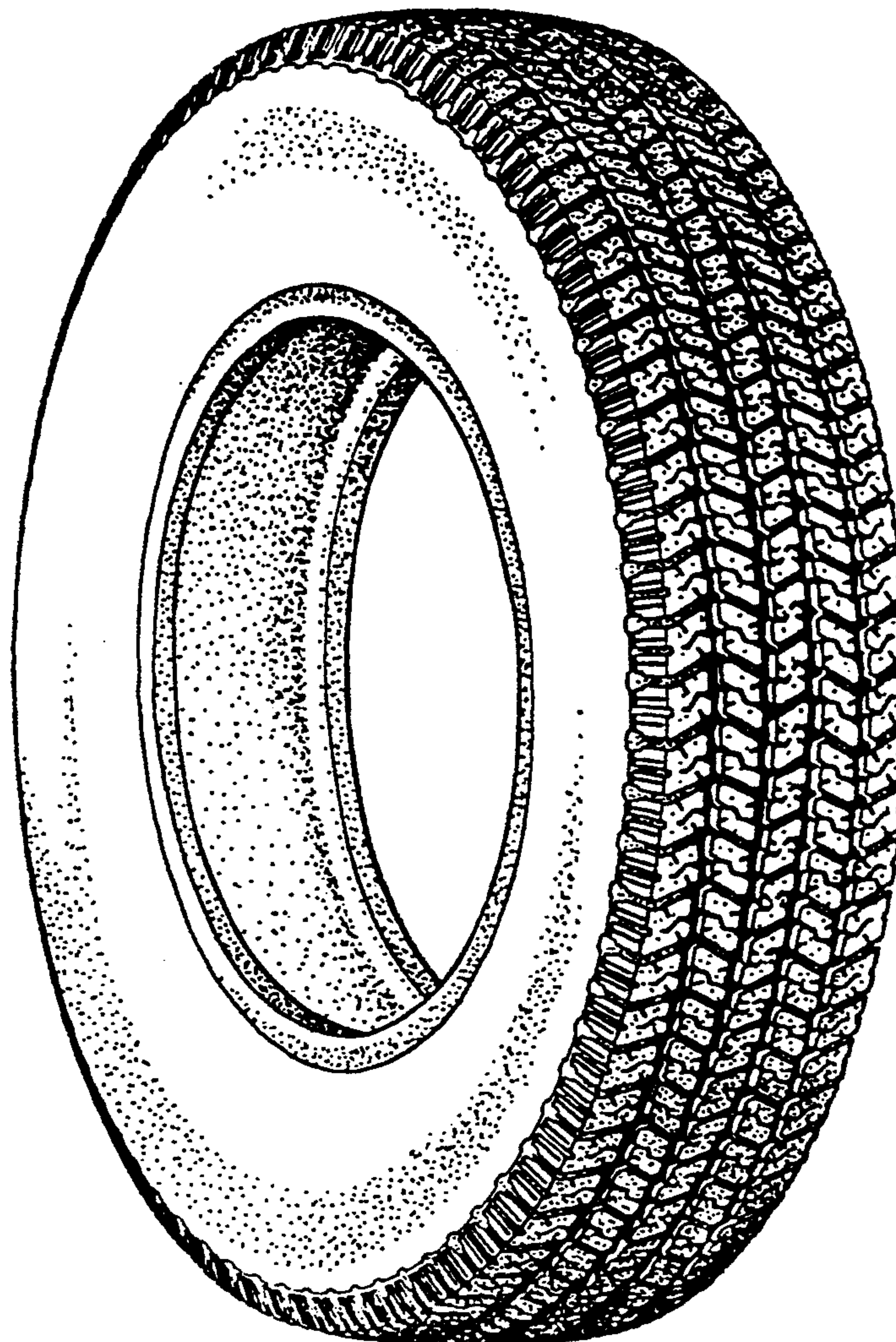

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tire showing my new
design, it being understood that the tread pattern is
repeated throughout the circumference of the tire, the
opposite side being substantially the same as that illus-
trated; and,

of the tread pattern of FIG. 1 showing my new design.



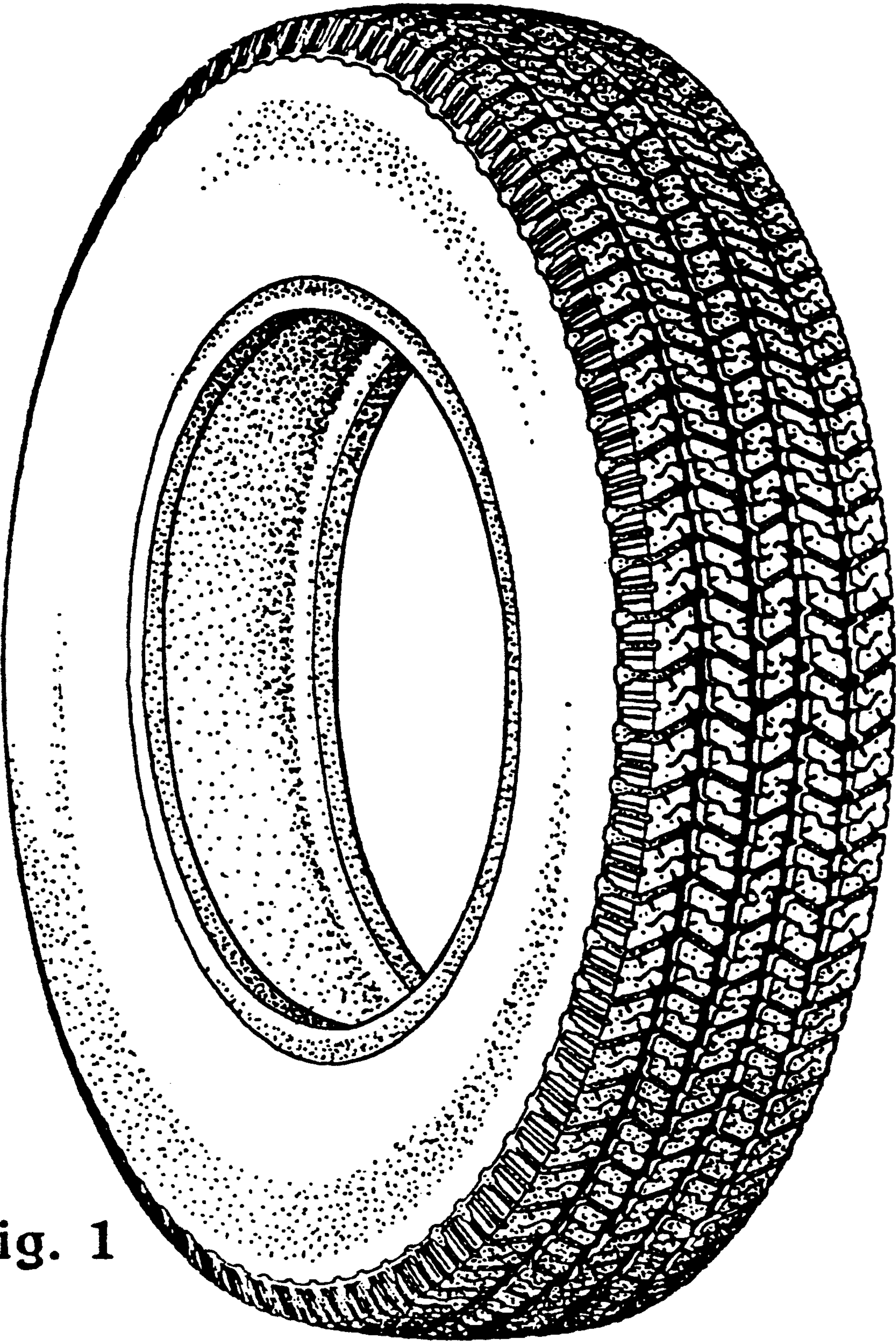
